Johnny Reid sings from the soul

*Bishop's University
grad releases
sophomore album*

Rock and roll, country and soul. That's how Johnny Reid describes his just-released self-titled CD. This rising Canadian star plays his music straight from the heart.

"It doesn't matter where you're from," said Reid, a native of Scotland. "In order to sing country western, it has to be sung from the soul."

Reid's ultimate goal has always been to entertain and the Bishop's University graduate succeeds. With slow, sweet ballads like "Jeannie" to foot-stomping, finger-snapping, body-shaking tunes like "Mr. Saturday Night," this album is a winner.

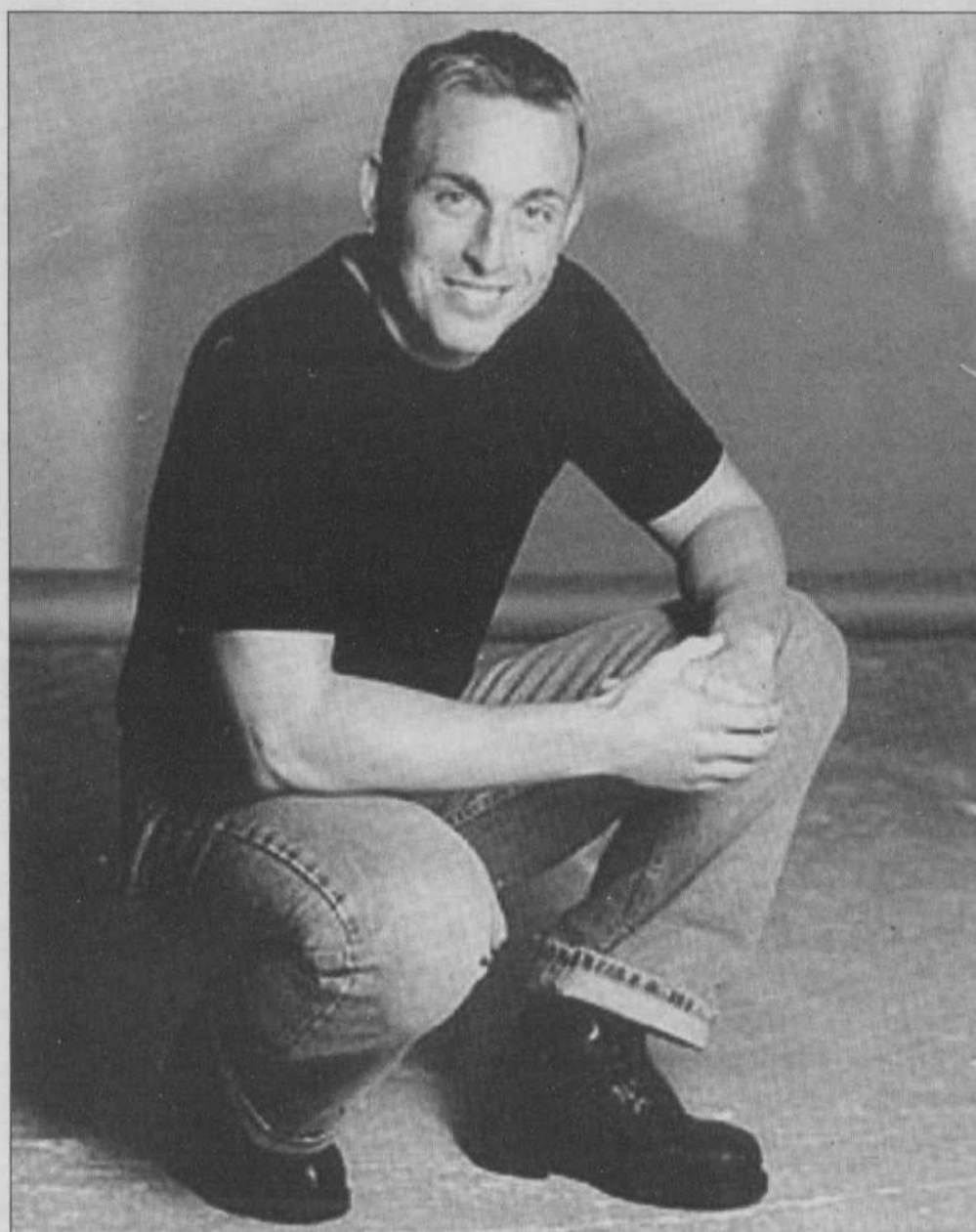
Reid is not only a singer and performer; he has written or co-written eight of the 13 tracks on the album. He said he's proud to be working with some of the finest songwriters in Canada: Award-winner Barry Brown, William Wallace (writer of "26 cents"), Dean McGart and David Tyson.

Included on the CD is "Given Up On Me," Reid's signature single that is No. 35 on the Canada Country Chart this week. Like much of Reid's music, this song has a personal history. One evening, Reid had been trying to call his girlfriend but only got her answering machine. Frustrated and feeling sorry for himself, he picked up his guitar, unplugged the phone and wrote a song.

The lyrics describe a singer trying to call his girlfriend from a phone booth; it's raining and he feels that she's "given up on me."

Reid's back-up band is fantastic throughout the album but outdoes itself in the jazzy "Mr. Saturday Night."

