## Quebec court says CPR not liable in Lac-Mégantic train crash

A Quebec Superior Court judge says Canadian Pacific Railway is not liable in the 2013 Lac-Mégantic, Que., railway disaster that killed 47 people.

Justice Martin Bureau ruled Wednesday that the actions the railway company was accused of are not the direct, immediate and logical cause of the damages suffered by the victims of the tragedy.

Bureau says the fault for the disaster lies with the train conductor, Thomas Harding, and with Montreal Maine and Atlantic

For the first time in 148 years, the Quebec Challenge Cup has found a temporary home at the North Hatley Curling Club, following a spirited tilt against the Bedford Curling

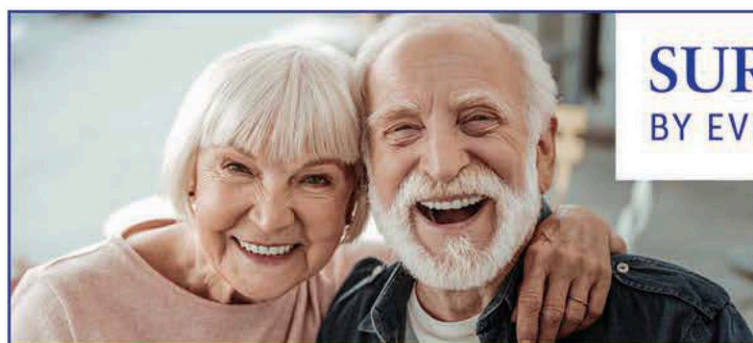
Club last month.

The Quebec Challenge Cup started back in 1874, according to North Hatley Curling Club President Marc Côté, and while it has appeared in various clubs throughout the Eastern Townships over its storied history, the cup has

never been seen at the club in North Hatley, until now.

The curling club has struggled throughout the pandemic, Côté shared. It was difficult to maintain upkeep, paying utility bills, electricity, heating,

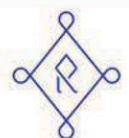
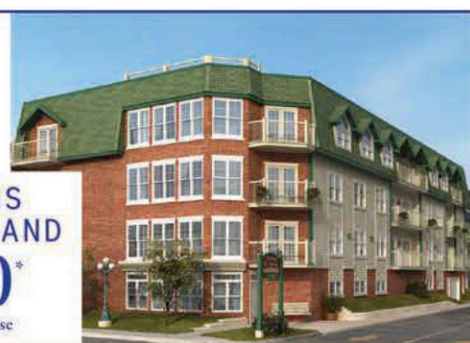

# The most “checked out” kids’ books of 2022!



## GOOD READS

### LENNOXVILLE LIBRARY

At this time of year folks are sharing round-ups and “best-of” lists for the year. My social media is filled with Spotify Wrapped lists, gift guides and lots of top-tens. Well, your local kid-lit reviewer has never been one to shy away from a bandwagon, and I find it fascinating to see which books have been borrowed the most from the local library shelves. My first impression of the list, was that, ironically, I hadn’t borrowed or read any of them! I must not be very trendy. But now, after reading many of them, and reading lots of descriptions and reviews, I expect I will be checking out a number of these soon, and potentially gifting a few to my own kids this Christmas. Enjoy!

#10 *The Digger and the Duckling* by Joseph Kuefler.

Digger and the other big trucks love to build. But when a lost duckling waddles onto the jobsite, Digger and his friends learn to do more than just scoop and hoist, they learn to become a family. Share this beautiful picture book as a great introduction to taking care of the environment.

#9 *The Fabled Stables #3 - Belly of the Beast* by Jonathan Auxier; illustrated by Olga Demidova.

Belly of the Beast is the third book in a chapter-book adventure series featuring magical animals, perfect for fans of *The Princess in Black* series. On an island at the top of the world are the Fabled Stables, a one-of-a-kind place for one-of-a-kind creatures. Auggie is their caretaker, and it’s his job to strike out into the Wide World and save creatures from danger. In this book, Auggie is literally swallowed by a creature, and

only with the help of his friends, and some magic and kindness will he be able to escape.

#8 *Those Kids from Fawn Creek* by Erin Entrada Kelly.

The latest book from Newbery Medalist Erin Entrada Kelly is a story of friendship, lies, acceptance, and community, featuring art by Celia Krampien. Every day is the same in Fawn Creek until someone new comes to join the small school and stir things up.

