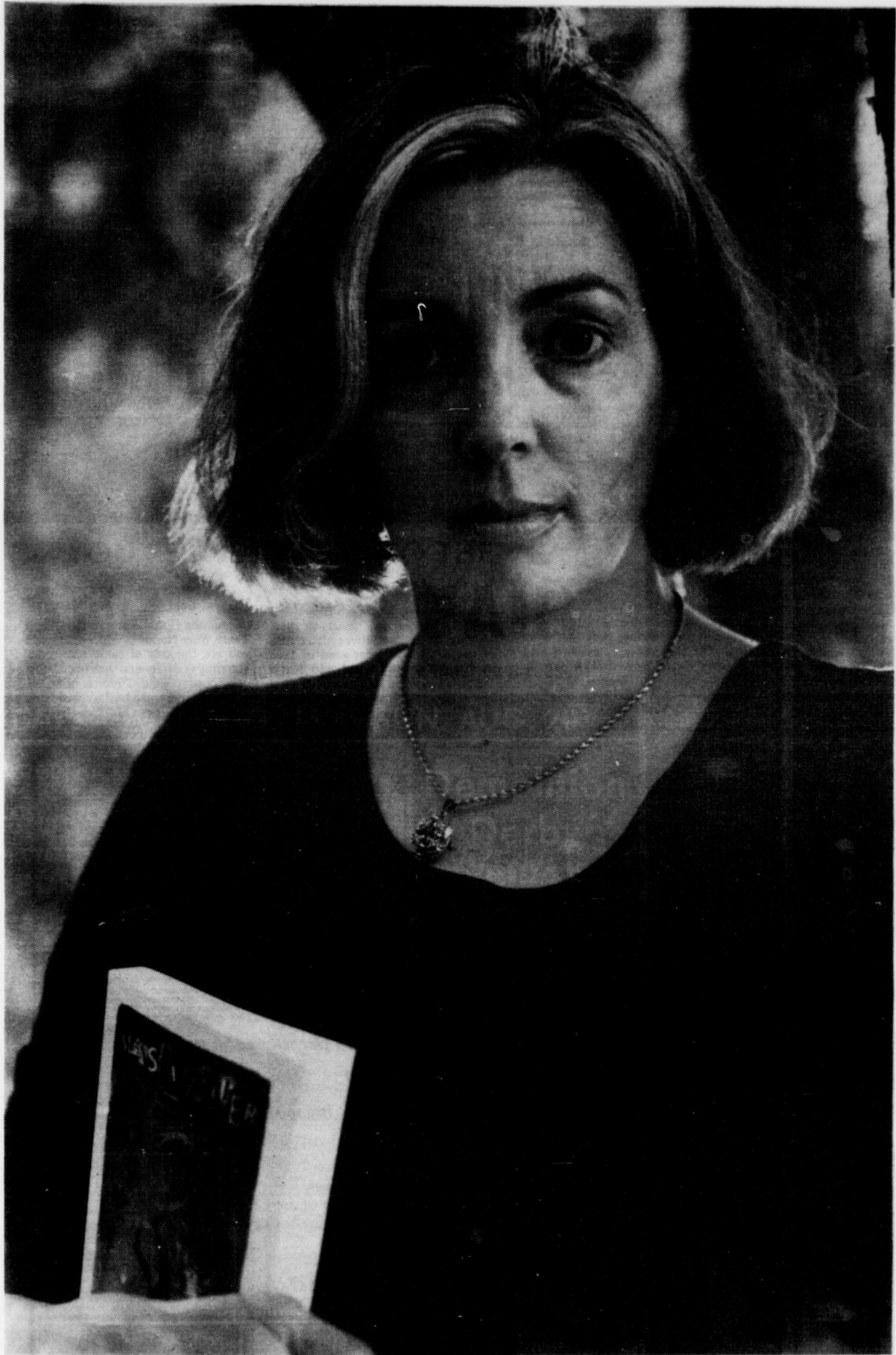

Statistics are out proving crime across Canada is down for the third year in a row and violent crime the lowest in a quarter century.

Trying to kill God: *Amadeus* at Stratford

STRATFORD, ONT. — Peter Shaffer's *Amadeus* opened at Stratford last Saturday to something more than a conventional standing ovation — a first night custom here, I think.

While there is always a sense of occasion at a Stratford opening, this evening seemed destined to be special: a fine company, an interesting play, the presence of its "superstar" playwright Shaffer, *mise en scène* by the Festival's Artistic Director Richard Monette, costumes and decor by one of the world's finest practising designers Desmond Heeley. Consequently, with every right to expect a good production, the audience responded in kind.

