## Moose Jaw to be the next Hollywood?

REGINA (CP) — Move over, Arcola. Moose Jaw is vying to become Saskatchewan's new movie city.

Arcola, a tiny hamlet in southeastern Saskatchewan, has laid claim to being the province's Hollywood for a decade since the last time the government helped finance a film — the production of W.O. Mitchell's classic **Who Has Seen The Wind**.

But now that the province has decided to put money into movies

again, the central city of Moose Jaw has been chosen as the location of the first production.

"It has to look cold and threatening," said writer Ken Mitchell, explaining why cameras will be on Moose Jaw streets next January to film an adaptation of his short story **The Great Electrical Revolution**.

Set in the 1930s, the story tells of an Irish immigrant family which steals electricity from the power company in retaliation for having its electricity cut off in the middle of a favorite radio program.

The first part of the film will be set in the CP Rail station in Moose Jaw. The half-hour show is expected to be ready for broadcast on Saskatchewan's STV stations next spring.

Mitchell, a Regina writer whose works include the screenplay for **The Hounds of Notre Dame**, spent almost two years converting his story for the screen and said he'll have to do more work to get it down to a half-hour, made-for-TV production.

"In many ways it's a keystone," Mitchell said of the script. "Having this script in place helped attract the project around it."

### PLAN SERIES


The **Great Electrical Revolution** will be the first of seven half-hour TV productions financed in part by the Saskatchewan government and the National Film Board.

"What it's meant to be is 100-percent Saskatchewan," said Barbara Stewart, a regional producer for the board in Saskatchewan.

Colin Maxwell, Saskatchewan's minister of recreation and culture, said last week the province will pay \$600,000 over three years to be matched by \$600,000 from the NFB.

Telefilm Canada is also expected to contribute up to 49 per cent of production costs, but no definite amount of money has been agreed to.

SaskWest Television Inc., part of Winnipeg entrepreneur Izzy Asper's Canwest group of companies, has agreed to buy the broadcast rights for the productions for about \$300,000.

# QSPELL will help writers get it down on paper

SHERBROOKE — Quebec's English language writers take heart. Someone out there is thinking of you.

A new organization, the Quebec Society for the Promotion of English Language Literature (QSPELL) has just announced the creation of annual literary awards for the province's English language writers. QSPELL plans to give three prizes in its first year to writers of fiction, non-fiction and poetry.

QSPELL was created last fall by Montreal "literati" as a voluntary

organization dedicated to increasing public awareness both within Quebec and across Canada of language literary activity in the province. Richard King, owner of Paragraph Books in Montreal, is president of QSPELL and one of its founders.

"We were thinking, why can't we create a prize for English writers in Quebec, but having few other restrictions, that will be widely based in the cultural community," King said.

That's exactly what they did. They formed a board of directors and an advisory council made up of some of Quebec's well-known and

some lesser-known writers as well as people within the province's literary community such as publishers and university professors. Among the more recognized members of QSPELL are such biggies of Canadian letters as poet Ralph Gustafson, Hugh MacLennan, Irving Layton, Mavis Gallant and Mordecai Richler.

"The hard part was the fundraising," King said.

But the funds were raised, enough money for three \$2,000 prizes, and even some left over for administrative costs.

"As long as we had enough for the prizes, we don't mind if we have

pate instead of caviar at the launching on Monday," King explained.

"QSPELL has been set up as a non-profit membership organization."

So far the organization has managed to amass a third of the \$30,000 they hope to collect before the prizes will be awarded next October.

King also hopes to receive some funds from the provincial government, but QSPELL first had to demonstrate that it would be getting donations from the public, to show that it had some chances of lasting as an organization.

"In the future we want to increase the prize. It's hard for a writer to live on \$2,000. If we could give \$10,000, at least the writer could take half the year to concentrate on writing."

"Quebec is a great province for writers. There are 21 awards for French literature here," King added. "That's more than any other province in Canada. Now there's 22, one of them for English language writers."