#7 *Animal BFFs: Even animals have best friends!* by Sophie Corrigan.

The only non-fiction in the top-ten, this beautiful hard-cover book explores friendships between all parts of the animal kingdom. Uncover some unlikely friendships from the world of animals and discover how creatures get through every day with a little help from their friends. This book is full of funny facts about animals and symbiotic relationships for children to explore.

#6 *Clementine and the Lion* by Zoey Abbott.

This fantastical book tells the tale of Clementine, who is rather relieved when her mother is snatched by dragons and her father is lost at sea in a bottle. Since her parents are ogres of the worst kind, she is overjoyed that she gets to take care of her self, and make her own decisions. This is almost thwarted by a pesky aunt, and a lion! Will she get to be on her own forever? Read and find out!

#5 *Hot Dog* by Doug Salati.

From a critically acclaimed creator comes this summery picture book featuring an overheated—and overwhelmed—pup who finds his calm with some sea, sand, and fresh air. This picture book has beautiful, descriptive writing to make the reader really feel the setting come to life.

#4 *The Bad Seed Goes to the Library* by Jory John and Pete Oswald.

The Bad Seed is in a good mood... for once. That’s because there’s a really cool book at the library available for checkout. The Bad Seed reads, and reads, but then he gets bad news: The book must be returned to the library so another seed can enjoy it. Will the Bad Seed return to his old ways and keep the book? Part of the series of books featuring “The Bad Seed,” this comical tale explains the joys and conventions of public libraries.

#3 *No nibbling!* written by Beth Ferry and illustrated by A. N. Kang.

Enjoy this wonderful story set in a garden plot, about Derwood the goat and Tabitha the Bunny’s pesky relationship, which blossoms into a beautiful friendship. The book is full of puns and vegetable-themed word-play which will delight readers of all ages.

#2 *Lizzy and the Cloud* by the Fan Brothers.

Lizzy is looking to adopt a cloud. She isn’t looking for a big one or a fancy one, just one that’s right for her. Then she finds Milo. Soon, she’s taking Milo out on walks with her family, watering Milo right on schedule, and seeing Milo grow and grow. But what happens when her pet cloud gets too big for Lizzy to handle? Find out when you read this beautiful and whimsical picture book.

#1 *The Year We Learned to Fly* by Jacqueline Woodson, illustrated by Rafael López.

This is a beautiful picture book about a brother and sister, who, on a dreary day, heed their grandmother’s advice: “Use those beautiful and brilliant minds of yours. Lift your arms, close your eyes, take a deep breath, and believe in a thing. Somebody, somewhere, at some point was just as bored as you are now.” In exploring their imaginations and lifting their spirits, the children learn about their ancestors overcoming adversity, despite struggles and challenges, by creating a beautiful magical space in which to fly with their minds.

# Quebec public health director expects more COVID cases, says avoid gatherings if sick

**A**head of the first holiday season in two years with no restrictions on private gatherings, Quebec's public health director encouraged people to use common sense and avoid parties if they feel sick.

Dr. Luc Boileau told reporters in Quebec City that he expects the number of COVID-19 cases in Quebec hospitals to rise as a result of holiday gatherings.

"We expect the COVID situation to get worse than it is right now," he said. "It's obvious that there will be more contacts between people during the next couple of weeks."

The holiday period is particularly risky for the spread of respiratory viruses, Boileau said, because family gatherings often involve multiple generations, including older people and very young children, who are at higher risk of serious illness.

He said he hopes people will be "really careful" and called on Quebecers to avoid gatherings for 10 days if they have flu-like symptoms, even if those symptoms are mild.

Healthy people, Boileau said, who have previously been exposed to COVID-19 or influenza may have few symptoms but could spread the virus to someone more vulnerable. He also called on people not to pass babies around at holiday parties and kiss them like "the Stanley Cup."

"Please, it's really important for them, the babies," he said.

Quebec hospitals have been buffeted by a trio of respiratory viruses in recent weeks, COVID-19, respiratory syncytial virus and influenza, and the situation remains "very difficult in the emergency rooms," Boileau said.

On Wednesday afternoon, the occupancy rate in Quebec emergency rooms averaged 133 per cent, the sixth time in nine days that average occupancy rates were above 130 per

cent.

Boileau said the number of cases of RSV, a disease that can cause serious illness in young children, is declining.

