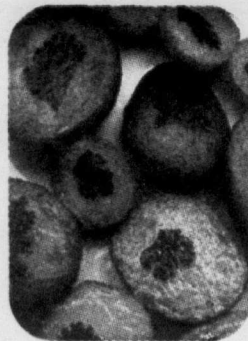


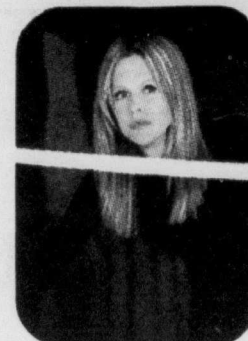

Fanny Collette at the Centre d'Arts in Richmond

Now that just about everyone has hundreds of digital images stored on their computers, on disks and cameras, pictures taken with old-fashioned 35 mm manual cameras are due to take on new value.

Fanny Collette is an amateur photographer and convinced anti-digitizer: "Photo is art, but digital photo is design," she says.

Instead, she likes to keep things simple. For starters, she only uses her old Minolta (manual adjustments only) plus two lenses: zoom and macro.

"The photos I take are what comes out, and once I've taken them, there's no changing the image. I do photography because it's my passion. I want to show people what I do."

"People who see my photos say that they resemble me, by the sensitivity and the gentleness that they see in them....But I don't have any 'tricks', so when people ask me to tell them how I got a particular shot, I can't explain it...I'm an autodidact."

Collette is a native of Lille, in France, near the Belgian border. "It's a long story," she says when asked how she has come to live in the Drummondville area.

But when it comes to her childhood surroundings, if it hadn't been for her father's garden, there wasn't much for a visually sensitive person to hang on to.

"It's a mining region, for coal. It's industrial and kind of poor. When I look

into my memories for visions of France, it's the Périgord region, in the southwest, near Bordeaux but more inland. The landscapes are so very, very beautiful."

Her parents' garden won the florales prize every year in their small village, and several years later, in Canada, Collette began to use her first camera to capture the momentary beauty of flowers.

Her other favourite subjects are children and landscapes - but what she appreciates the most are when something unexpected creeps into the picture.

"I don't take pictures where the subject has to 'pose'," she says. "I like to take them on the spur of the moment, and sometimes, nature has even rewarded me by sending a small animal into the frame just at the right moment."

One of her best moments came a couple of years ago in the fall, on a foggy morning when she woke up late for work and as she went outside, she spied some faded flowers that were surrounded by spider webs that had crystallized with the frost.

Though she was already late, she went back in to get her camera and took the picture, which won her second prize in the Wildlife Canada photo contest in 2002.

Collette's floral photos are reminiscent of David Hamilton's work, but she prefers to say "my eyes just get used to seeing things - and those are what appear in my pictures."

Give roasted potatoes a striking new look

Last week I had the in-laws over for dinner. For me, that meant I couldn't exactly serve up my usual meat and potatoes. So out to the market I went, to buy some ridiculously expensive lamb chops, young spinach to make salad, and a bag of little marble potatoes.

Sure, the lamb chops were nicely done, marinated in mustard, lemon and garlic (I'll give you this recipe later), but what really thrilled Mr. and Mrs. were my stamped potatoes.

Each half potato was slowly baked face down, with a leaf of herb on it, which eventually sticks to the potato and makes it look like it's been stamped or stenciled.

I used cilantro leaves, because I had them in the fridge, but fresh basil or any other herb with soft leaves will do. These are not only easy to make, but really look great at the dinner table!

They go wonderfully well as an accompaniment to any sort of roast, even baked fish. And remember: You can al-

INGREDIENTS (FOR FOUR)

2 cups olive oil (believe me!)
1 bunch cilantro
600 grams marble potatoes (or any other small, thin-skinned kind)
salt and freshly ground pepper
3 tbsp. balsamic vinegar

DIRECTIONS

Pre-heat the oven to 275 F. Wash the potatoes, pat them dry and cut them in half lengthwise. Toss them with salt and freshly-ground pepper.

Pour the olive oil onto a non-stick baking pan. Apply one leaf to the flat side of each potato half, then set it on the baking pan, skin side up. Repeat the process to all potato halves.

Bake uncovered for one hour, or until soft when pierced with a fork. Remove from the baking pan carefully, and serve on a platter with the balsamic sprinkled on top. You can use the oil left in the baking pan again, to sauté something, or even in the sauce for the roast that you will serve with the potatoes.

This soufflé is supposed to fall

Soufflés are magical. They start out as a wet mass of batter sitting in a dish. Add some heat, a little patience, and voila! — they rise to dreamy heights one could never have imagined when starting out.

But, for some cooks, the delicate process in creating the dish can be daunting. A reader's request for a recipe may provide a solution to this angst.

"I recently had a dish called twice-baked souffle at the Deep Cove Chalet and enjoyed it very much. Do you perhaps have a recipe for that? It makes an excellent lunch or light dinner with a salad, and would be a great addition to any recipe bank," e-mailed Margaret Trew Patterson.

Sounded familiar, but when I flipped through my old recipes I realized it was something I had not made since chefs' school some 20 years ago.