The writers eligible to enter the contest will have to lived in Quebec three out of the last five years. The works must have been written originally in English, no translations are accepted, although the writers' mother tongue does not have to be English.

Entries to the awards are to be sent in by publishers. Three sets of juries have already been determined, and the judges' names will be announced at the official launching of the awards on Monday evening May 16 at the Centaur Theatre in Montreal.

## Lang works on album with idols

NASHVILLE (CP) — When K.D. Lang started having trouble during a recent recording session in Nashville, she took her problems to a higher power — Patsy Cline.

Never mind that country superstar Cline, who sang hits like I Fall to Pieces, died in 1963. Cline's influence on Lang's career has been so strong that the native of Consort, Alta., (pop. 650), named her band the Reclines.

Lang also chose Cline's producer, Owen Bradley, to oversee her new album Shadowland.

Bradley, 73, called upon three of country music's best known female vocalists — Kitty Wells, Loretta Lynn and Brenda Lee — to add a unique touch to Lang's new record.

The three women eventually appeared on a medley on the album and in a new video, but not until Lang and Bradley had a brief wrangle over details of the project.

"Actually we had a big fight about it," Lang said during a recent video shoot at Bradley's country studio.

"I stomped out to the lake and had a talk with Patsy to find out why he was so stubborn — and of course he was right."

### RISEING STAR

That's Kathy Dawn Lang all right. From her spiky hair to her sawed-off cowboy boots, Lang has emerged as one of the most colorful and talented Canadian stars in years.

She's become somewhat of a regular on the Tonight Show TV program, and she put on an exciting performance during the closing ceremonies at the Winter Olympics.

Lang proved her mettle at last year's Canadian music awards, the Junos, when she defeated perennial winner Anne Murray as best female country vocalist.

Lang and Bradley had originally planned to record only six songs for a mini-album but it fast became a full-scale project.

The record, made with Nashville session musicians instead of the Reclines, has been critically acclaimed as one of the most dazzling vocal performances of 1988.

Some critics have asserted that Shadowland is her real debut, instead of last year's muddled effort, Angel With a Lariat, which sold 50,000 copies in Canada but was not the hit that had been predicted.

### FINDS NEW HERO

"Working with Owen, I realized that I was as big a Bradley fan as I was a Cline fan," Lang said. "It

was a good experience. It just went so easily."

Filled with tunes by country stalwarts such as Roger Miller, Bob Wills and Harlan Howard, Shadowland combines Bradley's classic production with Lang's prodigious singing ability.

A standout track is Honky Tonk Angels' Medley, which features the famous voices of Lynn, Lee and Wells in harmony with Lang and individually. The medley is named after Wells' 1952 hit It Wasn't God Who Made Honky Tonk Angels.

They combine the bluesy In the Evening (When the Sun Goes Down), Ernest Tubbs' You Nearly Lose Your Mind and the Delmore Brothers' Blues Stay Away from Me.

"I think it was one of the easiest sessions I've ever had," Lee said.

"K.D. can sing any part. And Loretta has a great range, as does Kitty, so it wasn't hard to find our parts at all."

During a news conference that preceded the video shoot, Lang was asked whether she felt intimidated working with the country legends.

"I think that intimidated is the wrong word," she said. "I think I felt honored and blessed."

Added Lee, "If you've ever seen K.D. work live, you'll know that not much intimidates her."

## Craftman builds stringed instruments

PETERSBURG, Ont. (CP) — With a razor-sharp knife, Mike McConville shaves fine slivers of wood from a Celtic harp frame in his workshop.

McConville, 33, is a luthier — a builder of stringed instruments — and one of the few in North America to construct the Celtic harp.

Once completed, the instrument will look identical to those played by McConville's Irish forefathers 12 centuries ago, but thanks to modern technology will sound far superior.

Born in Ireland, McConville came to Canada with his parents as a baby. He became interested in the luthier craft at age 12, when his father bought him his first guitar — an electric one — from a part-time luthier.

McConville went along "and

when I saw the shop and tools and parts lying around, it did something to me.

