The world was her studio

On Sept. 20, the Eastern Townships bid farewell to one of its most unusual residents when Janina Bogusz Grygar died at the age of 93.

The Polish-born Grygar, a long-time resident of Potton, was a prolific and largely self-trained folk painter, but also a writer of poetry, a memoir, and song lyrics published in her native Poland. She was also, according to Polish government records, the world's oldest Polish survivor of Siberian exile, and a refugee whose art not only sustained her spirit and family.

Grygar was born in Poland Feb. 17, 1909. She was a married with children when World War II ended and her husband, a Polish military officer, disappeared. Only years later did she discover the fate of her husband, one of many Polish officers murdered by the advancing Soviet army.

Polish nationals, including Grygar and her children, posed a problem for the new Russian occupiers, and were summarily shipped off to remote parts of Siberia, presumably to die and disappear forever in the obscurity of the Russian steppes.

The memory of this stark, two-and-a-half year exile would later be told in a series on nine unforgettable oil paintings by Grygar, each based upon an event in the artist's life. The efforts of the artist and her paintings would also stimulate the publication of a book on the Polish Siberian exiles, as well as the founding of a museum dedicated to their memories, where her nine paintings now rest.

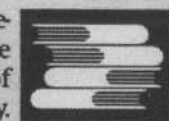

Fall rules year-round at Auberge des Appalaches

Daniel Martin and Micheline Côte have mountain air in their lungs. The two have spent most of their working lives around the peaks and valleys of Sutton.

Through his job with the Parc d'environnement naturel de Sutton, Martin helped design and implement the 70-km hiking network that runs through the mountains. Côte, meanwhile, worked for years at the Mont Sutton ski resort.

In 1996, the two purchased an empty auberge on Maple close to the ski hill. It had been operated by numerous owners in the past, but had closed down a couple of years prior. They named it Auberge des Appalaches after the Appalachian Mountains that surround it, and have been serving homegrown hospitality ever since.

Fall is the colour of the Auberge year-round. The comfortable dining room features fall leaves attractively arranged under glass at each of the 16 tables. Table settings include placemats with a photo of leaves and two tablecloths arranged asymmetrically, one beige, the other maroon.

The walls are a combination of burnt orange and beige divided by dark wood molding with an engraved pattern of leaves. The auberge also features a cozy living room with a wood-burning fireplace for patrons to relax over an aperitif to start the evening or a digestif to conclude it.

This month, the auberge is taking part in the Brome Lake Duckfest and chef Mario Lambert has designed a special menu highlighting the world-famous bird from Brome. Lambert is a Townships who grew up and studied in Sherbrooke and has worked at the Hovey Manor in North Hatley and La Merise in Cherry River before moving to Sutton and taking on his position at the Auberge des Ap-

This year's festival highlights the Asian influences of Peking and Lambert has peppered his four-course table d'hôte with the aromas of China, combining them with local flavours. It begins with the soup of the evening (winter squash tonight); followed by an appetizer of sautéed duck liver paté in raspberry vinegar or a salad of hearts of palm and artichokes in a three-pepper sauce.

The main dishes include smoked duck in five spices (\$28.95); stuffed roll of duck with a maple syrup sauce (\$26.95); braised duck with raisins in a caramelized sauce (\$23.95); filet of lamb with mushrooms in a cream sauce (\$26.95); traditional Swiss raclette (\$26.95); seafood shell au gratin (\$21.95); or the chef's selection of the evening (\$19.95), which on the night my companion and I visited was medallions of beef or filet of turbot. A choice of desserts and coffee, tea, tisane or fruitsane ends off the table d'hôte.

This particular menu is only available for five more evenings (Oct. 12, 13, 18, 19 and 25), however, Côte stresses that duck is a tradition at the Auberge and they always carry it on their regular table d'hôte menu, although not as plentifully as during the Duckfest.

The winter squash soup was thick and creamy, however the flavour was perhaps too subtle to appreciate; something with a bit more personality is called for. The duck liver paté was fine, sautéed to just slightly pink and served moist and tender in raspberry vinegar along with sliced tomatoes and salad. Perfect for duck liver lovers.

The "hearts salad" is also very subtle, but here it works well. Hearts of palm surround artichoke and cucumber in a creamy, bright beige three-pepper sauce. A light, slightly tart, pleasant salad.

The braised duck is a full leg and morsels in a caramelized brown sauce accented with raisins served in an oval ramekin. Deliciously tender – a must for fans of duck confit. It was served with fine accompaniments, including rice with

chopped red pepper, tender crisp cauliflower and a tangy Asian-style apple salad with celeriac.

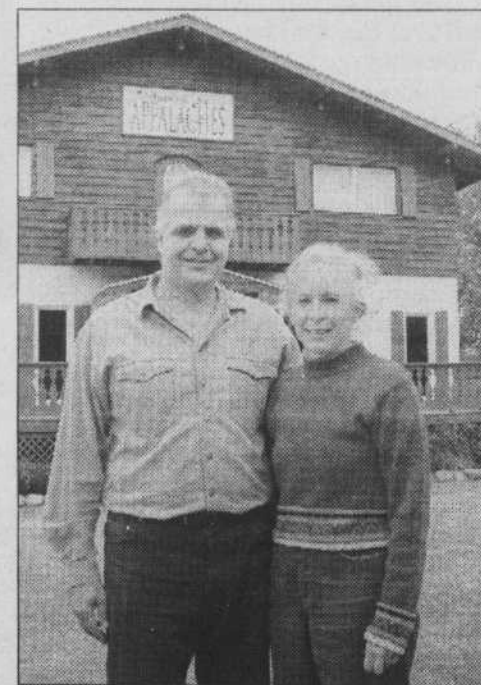
The filet of lamb, ordered medium but arriving rare, had to be sent back. When an entirely new plate made its arrival, this time perfectly medium, it was very good. Tender, nicely sautéed slices of lamb are served in a creamy white sauce with mushrooms. This was served with sautéed potatoes, cauliflower and the apple salad.

