CoC hopes to get Magog out on skates this weekend

MAGOG (LS) — Organizers of the fourth annual Memphremagog skating festival, *Memphremagog en patins*, are hoping to double the number of competitors in the events this weekend.

Last year, over 60 people took part in at least one of the activities, and at times there were over a thousand skaters on the site.

Memphremagog en patins starts Saturday at 1:30 p.m. with a contest of skating ability organized by the Optimists Club for young people aged 7-15. This, like the rest of the festival activities, takes

place at a 500-metre oval skating track that has been set up on the lake at Merry Point.

Saturday evening at 7 several teams will go head to head in a "bed race". This requires a bed on wheels and a team of five people, including at least one female. The team members must wear pyjamas or sweatsuits and beach sandals.

"This will be very funny," said organizing committee president René Pomerleau. The Chamber of Commerce team, last year's winner, is challenging local compa-

nies and organizations to try and beat them. Anyone interested can register by calling the Magog-Orford Chamber of Commerce at (819) 843-3949, or just show up. It costs \$5 per team.

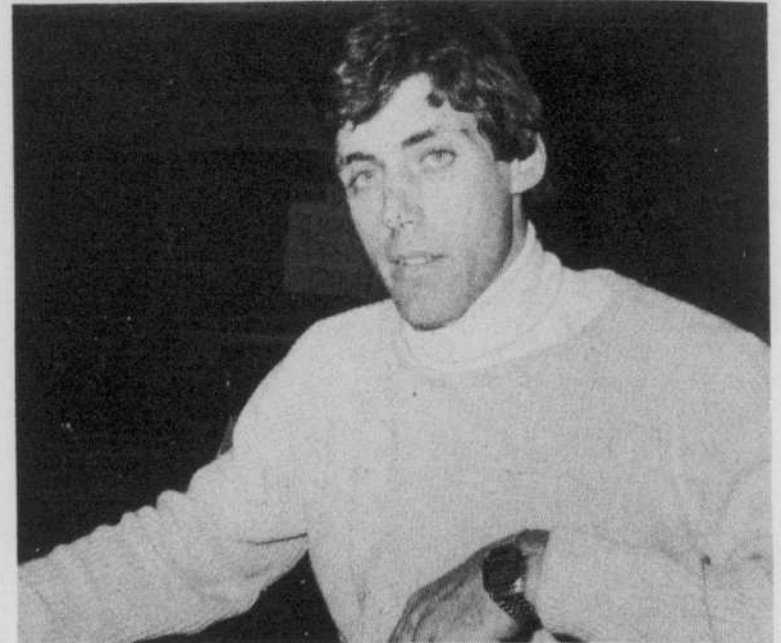
On Sunday, speedskating races take place from noon until 3:15 with eight categories covering participants starting at age 8. There's a 500-metre race for each age group, and a 2-km and 5-km race for some of the older participants. Skaters should try to arrive at least a half-hour before the competition, in case of schedule changes.

Registration is at 11 a.m. and adults pay \$5, children \$2.

The festival came about, Pomerleau explained, after the international marathon skate of 1983. This was meant to be a race around the whole lake, and the Magog-Orford Chamber of Commerce, along with its counterpart in Newport, put a lot of effort into organizing it. Things didn't work out as planned — someone sabotaged the ice at one point — and skaters ended up coming nowhere near Magog.

The next year it rained and the whole event was cancelled. Magog again missed the fringe benefits in tourist dollars that usually come along with an event like this.

The Chamber of Commerce then decided to get smart and make it

into a local event that wouldn't be such a major loss in case of bad weather, and would put more emphasis on local participation.

"We said to ourselves, we want to have a variety of activities that will attract all kinds of people," said Pomerleau. "At least this way we don't lose everything; the risks are lower."

The main goal of having the festival is to "create activities at the head of the lake", and attract tou-

rists, said Pomerleau.

A volunteer committee of about 10 people has been organizing the event, starting back in September.

They operate on a very small budget, covering some of the expenses with registration fees. A major contribution comes from the town, which has provided lighting and sound systems for the skating track.

The track is maintained throughout the winter.

Philometrists can join new association

The Philometrist is a newly formed association which operates exclusively by mail. The idea is to provide an outlet for individual members to exchange views and material.

Included with the membership fee, which by the way is \$7 per year, is a membership card and a quarterly bulletin that will guide and inform the beginner as well as the advanced collector. Also available at a cost is an album, cut square guides and a catalogue.

Parker's book on wine provides thorough index

As a collector of wine literature, I have come across a wide variety of books, pamphlets and encyclopedias concerning all aspects of the industry. Some are for the beginner, some for the serious student. In the latter category is *Bordeaux* by Robert M. Parker.

Subtitled, *The Definitive Guide for the Wines Produced Since 1961*, *Bordeaux* is the most complete index of modern Bordeaux wines that I have yet come across.

Parker, who is also the editor and publisher of *The Wine Index*, examines over 400 châteaux and approximately 2,000 wines. His tasting notes and recommendations are both thorough and insightful and are based on a lifelong familiarity with not only the top level wines such as *Mouton Rothschild*, *Lafite Rothschild* and *Latour* but a knowledge of the numerous Cru Bourgeois as well.

Not only does the author provide an elaborate vintage chart — based on a scale of 100 — he examines the historical development and present stature of all the major wines of Bordeaux over a 24-year period. Parker pulls no punches, defending wines that he feels are underrated and attacking those wines

which continue to draw high prices based on past glory alone.

Not even the mighty Mouton Rothschild escapes Parker's discerning eye and despite its traditional place as one of the world's premier wines, Parker chastises owner Baron Philippe de Rothschild for too many "mediocre" and "embarrassing" vintages.

The volume also includes valuable advice on the buying, storing and serving of fine wine complete with examples of a potential \$1,000, \$2,500 and \$5,000 cellar selected by the author.

If all this sounds a bit much, which for most of us it is, *Bordeaux* also contains a multitude of practical advice and considerable valuable information that will make the purchasing of wine, even for the amateur a more pleasant and possibly more profitable experience.

Concert to raise funds for costly organ restoration

SHERBROOKE—The Montreal Symphony Orchestra will be making an appearance in Sherbrooke this April, to do its part in helping to restore part of the city's musical and religious heritage.

The organ of the St. Michel cathedral on Cathedral Street in Sherbrooke is rapidly deteriorating, and a committee has been formed to raise the \$100,000 needed to restore it.

Suzanne Allard, organist at the church for the past 13 years, started the fund-raising effort. At a press conference announcing the MSO concert, Allard said she would like the people of Sher-

brooke and area to take this cause to heart, because of its cultural impact.

"The cathedral is a favorite place for large diocesan and other religious meetings; it's a place for large celebrations," says a press release from the committee.

"The cathedral is also a major tourist attraction and it's part of Sherbrooke's downtown core. It could and should become a cultural centre and attract noted professional organists who could bring the region new musical inspiration and encourage young people studying music."

LIMITATIONS

The organ is "really deteriora-

ting" said Allard. Although it can still play music, there are many limitations.

The organ was purchased and installed in the cathedral in 1918. Since that time it has never had a mechanical check-up and there hasn't been any major work done on it. The console is now showing serious signs of fatigue and there are some voices of the instrument that are no longer in working order.

Without restoration, said Allard, the organ will eventually deteriorate beyond repair, and it would cost \$300,000 to replace.

The committee has already collected over \$15,000 from various companies and organizations in the region. At the press conference Wednesday, Sherbrooke Trust made a surprise announcement of a \$5,000 donation.

The amount needed for the restoration comes to over \$1 per capita of the Sherbrooke population. The president of the committee, Serge Racine, said his experience in fund-raising has taught him that it is not easy to raise this kind of money. They needed some kind of hook, to get people to donate.

