McKellar's parents help keep him grounded

Socrates, and mining small-screen "classics" get writer/actor in shape for series

I'm not knocked out by Don McKellar. At least not literally. That's despite the Mannix-esque move he's executing on my neck, demonstrating a small homage to his TV-fed formative years, which he's woven into his CBC comedy series Twitch City.

"(Mannix) used to knock people out with one karate chop. Just like that - and they'd just drop, which we always thought was the coolest thing. 'Boink!' and people would just drop," McKellar explains during a break in production of seven new Twitch half-hours for fall.

The creator, writer and star is holed up in his east-end office with quotes from Socrates and Saturday Night Live on the walls.

That obscure Mannix tribute is typical of his series about twentysomethings living on the poverty line in Kensington Market.

GET IT?

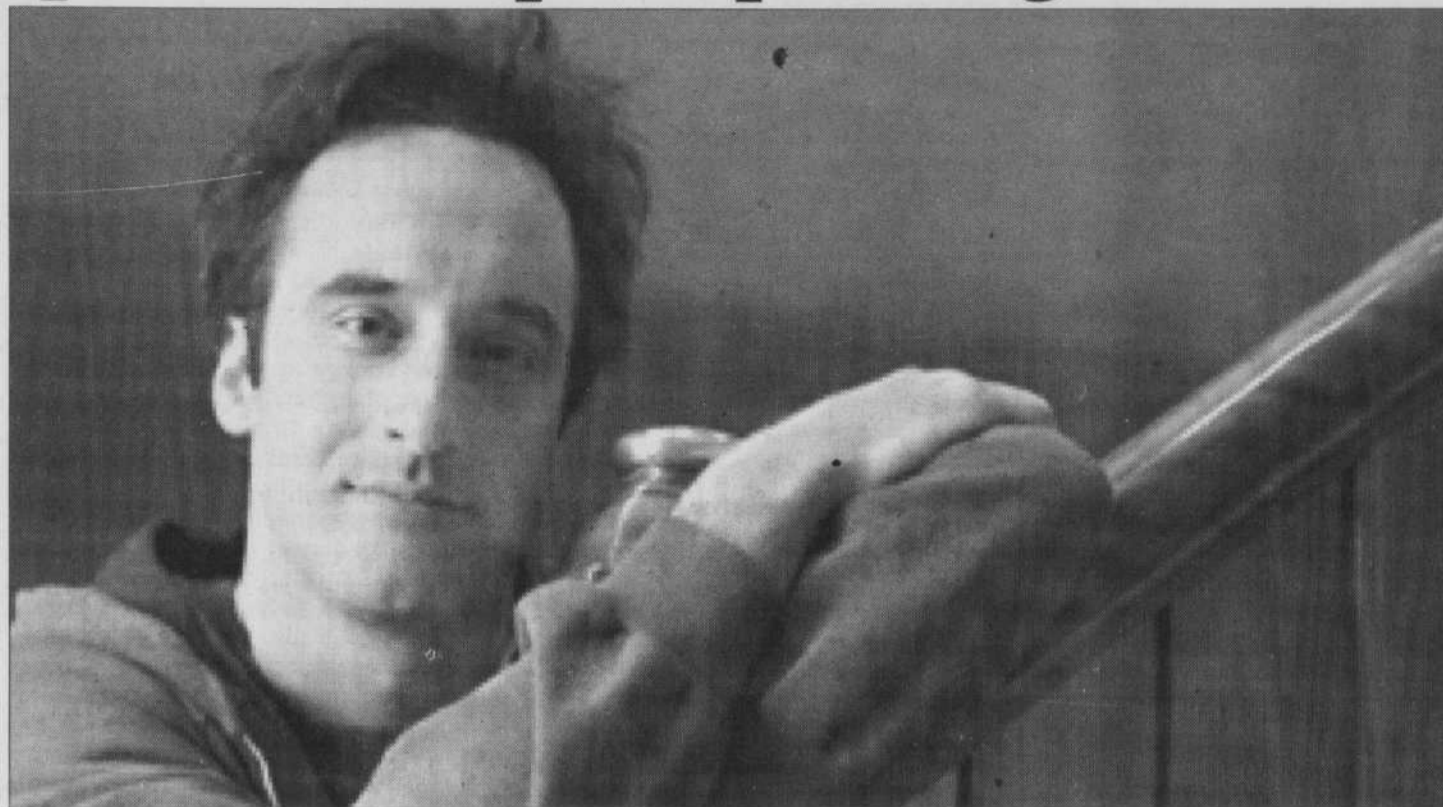
It doesn't matter whether you get the specific joke so long as you get the point - of people being isolated from the world, but feeling completely in touch with it through massive TV consumption.

