Who says there's nothing good on TV?

Last Monday, found artist Fabienne Lasserre and her assistant were surrounded by 100 television sets.

Banks of television sets forming elaborate works had been set up and everywhere at their feet were black and white television sets.

"This is the show in progress," Lasserre explained, taking time out

from the very physical job of mounting her work in her exhibit entitled *The Cave*.

"On the screens, I've used black outdoor oil housepaint. I paint the whole screen black and then I etch out the pictures. My boyfriend does etching," Lasserre laughed, "and I borrowed his tools."

"When the screens are all turned on in the black room, the effect is like stained glass. The light goes only where the etching has been. It makes a nice sound and it flickers because the images move and it's bluish."

Walking around the room from television set to television set, the powerful influence of mythology is felt.

"I am inspired by mythology of every different culture and epoch and pop culture and the link between the past and the present as if monsters, heroes and gods are the same with different appearances," Lasserre said, pointing out some of the different works.

"I am looking at Mickey Mouse, Calimero, dragons and goddesses. They're not really mythological characters, but inspired by mythology and mixed and blended together," she explained.

"I wanted to use images of different kinds of power, use satire, humour and black humour at the same time as something as something religious. I like to look at this as a little Chapel or a cave with religious paintings on the wall - a contemporary chapel made with garbage tv's."

One large installation of sets involves a boiling pot containing ninja turtles and cartoonish animals mixed with elephants and a cat.

Another group of sets involves a large goddess with three breasts and three heads exploding in different directions. This illustrates the goddess is changing identity. A voodoo goddess smoking a cigarette with an animal on her head is

portrayed standing on a lotus flower. She has cut one of her breasts off. In one hand she holds the breast and in the other, a knife. Lasserre has done her research.

"I'm always looking at and reading about India. I lived in Mexico," she said. "I like the Aztec and Mayan legends a lot. There is a balance between good and evil, creation and destruction coming from cycles. I like the colours they use in their paintings."

When asked if she missed using colour, Lasserre looked thoughtful.

"Right now I'm painting and I'm using every colour I can, so there must be a connection," she said.

The *Cave* exhibit runs until April 2 at Bishop's University Art Gallery. The gallery will be closed from Feb. 29 to March 3 during March break.

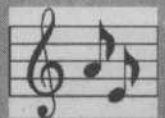

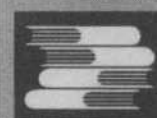

Cupid's arrow hits the mark at Casa Chirico

Any time is a good time for lovers and Casa Chirico proved it by holding over its special menu for lovers until the weekend when snow was cleared from the region's massive Valentine's Day storm.

The romantically-inclined menu included a plate sized heart-shaped pasta stuffed with cheese (Coeur de Cupidon), Veal cutlets a la Don Juan, Escargots Romeo and Potage Julietta, Cappellini Ethena and other delicacies named in honour of the world's great lovers.

Many of the weekend diners enjoying the special menu at the cozy Italian eatery admitted they were belatedly celebrating Valentine's Day. Others had already discovered the fine menu and taste of Southern Italy offered up there regularly by chef Salvatore Beltrano.

Casa Chirico is located across the street from Sherbrooke's Musée des beaux arts on Dufferin Street and at first glance gives the impression it is the storage centre for overflow art from the museum. Not a square inch of wall space is left unadorned in the rambling basement that winds into three separate dining areas each with its own eclectic collection of posters and paintings that defy a theme. The madonna and child share a wall with the chef's own creative endeavours and scenes of Italy abound.

But the real artistry is in the food. We began our lover's special with a bowl of steaming mussels (Moules Cyrano) and

the stuffed heart-shaped pasta (Coeur Enflammé) covered in a delicate tomato sauce made from fresh Italian tomatoes and just a touch of basil.

The chef's potage followed, delivering a thick and creamy vegetable purée.

My choice for main course was Saumon Molisano, a thick salmon filet in a white wine sauce which was served with strips of homemade pasta and colourful al dente vegetables. The linguini Amatriciana was equally delicious and the chef's lightly seasoned sauce was a real treat for pasta aficionados. The accompanying bread basket did not weather the Valentine delay quite as well, sadly.

Special mention should be made of the helpful and personalized service that made each diner feel like a special guest.

Dessert is not included in the table d'hôte menu but a special almond cake is worth the extra \$3.95 if there's still room. A fruit and cheese plate is also available for \$5.95 and the house special, Fromage flambé with honey is an experience for \$8.95.

