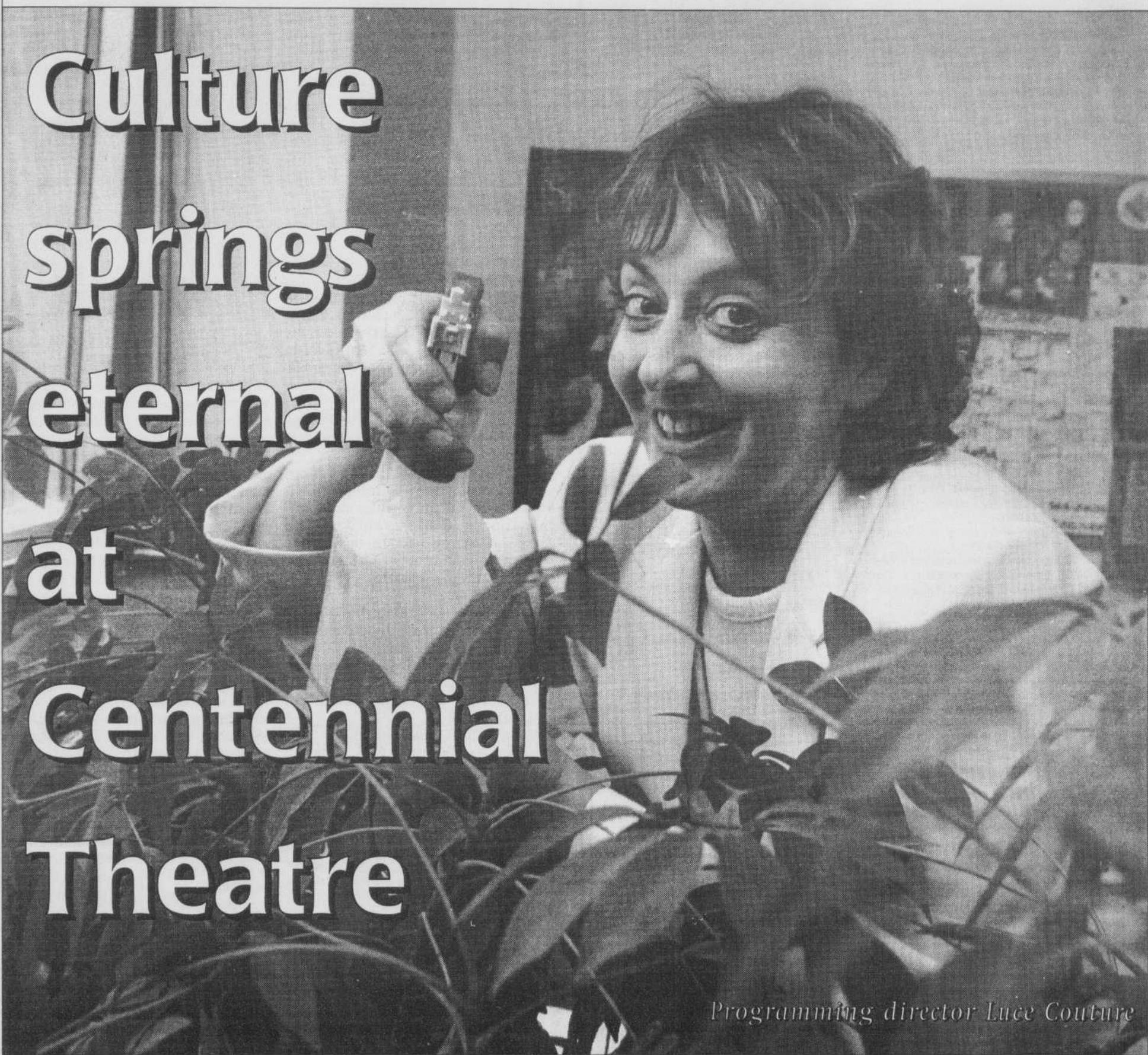

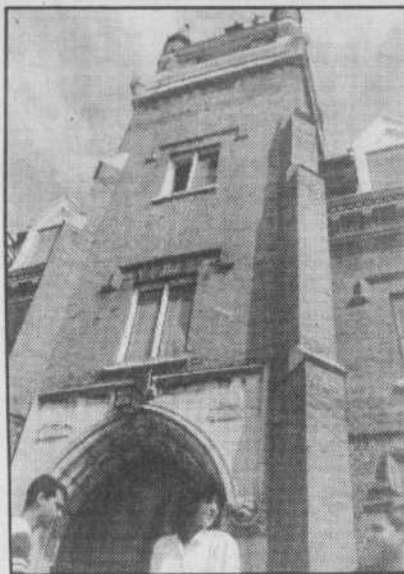

A pleasant evening at Fawlty Towers

Echo Art brings everybody's favorite innkeeper back to the stage this month as Basil Fawlty terrorizes the dinner theatre through Sept. 20.

Bill Petch leads a cast of local professional and amateur actors in two staged episodes of the popular 70s British TV series - "The Hotel Inspectors" and "The Wedding Guests."

This time out dinner patrons are part of the scenery as the show is designed to take place all over the barn theatre, not just on stage. This works so well that one hardly dares ask for a glass of water for fear of being yelled at!

"The Hotel Inspectors" features our miserable hero mistaking a hapless spoon salesman for a hotel inspector, with predictable results for the salesman.

In "The Wedding Guests," Basil gets on his moral high horse to sneer at an unmarried couple while fighting off a flirtatious guest, Miss Peignoir.

Through it all Sybil, Polly and Manuel try to make up for the ghastly behavior of their commander-in-chief.

Because the cast is not the same as last year, comparisons are inevitable. Petch is fine as Fawlty, tall and slender and somewhat similar in appearance to John Cleese. However, he lacks the manic energy Terry Simpson brought to his characterization and the marvelous variety of facial expressions.

Emma Stevens does double duty as actor-director. She plays the redoubtable Sybil with a snorting laugh and a more believable edge than Catherine Kessler. However, she is pretty much in the background as Petch has the major role and most of the lines.

Alison Muir reprises her role as Polly and she is excellent as usual. Muir is a gifted actress and seems natural in any of her roles.

Larry Hastings plays the much-maligned Manuel. He is funny and does a lot

of pratfalls, however his size does not lend itself to the hilariously put-upon obsequiousness of Sunil Mahtani's Manuel.