The rapturous applause, however, was a tribute not to the coalescence of these various elements in a transcendent theatrical experience but very simply to the production's starring actor, Brian Bedford.

If you didn't see the film, or even if you did, here's the story: court composer Antonio Salieri, now old, decrepit, and obviously a few bars short of a tune, insists that he murdered Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart some 30 years before.

SLIGHTLY MAD

He is, in common parlance, just slightly mad. The reason? As a young man, Salieri made a deal with God, dedicating himself to the Almighty in exchange for the chance to reflect His

glory through music. He is accordingly blessed with some talent and in turn lives a life of moral rectitude.

His world comes apart, however, when he is introduced to Mozart, an "obscure child" in whose music Salieri hears the voice of God Himself. By contrast, his own work is plodding, dull, mediocre. To make matters worse, the excrementally-obsessed and foul-mouthed Mozart manages to seduce Salieri's young protégé. Consumed by wounded pride and envy, Salieri begins a descent into evil, becoming the avowed enemy of God and resolving to destroy his manifestation, Mozart.

To tell his story and prove his own guilt, Salieri invokes us, his audience, into existence. Obliging, we are illuminated, acknowledged, and, in the process, made accessory to the act. Exposed as we are by the auditorium lighting, Salieri speaks directly to us, cajoling, persuading, amusing. And in so doing, he becomes one in a long line of Machiavellian villain-heroes — Iago, Richard III, Barbabas, Vindice — the direct address establishing a link between character and audience. We are allowed into the plotting: we become accomplices perhaps — and to this end, Salieri, pronouncing himself the "patron

saint of mediocrities", blesses and absolves us.

DOUBLE REALITY

Conjuring up for us the sequence of events that leads to the catastrophe, Salieri becomes both director and performer in the unfolding action. For an actor like Bedford, the possibilities inherent in playing such a double reality are manifest, and they do not go unexploited. In a real *coup de théâtre*, Bedford transforms himself from an ancient relic to a young man of 31 in a flash.

And as he takes us into his confidence, outlining his plans

and explaining his motives, he never releases his captive audience. Indeed, from the incoherent shouting of his introduction to the savage benediction of his farewell, he never leaves the stage. His performance is spellbinding, mercurial, almost improvisational in its response to the audience.

This is not, of course, a one-man show. Stephen Ouimette is happily cast as Mozart, managing to make this bizarre, pathetic genius credible and likeable. Megan Follows as Mozart's wife brings dignity to an undignified part, without losing the necessary sense of fun. She is perhaps a trifle soft-voiced. Robert Haley as Joseph II, Emperor of Austria, seems just right.

ELEGANT SET

Desmond Heeley's elegant setting of glass and metal is simplicity itself. A squared platform overlays the familiar octagonal thrust of the Festival stage, still visible to us. By the flickering light of chandeliers, props and furniture are swiftly and unobtrusively substituted to mark the occasional change of locale. Panels pivot, gently reflecting each other, or revealing the masked figures who appear noiselessly to execute the changes or to become a ghostly audience to the action. Through it all, Bedford is picked out by Michael Whitfield's lighting as a three-dimensional entity in a less substantial world.

With theatre at this level, and it is a very high level indeed, one is entitled to take critical notice of less than perfect moments. Perhaps it's a flaw in the play, perhaps merely some prosaic interpretation, but the scene of Mozart's destitution seems awkwardly staged. Heeley's unit set with its shimmering elegance works for all the scenes except this. The

poverty-stricken Mozart, shivering under a blanket with cheap wine for company, feverishly composes his *Requiem* perched like one of the homeless on the edge of this glittering world. Perched, not figuratively, but literally — on about 12 inches of platform. The visitation of Salieri as the masked messenger requires Bedford, narrating as he goes, to walk along the pit (the "dark alley") climb the stage left steps (the "dark stairway") and cross to Mozart on his dimly lit platform edge (the "dark room").

In a similar vein, if Mozart is not God's only begotten son, he certainly is, in Salieri's eyes, a singularly revolting incarnation. Lest we miss the point, director Monette has him expire in his wife's arms — an iconic image of the *pietà*. As he dies we are given Mozart's *Requiem*. As the climax of the internal play, this scene missed its expected transcendence — the muted strains of the music being kept under Follows' rather quiet voice. Apparently, the sound cue (both the selection and playback level) was debated up to the last, all the dithering finally producing the wrong choice. A bolder treatment might have crushed the hint of melodrama.

The unfortunate sense of bathos here is not helped by the twitching arm of the dying Mozart, presumably conducting until death takes him — the moment being clearly indicated by the fact that, ah, yes! his arm has stopped twitching. We didn't need sentimentality here, we needed power. This is, after all, the point where Salieri kills God?