TWICE-BAKED BLUE CHEESE AND GREEN ONION SOUFFLÉS

Makes four servings
Preparation time: 30 minutes
Cook time: About 60 minutes
2 tablespoons (25 mL) melted butter

or extra-virgin olive oil
1-2 tablespoons (15-25 mL) dry breadcrumbs
1 tablespoon (15 mL) all-purpose flour
1/2 cup (125 mL) light cream or whole milk
1 teaspoon (5 mL) Dijon mustard
salt and freshly ground pepper to taste
pinch nutmeg
3 large egg yolks, at room temperature
100 grams (4 ounces) crumbled blue cheese
1 or 2 green onions, to taste, finely sliced (white and green bits)
3 large egg whites, at room temperature
1/8 teaspoon (.5 mL) cream of tartar
Directions: Lightly brush the inside of four 6-ounce (3/4-cup/175 mL) soufflé cups with 1 tablespoon (15 mL) of the melted butter or olive oil, making sure you coat the surface evenly.

Lightly coat with breadcrumbs, shaking out the excess. Place soufflé cups in a baking pan, then set aside. Position rack in the lower third of oven; preheat to 400 F (200 C).

Put a kettle of water on to boil for

the water bath.

Heat the remaining 1 tablespoon (15 mL) of butter or olive oil in a small saucepan over medium heat. Stir in flour until well combined. Gradually whisk in the cream or milk. Increase heat to medium-high and cook, whisking constantly, until the mixture thickens. Remove from the heat. Stir in mustard, salt, pepper and nutmeg.

Whisk the egg yolks in a medium bowl until blended. Very, very slowly, whisk in the sauce until blended. Gently mix in the blue cheese and green onions, and then set aside.

Beat the egg whites with cream of tartar in a large clean bowl until stiff peaks form. Whisk 1/4 of the whites into the cheese mixture to lighten. Using a rubber spatula, gently fold the rest of the whites in 3 additions until blended.

Spoon the soufflé mixture into the prepared soufflé cups. Place the baking pan with the four soufflés in the oven and carefully add enough boiling water to come halfway up the sides of the cups. Bake until the soufflés are puffed and browned, 25-30 minutes.

Remove from the oven and let stand in the water bath for 20 minutes. (The soufflés can be served straight from the oven, if desired).

Transfer the soufflés to a rack and let cool to room temperature; they will shrink. Cover and refrigerate for up to 24 hours until ready to reheat.

About 40 minutes before serving, position rack in centre of oven; pre-heat to 350 F (180 C).

Line a baking sheet with parchment. Using a thin spatula, carefully loosen the sides of the soufflés. Carefully lift them out of the dish and place, right-side up, on the prepared baking sheet.

Bake until soufflés are puffed and golden, 20-25 minutes. Serve immediately.

On the side: I served these soufflés with a salad comprised of organic baby greens, dried cranberries, thin slices of ripe pear and toasted pecans. I dressed it with balsamic vinaigrette.

Have the salad and the dressing ready to go before you start baking the soufflés the second time so you can quickly toss it together just before it's done.

Leftist lyrics are singers' stock and trade *Music*

Montreal singer-songwriter Paul Cargnello doesn't mind being disliked by some people. In fact, the 24-year-old published poet, political activist and former frontman for reggae rockers The Vendettas prefers it that way.

"I've outright said things that offended record labels. The music industry doesn't understand art. They don't understand what they're doing by shoving people into little marketing boxes," he told *The Record* recently.

With his second solo album, *Between Evils*, the native of Montreal's Notre-Dame-de-Grace area, again with his trusty acoustic guitar, once again blends folk, rock, blues, and reggae into a style that few dare to try or even record. He even writes and performs songs in both French and English.

"If I had to describe my music... I'd be vague," he laughed before adding that this album is different from his first solo release, *Lightweight Romeo*.

"This one is more political, more personal. In *Lightweight Romeo*, I was angrier, it was 'if you're not with us, then you're against us.' Now I'm more inclusive," continues the self-proclaimed "leftist", who has been arrested at public demonstrations on a few different occasions.

Cargnello, who lists The Clash, Jean Leloup and Dr. John among his inspirations, published a collection of his poetry, entitled *Driving in Reverse*, in 1997.

From 1998 until 2001, he ran the *New Socialist Climate*, a political newsletter distributed in Montreal universities. His most recent publication is a book of poetry entitled *Old Hat*, released in 2002.

Cargnello lyrics typically explore a wide range of social issues, from greed (money moves everything around me/standing straight up on my soap-box with the heat rising/blisters on our hearts the sound of finance surrounds me/while disadvantage is wide/I'm thinning/I'm tired of sitting back/while the few keep winning) to indifference (stormy weather never heals a broken heart/searching a world without compassion/since it fell out of fashion/watching the death of a nation/and a laugh track humming).

"I write in a more personal fashion (in the second album), it's a more sincere delivery. It talks about me, my own experiences. I'm more giving in my songwriting and people respond to that," Cargnello adds.

"The main criticism with The Vendettas was that we were too

preachy."