For dessert, we tried the cheesecake and the Mont Sutton ice-cream. The cheesecake was flavourfully creamy, elegantly served with raspberry coulis. The Mont Sutton was a luscious combination of vanilla ice-cream with a fruit coulis and chocolate sauce, served with a sliced banana. Do I really need to tell you it was delicious?

The dinner for two, not including wine or gratuity, was \$59. The Auberge is entering a busy season. After their Duckfest menu on Friday and Saturday nights ends Oct. 25, the place is the site of the Sutton en blues festival where, from Oct. 26 to Dec. 14, blues artists such as Jim Zeller, the Stephen Barry Blues Band and the Steve Rowe Band play for appreciative audiences every Saturday night.

During this period, the Auberge is serving dinner on Friday nights only, although patrons may enjoy drinks with the Saturday shows. Then, from Dec. 15 on through the winter, the Auberge is open seven days a week for breakfast and dinner.

For outdoor enthusiasts, the Auberge also offers guided tours on snowshoes each Wednesday night from 8:30-10 during the winter (providing there is snow on the ground). The cost is \$5 if you provide your own snowshoes; \$10 if you don't. In the Auberge des Appalaches, Daniel Martin and Micheline Côte have created a place where visitors may enjoy the beauty of the Sutton mountains and the culinary flavours of this region and beyond.

The nine canvasses, which are arguably her most compelling works, depict heart-rending scenes of survival in the harsh Siberian steppes. The widow survived by performing manual work, for which she was paid in grain and loaves of bread.

Grygar and her children lived in a one-room house together with 27 other Polish exiles, many elderly. Grygar's son Zygmunt, born after the Siberian exile, retells the story of how his mother single-handedly built the brick oven in the house, despite the jeering of the others who were convinced that any effort was futile.

One canvass depicts Christmas in the crowded house, Grygar's brick oven providing life-sustaining heat and, in the centre of the room, a primitive Christmas tree fashioned from dead twigs ornamented with ribbons. The artist is a small, almost insignificant character in the midst of the crowded house. She later told her son that most depicted in that Christmas scene would escape the steppes only in death.

Another canvas in the series portrays a sudden and deadly snow squall. The only member of the Polish exiles with proper winter clothes, she was forced to do much of the fetching for the group. As she returned to her house with a vital parcel of food and supplies, a sudden squall enveloped her, leaving her blind and lost.

The painting depicts the peasant woman's feet visible through the swirling cloud of snow, the parcel lies beside her, dropped in a panic. She was saved from sure death by a voice guiding her to safety; the food, however, was lost in the storm.

Another painting depicts the house, covered to the rooftop by snow and a neighbour arduously digging through to free the trapped occupants.

Two of her most moving paintings portray her grief as a wife and mother. One is a depiction of a dream, where Grygar, dressed in simple peasant clothes, stands in the clearing of a green forest before a tall pole. From the top of the pole trails a long roll of paper on which hundreds of names of the missing Polish men are written, including that of her husband.

The final of the nine Siberian landscapes shows Grygar carrying the coffin of a her child, one of two of her children who would die in the steppes. After scrounging scraps of wood to build a simple coffin and cross, she bears the small coffin containing the body of her child to a place where the soil is soft enough for burial.

After two-and-a half years of exile, an amnesty released the Polish exiles, who were given no means with which to return home. Thus began a long voyage, with Grygar and her surviving children traveling from Siberia to Pakistan, India, East Africa (Uganda), India, Germany and finally to Canada. Throughout much of this period, she sustained her family by selling paintings. Along the way, she met and married Czech Ernest Grygar, with whom she lived until his death in December, 2000.

Zygmunt estimates that his mother painted around 100,000 canvasses, from 25 to 35 a day. While many were mass-produced for art wholesalers, her son says that she recognized the difference between her "good" art and her art of necessity, signing the latter with one of many pseudonyms.

However, Grygar is probably best known locally for her colourful eggs, painted using traditional Polish methods. Between 1967 and 1981, she presented her creations to many politicians and dig-

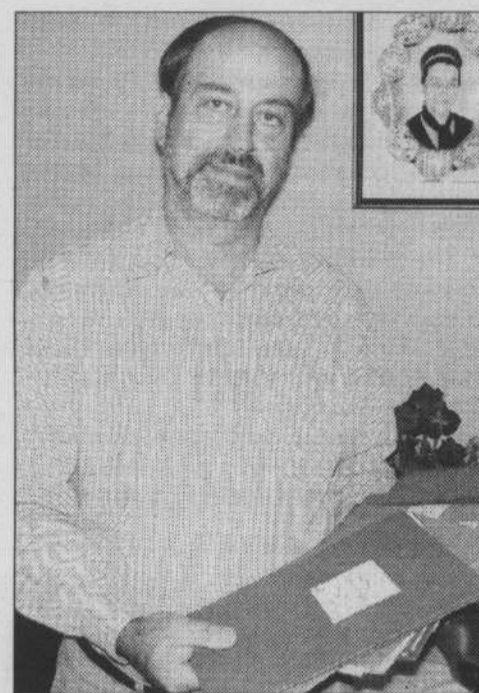
nitaries. Her files contain stacks of letters of thanks from the recipients, including Brian Mulroney, René Lévesque, Jean Chretien, Jean Drapeau, John Turner and Pierre Trudeau, to name a few.