Windsor native Ellen Frith draws on roots, dreams

New author's heroine is a likeable killer

SHERBROOKE — On January 2, 1988, Ellen Frith sat down at her typewriter and began writing the novel she knew was in her.

"I wrote one paragraph and daydreamed for half an hour about being on Peter Gzowski," said the author of the recently-published *Man-s-laughter* with a laugh.

Frith, a native of Windsor, has always been a dreamer. Those dreams, and her innate wanderlust, have served her well and paved the way for a rich and rewarding life.

Since leaving Windsor at 17, she has worked as a journalist and freelance writer in British Columbia and Wales; she has lived in Australia, Pakistan, Kenya and Nigeria, and she even worked on a farm in Tasmania.

While back in the Townships from her home in Cape Breton this week to see her family, Frith decided to do some promotion for her first novel. She'll be signing copies at W.H. Smith at the Carrefour de l'Estrie in Sherbrooke this weekend.

"My editor thinks the book will sell because he said, 'It's funny. The author is a middle-aged woman and in it, men die,'" Frith said during a stopover at the *Record* this week.

It seems women in their 40s with a sense of humor and homicidal tendencies are quite marketable.

They also make for intriguing reading. *Man-s-laughter* (one man's slaughter is another man's laughter?) tells the tale of Raymonde Susan Bailey, whose husbands keep falling to their deaths. While it is clear she is responsible for the murders, the novel explores the events and situations that would lead a woman like Bailey to such extreme behavior.

RELATIONSHIPS

Thus, it is not the murders, but the relationships between the characters that is the most important element in the novel, which follows Raymonde from her beginnings in fictional Shannon Falls, Quebec, to her incarceration in a Welsh prison.

Universal themes of abandonment and revenge are explored in the novel as Raymonde keeps falling for the wrong man.

"A lot of women feel abandoned by the very fact of being female," Frith said. "We're abandoned by our parents in a lot of ways because we're women. I think the reason women look for rescuers is the fact that they feel abandoned. A female child is loved and nourished by a female mother, but who nurtures her after

that? She has to turn into the nurturer."

Frith said Raymonde is not based on herself. "I've been married twice, but none of them are dead," she assured.

She did, however, draw on many of her own experiences in creating the heroine.

Besides having warm personalities and a quirky sense of humor, both Frith and Raymonde were born to a French-Canadian mother and British father in a small town, have had multiple husbands, three children and are world-travelled.

"The best way to lie is to keep it as close to the truth as possible," said Frith, who currently lives with husband Jerry and her youngest son Alec, 14, in Cape Breton.

Though Shannon Falls, the fictional town Raymonde grew up in, was placed geographically as Windsor, it is not a mirror image.

"I wanted to depict the universality of a small industrial town," said Frith.

PAPER MILL

Like most of the residents of Windsor, (It used to be known as Windsor Mills) Frith's life was pervaded by the old pulp and paper mill where her father worked. "Santa Claus came to visit at Christmas, I learned to write on the back of the Capaco newsletter."

Hanging around the mill as a child helped her immensely as an adult when she wrote the history of the B.C. mill town, Port Mellon, published two years ago.

Writing was in Frith's blood to some degree. Her father, Alec Booth, published a history of Richmond County many moons ago.

Frith said her parents instilled a great love of books in her.

"I grew up in a house surrounded by books," she said. "They were everywhere, from the floor to the ceiling, in every living room."

The idea for Frith's novel first surfaced in the late 80s during a six-month stint as a newspaper feature writer in North Wales.

"I interviewed a poet and novelist, Tudor Wynn Jones. He said, 'Do you have a novel in you?' and I said... 'Yeah'. All I had was the image of a woman with her hands in her pocket walking up a hill and she falls and doesn't have the energy to get up."

With this image, a key passage in *Man-s-laughter*, Frith began the seven-year learning process of writing her novel and getting it published by Oolichan Books.

Frith can hardly believe hers was chosen from among the more than 1,000 manuscripts her publisher receives every

year.

"After 45 years, this is what I was ready for," she said. "I couldn't have done it at 20 or 30."

What she did do at 20 could make a novel in itself.

LOVE OF TRAVELLING

As an art school student in Montreal, Frith met her first husband, Gordon Russell, a man in his 30s who worked in advertising. They shared a love of travelling and found themselves in London, England, in 1969.

"We were real hippy dippys," said Frith, only 19 at that time.

They had decided it was too cold to stay there much longer when fate stepped in.

"We saw an ad in a paper for a General Manager of an advertising firm in Karachi, Pakistan. We said 'Why not?'

and three weeks later, we had the job."