"My Texas swing song," said Reid of the tune. "There's always one guy dressed to the max who comes into the bar. I call him Mr. Saturday Night." Reid dedicates this song to "those who love to

have a good time."

We have Reid's grandmother to thank for the CD's bonus track, "When You and I Were Young, Maggie," a beautiful piece that showcases Reid's clear and powerful voice.

"Everybody knew that was my Grammie's song," says Reid, who believes in the immortality of music.

Music may be immortal, but for Reid singing is a "three-minute emotional rollercoaster ride."

Photos of his live performances show

Reid's passion for his music. He's sweating up a storm, the veins bulging in his neck and he's obviously having the time of his life.

"I love it, I breathe it," he said. "I just sing constantly. Even when I go to sleep I'm singing."

But music wasn't always in the stars for Reid. Recruited by Bishop's University's football team from his home in Brampton, Ontario, he was more likely to carry a football than a microphone.

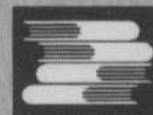

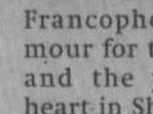

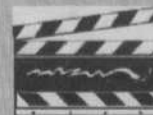

Les Alléghanys adds a friendly touch

All too often a vital ingredient missing from the menu of many restaurants is friendly, personalized service. This is certainly not the case at Les Alléghanys, a warm, pub-style eatery on Maple Road in Sutton.

Perfect for après ski get-togethers, the restaurant is divided into small rooms conducive for long chats over pitchers of beer or mugs of Irish coffee. The wood walls are decorated with photos and mementos of the staff and owners—chefs Rolland Potvin and Lynda Graham over the years, including a photo above our table of our waitress Margeaux at age 3. There are also photographs donated by patrons, such as an autographed poster of Quebec skier Jean-Luc Brassard and numerous pinups of skiers in action.

The bar area is a popular hang-out for youthful exuberance as the musical hits of the day emanate from the sound system.

Working at the restaurant since it opened six years ago, waitress Margeaux sure knew her stuff. With a smile and a sense of humour, she didn't miss a beat as she answered questions about the nine chef's suggestions offered the night my companion and I visited.

Rolland bills his cuisine as 'adventurous' and he seems to take pride in his creations. The menu, which changes weekly, reflects the sense of easy-going fun that permeates the restaurant. The dishes have eye-catching names and next to each one is a teaser meant to further entice diners.

We learn that La Roulade à la Rolland (\$15.95) is a 'superb invention of the chef' (if he says so himself); the Porc à la Zurich (\$16.95) is 'to be eaten only on special occasions'; the vegetarian dish Champignons à la Stroganoff (\$8.95) is an 'exclusive recipe'; the Sauté de Boeuf à l'Ancienne (\$10.95) is

'very exciting'; and the Gros Bol de Moules Alléghanys has 'made them famous.'

The special includes a choice of three appetizers: Soup, Salad of the Day or something called a Barquette. Coffee, tea or tisane is also included.

The food at Les Alléghanys is fine pub fare. Nothing is too spiced or too subtle, but everything is ac-

ceptable. If you know what to expect, you'll never be disappointed.

While patrons are pouring over the menu, they pick over plates of nachos and mild salsa. A mouth-watering basket of bread is also brought to the table. This contains delicious, warm, herb-crusted garlic bread, homemade melba toast, white bread and crackers.

As an appetizer, the Barquette was too intriguing to pass up. This was a good starter featuring muffin-shaped bread stuffed with artichokes and covered in a creamy white wine sauce with tomatoes and shallots.

My companion ordered the Soup, which today was Chicken Noodle. This

was a light soup, featuring clear broth, lots of chicken pieces and angel hair pasta.

The main dishes were tasty and attractively presented with herbed carrots, zucchini and turnip. The Porc à la Zurich featured tender pork medallions, lightly grilled with herbs, then baked in the oven covered in a mixture of two cheeses, cream and dijon mustard. The Roulade à la Rolland was a chicken filet stuffed with cheese and covered in a demi-glacé sauce featuring white wine, tomatoes, shallots, onion and bacon.

The two specials described above, without alcohol or tip, will cost an affordable \$38.

While not included in the special, the desserts were delicious and shouldn't be missed. At \$4.50 each, the Five-Fruit Pie was a generous slice of warm pie with a flaky crust and hearty filling; and the Profiterolle was an oversized pastry crammed with vanilla ice-cream and blanketed with chocolate sauce.

The à la carte menu includes Fajitas à la Chi-Chi Kawabunga served with guacamole, seasoned rice, mild house salsa, sour cream and veggies; the Poco-Loce — thin slices of marinated beef grilled with onions, sweet peppers, mushrooms and melted cheese and served with lime sauce; and La Végé, a mixture of six vegetables sautéed with onions, sweet peppers and mushrooms in olive oil and butter and served with melted cheese and an orange-lime sauce. These are all \$12.95, however half portions are available for \$7.95.

Also on the menu are grilled steaks and shrimp (between \$10.95-\$14.95), served with house salad, pepper sauce and potato of the day; and La César Pok-Pok (\$9.95) — the house Caesar salad with apples no less topped with marinated grilled chicken filets.

Rounding it all out are a selection of soups, cold plates, snacks and pastas, as well as local and imported beers and specialty coffees.

Les Alléghanys combines food, fun and a friendly atmosphere, just the right recipe for a cold winter's night.

