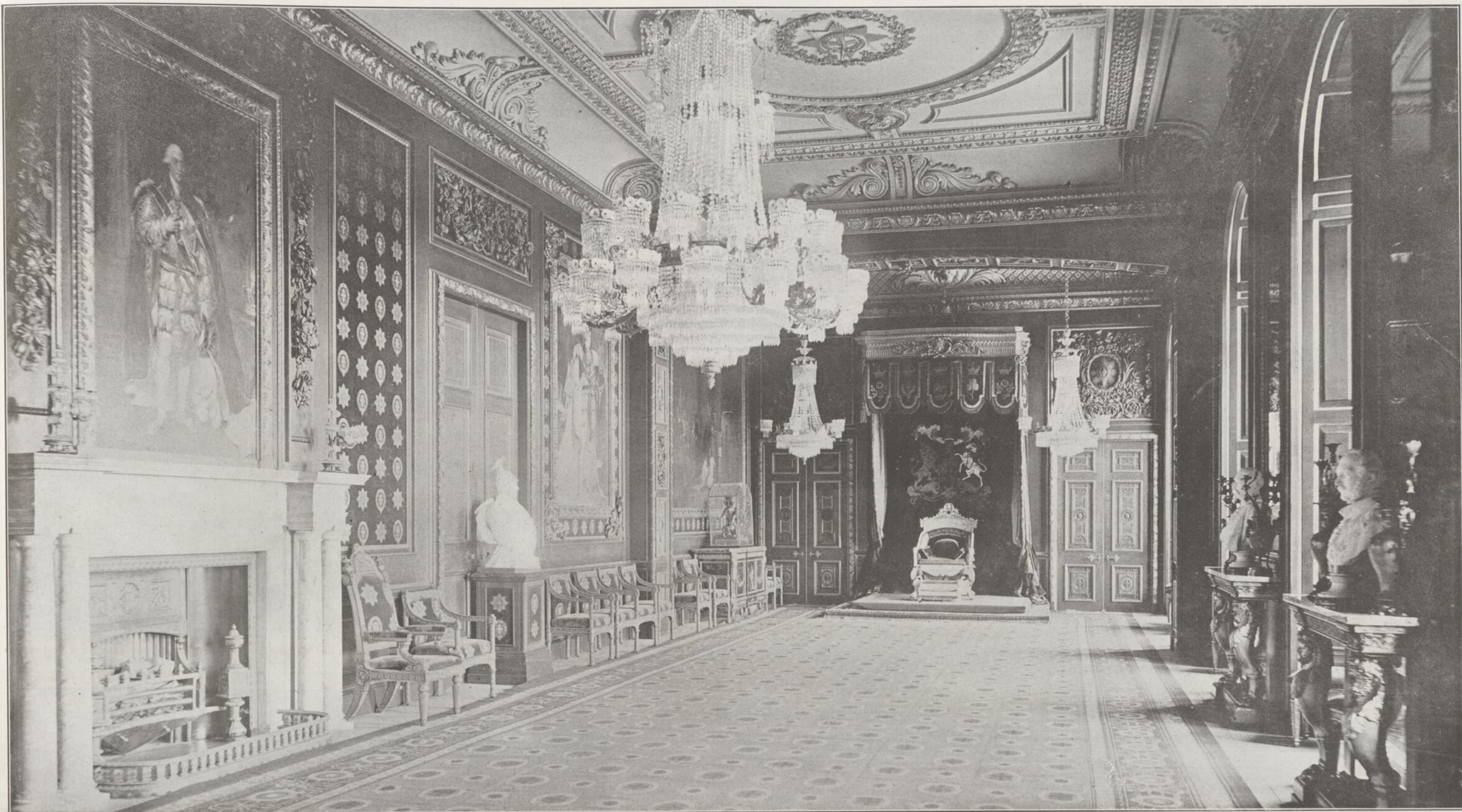


The Throne Room at Windsor Castle in Which His Majesty Held His Birthday Levee To-day

Montreal Cathedral in Which His Majesty Worshipped When Visiting This City in August, 1860



CHRIST CHURCH CATHEDRAL, MONTREAL, WHERE KING EDWARD WORSHIPPED ON SUNDAY, AUGUST 26, 1860—This edifice was completely renovated and re-decorated this year, and the above illustrations reveal the nature of the alterations. Reading from left to right, they show:—Top row: (1) The Nave, looking towards the Choir, showing the celestial organ, pulpit, lectern and the colors of the old 6th Fusiliers, of which Regiment (now the Prince of Wales Fusiliers) the King is Honorary Colonel. (2) The choir, showing the new marble floor and communion rail, the stalls, the Bishop's throne and altar. (3) The chancel front of the famous "Hill" organ (made in England in 1859). Bottom row: (1) Looking across the Choir into the North Transept, showing the pulpit, Bishop Oxenden's chair, and the font (presented to the old Cathedral in 1848). RUGBY FOOTBALL IN CANADA.