Frith's time in Pakistan was brief (when the civil war began her husband was transferred to East Africa) but she said it was indescribable.

"We had seven servants and membership in all the social clubs. We dined with ambassadors," she fondly remembered. "It was like participating in a movie. In 1969 it was the last gasp of the British Raj in Karachi. It was almost like being propelled back into history. After the civil war, things changed drastically.

Frith said in her travels she found that people are basically the same everywhere.

"The cultural differences are very slight," she said. "I feel that you can find kindred spi-

rits all around the world, in Africa, India, or Asia, just as likely as you'd find it in your backyard."

Frith is a woman who savors every experience she has, from time spent living in Wales to driving through Maine when visiting the Townships.

"Perception is what makes places wonderful. My father used to tell me he didn't have to travel to jungles around the world, all he needed was a magnifying glass and one square inch of back yard. It's true. We've lost the ability to perceive the magic around us."

Newman is *Nobody's Fool* in Oscar-nominated performance

Characters like "Sully" don't come along many times in an actor's life.

And Paul Newman makes the most of the curmudgeonly, over-the-hill construction worker who gets by on his lived-in good looks and crusty charm in Robert Benton's gentle comedy *Nobody's Fool* (Paramount).

Newman garnered an Academy Award nomination for his performance and won best acting honors from both the New York Film Critics Circle and the National Society of Film Critics.

Not much happens in Sully's hometown of North Bath, N.Y., until one Thanksgiving when his estranged son (Dylan Walsh) and family show up.

The scene where Newman and Walsh have their first bonding experience while trying to steal a snowblower is hilarious.

"Here I am finally with my dad — together at last — quality time, right? And what are we doing? Breaking and entering," Walsh says while scaling a chain-link fence.

Rounding out the rest of North Bath's quirky townspeople is the late Jessica Tandy as Sully's maternal landlady who thinks of him as more of a son than her own flesh and blood.

Also good is Bruce Willis as Sully's mean-spirited boss who refuses to compensate him for a knee injury.

Melanie Griffith, meanwhile, plays Willis's neglected wife who flirts with Sully every chance she gets.

"Maybe we should go out and buy .357 magnums and rob banks just like Bonnie and Clyde," she offers.

"You'll have to be Clyde," he responds with a sigh. "I'm too tired."

Outbreak (Warner) — Given the recent Ebola virus

scare, this medical thriller starring Dustin Hoffman as a renegade army doctor couldn't be more timely.

The film opens in Zaire 1967 as a Level Four virus (no known cure or vaccine) decimates a small village, causing the army to use a bomb to wipe out the deadly illness and the occupants carrying it.

Years later the virus appears again and is transported to the United States via a smuggled monkey.

Video View

Pretty soon the residents of a small California town are coughing, sneezing and dropping like flies. That's when Hoffman — against the orders of his superior (Morgan Freeman) and Freeman's superior (Canadian Donald Sutherland) — show up to help the medical team trying to find an antiviral serum.

Their race against time — and the army which wants to drop a bomb again — will keep you on the edge of your seat although it's sometimes hard to swallow Hoffman as an action hero.

Particularly when he and his young sidekick (Cuba Gooding Jr.) commandeer an army helicopter to search for the monkey which has been freed into the forest.

The side plot involving Hoffman and his estranged wife (Rene Russo), a fellow doctor, is also distracting.

Female road movies are still an emerging genre.

But with such enjoyable predecessors as the revenge-seeking outlaws featured in *Thelma and Louise* and the female-bonding antics of *Boys on the Side*, *Camilla* (Malofilm) has a lot to recommend it.

The Canadian-British co-production directed by Deepa Metha is a kinder, gentler road movie with Bridget Fonda and Jessica Tandy in the starring roles.

Fonda plays Freda, an unhappily married aspiring singer-composer vacationing with her husband (Exotica's Elias Koteas) in Peabo Island, Ga., when she meets the flamboyant Camilla (Tandy), a beautiful, 80-year-old violinist who lives with her soft-core pornographer son (Whale Music's Maury Chaykin).

When the two men take off to start a business together, the women decide to return to Toronto's Wintergarden theatre — supposedly the scene of Camilla's greatest concert.

The three-day trip is full of twists and turns, including the disappearance of Freda's Volkswagen, being robbed by a

con man (Graham Greene) and meeting the love of Camilla's life (played by Tandy's real-life Canadian-born husband Hume Cronyn) in Niagara Falls.

Although the movie is disjointed at times, Tandy — in her last starring role — succeeds in holding Camilla together.

There's also some impressive Canadian talent involved, including a script by Paul Quarrington (author of *Whale Music*) and music by Daniel Lanois (producer for U2, Peter Gabriel, Brian Eno).

