Fête du Lac returns with sizzling lineup

Mark July 12 down on your calendar because that's when Sherbrooke's La Fête du Lac des Nations comes to life for its 24th year, kicking off an explosion of fireworks, musical performances, rides, and much more.

There will be 36 musical acts of all genres from popular and rock, to jazz. Big names like David Usher, The Tea Party, Jimmy Johnson, Offenbach, Les Trois Accords, Groovy Aardvark, Project Orange, Éric Lapointe, Yelo Melo, Yann Perreau, Richard Desjardins and Jonas.

Cuban music group Habana Café is also returning. One Quebecer of the group, Michel Ouellet, said it's an honour to be playing on Opening Night this time around.

"Our music is hot, very happy and rhythmic," said Ouellet. "It is meant to be celebrated. Every time we play, everyone dances — we even give the audience a quick dance lesson and pull people onto the stage during the performance. It's a great way to open the festival."

The group consists of eight musicians: A singer, pianist, guitarist, bassist, saxophonist, trumpeter, a timbale player, and Ouellet, who plays the conga/bongo.

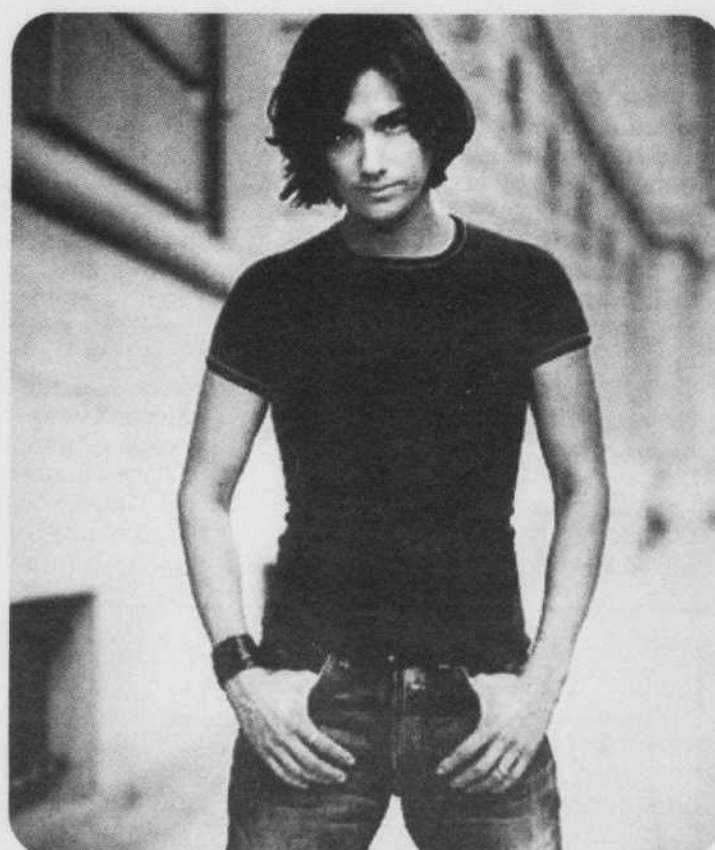
"We can't wait to perform outside for everyone," said Ouellet, who added that half of the group's songs will be traditional Cuban music, with the other half consisting of original compositions.

"Ours are more modern, but are done in the same spirit. We've got more of a Timba style going on."

Other featured acts include jazz artists Gwen, Coral Egan, Moonlight Girls, Dawn Tyler Watson and Quatuor à Médée. There will also be six performances with more of an international flavour by Lynda Thalie, Soraya Benitez, Alain-François, DJ Champion, Florent Vollant and Diamond Club.

Paul Shine and the Four O'clock Trio will also hit the stage every day at 4 p.m.

Aside from what's happening musically, all eyes will also be on the skies throughout the week, as the only pan-Canadian fireworks competition takes



place. For five nights, fireworks masters from across the country will try to outdo each other in spectacular performances capped with music by well-known pop artists.

Participants include Quebec's Apogée, Pro Fx from British Columbia, Big Bang Fireworks of Alberta, Ruggieri Fireworks & Special Effects from Saskatchewan, and Ontario's Firemaster Productions. A jury of 25 people will determine the overall winner.

