EXPLANATIONS :

ABBREVIATIONS USED IN ALPHABETICAL DIRECTORY: bdg. hse. *boarding house*; bds. *boards*; h. *house*; r. *rear*; sq. *square*.

The Names in CAPITALS are those of Subscribers and Advertisers.

The object of the ALPHABETICAL DIRECTORY is to find a person's address knowing his or her name; whilst the object of the STREET DIRECTORY is to find out a person's name knowing his or her address.

When hill, lane, place, road, square, or any other such word, does not follow the residence, the word *street*, is to be understood; for example: Abgrall Victor, laborer, Champlain 809, means Champlain street 809.

When two numbers are given in connection with one name, and only one street mentioned, the number first given is the place of *business*, and the second the *residence*,—which is always indicated by the letter h.—and both in the same street.

It will be noticed that the names of all members of a firm are added directly after the name of said firm. This, it must be understood, does not interfere with the regular insertion of the same names in their *Alphabetical order*.

Our advertising patrons may be found by referring to the Index, page 6. We feel justified, after many years acquaintance, in saying we believe them to be among the very best in their vocations, in the City of Quebec.

Names of residents in houses of ill-fame not being inscribed in the Street Key, will not, as a consequence, be found in the Alphabetical Directory.

In preparing this year's issue we have noted 2118 removals, have erased 1281 and have added 1273 names; the number of names in this year's Directory being 9600 shows a loss during the past year of 9 names, there being 9609 in the last edition. At the time of going to press, 20th May, there were still 125 houses unoccupied, equal to 200 lodgings, a fact which will more than account for the few omissions that may be found during the year.