Darleen Bell is delightful as the flirty Miss Peignoir and Arthur Killkelly is solid as the exacting and eccentric spoon salesman who suffers the wrath of Basil. Chris Freeman, Micheala Barnes, Diana Severs, Jean-Charles Rivard and Rose Highfield all have a part to play in Fawlty Towers. Steve Stevens returns in his role as the Major.

This is not a perfect piece of theatre, but the flaws are fairly minor and the pacing is energetic enough to cover some rather uneasy English accents.

The second half is funnier than the first, as if the actors need the first act to warm up to their roles. The physical comedy tends to work better than the verbal witticisms and Basil and Miss Peignoir have some hilarious moments on the floor.

All in all, an evening at Fawlty Towers is a very pleasant way to end the summer theatre season in the Townships.

Strolling through Frelighsburg's artwork

Village becomes an art studio for Festiv'Art

Professional and amateur artists offered the public a feast of colorful landscapes, vibrant abstracts, representational paintings, wildlife art, photographs and sculptures at Festiv'Art over the Labour Day weekend in Frelighsburg.

More than 130 artists and 13,000 art lovers from across Quebec and Ontario visited the annual visual arts event. In all, 1,000 paintings and art objects were displayed on verandas, front lawns and street corners throughout the tiny town. Easels were everywhere, with many artists working while crowds admired their work.

"We've transformed our village into an outdoor art gallery," said Andrée Potter, a Frelighsburg resident described by local artists as the source of inspiration for the event.

"It's especially nice to be able to take the art out of the studio and into the street here where people are so appreciative," added painter Lynda Bruce. "We also get a chance to know other artists."

Festiv'Art is the largest festival of its kind in Quebec - definitely encouraging news for organizers Hélène Doucet-Levasseur and Johanne Ratté. Relying on a small team of volunteers, they rallied the community for a third-consecutive year, bringing together not just artists, but neighbors, businesses, teachers, students, and the local church - all in the name of promoting culture.