In 1995, she traveled to her native Poland where she presented a painted egg commemorating the liberation of Poland from the Iron Curtain to then Polish president Lech Walesa. Her magnificent patriotic egg, emblazoned with the crests of each Canadian province, is now housed with other examples of her painted eggs in the Canadian Museum of Civilization in Hull and inspired the creation of the museum's ethnic art wing.

Her last work, a large painted ostrich egg which would have been presented to Pope John Paul on his visit to Toronto had illness not prevented its completion, is a magnificent creation. The front bears the white eagle, the symbol of Poland on a red background; rich floral garlands from a border between front and back. The back bears a completed image of the Pope.

Grygar also leaves behind many published and unpublished poems, mostly in Polish (nearly 300 in English). She is also the author of an epic rhyming poem telling her life story (in Polish) and an unfinished memoir. She is also a lyricist and SOCAN member who has penned songs that have been hits in her native Poland.

Tragedy struck one more time two years ago when her Potton house and an estimated 100 paintings were destroyed in a fire. It should come as no surprise that this survivor of war, exile and displace-

ment rebuilt and simply carried on. It should also come as no surprise that at the time of her death, Grygar was a nominee for the Order of Canada. Her son Zygmunt sums up his mother's turbulent life and energetic spirit simply: "the world was her studio".

Shortly before her death, looking back over her rich life, she told her son, "The bell has to toll for everyone."

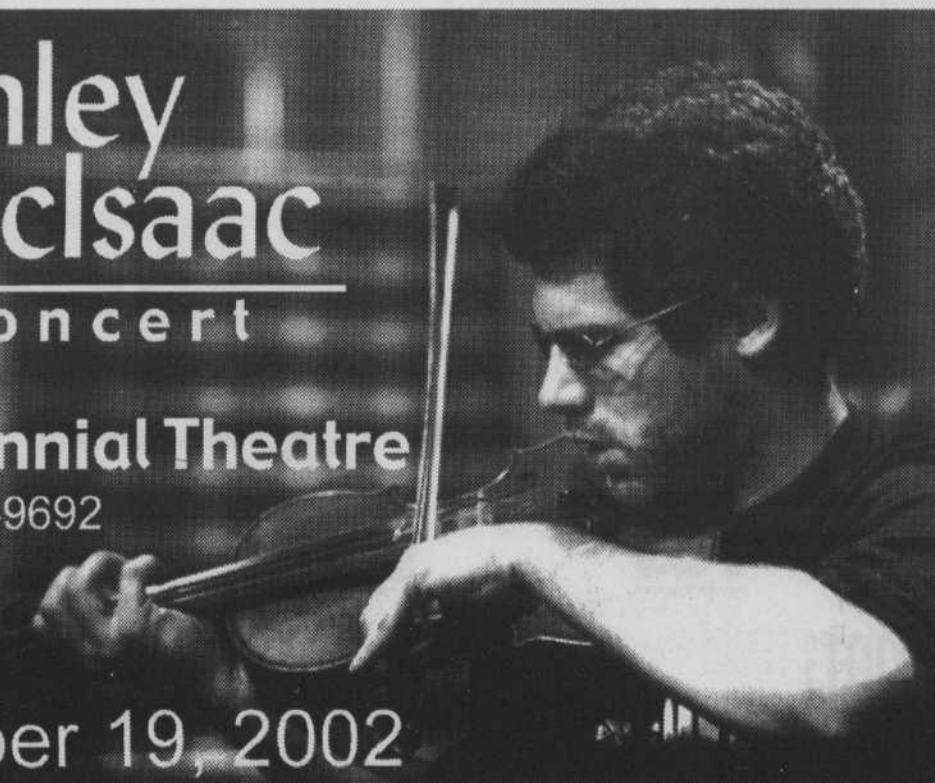

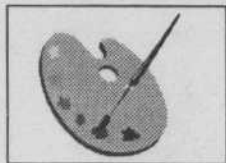

art A fine selection of museums and galleries make the Townships a mecca for artists and art-lovers

A unique look at the world of aviation art

Townshippers are being offered the unique opportunity to see the world of aviation through the ever inquisitive eyes of local painter Michel Veltkamp at La Maison des Arts et de la Culture de Brompton this month.

The exhibit, entitled Zoom-Zoom, features a dialogue between different forms, textures and colours, using a repetition of familiar symbols and shapes to initially spark your imagination.

Veltkamp grew up in Ontario with his Dutch parents, later studying at UQAM in Montreal where he received

his Masters in Plastic Arts. Working at Ronald Bloore's studio, he says he was exposed to the world of contemporary art and learned much from the many artists he met there.

Veltkamp admits the inspiration for his works comes from the materials that he works with, and the form of painting. This all contributes to making each painting unique. He says is forever trying to push the limits of his creativity and imagination.

"Artistic success depends less on the inevitable and timid quest of the originality of the artist and more on the ability to express the sheer pleasure that is derived from watching the blending of the paints and discovering never end-

ing possibilities that become present in the finished product," says Veltkamp.

"Real freedom of expression comes from your own experiences and sense of self-confidence. A piece starting out as a serious work often develops into a work that challenges the imagination."

Veltkamp adds that he has reached a point where he must destroy the strict traditional lessons that he was taught in art school in order to create a concept that flows freely from his own creativity.