The illustrations on this page portray a number of interesting features connected with the big Rugby football match between the "Tigers," of Hamilton, and Montreal, on the grounds of the Montreal Amateur Athletic Association, on the afternoon of October 26 last. They will doubtless appeal strongly to lovers of this fascinating game, as they reveal, better than words can describe, the style of play practised by these teams. The photographs were taken at various periods in the play, and therefore give a comprehensive idea of the famous struggle which resulted in a victory for the Hamilton or "Tiger" team.

CHRIST CHURCH CATHEDRAL, MONTREAL.

This beautiful edifice (a number of interior views of which are featured on page 1 of this Supplement) is one of the purest in its proportions and general outlines of all the Gothic structures in America. It was designed by an English architect named Willis, who died, however, shortly before the foundations were completed. The work of supervising the construction of the walls and spire subsequently devolved upon Mr. Thomas Scott, architect of the Houses of Parliament at Ottawa, and he eventually saw the edifice through to completion. It was opened in 1859 by the late Bishop Fulford, first

Bishop of Montreal, and Metropolitan of Canada. Less than a year afterwards (or, to be exact, on the morning of Sunday, August 26th, 1860), the present King of Great Britain and Ireland attended divine service within its walls, occupying the first pew on the right of the passage-way in the nave. On that occasion the sermon was preached by Bishop Fulford from I. Corinthians ix. 25. The Prince (His Majesty was then Prince of Wales) afterwards gave a handsome Bible to the Cathedral as a memento of his visit, and this Book may yet be seen by anyone who enters the Chapter House where it is kept. Soon after the Ven. Archdeacon Norton assumed the rectorate of Montreal, the exterior of the cathedral was repointed and its interior was quietly but decently decorated. Some years later improvements were made to the "Hill" organ, and a "celestial organ" was installed in the tower. This year, the interior once again underwent a thorough transformation, and several permanent improvements (including a marble floor in the choir and sanctuary, a series of beautiful marble steps leading to the altar, and a marble communion rail) were placed in position. In 1909 the jubilee of the Cathedral will occur, and it is hoped that when this function takes place, a new redos of marble will adorn the east wall, and a new set of stalls will be found in the choir. These two improvements are badly needed to complete the beauty of the Cathedral interior.