There will, of course also be plenty of fun activities for the kids, including a skate park, rides, and face painting every afternoon. They can also be entertained by Annie Brocoli, Ronald, Carnaval des Animaux, and Cirque Paidzo.

Tuna mousse, the ultimate party dish

Dining

I am in São Paulo, Brazil, visiting family and friends. For two days I racked my brain trying to figure out a recipe that would be representative of my native town — and yet not too exotic. My family's house cook, Bibi, suggested one of her all-time favorites: an ultra simple tuna mousse that looks very snazzy, once unmoulded. There is hardly any work involved, and the end result is light and delicious, and the ideal appetizer to a spring dinner party. Enjoy!

Ingredients (for 6)
2 cans tuna in oil
1/2 medium onion
1 garlic glove
2 cups plain yogurt
2 packs unflavoured gelatin powder
1 cup loosely packed parsley
1/2 large lime
2 cups thick cream
1/2 tsp. Salt
1 tsp. Ketchup
1 cup water
1 head iceberg lettuce, as a garnish

Directions: Place a large cake mould (preferably a glass one) in the freezer for at least half hour.

Peel the onion and garlic, and put in a blender with the yogurt, parsley, tabasco, cream, salt and ketchup.

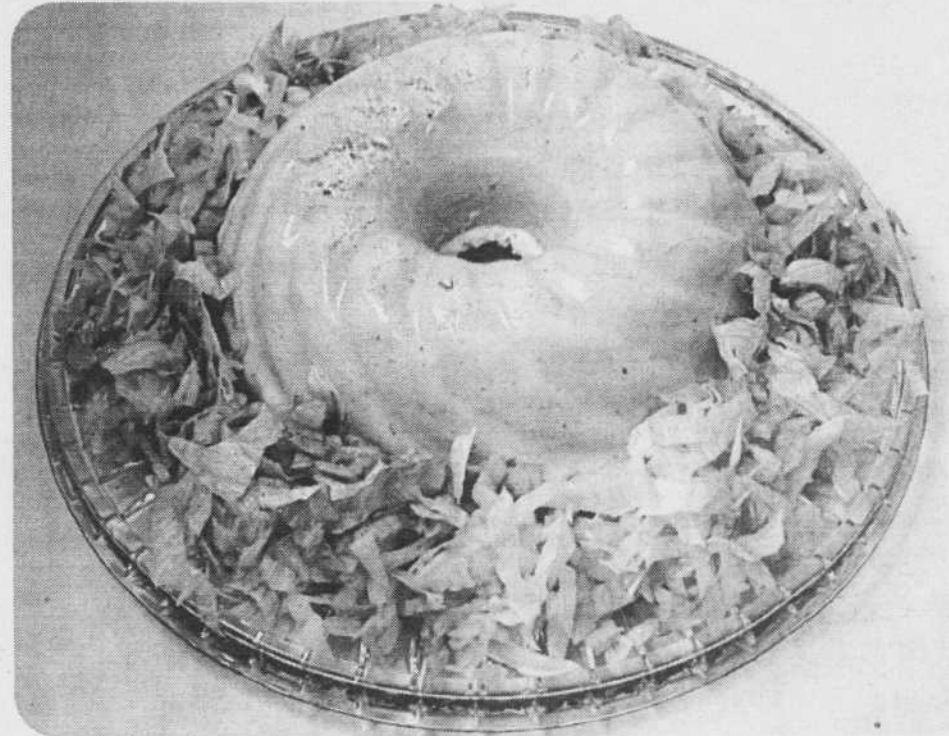
Squeeze the lime and add its juice to the mix. Blend for a couple of minutes until smooth.

Boil the cup of water (you may use the microwave), then dissolve the gelatin in it, whisking with a fork.

Add the diluted gelatin to the tuna mix. Pour into the frosty cake mould (if you are using a metal one, brush it with a little vegetable oil to avoid any trouble when unmoulding).

Let it set in the fridge for at least 2 hours. Moisten a dishcloth with hot water and wrap it around the mould for a couple of minutes. Remove.

Place a platter over mould and flip it over. Garnish with the iceberg lettuce, sliced thinly, or any other greens of your preference.