Twitch City's characters continue to struggle. Curtis (McKellar) and Hope (Molly Parker) are a couple, but she's still underemployed and he's no more eager to venture beyond their hovel of an apartment. A succession of strange, dangerous tenants inhabit their spare room.

Former roommate Nathan (Daniel MacIvor) remains in jail for killing a homeless man (Al Waxman).

Twitch director and longtime McKellar collaborator Bruce McDonald likes to suggest that the show's apartment is a model of one his friend once lived in, something McKellar denies.

"There's autobiographical stuff, of course," he admits. "But I think it's sort of a horrible caricature of the way I was at one point, sort of a cruel self-parody of me at a point. The way people might

have thought of me or I may have thought of myself at one point. But," he says, leaning heavily on the word, "it's fiction."

The fiction is getting even more surreal.

"It's hilarious doing this series because it just seems it's non-stop stuff. One day, it's neo-Nazis, the next the Meals on Wheels lady, then it's psychopaths, a hostage situation. It's quite busy."

CATS RULE

One episode, Planet Of The Cats, imagines a feline-ruled world - really, what cat owner hasn't? (There's an Androcles and the Lion story behind McKellar's acquisition of his own cat, Pinky, a stray that wandered Kensington with one paw stuck in its collar. McKellar was the only person it would let get near enough to rescue it.)

Professional cats - 30 of them - came too close for comfort to the allergic actress Parker, who had to dose herself with antihistamines before shooting the Planet episode.

Unlike his characters, McKellar continues to ride a career high.

Twitch will air in Australia and, with more episodes in the package, other international sales are expected. His end-of-the-world feature Last Night, which won him first director honours here and in Cannes, debuts soon in Europe and Asia. The acclaimed The Red

Violin, which he co-wrote and in which he appears, continues its long run. Just opened here is The Herd, in which he has a role.

Despite all of which, the slight 34-year-old remains as unassuming as ever. Perhaps that's due to the particularly passive-aggressive support he says he gets from his family.

"Any time anything happens, I'll say, 'I went on this amazing trip to some film festival,' and they'll say, 'Well, don't think you'll always be staying in four-star hotels.' I say to my parents, 'Can't you just say, "That's really good," one time, not "Well, it's not going to last, it's not going to last?"' Every good review is, 'Well, there's going to be terrible ones soon.' Thanks, Mom. Thanks for reminding me."

Moranis and Thomas to reprise beer-drinking brother routine

TAKE OFF HOSER!

Almost 20 years after the original McKenzie Brothers film, 1983's 'Strange Brew', plans and financing are afoot for a sequel.

According to the Hollywood Reporter, Dave Thomas' (aka Doug McKenzie) Maple Palm Productions has finally secured financing for the film that will team him up with Rick Moranis (aka Bob McKenzie). Thomas is also in talks to get fellow Canadian Dan Aykroyd (SNL, The Blues Brothers) in as a co-star.

"I sent [the script] to Dan Aykroyd cuz there's a great part for a fast-talking insurance salesman in it, and he's interested," he told the Toronto Sun's Jim Slotek last October. The original film celebrated Canadiana - from the stubby beer bottle and jelly donuts to Oktoberfest in Kitchener, Ont., - while clinging loosely to the plot line of Shakespeare's 'Hamlet'.

The 'Strange Brew' of the title referred to a batch of tainted beer brewed by the Elsinore Brewery (shades of Ham-

let) under the guidance of Brewmeister Smith (Max Von Sydow). The beer was destined for Oktoberfest and it was up to the bumbling McKenzie Brothers - with help from a disguised superdog - to save the day.

The direction for the new film, set to start filming July 12 in Toronto, will be handled by Paul Flaherty (brother of Joe), who lensed Martin Short's 'Clifford'. According to Thomas, the new film will be "about a bunch of losers who try to launch their homemade beer as a major brand and f— everything up."