"I have a great deal of respect for what I have learned, but it will always be only a stepping stone in creating a new world of possibilities," he continues. "The dynamics of the repetition of

familiar signs and symbols have been used by different cultures as forms of expression for many years. I use a wide variety of tools to reach the effect I want or rather the total effect many times comes from the tools I use — anything from a stencil carved in polystyrene with a nail, to a snowflake-shaped Christmas decoration, and even bubbles blown onto a canvas."


Veltkamp says he has even borrowed his wife's chainsaw and carved a nine-foot totem rabbit out of a large beam. Some exhibits even include pieces of crossword puzzles, peanut or candy wrappers.

Veltkamp says he likes to work with his canvases flat on the floor. He puts extensions on his brushes. In this way, his work can flow freely which he likes to refer to as artistic skating.

In each painting, Veltkamp says he tries to place something that doesn't seem to belong to the theme. He feels that visitors to the gallery need to have a porthole of escape in each work. If they do not like the way the "story" seems to be going, they have a "door" which opens their imagination into another world to somewhere they can relate to more easily or more comfortably.

Veltkamp is always glad to have visitors at his studio located in St. Adolphe de Dudswell where he has lived on a small farm with his wife and four children for the last 10 years.



Piano quartet's concert a religious experience

Chamber music lovers can look forward to a religious experience Saturday night when some of the area's brightest young stars shine in concert at North Hatley's St. Elizabeth Church.

The recently-formed Mykonos Piano Quartet, composed of two graduate students from the University of Montreal and two from the North Carolina School of the Arts, will present a program of Mozart (his Piano and String Quartet in G minor, K. 478) and Schumann (Piano Quartet in E flat major, op. 47).

Amélie Langlois, the group's 24-year-old pianist, said that the selections were considered carefully. The Mozart was chosen because "we wanted a piece from the classical era which would be accessible for everybody. And also, we love it."

As for the Schumann, "everybody just loves this piece," she said. "The third movement begins with a solo for cello and piano. For the whole movement, the piano

is really a support played softly, and the others revolve around that. It's really special."

The ensemble performed the same selections in Montreal in May, and Wednesday night at the University of Montreal's Chapel. Both concerts were well received, said Langlois.

The four young players, all in their early 20s, spent an intensive two weeks in rehearsals in May when the ensemble was formed before performing these pieces in North Carolina. Putting in long seven-hour days rehearsing, it took the group about a week to master each piece.

Langlois explained that they call the group a piano quartet so people won't confuse it with the more common chamber music quartet of just strings. Even though she is the titular pianist for the ensemble, she insisted that there is not too much

pressure on her.

"My part is fuller. It's true that the piano part is very demanding, but the strings have pretty exigent parts as well," she said. "But certainly, there are plenty of notes. When I rest, it's only for two or three bars at a time, and I generally play from beginning to end."

Langlois is pursuing her second and final year of her Master's at the North Carolina School of the Arts in instrumental and vocal accompaniment. She chose accompaniment rather than the solo performance program because she liked the repertoire, which permits her to work with violinists, cellists, and singers.

As an accompanist, Langlois sometimes finds herself playing second fiddle, so to

speaking, in a violin concerto, for example.

"But when we do a sonata, it's equal. I don't feel secondary. My role changes, depending on what we're playing."

A Sherbrooke native, she said she is very happy to return to the Townships to perform. "I had my musical beginnings in Sherbrooke. Now we're offering the results of our efforts abroad. It's special."

She added that the St. Elizabeth Church, with its acoustics, is a great place for a welcome home concert.

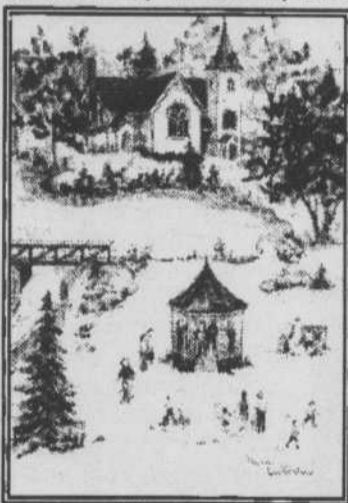
"That's our first criterion, the acoustics. Also, the caché of a church creates a special atmosphere for a concert."

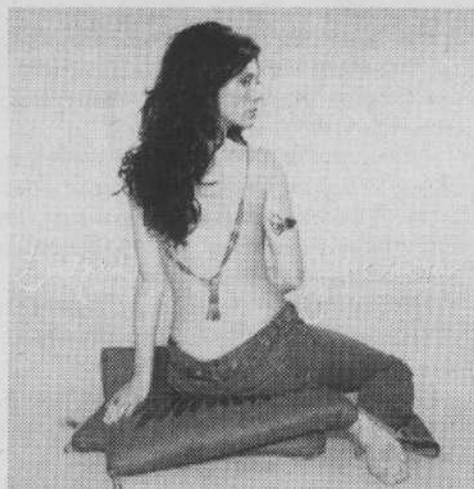

Sounds to soothe the savage beast

Hewitt's better than just barenaked on debut

It's what every teenage boy fantasizes about — Jennifer Love Hewitt barenaked. Yet it's not quite what a nation full of hormone-raging 15-year-olds think; the actress turned singer has recently released her first full-length album, appropriately entitled *Barenaked*. While many will be quick to dismiss Hewitt's debut disk without even listening to it (including many of my officemates), it is what it is — a spirited acoustic pop compilation featuring an innovative mix and the singer's surprisingly vast vocal range. I'm a big believer that authentic music talent is defined