Zooman (Malofilm): A family and a New York neighborhood find themselves at odds after a 12-year-old girl is shot to death, the result of random street violence.

When fearful neighbors refuse to tell the police anything, the dead girl's father (Lou Gos-

set Jr.) posts a sign on his window trying to shame them into coming forward.

Directed by Leon Ichaso (Sugar Hill), this film approaches its subject matter with a slightly different approach. *Zooman* is more like an ensemble play than a movie, giving the viewer the sense of being a voyeur as the family tries to work through its emotions.

Convincingly played by Khalil Kain, *Zooman* starts off a young tough ("I got up this morning and felt like killing somebody. So what?"), but gradually cracks under the pressure.

Also new on video: **Man of the House (Walt Disney)** — Jonathan Taylor Thomas of TV's *Home Improvement* tests out his mother's new boyfriend (Chevy Chase) at a camp for fathers and sons. Farrah Fawcett is mom.

Gentle charm graces Papa's stories

Papa Beaver's Storytime Nickelodeon, weekdays

Based on a series of tales by the French children's author Pere Castor, this animated, half-hour series offers a gentle, sometimes amusing block of stories aimed at preschoolers. During each episode, three little beavers gather around their grandfather to hear him tell stories from around the world.

Although animal characters seem to be largely featured, humans do crop up from time to time. In one story, a little girl wakes up in a bad mood, so all her animals try to cheer her up; a bird tells her she got off on the wrong foot, so the girl tries to literally start over on the "right" foot.

Lauren, 5, had a moderately enthusiastic response, saying that parts of it were nice and funny. She liked the little beavers but was hard pressed to come up with any other commentary.

Still, the stories are brief, simple, and rather sweet overall; they might be just the thing to interest your preschooler in storytelling.

Ratings Scale: 1-10
(10 is the highest)

Appropriateness: 7 — For kids 4 to 6 who enjoy watching the same characters tie everything together, and who can sit still long enough to watch the tales.

Humor: 6 — Some of the stories certainly have an understated humor — it's not really ha-ha funny.

Visuals: 6 — Soft pastel animation.
Social Value: 7 — Well-intentioned. And it's nice to discover a largely unknown author.

Believability: 7 — Kids may well relate to the paternal beaver; the stories themselves, of course, vary in appeal.

Fun Factor: 6 — Sometimes the show feels a little draggy; other times, it's a lulling and pleasant experience.

My Summer Story

"My Summer Story" tries very hard to be one of those small, charming coming-of-age movies that purport to show how a certain experience (usually taking place during the summer, or a balmy time of year) shaped the life of an adolescent. The problem with this movie, a sequel to the very popular "A Christmas Story," is that its plot isn't interesting enough to carry the whole movie, and it isn't charming or insightful enough to add much that's new to this genre.

Ralphie (Kieran Culkin), our hero on the brink of adulthood (or, at least, teen-agerhood), spends a summer

pondering the meaning of life as it relates to the search for the perfect spinning top, fishing trips with dad that always seem to end in embarrassment and life with his slightly offbeat parents (played by Charles Grodin and Mary Steenburgen).

You really want to like the movie; you keep waiting for that moment that will grab your heart or stir some childhood memory, but somehow, although you often come close, you're just never fully pulled in.

And yet, two unrelated and unbiased young viewers both loved the movie. "I love this movie so much," exclaimed Aliza, 10. "I must have watched it 10 times."

"It's funny and I could relate to it," agreed Stephanie, 12. Both she and Aliza cited a scene where Ralphie's

little brother is allowed to "fish" in their tank, but then wants to eat his catch, as one of their favorites.

Although adults might find it bland, the movie does seem to tap a responsive chord in kids. As Stephanie summed up, when asked if she would change anything: "Nothing. It was as good as it could get."

Red Green bumbles to TV stardom

HAMILTON (CP) — These days, Steve Smith looks like a man waiting for the other shoe to drop.

But the way things are going for him, the only place it's likely to land is in the wet cement outside some Hollywood theatre where the stars are invited to leave their footprints.

Smith has a book out, he has one of the hottest properties in TV syndication and the fan club for his *Red Green Show* seems to double every few months — it now boasts almost 40,000 members across the continent. The show gets 1,000 fan letters a week.

"The success of the show was the furthest thing from our minds when we started," says Smith, in the midst of shooting episodes for the coming season, the show's fifth, at the CHCH-TV studio in Hamilton.

After all, Red Green is, by Smith's own admission, the quintessential male bore.

He will talk with ludicrous authority on any subject, but especially if it has to do with being handy (which he's not), the outdoors, duct tape and life at Possum Lodge, which is a kind of ragtag, backwater fraternity of lovable bumbles, bluffers and tinkerers.