Sextet plays pop, with a touch of classical

At first glance, Atharaxia looks like a classical music sextet, but while the ensemble has all the traditional pieces – cello, violin, and piano – it is breaking the musical mould.

"The classical instruments aren't used in a classical way, explains Raphaël Pépin, 21, one of the group's founders. "We're not playing sonnets or concertos. We play pop music, but instead of having an electric guitar and a bass, we've replaced them with violins and cellos."

Pépin's home is littered with instruments. A piano dominates the living room, his cello is parked in the corner, and there's a pile of conga drums and maracas in his makeshift studio in the basement.

Pépin is a music major at the University of Sherbrooke. His partners in music – the other members of Atharaxia – are studying a range of subjects at university or CÉGEP, but all have musical backgrounds.

In spite of their classical training, Pepin said the members of Atharaxia have eclectic musical taste. "First and foremost we're all classical musicians. Then we asked ourselves: 'Do we want to play Beethoven our entire lives?'"

Pépin said the ensemble isn't trying to fit one musical category or another. He said artists such as Tori Amos and Loreena McKennitt have had an influence, adding the group brings together rock, pop, and world music, "but always with a classical arrangement."

Atharaxia hasn't had that many public performances, mostly playing receptions and competitions over the last four years. They're now set to stage a rare performance at the Centennial Theatre at Bishop's University.

A symphony orchestra made up of the best young musicians in Sherbrooke will back up the sextet. Pépin said musicians from the University of Sherbrooke, College de Sherbrooke, and a few high school prodigies make up the 40-member orchestra.

Pépin says having his compositions played by an orchestra is an honour. "It's a dream, I think, for any artist to

have his songs played by an orchestra. There is such a diversity of sound. It was a dream for us, especially to do it at our age. We're not known or anything."

The Conseil de la Culture de l'Estrie has made this event possible. The organization called for project ideas, and the ensemble submitted its plan to take its pop-styled classical music to the stage with the backing of a complete symphony orchestra. Atharaxia Symphonique won the backing of the Conseil.

Atharaxia was given enough money to get the project off the ground. René Bechard, a percussionist with the Sherbrooke Symphony Orchestra, is supervising the project.

Two orchestrators, Marc-Olivier Robidas and Jean-Francois Giguère, laboured over 16 Atharaxia's original pieces for eight months to come up with the score for the entire orchestra. All the while, they were still going to school. Robidas and Giguère will be conducting the orchestra when it takes the stage at Bishop's.

Pépin promises their brand of classical music is not for classical music connoisseurs, but he hopes they will be open to Atharaxia's brand of music.

"We hope people who are close to classical music will come to discover what we're doing and will be open to new things. They'll find a mélange of two worlds of music, but they'll discover good things."

It's easy to tell Pépin is thrilled about the project. It's not uncommon for musicians from any musical style to have the backing of an orchestra. Pépin said there is a difference, "at our age, at our beginning, even though we don't have a disc on the market, and it's with our very first songs. I think that's what is different."

The sextet will take centre stage at the concert on June 18 with the backing of the newly-minted symphony orchestra.

Atharaxia Symphonique will take place at the Centennial Theatre at Bishop's University on Saturday, June 18 at 8:00 pm. Tickets are \$10 for students and \$18 dollars for adults. For tickets, call (819) 822-9692.

Five questions with Sonia Wells

Q & A

Sonia Wells is a modest but very talented singer who now makes her home in the Eastern Townships.

Music is a big part of her life and sharing that passion comes easily to her, not only in English but also in a variety of other languages.

While she is an experienced performer as a soloist, her real sense of satisfaction and peace lies in performing with groups such as The Bishop's University Singers, Choromondo, the Crossing Borders Quintet and the Montreal Jubilation Gospel Choir that share her love of music.

Wells recently spoke with *The Record* from her home.

THE RECORD: What is it about Gospel music that holds your attention so much?

WELLS: "I am not what you would call a religious person, per say. It is the Gospel spirit that captures my attention, the exuberance, the sheer emotion that comes from that type of music which is so drenched in history. As a group, the Montreal Jubilation Gospel Choir sings many different types of music, in various languages, which is really exciting. We have done material with traditionally Gospel sounds like 'Amazing Grace' as well as familiar church chants and the South African national anthem.

