True promotion of philately begins at local clubs

A few articles ago, I wrote of the Royal '88 which was held in Winnipeg and the lack of dealer participation due to the ATA convention held in Toronto.

While we must realize that dealers are a necessity, they should not be the focal point of any exhibition. That's one reason why I was kind of happy to hear there were only eight dealers at the Winnipeg exhibition.

Putting together several pages of stamps and or covers worthy of an exhibit is no easy task. They must conform to the rules and regulations set forth by the exhibition host. In most cases the rules are those set forth by the F.I.P.

Stamp corner

The F.I.P. was formed in June of 1926 in Paris. It is a sort of watchdog trying to keep philately free from a number of practices that might endanger the hobby.

Exhibiting usually begins at the local level. By that I mean your local club. In order to qualify for national and international shows, you must first be successful at the local level. Most clubs will bring in credited judges.

Stamp exhibiting is considerably different from most other types of exhibiting. In the first place, medals are given instead of ribbons. Most important though is the manner in which the exhibitions are judged. In a small show, there may be a limit of five judges known as the jury panel.

Awards are not given on a first, second and third place basis. Rather they are given categorically, based on the quality of the material entered and the way it is presented. For the purpose of an example we'll use the category of topics. In this class, there may be as many as five entries, one on horses, two on trains, one on railways and one on churches. The jury may not find any good enough to be awarded a gold medal, which

is difficult enough to win at the best of times. However, they may find that two of the entries deserve silver medals while the other three merit lesser medals or none at all. The awarding of medals depends totally on the individual exhibitor's efforts.

Most philatelic events that are billed as "shows", are strictly dealer events and have few or no exhibits at all. Their main purpose is to sell stamps. I was never so disappointed as the day I went to a small club show billed as a stamp and coin exhibition and show. There were about three frames of stamps that were not even worthy to be called exhibits. They were put on a table in a corner making them hard to see.

However, there were so-called dealers. About ten tables of them. They were not what you would classify as legitimate dealers but rather club members trying to sell their surplus material. In all it was a complete shambles.

At most of the larger shows, dealers are given prime space, the pe-

rimeter. Exhibits are relegated to the center or in inconspicuous places at the end of the exhibition area.

As mentioned in a previous column, the Canadian Stamp Dealers Association have announced that they are launching a program to promote the hobby of philately by having more shows per year in major cities and by encouraging schools to start stamp clubs among their students. If these people were as interested in the hobby as they are in lining their pockets, I would say "hurrah".

The true promotion of philately begins at the local stamp club where knowledgeable people go out of their way to teach people how to properly enjoy the hobby.

The next time you happen to go to a stamp exhibition, take the time to have a good look at the exhibits that so many took so much time to put together for your viewing pleasure.

King of balloons finally made it

GLEN BURNIE, Md. (AP) — Bob Kemp, the man responsible for the inflatable Rocky Mountains used during the Calgary Winter Games opening ceremonies, remembers when he was a novice businessman and needed a loan.

He listed Chicken Licken, Goosy Loosy and Ducky Lucky as collateral.

He got the money after explaining the animals were the parade balloons on which he planned to build his company, Kemp Balloons Inc.

"I told them that's what makes the money for me," said Kemp. "It was survival at that point. We'd only been in business a couple of years."

The turning point for Kemp balloons was the presidential inauguration for Jimmy Carter, which was 12 days away when the call came asking for a giant, inflatable peanut.

"We said, 'If the peanut's there, pay us. If not, forget it.' We made it in 12 days," Kemp said.

That accomplishment and the ensuing publicity launched the company's reputation as a premier builder of parade balloons. Kemp's cast of more than 50 characters includes Popeye the sailor and his girlfriend Olive Oyl, the Pillsbury Dough Boy, Woody Woodpecker and Felix the Cat.

His colorful creations meander parade routes across the United States and around the world.

"It's fun," said the affable Kemp, 57. "It's like being on the fringe of show business."

WAIT FOR CALL

On the paint-splattered floor of Kemp's suburban Baltimore warehouse, Humpty Dumpty sits in a corner, a perpetual grin on his massive face. Popeye's head occupies much of the opposite side of

the room and various pieces of other characters wait for a fresh coat of paint or a call from a promoter who wants to hire a balloon.

"We've done a lot of exciting things," said Kemp.

Don Lunday, the executive director of the International Festivals Association in Pasadena, Calif. an organization of festival promoters and suppliers, says Kemp Balloons is one of the oldest and largest balloon makers.

