Pete Möss puts the professional into partying

Music is a dialogue between artist and listener, and Pete Möss have developed their own language.

"We live an alternative lifestyle," said Tim Brink, lead vocalist for Pete Möss. "We aren't 9 to 5 guys. We preach the rocker lifestyle of sex, drugs and rock and roll, and we live by it."

With the release of their new album, Brink and band mates Sly Tremblay (rhythm guitar), Jeff Doobie (bass), Martin Beauregard (drums), and Johnny Maximum (guitar) feel their language has found more consistency.

"We got to know each other better," said Doobie. "Life on the road, five guys crammed into a van for long road trips forces you to get to know the people you are with a little better, even if you didn't want to. With that, our sound has become more constant, tighter."

The hard rockers have been on the road pretty much since they released their first album back in 2006 entitled *Live Dirty*, rocking venues from Germany to Detroit, and as a result, tweaked their sound a little after working with likes of The Darkness, Simple plan, and CCR.

Adding to their already unique tongue was the input of well-known master sound technicians Nick Blagona (Deep Purple, Green Day, The Police), who was one of the judges that chose Pete Möss in CHOM radio station's Canadian rock band contest in

Sorry folks, hope you don't mind, but Maurice has been writing about everyone else for so long, that it's really high time for somebody to write about him for a change, don't you think?

A native of Waterloo, well known in the Townships area for years as a founding member of "Oliver Klaus." Along with his brother Bryan, he kept the band going through many different incarnations. In addition to having family obligations and his piano business to run, he still somehow manages to find the time to write new songs. As a piano technician, sound expert and musician himself, he can well understand the concerns of the many artists he presents and produces.

Furthermore, for over a year, he has been writing articles for the Record, producing the CIDI "Stop!" TV show for canal Vox, putting on numerous fundraisers and doing promotion and publicity to help resurrect the CIDI radio project which was just about defunct but is now "miraculously", and in large part due to his tireless efforts and dedication, finally hitting the airwaves as a test starting on November 5th, for real.

Most of these projects rely on help from volunteers. The musical productions usually involve John Cameron, a sound technician, and Julien Fortin, owner of SEM studio in Waterloo, who along with Maurice have a lot of experience between them and professional equipment, such as microphones and cables etc., which they often share with

each other.

Meanwhile, back at TVCW in Waterloo, Richard Morissette and Jean-Francois Labelle are only too happy to welcome Maurice's input and contributions and they also put their equipment (such as cameras) at his disposal, so he can continue producing TV shows.

Let's not forget to mention the hosts of the "Stop!" TV show: Richard Semelhaack, Bertand Cloutier and Julien Fortin who are always enthusiastic, informative and entertaining. We also have to give due credit to Eric Wabant for the website as well as Dave Anderson and David Chapman, photographers.

As far as CIDI is concerned, there are volunteer hosts and contributors, along with sponsors and supporters galore, many of whom have attended meetings, offered suggestions and financial support and participated on Brome Fair Weekend. They are almost too numerous to mention, but I shall try anyway, hope I don't forget anyone. Hosts Robert Beaulieu (Bob's your Uncle), Stuart Gilman (Gilman's Corner), his wife Mary Gilman and her sister Lucie, Brent Robillard (Ask the Pastor), Barbara Golden (Golden Barbs), Warren Woodworth (Let's talk Jazz), David McGovern, a student from Massey-Vanier who is entranced with the whole world of radio, Ralf Bushenbaum from Mansonville, playing an eclectic mix of his own favourites from his vast personal collection, Julie Taylor, a teacher, who loves to encourage her students and support community projects, Jim Ferrier, Pete Marrier and many others still waiting in the wings.

Montreal, and Matt DeMatteo (Mobile, Danko Jones), who collaborated on the new album, Sober on Strike: Episode 3.

"Working with these guys, these industry professionals has made us more skilled as musicians," Brink said. "Their influence has pushed us to become more than we even thought we could be."

"We were pushed to work as hard as we played, so much so that while recording Tim hit notes he didn't even know he could. We became professionals, I mean;



on the technical and management sides and "The Prez" of CIDI, Dewey Durrell, who is guilty of starting the whole radio thing, has been busy doing his part, painting the walls in the studio and the tower, publicity, putting up posters and whatever else it takes.

What on earth possesses all these people to do these things? I often wonder. I suppose they really believe in what they're doing and somehow gain satisfaction out of seeing a job well done, another show or project completed. A creative process, a contribution to the community.