"I took the guitar home, took the neck off, and designed and built one of my own I liked better."

He's been working with instruments ever since, often using tools he has designed and built himself.

### HE'S A MUSICIAN

A musician as well as luthier, McConville has travelled with a number of bands, plays half a dozen instruments and sings.


While performing in northern Quebec, he discovered a shortage of stringed-instrument repair facilities and decided to move there and capitalize on the void. After he'd seemingly repaired all the broken instruments in the region — 260 in the first six months — business began to slow and McConville

felt ready to return to Ontario.

Six months ago he moved to Petersburg in the Waterloo region of southwestern Ontario. He calls the area "an instrument technician's paradise. I can get specialized tools and materials for my trade here quicker than I could get them even in Toronto."

McConville doesn't just build stringed instruments. He dissects and analyses them, measuring their comparative performances the same way other scientists measure electricity or light.

He's the author of an extensive technical paper on the fine points of his craft, one that resulted from a five-year study funded by the Quebec government. In it McConville discusses how various construction techniques affect the sound of stringed instruments.

# Book about investigation that turns on narrator

**Presumed Innocent** by Scott Turow (WARNER BOOKS): \$5.95, 421 pp.

Readers of crime fiction become accustomed to having their stories retailed to them through one of the two usual sources. Either the narrator, or the author's persona, is a detective, or he is a regular beat cop. When it is learned that the narrator in Scott Turow's **Presumed Innocent** is a Prosecuting Attorney's assistant, lovers of innovative crime novels should not be discouraged at the prospect of entering a fictional world guided by this relatively unique guide. Turow's book is an amazing tour de force in its field — thanks to its author's pandering to every reader's constant requirements. Plot twists, surprises, and Dickensian sidetracks into the labyrinthine hallways of the American justice system, only whet the reader's appetite for the kind of reading fare dished out by this former law student, district attorney's assistant, and creative writing teacher turned author.

At the heart of the mystery presented to us in Turow's book is a brutal murder being investigated by one Rusty Sabich, the P.A.'s leading hand in dealing with unsavoury criminal investigations. The added wrinkle, and there are many of these, is that Sabich has to enter into an investigation of the murder of his very own mistress, Carolyn Polhemus. So far, very standard stuff, as far as crime writing is concerned. There is a full disclosure of the physical evidence concerning this case, but always with Turow's book there are twists and turns to the plot that keep the reader eagerly flipping the pages.

As Sabich, Turow's narrator,

leads us further along into this mystery, the delights of this book are revealed. Sabich's observations about his co-workers and the complex, layered system of American law, plus his comments on the process of electing minor legal officials in an unnamed mid-Western American city, are witty and full of insight. When it turns out that Sabich himself becomes the prosecution's principal suspect in the case that he himself began investigating, we encounter one of the many surprises that keep the reader totally engaged.

Turow has revealed that he wrote **Presumed Innocent** while commuting between his home and the US attorney's office in Chicago, but his study of law at Harvard and his New England experiences find their way into this novel. Turow used the Boston Municipal Court as a model for the courtroom scenes which dominate the latter part of **Presumed Innocent**. To give the impression that this is another dull book about the criminal justice system which labours over the predictable routine of courtroom dramas would be a disservice to Turow's wonderful sense of pacing and suspense.

Sabich has a devastatingly keen eye for searching out the foibles and eccentricities of the characters he has come into contact with after over a decade in the ranks of the prosecutors. When he is placed on the other side of the legal scales, and is under investigation himself,

he finds that many of his co-workers and even judges have that faint odour of corruption about them that lingers over the entire political system.

The characters here, from slick cops to overbearing black judges who rule courtrooms with total power, are a continuing source of delight to the reader caught up in Scott Turow's masterful web of intrigue, guilt and one man's fight for his life. The trial scenes unfold with rare excitement and the revelations by various witnesses — such as the Japanese-American Dr. Kumagain, an arrogant scientist responsible for the state's autopsies — move the plot along in unexpected, unpredictable directions. Scott Turow's book led a charmed, many-months-long life at the top of the bestseller charts in hardcover, and will most likely be the most sun-tanned, sand-sprinkled beach item of the summer in its paperback printing.