"There's a quality about Bob's, but the fact remains he is expensive," Lunday said. "You can rent cheaper inflatables. But the odds are they are not going to do what Bob's do."

Kemp's balloons rent from \$500 to \$11,000 US, depending on the character and the season. Prices go higher during holiday periods.

Kemp built his first balloons in 1973 for Gimbel's Thanksgiving parade in Philadelphia and made many of the balloons used in Macy's legendary parades.

This year, Kemp expects sales to top \$1 million US — a long way for a man who says he learned how to starve while employed as a social worker. He's also taught ballroom dancing, sold cars, promoted wine in California and was director of tourism for the city of Baltimore.

Kemp employs about 10 fulltime workers and as many as 30 during a busy period. His son Bobby is the chief designer. Once the design is created, a pattern is traced on long sheets of black rubber. The pieces are cut and sewn together, then inflated and painted.

When his balloons leave the warehouse, any number of things can happen.

SEIZE POPEYE

Popeye, for instance, was mistakenly taken off a plane in Paris en route to a children's Passover festival in Israel. The balloon mysteriously arrived just in time for the

festival, but on the way home, it was seized briefly by Israeli customs agents who questioned how it had entered the country.

Kemp's worst moment as a balloon man came at the Calgary Winter Olympics, where he staged his most ambitious project — an inflatable Canadian Rockies that was 35 metres long, 17 metres wide and 20 metres tall. Plans called for 25,000 smaller balloons to be released from inside the mountains as two huge dinosaur balloons cavorted in front of the spectators.

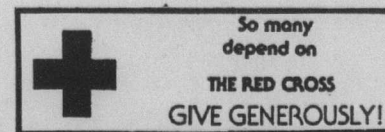
High winds forced Kemp to abort the project only a few moments after the mountains were inflated.

"They were asking me, 'Bob, is this mountain going to work?' We were calling the weather (office) every five minutes. It was my decision. The wind had died down. We had 300 people to hold it down. We had people with knives (to deflate it if necessary). We were prepared to immediately kill our balloon."

"The place went crazy when it went up. The wind hit and moved it about 10 feet. That's when we murdered the mountain. After we killed the mountain, they stood up and applauded and went crazy. It was an emotional moment for everybody."

His next goal is the franchising of his business, which he hoord, a home for retired balloons.

"It would be a place where people can stop in and see a part of history," Kemp said. "These are things they grew up with and saw on TV. They'd be retired there. It would have to be gigantic. People could walk around and touch a 65-foot Popeye on the nose."

DIPLOMATIC TAPDANCE

Ayer's Cliff mayor **Walter Hayward** demonstrated a remarkable schizophrasia over the matter. He signed a petition opposed to the races but added, "That's just my personal opinion. I will give my position as an official of the town after I have seen the race on August 28th."

With that mastery of the diplomatic tapdance, Hayward has a great future in federal politics.

THE NEW RIGHT:

"That Millionaires' National Convention in New Orleans," said **Chickenfat**, "was not a very edifying sight."

SPEAKING OF POVERTY:

QSPELL is an acronym for the **Quebec Society for the Promotion of English Language Literature**. (When the language cops aren't watching, that is. Officially in this dear, queer Quebec of ours it stands for **La Société Québécoise pour la promotion de la littérature de langue anglaise** — and ain't that a hoot?)

BEST FROM QUEBEC

It was started because there were a number of Quebec literary awards for works in French and none in English — yet many, if not most, of Canada's best English authors were and are Quebecers. There was **Leonard Cohen**, for example, **David Fennario** and **Mavis Gallant**. There was **A.M. Klein**, **Irving Layton**, **Buffy Glassco** of Foster, **Northrup Frye** from Sherbrooke, **Mordecai Richler** of Austin, **Hugh MacLellan**, **Ralph Gustafson**, **Doug Jones** and **Ron Sutherland** all of North Hatley, **F.R. Scott** schooled in Stanstead, **Louis Dudeck** at Way's Mills, even **Robert Allen** of Ayer's Cliff, **Don Bell** of Sutton, **Bernard Epps** of Gould Station and **H. Gordon Green** from Ormstown.