This is why I call them "the collaborators". They willingly share their time, equipment and knowledge for a common goal and the common good, promoting local artists be it on VOX TV or the CIDI radio station, articles in the Record or ads promoting local businesses.

As our artists and musicians benefit from the exposure and experience, we are equally privileged to witness and enjoy the fruits of their labours.

Their success is our success, so let's support their endeavors however we can.

Don't forget that CIDI 99.1 FM has started a three-week schedule of testing for Industry Canada that will continue for the next two weeks. At the moment people are encouraged to listen to a constant stream of regional, national and world music, along with local advertisements and announcements, until the station officially begins broadcasting on November 5th.

Also, over the next four months the Stop! TV show, produced by CIDI, will

Professional party animals that is...Despite the hard work at honing their skills as musicians, Pete Möss remains true to their original sounds, integrating some classic 70s rock and blues rhythms into the new album.

Approaching the music industry in a very different way, with an improved sound, Sober on Strike: Episode 3 provides listeners with a full musical experience.

"Sober on Strike has eight songs on it. We felt that a lot of bands have a good crop of songs on their album, but to get the traditional 12 or so tunes, they fill it with songs that aren't the same quality as the rest," said Maximum. "So we'll give you the best tracks we recorded, and charge you only \$9.99 for it as a result."

On top of the new tracks, the CD will contain a video, a live, unplugged version of a track from the first album, and if you download the album from iTunes, you'll get a bonus track.

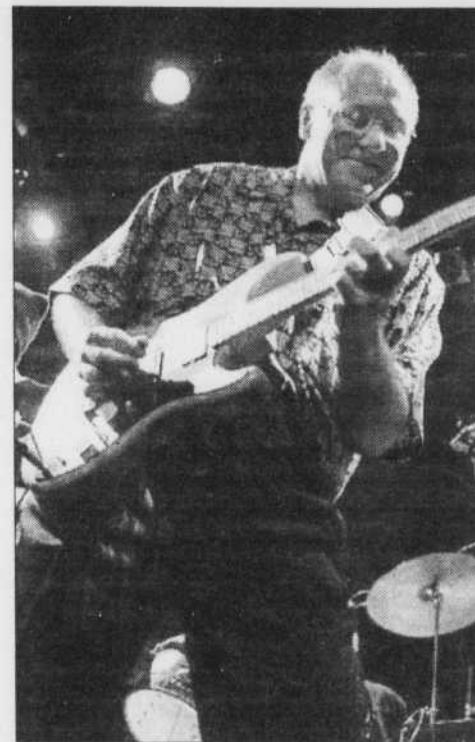
Brink said that Pete Möss wanted to give their fans exactly what they wanted. "The album has some of our original sounds, and some new ideas, like the track Sober on Strike, which appears three times, continuing from one track to the other."

When asked why they titled the album Sober on Strike: Episode 3, the simplistic and absurd answer is pure Pete Möss

"Well, the sober on strike is pretty simple...think about it, and the Episode 3 is a tribute to Star Wars. We plan to come out with Episodes 2 and 1, in reverse order, just like the movies."

Fans will be privy to Pete Möss' more solid, interesting and louder sound on October 21st when the band official launches Sober on Strike: Episode 3.

"Our music is like a rave, party 'til you drop," Doobie said.

The death of the local radio station

Last week I promised to wrap up the subject of Morse code, telegraph, Q codes, Blackberries and so called 'Texting', and relate them back to local broadcasting.

The common thread in all of this is the human desire to communicate. Times have changed; large families are not as common as they once were. Communities are not as tight knit as they used to be.

We once had a vital interest in our communities, the support of the various members of the community helped to ensure the survival of all. We used to know our neighbours and the bulk of what we consumed or produced came from within our community.

Locally produced radio provided a vital link in this chain of communication. Everyone tuned into their local station to keep up to date on what was going on in their region.

Local radio stations were gradually replaced by large commercial or public broadcasters that worked in a network. These stations usually provide a minimum of local content but they are shackled to their network affiliations and so they cannot fill the role of locally produced radio stations.

Local stations are becoming rare, as recently as in the 1980's there were close to one hundred independent sources of information today there are fewer than ten. This isn't a healthy trend as it could lead to the

public receiving information that has been approved by a select few, with other stories or subjects never making it to broadcast.