### RECORD REVIEWS

#### Toni Childs Union (A&M)

Female vocalists seem to be making a major impression on the pop music market lately: Suzanne Vega, Tracy Chapman, a resurgent Joni Mitchell, and now Orange, California-native Toni Childs. Childs returned to California after four years in London, only to meet up with David Ricketts (of David & David, "Welcome To The Boomtown") with whom she collaborates, under the co-production guidance of David Tickle (Split Enz), on **Union**.

Although Childs is the singer, with a dynamic, soulful voice (she says: "I've never liked the high, pretty voices. I liked the ones that were cracking, or hurting, and not afraid to show me how much they hurt") she confesses that working with Ricketts and Tickle "showed me that even for a 'solo artist', record-making is never a solo thing. That's why this album is called 'Union'".

Recorded in London, Paris, Los Angeles and even Africa, **Union** is blessed with very strong songs such as "Walk and Talk Like Angels" and "Don't Walk Away", as well as several tracks that feature African voices. On "Tin Drum", "Let The Rain Come Down", and the haunting tune "Zimbabwe", To-

ni Childs is joined by traditional choirs from Swaziland and Zambia, offering a female perspective on the sound that made **Graceland** such a resounding success for Paul Simon last year. The latter track is an extended plea for understanding in the African world, made more poignant by the soaring voices of the Semaswati Singers and the Zambian group known as New Generation. Behind many of the tracks is the presence of David Ricketts's guitar experiments that made "Boomtown" such an exciting song.

When the roots of rock are considered it should come as no surprise that the African rhythms on "Tin Drum" and other songs here blend so well with the contemporary California sound of Toni Childs. With her commanding vocal presence, obvious commitment to events and issues far afield from her west coast existence, Toni Childs represents the new force in female pop vocalists that certainly has more substance than the bejewelled, lingerie-bedecked, make-up laden madonnas of recent years.



#### Toto The Seventh One (COLUMBIA)

By the time most bands hit their seventh album they have usually found a secure groove for their playing and singing. That kind of grooming hasn't really been necessary for the supergroup of session players from California known as Toto. Toto's problem has been that they are derided for being too good, too letter perfect in their instrumental charts and, like the Eagles before them, convicted of being a band which offers a stage show in concert that note-perfectly duplicates their studio work.

On their 7th recording Toto's lead vocalist Joseph Williams is more comfortable with the material than he was with **Fahrenheit** in 1986. The upheaval that began with Bobby Kimball leaving Toto after **Toto IV** appears to have been resolved, and Williams and the rest of the band sound like a unit on this one.

The Porcaro brothers, Mike and Jeff, Steve Lukather and David Paich have meshed with Williams for this album which is distinguished by a couple of songs that use girl's names for building tender ballads — "Pamela" and "Anna" are both fine songs, the latter in particular, written by Lukather & Randy Goodrum, brings Toto back to the quality of songs like "99" and "Rosanna". On "Stop Loving You", Lukather teams with Paich to write an up-tempo number, while on "Stay Away" Linda Ronstadt

guests on background vocals.

On "Home Of The Brave" Williams and Paich share the lead vocal chores on the album's longest, anthemic song about the way to counteract America's rude fall from grace in the world's eyes. Such a lineup of strong songs should ensure that Toto's seventh, like Beethoven's fifth and ninth, will be distinguished from the rest of their respective musical canons.

### VIDEO SCREENINGS

#### Someone To Watch Over Me (RCA/COLUMBIA VIDEO)

Director Ridley Scott proves that his directorial skills were no fluke with **Alien** in this cleverly filmed story about a cop from Queens, New York who must watch over a beautiful socialite who becomes a witness to a brutal murder.