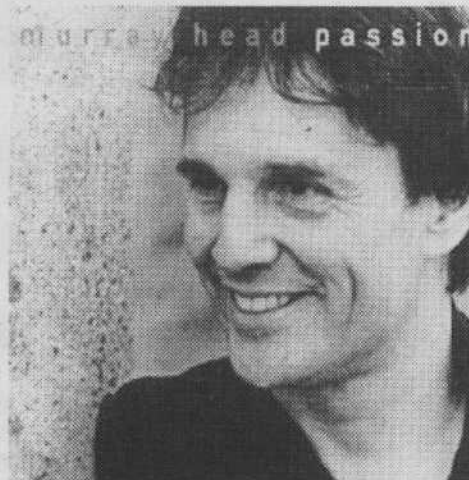
by an artist's song-writing abilities. In this case, Hewitt co-writes seven of the album's 12 songs, including writing the single 'Stronger'. Not only that, but Hewitt is able to pull off a vocal-heavy 'Me and Bobby McGee' with minimal instrumental. The disk is recorded, mixed and co-produced by pop/rock heavy-weight Meredith Brooks ('Bitch'), whose quasi-feminist influences are felt throughout ('Rock the Roll', 'Stronger'). Drop the preconceived notions of Hewitt the actress, and music fans may be genuinely surprised with *Barenaked* and Hewitt the musician.

Nirvana, a pinch of Pearl Jam, some Stone Temple Pilots and Soundgarden, throw into the mix a bit of Bush, Creed and Nickelback, shake vigorously and you have Seether's latest, entitled *Disclaimer*. But don't take my word for it, take there's: "Don't tell me that you're trendsetters/I don't care if you are." Angry, dark lyrics resound throughout the entire disk, as old ground is covered once again by a new band. On 'Sympathetic' they sing, "The same old feelings are taking over and I can't seem to make them go away." The album also includes two slower numbers, 'Fine Again' and 'Fade Away'. All around, *Disclaimer* is a good listen, but by no stretch of the imagination is it new ground.

also includes Murray Head on lead vocals and guitar. It's easy to overlook Head on *Passion*, especially after noticing his featured guests. However, he is responsible for the album's best tracks, 'Say it Ain't So, Joe' and 'Affair Across a Crowded Room'. To his discredit, however, he is also to blame for the disk's worst tracks. Taking centre stage is the eye-gouging single 'Sorry, I Love You', which is an embarrassing screaming/crying/mumbling tribute to his wife (thanks honey, but next time I'll just take flowers'). For the most part, Head's depressing, ear-piercing lyrics fail to blend with the album's auspicious beats and charged guitar rifts. Not only that, but when Head realizes the microphone is actually on, his vocals are dry and dull.

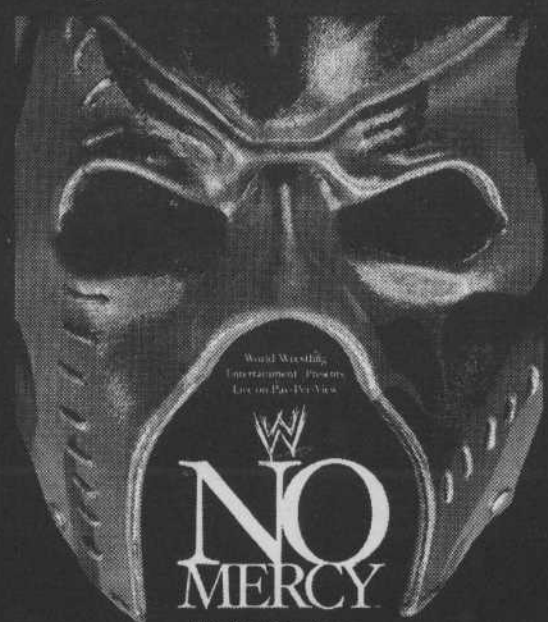

Scarlet Pimpernel a joyride to the French Revolution

The Scarlet Pimpernel is a play full of disguises. True to its form, the current production at the Stratford Festival about the fictional British hero of the French Revolution who saves English aristocrats from the guillotine begins with an intense, dramatic opening.

As directed by Dennis Garnhum, the scene in which French soldiers lead their enemies to the guillotine and chop off their heads is effective in its seriousness. However, The Scarlet Pimpernel, adapted in 1985 by Beverley Cross from the 1905 novel by Hungarian-born Baroness Orczy, is a comedy.

Yet where's the wink to the audience at the start? Just as we are repulsed by the bloodiness and anger of the opening, in comes The Scarlet Pimpernel (Peter Donaldson) dressed as a peasant woman to save the day. We are then treated to a stylized, comical fight sequence. When we meet the Pimpernel's alter ego, the bumbling, effeminate Sir Percy Blakeney, the comic transformation is complete.

Garnhum has made a trade-off. By focusing on the humour, the tension he tries to create in the play is lost. Chauvelin (Peter Hutt), the ruthless chief agent of the Paris Commune's Committee of Security out to stop the Pimpernel dead in his tracks, is played for straight laughs, not the eerie black humour that would have worked for the audience to believe the evil intentions of this character.

There is no doubt that humour is contained within the text itself, but after the disturbing opening, as the play settles into the form of comedy, it takes some time for it to win our affections. Once we give in to it, and get used to lines such as "(The Scarlet Pimpernel's) brain is as resourceful as his identity is mysterious," the play works on a tongue-in-cheek, swash-buckling Three Musketeers level.