And it paid off. Promoting culture has brought a windfall of tourist dollars to the region. Last year alone, visitors bought \$70,000 worth of paintings and pumped thousands more dollars into the local economy. For restaurants, bed & breakfasts, and convenience stores, the impact is immediate. "But just as important, Frelighsburg is becoming known as a popular tourist destination," said Johanne Ratté. "This is a region where people will return again and again throughout the year to relax, enjoy the scenery, and benefit from all that we have to offer."

As well, the festival encourages

young Townshippers to develop their artistic talents. With this in mind, Hélène Doucet-Levasseur, a Festiv'Art organizer who also spearheaded Frelighsburg's Tourism, Art and Commerce group, was proud to present a cheque for \$250 to the local elementary school to help purchase art supplies.

Students were also involved in the amateur painting competition, and for the outstanding quality and promise of her representational work, 12-year-old Émilie Miller was voted the public's favorite amateur painter and awarded a cheque for \$150.

Relying on the generosity of local merchants and businesses, festival volunteers raised \$3,400 to be given to six artists. At the close of the festival, a panel of judges awarded Angela Coles of Stanbridge East the \$1,000 prize in the professional contemporary art category. Another professional, Rachel Labbé,

won the same amount for her representational art. In the amateur competition, Jean-Luc Proulx took the \$500 prize for his contemporary paintings, while Noémie McComber of Frelighsburg won the \$500 award for representational art for the third year in a row.

The public was also asked to vote for their favorite artists and they chose Marcel Mussoli, who was awarded \$250 as the public's choice for best professional painter, and Émilie Miller. The local church also raffled off a painting by Frelighsburg artist Noella Racine, won by Louise Mailloux.

Patricia Pépin was another artist who captured the public's attention. Her lifelike oil paintings of cougars, eagles, ducks, and wolves are incredibly detailed, passionate and alive. The self-

taught Bromont native recently earned a coveted place at the prestigious American Birds in Art exhibit and competition. Look out for the launch of Pépin's Studio Cormoran, where wildlife lovers will soon be invited to admire some of the animal portraits that riveted passersby this weekend.

Those who missed Festiv'Art 98 can still see the work of local painters, artists and craftspeople during La Tournée des 20, an organized tour through Dunham's wine region during September and October. Artists will include internationally-recognized Ayfer Gursov, Lynda Bruce, Linda Hobley, Mary Muir, and Angela Coles.