Tom Berenger plays detective Mike Keegan with enough nice-guy likeability to almost make viewers forget his role as the despicable Sergeant Barnes in **Platoon**. Berenger is assigned to protect gorgeous and fashionable Mimi Rogers, who plays the sophisticated Claire Gregory. As Berenger falls under the spell of his tour of duty's classy subject, director Ridley juxtaposes the life of a Queens cop and his feisty wife Ellie (Lorraine Bracco) and son Tommy.

The filming makes the most out of moody shots, soaring symphonic music when cop Berenger heads up-town to babysit the lady, and bold camera techniques in the climactic moments, à la **Alien**. In a play on the idea of fatal attraction, Berenger becomes enamoured of his protectee even as he catches himself moving away from the life of his family. The developing affair between the cop and the lady, the domestic strife between the cop and his wife, are each wedged in between the movie's relentless plot device — the fact that the killer the lady witnessed knifing her friend is out to get her at any expense.

With rising action that is heightened by director Scott's eye for detail and realism, this film moves quickly toward a classic showdown — with an unexpected, powerful ending. The performances by all the major players are first rate, in particular that of Lorraine Bracco as the cop's wife, Ellie. Bracco is convincing in a role that asks her to play the Debra Winger part in **Terms Of Endearment**, and Berenger's brooding good looks will do nothing but shoot up his stock in the leading-man department. # Axile tries to demystify the ordinary things in life

**SHERBROOKE** — The two dancers going through their warm-up routines are quiet, concentrating on every movement. They bend their bodies forward, stretch their legs and arms, their bodies supple and light. They are concentrating, moving slowly with care, knowing well enough that the wrong move could ruin everything they are working so hard to create.

The dancers are Brigitte Graff and Liliane St-Arnaud, the originators of Axile, a year-old modern dance company based in Sherbrooke.

Graff and St-Arnaud's concern with their bodies is a major part of the dance company itself, and it was transferred to one of its creations, a children's show called *Casse-Tête*, meaning puzzle.

*Casse-Tête* is more than a children's show, according to the two dancers.

"The children also take part in the show, that's why we call it a *spectacle intervention*," Graff explained.

## CHILDREN ARE IMPORTANT

By "intervention" Graff means that the children in the audience have the opportunity to become part of the show, and an important part at that because through their participation they can learn to understand their bodies and how they work.

This pedagogical aspect of the children's show is the very basis of Axile as a dance company. According to Graff, one of the dance company's goals is to promote modern dance, to make it more accessible to children, and through them to their parents.

"Everyone is acquainted with classical ballet, and even ballet jazz, people know quite a lot about it, it has its own following," Graff said. "But when it comes to modern dance, people are afraid of it. They just don't know very much about it."

Nodding her head, St-Arnaud agreed. She said that is also part of the goal of Axile, to let people in on what modern dance is all about.

"What we are trying to do is to teach children to be open to the unusual. That way their parents will hear about it from their children and they'll be interested to go see a performance," St-Arnaud explained.

## TWO OLD PROS

If there is one thing these two dancers know well, it is teaching modern dance. Graff, who moved from Belgium to Sherbrooke three years ago, has been teaching modern dance for almost five years. She now teaches at the *Ecole Dance Formation* in Sherbrooke.

St-Arnaud, born in Victoriaville, has also been teaching modern dance for the physical education department at the University of Sherbrooke.

So the two are old pros. Well, not so old. With their tiny figures and long, bouncy hair, they both look hardly old enough to be out of university.

But they certainly know the business well and have had enough experience not only in teaching dance but dancing itself.

They don't kid themselves as to what it takes to run a dance company. When they created Axile with two men, Marquis Poissant, their sales director and Serge Maurice, their technical director, they knew they were in for a lot of hard work and very little free time. They all went ahead with their project, and together formed a professional dance company that set out to do something that from the start they knew would be almost impossible, to make modern dance accessible to people who would never have considered it as a form of entertainment, while making Sherbrooke their home base.

## PARTNERS

Axile doesn't approach its goal of getting the local population acquainted with modern dance in any ordinary way. In each performance, the dancers use objects,

chairs, tables and wood dolls, but used in ways they have never been used before.