Cargnello's relationship with The Vendettas was one he would not trade for the world, but it had become strained after seven years.

"We were indy (independent) and our sound was so different so nobody gave us a major recording contract, but at the same time we were selling too much to be that indy, do-it-yourself band," he remembers. "That made it hard for us to evolve."

"It's easier to market a solo artist anyway, you're not expected to fit into one category of music."

While the lure for Cargnello to relocate to bigger and more lucrative markets such as Toronto and New York is constant, the musician is happy to be in Quebec.

"There's more respect for singers-songwriters in Montreal, they've created their own scene there. In Toronto, you really have to fit into a certain niche, but if you don't, then you're hard to market," Cargnello says. "My music isn't exactly punk like it was with The Vendettas. I draw from different pools of music and that's acceptable in places like Montreal and Quebec City."

While he recorded *Lightweight Romeo* with Stand Alone Records, the Montreal artist recently joined La Tribu, a record company with primarily French language recording artists.

"They tracked me down. They wanted to take a chance on me," he says, adding quickly that his relationship with Stand Alone was wonderful.

Although he could have dealt with a bigger record company, Cargnello was not interested in seeing his artistic freedom put in jeopardy.

"Usually, (big) labels don't work much for you. They may like this song, but not that one as a single," he says. "They'd ask me to tone down my political views and say that I was too confrontational."

Quebec insect man is inspiration for film *Movies*

Georges Brossard unscrews a jar and shakes out a tarantula, a hairy thing the size of an entree in a pricey French restaurant. He lets it crawl onto his hand and watches it with interest.

"She damn (well) knows it would be the last time she bite if she bites Georges," he says to a gathering of interested spectators, most of whom are hiding behind a photographer's back.

You can feel the crowd exhale when Brossard returns the entree to its empty pickle jar.

To Brossard, the fear is just another sign of the misunderstanding humans have of insects. He says it's just due to ignorance.

"They are so scared of tarantulas. They are so scared of beetles. They call them bugs. Bugs, bugs."

Insects are Brossard's life, not to mention his jewelry: A live, gem-encrusted ground beetle from Chile is sitting on his lapel.

He says he's had it for four years — he feeds it wood — and that he and the beetle love each other.

The tarantula he brought back from a recent two-month trip to Costa Rica. Same goes for a scorpion that he also keeps in a jar in his briefcase: He lets it sit in his palm for a while before grabbing it by the tail and putting it away.

One sting would be the end of Brossard: "an inch from death," he says, somewhat giddily.

Brossard is an entomologist who was host of a TV series called *Insectia* on the Discovery Channel and who has started seven insectariums around the world, including one in Montreal.

He travels the globe, collecting 100,000 insects a year and donates half of them to his insect museums; the rest he keeps in his house not far from Brossard, the Montreal suburb founded by his father, a successful car dealer.

Among his possessions are a group of shimmering blue butterflies, morphos, some of which he carries in wooden display cases, tucked in among the poisonous scorpions.

And therein lies a movie.

Brossard, 64, is the inspiration for *The Blue Butterfly*, a Canadian film that opens this month. It tells the story of a young Montreal boy with terminal brain cancer, played by Toronto-based actor Marc Donato, whose dying wish is to capture a blue butterfly in the tropical rain forest.

The boy persuades famous entomologist Alan Osborne (William Hurt) to

take him there. In the jungles of Costa Rica, they pursue the magical morpho and learn lessons about life and family.

The story is based on something that actually happened to Brossard in 1986. The boy, a young insect fan named David Marenger, is now 23 years old, his cancer in remission.

The story that became the movie was put together from Brossard's diaries of the trip; he also acted as an adviser during the filming.

The main thing he'd like to say about it is that William Hurt stole the role out from under him.

"That f_er," he says. "He took my place. It's my life. It's part of my life. I'm an actor. It's me that should have done it."

Brossard isn't kidding about being an actor. A sort of Indiana Jones of insects, he is a flamboyant personality, in wild contrast to the underplayed persona of Hurt.

While he says he understands Hurt's name is necessary to get people to see the movie he was — or pretends he was — outraged.

"You want me to answer you straight like everybody does, I will. 'A beautiful movie. I was so happy.' OK? No. Me, I'm telling you the truth. I was mad like hell."

Brossard was in Ottawa as part of a promotional tour for the film — some of the entourage call him Georges of the Jungle — and telling everyone about the true story of going to the rain forest with the dying boy.

"He grabbed my pants and said, 'I want to chase a blue butterfly with you,'" Brossard recalls. "I could not refuse him. He had the age of my son. Eleven years old. In his eyes, I could see he was f_. Can I say that? He was f_, life was finished for him."