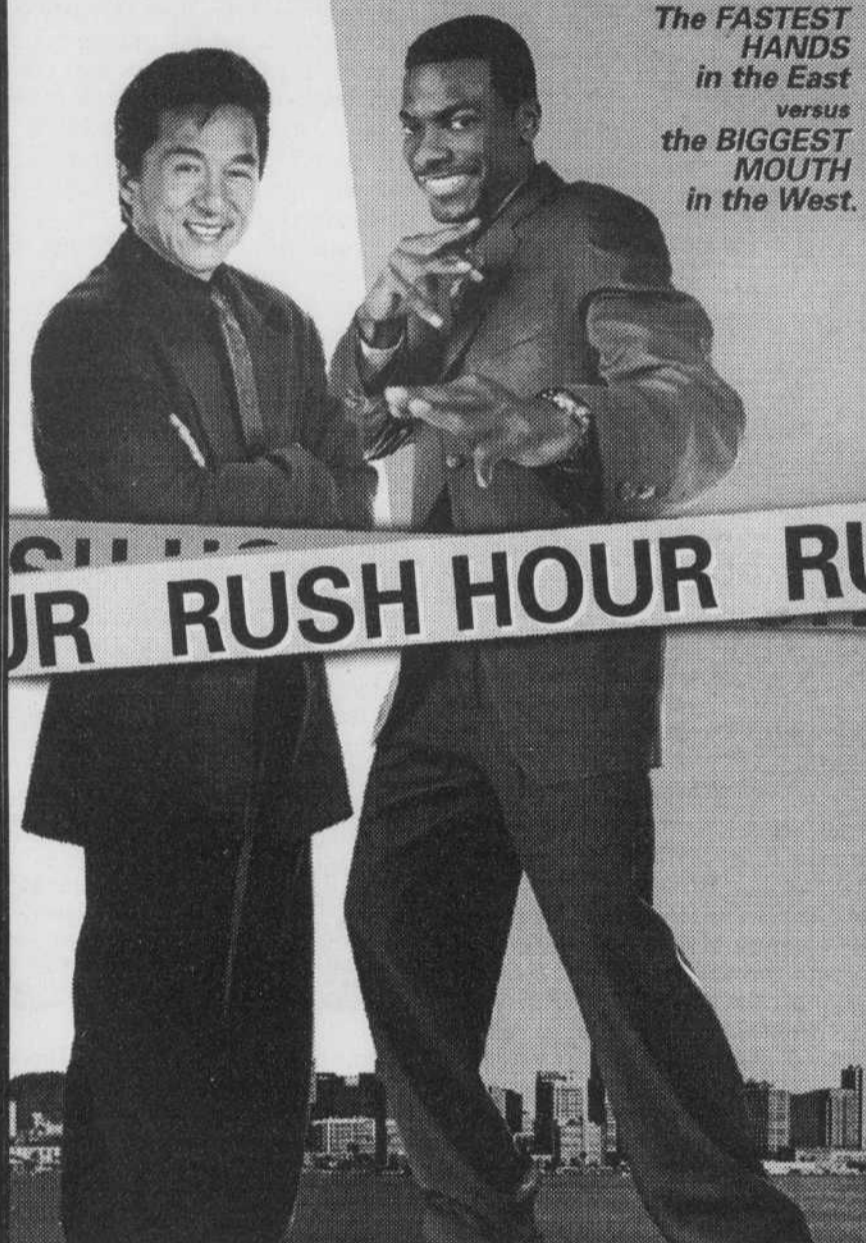

Montreal World Film Festival: Cinematic utopia

At most times when thinking of film and its future in our culture, the situation looks bleak. The analogy follows of film as a herd of sheep encircled by a pack wolves with the strongest sheep being a wolf in disguise.

While new cinemas are continuously opening, the justified fear is these will simply be an expanded platform for the Hollywood money mill, where the only content that really matters is that of the bags that pass between the theatres and the banks.

By international standards, Canada has a thriving film industry, home to some of the world's finest cinematic talents, still the Canadian film that makes its production costs back (don't even think about profit) is an anomaly. Our culture continues to exist not because we support it with our interest but because we support it with our taxes.

It comes down to festivals such as Montreal's World Film Festival to champion the beleaguered medium. The festival ran this year from Aug. 27 to Sept. 7 and more than played its part as defender of the hapless art. Caught within the swirl of the city center, film showed no sign of decline. For a short time, there was an oasis of cinemas ex-

hibiting non-formula flair. While the fest faced criticism from the media for a lacklustre gala line-up; compared with past invites Anthony Hopkins, Sidney Poitier and Rod Steiger, this year's highlight, Sandra Bullock, did not seem so spectacular.

Still it achieved its ultimate aim admirably.

From the opening to the closing, the festival easily demonstrated its dedication to showcasing films that have cultural resonance. It opened with the latest film from Quebec-born director-playwright Robert Lepage, *NÔ*.

"My first two films were made for the critics and myself (respectively), this one is for the people," said Lepage.

"For the people" could easily have been the motto for the festival on the whole.

In a time when Hollywood eclipses the works of smaller film industries so effortlessly, and technology has made going to the cinema a barely justifiable effort in nostalgia, the World Film Festival has been a bastion of hope. For a short while, downtown Montreal was a prototype for a cinematic utopia, where film was as much about community as entertainment and films from the 360 degrees of the world were experienced as easily as the latest Disney vehicle. Those who attended festival screenings understand why film is called the seventh art.

A new season of culture and entertainment is underway at Centennial Theatre at Bishop's University, where a diverse group of professional talents from the world over will stop in Lennoxville for a performance or two.

The main offerings at the non-profit theatre are grouped into two music series and a dance series.

"The series are more open to both the public and the students," said programming director Luce Couture.

The first music series features classical performers, including soprano Karina Gauvin with pianist Michael McMahon on Sept. 26.

"I had heard about her because she is a rising star in Montreal and around the world. She is getting very good reviews," said Couture.

The Atelier de l'Opéra de Montréal will present Donizetti's comic opera *Elisir d'amore* on Jan. 31, followed by internationally renowned classical guitarist Rémi Boucher on Feb. 13.

The Gryphon Trio, a chamber music group consisting of a pianist, a cellist and a violinist, will play March 27.