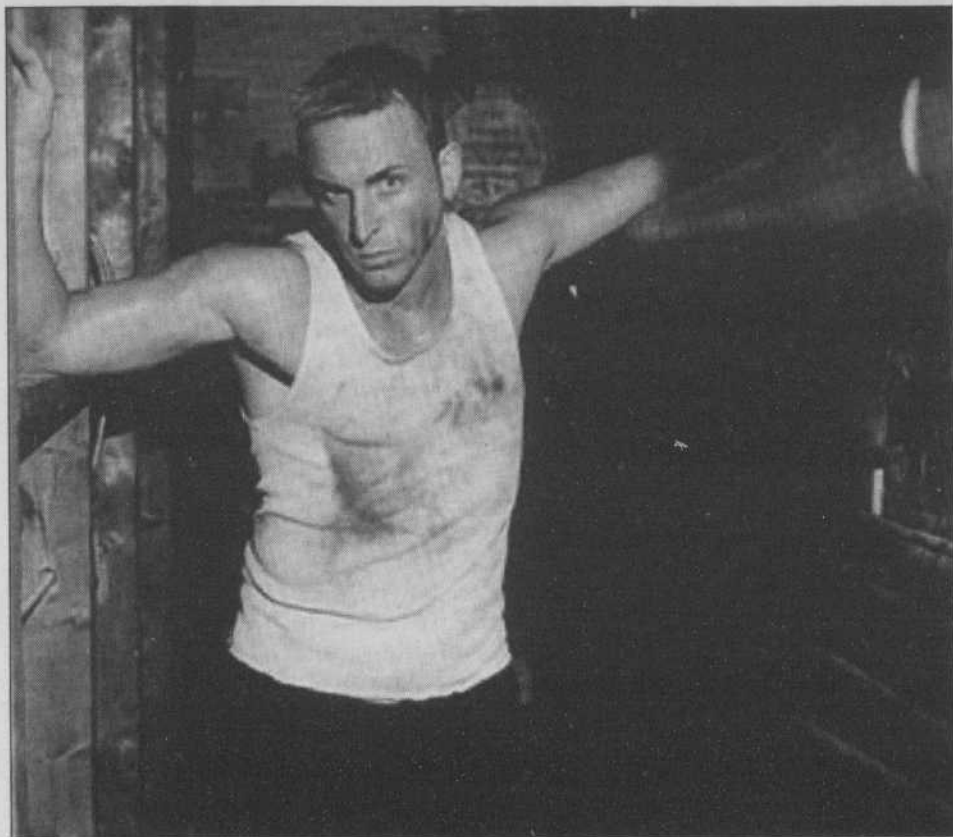

Dyer discusses democracy at BU

Gwynne Dyer, one of Canada's most respected and leading experts on foreign affairs, will be giving a lecture at Bishop's University, Monday Jan. 17, entitled 'Democratic Overdog: Strategy, Morality and Etiquette for the New Masters of the Universe', sponsored by the 'Provigo Distinguished Speakers Series'.

The Newfoundland native has received degrees from Canadian, American and British universities. He has served in three navies and held an appointment at Oxford University before becoming a freelance journalist, broadcaster and lecturer for 20 years.

Dyer's first television documentary series, 'War' was seen by viewers in 45 countries in the mid-80's. One of its episodes 'Profession of Arms' was nominated for an Academy award. Dyer has worked on many other documentaries, including his most recent 'Protection Force', a three-part series on peacekeepers in Bosnia first aired in 1995. His bi-weekly international affairs column is published by 175 papers in 45 countries.

With the demise of Communism in the early 90s and many large dictatorships from South Africa to Indonesia falling, Dyer examines the responsibilities of the increasingly powerful democratic countries, once seen as an underdog protector of rights and freedoms. He asks whether democracies are really upholding morality.

This is pointed up by the unprecedented NATO decision to bomb Serbia for three months on behalf of the people of Kosovo - a thousand-bomber air campaign to uphold humanitarian goals and because thousands of Serbian casualties occurred with no casualties incurred by NATO forces.

Dyer looks at the ramifications of this kind of campaign in light of the established United Nations system. With war without casualties on one side becoming a possibility, he asks 'Is there a new obligation for democracy?' and 'Has NATO crossed moral boundaries by interfering with the disputes of other countries?'

Gwynne Dyer will deliver the lecture, 'Democratic Overdog', Monday Jan. 17 at 7:30 p.m. at Bandeen Hall at Bishop's University. The public is welcome to attend.