NEED GIMMICK

"You have to find a gimmick, an event," he said. "We have seen that if you offer them something in return, people are more likely to contribute." Having the MSO perform in Sherbrooke is just what they need, he said.

The committee's goal is to sell 1,500 tickets to the concert at \$25 to \$100 each.

"There have to be at least 1,500 music lovers in Sherbrooke," said Racine. "We think we have what it takes to get the \$1 per capita we need to restore the organ."

The cost of having the MSO play at the cathedral is \$20,000, and the committee wants to have this cost covered, through other contributions, well before the concert.

The committee is confident enough of success in its drive that it has already signed a contract with the Guilbault Thérien company of Saint-Hyacinthe for the restoration. The work is to begin in June, and should be completed by May, 1987. The restoration will take an estimated 630 hours of work.

THREE WORKS

The concert, at 7:30 Sunday, April 6 will consist of three works. The first is Haydn's *Symphony no. 95 in C minor*. This, as explained by committee member Jean-Luc Grégoire, is one of the 12 symphonies composed by Haydn in London, and one of the first written for the public rather than for a wealthy protector, attesting to the popular appeal of the music.

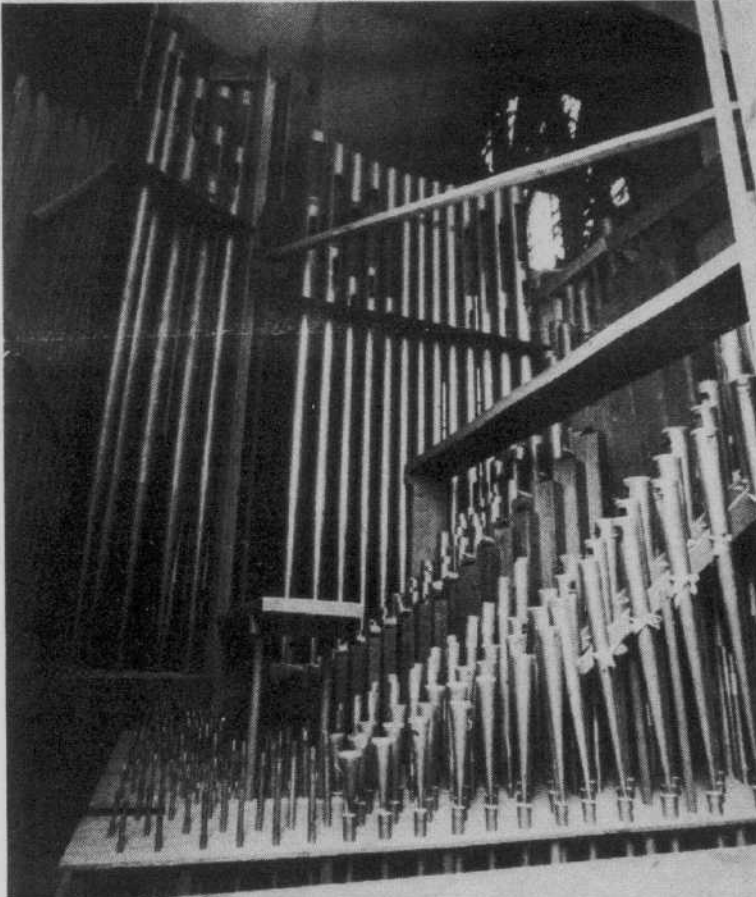
The second selection, Mendelssohn's *Concerto for violin in E minor, opus 64* is "probably the most popular concerto for violin ever written," said Grégoire, and will feature Richard Roberts as soloist.

The third and final selection is the very popular *Symphony no. 5 in C minor, opus 67*, by Beethoven.

Tickets are available at Sherbrooke Trust in the Carrefour de l'Estrie shopping centre and at the cathedral, 130 Cathedral street.

The pipes of the 60-year-old organ at the St. Michel cathedral have never had a thorough cleaning, and the console is showing signs of fatigue.

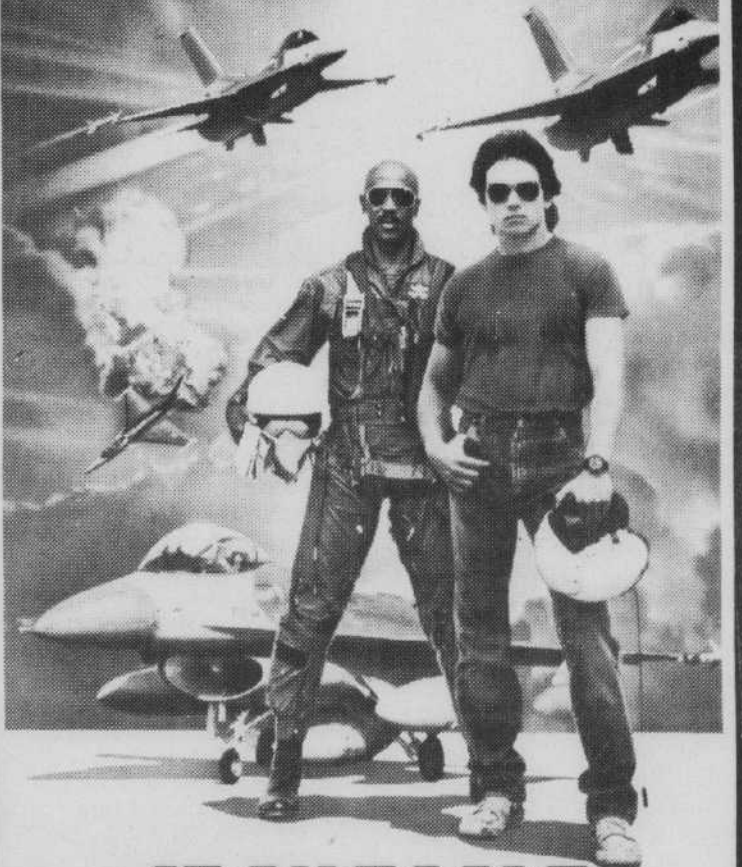

Davies novel lifts readers into other times and places

What's Bred In the Bone, by Robertson Davies (MACMILLAN): \$22.95, 436 pp.

When a reader puts himself into the hands of our most engaging writer of fiction, Robertson Davies, he is at once struck by the impression that he is in the company of a master storyteller, a tale-spinner with the talent to catch his reader up in a created world of wonders. Like the nineteenth century masters that his work seems to conjure up in its deftness with characterizations and masterful plotting, Davies can lift readers into other times and places with an ease that is startling and pleasurable to experience.

WHAT'S BRED IN THE BONE

What's Bred In The Bone begins with a full portrait of the formative years of one Francis Cornish in the tiny Ottawa Valley town of Blairlogie that is a rival to Davies' craftsmanship exhibited in the famous Deptford Trilogy for its uncanny insight into smalltown Ontario. Blairlogie appears to be a hybrid of Ontario communities such as Pembroke or Calabogie, and Davies gets to the social roots of the town with the careful subtlety of a skilled surgeon.

Peeling back the layers of religious, ethnic and class prejudices, Davies traces the strange family background of the Cornishes with reference to the warring Catholic and Protestant factions which shape the youth of young Francis Cornish.

When the novel shifts to follow the youthful Canadian to his Oxford University sojourn, Davies is as adept at infusing his book with the comic whimsicality of English mannerisms as he is at satirizing Tory Ontario oddities. But whether he is depicting the youthful Cornish sketching a corpse as Zadok Hoyle prepares it for burial, or tracing the strange practices of the natives of Blairlogie, it is with memorable characterizations that Davies makes his mark with **What's Bred In The Bone**.