"I originally studied theatre but once I saw this group perform I just knew it was something I wanted to be a part of. There is something about hearing Gospel music at its best that quite literally lifts people out of their seats just from the sheer power of what is being sung. Little do these people know but the rewards are equally as

great for us to be witnessing the effect of what we are doing has on our audiences."

THE RECORD: What other choirs are you involved with?

WELLS: "I was with Choromondo for a short period of time. The thing I liked most about this group of women who concentrate their efforts on singing world music was the great ambience of sharing. Allyna Harris is a wonderfully gifted and caring person who knows how to surround herself with talented people. Through working with her, I was exposed to a new and different repertoire of music.

"I find that having an ear for music makes it easier to learn new languages. The problem arises when someone can read the words phonetically off the paper but has no idea what the composer was thinking or how he was feeling when he wrote this particular piece – something is definitely lost from the performance if this scenario arises."

THE RECORD: Who is the Crossing Borders Quintet?

WELLS: "The Crossing Borders Quintet is a relatively new group made up of Ben Kinsley, Sarah Kinsley, Thurmond Knight, Jenny Major and myself. I met Ben through a musician friend and heard that he was looking for a singer. The concept behind the Quintet evolves around the fact that many who live in our border area have friends and family on both sides. Our members come from both Canada and the U.S.

"Our mandate is to perform benefit concerts, sharing music with other performers in order to help raise funds for important causes. We have done concerts that have raised funds for the Dixville Home, a scholarship fund in memory of Sarah's mother, to help send a team of students from Stanstead

College to participate in a Habitat for Humanity project in Mexico, and have been able to provide instruments for a school in Holland. Sharing our music and being able to bring these causes into the limelight is very important to all of us."

THE RECORD: Do you enjoy teaching music?

WELLS: "I really enjoy teaching music to my students at Stanstead College. The Choir Club is voluntary but sometimes the kids forget that it is not like most other clubs. It is important that you make an effort to retain what you learned from one time to the next to make it all come together.

"Leading up to a musical performance is like putting together a puzzle unlike other clubs where you learn something one time and are not required to think of it again until you want to. I can teach them the notes and the background but it is up to them to learn to put it together to make it work as a performance. A successful performance contains not only notes and words but also a sense of texture, the use of expressions to create special moments in a song and the ability to know when it is appropriate to fade out both quickly and at a slow pace in order to get the most out of the piece of music.

"I would like to teach younger kids as well some day. It is such a wonderful experience when you see a child's face light

up in that moment when he realizes that he has really accomplished something."

THE RECORD: What are the goals you have set for yourself?

WELLS: "I have never actually taken voice lessons but now that I am working on my BA in Music at Bishop's University, I have started taking lessons from Sarah Hoblyn who is an excellent instructor. My work with the University Singers and director Janice Crook has also been a wonderful experience. We give two concerts a year, one at Christmas time and one in the spring, which always has some kind of theme. The theme one year was People, Places and Times which gave us a wide repertoire to choose from. I got to sing 'Midnight Train to Georgia' which turned out really well.

"I am also in the process of teaching myself to play the piano. I already know the basics, it just takes lots of practice. My ultimate goal would be to perform like Sarah McCloughlin and Carol King, being able to accompany myself. I think it would add so much more to a solo performance."

OASIS

Don't Believe the Truth
(Epic)

After years of attempted reinvention, Oasis has arrived at a sound somewhere close to (What's the Story) Morning Glory?, the album that made them famous. The handful of albums in between Morning Glory and Don't Believe the Truth didn't make the same waves. The Gallagher brothers & friends have come back with a more mature version of themselves. Noel Gallagher still stands front and centre, writing and producing the majority of tracks. Within the band, however, his attitude has changed and he's relinquished some control. The album has a number of marquee tracks that showcase the band's signature sound, revealing the influence of the best bands of the original British Invasion. Adding new drummer Zak Starkey — the son of Ringo Starr — may threaten to push the band's Beatles impersonation to new heights.