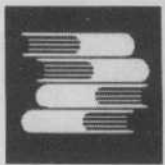

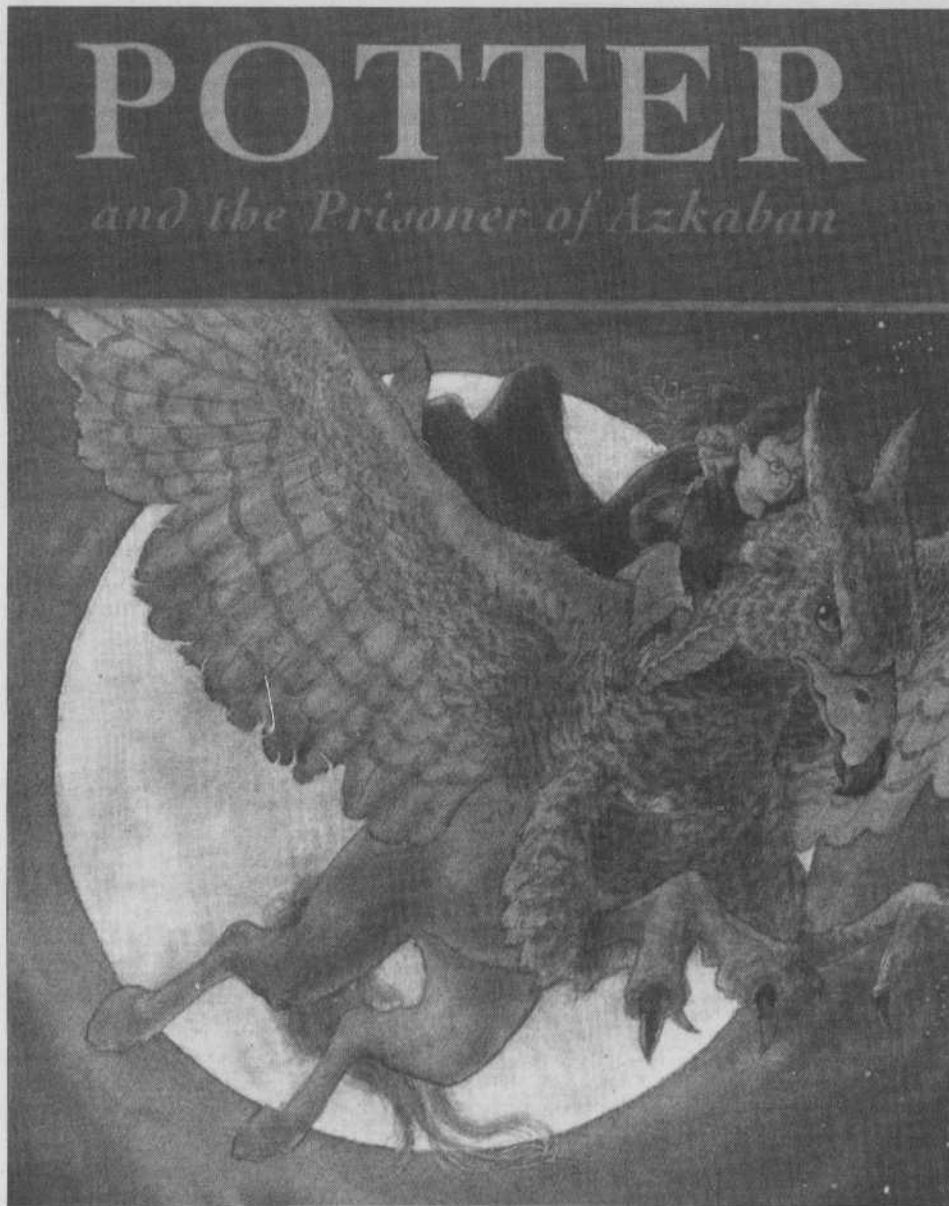

Potter bewitches young readers in *Prisoner*



REVIEW OF HARRY POTTER AND THE PRISONER OF AZKABAN, BY J.K. ROWLING

As I settled in to read Harry Potter and the Prisoner of Azkaban, one of my daughters made off with the first book in the series, Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone, which she devoured, then tore into the second book Harry Potter and the Chamber of Secrets, before I'd finished.

She was impressed by the J.K. Rowling's imaginative writing which she thought had probably been influenced by Roald Dahl, with its propensity for really evil villains and good children.

There is indeed something classic in Rowling's depiction of heroic children in a world of mixed-up adults. Harry Potter, a young English boy, is stuck for the summer with his nasty Uncle and Aunt and pining to return to school. Harry, is a wizard, attending Hogwarts School of Witchcraft. His best friends Hermione and Ron are also wizards.

Though his craven uncle and aunt tell people Harry's parents died in a car crash, they were in fact murdered by an evil sorcerer.

This year, when Harry returns to school, an evil sorcerer implicated in their death wreaks havoc on witch society and "Muggles" (the witch word for humans) society too.

Sirius Black is capable of the darkest magic and even the prison of Azka-

ban with its terrifying soul destroying guards known as Dementors cannot hold him. Harry and his teachers have reason to believe that Black is coming to claim Harry. As his teachers try to protect him, for some of them think of him as family, the Dementors are called in to guard the school and Harry, Hermione and Ron have to discover who is friend and who is foe.

Children from about age 10 and up will find themselves engaged in the world of hippogriffs, Boggarts, Red Caps, Kappas and Grindylows - a world in which sorcerer children flying on broomsticks play rousing games of Quidditch, chasing bludgers and snitches and study Defence Against the Dark Arts, Divination and Transfiguration.

Rowling has a keen sense of plot with lots of interesting twists and turns.

While containing elements of fantasy and mystery, Harry Potter and the Prisoner of Azkaban is also rooted in an English kind of reality of school dinners, dormitories and mischief-making. The book is rich in detail, though occasionally, Rowling's tendency to alliterate can become a little tedious. Generally, the characters are convincing and the excitement level increases with every page.

Rowling has written a book to appeal to children and adults alike.

While her writing lacks the sheer intellect and mischievousness of Roald Dahl, Rowling has created a believable fantasy world which will keep readers hooked for years to come.