The characters that inhabit this new world of Davies's crafting are a reader's delight of Dickensian grotesqueries such as Zadok Hoyle, the Boer War veteran who drives the delivery horse-cart for Devinney's Furniture and Under-

taking Parlours.

The biography of Francis Cornish, revealed by his "daimon", or custodian spirit, is distinctly Canadian in its subject and in its atmosphere, but the story is hardly encompassed by the shores of our broad country. There are wonderful twistings and turnings of the book's plot, leading into fascinating sidebars that feature such esoterica as embalming, astrology, counterfeiting oil painting textures, and lore about the pre-institution days of the early 20th century when families by necessity harboured mis-shapen mistakes of nature in their attics, away from the prying eyes of neighbours.

In addition to the Canadian locales, Davies spirits the reader off to the aforementioned setting of Oxford University, and to the Austrian castle where young Frank Cornish learns the questionable practice of refurbishing ancient paintings from another of the novel's rare characters, Tancred Saraceni. With Saraceni as his mentor, Cornish learns the skills that elevate him to the pinnacle of the art world, as Hitler's Germany and the sinister click-clack of loaded freight cars bound for concentration camps rebound around his ears.

Recruited as a "snoop" at Oxford, Cornish doubles as an agent for Britain's M15, listening out the windows of Dusterstein castle for the tell-tale noise of the death trains, reports of which he must make to his friendly "Uncle Jack" in letters sent back to England.

The cosmopolitan touch of international intrigue at the end of Robertson Davies' book is just a bonus addition to a fine novel of Canadian manners. **What's Bred In The Bone** probes into many worlds and stirs up countless ideas, all in the guise of a fictional biography of a famous Canadian; no wonder, then, that Robertson Davies has triggered fresh interest in his interesting body of work with this best-selling, enjoyable novel.

RECORD REVIEWS

Feargal Sharkey FEARGAL SHARKEY (A&M-Virgin)

A great many influences have combined to make sure this exceptional solo album debut by Derry Ireland's Feargal (pronounced FUR-GULL) Sharkey was released to delight record buyers looking for fresh, talented acts.

Sharkey, coaxed into this project by Eurythmic's guitarist Dave Stewart, has chosen a song written by stunning Lone Justice Star Maria McKee, titled "A Good Heart", which is also the must played video release.

Sharkey's voice is a bit of a cross between the lyrical side of Chris DeBurgh and the rocky propensities of the Joe Cocker sound, heavy accents intact on a vocal blend that commands attention. The songs

and production on Sharkey's album have been handled with the kind of perception that went into the last couple of top 10 singles that he was associated with: Madness and Roger Taylor of Queen's hits "Listen To Your Father" and "Loving You". One of the songs that sits right up and begs for attention here is a Chrissy Hynde tune, "Made To Measure", that brings out the dynamics in Feargal Sharkey's voice — a voice that has been in need of a permanent home since the demise of his band The Undertones in the summer of 1983.

Thanks to the perception of Dave Stewart, Feargal Sharkey will now be heard on his own merits, judging from the impact that this album is having. Even the old Stones' anthem "It's All Over Now", one of their earliest raunchy successes, is handled well by Sharkey, becoming less of a churning, grinding tune, and more of an even-textured pop song with layer after layer of synthesizers and a wall of background sound.

But the Myriad fans of Chris DeBurgh will find themselves twisting that FM dial back a bit to get a better listen to this voice of Feargal Sharkey's which sounds remarkably like the early work of the Dublin native. Not that there should be any hard feelings about an innovative solo voice joining the likes of Paul Young in making the music coming from the United Kingdom and the not-so-united emerald isle as exciting as any coming from other locales.



Bruce Cockburn **WORLD OF WONDERS (TRUE NORTH-COLUMBIA)**

Bruce Cockburn has racked up almost as many Canadian Folksinger Of The Year Awards as Gordon Lightfoot during his sixteen year career as a recording artist. With **WORLD OF WONDERS**, his sixteenth album, Cockburn, has cloaked his vitriolic assaults on the world's woes in something far more akin to rock 'n' roll than the initial forays he made into folk when he vied with Gordon for the folkie titles. The folk monicker still holds true — like Tom Paxton, Dylan or the writers of the folkie sixties, Cockburn looks out on a very

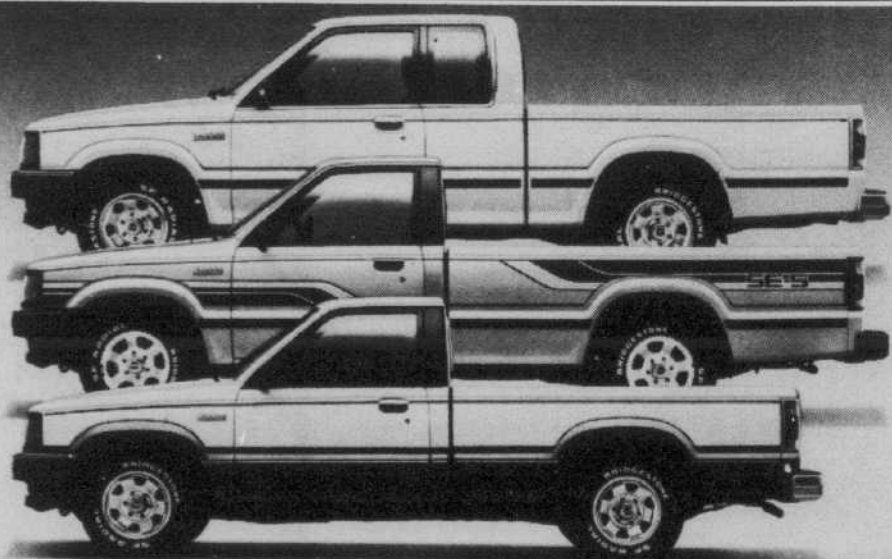
imperfect world — a world that may be full of wonders, but that is as readily an affront to the sensibilities of one of our most observant poet/singer/songwriters.

The familiar Canadian place notations that Cockburn usually uses to anchor his songs against a particular topography (Burrit's Rapids, January; Toronto, July) give way to international datelines that have seen the artist tour the Caribbean, South America, 2 Germanies, and the United States, as these diverse songs attest.

Whether the song is a hard-hitting, bitter-edged look at the free world — "Call It Democracy", or the current video vehicle, "People See Through You", which could be interpreted as Bruce's latest indictment of our sprawling neighbour to the south, the one thing a listener gets with Cockburn's songs is commitment. Another thing he gets is brilliantly etched word pictures — witness this verse from the caustic look at "Berlin Tonight" — "Dull twilight spits hesitant sulphur rain/sky been down around our ears for weeks/only once — gap-glimpsed moon over that anal-retentive wall/as we laughed through some midnight checkpoint under yellow urban cloud".

Swaying rhythms, acrid monologues about Jamaican Easter scenes, an imagistic title tune, and a bitter-sweet ballad to "Lily Of The Midnight Sky", are but part of the musical **WORLD OF WONDERS** spun out by Ottawa native Bruce Cockburn — who may be seen, by the way, at Montreal's The Spectrum for two shows on March 15th, as part of Cockburn's CANADA FIRST tour which kicks off on February 21st in Victoria, B.C.

Group offers rare chance to hear live chamber music

SHERBROOKE — A chamber music group composed of local musicians will perform its first major concert at the Centennial Theatre next Friday, Feb. 21 at 8:30.

Sherbrooke pianist France Dupuis came up with the idea of a chamber music group, contacted other musicians she knew, and about a year ago a group of five was formed.

The reason behind it was mainly to give some area musicians a chance to play music in a group, rather than practising alone all the time. Not everyone can play for the Sherbrooke Symphony Orchestra, she said, although most of these have at one time or another. But they still have a need to play and

perform.