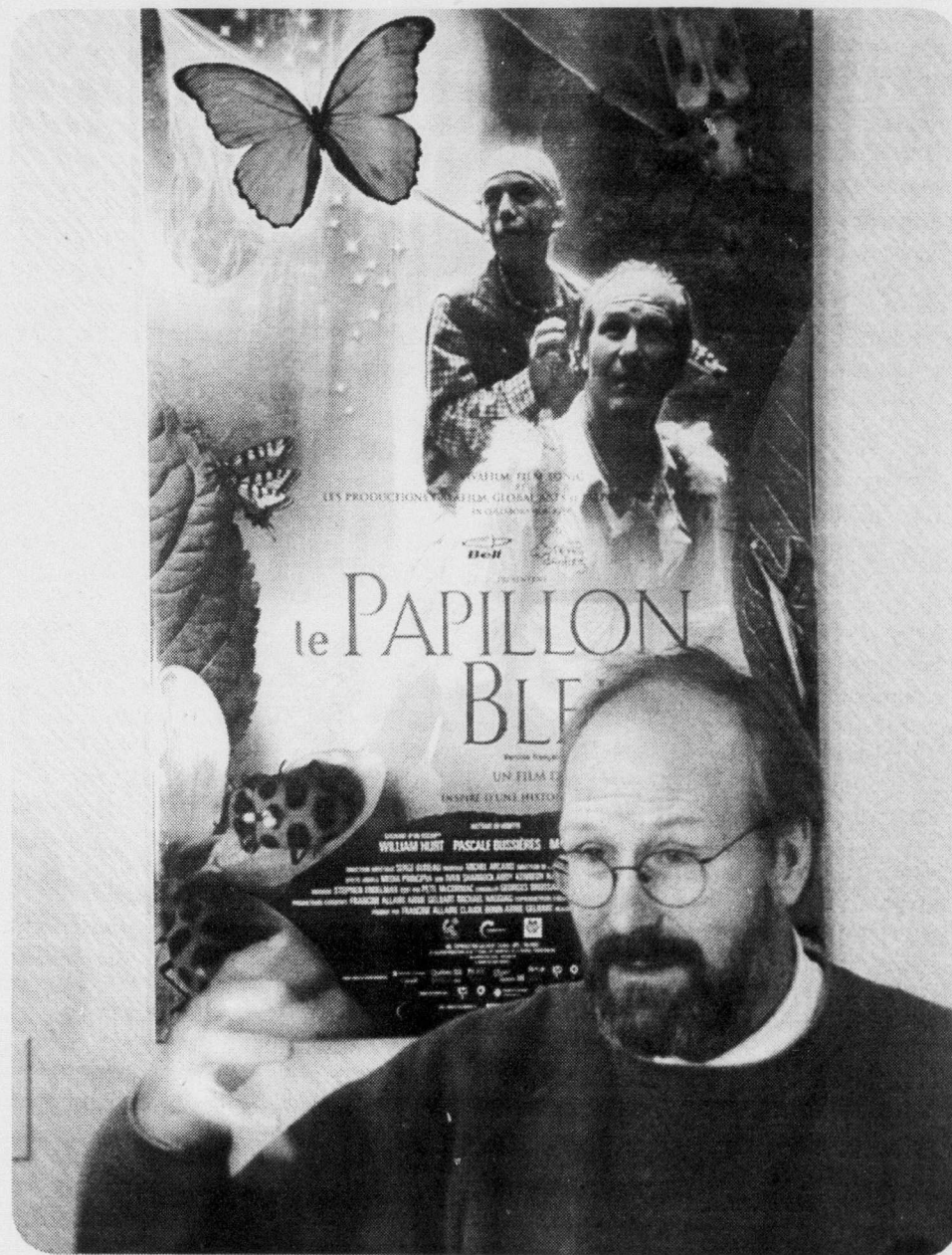
So Brossard took David to Costa Rica. Because of the boy's cancer, his sense of balance was off and he could not walk, so Brossard had to carry him on his back for 10 days.

But although they came close to morphos, David couldn't catch one. After five days, as Brossard tells the story, he stumbled and fell, hurting both himself and David.

"I was mad, and I said to him, 'Man you don't work any more. You lost faith. You lost passion. I won't carry you any more. Hunt yourself.' And I said, 'Get up and walk.'"

And David got up, and began to walk, and soon he would walk without stumbling, and then he was running, and then he was cured.

"No shit," Brossard says. "The bad went out of him, and he never died.

He is here today."

Brossard has a raconteur's sense of drama. Ask him if a morpho is as difficult to catch as is presented in the film, and he whispers: "And rare. And tough. He never lands."

He grabs one of his display cases, holding four morphos pinned to a board. "The butterfly never lands. They are gorgeous."

His full-time job is collecting insects and dividing the collection between his insectariums and his personal stash of 300,000, which cover the walls of his home.

"I go to South Africa and Africa in October and November. In December and January, Asia, Thailand, Singapore, Malaysia, the Philippines, Indonesia.

"Then in March, April I move to

South America. I come back May 1. One hundred thousand insects. Then I give one half to my insectariums in Montreal, New Orleans, Newfoundland, Africa, China — I supply them all.

"I established a network of insectariums. Everybody helps each other. It's my way. And I keep the rest at home. I love to be surrounded by insects."

Brossard says he can afford his lifestyle because "I'm rich."

Brossard worked as a lawyer before he quit at the age of 38. Now he hosts a TV shows and gives speeches about insects.

He says he didn't take money for the film.

"I want to reconcile humans with insects," he says. "That's my job."