Diners are invited to bring their own wine which keeps the meal within an affordable range for such fine food. The Valentine's Day special ran about the same as the restaurant's regular table d'hôte menu, from \$15.95 to \$34.95.

Casa Chirico also features a wonderful lunchtime menu daily from Tuesday to Friday from 11:30 to 2 p.m.

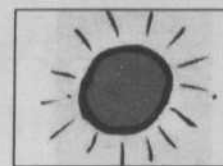

Exploring Alaska by luxurious cruise ship

Above the Arctic Circle, the glaciers rise rugged and fresh, out of icy, emerald waters. They rumble, shifting and restless, casting flows into the current.

Whales regularly glide by, while on the nearby land bears wander the woods. In the distance, bald eagles circle, screeching.

It's all part of Alaska, and once discovered, this land will stay with you forever. One of the most captivating ways to explore it, as we learned on the Sea Princess cruise ship, is on the water.

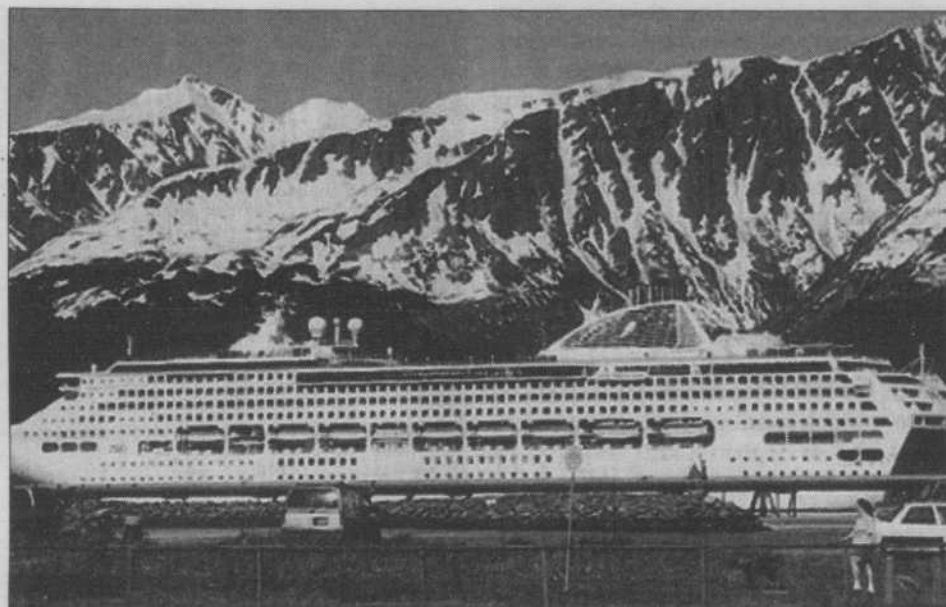
With close to 54,000 kilometres of shoreline, the Great Land, as it is known, is very much a coastal state that has been enchanting those in search of adventure for almost two centuries.

And although you can travel through a waterway route similar to that taken by explorers, the style of your journey will exceed almost anything those early adventurers could have imagined.

Much of current Alaskan travel is a pairing of some of the world's most spectacular natural splendours and an equally top notch-mode of transport - grand class cruise ships. These vessels - nothing short of floating, luxury resorts with all the trimmings - aren't just content to float past the views. Rather, they add excursions such as dog-sledding and helicopter sight-seeing trips, to let passengers experience a close-up view of the most pristine ice and snow you've ever seen - year-round fixtures in some parts of the Alaskan landscape.

Although it may be difficult to imagine getting excited about these chilly elements while we're knee deep in them at this time of year, they are sure to illicit ample emotion as you travel north for Alaskan adventure in the summer. The beauty is awe-inspiring, from views of the majestic Mount McKinley and the huge huddles of ice that surround you in Glacier Bay, to the dense forest of Denali National Park.

And instead of trudging through this

terrain, you're serenely cruising past these stunning scenarios in the ultimate of modern day luxury and comfort. If by chance the mercury dips too low for you (the average temperature during cruise ship season, June to September, in Alaska is 15 to 23 C), you can always signal a waiter for a blanket or hot chocolate.

Or, you could pop into one of the many world-class lounges and dining rooms for which Princess Cruise Line ships are famous, to savour the scene from glass-enclosed comfort.

