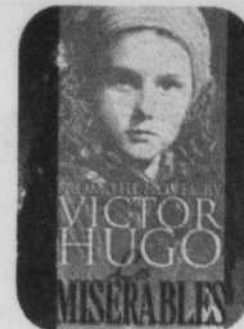

## Two solitudes? One stage

*Pop style brings them together*

**T**he two come from very different backgrounds — one, an anglophone from Guelph, Ontario, the other a native of Nicolet, Quebec, who now share a common ground as French songwriters and performers as well as a stage on their current tour together.

"I'm proud to be playing with her," is how Andrea Lindsay sums up her new-found experience of joining fellow songstress Brigitte Saint-Aubain on stage on their current tour.

While Saint-Aubain brings a folksy-to-pop style to the stage, and Lindsay comes from an avant-garde nouvel chanson-meets-pop world, the two are enjoying playing together. "I've never had any one else on stage with me before, doing backing vocals or anything like that with me, so it's a nice experience for me to be trying that," says Lindsay.

The two are both solo artists who have come together for both economic reasons and to grow their fan bases. "This tour was really the brain child of Brigitte and her manager," says Lindsay, "in a context where artists and managers are trying to afford venues, we couldn't fill some of the places we want to play on our own, so combining the two shows make it fun."

They met on the 2006 Toutes Les Filles music tour and got along great. "We have a lot in common," says Lindsay of their relationship, "we have a lot of laughs and enjoy each other's presence."

Saint-Aubain adds that she was a fan of Lindsay's music before the two had ever even met. "I loved her album," says Saint-Aubain, "I could tell from her music that I liked her as a person and as an artist."

The two play on each other's songs during the performance, performing

# Italian made easy

Once you learn  
the tricks

Favourable reviews of Elena Faita's Italian cooking classes had whetted my appetite for quite some time. But since all her classes are sold out several months in advance, I only recently got the chance to set foot in Mezza Luna's homey kitchen on Dante Street in Montreal's Little Italy area.

There, each week night, Faita passionately passes on the recipes of her mother Teresa Venditelli to an eager crowd of Italian food lovers.

The green entrance door of Scuola di Cucina Mezza Luna, one in a row of six, is so unassuming and lacking any obvious sign that I wonder whether I've got the right address. But once ajar, enticing smells of herbs and garlic lure me towards the cozy kitchen in the back of the house, where pots and pans hang from a large rack on the ceiling above a demo-island in the middle of the room. On two rows of chairs facing the island, roughly 20 students are with much anticipation awaiting the specialty of this night: *antipasti*.

Some are newcomers, but the majority of them are regular followers of Faita's culinary classes, which cover a large variety of traditional Italian dishes and foods: gnocchi, pizza, focaccia, risotto, polenta, fish and seafood, veal, and home-made sausages, pesto, tomato sauce, and pastas.

Soon all our senses are in overdrive. We watch the preparation of a *ciambella alla salsiccia e formaggio*, a magnificent bread roll in the form of a crown filled with Italian sausage, dried bacon, and provolone cheese. We learn how to properly roast red peppers for the *bruschetta al finocchio selvatico con peperoni*: never cutting them before roasting, leaving out any oil, and covering them directly with saran wrap for about 15 minutes as soon as they come out of the oven.

We discover how a whole bunch of unpeeled cloves of garlic, wrapped in foil that is left open on top, together with all kinds of fresh herb sprigs added to slightly incised eggplants, make all the difference in the world to the heavenly smelling *bruschetta con caviar di melanzane*. And we find out that even in Faita's kitchen, where fresh produce is an absolute must, dried oregano can be used successfully if only one rubs the herbs between the fingers first to get their flavour back.

Last but not least, Faita insists on chopping parsley with the famous *mezzaluna*, a curved blade with a wooden handle on each end.