"It's important to play as a group," she said, "and not always to practise alone, long hours and long years. Now we can work together and benefit from playing together and we think that the people who go to the concert will benefit too."

SMALL ROOM IDEAL

As the name suggests, chamber music is music that can be played in rooms or small halls as opposed to concert halls. Ideally, said Dupuis, you would play in a room that would hold small groups of no more than 50, but the Centennial theatre is fine for their purposes.

The group gave a concert last summer at the Festival Lac Massawippi, but Dupuis says this is their first real chance to reach the

Sherbrooke-Lennoxville population.

The concert will feature three selections, one trio, one quartet and one quintet.

The first selection is Mozart's *Trio, K. 498, in E flat major*, a trio for viola, piano and clarinet, with Zofia Wierzbicka on viola, France Dupuis on piano and Paul Danse-reau on clarinet. The viola and clarinet combination is rather rare, said Dupuis, so it has an interesting and different sound. Danse-reau was asked to join the groups specifically for this concert.

The second selection is Gabriel Fauré's *Piano quartet in C minor, opus 15*. This is a work that is not very well-known, says Dupuis, and the group has "discovered" it through practising. "It's good to learn a new repertoire, for ourselves and for the people who come to hear us," she said. "We can communicate that discovery to other people."

It features Dupuis on piano, Annie Pierard-Ledoux on violin, Danielle Dion on viola, Zofia Wierzbicka on cello and Claude Proulx on double bass.

FEATURES BASS

The final selection is Schubert's quintet, *The Trout*. This one puts Proulx's talents on the bass to the test. "There's very little chamber music for bass," he said. "This is a very good opportunity for me to play chamber music. It's also one of the finest pieces of music for bass." The quintet also features the

piano, violin, viola and cello.

The six members of the group have all had extensive musical education, and experience with the Sherbrooke Symphony or other orchestras. Wierzbicka, who is of Polish origin, spent 10 years second soloist with the Antwerp Symphony Orchestra in Belgium.

In a recent interview, Dupuis, Proulx and Wierzbicka agreed that the particular attraction of chamber music for them is the close personal interaction it requires, and the freedom of interpretation.

LIKE SOLOISTS

"In chamber music everyone has a personal relationship and each one can say what he thinks," said Proulx.

"It gives us the chance to express ourselves and not be obliged to adapt to someone else (i.e. a conductor)," said Wierzbicka.

Chamber music is demanding, however, as there are no backups for any of the members; "You're really all soloists," said Dupuis. "You have to work very hard — as hard as any soloist."

Dupuis says she hopes this concert will be a step in introducing the area population to live chamber music, and perhaps will encourage others to form groups.

"We hope it will inspire people to ask for much more chamber music," she said. "I think it's one of the most interesting ways of doing music."

The concert is at 8:30 on Feb. 21 and tickets are \$2 and \$3.

Original musical play *Beatrice* opens here in April

SHERBROOKE — *Beatrice*, a musical play set to open in April here, is going to spotlight a lot of local talent for the home audience, and then set off on an international tour.

That's if everything goes as writer and producer Bryant Neal plans.

Originally scheduled to open at the end of this month, *Beatrice* has been delayed because mechanical parts for the stage are not yet available from the States.

And the stage is an important element in this play, which is expected to be full of technical wizardry and innovative, energetic music and dance numbers.

Beatrice is a love story, said Neal in an interview. The story begins with a student named Beatrice falling in love with a working man. The story that ensues follows them through the trials of trying to reconcile their two worlds.

VERY MODERN

"There's a conflict of interest. Each one tries to change the other's aspirations," said Neal. "It's very modern, very emotional. It's a play that's going to make you laugh and make you cry."

Neal is a former navy pilot from Los Angeles who now has a management company, BN Productions, that promotes and plans tours for local performers. While living in the States he became interested in performers coming out of Canada, and now is committed to helping them make a name for themselves at home.

This is Neal's first musical play, and he's gone all out to make it a success. As a form of promotion, an album by the same name as the play was released just a week ago, featuring nine of the 18 songs that will be in the play. A double album is planned for after the play's opening.

There are 74 people in all involved in the production, said Neal, some from the Townships and others from outside the region.

One of the familiar local names featured on the album is Roy Robi, the former Platters member who has taken up residence and continued performing around the Townships. He is featured in the title track of the album.

Raymond Fabi, who arranged some of the music, was originally

from the Sherbrooke area. Mario Rubnikowich, the owner of Studio Works in Montreal, where the record was produced, used to run MR Studios in Lennoxville, where he was born and raised.

GIVE EXPOSURE

Martin Richards, on keyboards, is a local boy, and Nathalie Goudreau, a singer, is from the Sherbrooke area.

Yvan and Alain Belanger, who wrote the music for Neal's lyrics, are Sherbrooke residents.

Neal said he has put a few amateurs into the show along with the professionals, because he wants to give them the exposure they deserve. When this play finishes, he says, they will have an international tour and two albums to their credit, which will give them a boost

in their careers.

Although there is a plot line to the play, the characters and concrete details of the story are indistinct enough that the universal themes can come through, says Neal. "We don't want to be specific," he said. "You can relate this story to your own lifestyle."

The message comes across primarily through the music and dance, Neal said. There's only a bit of narration at one point.

LIVE MUSIC

Six professional dancers have been hired to perform the two parts, because it would be too strenuous for only two to keep up the pace through the tour Neal has planned. All the music will be performed live.

There will be some technical sur-

prises involving the stage, and special lighting effects.

There will be something in the play to please everyone, said Neal. Many types of music are represented including ballads, dance music, funk, traditional Quebecois-style music and commercial rock.

The play is already booked for 9 days in Quebec, 10 days across Canada, 15 days in the U.S. and 22 days in Europe, covering 17 countries, said Neal.

The delay in the play's opening caused some publicity problems, said Neal, since they had already started advertising it for the end of February. But this will give the cast even more time to polish their performance.

The album should be in Sherbrooke stores in a couple of weeks,



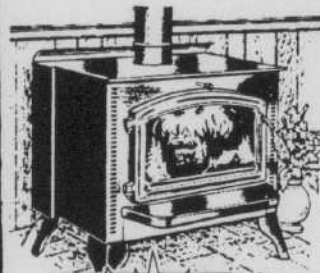

and it will also be available at the play. The location and date of the Sherbrooke performance has yet to be determined.

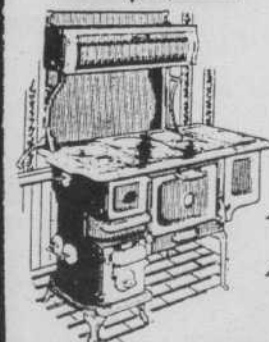

Sutton artist first in Granby series

Sense of *joie de vivre* pervades Morisset's work

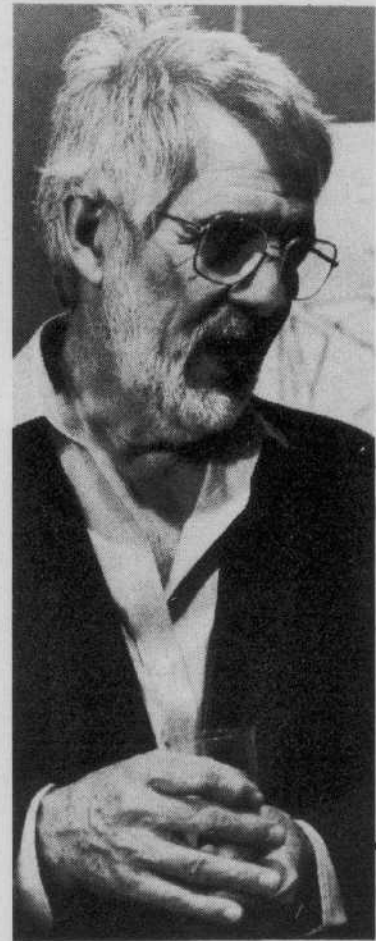
GRANBY — After making a career for himself in interior design, a return to painting is, for Bernard Morisset, a chance to make his own rules.