"It's good news for pediatric units, that's not to say things are going well for our pediatric hospitals. They continue to be crowded; it's still demanding for the teams, but at least that virus is on a more reassuring trend," he said.

However, the province is in the midst of an early flu season, and while it's possible that the peak of the outbreak has been reached, the number of cases "remains very high," Boileau said.

Earlier Wednesday, the Health Department said 2,081 people were in hospital with COVID-19, an increase of 60 from the day before. It's the highest number of COVID-19 hospitalizations in the province since Oct. 19.

The news conference Wednesday took place almost a year after Quebec Premier Francois Legault announced

a series of new restrictions aimed at slowing the spread of the Omicron variant of COVID-19, including a ban on work parties.

On Dec. 16, 2021, when that announcement was made, fewer than 400 people were in hospital with the disease.

But Boileau said the situation is different this year: people have a high level of protection from the virus because of vaccination and previous infection, and most patients currently in hospital tested positive for COVID-19 after they were admitted for other reasons.

The Health Department said 698 COVID-19 patients, about 33 per cent, were admitted because of the disease.

"It's not the same picture, so we're not as worried as we were last year," Boileau said, adding that he does not plan to recommend the province reintroduce any sort of coercive measures.

and insurance, when the province went into lockdown, he explained, adding there was a point when he wasn't sure they would reopen.

"We've been struggling financially in North Hatley for the past couple of years because of Covid. It has been a really good boost to our club. We really needed it and I'm super proud to have finally won it, especially with the gang of guys that we won it with," Côté told The Record.

The Quebec Challenge Cup is unique to Quebec and Eastern Ontario. And it only comes around every five to seven years, Côté said. Since clubs from both provinces are allowed to take a crack at hoisting the towering five-foot tall trophy, the waiting list can be quite lengthy.

The cup holders are required to defend their title every two or three weeks, Côté continued. North Hatley will face off against St. Lambert on Sunday, Dec. 18 at noon. It is the first

time the club will host a challenge event, and there is a buzz in the air, especially for veteran members.

The way it works is two teams from each club will face off against each other. The club with the most combined points takes the trophy. If North Hatley loses on Sunday, they will fall down to the bottom of list. They will have to wait another few years before they can get another shot.

Côté has been curling for 30 years. He took part in his first challenge cup in 2009. The opportunities are few and far between, he said, so he intends to relish every second of the event on Sunday. The club is more competitive, though, since adding some youth, he noted.

"In the last couple of years, our club, we've been lucky to attract a couple of the younger curlers in the area because of, well, young families and we have a good junior program and we welcome the kids to the club. We have a big

family environment in North Hatley," said Côté.

Côté has taken part in three challenge cups. But it was Marty Rourke's first time competing in the event. Rourke, who has 30 years of curling experience under his belt, only joined the club in North Hatley nearly eight years ago. He said he was lucky to take part in such a significant event.

"The whole experience around it is a tradition and curling is a traditional game in a lot of ways and to be part of that was really cool. For me, I mean, my dad played in it a bunch of times, so it was neat to kind of hear the stories and actually get to compete," Rourke told The Record.

Rourke played an important role in securing the club's first ever cup. It was his prowess and precision on the ice that pushed North Hatley's point total over the top when they came head-to-head with Bedford. Rourke added the same eight curlers will play St. Lambert

on Sunday.

"It really is something that was pretty cool. Our club is small and we've had our ups and downs but I think it brought a lot of people together and it certainly makes it fun. We're looking forward to putting on a good show Sunday and hopefully having a lot of people out," he said.

Like Côté, Rourke is hoping this latest victory will generate some interest in the sport. The goal is to bring in more youth and not only teach kids the fundamentals of curling, but also about the sport's history in Canada. Sunday's event will start with a local junior curlers showcase. "It's a real family atmosphere [...] We have our juniors playing before and have them around the club, too. They'll get to experience a little bit of this tradition and see this cup that's maybe even taller than a few of the ones that are playing," Rourke said in a phone interview Tuesday.

Railway Limited, Harding's employer and owner of the runaway train.

Canadian Pacific is the only company accused of responsibility in the derailment that did not participate in a \$430-million settlement fund for victims, which was created as part of a class-action lawsuit involving almost 4,000 people.

The company maintained it bore no

responsibility for the disaster because the train was not operated by CP employees or travelling on CP tracks when it derailed.