While we are taking it all in and fran-

tically add the many useful tips to the recipe sheet handed out in the beginning of the evening, Faita and assistant Nathalie deliver a flawless show of cookery, cooperation and presentation. They blow us away with effortlessly conjuring up at least five of their delicious recipes simultaneously, all the while explaining the steps animatedly – in French, English and Italian – inviting students to participate in the cutting and rolling, showing the final products in their pots and casseroles, patiently answering questions without showing any sign of rush, and even succeeding to keep their zinc and cooking table clean during the whole process. Here are true aficionados and experts at work!

Elena Faita-Venditelli, second daughter of emigrants from San Vittore del Lazio in Central Italy, would not have dreamed of teaching culinary classes earlier in life. When her older sister married at age 16, Faita was taken out of school to work at home, taking care of her younger siblings while her mother worked in a stand at the nearby Jean Talon fruit and vegetable market to supplement the family income.

Having the future of her offspring in mind, mom Teresa also managed to save up money for a hardware store around the corner that had originally belonged to an uncle. When Faita, her sister Maria and her daughter Christina eventually took over the store in 1981, they decided to give it a boost by importing namebrand kitchenware straight from Italy, not yet to be found elsewhere in Montreal.

That proved to be a smart move and brought them fame throughout the city, especially thanks to their machines for making fresh pasta.

But because many of their patrons still feared that preparing their own pasta would be too complicated, they started to give demonstrations on Saturday afternoons in their hardware store. These demos were often accompanied by free recipes which Elena had learned from her mother and was eager to pass on. When more and more people got wind of these simple but delicious home-cooking recipes and the demand kept growing, the idea of a cooking school was born.

Since Mezza Luna's inception in 1993 with just a handful of students and one class a week, Faita's light has been rising steadily. Her repertoire has expanded and there's no need for advertising. She has become a regular guest cook on French TV food channels and has been featured in renowned magazines such as *Chez Soi* and *Gourmet*. She also co-owns the fabulous Montreal restaurant *Au Pied de Cochon* with Martin Picard, one of Montreal's most promising chefs. There's more: she regularly hosts Italian wine tasting sessions or classes with other prominent chefs in her kitchen,

and she's become one of the leading figures of the rapidly growing Slow Food Movement in Canada, which strives to protect the pleasures of the table from the homogenization of modern fast food. To top it all off, one can still find her daily in the hardware store around the corner, selling the very cookware she uses at night in her classes.

Asked for the magic formula of her success and the source of all her energy, Faita speaks of the incredible work ethic and sense of responsibility she has had to grow up with from a very young age. On the other hand is the ability to remain the same modest person she always has been, continuing to treat everyone with honesty, directness and respect. Add to this her obvious knack for preparing tasty dishes, her passion for the simple, rustic Italian kitchen, and her strong belief in fresh home-made food, and.... *ecco fatto!*

By the end of the evening, after our mouths have been watering for more than two hours, the long-awaited mo-

ment is finally there: we are invited to sit at a table in the dining room to test all the dishes prepared by Faita and Nathalie, accompanied by a glass of red wine.

Judging by the many second helpings, the *antipasti* is clearly a hit all around.

"You are what you cook" holds true. Faita's culinary tricks and treats are just a reflection of her own down-to-earth yet enigmatic personality: simple, unpretentious, straight-forward, yet high in quality, generous, colourful, fresh, and full of surprising combinations. Is it a wonder then, that I too succumb to joining the ranks of loyal followers who keep flocking to Faita's home kitchen in Little Italy? And guess what... making my own fresh pasta and tomato sauce will be next!

# It's racy

*Comedy's also  
challenging  
and complex*

Lennoxville director Laurel Thomson is readying her cast of 13 second-year Champlain College students for an English production of the racy 1744 play, *La Dispute*, written by the man who was considered the 18th century's most important playwright — Pierre Carlet de Champlain de Marivaux.

"His style was steeped more with what's going on behind what you see," says Thomson. "I'm used to Shakespeare who gives you everything; Marivaux is much more complex."

The playwright (he was born in 1688) wrote funny pieces for rival acting companies *La Comédie Française* and *La Comédie Italienne* of Paris. He is famous for a delicate brand of comedy that examines the trials and tribulations of romantic love and the confusion that results — and Thomson believes her production packs in even more now than it did centuries ago.