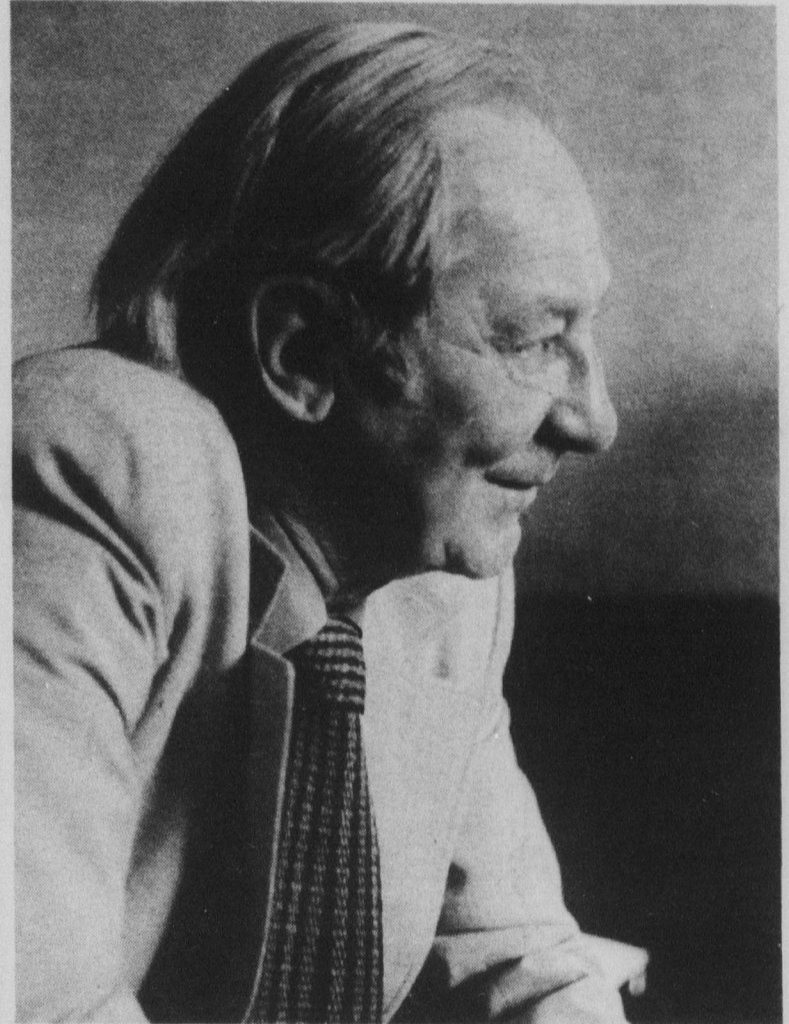
QSPELL, therefore, has established \$2000 prizes in three categories for English writers who have lived in Quebec for at least three of the last five years. Their

books must have been published between May 15, 1986, and May 15, 1988, but not necessarily in Quebec or even in Canada. Sixteen entries have been accepted in the fiction category, 34 for non-fiction and 22 books of poetry. The short list will be announced on September 1st, promotional material sent out to schools, libraries and bookstores and the winners presented at a gala dinner on October 27th.

It is hoped these awards will in-

crease public awareness of English authors in Quebec, offer them encouragement, support and promotion through public readings, lectures, conferences, publications and literary organizations.

Here in the Townships, French writers have banded together under the **Association des auteurs des Cantons de l'Est** but, despite their numbers, there is no corresponding group for English writers.

Lower North Shore held strong fascination for Abbot



Abbot spent four years, on and off, visiting the area, getting to know the people, taking photographs and writing her book. TOMIFOBIA — Have you ever considered where the North Shore is? A largely unknown part of Quebec, this is the region lining the St. Lawrence River near Newfoundland. Such towns as Blanc Sablon, La Tabatiere and St. Augustine make up one of the most secluded regions of the province, and one of the most fascinating.

Louise Abbot was among those people who had heard about the area but didn't really know anything about it. The Townships-born freelance photojournalist became interested in the North Shore area through her research work for CBC Radio in Montreal. She had to find a person to be interviewed about the region on the radio, so she spoke to several people from the area until she found the perfect one.

"Her accent and everything she said interested me," Abbot remembered.

That was 1982 and she had never even set foot in the area. Yet the fascination was stronger than her and she decided to get to know it first hand. So she asked for a federal government Explorations grant to visit the Lower North Shore so she could do some freelance work and perhaps have some of her pictures exhibited.

BOOK ABOUT TRIP

The freelance work got done, but something she hadn't even considered also came about thanks to the trip. She published her first book, *The Coast Way, a Portrait of the English on the Lower North Shore of the St. Lawrence*.

David Norton of McGill-Queen's Publishers wrote to Abbot in the Lower North Shore saying he was interested in publishing a book about her trip. So she hired a designer to create a 'dummy': a sample chapter for the publisher to get an idea of what her book would look like.