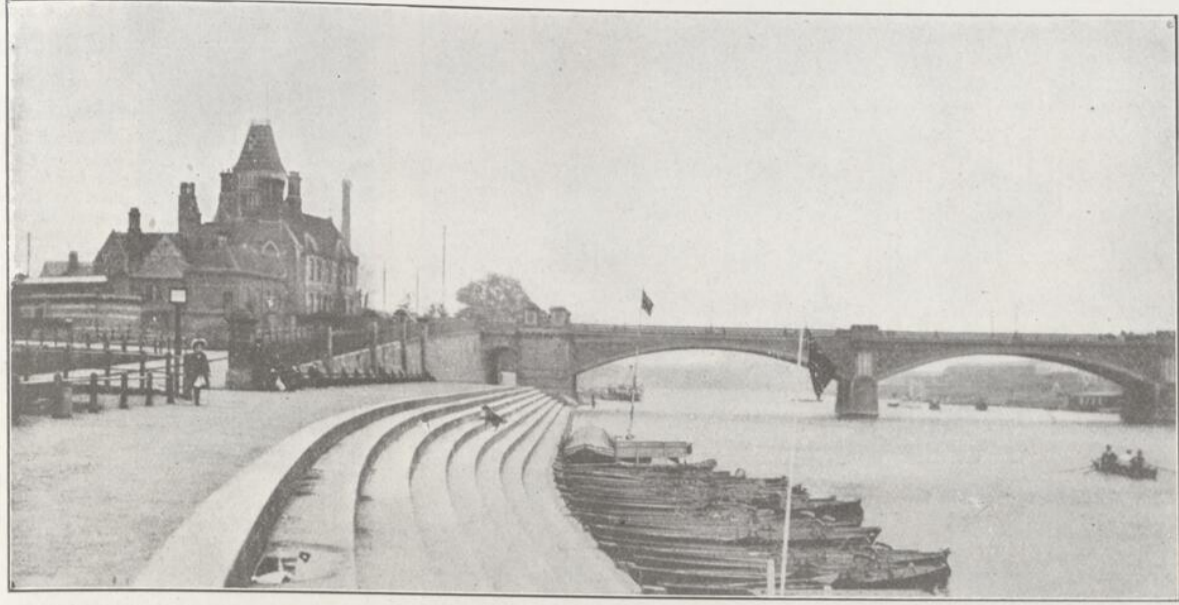

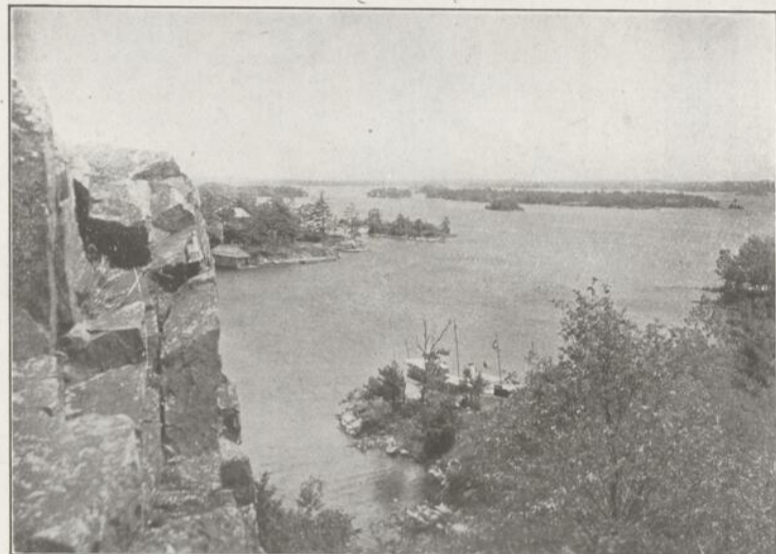

THE STRATHCONA MEMORIAL.

Since this splendid statue (an illustration of which appears on this page) was unveiled on May 24th last, it has been an object of increasing admiration on the part of not only the citizens of Montreal, but of the strangers who have entered the city's gates in the interim between then and now. Its fine location and its impressive dignity have appealed strongly to the artistic temperaments of thousands, and the life and vitality which the sculptor has succeeded in infusing into the horse and trooper has been the subject of many eulogistic references.

During the past summer the Alder-

men composing the Parks and Ferries Committee of the City Council decided to make the environment of the Memorial even more beautiful than it was, and with that object in view gave orders to Mr. Pinoteau, the city's chief gardener, to place at intervals around the mound huge tubs of hydrangeas, such as for years had been features of the floral decorations of Parc Lafontaine. The plants were placed in position when they had attained full bloom, and their appearance on the square evoked considerable enthusiasm.

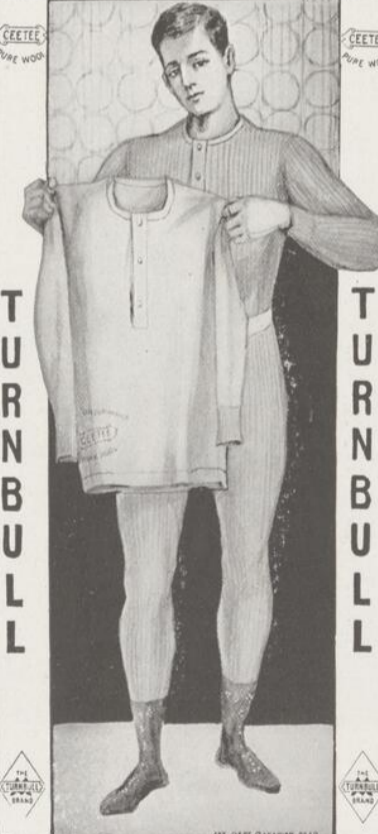

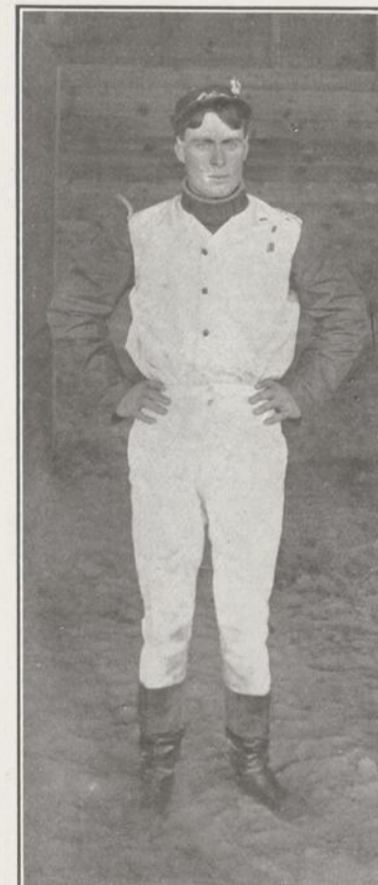

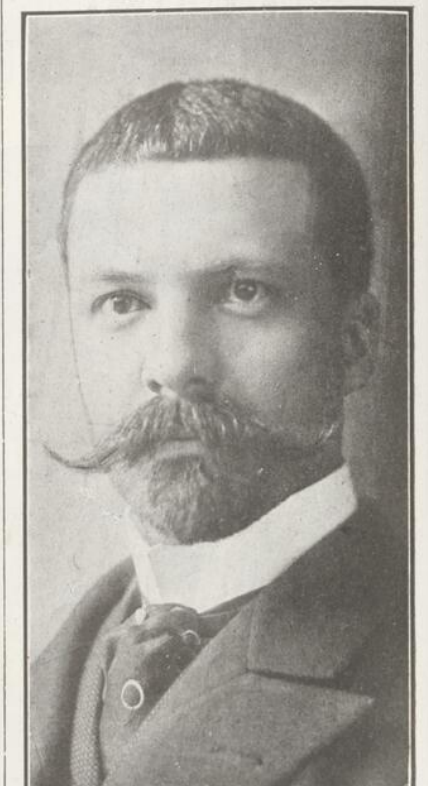