"In 1744, when *La Dispute* premiered at the *Comédie Française* it was not received very well. Today it speaks to us in ways Marivaux could never have imagined. It's so timely,"

says the director, who is in her second year of teaching at Champlain College.

"The play's premise is still as provocative as it was in the eighteenth century. In a cruel experiment meant to test the faithlessness of men and women, four children are raised in complete isolation and then, 18 years later, set free. It's very funny. It's young people falling in love with themselves, with the desire to be loved. There's no social screen, just pure innocence."

In the play the four youth, essentially observed like guinea pigs (portrayed by Sarah-Michelle Hollands, Dominic Saint-Laurent, Marie-Pier Bernier-Girardin and Alvaro Arena), are now naive adolescents, and are introduced to each other, one at a time, so as to trigger conflicting emotions. The strange new world they enter is part scientific laboratory and part theatre stage, and what they discover is shocking.

"The question is, who cheated on who first in the Garden of Eden?" Thomson reveals. "This is a heated dispute between the sexes."

This will be Thomson's second campus directing gig, which follows last year's successful *Cocktails* at Pam's.

She is also the artistic director of Lennoxville's Dog-Cart Productions, which produced *The Importance of Being Earnest* in 2003 and *Arms and*

the Man in 2004.

The acting graduate of the National Theatre School of Canada has also volunteered her time throughout the community, including on the production of *A Midsummer Night's Dream* featuring local youth during a past Lennoxville Friendship Day.

She has performed and toured with the Stratford Festival and the Piggery Theatre in North Hatley, and she starred in Theatre Knowlton's *The Tall Girl* in 2005.

Not only will the play make audience members laugh and think, she says, the costumes are unique.

"It was a privilege for me to work

with Candace Herring. She is a professional costume designer who has designed costumes for productions in New York City. We're making these 18th century costumes, which you rarely see on stage because they are just so difficult to make with the ruffles and lace."

The production is on from Wednesday, Nov. 21 to 24 in the Hangar at Champlain College with an 8 p.m. show time and a 2 p.m. matinee on the 24th, but seating is limited. Tickets are \$7 or \$5 each for groups of 20 or more and should be reserved early by calling 819-823-2395.

# Beauty adds joy to life

## Clay artists and avatars

Sometimes, I wonder if the answer to life isn't right here before us. I know that we're all thinking at times about our finite existence, but life gets in the way, doesn't it? No time for this, that and the other thing except for creating avatars on popular websites such as Second Life. Besides, it's kind of taboo to be talking about who we are.

Anyway, life is not a favourite topic for most of us, and who wants to get weighed down with the philosophy; it's much easier to limit deep thinking to "how's it going?", "What about this weather, eh?" and "Gee, I think your avatar looks great."

Robin Badger and Robert Chartier, two potters who met and fell in love in pottery school, opened their studio Down to Earth in 1995. Situated on a 100 acre family farm in the mountains of West Bolton, the studio showcases the works of two very different clay artists.

After studying in Old Montreal at the Centre de Céramique Bonsecours and apprenticing with well-known potters such as Stanley Lake and Louise Bousquet, they decided the best community for their art would be here in the Townships.

"Our studio is an oasis of peace and tranquillity in today's busy world," says Badger. "Clay pots have always held a great attraction for me. I love the feel of a hand-thrown vessel and strive to create pieces that are a joy to use as well as to look at."

The land plays a big part in the creation of their works, starting with the clay it produces and the inspiration it cultivates.

"Being alive is being tuned in every second, and to be present to what surrounds me has a strong influence on my work," says Chartier. "Nature is so evocative, with large lines and delicate nuances counterbalancing at the same time, these are the elements that you will find in my work."

I can't help but see a similarity between the process of creating works of art and the creationist theory. A pot, for example, has a creator who can only shape it based on his own experience. Religious scriptures are full of references to a God that created earth and human life in his own image, based on thoughts.