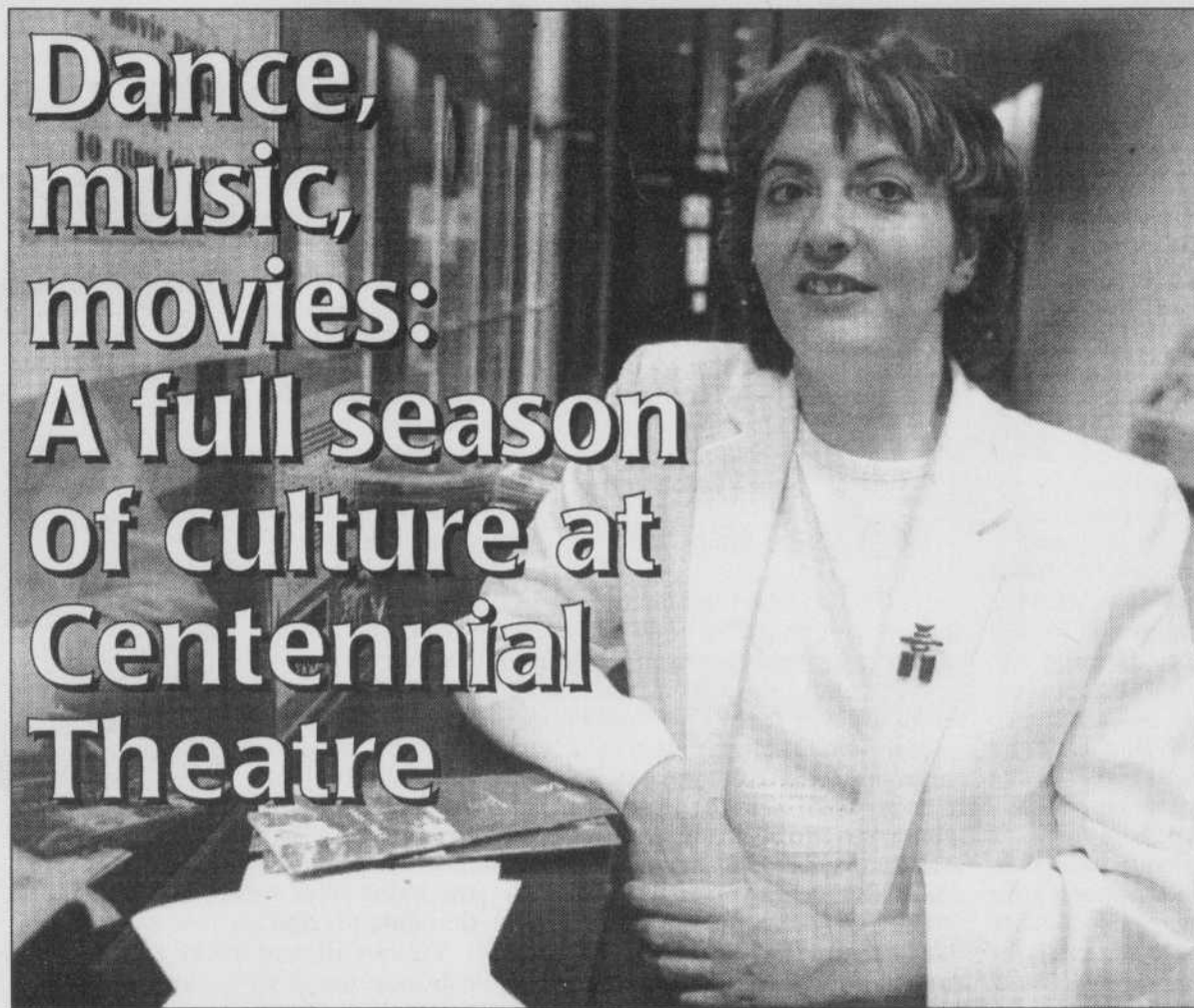
"They are the kind of classical performers who are able to communicate their love of music. Even if it is very difficult contemporary music, you can understand. It is one of the best trios I know," Couture said.

The second music series, consisting of jazz and world beat, will open with Quèba, 11 salsa musicians. The group is composed of Quebec and Cuba natives.

"They are going to play all kinds of instruments and salsa. This show should be simply amazing," Couture said.