Another aspect is that hearing news from large metropolitan centres can give us a skewed vision of reality as it relates to our community.

Life in Toronto is not the same as living in the Townships. If we don't see ourselves reflected in the broadcasts that we listen to, how germane are these stations to our group image.

The party will start at 2p.m. and the tribute will be paid around 7p.m. It is the best time to thank those two musicians who keep on giving, year after year.

Knowlton Players will begin its 2008/2009 season October 23rd. The theatre group will be opening with a suspense thriller, 'I'll Be Back Before Midnight' a play by Canadian playwright Peter Colley. Given the fact that Louise Penny has made this corner of The Townships famous in her Detective Gamache suspense novels, it somehow seems fitting that Knowlton Players has added to the 'Cloak and Dagger' atmosphere that often accompanies this area in Autumn.

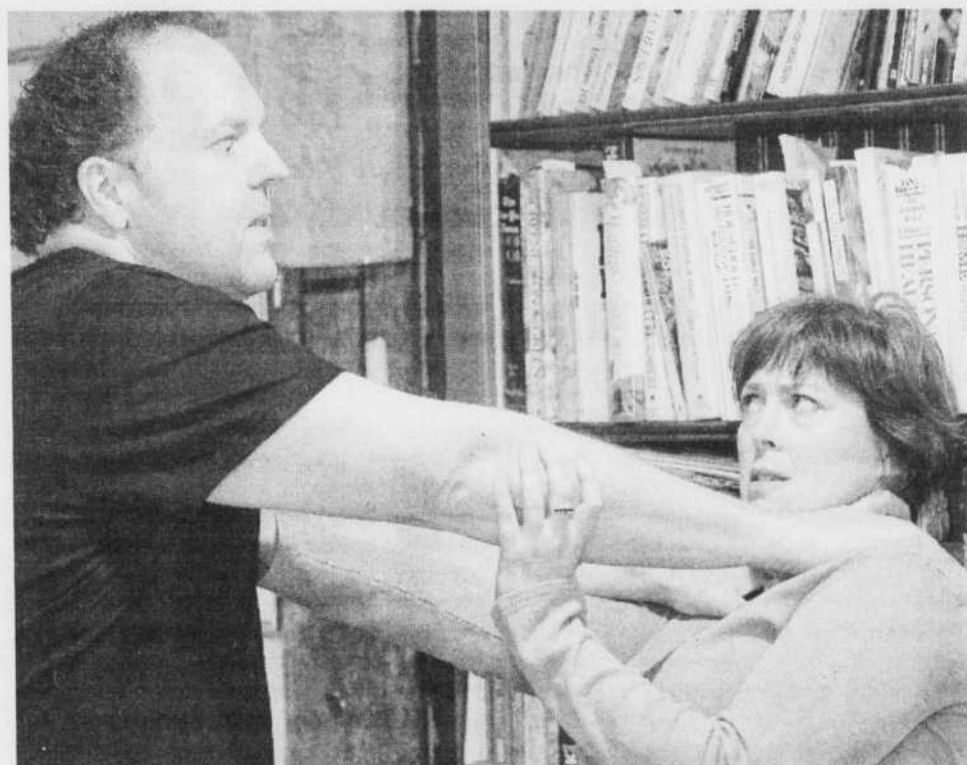
Colley's play has been produced in 48 of the 50 American States, in every province in Canada and has enjoyed production in 25 countries. Directed by Gerry Potterton of Knowlton Players, audiences will most assuredly be held riveted to their seats as they watch actors Danny McAuley and Darleen Bell, play Greg and Jan, a married couple that have rented an old farmhouse in the country, so that Jan may begin recovery from a recent 'breakdown'. They are soon joined by Laura, played by Michaela Barnes despite Jan's opposition to her joining them. Laura, Greg's sister adds an element of devious depth as Bob Hennessey playing the owner of the farmhouse, George, tells them about the murder that occurred in the house. Jan begins to hear noises in the house and that's when things really begin to cook. With plot twists and subtle clues, the play has all the ingredients needed to make an audience fall into the bloodthirsty action.