If there is a God who created us, then he would want us to act likewise. Why? Because he knows only what he is capable of. Creating an avatar in the virtual world of the Internet, for instance, is eerily similar to God having created us, if that's what you believe in, don't you think?

Chartier's work, like himself, is exciting and different, something the Creator has shown us in his work. Never content with doing the same thing twice, Chartier's pieces reflect a feeling of free expression and improvisation. His artistic career has taken him from kite making to pottery and his clay works retain a sense of lightness. "I love the challenge that large pieces offer me, and I feel a strong connection to life's currents," says Chartier.

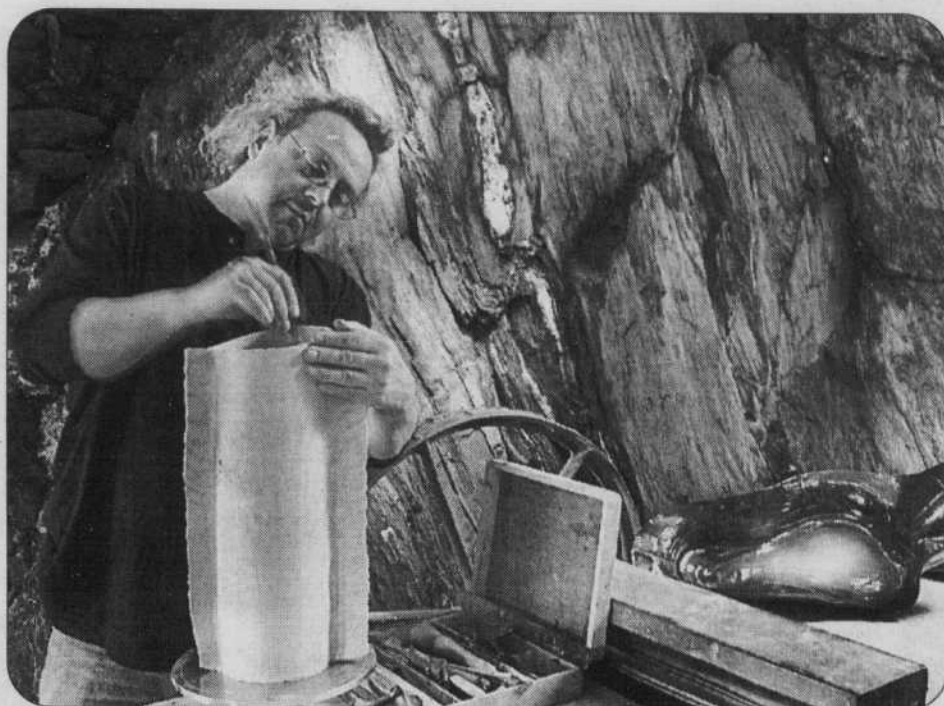
The Second Life website says that "it is about personal expression providing an online society within a 3D world, where users can explore, build, socialize and participate in their own economy... and your avatar is the most personal expression of all. After all, an avatar is your persona in the virtual world... the tool to personalize your avatar is very simple to use and allows you to change anything you like, from the tip of your nose to the tint of your skin. Don't worry if it's not perfect at first, you can change your look at any time."

The act of creating something, I suppose, is always a work in progress until one decides to shut it down. It seems that often an artist is never quite happy with a work, and sooner or later has to accept it for what it is. God, the artist and creator of life, is an interesting concept, and what excites me is that we could possibly, as humans, be reflecting in our actions who we are: our creator.

Much as cyberspace avatars reflect their creators, maybe so do we. This implies that we must be imitating, in all that we do, our source. Much the same as the ceramic pot its potter. The website avatars have everything that we have given them, and represent the very best of what we want for ourselves. What does this say about our aspirations?

If all we can do is build another shopping centre, albeit online, populated by avatars created in our image, then I have to think we don't make very effective gods. What is this obsession that we have with commercial gain and the way we express it? Is this what community is all about? Here we are, given a chance to set up a blueprint of a per-

fect community online and all we do is want the same old thing. I'm getting tired.