Pianist and composer Lorraine Desmarais will play with trumpeter Tiger Okoshi and other musicians on Nov. 28. Desmarais has won prizes at the Montreal Jazz Festival and around the world.

Okoshi will also give a master class to students.

"Lorraine Desmarais is very good but also very accessible. It is not the fusion, eclectic jazz. She plays a style that is more liked by people in this region, more mainstream," Couture said.

The last show of this series will be *Quartango*, a group of four musicians who play traditional and modern tango, on Feb. 27.

"Last year, when I discovered them, they were my coup de coeur. They are

funny when they play, they move a lot and they talk to the public, French and English, it does not matter. They were one of the classiest acts that I saw," Couture said.

The dance series is offered in collaboration with the University of Sherbrooke since they have a bigger hall. They will host the more classical dance shows while Centennial will present the modern shows.

The Grands ballets canadiens will perform Hoffman's *Coppelia* on Oct. 14 at the University of Sherbrooke.

The dance company Cas Public will be back, after the success of its *Suites Furieuses*, to present *Incarnation* on Oct. 28 at Bishop's. The company will also be in residence at Bishop's University starting Sept. 13, where they will be rehearsing for the debut of *Incarnation* in St-Jerome on Oct. 23. The university will hold an open house for those who wish to attend rehearsals.

The Townships dance company Sursaut will present its critically acclaimed *The Nutcracker* with more than 25 dancers, actors, jugglers and acrobats on stage. This family-oriented show will be presented at the University of Sherbrooke on Dec. 5. This will be followed on March 30, back at Centennial, by the dance company Carré des Lombes with choreography by Danièle Desnoyers.

Shows designed for schools and families include Tuyo's *Ancient Modernity*, in which performers invent their own instruments, on Nov. 6. They are mostly known in Europe.

Another interesting show for

Here's my review for this week:

BRADY SEALS, Brady Seals, (Warner Bros.)

It's been a while since Brady Seals left the popular group Little Texas to pursue a career on his own. His first album didn't sell much but I think things will be different following this sophomore effort.

Seals is a talented musician, a good singer and a gifted songwriter. He wrote or co-wrote seven of the 10 songs on this album. He also co-produced it with veteran Rodney Crowell, a man who knows a lot about writing or singing a hit.

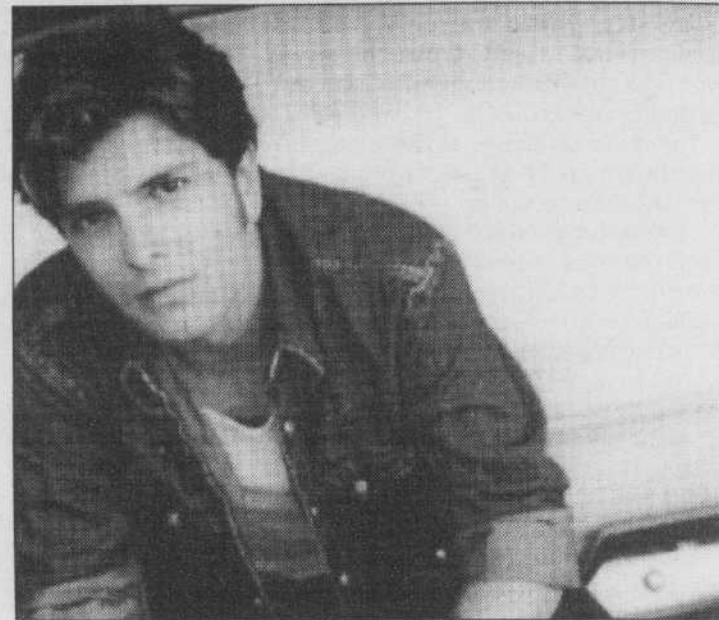
From beginning to end Seals seems like he found the perfect place to stand, this thin line in between contemporary and traditional country music.

There's a good balance of ballads, wailing violins, steel guitars and more

sophisticated guitar riffs on up-tempo material. The first single "I Feel" is a clever medium-tempo song which is very appealing to radio listeners.

There's also "Whole Lotta Hurt," about the many regrets suffered by a man after losing his girlfriend while "Country as a Boy Can Be" is a wry resumé of Seals country roots, including shelling black-eyed peas and getting his first whipping in the barn after sampling (drinking) Grandma's recipe.