On July 6, 2013, an unmanned train carrying crude oil and owned by MMA roared into Lac-Mégantic and derailed, with its cargo exploding and decimating part of the downtown core and killing 47 people.

# Open to the Spirit

Today's word: "Legends"

1) Events that we deem legendary are usually celebrated in story, poetry, song or myriad other art forms. Many of the seasonal carols we sing are legends retold over millennia. Legends are rooted in events with some history, whether factual or imagined — happenings that change over time as they are told and retold, handed down from generation to generation. That is true of many of the stories we tell in this holy season at year's ending.

On a recent visit back home, one of my daughters gifted me with a Yule tree ornament from the collection of a beloved aunt who died about this time a year ago. The little box had my name on it, and it held a delicate white filigree crèche scene showing the three Magi offering gifts to the holy child. This aunt first told me the story of my ancestor Henry van Dyke, who as both poet and pastor back in 1895 wrote the story of The Other Wise Man. His retelling of the Nativity story imagines a fourth wise man, Artaban, one of the learned astronomers of Persia, a follower of the Zoroastrian deity Ahura Mazda. With his three learned friends, whose names you know, he meets in his observatory on Mount Orontes to

plan the arduous trip to Bethlehem after seeing the prophetic star in the night sky. The other three make it to their destination and meet the Holy Family face to face. But the Fourth Wise Man is delayed repeatedly by his many acts of mercy and compassion to strangers along his path. Though he searches a lifetime for the king of Hebrew prophecy, Artaban in the end has found the Holy One in all those he met along his journey. The story's inscription reads: "Who seeks for heaven alone to save his soul / May keep the path but will not reach the goal; / While he who walks in love may wander far, / Yet God will bring him where the blessed are."

This season, as in every year, we will revisit many legends and stories, told, retold, and reimagined, on the ancient theme of the coming of light into the world. Every children's pageant is a new take on the old story, with contemporary trimmings and a new cast every year! Perhaps you too have legends that change over time, stories of family gatherings or previous holiday celebrations. May all our legends be blessed, and may our hearts be filled to overflowing with the many meanings of this hallowed time.

2) As we approach the holiday season once again, I have begun my annual reflection on the story

of the Jewish holiday of Hanukkah. While some of the details are up for debate, the legend is rooted in the tale of Judah Maccabee and his family, a small but mighty group of warriors who overcame the powerful king Antiochus and the Greeks to reclaim the Temple in Jerusalem and once again be able to practice their traditions and live freely as Jews. This part of the story is straightforward, as it describes with a heavy dose of pride how the "weak overcame the strong." Yet the most familiar part of the Hanukkah story is frankly a bit harder to believe. As we tell our children, when the time came to rededicate the Temple, there was only enough oil in the Menorah to last one day, but a miracle occurred and with God's help, it lasted eight days! While both parts of the story are important, it is the miracle that holds the holiday together and the part of the story that is made into children's books and movies.

But when I tell this story, I am sometimes asked a simple but obvious question: "Did that all really happen? That seems a bit hard to believe!" It is not just Hanukkah, and it is easy to ask the same questions about any holiday or any ancient legend which somehow doesn't seem to hold up to the modern-day scientific mind. The simple answer, at least with Hanukkah, is "no." Most evidence points to the fact that the miracle of the oil never actually occurred, but it was instead an "invention" of the ancient rabbis to add power and meaning to the holiday, to bring God and faith back into the story.

But is the story true? Yes, it is also true. What matters most when thinking about faith and tradition is not whether a story or legend is historically accurate, but what the story has done to the people telling it. After generations of telling a story, the morals and the meaning have a very real effect on the way that people live their lives and how they organize their community. The truth comes through in the way the story is used, and in this way, it doesn't matter whether every fact is correct.

With the story of Hanukkah, this works on many levels. We have the legend of Judah and the Maccabees who can remind us to stay strong in the face of oppression and to never believe that we don't have the power to overcome evil. With the miracle of the oil, we can remember the power of faith and the strength of community, and also understand the ways that a good story can help keep traditions and rituals alive throughout the generations. The "truth" of these events happens when we live the values which they impart and when we learn something new each time they are told. It also seems to be, at least with Jewish holidays, that the stories give us an excuse to have some tasty treats. As the old Jewish joke goes: Every Jewish holiday is essentially the same: "They tried to kill us, we won, let's eat!". Now, if that's the moral of

the story, count me in!