Puzzle book requires parental back-up

Car Smarts is not another one of those word-search puzzle books designed to keep kids busy in the car.

As the title suggests, this book calls for "smarts:" real explanations given for those everyday questions that we've either forgotten the answers to, or never knew.

For example, "How many raindrops are in a typical thunder-

cloud?" or, "How does a speedometer measure speed?", and, "Why are mountains often covered in fog or mist?" The many travel-related activities range from learning how to use a map to predicting the weather, reading tires and designing license plates.

The back cover claims the book is "ideal for kids 8 and up," but our representative eight-year-old Angelique found it "very complicated and sort of boring," so be prepared to read along with

younger children in order to help with the more difficult terms. Angelique did like guessing at the "Did you know?" questions but balked at counting road kill, another suggested activity.

Before the big trip, read through the book and choose some activities with your child. It could mean the difference between a trip punctuated with "Mom, are we there yet?" and one of discovery and learning.

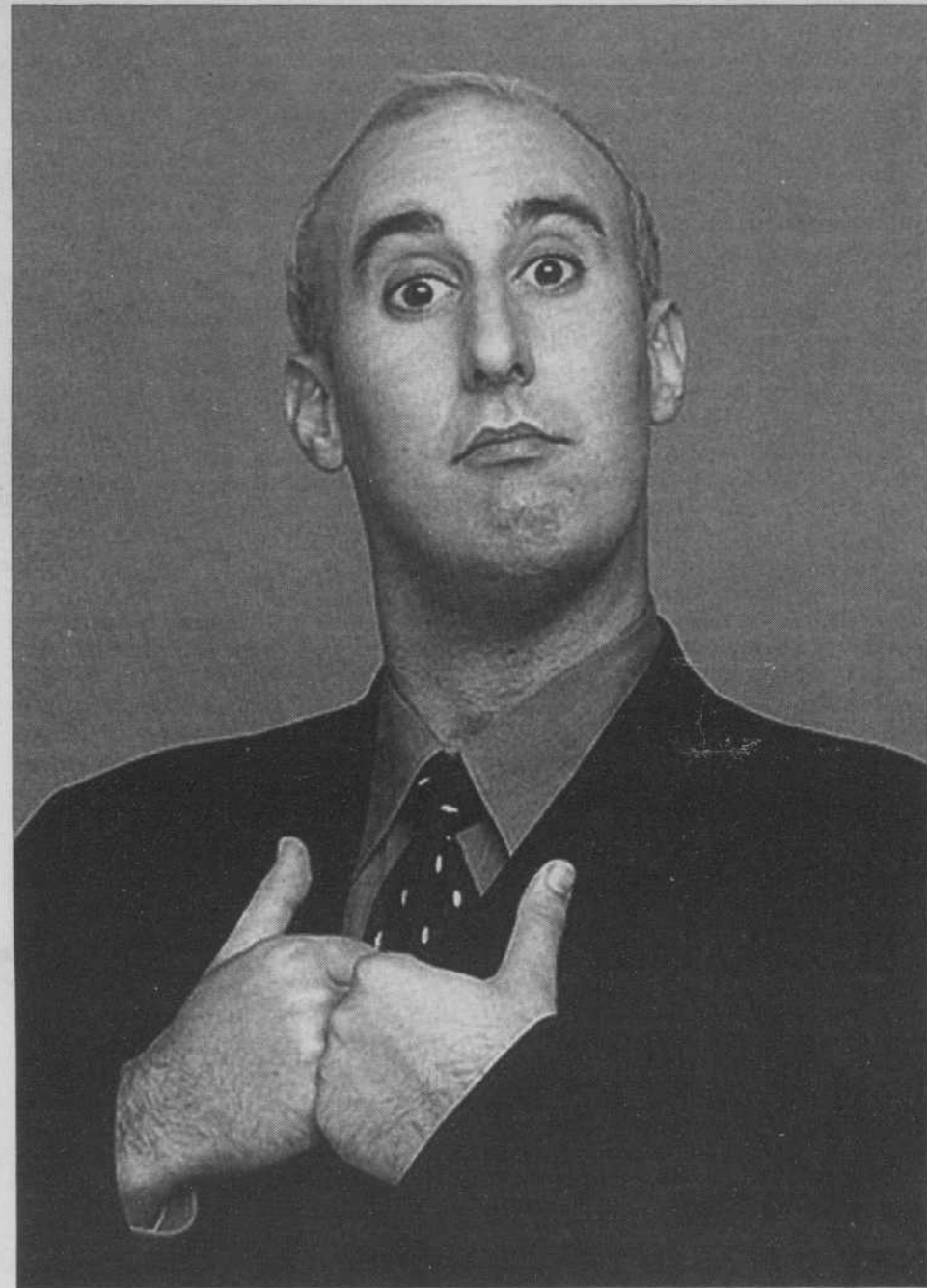

Riefenstahl role a risk for Foster

Jodie Foster knows she could be jeopardizing her image by taking on the role of an infamous figure from the Nazi era. But she says she never thought twice about deciding to produce and star in a new film about Leni Riefenstahl, the superb filmmaker who worked for Adolph Hitler.

"Playing Leni is a risk," Foster said in an interview. "It's an enormous challenge - I think it will be the most challenging film of my life, but it's something I've wanted to do for a long time."