The Possum Lodge's motto? When All Else Fails, Play Dead.

Red Green's Handyman's

Corner is probably the most popular segment of the show. Red once tried to build a kid's ride out of one of those rotating circular clothes lines. You get the picture.

"How can you not love him," says one fan. "It's a celebration of male incompetence," doggedly posturing under the illusion that everything is firmly under control. Sound familiar? Everyone knows a guy just like Red Green.

The show started as a series for CHCH in 1990, a low-budget staple that would keep Smith's company afloat while he prepared pilots for more ambitious projects.

The Red Green Show was such a hit locally the pilots never got made.

Just the same, CHCH dropped the show after a short run. The cancellation caused near riots. High schools sent in petitions. Some took out a billboard — "Forget the Whales, Save Red Green."

But the cancellation was probably the best thing that could have happened to the show. Smith got a New York representative to shop the show around in the United States.

By the fall of '93 *The Red Green Show* was showing in five U.S. markets. Now it is being carried on over 60 stations.

It has also been sold in Trinidad and Tobago, the Pacific

Rim and Turkey.

In Canada, *The Red Green Show* is carried on Global. Last year there was a barter deal in which Smith bought the airtime from Global in Ontario and sold the ad time himself, using the money to meet production costs.

This year CanWest-Global is paying a licence fee to air the show across the country, says Dave Smith, business manager for S and S Production Inc.

All this, from a defiantly ordinary character Smith created in 1980 and trotted out on his various CHCH comedy shows — *Smith and Smith*, *The Comedy Mill*, and so on.

Red Green has achieved cult hero status.

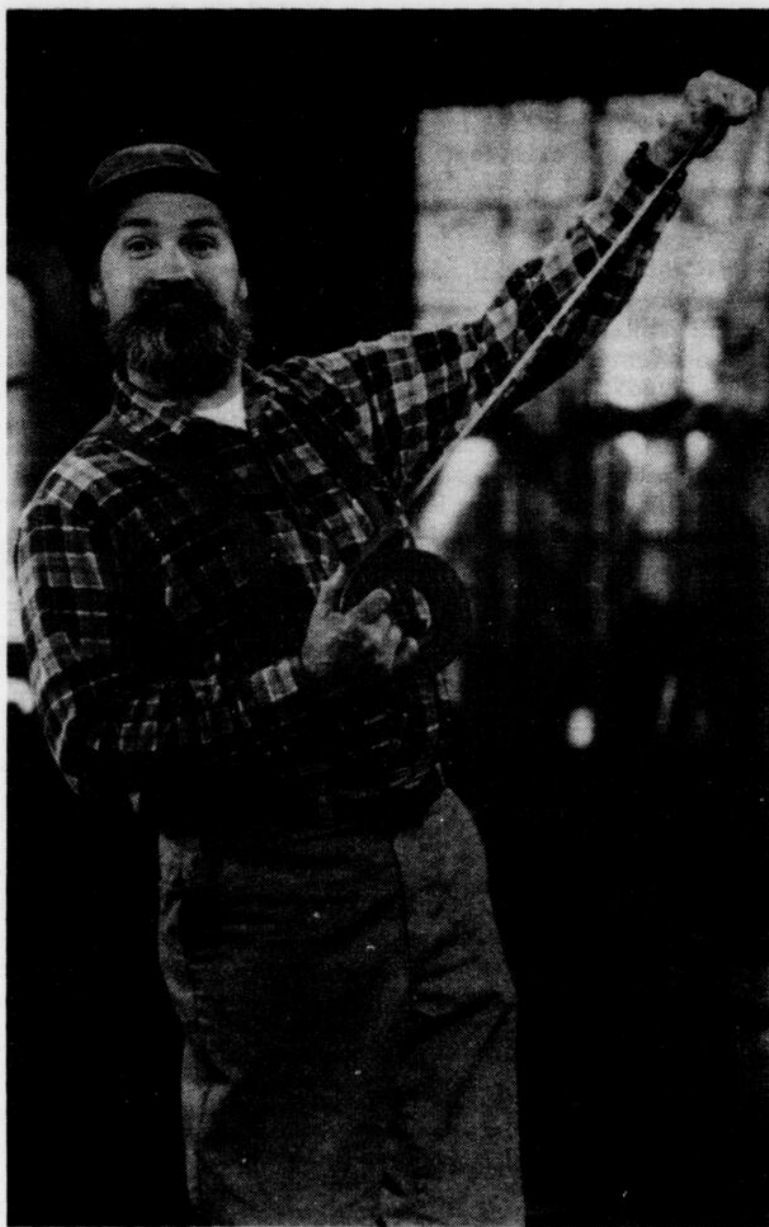
Smith made 39 plane flights in March — many for appearances on televised PBS pledge drives where he brings in more pledges than all the paid pitch people combined.