3) We are fast approaching Christmas, and legends are a part of this season. Some of us put up stockings for Santa to fill Christmas Eve. This is based on a legend about a caring priest named Nicholas who threw coins into the window of poor families, which landed in stockings hung to dry by a fireplace. Another legend is about a 4th wise man, who missed the journey with the other 3 magi, and wanders the world doing good deeds. Another legend from Iceland is about the 12 Yule lads who wander around putting gifts in empty shoes before Christmas. Many, many countries have their own legends and traditions.

When I first read about an author stating that human beings used legends to make meaning out of life, I was skeptical. Did that mean that we were living some kind of fiction, not based on reality? With time though I have come to appreciate this approach. Through legends we develop a sense of who we are, what our history has taught us and what kind of challenges we may face. Also in life there are historical truths, and emotional truths. When I was younger, I was raised by storytellers. My Dad, my grandfather, even my aunts and uncles told stories. They were part real life, and part fiction. Many of them were used to teach a lesson. I tend to do that too. One of my catchphrases is: "Let me tell you a story". Many legends lead to empathetic actions which bring love and hope.

To be sure, there may be some factual basis to many of these stories but used as metaphors they have an even greater application. How does one describe humanity's relationship to the parts of life we cannot see, or touch or feel? What would life be like without love, or courage or beauty? The legend of Pandora's box offers hope in traumatic times, 2,000 years after the story was first told.

In the past few years, we have discovered legends from our Indigenous brothers and sisters, like the one about the Dreamcatcher. These are important. I do not want to toss them away or dismiss their importance with a cynical comment. I want to use their power to change our country for the future. I have a dreamcatcher on the window across from where I sit writing. I hope that you, our readers, will enjoy these various legends in this joyful season, listen with empathy, and use them prompt good deeds in a sometimes cruel world. . .

# Townshippers Foundation keeps community interest at heart

The Townshippers Foundation, a non-profit charitable organization, has become a beacon of support within communities throughout the Eastern Townships, investing thousands of dollars every year to continuously improve the quality of life in the region.

Jane Loiselle, the current president of the board of the directors for the foundation, has been involved in the organization for more than 10 years. Although the pandemic slowed down the organization's charitable work, the foundation has remained an active voice in the Townships.

"Our methodology will always remain the same. One of our members said years ago that we can only give away what we receive, in other words the donations that we receive. We keep a small percentage just to cover administrative fees, and we're proud of that fact," Loiselle said.

She told The Record most foundations use an 80-20 split when they receive donations. But the Townshippers Foundation only takes about 10 per cent of donations to cover its administrative costs, such as purchasing printing paper, for example. The rest goes back into the community.

While the board president said that she has noticed folks are not donating as much these days, likely a byproduct of the pandemic, the organization continues to receive a steady stream of monetary support from the public. It also allows the foundation to offer grants between \$500 and \$2,500.

"It goes up and down," she said. "Some years, we're very fortunate, many people have thought of us in their wills and they've given us a bequest, which is always nice. But I'd say we probably average \$40,000 a year in donations, maybe a little higher."

Despite the significant amount raised, however, Loiselle added one of the challenges she has noticed is groups are less eager to put forward a project proposal because there is a constant worry that it might be cancelled at the last-minute due to Covid. But she believes folks are starting to come out of their shell again.

Loiselle told The Record that prior to the pandemic, the organization received roughly 30 to 35 project proposals per year. Now, the number of proposals lies anywhere between 20 and 24, she explained in a phone interview Thursday. A project also needs to meet the proper criteria.

"The last couple of years have been a bit slow. I think we had 23 or 24 requests last year. Some years we've had as many as 40. But I think probably the average is in the 20 to 24 range. We do, on occasion, have to refuse a project because it doesn't meet our criteria," said Loiselle.

The organization is essentially providing seed money to people and groups to help start their project. But the money isn't simply deposited into someone's personal banking account. They need to have a business account, she said, holding them accountable for the project's future. There also needs to be a concrete business plan, as well as a projected budget, Loiselle continued. And while the organization is not able to provide \$10,000 for one project, for example, they have also created a partnerships program to help folks who need more funding.

"We say, 'Look, you can't get charitable status to issue a tax receipt. We'll form a partnership with you. You do the legwork in terms of fundraising, and the money goes through us.' We take a small percentage, we issue a tax receipt and that money goes back to the group," she said. According to the foundation's website, this is a way to "help groups and organizations without registered charitable status." Donors sometimes want the benefits of charitable tax receipts. But "many small groups working to raise their own funds are unable to issue tax receipts."