Peter Donaldson

as Sir Percy/Scarlet Pimpernel is great as the frivolous fool; not quite believable as the handsome hero. Peter Hutt as Chauvelin looks the villain when he's silent; he isn't as convincing when he speaks. Sheila McCarthy is solid as Sir Percy's wife and, speaking of transformations, this English-Canadian actress playing a French woman in this British play works.

Kelly Wolf's elegant costumes not only disguise the actors, they depict the transformation English aristocracy was undergoing at the turn of the century in their fashion. Thus, some women wear pannier skirts with large petticoats and corsets while others sport narrow, high-waisted coats, a newer style that was coming into vogue. Men wear breeches, frock coats and ponytailed wigs.

The comic sensibility of Stratford's Scarlet Pimpernel at times works against the production. However, once audiences agree to go along for the ride, it is a fun, fast-paced trip to a French Revolution that could only exist in the form of pulp fiction.

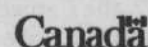

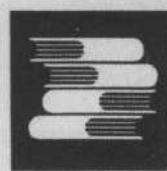

General McClellan turned cautious virtue to vice

Most of the time, wars last long. Yet, their outcomes are sometimes decided during a single battle. During World War II, the turning point occurred in December, 1941. At this time, the Russians bounced and started to turn back the German advance towards Moscow and the United States officially entered in the hostilities, after Pearl Harbor.

There are other similar examples. For instance, it happened during one of the crucial moments in United States' history: the Civil War. In his most recent book, *Crossroads of Freedom: Antietam: The Battle That Changed the Course of the Civil War*, Princeton University historian James McPherson explains how a single battle reversed the good fortune of the Southern Confederacy.

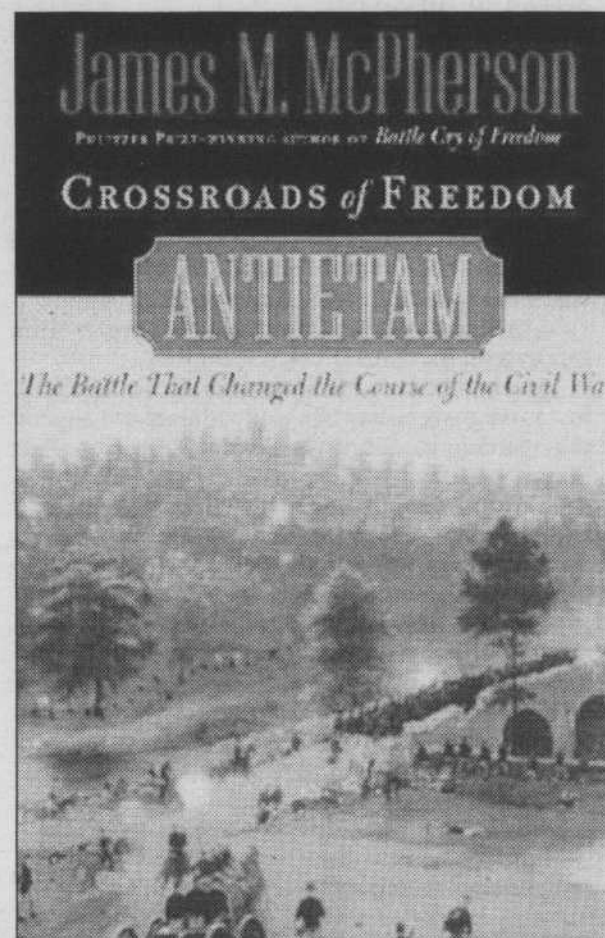
In this brilliant essay, this famous historian illustrates how victory is precarious. Thus, after a period of military success for Abraham Lincoln's army, "the pendulum of battle swung toward the Confederacy in the summer of 1862." General Robert E. Lee's army had the upper hand over the Northern army on various occasions. All of this would change in September.

Meanwhile, Lincoln's government had to cope with desperation among the population and military ranks. The situation was also alarming, since foreign nations waited to see if the South would continue to win battles, before recognizing Jefferson Davis' government, and thus forcing Lincoln to terminate the war.

General George McClellan was reluctant to efficiently pursue the enemy, even though his men outnumbered them. He always found a good pretext not to follow orders given to him. While the Confederate army was swift to move, McClellan always found a good reason - and some delays - to slow down the pace of his action. McClellan "would take no initiative without "absolute assurance of success" - which rarely if ever exists in any human endeavor, much less in war." Stated another way, McClellan seemed to have been a master at dropping the ball.

Contrary to that, General Robert E. Lee was not afraid to take risks. That may be one of the reasons he was so successful on the battlefield. On Sept. 4, he ordered his men to cross the Potomac, in Maryland, to invade the North. He did not encounter success and had to retreat. A few days later, while Union soldiers were chasing Confederate troops, a Northern soldier found a copy of Lee's orders to his army, in the grass. Upon learning of the content of this envelope, "McClellan was determined to be careful." Again, McClellan could have taken full advantage of the situation. But that was not to happen.

After the two armies encountered in Antietam on Sept. 17, the Confederates retreated, "Lee would be unable to think about resuming his preferred strategy, the offensive, and for another eight months, victory was not complete." Lee could have been crushed. "20,000 of his (McClellan's) soldiers did not fire a shot at all", during Antietam battle. Odd.



Reading McPherson, we can clearly discern that McClellan's exaggerated caution and reluctance to squash the enemy proved damaging. Had he crushed the Confederate army when he had the chance, and Antietam was such an occasion, the Civil War may well have ended sooner, thus saving many lives.