Five questions with Larry Niles

Q & A

Larry Niles is a self-taught vocalist/guitarist from the Sherbrooke area. His unique interpretations and compositions are what set him apart from other musicians.

Now that he has reached the 'Happy 60s', he spends most of his time doing what he loves best — composing and sharing his passion for music with students and friends. He has played at Jazz Festivals, worked with Michel Dunato at Radio-Canada and used to appear weekly on Tele 7.

He will be performing at the Café Santé in Stanstead on Saturday evening, Feb. 14 a delightful way to spend Valentine's Day with your sweetheart.

The Record caught up with Larry Niles for an interview this week.

THE RECORD: What do you think contributes to your being at your best right now?

NILES: "I have been working in the music industry for almost 44 years now. I have not only worked with other solo artists but also performed as background for international shows, like the one I did with Neil Sedaka.

These experiences have given me something that I could never learn in any class, in terms of the ability to express myself both vocally and musically. I'm taking better care of myself now. I'm filled with energy as if I was 20 again, and I can devote as much time as I want to my composing."

THE RECORD: Who would you say influenced your music?

NILES: "As a child in Amherst, Nova Scotia, there was always music around us. My mother was a classical pianist and my brother played the guitar, too. I have always had a fondness for film music. Performers like Sammy Davis, Jr., Nat King Cole, Tony Bennett and Frank Sinatra were some of my favourites. Harry Mancini to me was the ultimate performer. It has always been a dream of mine to offer my music to film producers."

THE RECORD: You said that you have composed and arranged over 100 tunes as well as the two CDs that you created. Would you tell us about that part of your life?

NILES: "During periods of my most profound inspiration, I have been known to write as many as eight tunes in one day. I think my favourite project was my first CD entitled 'Free as A Bird's Flight'. The theme of it was very spiritual, full of compassion and harmony. The other CD was titled 'Urban Monk' which was much different and was per-

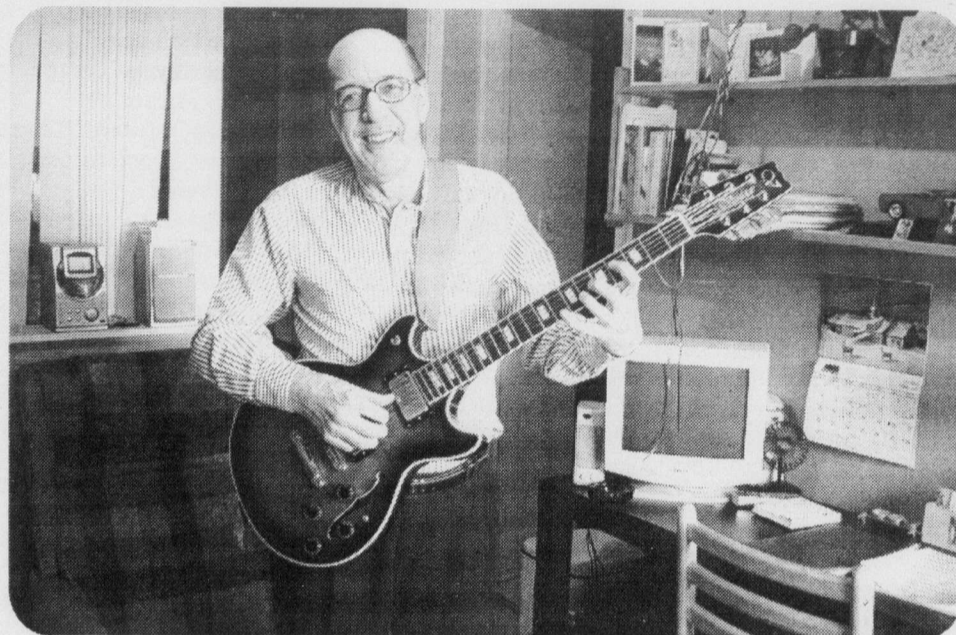
formed with six other musicians. I am currently working on a new CD which is scheduled to be published some time this year — totally instrumental. This will be a solo album, including many of my own compositions."

THE RECORD: You have some definite guidelines for teaching music to your students. Would you elaborate on these ideas?

NILES: "I always try to use pieces of music that I think my students will be interested in. If they are bored by a piece, it hinders their ability to really see the many aspects that it has to offer. I also feel that it is a good idea that a person wanting to play the guitar has a background in piano or some other instrument with chords. It makes the learning process easier by allowing the student to concentrate on the special qualities of the guitar. It also makes it easier to play with other instrumentalists because you automatically pick up on the similarities as well as the differences. Their 'ear' is sharper, making the blend of musical sound even more special."

THE RECORD: Will you be performing solo on Saturday evening at the Café Santé?

NILES: "I am pleased to say that I will be accompanied by Guy Breton, on the stand-up base, and Jacques Robert, percussionist, who, in my opinion, plays the best drums in the Sherbrooke area. It will be an evening of jazz, mostly. Some of my original compositions will be included in the performance as well as my interpretations of other artists. That is the creative part of jazz — taking a simple tune and rearranging it to add my own colour. I could never play something by someone, such as Chet Atkins, as well as he could but I can add my special flavour to the composition and give as good a quality performance as he did."