SCREAMING TREES

Ocean of Confusion
(Epic-Legacy)

The grungy underbelly of Seattle's music scene moved to the mainstream after Nirvana became a surprise success, opening the doors for everyone else. The Screaming Trees were part of this scene, and they kept good company. Soundgarden and Nirvana were fans, and the grunge prince, Kurt Cobain, was among those who collaborated with members of the Trees on side projects. The Trees found moderate success, but were caught in the void between mainstream and the musical underground. In the '90s, they put out a handful of releases on Epic. Much of Ocean of Confusion is plucked from those last albums, with a couple of unreleased songs thrown in for good measure. Though the Trees didn't see the same commercial success as other grunge bands, this album deserves a space alongside their Seattle brethren.

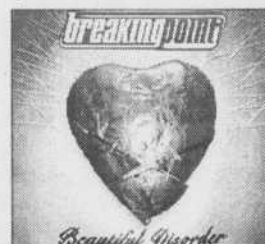

BREAKING POINT
Beautiful Disorder
(Wind-Up Records)

After four years of silence, Breaking Point has come down with the sophomore blues on Beautiful Disorder. The Memphis-based group emerged in the radio rock movement in the wake of grunge. Its debut album, Coming of Age, drew some comparisons to Creed and shared the same musical real estate as of other southern rockers, such as 3 Doors Down. The album is plagued with pop rock clich s, from echo effects to double-tracked vocals to string section accompaniment. Breaking Point hasn't undergone any great changes between albums, but the band fails to come up with anything new on this second effort. The album is brash and energetic, but the lyrics are empty and the music slowly fades into the background.

DAVE MATTHEWS BAND
Stand Up
(Sony/BMG)

Dave Matthews Band stakes a similar claim here to Bruce Springsteen's Devils and Dust, in protesting the political right while mythologizing American re-

silence in the wake of 9-11. But there's a more urban feel to DMB's easy-going R&B and groove. Akin to DMB's Under the Table and Breathing or Matthews' solo outing, there's a quieter assurance to the songs. The drumming of Carter Beauford continues to anchor the sound on the album's highlights — the African beats of 'Dreamgirl', the Cajun influences in 'Hello Again' and 'Louisiana Bayou', the jazzy 'Stolen Away on 55th and 3rd', and the Police-like 'Stand Up'.

LCD Soundsystem
(Capitol)

James Murphy's angry-young-man songs are channelled through rap, but LCD Soundsystem is all groove and dance rhythms. It's an interesting and compelling mix and this collection has 16 tracks over a pair of CDs, making it a bargain. Lead tracks include 'Too Much Love', 'Yeah' (two versions, Crass and Pre-



tentious), the old-style R&B of 'On Repeat', and two musical navel-gazing songs, 'Daft Punk is Playing at My House' and 'Losing My Edge'. 'Never As Tired As When I'm Waking Up', a Beatles-like oasis in the middle of all the fury, is a gem.

Out of Exile
(Epic)

Much depended on this sophomore effort from Chris Cornell and Audioslave. Could the band's mercurial personalities bear up to the pressure of a sequel to one of the top CDs of 2002? Three years is a long absence in the fickle pop music marketplace. The good news is Out of Exile, with its Bad Company-like title track, is polished and assured. The songs are immediately accessible and Tom Morello remains that most idiosyncratic of lead guitarists. And Cornell has rock's best pipes outside U2, especially now that Rob Thomas has gone MOR.

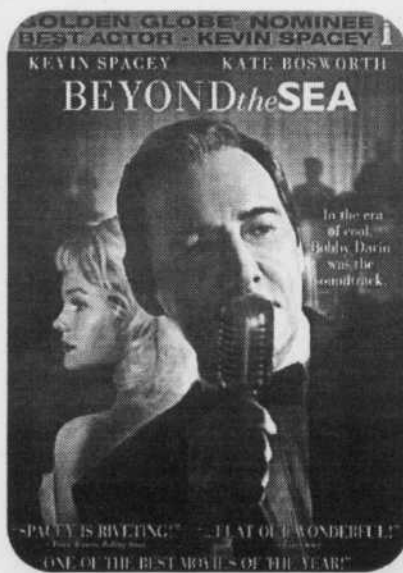

Author says hours on street led to book Bangkok Tattoo

Best-selling British author John Burdett doesn't deny it: he does spend a lot of time in Bangkok bars talking to young hookers.

But he also insists that these hours of conversation were invaluable in helping him to understand Thai culture and to ensure a solid spine of realism for his latest exotic thriller, Bangkok Tattoo, which has just been published in Canada by Knopf.