This is where the foundation steps in, issuing tax receipts and giving donors another incentive to provide financial support. The program has worked remarkably well, Loiselle said, and it has allowed the organization to reach folks and organizations from all over the Eastern Townships.

The Townshippers Foundation has been an integral support system in the region and it was recognized this year as one of CBC Quebec's Charities of the Year. Loiselle said the notoriety will go a long way for collecting donations and generating more public interest.

She also made a point of stating that although the foundation is often confused for Townshippers' Association, the two organizations are in fact separate entities. The foundation was born out of the association after funding requests for community projects started to pile on, she explained.


Loiselle, who worked with Townshippers' Association for six years, said eventually the foundation took over that part of it. There is no self-interest, she noted, and the foundation has its own internal review process. But the association does help keep the lights on at the office.

"[Townshippers' Association] very generously gives us office space and pays for staff support, so that's a big part. If we had to start paying for that, I don't know what we would do. We would probably work out of our homes, you know, like many groups do," Loiselle shared.

There's something special about opening presents, reading a book, or cuddling up to watch a movie knowing a winter wonderland, full of fluffy snow, is waiting for you just outside your door.

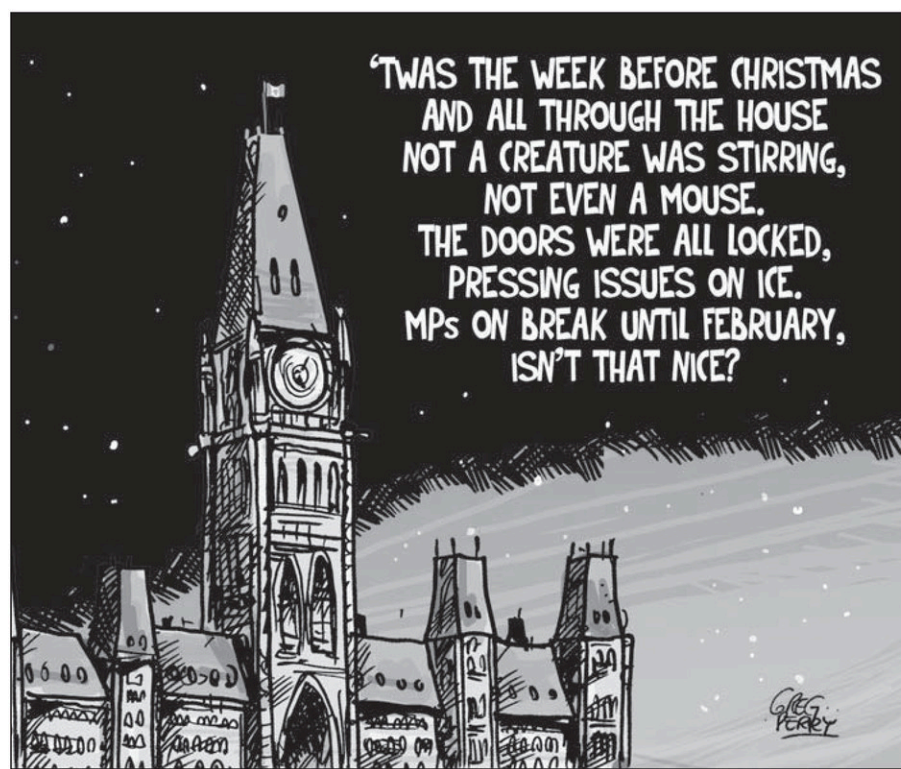
We're lucky to live in a province that experiences every season to its fullest.

## Phoenix look for spark in December drought

With just four wins over their last 10 games, the Sherbrooke Phoenix have hit a bit of a rough patch heading into the holiday break, and their downward spiral was highlighted in a lopsided 7-1 loss to the Chicoutimi Saguenéens on Sunday.

It was Sherbrooke's first blowout loss of the season. However, it also encapsulated the team's recent struggles to find the back of the net, as well as keeping pucks out of their own end. They haven't been closing out games like they have in the past, and the trend is worrisome.

According to Jonathan Deschenes, who stepped in as interim head coach while Stephane Julien is away with Hockey Canada for the World Junior Ice Hockey Championships, it's simple: the Phoenix aren't burying their chances, and there have been countless opportunities.