After Antietam on Sept. 22, Lincoln unveiled his Emancipation Proclamation. From that moment on, it was hard - next to impossible for England to afford recognition of the South. "Everyone can understand the significance of a war where emancipation is written on one banner and slavery on the other", wrote the American minister to the Netherlands. Momentum was on Lincoln's side, but he would have to wait close to three years before declaring victory.

Finally, there was the inevitable political dimension to all that. General McClellan was a Democrat, while Lincoln was a Republican. Democrats disagreed with the Emancipation Proclamation. In the mid-term elections of 1862, they were hopeful to defeat the Republicans. It was not to happen. And after being relieved of his duties by Lincoln for a second time, McClellan ran unsuccessfully against Lincoln in 1864 under the Democrat's banner. For once, it would have been wise from him to be careful. He was as poor a politician as he was as general.

This said, James McPherson *Crossroads of Freedom* is a very good read. And for anybody who wants to start learning about this fascinating part of history, it's a very good start.

Pfeiffer's twisted humanity hardly registers

White Oleander is a beautifully made testament, but to what?

Michelle Pfeiffer plays an unusual and compelling character in *White Oleander*, a drama about a young girl looking for an adult she can trust to get her through the world and about the unusual mother who undermines that journey.

Pfeiffer plays Ingrid, the mother, an uncompromising, dangerous, poisonous, and beautiful artist who kills her philandering boyfriend and is dragged out of the house by police.

"I'll be back in an hour," she yells to her teenage daughter Astrid (newcomer Alison Lohman). Shortly after, she is sentenced to 35 years in prison.

Behind bars, Ingrid remains steadfast. "Don't cry," she tells Astrid, when the girl comes to visit. "We're not like that. We're the Vikings." And, "Prison agrees with me. There's no hypocrisy.

Kill or be killed and everybody knows it." And, "We can't allow them to change us, to lessen us."

Ingrid wants to fool us with her good looks and her talent and those startling grey eyes; in fact, she is like some jailed Mafiosa who pulls the strings from behind bars. She's still controlling her family, which is comprised of Astrid.

But Astrid is also being tugged by what we know as the real world, or what is left of it in modern-day Los Angeles. She moves from foster home to foster home, taking on the protective colouration of her latest family — the vulgar pink dresses of Starr (the fabulous Robin Wright Penn), a former stripper turned born-again Christian, who asks Astrid if she has accepted Jesus as her personal saviour; the casual running-along-the-beach gear of Claire (squinchy-eyed Renee Zellweger), a failed actress and emotional cripple who nonetheless gives Ingrid interesting lessons in the code of movieland rejection ("too exotic" means brunette; "too classic" means old).

As Astrid visits mom in prison, decked out in her latest gear, her new attempt to fit in, Ingrid regards her with cold blue eyes and a sort of hardened beauty, which Pfeiffer has learned to use as a bludgeon as well as a lure.

"Are you out of your mind?," she asks when her daughter turns up with a cross around her neck and announces she is Christian. And as for poor Claire, "There's an entire order called the Poor Claires."

White Oleander, based on the best-selling, Oprah-approved novel by Janet Fitch, has all the makings of a potboiler, but director Peter Kosminsky, making his American feature debut, has a quiet style underplays the melodrama.

He films the story almost as if it was a documentary, with hand-held cameras and long lenses and the occasional jiggly close-up when the action

becomes jarring, which is typically after the excitement: at Ingrid's arrest (we never see the murder), or during the commotion when Astrid is sent to an institution for foster kids who can't find a family (we see only glimpses of a fight). There she falls under the influence of Paul (Patrick Fugit of *Almost Famous*), an artist like Astrid, who says he enjoys the place: it's "a floor you can't fall below."

Through it all — the attractions to older men, the tough kids, the broken marriages, a semi-crooked foster mother under whose care she develops a sort of Goth hooker look — Astrid holds on to some kind of inner identity.

Lohman, who has done some TV and stage work, has a calm decency that anchors the story, and she never gives in to the emotional temptations of the storyline. She's a tough young performer, as tough as Ingrid, and Lohman manages to hold her own

against some tough competition.

But while playing *White Oleander* in the middle register gives this provocative material an air of truth, it mutes the connections that an audience might feel. Astrid has a tough time, but it's mostly an emotional ride she is taking and the film keeps that aspect at such a low boil you barely feel it.

There's a twisted sort of humanity under Pfeiffer's coldness that hardly registers, and the film becomes a series of vignettes in which fine performers do interesting turns as an eccentric series of foster parents for a rather decent, attractive girl who anyone would be happy to welcome into their home. The film's defining moments happen off screen.

I'm not sure how we're supposed to react to all this; the movie feels inconclusive even in its tragedies. *White Oleander* is a beautifully made testament, but to what?

Womack pushes her limits on new album

Lee Ann Womack became a country music sensation two years ago with the release of her smash hit 'I Hope You Dance', a tune which quickly became her signature song.

The single was quickly praised by critics as well as fans of all musical genres, introducing the artist to a whole new audience.

'I Hope You Dance' eventually made it to number 1 on the pop and country charts, and also became an anthem that spoke freely and openly to our most secret dreams hidden deep in our hearts. The beautiful and impressive lyrics carried a very strong message, and made it the perfect choice for many occasions. It even gave Womack the opportunity to sing at the Nobel Prize ceremony, Orange Bowl and the White House to name a few.

The album *I Hope You Dance* sold three million copies, and won numerous awards. Most people in the industry said that it would be extremely hard to top the single, or even come out with something as good.

But the CMA Female Vocalist of the Year is back with a new album, enti-

led *Something Worth Leaving Behind*, her fourth to date. With its release, Womack has managed to create another great album. Her trademark sound is still there, although she pushes the boundaries of country music to explore exciting new avenues.