She spent four years, on and off, visiting the area, getting to know the people, taking photographs and writing her book. The result is a portrait, in photographs and words, of the people she met, the ways in which their lives have changed during the past 20 years, and the way they feel about those changes. Abbot calls it 'visual anthropology'.

Abbot says the people living in the area have, until recently, depended on oral history. But what is called progress has changed all that.

LOOK AT OUTSIDE WORLD

"Younger people aren't learning that much about their history," Abbot explained. The author named some of the more important changes for that region as the snowmobile and the television.

"TV gave them a look at the outside world they didn't have until then," she said.

The television didn't go to the Lower North Shore until electricity did, and that didn't happen until the early 1970s. That was quite an even.

Abbot remembered what one local man said about that event.

"The first night I put on every light in the house and left them all on just to sit down and look. I felt so glad we had electric, eh...it changed a lot after electricity come," he said.

The Lower North Shore is certainly one of the lesser known areas of the province and there is a

great lack of information about it. This was a particular hurdle for Abbot, who had to depend almost entirely on her own interviews with the people of the area. But she says she was lucky enough that people opened up to her considerably and even continued to correspond with her after she left.

TWO YEARS

In her comfortable home in Georgeville, Abbot seems to enjoy discussing these people who opened their homes and hearts to her. "I'll be going to Chevery for the book launching," she said with a happy smile, and adding that it's been two years since she last saw

the people.

"This time my husband will be going for his first time," she added. "He's heard so much about them, and they heard so much about him."

The timing for the launching is perfect as there is a wedding in town at the same time and everyone from nearby towns will be there. "So everyone will be able to see what I've done," she said.

Abbot is also having a book launching at Georgeville's Murray Memorial Hall on Saturday. But this writer is not about to sit on her laurels. She is already working on her next book, to be about French Newfoundlanders living in the Port-au-Port Peninsula.

"I guess I'm fascinated by the isolated parts of the Maritime islands," she said.

What's next for the person who seems to enjoy going to the more

The Coast Way

A Portrait of the English on the Lower North Shore of the St Lawrence

Plains of Abraham are a piece of Canadian history

QUEBEC (CP) — The sounds of musket fire can no longer be heard except in the imagination.

But there are reminders everywhere on the Plains of Abraham of the crucial battle of Sept. 13, 1759, between French and English soldiers that presaged the end of the French regime in North America and the dawn of British supremacy.

The Plains, where Scottish ship pilot Abraham Martin once grazed his cattle, celebrate their 80th anniversary this year as a national park.

Plaques throughout the 101 hectares of gently rolling landscape recall the bloody encounter between the French and English that lasted a scant 15 minutes.

They show where the opposing armies faced each other, and they mark the spots where the two generals, Louis Montcalm of France and James Wolfe of England — the loser and the victor — were mortally wounded.

"You're walking through history, it's here that everything began," says Rene Bureau, 73, a retired museum curator who grew up

near the Plains and never moved away.

STIRS EMOTIONS

More than 200 years later, the battle can still stir emotions. The English inscription on the plaque where Montcalm fell was recently changed after complaints from anglophone visitors that it was too extravagant in its praise for the defeated French marquis.

"The gallant, good and great Montcalm, four times deservingly victorious and at last defeated — through no fault of his own — here received his mortal wound," read the notice composed in 1940 by an anglophone colonel who was also a historian.

It was replaced last year to conform with the French version which states simply that the defeated Montcalm was wounded there. A park spokesman was unable to say why the original French and English versions differed so greatly.

A monument to Wolfe marking where he died, minutes after hearing that the English won the battle, has also known its share of notoriety.

The column topped by a Roman helmet was blown up by nationalist

extremists in 1963 and had to be rebuilt. In an apparent attempt not to cause any offence, the monument's inscription does not mention that Wolfe was victorious — only that he died there.

There is no monument in the park to Montcalm who managed to enter the city on his horse despite his wounds. The city, however, has monuments to him and his yellowed skull is on display in the museum of the Ursuline convent where he died hours after the battle.

OVERLOOK RIVER

The Plains park which commands a sweeping view of the St. Lawrence River, was established in 1908 to commemorate the 300th anniversary of the founding of Quebec City.

Civic officials thought it important to guarantee the growing city some breathing space and the federal government created the National Battlefields Commission.

Its task was to ensure the preservation of the sites commemorating the battles fought in Quebec between the English and French.

A road has been built where Wolfe's forces ascended the cliffs

from the St. Lawrence River under cover of darkness to take Montcalm's forces by surprise.