"There was a part at the beginning where we didn't have the results that we wanted, but we were playing the right way. We had a lot of chances, more than the opponent, we had a lot of puck possession, but we were getting gutted on both ends of the ice," Deschenes explained.

It doesn't help that the team is missing some its core leadership group in Julien, star forward Joshua Roy, and dynamic defenseman Tyson Hinds. Roy and Hinds both cracked Team Canada's roster, so they will be out of the Phoenix lineup at least until after the holiday break.

"Bad things are going to happen. I always say things are going to go to sh\*t a little bit. Nothing is going to be perfect, but it is how you react and

bounce back from it," said Deschenes, adding players need to recover quickly after a bad shift, or even a missed scoring opportunity.

Asked whether they are having trouble finding momentum on the road, Sherbrooke's recent losses have come away from home, Deschenes told The Record he doesn't see any correlation. He noted all of those losses, besides Chicoutimi, have been by one or two goals.

Deschenes is more concerned about a prolonged losing streak. He said there needs to be some urgency on the ice and in the locker room. The trouble with losing streaks is becoming complacent and losing the hunger to win, Deschenes continued, so they'll need to dig deep.

The Phoenix have also been jumping between goaltenders for the past few weeks trying to find a spark between the pipes. Jakob Robillard and Samuel St-Hilaire have each displayed moments of brilliance. A big save can do wonders to a team's confidence and shift momentum.

The Phoenix will have a perfect opportunity to bounce back this weekend with back-to-back games against the second-place Victoriaville Tigres. The Phoenix are motivated to get back into the win column, according to Deschenes, they want to prove that they can win anywhere.

"The next two games are important for us against Victoriaville. They're just a little bit ahead of us in the standings. It's a team that, the way they play, it's how much are we willing to put on our work boots. They're a tight group, work hard and they're tough to play against," he said.

**G**ordon Shea is a young man with a lot of drive who wants to succeed and bring his music to a nation. This has been a dream of his for many years now. He is giving all he's got, hoping one day it will all come true.

Shea was born in Sherbrooke, but his parents moved to Coaticook where he grew up. His mother plays the organ while his father is a record collector with eclectic musical tastes. His collection includes a lot of Beatles, Paul McCartney and Elvis Presley records, his all-time idols, as well as many other musical genres.

Shea's uncle Robert Shea is a bass player in the region who is very well known for his collaboration with many popular bands.

The young man was raised in a home where music was an essential item for the whole family.

# Fall to pieces over a puzzling new museum exhibit

The Beaulne Museum is pleased to present its newest exhibition: "In 1000 pieces!" The history of puzzles, from Dec 11, 2022 to Jan 22, 2023. The public and the press are cordially invited to visit.

The origin of puzzles dates back to 1760 when the English cartographer and engraver John Spilsbury had the idea of cutting out maps illustrating different countries of the world to allow learning geography in a fun way. The word "puzzle," which generally designates an enigma or

a brain teaser, then entered into usage and the first puzzles were made with a thin wooden board on which an image is painted. From the 20th century, an evolution then took place in the sense that the elements of the puzzle which until then had simply been placed side by side then became nestable, as in a modern jigsaw puzzle. In addition, production became industrialized, so that production costs fell. From then on, mass production began and allowed the puzzle to be distributed on a large scale.

This exhibition, whose theme

is perfectly suited to the holiday season, presents some thirty puzzles from different periods, from the end of the 19th century to the second half of the 20th century, exclusively from the Museum's collections.

Menard sometimes help him with the arrangements on the original tunes.

Shea stressed that he listens to a wide variety of music from rap to classical.

"I must admit that I have a preference for Paul McCartney, but I love listening to a mix of genres. I find it shows in my music. I love mixing jazz elements with other styles.