So where does the adventure come in? Well, you can fly via helicopter to a glacier where you are met by Iditarod participants, who will introduce you to the fine art of dog-sledding and take you along for a ride. Or, you could land some of the best salmon in the world, go whale- (or other wildlife-) watching, or experience nature on a rain forest nature walk or glacier hike.

"Princess knows that no two passengers are alike, so we've met as wide a

range of interests as we could possibly imagine," says Sea Princess's cruise director Paul Burns, who organizes and arranges the bulk of on-board entertainment. "There's a whole different atmosphere on cruise ships now that it's important for people to see."

As the types of people taking cruises have diversified, explains Burns, so has what is offered. Families traveling with kids, young couples, people traveling in large groups, as well as more singles, have changed the demographic of passenger lists, once primarily dominated by elderly couples.

"In the last five or six years the selection of things to do has really been expanded to suit this," says Burns. "We're offering passengers what they want, when they want it, in dining and entertainment."

Traditional pastimes still exist, but if you're looking for something a little more active, let's talk sports. How about shooting a few hoops or playing a lively game of one-on-one on the top-side

court? Or, you could book a little time on the state-of-the art golf simulator to improve your swing. Then, there's the pool for a quick dip, of course, as well as cozy little hot tubs hidden around the ship. And that's in addition to aerobics classes, a walking club, or a quick salsa or samba lesson from a professional dancer.

Food, as you would expect, is ample. There's not a time of day that food is not on hand and scarcely a kind of food you can't find, from the freshest and most elaborate of sushi to the best pizza this side of Sicily.

Despite all these great diversions, when a day in port arrives, the ship all but empties. Passengers eagerly set out to explore Alaska. Days in port - in coastal towns ranging from tiny and exciting finds like Seward and Ketchikan to city-sized Juneau - allow for excursions as unique as the towns themselves.

A best bet for a short day in port can be experienced when you land in Skagway. You can fill a half-day with an adventure like the Glacier Point Wilderness Safari. In this package from Chilkat Guides, you're escorted from the ship to an airstrip, where you board a small plane for a scenic flight to the edge of a wilderness area.

You land on a remote beach and from there, you ride in a four-wheel drive safari vehicle through a lush rain forest to a trail hike that's one-quarter of a mile across the glacier. It leads to the lake that lies at the foot of the glacier, which you then cross in 31-foot Alaskan-sized canoes. As you paddle up close, face-to-face with the mighty Davidson Glacier, you see this remnant of the ice age, which reflects the feeling many visitors have about Alaska: No matter how much time you spend there, you'll often feel you've just seen the tip of the iceberg.

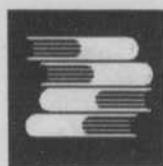

Tale of transvestite hooker makes Booker list

"You see what I am is an ordinary transvestite prostitute, not the slightest bit interested in politics at all," declares the tart-tongued tart Patrick (Pussy) Braden from Tyreelin', as police rush in to falsely arrest her for the bombing of a London pub.

Strangely, Patrick McCabe's 'Breakfast on Pluto' is not the first work to look at transvestism and the euphemistically described 'Troubles' of Northern Ireland. Many will remember Neal Jordan's 'Crying Game' in which an IRA terrorist fulfils a dying English soldier's last wish by getting in touch with the love of his life. While 'Crying Game' is a love story, set within the brutal world of IRA terrorism, 'Breakfast on Pluto', is something more.

Patrick Braden, veteran of mental hospitals and prison, founding child of an innocent young woman and the Parish priest, is the embodiment of a suppressed and seething Northern Ireland, strait-jacketed by years of history. Patrick (Pussy) Braden is no odder a sight in parochial Ireland, than the years of the late 60s and early 70s, some of the most vicious years of sectarian violence and also the years of bell-bottomed pants, wacky pop music, David Bowie, the Beatles, Joe Cocker and old-fashioned Catholicism. This is an odd juxtaposition, also examined in McCabe's 'The Butcher Boy'.

Patrick/Pussy has the ability to make

some of the saddest things funny. He befriends a girl named Charlie and Irwin, a boy with aspirations to join the IRA. The three of them run 'The Juke Box Jury', a dress-up game with music.