Montcalm made the grave error of attacking the English before collecting all his troops, including 3,000 crack soldiers stationed further downriver.

Had the French general waited, he could have arrayed almost 10,000 men against the British forces who numbered only 4,400.

The disciplined British regulars fired three volleys in six minutes, swiftly routing the disorganized French, many of whom were ill-trained militia.

But the battle for Quebec was not finally decided until the following spring when the French counter-attacked.

DEFEATED BRITISH

They defeated the British troops and laid siege to the walled city while awaiting reinforcements from France. To their dismay, it was a British fleet that sailed up the river first and the French were forced to retreat.

The spring battle is commemorated in the Parc-des-Braves, also under the commission's supervision, which lies a short distance

from the Plains.

Later in the year, the British seized Montreal and with that defeat, New France fell.

In years gone by, children in Quebec City used to re-enact their own versions of the battle of the Plains of Abraham.

"In our heads, the English were the enemies," Bureau recalls. "Wolfe for us was the 'Big, Bad Wolfe' — he had taken our country."

The plains also boast a series of defensive Martello towers. The round, thick-walled stone fortifications were built by the British during the first half of the 19th century to ward off potential attackers but they never saw any action.

The park, where Quebecers now cross-country ski in winter and jog and ride their bicycles in summer, has also served as the site of a golf course, a prison, a munitions factory — and as a landing strip.

American aviator Charles Lindbergh landed on the Plains to rush serum to a pilot friend dying in a Quebec City hospital of pneumonia. The mercy flight was in vain.

It is "a park of memories," says Bureau.

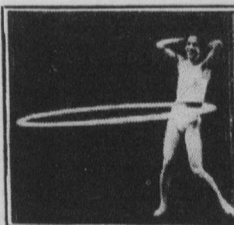

St. John River starting to reawaken

GAGETOWN, N.B. (CP) — The Indians called it Woolastook — the godly river.

Champlain first saw it on St. John the Baptist Day in 1604 and called it the St. John.

Now, 20th-century travellers are discovering that New Brunswick's god and bountiful St. John River is a waterway to surprises.

The St. John is more than a river. It's a vast network of lakes and islands, 19th-century villages and stopping-off spots. It's a bird-watcher's paradise and a fisherman's dream.

Old wharves with their spindly legs in the river are evocative reminders of the busy steamboat days of early New Brunswick, when the St. John was called the Rhine of North America.

In those days — the 1800s and

early 1900s — the river was a busy transportation route. But after the railways came, the boats were beached and the St. John, for the most part, slipped into repose.

It's just starting to reawaken.

BOATERS VISIT

Tom Colpitts's biggest problem these days is trying to keep the gas tanks filled at his marina in Gagetown, a popular stopping place for boaters.

Eight years ago when he opened his general store and marina, people in the quaint riverside village told him he was crazy. There were hardly any boats on the river then, and when one went by, it was the talk of the town for days.

But Colpitts and a number of other people who stuck by the river are now regarded as visionaries. They knew the Rhine of North America would be rediscovered.

This summer, the river at Gagetown is clogged with boats of all kinds, from canoes to three-storey cruisers worth upwards of \$200,000.

"We get Americans coming up all the time from tourism clubs and outfits like the Manchester Yacht Club (near Boston)," says Colpitts, surveying the sleek yachts parked at his marina.

"These people have sailed all over the world and they just shake their heads and say, 'Boy, you guys don't realize what you have up here.'"

"And I say, 'Well, some of us do and we're working at it.'"

What they have is some of best boating, swimming, fishing and general lazing-around areas anywhere.

Chabon hero faces troubles of a new generation

The Mysteries Of Pittsburgh by Michael Chabon (MORROW-MACMILLAN): \$24.95, 297 pp.

Writers of books about coming of age in America have the unfortunate burden of being compared to J.D. Salinger or F. Scott Fitzgerald, and while Michael Chabon's *The Mysteries Of Pittsburgh* is an interesting first novel it has neither the power nor the scope of *Catcher In The Rye* or *The Great Gatsby*. Chabon's young hero, Arthur Bechstein, must of course deal with the same range of possibilities that greets every youth passing into manhood, and in this sense Chabon's book treats the reader to an interesting enough scenario.

The young Bechstein has just graduated from college, is working for the summer at the giant book-selling store known as Boardwalk Books, and is coming to terms with the mysterious death of his mother, while patching up strained relations with his notorious, gangster-like father. As Arthur struggles to find himself in the turmoil of his family relationship, he is drawn into a circle of acquaintances that provides the book with its most interesting character delineations.