"I feel this virtual world people are creating... reflects a malaise of today's world," Badger says, "where people are trying to find happiness outside themselves." Well, it's fine for her to say,

after all she's an artist and therefore more in touch with herself than most of us. All the same, someone has to lead us out of the darkness.

"We are bullied from all sides... marketing telling us that we should 'look like this', 'live this way', 'aspire to these things' etc.," says Badger. "People consider it 'lifestyle', but I think it is bound to disappoint." Personally, I agree.

In the Townships we have the same road to travel as everyone else and need to realize who we are as a community if we want to thrive. We are in the ongoing process of creating and need not give up. Developing the arts and supporting our artists is the most important thing we can do in order to preserve our past and build a viable future for our children. I don't think that by uploading ourselves into cyberspace we will be shaping our community on the ground anytime soon.

"We can never buy enough things to fill up an empty inside, but people keep trying," says Badger. "We always think if we only had more money, we would be happy... we no longer see the real world around us, so we try to create a virtual one on the 'net perhaps?"

Consulting Merriam-Webster once again, we find that the etymology of avatar is: "Sanskrit *avat* - arah descent, from *avatarati* he descends, from *ava* - away + *tarati* he crosses over." Its meaning in part is "the incarnation of a Hindu deity (such as Vishnu), an incarnation in human form, an embodiment often in a person." Holy cow!

That's it. Humankind has its gods and most of us have one. No matter, all of them have a need to incarnate at some point in time with the hope of saving us. Imagine, soon there will be virtual avatars descending from the real world (whatever that is) with no other reason than to save the thousands of avatars lost in the hopeless world of commercial cyberspace. Stay tuned.

Who we are is not a nervous response to someone asking us, "How's it going?" at the post office. It's the thoughts we think in private about who we really are. It's about growing old and wanting to know why we're here in the first place, and not always about the best deal when the loonie is high as we merrily go cross-border shopping.

more of a daunting challenge, Fox said.

"Every undergraduate in an English department hears about it. There's this great loathing or fear of Beowulf, at the same time as this fascination with this thing that's so difficult and has formed the first text of the curriculum of English literature for so long," Fox said.

"The lingering fascination is due to the fact the poem is utterly enigmatic. It's a mystery without one all-embracing solution. You can think of it as sort of a DaVinci Code in text. There's no one way to read the poem that makes sense with all the other parts of the poem."

Gaiman, the author of such novels as *American Gods* and *Anansi Boys*, but still perhaps best known for his Sandman comic series (once described by Norman Mailer as "a comic strip for intellectuals"), first stumbled across the Beowulf story in comic form, back when he was 13.

"If memory serves it was a comic called *Beowulf: Dragon Slayer* and it was pretty terrible in all truth," Gaiman re-

called, "but it was interesting enough for me to go to the school library and find the Penguin Classic translation of Beowulf and read it. And I thought, this is a great story. It's got serious monsters in it and dragon fighting at the end. That's when I fell in love with it."

Gaiman and Avary wrote their original screenplay back in 1998 but production challenges stalled the project until Zemeckis decided he could pull the story off with the same motion capture technology he pioneered with *Polar Express*. Gaiman thinks the cinematic result is a triumph and is even touting as Oscar-worthy the performance of Anthony Hopkins as the Danish king Hrothgar.

Mostly he's just happy he's played a part in spreading the ancient tale.

"I love the idea that people will go and see our Beowulf and at least know, my god, there's a cracking story there," he said. "Even if some of those kids are compelled to pick up the original and understand what's going on, I think we'll have done our job."

Everything is Fine is Josh Turner's third studio album on MCA Records. With each CD he has released so far, the 'Long Black Train' singer has managed to establish himself as a solid and talented country artist who will stay in this industry for a long time.

Since his debut, Turner has become one of the most popular touring acts in the music business — he is a great performer. He has also been nominated for CMA Male Vocalist of the year.

The new album shows the level of success this newest member of the Grand Ole Opry can achieve. It features traditional country sound. The songs are well crafted and his wonderful bass-baritone is amazing.