"When you design, you must do something to please a certain person," he said. "It's subject to their approval. With painting, you feel completely free to do what you want to. I can go to the limit of my own fancy, to express in full liberty how I think and what I feel."

"When painting, the world is yours; you can do anything."

Morisset, a resident of Sutton for the past four years, is the first artist featured in the 1986 *Événements du hall* program in the foyer of the provincial government building in Granby.

About 20 of his watercolor and gouache paintings are displayed

TAUGHT DESIGN

Morisset is originally from Quebec city. During his college education he studied painting with the likes of Paul-Emile Borduas, and participated in group exhibitions at the Dominion Gallery, the Montreal Museum of Fine Arts and the University of Montreal among others. He later went into interior design, and taught in this field for many years.

He returned to painting in 1971, taking part in further exhibitions, both group and solo. But now it has been eight years since he has shown his work.

Morisset prefers to use gouache — a paint much like watercolor except that it's more opaque and doesn't blend when one color is painted over another.

His paintings use bright colors, laid on in bold, wide strokes that almost give the impression of finger-painting. They are generally abstract, sometimes with a recognizable form (human, for example) dominating, and other times consisting primarily of geometric patterns, or amorphous shapes.

He uses almost every color of the rainbow, with only a little black in a couple of paintings. This he attributes to his state of mind when he did them.

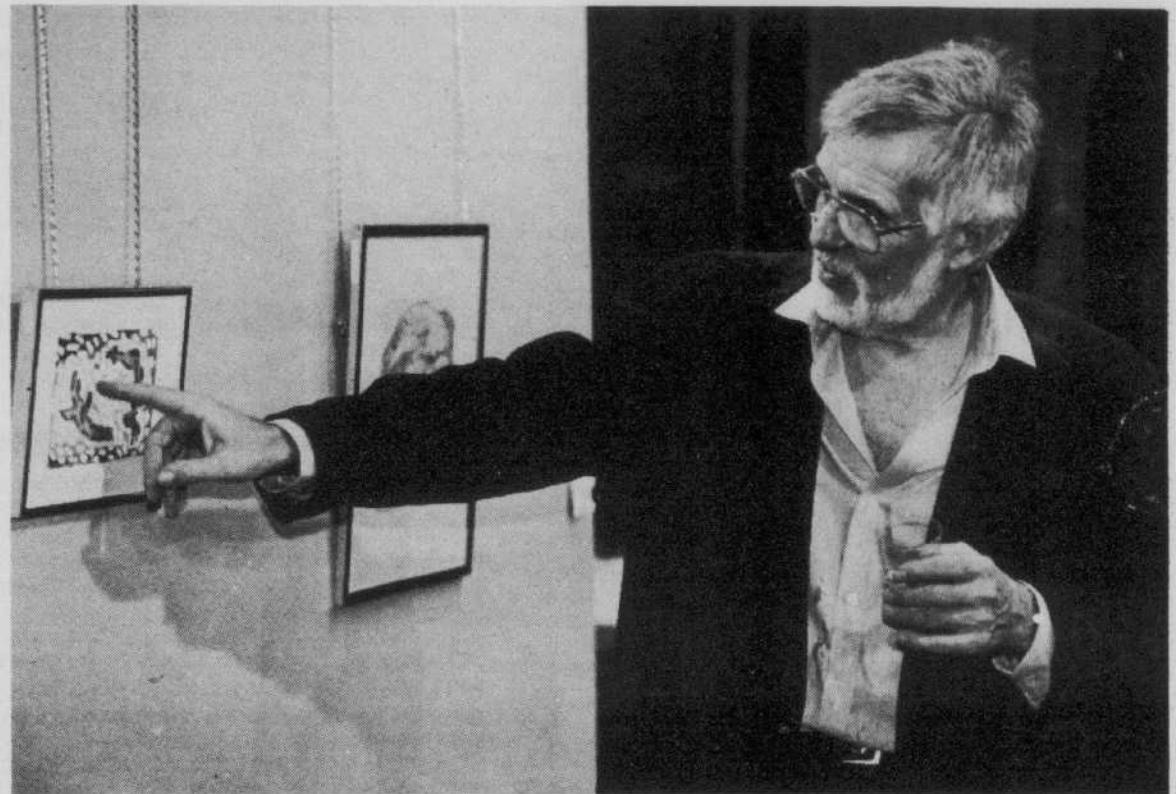
"I think what I've done here is express *joie de vivre*; a certain disposition to be happy," he said. "I felt like that when I did this series. I was happy and I felt free."

One painting entitled *Joie de vivre* depicts, with a couple of strokes, a human figure with arms raised in an attitude of exultation.

This theme, he stressed, is something he recognized after he did the paintings — not a plan he decided on beforehand.

"I'm not working consciously to build something precise and develop a concept," he said. "It's spontaneous. This is what painting is all about."

Morisset was interviewed at the launching of the 1986 season of the *Événements du hall* series. The series began in 1984, the initiative of a group of people from Communication-Québec, the *Loisirs de Granby* (recreational association) and some local artists.

Nicole Saint-Jacques, one of the series' organizers, said the goal of the series is to reach people who would not normally visit art galleries.

BECOME KNOWN

"We want to reach, not people who are connoisseurs, but people who appreciate beautiful things," she said. "This allows a lot of local artists to become known outside the 'privileged areas' of art."

The building houses the courthouse, *Communications-Québec* and several other government services. This means all kinds of people will be exposed to the art work on display in the foyer.

Turning the hall into an art gallery also draws attention to a stained glass mural by Montreal artist Marcelle Ferron that covers one side of the hall, said Saint-Jacques.

This year's line-up of artists is characterized by its diversity, said Saint-Jacques. They are all local artists using various media, including oils, pastels, engraving, sculpture, photography and stained glass.

A special feature in December will be a retrospective including one work from each of the artists that will have shown there to date. There have been 16 so far, and 16 more are scheduled for 1986.

Johanne Bérubé Carrier and Julien Paradis, artists who are on the selection committee, say the series is a great benefit to artists and the community.

"We are very pleased to have this space," said Bérubé. "We would like people to become more sensitized to art through this."

The hall is open the same hours as the government offices, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday to Friday. The building is at 77 Main St. in Granby.

Fortunately, the OSS has decided to present a good portion of the concert again Sunday in a matinee at 11 a.m. The concert Saturday will consist of Benjamin Britten's **A Young Person's Guide to the Orchestra, op. 34**, Keith Bissell's **Andante e Scherzo**, Georges Bizet's **Petite suite, op. 22** and Beethoven's **Symphony no. 5 in C minor, op. 67**. Then Sunday they'll present the parts of this concert which they consider the most "accessible" — deleting the Bissell and parts of Beethoven. Tickets for the Saturday concert are on sale at the box office for \$10 (\$7 seniors and students) and can be reserved by calling (819)821-7744. The Sunday matinee tickets can be picked up on arrival for \$3 adults, and \$1.50 children.

In the western part of the Townships, where it isn't so easy to just pop over to Bishop's or the University of Sherbrooke, classical music devotees can still stave their hunger for culture with a pair of concerts being presented at the **Old Brick Church** in West Brome this weekend. At 8 p.m. tomorrow, and again at 3 p.m. Sunday, the **Classical Duo of Montreal and Friends** will present works by **Vinci, Paganini, Bartok** and **Schubert**. This group consists of flutist **Eric Wilner** and guitarist **David Joachim**, along with **David Quinn** on viola and **Marcel St. Cyr** on cello. These concerts are free, and if you want more information you can call (514)263-2346.