"Culture doesn't just mean one sort of thing," she said. "It means open to all sorts of things, whether it's music, or theatre, or dance. Without that openness, you can't really have a Maison de la Culture."

The underused church is the obvious location, since the concerts will provide needed funding to maintain the building, and since the church is so well-suited for concerts.

"It's a beautiful building, and the acoustics are fantastic," said Pauline Thorneloe, a member of the United Church and the Maison's organizing committee.

Quintin agreed. "There is a lot of atmosphere, a lot of spirit in that building."

The Maison de la Culture is a joint initiative of anglophone United Church members like Thorneloe and ordinary citizens from Cookshire, many of them francophones like Croisetière, with an interest in the community.

"We will pay the normal costs of using the church, so that will give the church a bit of income. It will also provide a chance for people to see the church who wouldn't normally set foot in it," Croisetière explained.

"It is an appreciation for culture and architecture that will bring the French and English communities in Cookshire-Eaton closer together."

This aspect of the project, the coming together of the French and the English communities is important for Quintin, as well.

"I always dreamed that both cultures would come together like this, and I find the situation very agreeable," she said.

Between now and the end of February, artists, singers and dancers, young and old, classical or popular, professional or amateur, French or English, are invited to contact the organizing committee to arrange an audition. The first show of the Maison de la Culture de Cookshire-Eaton will likely take place in May.

"We're asking people, if they have a talent, to sign up," Quintin said. "The first concert is open to everybody. We decided to do it that way, instead of inviting an artist from outside, because we want people to listen as well as participate."

Since the project is only in its early stages,

Asked whether or not his political views hurt his chances of making it big in the music industry — Between Evils refers to the political choice Quebecers have between those he calls right-wingers and conservatives — Cargnello dismisses the idea of selling his soul to make 'commercial' music.

"We are trying to move away from songwriting as an industry/art and I won't let that happen in my music," he says.

"Anyway, I've insulted all the capitalist apologists already and I don't expect conversions anyway."

Cargnello expects to perform in the Lennoxville and Sherbrooke areas sometime in the summer, until then, he is ready to head back into the studio to record another album.

"I already have tracks lined up for that," he says.

Cargnello's first public performance was with little brother Chris at an open mike night at Montreal's famed The Yellow Door when he was 11. The duo performed a song Chris, now 21, had written called 'Michael Bolton sucks'.

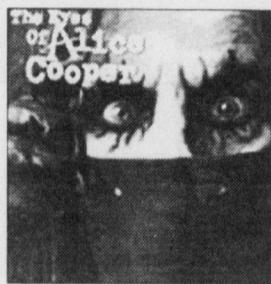

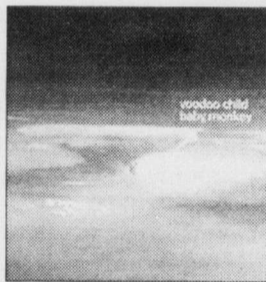
OLD CROW MEDICINE SHOW

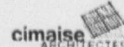
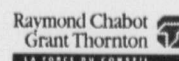

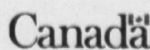

Wyatt's latest novel inspired by her father

Over the last 50 years, author and playwright Rachel Wyatt has achieved virtually everything a writer could hope for. Awarded the Order of Canada in 2002, she served as the director of writing programs at the Banff Centre for the Arts through most of the 1990s.

Her radio plays have been aired by the CBC and the BBC, several of her stage plays have been produced by theatres in Canada and in Britain, and she has turned out five novels and two collections of short fiction.

Born and raised in Bradford, England, she moved to Canada with her family in 1957. They settled in Toronto, where she discovered CBC Radio.

"I heard a talk or two on radio and I thought, 'I can do that,'" Wyatt, who is in her 70s, says, describing her early writing days.

She began by broadcasting her own short pieces. "And then one day I'd written something that I called 'a talk for two voices,' so it went to the drama department and was produced as a play, to my surprise."

Thus began her long love affair with radio drama. When a change in CBC management bumped her off the roster, she turned back to England, selling her plays to the BBC.

"And then the management changed again," she laughs, "and said, 'What are you doing with your stuff?' I said, 'Exporting it.' So then I

wrote some more for the CBC."

All in all, more than 100 of her radio plays were produced.

Her life's many varied activities have clearly contributed to her writing. But the inspiration for her latest novel, *Time's Reach* (Oolichan Books, 270 pages), came from her father — specifically, from a mystery he took to the grave with him.

Between the two world wars, he worked for a wool merchant, selling raw wool to buyers in Budapest, Vienna, Germany and elsewhere. He learned German and French for the job and spent much of his working life on trains and boats.

After his death, a photograph surfaced among his belongings that placed him at a Nazi concentration camp just before the end of war — a trip he never spoke about, and which no one in his family even knew he had undertaken.

The photo led his children and grandchildren to research his secret life, and though not much was learned, it became clear that he had been much more than a mild-mannered travelling salesman.