He carries his laptop on all his flights and does some writing on the plane.

But much of the final shape of *The Red Green Show* gets determined by the audiences at the tapings.

"The audience is always right," says Smith. "They tell you where a skit ends."

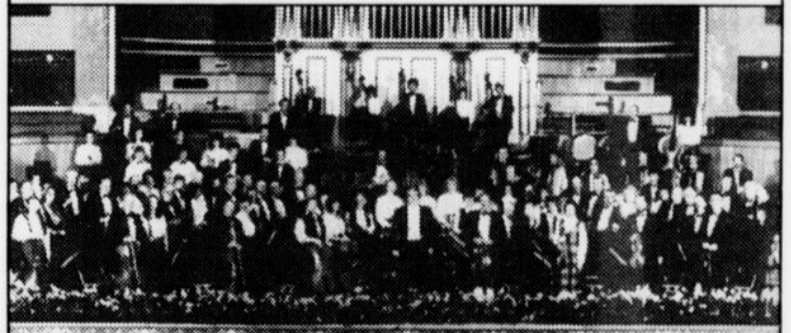

Canadians recreate Nixon's White House north of border

TORONTO (CP) — Beau Bridges looks very presidential (circa 1972) in his starched white shirt, conservative tie, Republican blue suit and semi-Cyrano nose.
What's it like to look in the mirror and see Richard Nixon? "I feel like there's a big squirrel on my face," Bridges replies, providing both a laurel to his makeup artist and a bull's-eye description of the rodent-like late president.
Appearance is especially important when portraying such familiar characters as dirty-trickster Nixon and his haughty German-accented sidekick, Henry Kissinger.
Visitors to the set are apt to do a double-take when first spotting Bridges or co-star Ron Silver, in the other title role, in the two-hour made-for-cable-TV movie called Kissinger and Nixon.
"Obviously, the makeup is amazing," says Canadian Matt

Frewer, who appears as Kissinger's deputy, Gen. Alexander Haig. "But I think lesser actors would just let the makeup do the work. Both these guys have really invested themselves in Nixon and Kissinger and are not only flawless in terms of gesture and voice, but really understand the guys."
The punchline to this exercise in serious film-making is the enormous made-in-Canada stamp on a story about the White House machinations leading up to the U.S. pullout from Vietnam in 1973.
It's being made — for Turner television in the U.S. and the Movie Network in Canada — by Toronto-based Paragon Entertainment, for broadcast late this year or early 1996.
The \$4-million-plus project was developed by Canadian Lionel Chetwynd, 52, who wrote the screenplay and shares another credit as executive producer.
It's directed by Dan Petrie, 74, the pride of Glace Bay,

N.S., who has gained his considerable fame on both sides of the border with films such as A Raisin in the Sun (1961), his Canadian award-winning The Bay Boy (1984) and Cocoon: The Return (1988).
Most of those working on the film, Canadians included, bring to the set personal opinions about the Vietnam War and the conduct of the Nixon administration just before it was razed by Watergate. None say it will cloud the picture.
"I did not inflict it with my own sense of what is right and wrong," says scriptwriter Chetwynd, a Montrealer with an impressive list of credits that include two other Vietnam War films: as writer-director of The Hanoi Hilton (1987) and writer-producer of To Heal a Nation (1988).
He based this story mainly on material from Nixon speechwriter Walter Isaacson's scholarly biography titled Kissinger.

Red-headed Texan to appear at Champlain Valley Fair Positive messages apparent in Parnell's songs

Thousands of fans will have a chance to see Lee Roy Parnell as Alan Jackson's invited guest on September 3 at the Champlain Valley Fair in Essex Junction, Vt.

The red-headed Texan has an established reputation on stage and should not disappoint concert-goers. Indeed the entertainer has a history of mesmerizing grandmothers to young dancing cowboys and cowgirls with his slide guitar wizardry and the passion in his voice.

His brand of country music appeals to fans of all ages and walks of life because it contains a common message of hope.

Parnell explores life's trials and tribulations in his music but it always offers a positive message.

He said there are certain elements he looks for in a song.

"Good lyrics that make you think, lyrics that tell of a struggle, but there's a ray of hope," he enthused. "When I go in studio to record an album, I have to find 10 songs that work together. I'm real conscious of how each song sets up the next one."

Parnell said the songs he chose for his just-released fourth album *We All Get Lucky Sometimes* "work together beautifully."