Gerald Potterton, director for this production stated, "I came on board as the director about 2 weeks ago. The play, an intricate little thing demands a great deal of orchestration and the suspense is created by the timing, the development of the plot." The play was originally planned to be directed by Vesta Jorgenson, however, because of unforeseen events, Jorgenson stepped down. Potterton known for his dedication to the theatre and film world was quick to say "Yes" when asked to take over the roll as director. Because of exorbitant fees to rent the theatre space in Knowlton, Knowlton Players, the mainstay of theatre in Knowlton are practicing in Potterton's kitchen. Mary Walsh, one of Canada's leading ladies, once said, "Just in order to put a show, we would take our own furniture, fridges, stoves, kids, what have you, onto the set, just so the show could go on." Seems Knowlton Players have the same sense of dedication.

Dan Whitham and his construction team have been busy the past few weeks constructing the elaborate sets in a warehouse in Cowansville, while Terry Millard, stage manager, who came down with the flu, just as Potterton took the reins, dragged himself to the rehearsals, so that the show will go on without a hitch. Potterton said, "We have been having a great deal of fun, and with all of this coming together in short order, the energy is high and the show promises to be a good one."

The show will run from October 23rd to November 2nd at Arts Knowlton Playhouse, 9 Mont Echo Road in Knowlton. Knowlton Players will be donating the proceeds from the sale of 100 tickets for the opening performance to The Pettes

Memorial Library in Knowlton. Those tickets are available at the library. Showtime's are 8:00pm Thursday, Friday, and Saturday and 2:00 pm on Sundays. For reservations please call 450.242.2510.

A first appearance for Pierre-Paul Savoie at Centennial Theatre

Former Sherbrooke resident, Luc Dunberry, dancer and choreographer in Germany creates work for fellow dancer

Choreographer Pierre-Paul Savoie, a pillar on the Quebec dance scene, will present his latest choreography *Confidences d'un corps* at Centennial Theatre on Tuesday, October 21 at 8 pm. As part of the Diasporama project, the program also includes a choreography by Luc Dunberry, a former music student at Cegep de Sherbrooke who has been living in Germany for the past ten years and now works as a dancer for one of Germany most illustrious dance companies, the Sasha Waltz Dance Company. Dunberry's creation entitled *Mi-un, ni d'eux* will be performed by Pierre-Paul Savoie and Marc Boivin.

Pierre-Paul Savoie will be the guest for the pre-show chat at 7:15 p.m. in the Centennial Theatre Lobby.

Pierre-Paul Savoie and Luc Dunberry were artists-in-residence at Centennial Theatre last April in order to put the final touches on Dunberry's work. A choreography embedded with German influences that Dunberry has gathered during his many years in Europe. For Savoie, the Diasporama Project was created in an effort to have other choreographers create works for him and to push his limits as an artist. He chose to collaborate with Quebec choreographers currently working abroad such as Andre Gingras, now living in the Netherlands, who created an astounding choreography for Savoie at the Canada Dance Festival this past June in Ottawa. Future projects include work with Linda Mancini, now residing in New York, and Mireille Leblanc, formerly part of Montreal dance company O Vertigo, currently based in Göteborg, Sweden.

Choreographer Pierre-Paul Savoie is well known in the dance milieu having held the position of President of the Regroupement de la danse du Québec for several years and for defending the in-

terests of the dance community with great dedication. In February 2008, he received the Hommage Award during the Bourse RIDEAU honoring his work as a choreographer and his involvement within the dance community. *Confidences d'un corps* constitutes a return to the past, the suffering, and the joys that have taken root within him to make him the man he is today: sensitive and genuine.

The images created through video for *Mi-un, ni d'eux* as well as the musical support for the choreography create a rich visual universe that leads the audience to a fantastical realm: the conver-

gence of the dancers' bodies echo the projected images through real time and space resulting in a stunning sensory experience.

Tickets are presently on sale. Subscriptions to the Danse Series are still available; 4 shows for \$90 among the remaining six performances. The Box Office is open from Monday to Friday between 8:30 am to 4 pm and also on the evening of a performance. 819-822-9692.

Greatest hits albums gaining in popularity

It really seems like there's a whole lot of 'Greatest Hits' packages coming out lately. It is most likely a way to stretch the lap of time between two albums as well as a way to keep the fans' attention.

In two short weeks, there's been Greatest Hits released by Craig Morgan, Big & Rich, Merle Haggard, The Wilkinsons, and Tim McGraw, just to name a few. These are perfect releases for long-time fans, who have liked the singles on the radio or on CMT but have never bought the albums. Likewise, it's the perfect introductory album for a new generation of fans. The musical essence of each of the artists is usually found in these packages. We'll take a look at a few of them.