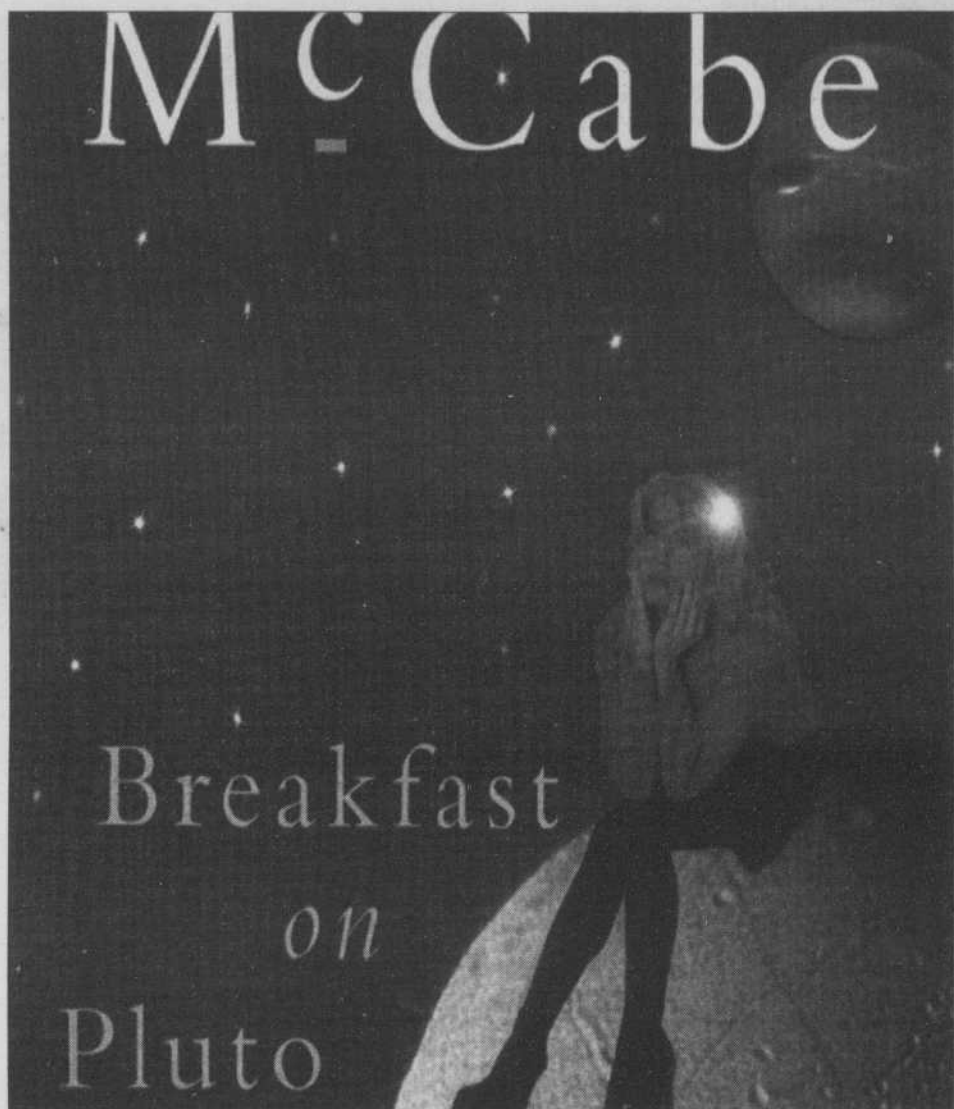
Hardened by a life of prostitution, Patrick remains loyal to his real friends. He is hilariously dismissive of his liaisons with a politician known as 'Dummy Teat', a sugar-daddy and a grieving mother. All the while, Braden, searches for his disappeared mother, Eily Bergin.

The narrative moves deftly and swiftly from black humour to black violence, as a friend is captured and tortured by political extremists. Nothing is held back as wholly described brutality becomes a part of this surreal, often over-the-top story.

This combination of campy excess and stark reality is powerfully moving. Upon being released from jail for wrongful charges of political terrorism, Braden becomes involved with a group of IRA terrorists. Braden's persistence to continue his life and his loyalty to friends beset by tragedy strikes a strangely optimistic note.

Despite his jealous attack on a rival and the torching of his birth father's church, readers will find themselves rooting for Patrick/Pussy Braden.

Difficult, angry, coarse and enlightened, 'Breakfast on Pluto' resonates. In 1998 it was shortlisted for the Booker Prize. It is currently available in paperback at leading bookstores.