The McKenzie Brothers began life on the sketch comedy show SCTV, in a segment called 'The Great White North.' During the segment, the parka and touque wearing Bob and Doug McKenzie drank beer, consumed donuts and back bacon sandwiches and discussed similar Canadian related topics.

The sketch, created as a protest against strict Canadian content regulations for domestic television, ironically translated well enough south of the border to be included in the US version of SCTV.

The McKenzie Brothers were recently resurrected for a series of Molson Canadian ads and Moranis and Thomas were recently awarded the Order Of Canada for their contribution to Canadian culture.

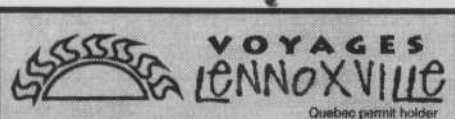

West Brome artist makes sculpture for the body

*Wearable art
incorporates nature
and history*

West Brome painter and jewelry-maker Myriam Bardoul calls her creations "art for the body".

Working from a workshop in her home, this 10-year veteran of the Tour des Arts fashions ornaments that pay tribute to the diverse roots of Western Art and, at the same time, display the whimsical nature of the individual imagination.

The Belgian artist arrived in Canada at 17, bringing with her the memories of visiting museums housing some of Europe's finest collections of Egyptian artifacts. Bardoul pursued painting and developed the technical understanding of color, composition and media that would eventually play such an important part in jewelry making.

"Right now, it is a mixed media world," she said, speaking from her home studio. "I envy young artists just starting out: There are so many ways to express things."

Bardoul started making jewelry out of beads, paper and cardboard, recycled jewelry, scrap metal, shells, wood and stone to provide a rich variety of colors and textures. Later, while taking a workshop, she discovered Fimo, a clay-like polymer popular among craft enthusiasts, and quickly adapted it to her needs. Using the polymer, she fashions light weight objects that mimic the color and texture of precious stones such as amber, turquoise, jasper and jade as well as natural materials such as bone, shell or ivory.

Bardoul transfers images or text to the unhardened polymer or imprints it with patterns from stamped or carved objects. The imprinted compound, once dried, may be treated with metallic powders that simulate precious metals which are then incorporated into settings.

Her tools are ingeniously simple: a hand-cranked pasta machine rolls out

thin ribbons of the polymer that may be cut into shapes to form the base of amulets. A toaster oven acts as her kiln. It is decidedly low-tech, but the results are surprising. Bardoul uses her knowledge as a painter to mix her own colored polymer clay and to simulate natural surfaces, such as the flecked surface of stone.

Historical themes recur throughout her works. "When I was a child in Belgium, I remember visiting museums with collections of Egyptian and Greek art," she explained. This fascination with antiquity has remained with her.

While giving a tour of her workshop, she displayed a series of necklaces sporting scarabs, the beetle sacred to the ancient Egyptians and symbol of the continuity of life.

"I like to make amulets - sculpture that you wear," she explained.

The history of writing is also an important theme in her works: the walls of her workshop are decorated with collages that incorporate facsimiles of 17th century Flemish manuscripts owned by her family.

On a recent trip to Mexico, she came face to face with pre-Columbian culture and as a result, has begun to incorporate Mayan hieroglyphs into her creations. Natural themes are important as well: her workshop is dotted with collected stones, shells and interesting pieces of driftwood which are both decorative and, in some cases, destined to be incorporated into an amulet or sculpture. "When you love to work with nature, you seek to recreate it," she said.

A perennial member of the Tour des Arts, Bardoul finds time to teach jewelry making workshops to adults at Bishop's University (Knowlton campus) and the Visual Arts Center in Montreal as well as a kids' workshop at ArtsSutton. "I really enjoy giving people the knowledge to make something of their own."

If we look back, Hill got four awards last year with her husband Tim McGraw for "It's Your Love," while this year only one of the six nominations is for something she did with him.

Hill's nomination with her husband is for Top Vocal Event of the Year for "Just To Hear You Say That You Love Me." They are in competition with Steve Wariner and Garth Brooks' "Burnin' The Roadhouse Down," the Brooks & Dunn/ Reba Mc Entire duet "If You See Him/ If You See Her," "Same Old Train," by Marty Stuart and various artists from *Tribute to Tradition* and "No Place That Far," a collaboration between Sara Evans and Vince Gill.

Actually it would be nice to see a woman get this honor considering the fact that Twain has opened the way for other female singers by changing many of the rules in Country Music City.