In fact, Bangkok's prostitutes proved to be such a resource that he ended up realizing that he had written more than just a fast-paced mystery about the grisly murder of a young CIA operative, that the novel did reflect underlying social concerns.

In fact he sees your average young Thai hooker as something of a heroine.

"I've been talking to the girls who work the bars for years now," Burdett, 53, says by phone from Toronto. "I've been to their homes in the country. None of them are Bangkok girls, they all come from peasant subsistence farms and they're all looking after their families."

In researching the book, Burdett learned some hard truths about economics in the Far East — particularly the impact on this region of subsidized agriculture.

"I read in The New York Times about a year ago that the wealthy countries of the world spend almost \$1 billion a day on farm subsidies, which artificially keeps the price of agricultural produce low on world markets. So, for example, it's practically impossible for a Thai

farmer to sell rice to Japan because Japan heavily subsidized its own rice farms, and the long and short of it is that these farmers have to be 'subsidized' in some way."

One of the most reliable subsidies for a subsistence-level Thai farmer is a caring daughter's earnings from prostitution.

"What happens is that these heroic young ladies go to work the bars in Bangkok — usually for a couple of years, not much longer than that — and send the money home."

Burdett's researches have revealed parallel situations in other parts of the world, including Africa and South America. He says that his novels are not written with a "deliberate social purpose" — but if one emerges, it is merely reflecting

"the underlying economic reality of what's going on."

He knows of three instances where girls have sent their sex earnings home so their parents can buy a water buffalo.

"Water buffalos are extremely useful. They're Thailand's tractors. They do all sorts of agricultural work."

So he gets irritated when some Western TV show airs yet another "lurid and titillating program" about the Southeast Asia sex industry "with a heavy moral judgment at the end — but nobody mentions agricultural subsidies. It's very simple. If people are offended by sex for sale in Southeast Asia, then they really ought to be lobbying against the agricultural subsidies, because that's what's really driving it."

Guys genetically more suited for the barbecue?

In her book *The Rituals of Dinner*, the normally sensible and practical "anthropologist of everyday life" Margaret Visser, gives remarkably short shrift to barbecuing. In an otherwise entertaining and insightful book, it is a blatant omission.

Worse, she uses what little space she devotes to barbecuing to take gratuitous sideswipes at guys who, as the barbecuing world knows, are masters of the outside cook-out and genetically more suited to producing stupendous meals be it in the backyard or great outdoors. Why? Who knows?

Nature is mysterious sometimes.

Visser, an erudite South African-sounding person (she was actually born in Rhodesia, now Zambia) often heard on CBC radio, offers a theory as to why males so effortlessly dominate the barbecue arena: "In the modern ceremony of the barbecue," she says, "there remains an echo of the ancient ritual of the impromptu meal at the scene of the hunt."

She's onto something, maybe, but her analysis quickly goes awry. "The fare is 'party' or 'picnic' as opposed to everyday," she continues. "These are therefore occasions when men may jocularly don aprons and set about enjoying the process of cooking."

Barbecues begin with the male-dominated fire making. They take place outside the house — though not necessarily very far from it — and the 'masculine' live fire is accompanied by the special grids, knives and skewers.

The women tend to take care of the

salads, the plates, the dessert, and washing the dishes afterwards."

What can she possibly mean by 'male dominated fire making'? Most of us aficionados of the barbecue simply turn on the gas and press a knob.

The knob makes a deep clicking sound and following an 'popping' as the gas ignites, the flames appear. What's 'male dominated' about that?

And what's this "jocularly don aprons" bit? A little patronizing? A touch contemptuous? And what's wrong with donning an apron, anyway — jocularly or otherwise? Why is it the art of barbecuing is continually being undermined?

The tendency of women to take care of peripheral matters, such as salads and

plates, is of course quite reasonable. The barbecue is a demanding beast. One can easily ruin a perfectly good meal, and be the target of the quiet derision of guests, by letting the concentration slip. Attending to a meal's complement while focusing on the star of the plate is a dangerous double act.

Fortunately, there are deep barbecue thinkers out there — people who understand the craft and its pitfalls.