He is also a very talented songwriter as he wrote or co-wrote seven of the 12 tracks on the new collection. Two of those tunes were co-penned with John Anderson, who has become one of Turner's favourite writing partners.

Turner's music is positive and when you hear one of his songs, you hear exactly what country music is all about. His roots are firmly set in traditional music and he can make any contemporary song sound like a country classic.

Turner has great ability to pick tunes. Of course, he feels the need to please his fans but the songs are very

representative of who he is in real life. This is most likely why he always sounds so genuine.

The first single released from the album is 'Firecracker', an upbeat tune about finding love with the right girl. It is doing very well on the charts. There's also the title track 'Everything Is Fine', about the good things in life.

The new collection offers two outstanding duets. Trisha Yearwood joins him for a poignant love song called 'Another Try'. It's about two lovers persuaded that, if they could get another chance, they would fight with everything they have to make it work.

R & B artist Anthony Hamilton collaborates with Turner on 'Nowhere Fast'. Hamilton wrote it and made a few changes to fit Turner's style. The vocal chemistry between the two

is captivating. I love the R & B sound with the country twist.

'The Longer the Waiting (The Sweeter the Kiss)' is one of the best things on the

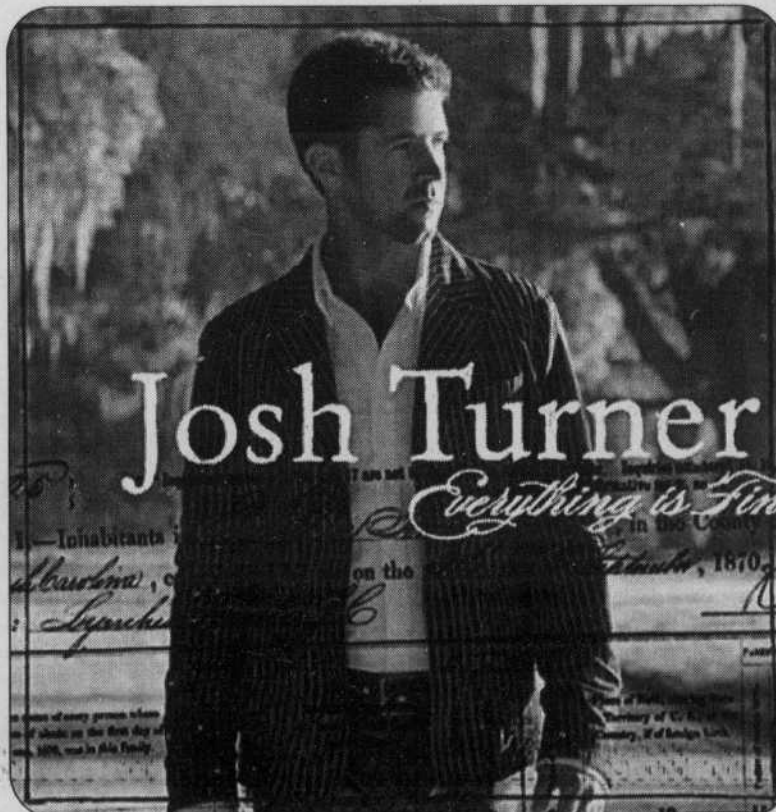
record. It blends traditional Celtic music (complete with bagpipes) with country. It is emotionally very powerful.

Turner seems like the very serious type, so it is funny to hear him sing numbers like the self-penned 'Trailerhood'. The tongue-in-cheek description of life tells us that he hasn't forgotten the blue-collar crowd.

There's also a wonderful cover of the George Jones hit 'One Woman Man'. Turner does an exceptional job with that classic. This is one of country fandom's favourite songs and it would make Jones proud.

I am surprised by the lack of country male performers who can use a falsetto and Turner is perhaps the only man in country music who's not afraid to do so. On this album, he enters the high range of his voice multiple times, and this gives his music a special quality that you just cannot find very often in country music today. This is