Arthur meets a beautiful girl, a beautiful boy who is his namesake, and an aggressive, troublesome biker named Cleveland whose exploits are blown into legendary proportions before he actually appears on the scene. Cleveland's entrance comes as Arthur is enduring yet another boring day at Boardwalk Books, when the surly figure comes storming into the shop and spirits the bewildered Arthur out the door and onto the back of his sturdy motorcycle.

The love relationship with the girl named Phlox, who works at the library, turns out to have serious competition with Arthur's growing affection for his male namesake. The two Arthurs finally consummate their relationship, much to Phlox's jealous horror, and the book's protagonist has to wrestle with the very modern dilemma—does he love the girl, or does he love the boy?

The party scenes and the hanging around that constitute a large proportion of Chabon's book are handled with a dream-like blurring of reality, giving the narrative a strange aura of fragmentation, as

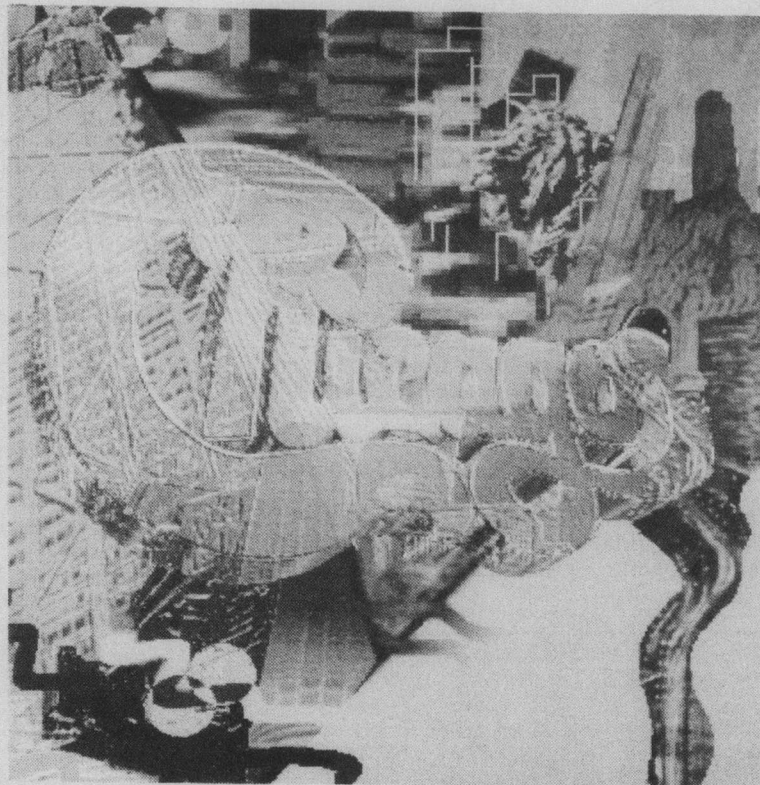

though much of the action were being transcribed through a cocaine-induced buzz.

One of the most intriguing mysteries of Pittsburgh is the occupation of Bechstein senior, who has a retinue of black-suited henchmen and some kind of crime syndicate dealings which finally reach out to encompass the hard-luck hood Cleveland. In fact, Cleveland's expected but spectacular demise closes

Vaughan during one of Double Trouble's western swings and be invited to open for Vaughan's tour.

Reeling from this tragedy, Arthur Bechstein, instead of striking out for the territories, undertakes a European tour with his lover Arthur, only to find early on that they were not compatible in any permanent sense.

The Mysteries Of Pittsburgh closes with its narrator's reflections about the friends he has made and lost, and some introspection about the nature of remembrance: "No doubt all of this is not true remembrance but the ruinous work of nostalgia, which obliterates the past, and no doubt, as usual, I have exaggerated everything". The exaggeration has luckily enough proved to make for an entertaining and revealing look at the aspirations and habits of a new generation of Nick Carraways and Holden Caulfields.

RECORD REVIEWS

Colin James Colin James (VIRGIN-A&M)

This 22-year old prairie rocker from Regina, Saskatchewan is already playing like a veteran bluesman, with enough together chops to catch the ear of Stevie Ray

Franklin, Wilson Pickett, Bobby Darin, Danny Kortchmar and Bob Rock on his debut album, as he bends the strings through ten lively blues numbers.