Vince Gill and Ricky Skaggs contribute some great harmony but back vocal is not the only place they can be found on this album. Their influence on Brady Seals' work is all over, most

prominently on "Summer Night Lovin' You," a bluegrass-flavored tune.

"You're My Kind of Woman" is traditional as can be and could easily belong to the repertoire of artists such as Vince Gill, George Strait or Alan Jackson. Seals delivers it perfectly.

The collection includes strong material and the arrangement leaves him a lot of room to show what he could do as a singer. Seals used this freedom to good advantage as he gave his best to make this second album a winner.

Who knows what the future will hold, but I think already established artists have just found some pretty stiff competition with this new Brady Seals collection.

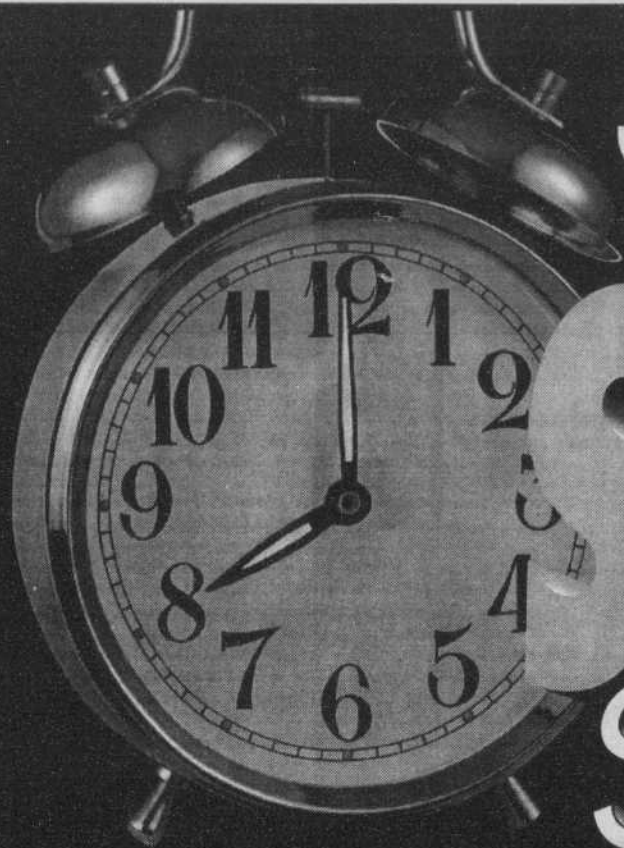

New programs, competition for first Canadian all-news network Change is in the air for Newsworld's 10th

CBC Newsworld, the first Canadian all-news network, begins its 10th season this month with several new programs.

When CBC Newsworld launched in 1989, it faced competition only from the United States-based CNN. Today, contenders include CTV News 1; CablePulse 24, the first local cable news channel offering "MegaCity News" to southern Ontario; CNBC, headquartered in Fort Lee, N.J.; and the upcoming Report on Business TV, based on its namesake publication.

"The world of television is becoming very competitive, and we're accepting that challenge with vigor," said Tony Burman, who took over the reins of the network last February.

The first change is in the channel's early morning programming, with CBC Morning replacing the CBC Morning News.

The program is designed to take on the competition, starting at the same time as CTV's Canada AM. It borrows more than its time slot from CTV; former Canada AM anchor Nancy Wilson hosts from Toronto, while Norma Lee MacLeod and Mark Kelley are on the Halifax desk.

Former CBC Morning News anchor Bill Cameron hosts Newsworld International and Newsworld Today. Both programs include BBC World News. In between the two programs, Anne Petrie hosts Absolutely Canada, a roundup of news from CBC local stations.

Weekday evenings, senior correspondent Ali-

son Smith hosts Newsworld Reports, an extended version of the existing The Lead, which examines the day's top stories in depth. Immediately following Newsworld Reports is The Strip, a prime-time block including Evan Solomon's Hot Type, Daniel Richler's Big Life and Laurie Brown's On the Arts. The shows remain separate, but look for some of the hosts to drop in on one another's shows.

Avi Lewis moderates counterSpin, a debate show airing four nights each week. Burman said he expects the program to become an important battleground for those trying to influence public opinion.