The students in the department of music of the **CEGEP de Sherbrooke** are having their third **Midday Concert** next Wednesday at noon. They'll be presenting pieces from various musical periods in the **Salle Alfred Des Rochers**, which is found in Pavillion 3 of the CEGEP. Use the Terrill St. entrance. Admission is free.

In Montreal this Saturday, the **Montreal Symphony Orchestra** will present a programme including works by **Schubert, Haydn** and **Tchaikovsky** in the auditorium of the **St-Jean CEGEP**. That's at 8 p.m.

Something to look ahead to for next Friday, Feb. 21, is a concert of chamber music by a group of local musicians and teachers of music at the **Centennial Theatre**. I talked to three of the six members of the group this week, about chamber music and all that, and you can read all about it in a story on page 5.

And now, into the fun-time music:

The **Del Monty** in Rock Island didn't have the name of their band in time to inform me, but they always have good rock and roll music playing there, with a different band every weekend.

Jim Place in Burrough's Falls, just outside of Ayer's Cliff, was in about the same position. They're having the crowning of the carnival queen and other carnival activities Saturday night, and will have a group to play popular, commercial music, but they didn't know exactly who it would be.

The **Pub Chez Ronnie** has a band called **Paradox** playing tonight and tomorrow night from 11 p.m. on, and they play commercial music.

A couple of places are having Valentine's parties, or at least something out of the ordinary to mark the occasion. The **Auberge Glen Sutton** has **Moonquake** in for a **Valentine's Weekend Rock and Roll Dance Party**, playing tonight and tomorrow starting at about 9:30. They play what the owner there describes as 60s and 70s rock. Ladies get in free, but men will have to pay \$3.

There'll be a Valentine's dance as well at the **Richmond Legion Hall** Saturday from 9 to 1:30. **Country Plus** will be playing for this dance.

Rod Bray and the Countrymen make an appearance at yet another Valentine's dance at a **Mont Scotch Hill**, between

Danville and Richmond, tomorrow. This is a Snowmobile Club event, but all are welcome. This will run from 9 until 1:30.

Then there's one at the **Cowansville Legion** as well, tomorrow from 8:30 to 1:30. **The Bolton Brothers Band** plays for this event.

Dave Lapp, a local musician who's done pretty well throughout the province and beyond lately, is back home in Lennoxville Monday night, playing his folk-bordering-on-commercial music at the **Golden Lion Pub** from 9 until 1. He released his first extended play album not too long ago, with several of his best songs, and last I heard it wasn't doing too badly. You can probably ask him about it at the Lion if you haven't already gone out and bought it.

Mike Goodsell's one man show continues at the Imperial Hotel this weekend and throughout February and March. He plays Friday and Saturday nights from 10 until 2, and Sunday from 7 to midnight. He's adding new material to his repertoire all the time, so if you've seen him once, well, go see him again. He basically plays fairly recent soft rock and country music that you've heard on the radio, and he keeps his electronic backup at a pleasant volume that allows you to get up and dance, or sit and talk. He's got a good voice and the way he can make it sound like he's got a whole band up there with him is quite fascinating.

Station 88 in South Stukely welcomes **The Backroad Band**, a country-western band that'll be playing there Friday and Saturday nights starting about 9 p.m. throughout the month of February.

More country-western sounds are featured at the **Maples** in Stanstead, where **Moonshine** will play Friday and Saturday nights from 9:30 to 2:30 all month long as well.

At the **Burning Log Bistro** near Mansonville, the traditional folk ensemble **Borderline** will perform Saturday night starting at around 7:30. They play all sorts of instruments, apparently, including the Irish harp, guitar and tin whistles. Friday night, as usual, owner **Jim Lawrence** will provide the music — or perhaps we should say the entertainment. He claims to play the mandolin, guitar and four- and five-string banjo.

Whiteliner, a country-rock group, continues to play at **Hee Haw Country**, 470 Main West in Magog, this weekend and for the rest of the month. They'll start playing at about 9:30 tonight and tomorrow night.

The **Shady Crest** in Ayer's Cliff has **Station 4**, another country-rock band, in for the weekend. They play Friday and Saturday from 9:30 to 2:30 and Sunday from 3:30 to 9:30.

At the **F.L. Hideaway** in Lennoxville, once again, **The Hall Brothers** will play Friday and Saturday night.

The **Hut** in Lennoxville feature **Weekend Express** this weekend, playing Saturday only, from 9:30 until 1:30.

Now, that should give you enough to choose from, wouldn't you say?

Exhibitions/Events

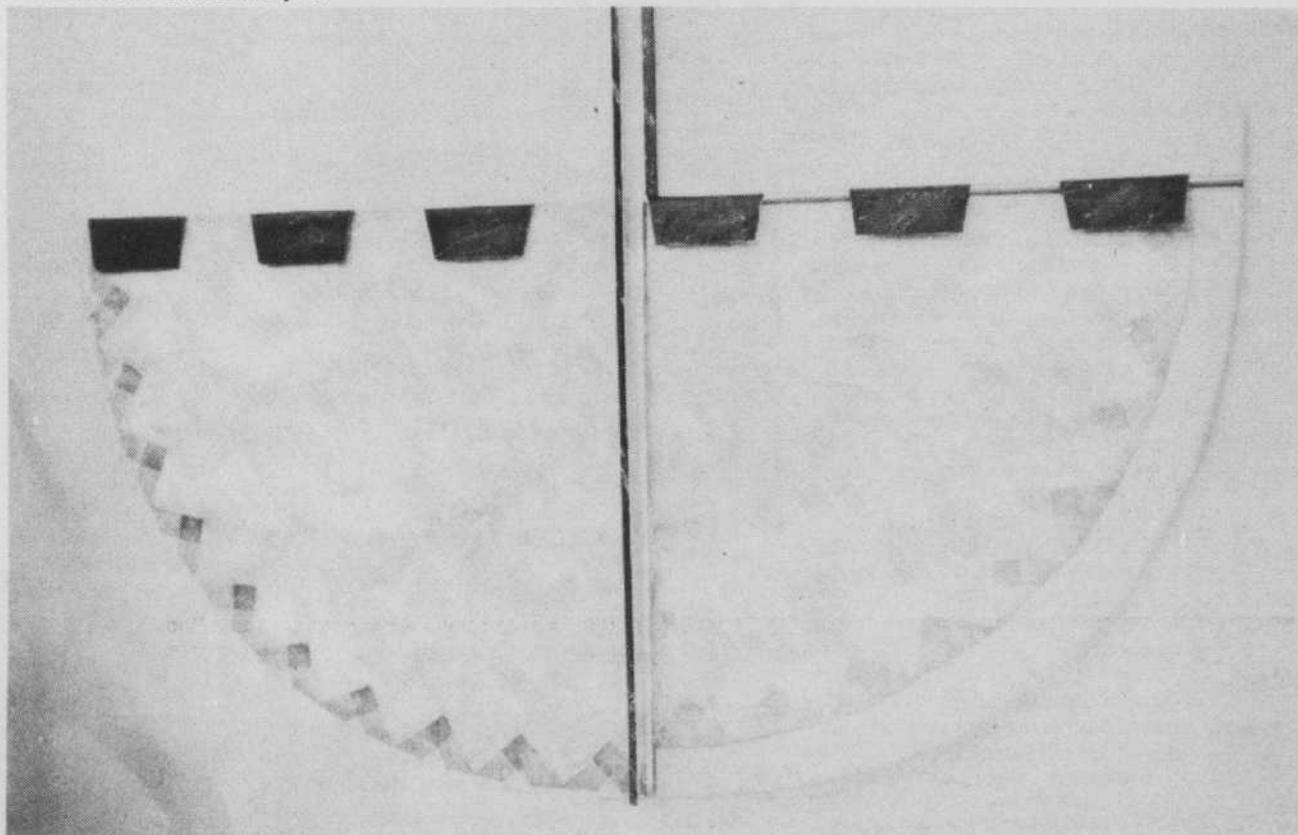
I'll keep this relatively brief this time, since I've pretty well decided you're all going to be awfully busy going to concerts and other musical events in the coming week and won't have much time for art shows (arrogant of me, isn't it?).