After a few years spent with Broken Bow Records, Craig Morgan is moving to Sony BMG, a major Record company. As he is preparing his first release for his new label, his former label takes a look back at his career with Greatest Hits, a collection of Morgan's singles from his three albums with them.

Even if Craig Morgan is not a major record-seller, he has produced a solid body of work over the last five years. His Greatest Hits album may surprise many listeners of country radio. They might recognize many songs that they didn't realize were all by the same artist. The biggest hits found here are 'That's What I Love About Sunday' (Billboard's most-played country radio song of 2005, 'Redneck Yacht Club' and 'Little Bit of Life', and they represent perfectly Morgan's style as a country singer.

Some songs such as 'International

Harvester' and 'I Got You', were not big hits, but are still great to listen to.

Morgan's collection provides plenty of light romance and good-natured humor, but he also proves that he can dig deeper. There are a couple of heart-breaking ballads, among the best singles released by any artist in the past five years. 'Tough' is a tribute to a wife who is struggling with cancer while 'Every Friday Afternoon' is even more

powerful. The song is about a man, whose ex-wife is moving with their child so far away, that he won't be able to see him on the weekends.

Craig Morgan's Greatest Hits features two No.1 singles, six top 10 hits, along with four additional favourite songs co-written by Craig.

This is a good buy.

Tim McGraw has had a huge career of hits and accomplishments, including two greatest hits projects. If it seems that Tim McGraw's latest hits collection came pretty soon after his last one, you're not mistaken. It was only two and a half years ago, that Greatest Hits Vol. 2 was released, complete with four new tracks included with the twelve previously released hits.

Still, there's an exciting side to the release of this greatest hits package. It includes many hits that were overlooked on his previous collections. 'Unbroken' was a No.1 in early 2002 while 'Angry All the Time' was also a powerful number.

One of the most noteworthy additions is 'Can't Really Be Gone' which was also No.1 for McGraw in 1995. From the album, Live Like You Were Dying, there's 'Do You Want Fries With That

and 'Back When'.

The remainder of the album contains hits from McGraw's last album. The recent No.1 hit 'Last Dollar' and McGraw's huge song 'If You're Reading This' are there. His latest hit 'Let It Go' is also included for marketing purposes. Curb adds a bonus live track to one of McGraw's biggest hits 'Real Good Man', which was not only a big No.1 but has become an anthem among country fans as well.

In a statement issued by his publicist on October 14th, Tim McGraw said the new Greatest Hits was released despite his opinion. He has been working on a new album for more than a year now and has debuted three new songs on this year's Live Your Voice tour. The artist was planning to release an album of new material this fall.

'I am saddened and disappointed that my label chose to put out another hits album instead of new music', McGraw said. 'I've only had one studio album since my last hits package. It has to be just as confusing to the fans as it is to me. I had no involvement in the creation or presentation of this record. Sure, I love the songs, and I don't want to take anything away from all the creative people who were a part of making those records. But the whole concept is an embarrassment to me as an artist.'

It's not the first time that Tim McGraw doesn't agree with Curb Records. In 2000, McGraw wanted to release an album of new material, but the label instead released his first greatest hits album, just in time for the holiday, when people needed to buy gifts.

It seems like anything by Merle Haggard released on the market becomes a seller. No wonder, he's one of the best recording country artists ever. Many of the fans favourite have been recorded many years ago, so when the record company decides to re-record some of his songs in order to improve the quality of the sound, it works.

Most of Merle Haggard's biggest hits for Capitol Records, classics like 'Mama Tried', 'Branded Man', 'The Bottle Let Me Down', 'The Fightin' Side of Me', 'Okie from Muskogee', 'Mama's Hungry Eyes', and 'I'm a Lonesome Fugitive', are on the first hits volume. But there are still plenty of Haggard gems left for this '20 Hits Volume Two', including the brilliant 'Today I Started Loving You Again', the witty 'The Roots of My Raising', and the sad and poignant 'Things Aren't Funny Anymore.'

The versions of the songs included here are actually re-recordings which make for better sound. Merle Haggard is the real deal, both as a singer and as a songwriter. The collection includes twenty of our all time favourites. What a great buy.

Centre Lac-Brome knows it won't be easy to show cheap movies, especially in English, but hope that an alternative to travelling to Cowansville to see a film will bring people through the doors.