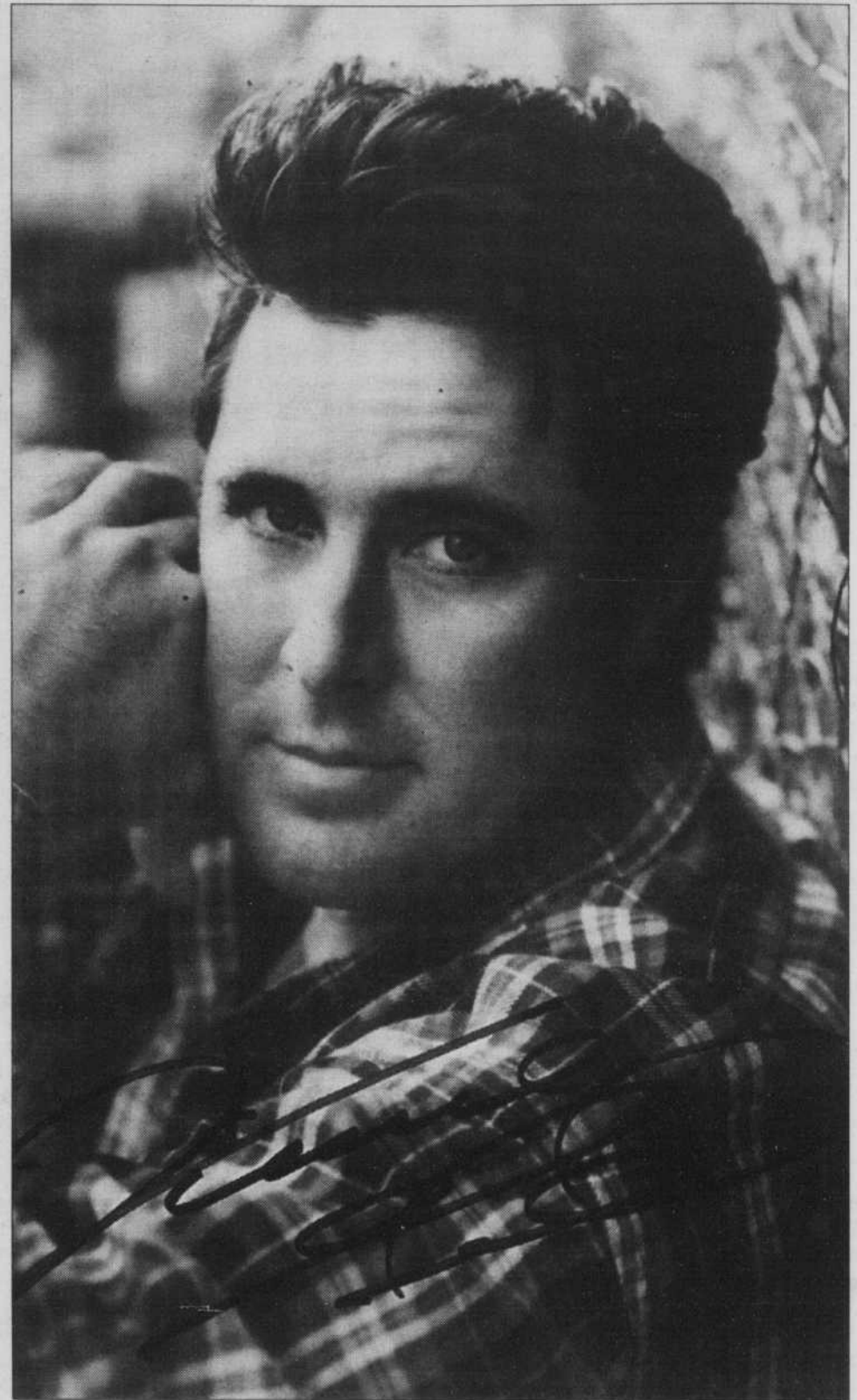

Boppin' Blues delivers a spring gift to Blues fans

Blues is without argument root music, music from the soul for the soul and here's a sampling of a few new albums:

Bryan Lee, Live At The Old Absinthe House Bar... Saturday Night, (Justin Time)

This new collection is Bryan Lee's sixth collaboration with Canadian Justin Time label and a logical follow-up to the previous album. This is real Blues music for real Blues people.