If you're a resident of the Granby area, however, you might take the time to stop in at the provincial government building there to have a look at some watercolor and gouache paintings by Sutton artist **Bernard Morisset**. He's the first on a long list of artists to be exhibiting there as part of the **Evénements du hall** series of 1986. Morisset talks about his art in an article on page 7.

In Sherbrooke, the **Galerie Horace** features two Montreal artists, **Arnaud Gosselin** and **Michel Gaboury**. These, typical of Horace Gallery shows, are really quite far out, and, if you're like me, you may not get the point. Gaboury's **Traces fragiles/pour attraper les nuages** examines the connections between painting and photography. There are lots of black boxes and black frames enclosing bits of sky, suggesting, I suppose, the way photography frames and puts artificial boundaries on reality.

Arnaud Gosselin plays on a rather tiresome theme of questioning what exactly it is a painter does, what art is, the nature of creativity, and so on. To do so he breaks the rules, presenting large, oddly-shaped, crumpled canvases without frames, and so on, to provoke the viewer into questioning what art is. Well, I suppose it worked, but I was inclined to conclude that this was not it.

Continuing at the **Caisse Populaire de Sherbrooke-Est** at King and Bowen is an exhibition of Polish posters. I haven't

seen it, but the literature sent to me says the poster has developed into quite an art form in Poland, just as it has here, and yet in Poland different themes predominate. Here's a rough translation of bits of the press release: "The poster in Poland has become, over the years, the spokesman for the profound need for liberty and the desire to be a sovereign people. These needs, sometimes expressed in explosive ways, and the limited techniques create unique images that cannot be regarded indifferently." The display continues until Feb. 28.

Etchings, lithographs, woodcuts and photography by Sue Rusk and Evelyn Dufour are on display at the Arts-Sutton Gallery in Sutton until Sunday. The gallery is open Friday through Sunday from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.

The Bishop's University-Champlain College Art Gallery has an exhibition of work by faculty members on until the 21st. It includes paintings by David Sorensen, ceramics by Ken Madokoro, watercolors by Denis Palmer, relief sculpture by Jim Benson and photographs by Nicole Benoit. The gallery is open Monday to Friday 11 a.m. to 3 p.m.

The Sherbrooke Fine Arts Museum is showing some of the donations it has received in the past two months. These include works by Arthur Villeneuve, Adrien Hébert, Charles-Auguste Brisson, Henry Saxe, Pierre Lussier and Louise Panneton. They will be on display until the end of March. The museum, at 86 Wellington North, is open Sunday to Friday from 1 to 5 p.m.

Movies

There's not a lot new in the movie theatres this week, so I'll begin with something really old. The Bishop's University Film Society (BUFS) has a double bill planned for tonight in the Centennial Theatre on campus. Starting at 7:30 it's the 1943 classic *Casablanca* with Humphrey Bogart and Ingrid Bergman. This is followed by *Play It Again, Sam*, a 1972 comedy in which Woody Allen plays a man obsessed with the character Bogart plays in *Casablanca*. Diane Keaton and Susan Anspach also appear in this one, which the BUFS press release pronounces "hilarious". Tickets for BUFS plays are \$2.49 for students, \$2.99 for the general public and 99¢ for children.

For more off-the-beaten-track film viewing, the NFB theatre, at 311 King St. W. in Sherbrooke is showing three films on parenthood and divorce next Tuesday at 2 and 8 p.m. *The Third Person* follows a couple home with their first baby and documents the two weeks following. The parents talk about the myths and realities of parenthood as they experience them. *Coming Apart* demonstrates how conciliation and mediation services can be used to help separated

and divorced parents work out ways of sharing parental responsibilities. *Dad's House, Mom's House* explores the phenomenon of joint custody, focussing on the experiences of three couples. The three films run 1 hour and 40 minutes altogether.

Okay, now for the movie theatres. We have one possibility only in Sherbrooke. The Capitol Theatre has *Iron Eagle*, playing nightly at 6:45 and 9:00, and Sunday and Tuesday at 1:30 as well. There's an ad for this a couple of pages back, which tells you as much as I know about it.

Over in Cowansville at the Cinema Princess, at 7:15 it's a science fiction film called *Warning Sign* and at 9:00 it's the *Jewel of the Nile* — you've heard enough about this one I'm sure — Michael Douglas, Kathleen Turner, Danny DeVito, etc. I still haven't heard anything good about the film, but it's sure hangin' in there.

The Merrill's Showplace Theatre in Newport also has *Jewel of the Nile*, showing nightly at 7:05 and 9:30 with weekend matinees at 2:05. *Iron Eagle* is also playing there, nightly at 7:10 and 9:15 with matinees Saturday and Sunday at 1:55.

Finally at Merrill's, *Youngblood* plays at 7:00 and 9:25 every night, and at 1:45 Saturday and Sunday. Now this one I can tell you a few things about, thanks to good old Canadian Press. Rob Lowe, star of *St. Elmo's Fire*, *Class* and *The Outsiders*, plays a farm boy who has hopes of playing for the National Hockey League. Eric Nesterenko, a retired hockey player who divided his career between the Chicago Black Hawks and the Toronto Maple Leafs, was hired to coach Lowe on skating and hockey. He ended up with a role as Lowe's father, a hard-working man who has a dim view of his son's choice, especially after seeing his eldest son blinded in one eye playing hockey. This movie was shot in Toronto in late 1984. I've heard that it gives a pretty good illustration of what hockey's all about — not the least bit reminiscent of *Slapshot* — and of course includes its share of violence.

Television

I mentioned a few weeks ago how I liked the various music and movie awards shows because it gives me a chance to catch up on who's who in the entertainment world. Well, here's another chance. Tonight on CBC Television *Good Rockin' Tonight* presents the 1986 International British Recording Industry Awards. This glamorous two-hour event is the equivalent of the Canadian Juno and the American Grammy Awards and will feature such names as Sade, Tears For Fears, Phil Collins and Huey Lewis as performers. The program airs at 11:30 p.m.



Megan Follows portrays the precocious, irresistible Anne Shirley, the heroine of the classic *Anne of Green Gables* on *Wonderworks*. It airs on four consecutive Mondays at 8 p.m. beginning Feb. 17 on Vermont ETV.

Saturday night on Vermont ETV, James Cagney stars in *The Roaring Twenties* at 9 p.m. In the 1939 classic, three army buddies find their lives intertwining dramatically after the first world war ends and Prohibition begins. Humphrey Bogart co-stars.

At 9 p.m. Sunday, CBC Television has a special on *The Mighty Quinn*. Father Vaughn Quinn is best known to Canadian viewers as the star goalie of the Flying Fathers, the hockey team of priests which has raised millions for charity. In the U.S., however, he is known for running one of the largest alcoholic treatment centres in the country. This documentary follows Quinn from the intake centre in Detroit to the rural treatment facility, and finally out onto Lake St. Clair for three intensive days on a 38-foot sailboat with a small group of residents.

If you missed *Anne of Green Gables* when it was on CBC, you have another chance starting Monday, when the first of the four parts airs on Vermont ETV at 8 p.m. Megan Follows plays an orphan girl who is sent by accident to an elderly brother and sister who wanted a boy to help with the chores. Colleen Dewhurst and Richard Farnsworth co-star.