The album is highlighted by the title track, a stunning ballad that may not tackle the same topic as 'I Hope You Dance', but is just as important. The emotions are not the same — this one is a little darker — but she still hits a nerve, making its way into the heart in a very subtle way. After one listen to the first single, you want to thank the ones you love for being in your life.

Although Womack's style has changed a little, she projects her wonderful voice with honesty and truthfulness, reminding fans that she has carved a niche in country music and she is there to stay.

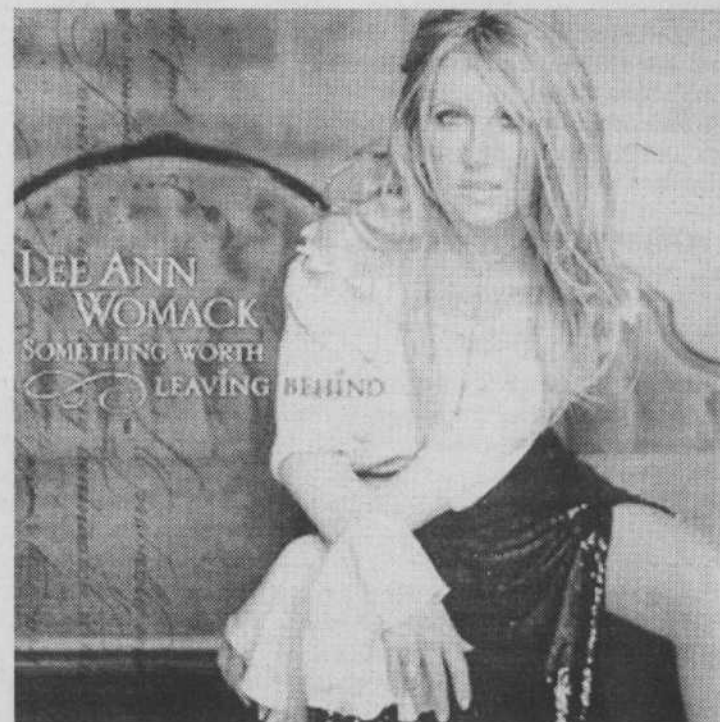
But the title track is not the only pearl on this new collection, which is carefully crafted and filled with all the emotion you can experience in life such as joy, pain and everything in between. There's the positive joy of 'I Saw Your Light' and the wisdom of the beautiful 'Forever Everyday'.

But Womack also knows how to have fun, as fans find out with the rockin' 'I Need You', a powerful and gritty number that will make you dance until you drop.

Womack uses all of her talent on 'Orphan Train' and 'You Should Have Lied', on which she gets to push her voice to the limit. Fans can find the Nashville sound on 'He'll Be Back', a style that suits the singer to perfection, while the 70's pop-style is noteworthy on 'When You Gonna Run To Me'.

The single 'Closing This Memory Down' is about an aching heartbreak. Womack's emotional rendition is breath taking as she makes listeners feel all the pain of a heartbreak.

There's also the peculiar poetry of 'Blame It On Me', a great number penned by Bruce Robison. 'Talk To Me' is moody and very stylized as Womack sings: "If you can tell me what you're thinking/Find the words for how you feel/Understanding is forgiving".



The new 12-song album proves how talented Womack is when it comes to picking the material she wants to sing. It also shows that she can very successfully cover a very wide gamut of styles without losing her punch.

Something in her voice sometimes remind me of Dolly Parton, and this is good. This fourth album might not be hard core country, but it is greatly crafted and a delight to listen to.

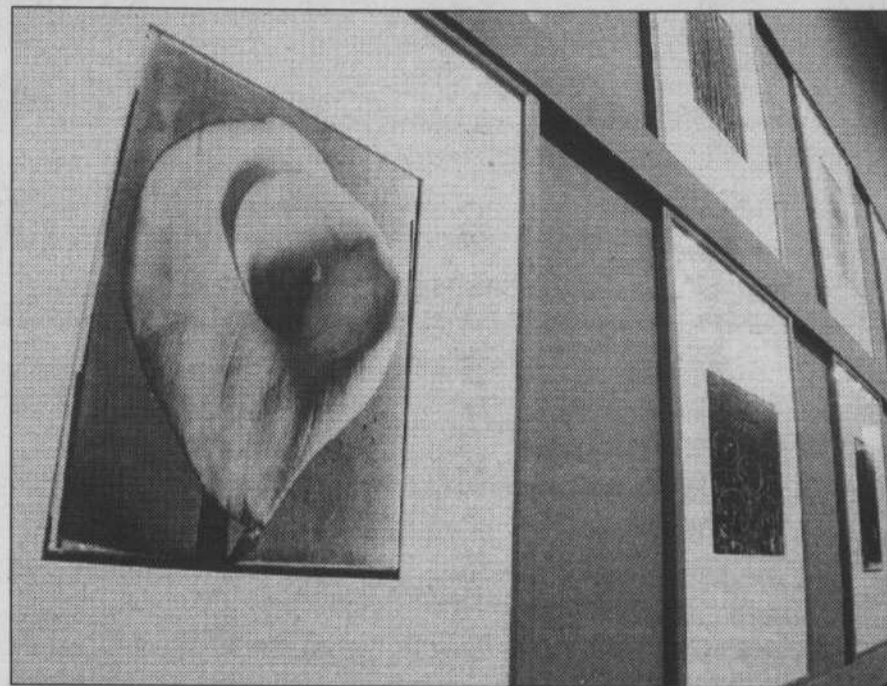