"The objects aren't used as accessories or props, but more as partners. We use ski boots or a rocking chair, and try to find new ways to use them," Graff said.

"We're trying to demystify these objects, to take away their know usage, to make them come to life so that it makes people use their imagination and help them discover their imagination," St-Arnaud added.

"I will use a rocking chair, but I won't just sit and rock on it in the usual way, I'll try to find other ways of doing it," Graff explained.

If it sounds like Axile is trying to take modern dance several steps further, that was the dancers' intention from the start. But the founders of Axile know well enough what they are trying to achieve is bound to take more than a year or two, and they don't expect to reap financial rewards for a long time.

"We are a non-lucrative organization. We just want to promote modern dance and to tell people that there is a professional dance company in the region that plans to stay in the region," St-Arnaud explained.

## GROWING

But although Graff and St-Arnaud say they don't plan to make any money from their enterprise for a long time, and on the contrary are investing more than just their time and expertise into it, Axile is already growing. From the four people that first conceived it the company already has a new administrative consultant, Ghyslaine Phaneuf.

There are also three new dancers added to the troupe, Susanne Daigle, Manon Favreau and Diane Jacques. The extra dancers are part of the group's plans to adapt the children's show so that it can be performed in auditorium.

*Casse-Tête* has previously been performed in several schools in the area and in Lévy, near Quebec City. But in bringing it to an auditorium the show will require more than two dancers as the children in the audience will no longer be able to take part in the performance.

Graff and St-Arnaud acknowledge that the company is growing faster than they had expected it would in only its first year, they insist they don't want things to move too fast. They don't expect people to come and work with Axile without being paid although that is what they are doing right now.

## OFFERED A CHANCE

"We've been offered the chance to perform *Casse-Tête* in Montreal, but we said no. We were honest. We know that as it is now it is only a show that can be performed in a school, and it wouldn't work in an auditorium," Graff said.

For now they plan to work on changing *Casse-Tête* and also on creating an adult show they hope to perform in Sherbrooke this fall. If they take it nice and slow, they might just get very far.

## Churchill's War Rooms are open to public scrutiny

LONDON — The letter, written in a child's scrawling hand, peers out from a haphazard assortment of war remembrances kept in a glass cabinet:

"Dear Mummy and Daddy,  
"We had a terrible raid on Exeter this morning. The warning sounded at 1:45 a.m. We got up and went downstairs. Soon the planes were over and bombs were dropped. Jean and I dived under the dining room table. Then Mrs. Every went upstairs and shouted, or rather screamed, that the house was on fire."

Nearly 70,000 civilians throughout England were killed by German bombs dropped during the

Second World War. Through it all, Prime Minister Winston Churchill and his war cabinet plotted the country's course from a dismal concrete bunker three metres below ground.

The Cabinet War Rooms sit beneath the government offices of Great George Street, and minutes from Whitehall where 10 Downing Street, the Houses of Parliament, and the principal ministries are located.

It was from this underground maze, where the walls are as thick as five metres in places, that Churchill and his cabinet sat late into the night, designing their country's eventual victory.

**OPENED 1984**

The men and women behind Bri-

tain's war effort used the bunker from 1938, when the threat of war with Germany began to build, until the war's end in 1945.

The most significant portion of this labyrinth, chosen for the security of the steel-framed structure above and its proximity to Whitehall, has been open to the public since 1984. It could accommodate 270 people, who could eat, sleep and work here without needing to come above ground for weeks.

The 20-odd rooms, with glass walls replacing the original concrete to help expose the interiors to visitors, are on display as they were during the war.

Because of the back-in-a-moment appearance of the place, there's an air of expectancy about

it. Perhaps even apprehension.

The historic cabinet room, where Churchill held more than 100 meetings with his war cabinet and defence committee, is set as it would have been for the 5 p.m. meeting of Oct. 14, 1940.

A huge square table dominates the room. Papers and pencils sit waiting at each of the 21 places. A nameplate marks Churchill's place—in a wooden chair at the far side of the room, beneath a huge world map.