The Conversations at Curlow Creek

David Malouf's critically acclaimed 'The Conversations at Curlow Creek' offers a powerful and sympathetic view of the human condition. The setting is 1827 Australia, a newly colonized country where convicts and other unfortunates find themselves in a hard and unappealing land.

Australia is in the process of becoming a country, and the men who find themselves in it are in a kind of limbo. The novel opens with professional soldier Michael Adair, along with a handful of other officers, keeping watch over Carney, a convict waiting to be hanged the next day. Both Adair and Carney are Irish, and they find it difficult to adjust to this desert-like country, so different

from their own.

By conversing with Carney through the night, Adair finds himself flooded with memories of his childhood. He tries to reassess his past, and through information about Carney's life, he hopes to discover what happened to his brother. Adair recalls a past where his own parents rejected him, caught up in their own escapist world of music as opera singers.

Mama Aimee, his mother's wealthy girlhood friend, takes on the young Adair, since her own babies all died in infancy. But Adair never feels like a true member of the family—more like a charity case. When Mama Aimee's son Fergus is born, Adair develops a strong bond with him. However, the independent, enigmatic Fergus always keeps himself distant from Adair and even from his

own parents.

Adair always wonders if he is to blame, if Fergus' distance results from his mother's stronger bond with Adair than with her biological son. When Fergus goes missing and is rumoured to be part of a gang of outlaws, Adair wonders if he has played a role in his stepbrother's abandonment of his family.

Superstitions and notions of destiny are shown to be a large part of Irish culture in the novel, and these beliefs are often stronger than the belief in the justice of manmade laws. Fergus himself is a child who never cried, and Adair remembers how the servants and Mama Aimee believed Fergus to be watched over by spirits.

Adair realizes that he would never have come to Australia in the awkward position of jailer if it had not been for

Fergus' disappearance. The boundary between the just and the unjust, and between duty and sympathy become blurred in the novel. Manmade laws, more often than not, are not just, Adair realizes. The difference between a criminal and other men is not very great when it comes to human desires, goals, suffering, and dignity.

Malouf's lyrical prose evokes the magical quality of the characters and events. The world is a magical place, according to Malouf, where all our destinies are inextricably linked. The message is a humanitarian one: we should not judge others by inadequate laws because everyone is equal in their human condition.

An uplifting and thought-provoking novel, though at times too sentimental. 'The Conversations at Curlow Creek' is available at the Lennoxville Library.

Love and the law

Eight Days A week

"A man is two people: himself and his penis." If you find yourself laughing at this statement, agreeing or identifying with it, then you're in the mood for some harmlessly light and non-intellectual entertainment such as Michael Davis' *Eight Days A Week*.

This comedy dramatizes a teenage boy's, Peter (Joshua Schaeffer) first encounter with love and lust. Peter cannot get Erica (Keri Russell) out of his mind, but Erica barely acknowledges his existence and she is leaving for college in three months. Besides, Erica already has a boyfriend (Johnny Green) who inherited "the asshole gene"—something that Peter lacks. As they say, "nice guys finish last".

So Peter gives up until his grandfather (Buck Kartalian) gives him advice: "Women are like breaking into a bank. It takes nerve, and a little bit of dynamite to break the vault". With this wise advice, Peter decides stand under Erica's balcony night and day until she falls in love with him. Nothing will stop Peter from getting the woman that he loves!

This is a film about manhood, and it is especially recommended to men of all ages. The young ones can look at *Eight Days A Week* and sympathize with Peter, while the older ones can recall what it was like to be young, in love, and inexperienced.

The male audience should also enjoy Keri Russell's presence in this film. The camera loves Russell as it constantly flatters her with full-shots of her figure, and close-up shots of other body parts. The only downside to this is that Russell's presence is reduced to a point where she is there just as a decorative element, and we don't get to see much of her acting skills.

Murder of Crows

Rowdy Herrington's 'whodunit' film deals with the overly used theme: the justice system and its faults. *Murder of Crows'* screenplay—which is also written by Herrington—is creative, but at the end it becomes melodramatic and farfetched.

As expected, the formula is the same: it involves a man who is wrongly accused, and he must prove his innocence. Cuba Gooding, Jr. is a lawyer named Russell who gives up his career. Repulsed by the system's injustice, he finds refuge in Florida, where he works as a tourist guide. In his spare time, Russell writes his barely started novel.