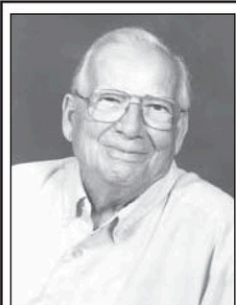

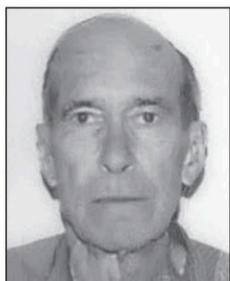

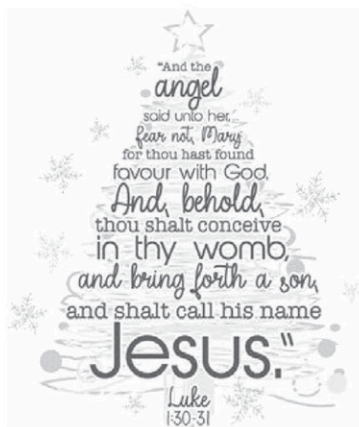

Now I feel back in the same place, and I don't know how to stop this running circle of guilt, like it was my fault he cheated on me. I really wish I could get over it and move on, because that's what I should do. But I have flashbacks and make up scenarios in my head. Please give me some advice. I'm tired of feeling this way. I need a way to let go of this heavy weight on my shoulders. – Lost in Love

Dear Lost in Love: He needs to help you take that weight off your shoulders. 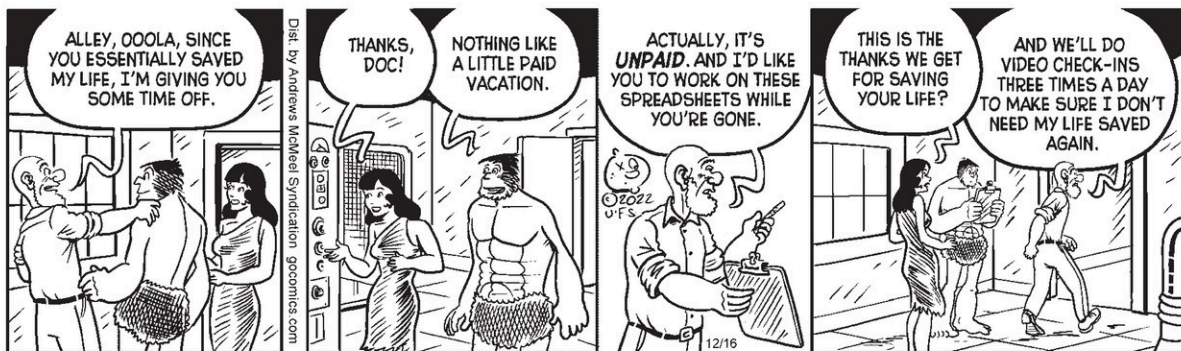

## My kingdom for a deuce

Shakespeare, in his play about Julius Caesar, used the line, "He shall not live; look, with a spot I damn him."

However, one quality that marks a bridge expert ahead of a less-capable player is the way in which he keeps careful track of the spot cards. Today's deal was declared by the late Richard Schwartz, a 13-time national champion. South's opening bid showed a balanced 20-22 points. North's four-diamond response was a Texas transfer to four hearts.

West cashed his two top clubs, East playing first the two, then the nine. Reading the latter play as a suit-preference signal, West switched to the spade king.

There were 10 easy tricks available, but as this deal was from a pair event, it was important to try to make an overtrick.

Schwartz won with the spade ace and cashed the heart ace. "Please play the four, partner."

Next, declarer cashed the diamond ace-king. Then he ruffed the diamond three with dummy's heart jack to ensure East couldn't overruff.

"Any heart but the two, please, partner."

Schwartz won with his king and led the diamond four.

"That's the card I want," replied Schwartz. He overtook the two with his three and cashed the diamond nine, on which he discarded dummy's spade loser. The overtrick had been collected for an excellent score on the board.

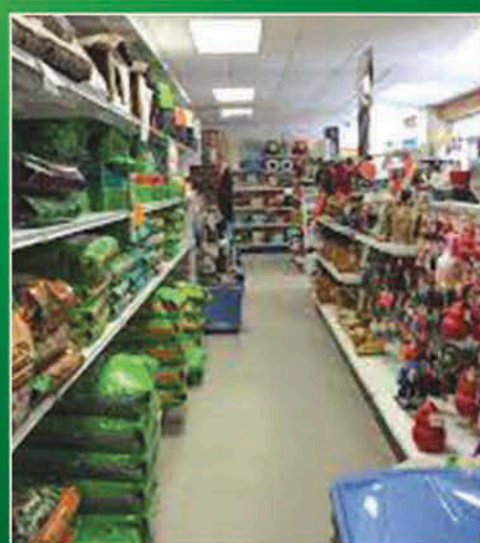