The young James has played with bluesmen 50 years his senior, such as Big Joe Duskins and Ynak Rachel, but cites early vocal influences as Jackie Wilson, Otis Rush and Albert King. Indeed the vocalizing on *Colin James* is never completely overshadowed by the gutsy blues riffing by the prairie answer to Eric Clapton.

"Why'd You Lie" gives James a chance to show his indebtedness to Jackie Wilson on the vocal end, and to Cjango Rienhart, on the instrumental bridge. Considering Colin James's age and his already rich experience on the inside of the music he obviously loves, it seems only a matter of time before the western Canadian bluesman makes a solid impression on the small but select blues crowd.

Chicago Chicago 19 (REPRISE-WEA)

The resilience of supergroup Chicago is evidenced by the fact that 19 records into their career the loss of the super pipes of Peter Cetera has caused nary a blip on the

video screen of their continued success. Bill Champlin steps to the spotlight for the vocals on the most recent Chicago release, and his singing on the tracks here, alternating with Robert Lamm's contributions, has pushed tunes like "I Don't Wanna Live Without Your Love" into bestselling prominence.

Probably as important as the shifts in vocal personnel are the easy transitions Chicago makes in replacement musicians. Can that really be a second generation bassist in Jason Scheff, carrying on in the tradition of his father, Jerry, who toiled in the employ of Elvis Presley, taking care of business as the bottom end to the fabulous guitar playing of James Burton in Elvis's Vegas band?

"We Can Last Forever" follows in the tradition of great Cetera tracks like "Hard To Say I'm Sorry" from *Chicago 16*, and it is interesting to note that David Foster's production on that record has now given way to Chas Sanford's on this record, with Sanford also adding the guitar solos to the solid septet. Able to rally after death (guitarist Terry Kath shot himself) and defection (Cetera's flight to movie soundtrack hits *Karate Kid II*), Chicago has the longevity that most bands would sell their soul to achieve — and do.

VIDEO SCREENINGS

Ironweed (HOME BOX OFFICE)
The third of William Kennedy's Albany cycle books is brought to the screen by Hector Babenco, who directs a production that uses Kennedy's own screenplay and a powerful performance by Jack Nicholson to capture the squalor of 1938 in the hoboe jungles of the Great Depression.

Ironweed is the tragic story of Francis Phelan, ex-baseball player, odd-jobber and haunted bum who is running from his memories and doomed to suffer for his past transgressions by his vivid imagination. Nicholson plays Phe-

lan with laid-back sentimentality, managing to keep that devilish twinkle out of his eye that might give away his handling of this serious role that is steeped in pathos.

As Helen, Francis's bosom companion, Meryl Streep is not quite so fortunately cast in a role she is suited to. Her accent is constantly shifting and her mannerisms are more disconcerting than authentic. The other member of this ghastly trio of down-and-outers is Rudy, played superbly by Tom Waits, whose whiskey howl of a voice is perfectly suited to the pathetic Rudy.

With Albany, New York as the period piece backdrop to Kennedy's grim story, Nicholson and friends make the rounds of flophouses, sleazy bars and hoboe jungles as they suffer through the economic hardships of the thirties.

Francis Phelan's life is made even harder by the memories that dog his footsteps. There is the death of his infant son Gerald, who slipped through his hands after he returned from work and having "only four beers"; his wife Annie and their children, Billy and Peggy, who Phelan abandoned long before the movie opens.

There is also a parade of woeful, haggard faces, those men Phelan has killed through rancour or spite or accident, over the years, their spectre rising in ghostly apparitions that engage Phelan in one-way conversations that appear to onlookers as absolute madness.