Wyatt says she and other family members believe the British government asked him to voluntarily report on things he saw during his travels. He was "not a spy, per se, but he always stopped in London on the way home. They asked him to just keep his ears and eyes open."

After making this discovery, Wyatt felt compelled to write about it, though she put it off for a long time because it was so close to home.

She tried to write the book as non-fiction, but since she didn't know all the facts — what he reported on and where exactly he went — that didn't work.

Eventually, she returned to the story with the idea of fictionalizing it.

The religious president

To better understand politicians, it's important to know who they are. Sometimes, it involves discovering their religious beliefs. In *God and Ronald Reagan*, author Paul Kengor, an academic with serious credentials in the intellectual world, takes it upon himself to reveal the relationship between the 40th President of the United States and faith and God.

Ronald Reagan was inspired religiously by his mother, a pious and involved woman in her community. Marching in her footsteps, the young Ronald also invested the best of himself in the service of the Church.

In those formative teenage years of his life, the future leader and mentor of the Republican Party envisioned the necessity of being a 'practical Christian', a person who can act as well as he speaks.

Understanding those early years is essential to acquaint ourselves with the man behind the politician.

It is often said that fighting communism was the prime motivation of Reagan's political life.

But there was obviously more. According to Paul Kengor, "The malevolence of atheistic Soviet communism stoked his [Reagan's] passions; it fuelled him.

And without it, America and the world might never have seen Reagan ascend to the Presidency."

For Ronald Reagan, denying religious freedom was sufficient reason to denounce the Soviet Union as being an 'Evil Empire'.

"To him the cause of freedom was inextricably linked with God, and poised in direct opposition to the forces of aggressive, atheistic communism."

And God had a special plan for America to bring communism down.

For those who had the opportunity to hear Ronald Reagan's speeches during his presidency, it's easy to remember the numerous references he made to God, faith and other religious notions.

Of course, religious beliefs also had an impact on other aspects of Ronald Reagan's political life. For example, he linked abortion and civil rights.

Where Lincoln fought to give slaves back their lives, Reagan was motivated

by a similar vision to fight for the unborn. And like George W. Bush today, he favoured public prayers in schools and faith-based initiatives.

Nonetheless, Ronald Reagan's religion was a personal matter. There was no intention on his part to impose his religious vision to the detriment of another.

The word tolerance could well accompany Paul Kengor's work.

This said, it's not easy to approach and elaborate on the relationship between beliefs and political actions. The secularism of contemporary life asks us to overlook this rather important and significant notion.

We are constantly reminded that religion and public life are to be treated separately. The reality is much different. To his great credit, Paul Kengor not only explores Ronald Reagan under a new light — his religious life — but he also puts back on rails the necessity of including religion in the analysis of public personalities and discourses.

God and Ronald Reagan is not only an excellent work by a meticulous scholar, but also a beautiful book.

Ryan a perfect fit to play boxing manager *Movies*

Meg Ryan is being herself this morning. Which means she's being warm and outgoing, with that friendly open smile and those sparkling eyes that crinkle up in the way that only Meg Ryan's eyes can.

She's looking quietly classy with her gray and beige hooded sweater, long beige skirt and gold medallion, whereas her neighbour — and the person Ryan portrays in the new Paramount release, *Against The Ropes* — is looking distinctly brassy with her clinging velvet top, oversized dangle earrings and heavy makeup.

It may seem an odd match — Meg Ryan, the kind of actress that pundits love to dub Hollywood's sweetheart, portraying Jackie Kallen, renowned in the sports fraternity as a tough broad for her audacity in breaking into the male-dominated world of boxing and for becoming the most successful female manager in the history of the sport.

But Ryan gets truly rhapsodic not only about the woman who inspired the movie opening Feb. 20, but about boxing itself.

"There is a real poetry in that sport," she sighs.

Furthermore, she was eager to adopt all aspects of Kallen's persona — from the short skirts and high heels to the bold walk to the feisty demeanor — to get her performance right.

"I love the way Jackie looks in the movie," Ryan says. "That prompts an interjection from Kallen. 'It's actually the way YOU look in the movie,'" she tells Ryan who then admits she felt "awkward" being Kallen when she did her screen test, but ended up loving the experience.

Still, the actress is the first to admit that she never expected to be in a boxing film because the world seemed so alien to her. In fact, she claims it happened almost by accident.

"I saw a picture of Jackie and her little dog and one of her boxers and I thought: What in the world is going on here? Who is this woman and what

is the boxing connection?"

When she learned more about Kallen, she decided to go after the film role.

"It was a sort of great investigation of a fantastic character in a really exciting and electrified world and I didn't know anything about boxing and I came to really like it."

Against The Ropes is a fictionalized drama inspired by Kallen's gutsy battle to follow in the family tradition (both her father and uncle were in the boxing business) and make the sport her career. The film chronicles her battle against macho prejudice in the person of all-powerful boxing kingpin Tony Shalhoub and what happens when she and retired trainer Charles S. Dutton decide to turn a surly street hustler (Omar Epps) into a champ.