Opie inspired by Cinderella Man

Back when he was Opie Taylor — the freckle-faced embodiment of apple pie and the American Dream — Ron Howard developed a fascination for one of the darkest chapters of 20th century history.

"I can't even tell you how old I was, or what grade I would have been in because I didn't really go to school in a formal environment, but I lost myself in the subject of the Great Depression. I took out all the books in the Burbank Public library I could get my hands on," says Howard, over the phone from his office in Los Angeles.

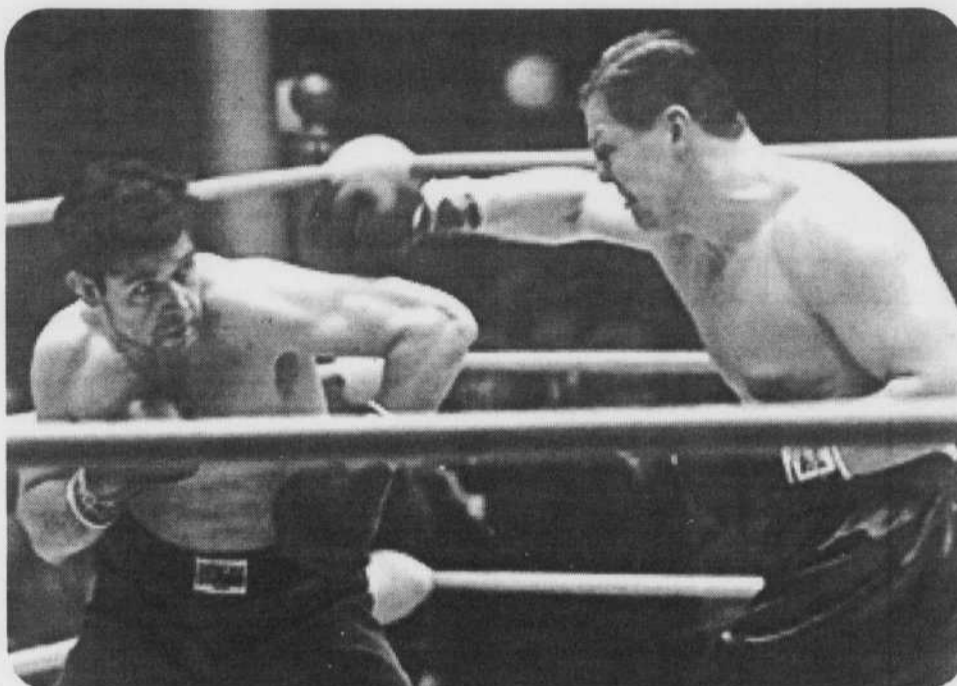
"It was disturbing and shocking to me, particularly the images of the urban poor. I'd seen rural poverty, but the image of men in business suits trying to sell apples on the street was new to me. My world felt secure, but here was proof that it wasn't.

"Things could change at any time and it made me think a lot — it made me think, what would I do?"

For Howard, the short answer was make a movie. Swept away by the images of aloof sadness captured by Dorothea Lange, Walker Evans and Ben Shawn, Howard made his first Depression-themed movie for his school class. He says it was a documentary that took weeks to complete.

That school project was one of Howard's first directorial efforts and taught him just how labour-intensive the filmmaking process can be, but even now, after directing award-winning movies such as *A Beautiful Mind*, *Apollo 13* and *Splash*, Howard says it never feels like work when you're passionate about it, and years later, he's still passionate about the Depression.

Cinderella Man is Howard's latest labour of love set against the backdrop of a broken nation. Based on the true story of boxing great Jim Braddock, *Cinderella Man* features Academy Award-winner Russell Crowe as Braddock, a boxer who came back from anonymity and a lost boxing licence to beat heavyweight champion Max Baer in 1935.

"It's a story of suffering and survival, but I think we took a very humanistic look at it. It's not just a boxing movie, or a movie about the Depression. It's also a love story about a married couple. As someone coming up on his 30th wedding anniversary (June 7), I think that's a little too rare these days."

Howard says he's taken heat for seeking bright spots in tragic tales. Critics have called his films the cinematic equivalent of Prozac and *Cinderella Man* is sure to be painted with the same smiley-face brush because it, too, has a "happy ending."

