Supreme Court of the Dominion and Court of Exchequer.

The Supreme Court, as a high Court of Appeal, constituted by Dominion Statute, 38 Vic., cap. 2, assented to 8th April, 1875, is composed of a Chief Justice and five Puisné

Judges, and has appellate civil and criminal jurisdiction within and throughout the Dominion of Canada. The Judges reside at Ottawa, where the Supreme Court holds annually two Sessions, beginning respectively on the third Monday in January and June. The Exchequer Court, presided over by the same Judges, possesses concurrent original jurisdiction in the Dominion in all cases in which it is sought to enforce any law relating to the revenue, and exclusive original jurisdiction in all cases in which demand is made or relief sought in respect of any matter which might in England, be the subject of a suit or action in the Court of Exchequer on its revenue side against the Crown, or any officer of the Crown.

In 1663 was founded the Quebec Seminary which afterwards became a regular College, and it had, by successive addition, acquired a high degree of importance, when it was ejected, by Her Majesty's Royal Charter, into a University, under the style and name of *The Laval University*. By this charter, which bears date December 8th, 1852, no change was effected in the constitution of the Seminary itself, but a council composed of the directors of the institution, and the three senior professors of the several faculties was empowered to possess and enjoy all the privileges granted to the Universities of the United Kingdom, and especially that of conferring degrees in the Faculties of Divinity, Law, Medicine and Arts. On the 15th May, 1876, His Holiness Pope Pius IX, gave to the Laval University, the Canonical erection. His Grace the Roman Catholic Archbishop of Quebec is, by virtue of his office, Visitor and Apostolic Chancellor of the University. The Superior of the Seminary, for the time being, holds the office of Rector.