Procrastination has the best of him. Things look up one day when an old man (Mark Pelligrino), a tourist who is also a wannabe writer, hands him his newly finished unpublished novel to read. Russell is fascinated by the novel which is a revenge story about a serial killer who murders lawyers that have successfully defended and acquitted criminals.

When Russell goes to return the novel, he is informed that the old man died from a heart failure. Russell naively steals the novel, gets it published under his name, and becomes a success. There's only one problem: the murders in the novel are not fictitious, they are real. Now Russell is accused of murder, and no one believes in his innocence.

The plot twist and turns, and it keeps the audience wondering in suspense: who is the old man? Why did he give the novel to Russell? Who is the murderer? What are the murderer's motives behind this scheme?

When we finally get to the film's end, we discover the motives behind the schemes, and the murderer's identity. Suddenly, the suspenseful moments have turned into melodrama. Also, let's not forget the predictable Hollywood, happy ending that adds more to the melodrama.

Remembering slaves in New France

Speaker to discuss the history of New World slavery

Norwich University scholar Raymond Zirblis will speak this Friday at 7:30 p.m. at the Haskell Free Library in Derby Line, Vermont, on the institution of slavery in the New England and Canada.

"It is not commonly known that slavery was a well-established institution in colonial times on the Canadian side under French control and later, under the British," said Zirblis, speaking from his Norwich University office.

"Every part of society had a part in it. Not everybody had a slave, but

almost everyone knew someone who had one."

Zirblis highlighted the fact that in the early days of New France, two-thirds to three-quarters of the slaves were indigenous native peoples, with the remainder being enslaved peoples of African descent. He estimates that the slave population of New France was at its peak between 4000 and 5000 people.

From the time of the introduction of slavery, Zirblis said that governments had to address the problem of runaway slaves, many of whom headed north. He noted that 17th century French legislation automatically made British slaves entering French domain the property of the King of France.

By 1640, all of the colonies had treaties for the return of runaway slaves. In 1709, a death penalty was enacted by the New York legislature for any slave found 10 miles north of Al-

bany without proper papers.

"In French Canada, slavery is a little more humane, probably because of the Catholic influence," he continued. "The Church determined that slaves and native peoples had souls."

"Slaves in French families went through the sacraments."

Zirblis concluded that this led to a slightly less virulent form of slavery, though it did not diminish the immorality of the institution. It also did not diminish the wrath of society for those who had crossed the line, such as Marie Angélique, the Montreal slave who, while trying to escape, set a fire that eventually engulfed half of Montreal. As punishment for her deed, she was burned at the stake at Place d'Armes.

In the 1790s, Simcoe abolished slavery in Upper Canada, although Zirblis notes that this was not binding on Lower Canada. Later, in the 1830s, slav-

ery was abolished throughout the British Commonwealth. Over time, the institution declined throughout the northeast, perhaps due to a heightened sense of morality, but more likely due to economic conditions that made slavery less economically feasible.

Zirblis added that Canadians and New Englanders alike enjoyed the moral high ground prior to the American Civil War but have been remarkably reluctant to examine the role of slavery in the colonial North America or its subsequent legacy.

"The economic sanctions that followed (in the States, seen as the Jim Crow laws) were just as devastating as the institution of slavery."

Raymond Zirblis will be the guest speaker on Friday, Feb. 25 at 7:30 p.m. at the Haskell Free Library in Derby Line, Vermont.

Campbell happy to stretch for new roles

Change frightens Neve Campbell. But she knows it's inevitable.

"If I'm not willing to take risks, I might as well stop now," she says flatly.

And of course this raven-haired Canadian beauty has no intention of quitting acting, and she is looking for risks.

For example: the black comedy, *Drowning Mona*, which arrives in theaters March 3. Campbell, 26, sees it as a potent symbol of the new directions she is taking in what is proving to be a watershed year for her.

She may be basking in the current box-office success of *Scream 3*, but because this is the final installment in filmmaker Wes Craven's craftily conceived shock trilogy, she is also bidding farewell the character of Sidney, its indomitable heroine.

Even more wrenching is the fact that this is the final season for *Party of Five*, the critically acclaimed series about a group of siblings forced to fend on their own. Campbell had signaled her intention to leave the program even before it was canceled, but she still says it will be sad to part company with the series and the character of Julia.