Riefenstahl, now 97, applied her cinematic genius to two notorious Nazi propaganda films during the 1930s. One was the 1936 *Triumph Of The Will*, a subversively compelling account of the rise of Nazi Germany. She followed this up with a documentary glorifying Germany's performance at the 1936 Berlin Olympics. Both movies continue to be hailed as masterpieces - even by critics sickened by what they represent.

Riefenstahl has spent the last half century seeking to rehabilitate herself by suggesting that using her great gifts to advance the cause of Nazism

in Europe was a necessary career move forced on her by Hitler. But a 1994 film portrait, *The Wonderful Horrible Life of Leni Riefenstahl*, is less forgiving.

When it was released, film historian and critic Joseph McBride wrote that "director Ray Muller's thoughtful documentary portrait provides a bracing antidote to the historical revisionism of Riefenstahl's Faustian pact with Hitler" and said the film offered "incontrovertible evidence" of Riefenstahl's "willingness to accept and glorify Nazi ideology."

Foster says she knows she'll be entering a minefield but that's one reason the project fascinates her. "There is no other woman in the 20th century who has been so admired and vil-

fied simultaneously," she admits. Indeed, the incendiary subject matter was the reason she chose to produce the film herself.

"I'd been trying to figure out how to do it for a while, and finally decided the best way was with the most autonomy. You can't really make a movie like this unless you're fearless about it. I think you can easily fall victim to people telling you

what to do in a way that could really shift the tone of the film. There's so much baggage to the story that you need a very clear independent vision."

Foster has met Riefenstahl, who still scuba dives in her 98th year. "She is an amazing lady, incredibly complex. But it is going to be a very, very difficult film."

Foster has another reason for tack-

ling such subject matter. She gets easily bored these days. "I've been acting for so many years now that unless it's really challenging and something I haven't done before, it's very hard for me to do it."

Still on the subject of Jodie Foster, she remains under pressure to reprise her Oscar-winning Clarice Starling character in Hannibal, the long-awaited sequel to *The Silence Of The Lambs*. Foster herself has now indicated she's out of the project because it will conflict with her plans to direct a movie - yet as recently as early December, she was telling reporters that "nothing would make me happier to do a sequel" but that she was still waiting to see the final screen treatment. Matters heated up on Dec. 29 when *The London Daily Express* reported that costar Anthony Hopkins was "furious" with her for rejecting a revised script prepared at her request. It appears that Foster's main problem is that she can't stomach the fate of her character. Earlier in the year, she was disgusted with the Thomas Harris novel which ends with Clarice teaming up with the cannibalistic villain, Hannibal Lecter.

Adventure, suspense, and a few laughs can be found in director Scott Silver's *The Mod Squad*. Claire Danes, Giovanni Ribisi and Omar Epps are in top form in this quirky action-drama as they play a trio of ex-delinquents hired by Officer Grier (Dennis Farina) to catch "the bad guys".

Things start to go wrong when a police officer gets murdered and the trio's mission is suspended. It turns out that drugs are being stolen from the evidence locker, and Julie, Peter, and Lincoln-"Link"(Danes, Ribisi and Epps)-begin to suspect dirty dealings among the cops. They decide to continue the investigation on their own, and the adventure begins.

Tensions flare as the three former delinquents struggle to get along. Link tries to keep the clumsy, careless Peter in line and Julie tries to rekindle an old flame. It gets hard to separate the good guys from the bad guys, and they realize that they can't trust anyone but themselves.

This film is funny and exciting, al-

though the language and violence are too graphic for all members of the family. The *Mod Squad* proves that Claire Danes and Giovanni Ribisi have firmly established themselves as fine actors. These three actors work well together and it would be fun to see them reunite in a sequel.

THE THOMAS CROWN AFFAIR

Escape into a playful world of crime, romance, and adventure with the remake of *The Thomas Crown Affair*, directed by John McTierman.

When you are a rich, bored, trustworthy art benefactor like Thomas Crown (Pierce Brosnan), you can get away with committing elegant crimes such as stealing a Monet painting in broad daylight. Flamboyantly witty Catherine Banning (Rene Russo) enters the scene. Mr. Crown is the first suspect on her list, and as she puts it, "I hope to get him".

Believe it folks, she does get him. Crown is seduced by her intelligence and femme fatale demeanor, and she cannot resist his confidence nor his sexy allure. Consequently, attraction complicates matters. The film's plot is structured like a cat and mouse chase. Will they betray each other or will they surrender to love?

The chemistry between Russo and Brosnan is hot enough to set the screen on fire-especially in a dance scene in which Russo sensuously swings her hips to seduce Brosnan. Pierce couldn't be sexier or more charismatic. Ladies, whether you are a fan or not, I guarantee that you will find Mr. Brosnan irresistible in his role as Thomas Crown. An incredibly fun film.

RESURRECTION

Russell Mulcahy's dark, psychological thriller, *Resurrection*, is a whodunit story that seeks to solve the mystery of serial killings that are committed by a religious fanatic.

Christopher Lambert plays Detec-

tive Prudhomme who is determined to arrest this intelligent, creative, mysterious killer whose victims' names and occupations correspond to Christ's apostles. Also, the victims' ages correspond to Christ's age at his death. The killer amputates his victims' body parts in order to reconstruct Christ's body for Easter morning. Things get personal between the detective and the killer, when Prudhomme's wife's (Barbara Tyson) life is endangered.