The popular Pamela Wallin returns for another season, but at the end of each work week, the show will add a different

co-host for a "house party," as CBC Newsworld cameras roam through gatherings of the rich and famous.

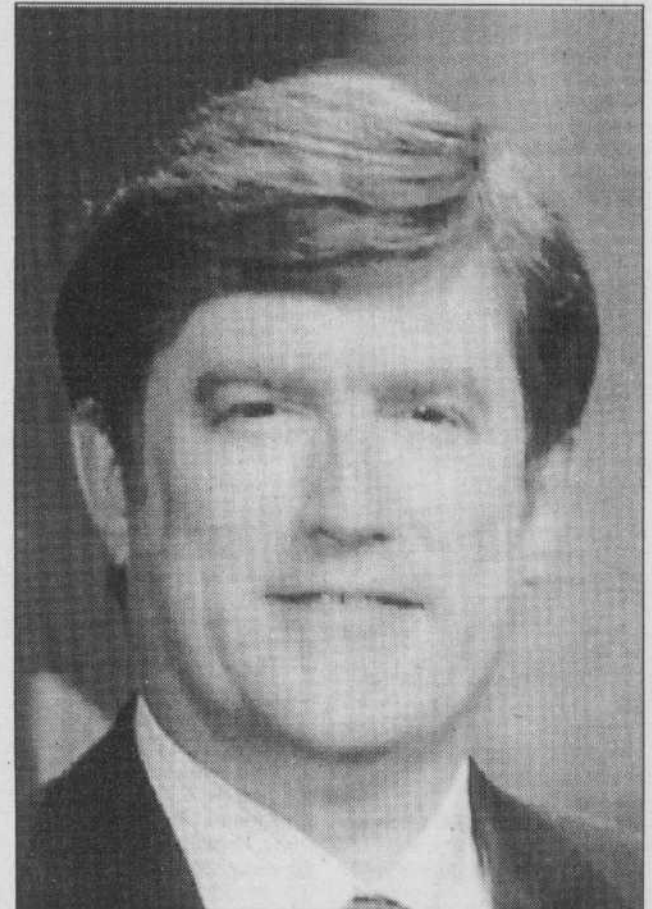
Wallin leads the informal conversations on the show, which promises to be either the next thing in talk TV or an unmitigated disaster.

Ralph Benmergui, who knows all about talk show disasters, is back in his old Friday night time slot with Not Just the News.

Benmergui, who will continue to host Benmergui Live, looks at the week's political satire in print, stage, music, cartoons, and, of course, CBC comedy shows.

Bill Cameron hosts Newsworld International and Newsworld Today on the network which celebrates its 10th season this year.

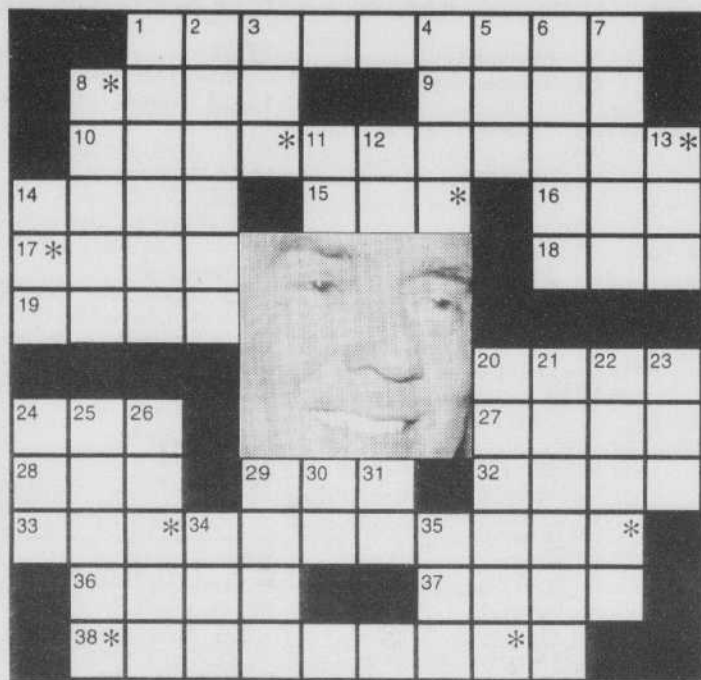