NO OVER-PRODUCTION

He makes sure his albums aren't over-produced.

"There aren't a lot of effects used on my records, so people come to see me and they get the real thing," he said. "Also, lyrically, I don't like to cut downer songs. I won't cut songs that have despair in them. I like songs about conflicts we face each day, but show that with a little faith and love, we can

overcome a lot of things." Parnell is one songwriter who is very careful about what he says in his songs because he understands that music is a very powerful force in people's lives.

"I feel music is medicine," he said. "I use it for medicine. If I'm feeling low I can pop in a Haggard tape and it pulls all that out of me. I feel it's my responsibility to keep the music right, I want people to feel better after they hear my record than they did before they put it on."

Parnell's music has elements of blues, old rock 'n' roll, Western swing and, of course, country.

This is exactly what his new album, *We All Get Lucky Sometimes*, on Career Records is all about. Here, faithful to his established tradition of recording, Parnell shows no signs of changing hats, although it's his rockiest production so far.

The album includes high-octane boogie tunes such as "Givin' Water To A Drowning

Man" and the party anthem "If The House Is Rockin'". The party theme shows up again on the 1940s-style "Knock Yourself Out" destined to become a dance-floor favorite.

Parnell has taken two avenues on this nice collection — if he isn't singing about love, he's showing us a good time.

Parnell, 38, has made a living as a musician since high school. He gained major recognition last year as he received his first CMA nomination as one of the five finalists for the Horizon Award.

A string of hits contributed to his success — "On the Road", "I'm Holding My Own", "Tender Moment", "What Kind Of Fool, Do You Think I Am" and "Love Without Mercy".

Parnell and his wife Kim have two children, Blake, 13,

and Allison, 9, and his family is his priority.

"The most important job is raising my kids and being a good husband," he said. "In the summer, during my heavy touring schedule my family goes out on the road with me."

Parnell feels privileged to play music for a living and he said it's his duty to keep the message right.

His Christian upbringing and faith have always served him well during the rough times in his life.

"I'm fortunate to have grown up in a Christian home and have carried those values with me," he said, adding "That doesn't mean I haven't tested them."

With his soulful singing, dazzling slide guitar ability and a penchant for mixing

rhythm and blues and rock 'n' roll into his country music, Parnell occupies a place of his own in modern country.

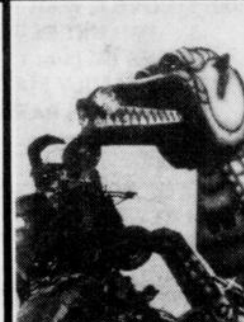

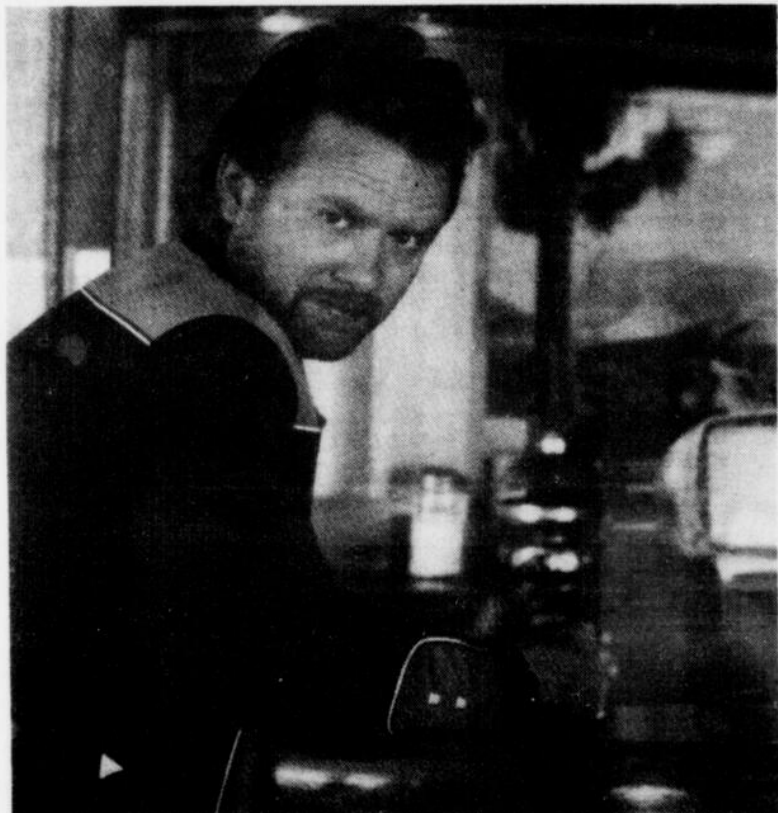