Phelan's battle with his past is filmed in sombre shades and often appears to be a period piece companion to the recent flick *Bar Fly*, with its equally depressing themes and unsavoury characters. *Ironweed* is, for all its dour message, a thoroughly engaging and thought-provoking movie, with Nicholson's contribution a first-rate bit of acting. 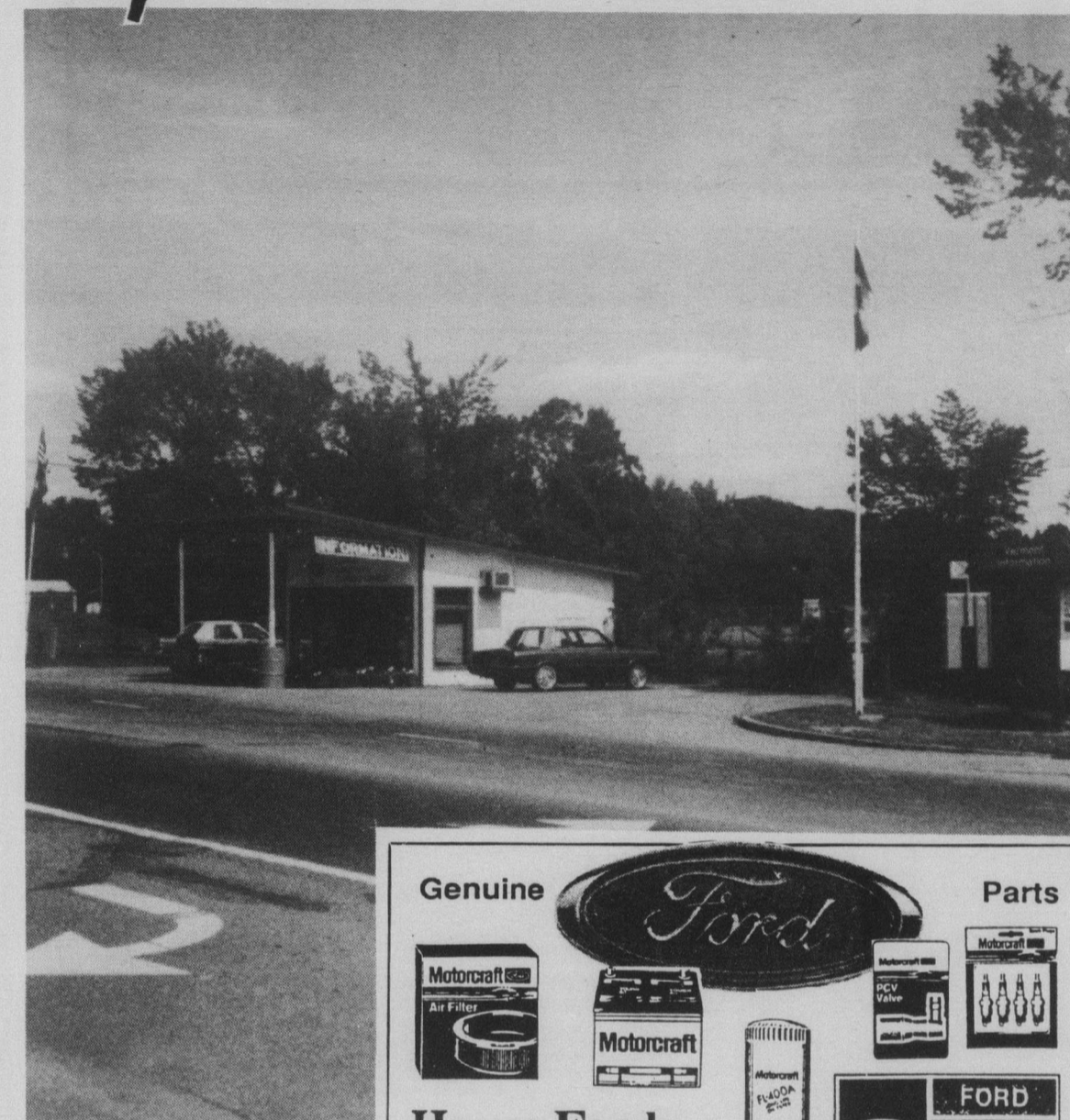

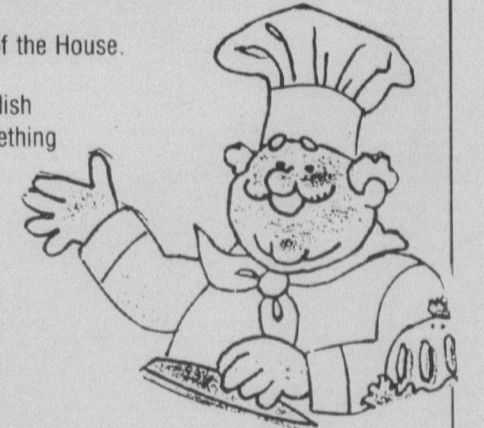

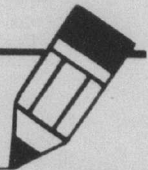

Kris Kristofferson stars in 'Blood and Orchids'

Kris Kristofferson and Jane Alexander are on opposite sides in a fight against prejudice and corruption in *Blood and Orchids*, to be rebroadcast Sunday and Tuesday, Aug. 28 and 30, on CBS.

Set in Hawaii in the 1930s, the drama finds Kristofferson seeking the truth to an incident involving four island youths.