Tuesday at 7 p.m., CBC Television's *Gzowsky and Co.* profiles Dr. Reinhold Kaletsch, a German physician whose holiday camping trip turned into a nightmare and a struggle for survival in the northern wilderness. Kaletsch, a part-time adventurer and explorer, slipped and fell while surveying a remote, uninhabited area in 1979. He received a concussion and broke his back in two places. After lying motionless for 10 days in sometimes sub-zero weather, he discovered he could walk and eventually got back to civilization.

And that's about all that seems to stand out in the choices for next week's viewing.

Radio

I seem to be lacking my *Radio Guide* for some reason, so this is going to be a poor excuse for a Radio column. All I have that looks interesting is a press release regarding a six-part series of plays by women writers being broadcast on CBC Radio.

The final play in the series can be heard Sunday at 4:04 p.m. *Hunting the Lion* by Beverley Rosen (Simons) is an introspective piece that looks into the imaginative world of Ann Parrish, a wife, mother, mistress and writer — a woman who lives as a domesticated animal, but has the thrill of the hunt in her bones.

Boston Museum of Science exhibit

“Amber Waves” gives sobering view of the arms race

BOSTON — An almost blinding sunlight bounces off the Charles River through the windows of this city's Museum of Science, casting sharp shadows across a field of small ceramic cones and larger missile-shaped objects sprawled across the museum floor, and almost obliterating the view of Boston's skyline behind them.

Which may be fitting.

Because one-third of these cones represent nuclear warheads that, in the words of Douglas B. Smith, an exhibits planner here, could “blow away a city of this size. No problem.”

Barbara Donachy's alluring and disturbing exhibit, “Amber Waves of Grain,” is a one-for-one miniature representation of America's nuclear arsenal. It displays about 30,000 cones, a dense flight of B-52's hanging from the ceiling, and a long phalanx of Trident submarines stealing through the midst of the cones.

The exhibit was born in 1981 when Donachy and her husband, designer Andry Bardwell, returned from a trip to Europe. There they encountered vocal opposition to the arms buildup and began wondering about a way to bring the giant numbers involved in the nuclear arsenal into some kind of graphic perspective.

SPENT \$16,000

They wound up spending \$16,000 of their own money researching the US nuclear arsenal and underwriting the equipment and material to build the exhibit.

Miss Donachy was pregnant at the time the project began (her baby was born right after the first ceramic cones were fired), and she told the Monitor by telephone from her Denver home, “I didn't want to be so shortsighted as to be worry about diaper rash, and not taking care of bigger things, like nuclear war.”

Donachy tried to bring the unimaginable within the grasp of the imagination, to make us look at things that the conservative columnist George F. Will once called “so familiar that they no longer seem, as they should, astonishing and disquieting.”

“I wanted it to be very tranquil, not high-tech — all very earthy,” she says. “I wanted something that would be a dichotomy ... so that people wouldn't just walk away from it. This is something beautiful that represents something awful.”

Wherever it has traveled — from New York City to the nation's capital to West Germany and now to Boston — this still, almost tranquil field of earthy cones, which looks very much like a streaked and windy field of wheat, has stirred an emotional response.

LIKE CEMETERY

“I'm a kid, and I don't want to

die!” one child wrote in the book provided for comments. “Your impressive display reminds me of a cemetery,” added another visitor.

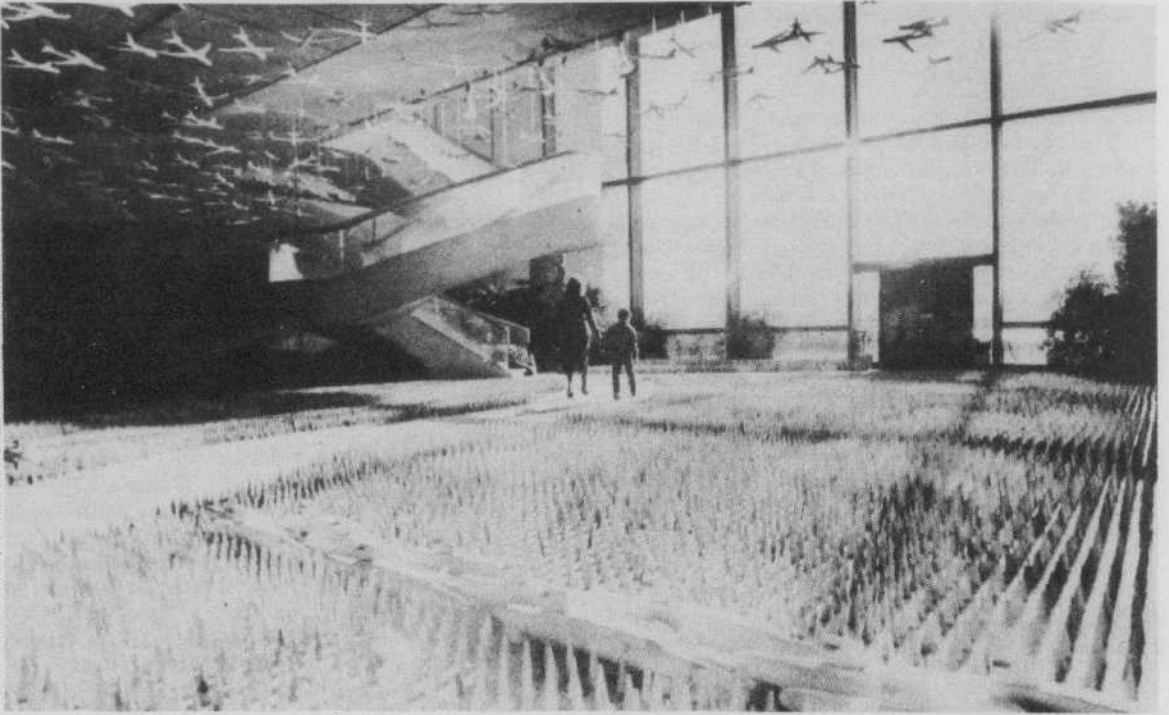
“I'm from Hiroshima,” a young woman on her first visit to the US wrote in Japanese. “I'm worried that the United States has such military power. But I'm relieved to see that this exhibition is so popular. Nuclear explosions, such as those that occurred in Nagasaki and Hiroshima, should never be repeated.”

Some visitors took encouragement from the exhibit: “Coming from Eastern Europe, I think that the only — unfortunately only — way to keep peace, threatened by the Soviets, is to be ready for all eventualities. The US has the possibility of saving the world as long as she is strong enough.”

Another European began by saying, “We live in the middle of Pershing bases in Germany and do feel troubled,” but went on to argue for a need to arm heavily with nuclear weapons.

UPDATED

The exhibit, which leaves here for Rockford, Ill., on March 2, has been updated by this museum to reflect the current size of the arsenal. The museum has also paired it with an exhibit from the Cleveland Health Education Museum entitled “The Atom: Peril and Promise,” which more graphically depicts the effects of nuclear weapons, as well as technical questions relating to the uses and abuses of nuclear power. In this companion exhibit, artists portray — in styles ranging from primitive to sophisticated — the “unforgettable fire” of Hiroshima and Nagasaki.

though, the quiet simplicity of “Amber Waves of Grain” seems to have a more immediate impact on visitors.

One tall, bearded man read the accompanying wall charts showing the size and destructive power of the nuclear arsenal, shook his head and walked away.

Later, four elderly women happened by. “It gives me the creeps,” one said. “It's insane,” added another. Then they engaged in a lengthy impromptu discussion of nuclear disarmament.

“Do these things hurt?” one schoolboy asked.