"I was interested in playing someone who presented herself differently than me," Ryan says. "But I also loved the story of a woman navigating an oppressive male environment that wanted

to underestimate her, that wanted to put her in a box, and of her refusal to let that happen. I really liked that."

The film is set in the entrenched boxing world of Cleveland, but as she shot the film, Ryan was astonished at how much it reminded her of Hollywood — a place where women must still struggle to be heard.

"It's very easy in Hollywood to be categorized initially by how you look," she reflects. She herself was determined from the beginning not to seek a career as a sex symbol. "You can see that as an easy way in, but it can work against you after a while." She thinks women who assert their "fullness and individuality" are still seen as a threat.

"I think if you're an empowered woman in any environment, you can arouse the anger of people. I think you can be despised for your successes as much as your failures."

As for the cheerful, forthright Kallen, she figures that the essence of her life has been captured in the

movie, and she's seemingly untroubled by the liberties taken by screenwriter Cheryl Edwards. For example, Epps's character is a composite of several boxers she has managed; furthermore, the producers decided to make Cleveland the setting rather than Kallen's own home town of Detroit and then, having done that, filmed most of *Against The Ropes* in Toronto.

But it was Kallen herself who had her husband of 30 years removed from the script, and she makes no apology for doing so.

"At first I really did fight to keep my husband and my children in the story because they are such a big part of my life. I actually flew my husband out to California with me while the movie was in development, and said: 'I cannot leave this man out of my story. He's been my husband for 30 years and he's going to hate seeing the movie and finding that he's not in it.'"

A glimpse into Bertolucci's life

Is North America ready for Bernardo Bertolucci's new movie? "When you see what happened with the breast of Janet Jackson, you start to doubt," the director says. "It's something that in Europe that would maybe make us laugh."

The breast of Janet Jackson is as nothing compared to the goings-on in *The Dreamers*, Bertolucci's cinematic love letter to 1968, the year of protest and sexual revolution in Paris.

The film, which opens Friday, tells the story of Matthew, a young American who gets caught up in the battle that ensued when the French government fired Henri Langlois, head of the Cinéma-thèque Française.

The firing galvanized a cultural upheaval. Students took to the streets in violent protest; Matthew, meanwhile, hooks up with a pair of French twins, Theo and Isabelle, and they all take to bed.

The film features much sexual activity, full nudity and intimations of incest, among other things, and it made news when Fox Searchlight opted to show the film uncut in the U.S.

"I think there are movies for children and movies for grown-ups," the 63-year-

old director says on the phone from Rome, and despite the Janet Jackson uproar, the director says the movie is doing well in its early U.S. screenings. It leads him to believe the controversy over the singing star baring her breast during the Super Bowl telecast was a media invention.

"I cannot believe that millions of Americans have been calling CBS saying: 'We are devastated because we have seen for two seconds the breast of Janet Jackson.' Somebody told me it was because it was family time on TV. I said, 'Families, so what?' Children. Children have a very vivid memory of the breast of their mothers. The breast of our mother is how we started our life, the life of everybody started with that image."

Sex is only part of the message in *The Dreamers*, which reflects an important time in Bertolucci's life. The director who shocked the world with *Last Tango in Paris* (1973) and swept nine Academy Awards for *The Last Emperor* (1987) says the 1960s marked everyone who lived through them.

"The whole '60s were fantastic decade, but '68 was like the peak of that moment," he says. "Magically what hap-

pened in Paris in some way was happening in Italy, was happening in Germany, was happening in Berkeley California, was happening in Columbia University.

"There was a great illusion, a great hope to be able to change the world. It was a period of great dreams, Utopian dreams.

"It was possible for somebody who was touched by this wind of freedom and change to mix up, as I think I show in the movie, cinema with politics, with sex, with rock and roll."

Bertolucci says even those who were there, now believe the protests of 1968 were a failure. It did fail for those who wanted a revolution — "thank God there wasn't," he says — but he believes the spirit of 1968 changed the world at a personal level.

"I remember the world before '68. It was full of authorities everywhere, everywhere you looked there was an authority telling you 'No.' That has been swept away. It was unacceptable. And especially, the most important thing is the relationship between men and women, which are completely changed, completely different. So '68 had a great effect on society."

The director says that in his travels,

he has noticed this has been mostly forgotten. "Young minds are atrophied about the past," he says. "There is a kind of big general amnesia about what happened in the past, and that is quite dangerous.

"I can see on the other hand that kids are moving in the present with an elegance and a grace that maybe we didn't have, because we had the weight of the past on our shoulders. Today they move like fish in the water into the present."

Bertolucci wanted to be a poet once, before he met the late filmmaker Pier Paolo Pasolini in 1961 and became an assistant on his first film, *Accatone*. It was like assisting at the invention of cinema, he says.

Also, Bertolucci wasn't actually in Paris during the 1968 protests. He was in Rome, shooting a movie called *Partner*, starring French actor Pierre Clementi.

He said Clementi would go from Rome to Paris every weekend and return on Monday with stories about what was going on. The walls of Paris were blossoming with slogans, he says: Be Realistic. Ask For The Impossible, or It Is Forbidden To Forbid.