Resurrection's shadowy visual style and plot inevitably invite us to compare the film to David Fincher's *Seven*. Both films include a serial killer who selects his victims according to religious significance, along with messages written in blood, a detective's wife in danger, and a crying scene that Lambert plays à la Brad Pitt. Briefly, *Resurrection* is not innovative. Nevertheless it is a suspenseful, entertaining film. Those who enjoyed *Seven* will certainly appreciate this film. Also, fans of Canadian filmmaker David Cronenberg should be on the lookout for him in his role as Father Rousell.

Ripley's talents are tedious after two hours

Believe it or not, Ripley is just too long. While Miramax Films fails to mention the movie's length in its otherwise extensive press kit, *The Talented Mr. Ripley* is a two-and-a-half hour plus undertaking. Director Anthony Minghella, best known for his masterpiece *The English Patient*, creates a visually stunning but emotionally bankrupt production based on the novel by Patricia Highsmith.

The story revolves around Tom Ripley (played by Matt Damon), a kid from the wrong side of the tracks living in the fifties who longs for the jet set lifestyle. Insinuating himself into a high society function, Ripley is enlisted to track down wealthy layabout and wayward son Dickie Greenleaf (Jude Law), who last time anyone heard, was partying in scenic Italy with would-be novelist Marge Sherwood (Gwyneth Paltrow).

Once he gets to Europe, Ripley attaches himself to the spoiled Dickie character and becomes obsessed with him. Here lies the ambiguity of

Damon's performance; he seems as easily fixated by boys as girls as the film wears on. If anything, Ripley seems to be a try-sexual (he'll try anything once). Still, his ability to mimic everything from voices to appearances enables him to endear himself to Dickie and Marge and live off Dickie's seemingly limitless family fortune.

In his yearning for acceptance by

his new-found privileged pals, Ripley also develops a taste for this good life and becomes determined to maintain the lifestyle by any means necessary. Ripley goes the homicidal route from there, abruptly jumping from San Remo to Rome to Venice and points in between, cluttering up the countryside with corpses.

Minghella manages to conceive a stylish and pretty piece of cinema, making use of the impressive visual backdrops that his Italian locations provide. If anything, Minghella may have been more preoccupied with recreating 1950s Italy and the details of the period's fashion and music than with the subtleties of his cast's performances.

While Damon offers a competent portrayal of the confused Ripley, the viewer becomes ultimately indifferent to his actions. After a while people will be hoping for Matt to knock off Law's brattish Dickie, who becomes more and more reprehensible as the film progresses. But once Dickie's sis-syish pal Freddie Miles shows up (in an irritating turn by the normally commendable Philip Seymour Hoffman)

you want the Ripley rampage to get going ahead of schedule.

This is Minghella's dilemma; does the audience sympathize with the villain or the victims? It's hard to feel bad for Ripley as the latter-day doppelganger who amasses the wealth and possessions of his prey. You want Dickie and Freddie to be done in within moments of meeting them. At times there is pity for the beleaguered Marge or the hardly-seen Meredith Logue (played by Cate Blanchett), but mostly you're wondering if this thing is going to end anytime soon.

If this movie were a drink, it would be one part Italian tourism promotion, one part 50s retrospective, with a splash of violence. Hold the compassion for the characters. If Minghella had made this thing a two hours or less single instead of a double, it might have been easier to swallow.