"I have bittersweet feelings. I spent 15 hours a day, five days a week, on *Party*. I spent six years with these people. I spent

more time being Julia than being myself in a lot of ways - which is frightening. But it is still sad to see it go."

Furthermore, she will always be grateful to both *Party of Five* and the *Scream* movies. "Party of Five is the reason I came to the States from Canada. It's why my face got out there. It's been great for me, a great way to work my muscles every day as an actor, and that's something not many people get to do. As for *Scream* - well, we had so much fun together on those films."

But now it's time for "new opportunities and growing and being inspired and trying new things."

Campbell has sought different roles from the the beginning. That was her rationale for doing the black-magic thriller, *The Craft*, during her first hiatus for *Party of Five*; for signing up for the *Scream* movies; and for going to kinky extremes with the controversial teenage movie, *Wild Things*.

"Each time I do a project I'm very concerned about not doing the same thing the next time round."

Nevertheless, Campbell does feel more vulnerable as she enters 2000 because she no longer enjoys the protective cocoon of a hit television series. She's out there on her own and will sink or swim by the roles she chooses. Her first priority is to slow down.

"My schedule can't ever be as hard as it was for the last six years when I was doing a television show for nine months and then two movies back-to-back during the hiatus."

So she's looking forward to just doing films and giving herself time to pick the right scripts. That process already started for her last summer with *Drowning Mona*, an eccentric comedy that takes Campbell into new and untested territory.

"It's always scary to try new things. You hope you're going to be able to pull it off, but you can't be sure." Which is exactly why she steeled herself to becoming involved in this darkly comic saga of murder and emotional mayhem in a small upstate New York community.

The town of Verplanck seems noted for three things. One is its annual knife-throwing contest. The second is the fact that everybody drives a Yugo automobile because they come cheap. The third is

that Verplanck is home to the monstrous Mona Dearly (Bette Midler), the best known and least liked woman in the community.

When the brakes on Mona's Yugo fail and plunge her to a watery death in the Hudson River, virtually everyone in town comes under the suspicion of local police chief Wyatt Rash (Danny DeVito), because virtually everyone has good reason to want her dead.

Campbell plays Wyatt's comely daughter, Ellie, who is in raptures over Mona's death. Ellie is engaged to marry flax-haired local boy Bobby Calzone (Casey Affleck) and is obsessed with having the flashiest wedding the town has ever experienced. The main obstacle to Ellie's happiness has been the unspeakable Mona, who has been sabotaging her future hubby's gardening business.

"My character was absolutely ridiculous!" Campbell giggles. "The film itself is absurd, so I just tried to be as silly and ridiculous as possible."

Drowning Mona was also intimidating because she was keeping company with the likes of DeVito, Midler and Jamie Lee Curtis, who plays a frowsy waitress.

"You're working with people who have done many comedies in the past and have been very successful at it." Ultimately, however, the experience was liberating. "I was laughing my head off the whole time, and with that kind of character you don't have to be concerned about how you're going to come across. You just commit to her and hopefully it will work."

The script requires Campbell to be kissed passionately by Kathleen Wilhoite in the role of the town mechanic.

"It was not my idea," Campbell laughs. "It was in the script."

But doing the scene gave her some of her most amusing moments because DeVito's young son was on the set that day and started freaking out over the high number of takes required to get the scene right.

"Dad, why does she have to keep kissing women?" the scandalized six-year-old asked.

Ellie's copious and tumbled tinted hair has been causing a lot of comments from preview audiences who have seen Campbell's denim-clad performance. But talking to reporters this morning she looks as though she's on her way to a fashion shoot: her hair is fastened severely back, she's wearing a high-necked ribbed grey sweater.

She giggles that while her hair in *Drowning Mona* doesn't have much to do with her, it does have a lot to do with the character of Ellie.

"It is important to change your look. These things really help you to get into a character because Ellie wouldn't look as I do and wouldn't dress the way I do and style her hair in the way that I do."

Later this year, another side of Campbell will be revealed with *Panic* in which she plays a sexually charged 23-year-old who becomes involved with middle-aged, middle-class William H. Macy.

"It really was an experience. The writing is so good, and Bill Macy is an unbelievable actor."

With Campbell, the bottom line is that for all her apprehension about breaking new ground, she seems totally in control of her destiny.

"I'm extremely careful about all my decisions," she says.

Asked if there was anything she wanted to change about herself, she's firm: "There's nothing I would change. I would just hope to continue growing."