The music is as rootsy, soulful and smoky as you expect true Blues to be. Nothing here has been done to make it sound fresher or even break new ground; it sticks to tradition and it's mighty fine.

Bryan Lee has rare vocal qualities that allow him to sing the Blues with intense emotion.

The quality of the recording is exceptional for a live album and Lee has enlisted some great sidemen for this one such as Canadian Frank Marino and Louisiana prodigy Kenny Wayne Shepherd.

From the opening, the album consistently rises in intensity until the very

This is the fourth album for the local group Boppin' Blues Band with Mike Goudreau as the front man and lead singer and you might call it a spring gift.

It's aptly titled since it offers nothing but a reason to be happy... I mean happy to play it over and over.

Very faithful to the Boppin' Blues Band sound this new album offers a collection of 13 songs, 10 of which are originals. Once again they have used their winning recipe: a bit of jazz, some infectious swing, some blues and a dash of country perfectly spiced with influences taken from the 50s and 60s.

The product is pleasurable for almost anybody and you don't have to be a connoisseur of jazz or blues to appreciate it. Goudreau's vocals along with the impeccable orchestration will take you on a magical ride.

The group includes Richard Bergeron on drums, Jacques Jobin on electric and acoustic basses, Dany Roy on tenor and baritone sax, Maxime St-Pierre on trumpet and Mike Goudreau on electric and acoustic guitars and vocals.


They also enlisted Mike Goodsell on pedal steel guitar, Harmonica Zeke on harmonica, Carlo Fabi Jr. on organ and Guy Breton on upright base for certain numbers.

This is an excellent album, happy and fresh as springtime, one that will give you many hours of pleasurable listening.

Boppin' Blues Band are currently touring to promote their new album as they will soon perform in Ottawa and Gatineau before they hit the festival trail this summer.

Petty is passionate about show's new direction

The final week of her 10th season begins Monday, April 5, and Dini Petty, CTV's talk show diva, is already lamenting the time off.

"I said to my staff yesterday I'm really sad the season is coming to an end," Petty said in a recent interview. "I'm having so much fun. This is the best year I've ever had."

"We're doing the show that I always wanted to do, and it's doing really well. The thought that comes to mind is that I've really found my groove, my niche, my place."

Dini is marking the end of its first year on a new set, in a new time slot (she's now seen in the afternoons in most markets, rather than her previous morning slot), with a new approach. The emphasis is still on interviews - her strong suit after more than 25 years of chatting - but there's less emphasis on celebrity promotion and more talk about what makes people tick and how they can make themselves better. This season, Petty was as likely to welcome an expert in alternative medicine or a breast cancer survivor as to chat with Anne Murray or have the Rankins perform.

And even when the celebrities did show up, Petty tended to spend more time in interviews, seeking to relate to them as people, rather than just professionals with a CD to sell, a book to pitch or a tour to promote.

"These are the things I've always wanted," says Petty, 54. "I've always wanted longer interviews. I've always wanted to talk to the real person behind the interviews. I've always wanted more of what are you about, what do you believe, what do you think and feel?"

This season's changes are part of an evolution that has seen Canada's longest-running national talk show in constant flux in recent years. First there was a con-

scious move toward more Canadian celebrities, then a brief flirtation with a Live - Regis & Kathie Lee-style format, with Dan Duran as Petty's foil and co-host.

But this latest change comes from a more personal place, Petty admits. Her desire to help and even inspire viewers as well as entertain them is a reflection of her own life struggle and her desire to share the formula that has worked for her.

The former model and actress, three times married and divorced, says she's only recently been able to overcome the low self-esteem that has plagued her most of her life, despite the self-confidence that came with her job.

"Self-confidence is knowing you can do something," she says. "Self-esteem is when you look in the mirror and there is a value that you place on yourself."

In the past three years, she has been sharing her story in speaking engagements and, more recently, in a book and audiotape called *The Self-Directed Journey*. She'll spend two months this spring on a speaking tour aimed at raising money to provide copies of her self-help guide to women in transition homes and shelters.

Despite stiff competition from the likes of Oprah Winfrey and Rosie O'Donnell, audience numbers are generally up from last season. Petty believes viewers are responding to her own enthusiasm.

"If you bring me somebody or something that I think is fascinating and I have a passion about, I'll give you an incredibly passionate interview because my heart and soul is in it," she says.