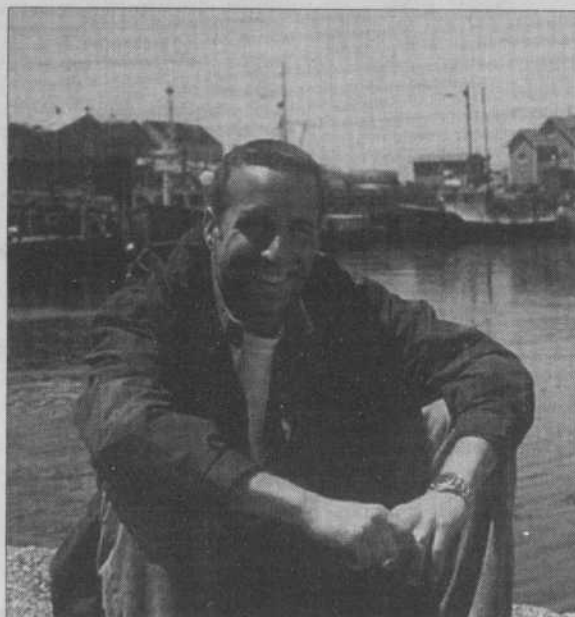

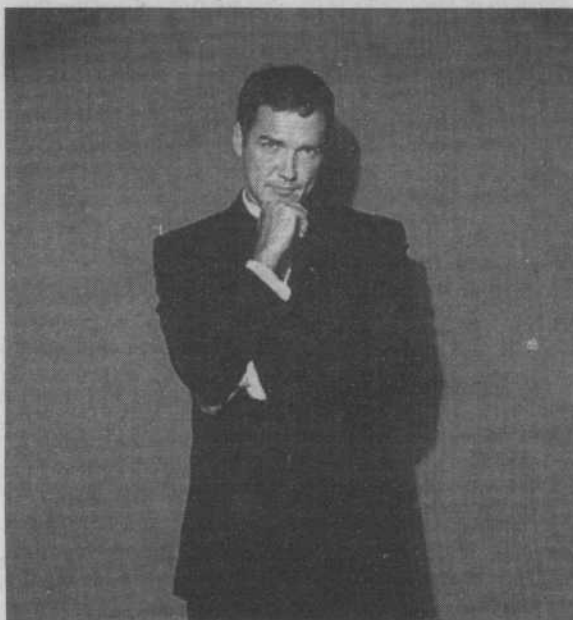

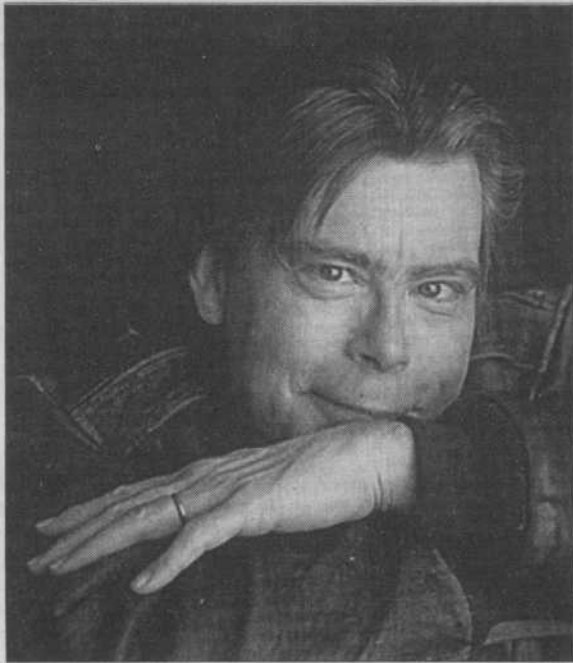

Elise goes the distance as runner Claiborne

Kimberly Elise (Beloved) scores a personal best in the title role of *The Loretta Claiborne Story*, an uplifting movie premiering Sunday, Jan. 16, on ABC's *The Wonderful World of Disney*.

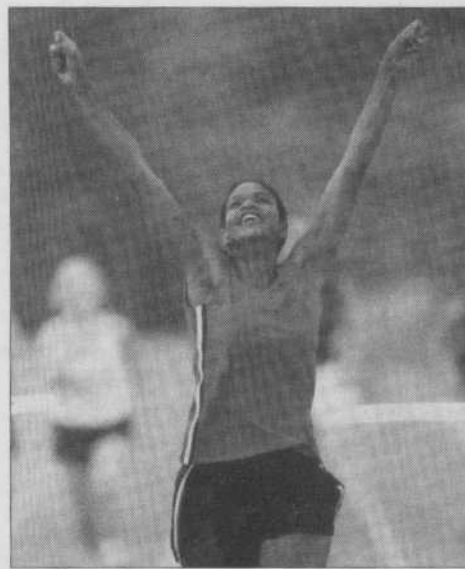
The film, directed by Lee Grant, also stars Emmy winner Camryn Manheim (*The Practice*) and Tina Lifford (*The Temptations*). Timothy Shriver, the son of Special Olympics booster Eunice Kennedy Shriver, is an executive producer.

Part of a large, poor family headed by a single mother (Lifford), Loretta Claiborne was born partially blind. Unable to walk or talk until age 4, she endures the predictable taunts and humiliation for her mild mental retardation while growing up, finding her bliss at last in running.

Her discovery of that talent happily coincides with the establishment of the Special Olympics program, which genuinely changes her life. She receives the 1996 Arthur Ashe Award for Courage at the ESPY Awards.

It's a story that easily could tip over into mawkishness or sentimentality, yet it never does, thanks to striking performances by its stars and bracing direction by Grant.

Manheim is terrific as feisty social worker Janet McFarland, but the role is al-

most a copy of her award-winning work on *The Practice*. More surprising is Lifford, who turns Loretta's mother, Rita, into a figure of iron will and righteous anger.

"If God only gives us what we can handle, he must think the world of me!" Rita snorts at one point, and you sense that she is right.

If Lifford and Manheim are excellent,

however, Elise is nothing short of extraordinary. The 28-year-old actress came out of the theater less than four years ago and has been giving breakout performances ever since. This one is no exception, making Loretta prickly and stubborn, not a martyr to her disability.

"Our goal was to capture Loretta's spirit more than to just do an imitation," Elise says, recalling the creative decision she reached with director Grant. "The things that I saw and felt coming from her when I met her were what I wanted to put into the character."

"I saw a very sensitive person, but someone who, at the same time, was very strong and confident. She was very funny, very smart and full of intelligent information. But what struck me most was her sensitivity. That kind of character is just so rare."

Elise acknowledges that playing mentally and physically challenged characters is full of traps, but she found freedom in the diversity of the disabled community.

"The

biggest thing I had going for me is that there is just not one 'type' of developmentally disabled person," she explains. "They're each such a diverse and particular individual, and that made me feel safer, once I knew there wasn't just one 'right' way to play the character. Each child that I met was as different and unique as pebbles on a beach."

The role proved physically challenging as well. While Elise has kept in shape by running for most of her life, she had given birth to a daughter just a few months before filming.

"The running was really rough, because my body had just been through this (other) trial, and having to do those scenes without having a chance to train properly and get back into shape was tough," she says ruefully.

And that same toughness keeps this TV movie running smoothly.