There's always been something special about going to the movies. It may be the salty popcorn or the big chairs or just the idea of sitting in front of a big screen for a short escape from our everyday lives. Luckily it doesn't always mean a drive to Cowansville or beyond to catch the stars on the silver screen. Centre Lac Brome has started offering family movies once a month in both French and English. With the new stadium seating, the experience is similar to being in the big theatre. And they even have popcorn!

But running one of these pre-video released movies doesn't come cheap. "We need to have 100 people come in order to break even," says Johanne Morin, "Last month we had 60."

With the idea of being able to offer the greatest number of people the opportunity to see the movies, starting this month they will be showing at 5:15 p.m. in French and 7:15 p.m. in English on Friday, October 24th for only five dollars per person. The offering this month is Kung Fu Panda; Dreamworks' latest

release about a lazy panda who becomes "the chosen one." Kids and adults will enjoy this one.

The Centre Lac Brome has more ideas in mind for the film series come next summer if the Friday nights do well. Says Morin, "We would love to start an outdoor movie series in the park, featuring films for grown-ups and maybe mix in some classics as well."

The challenge with a movie series in this area is getting people to attend. Theatre Lac Brome tried a Sunday evening cinema series for more than a year offering a broad range of films including documentaries, musicals and award-winning dramas. Attendance simply didn't merit continuing the series.

Despite its small-town status, Knowlton has a long history of showing movies. The first movie theatre opened on Knowlton road beside Ecole St. Edouard in the early 50's. Mike Pile was just 9 years old when he started going with his brother. "Back then going to the movies was quite an experience. We used to walk 5 miles from our farm in West Bolton on Saturday afternoons to catch the double feature." He says with a laugh. "Then when the movies ended at 11 p.m., we'd walk back."

"We came here in 1949 from Amsterdam. Imagine taking city kids and putting them in the country. Having the movie theatre was great."

Pile remembers seeing Cowboy movies with Gene Autrey and Hopalong Cassidy and of course movies like Stagecoach and Beau Geste. "There were always full crowds and popcorn," says Pile. "But don't forget we didn't have TV back then."

Unfortunately the theatre closed in the late 50's and people had to go to Cowansville to see the stars.

Pile would love to see the movies offered at the community centre succeed, giving families the opportunity to see movies on the big screen close to home. "It takes some time for people to realize movies are here. But I'm sure it'll do well."

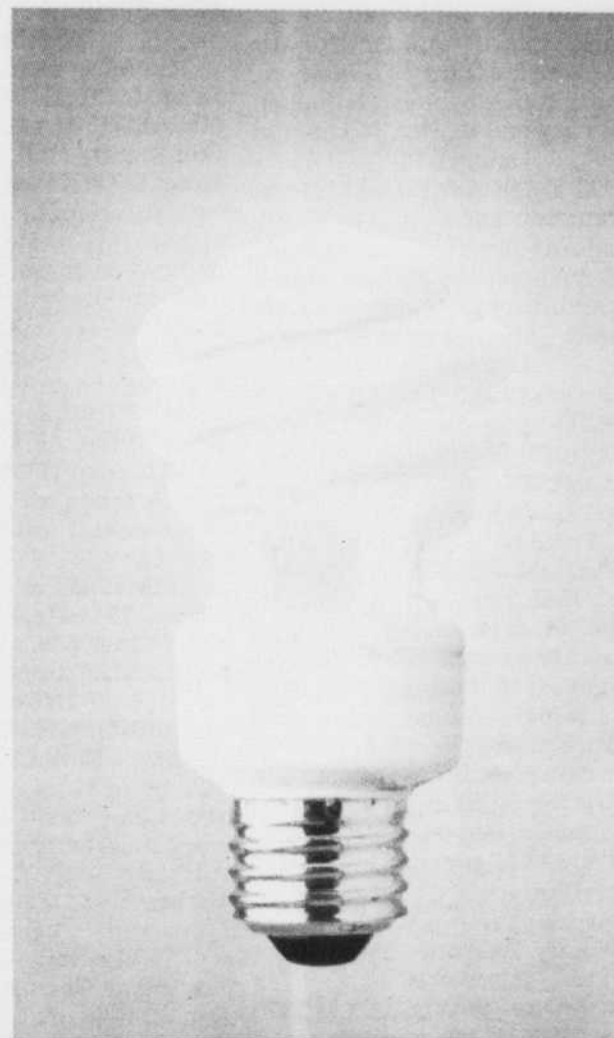