### RAID WARNING

Above the door, two lights, one painted red, one green, indicated whether an air raid was in progress. For cabinet meetings, Clement Attlee, the deputy prime minister, remained on Churchill's left with Sir Edward Bridges, cabinet secretary, on his right.

Just outside the cabinet room, a trapdoor in the floor leads to the sub-basement (not open to the public), a low, dingy space where most of the staff stayed during the worst of the bombings.

The Transatlantic Telephone Room contains the scrambled telephone Churchill used to speak directly to Franklin D. Roosevelt, the American president. Churchill was so concerned that room remain a secret that he had it disguised as his private bathroom.

Farther into the complex is the map room, which was manned around the clock by officers from the three armed forces. A line of red, green and ivory phones linked the map room to other important centres in London, including 10 Downing Street.

Maps of France, Italy, North Africa and other battle areas cover every inch of the walls. Yellow,

white and blue pushpins, indicating the positions of Allied and enemy troops, are still scattered across them.

### NEAR MAPS

Churchill's private room, a combination of office and bedroom with a large wooden desk and a small single bed, is strategically placed next door to the map room. Churchill only slept here three times—he and his wife lived in apartments on the main floor of the building, dubbed 10 Downing Street Annex.

However, it was from this sad little room with its drab block walls that Churchill made many of his famous broadcasts.

Personal memories of the great man abound. In his office sit his battered Remington typewriter, his chamberpot and bottles of his favorite champagne—Pol Roger. Upon his death in 1965, the company bordered the bottles in black.

Other rooms open to the public include emergency quarters for officers, the room for BBC equipment.

You can still see the rows of desks in the offices for the round-the-clock typing pools. Typists received regular ultraviolet treatment to counter the effects of working and sleeping underground.

While some rooms have been converted to exhibition areas, many remain just as they were left the day when the emergency headquarters were abandoned with the formal surrender of Japan in 1945.

The entrance to the Cabinet War Rooms is open daily. It is located at Clive Steps on King Charles Street. The nearest Underground stop is Westminster.

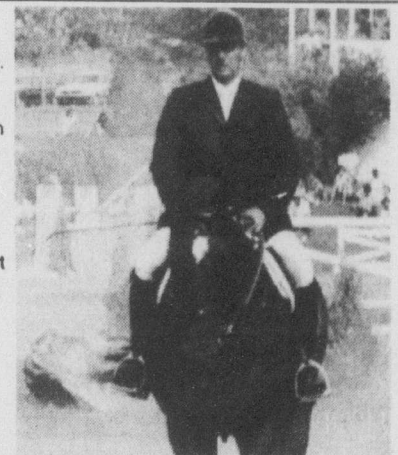

Showtimes, weekly at 7:15 and 9:20, Saturday and Sunday matinées at 1, 3:05 and 5:10.

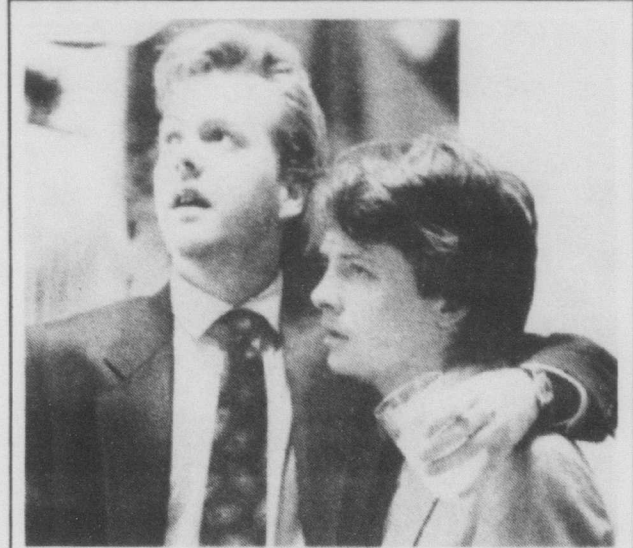