The minute we get on to the subject of Howard's reputation for making art films without an edge, his voice suddenly turns slightly staccato.

It's the first time in the 30-minute conversation he doesn't sound like Richie Cunningham picking up his prom date.

"I have one little pet peeve and it's the way the critical community tends to see tragedies and cautionary tales

as intrinsically more valuable.

"I have no problem with going out there and trying to acknowledge the bright side, and be optimistic. But I don't understand why the cynics out there think an affirmative story is less important than a negative one."

Howard says on a personal level, he's always felt the bright side was more rewarding — emotionally, spiritually and even artistically.

"Look, I'm 51-years-old and I've seen a lot of heartache in my life. I've seen tragedy. I've seen terrible things happen to good people for no reason. I get it. When I talk to my kids about it, I tell them there are moments of real joy and achievement — and those are the moments you live for, but the scales don't really balance out.

"You pay dearly for those moments, but that's why it's so important to acknowledge those fleeting moments when things work. Those are the moments that get you through."

Howard's sensibilities are evident throughout *Cinderella Man* as he bal-

ances the pitch of the Depression with the beacon of Braddock's bid for the title. On the dark side, Howard takes the viewer to the very nadir of Braddock's life, after breaking his hand, losing his fight licence and nearly losing his kids to poverty.

As bad as things are for Braddock, they're even worse for those around him. Those who can't pay rent live in a makeshift tent city called Hooverville, located in the middle of New York's Central Park — all of which Howard depicts in dirty gray detail.

"Those images of the urban poor really moved me as a kid, because it was a reminder of how the system failed people. The American Dream has worked out well for me — to the point where my mother always said I was born with a four-leaf clover behind my ear — but it doesn't work out for everybody.

"This nation was almost on the verge of a farmers' revolt and things still aren't right.

"Today, we call these people the working poor, but it's the same thing. They are people who just can't make it — the system is failing them," he says.

"But that's why I was so taken with the story of Jim Braddock. The system failed him, but he didn't give up. The basic truths of his journey offered a range of attitudes about (the American Dream), and so did the genre — as a boxing movie — but that didn't push me into finding an optimistic angle where there was none. This is a story of struggle and survival."

Though Howard is currently doing pre-production on the highly anticipated film version of Dan Brown's bestselling *DaVinci Code* with actor Tom Hanks, he says he knows he and Crowe will work together again.

"Evolutionary, for me, is a sense of optimism — that we're moving towards something better. I can generally tell which is which, and working with Russell has been evolutionary for me. It's how I try to guide my life."

Dust to Glory takes us into heart of racing *Movies*

There's a lot of dust, but not much glory in Dana Brown's new film that takes us into the sand-caked heart of the Baja 1000 — one of the world's longest point-to-point motor races that stretches across the Baja peninsula.

The dust comes care of the many silt beds that seem to swallow a vehicle whole.

The glory — or what there is of it — is really just peer recognition, a friendly pat on the back from the other riders who share the same bonehead need to prove themselves man enough, or woman enough, to finish the gruelling, bone-crushing, bum-numbing course in under 32 hours.

Why some people push the very limits of personal endurance is something most of us without the daredevil gene will never understand, but that doesn't mean we can't find pleasure in playing voyeur.

Quite the contrary. The more dangerous and crazy the given stunt is, the more pleasure we derive in watching it all unfold. Hence, the success of Fear Factor and other reality shows

that leave us white-knuckled on the couch. Evil Knievel built an entire career on this.

Dana Brown understands this somewhat pathetic fact of human psychology and gives us a rubber-necker's front row seat to the insanity in Dust to Glory.

Using dozens of lightweight cameras to capture the action, Brown has a broad canvas of shots to choose from, and gives us everything from a helmet-cam view of a motorcycle crash to scenic, helicopter shots panning over miles of sunbaked sand and teal blue ocean.

What holds this general study of the race together are the personalities. Using Mike "Mouse" McCoy as his central figure, Brown focuses on the one participant who wants to finish

the race singlehanded.

Contestants usually share the draining driving duties with two or three people. But McCoy was adamant about being the sole driver on this 1,000-mile journey. That makes us sympathetic to his crazy cause because we watch McCoy lose his mind over the course of the film.

That's half the sick fun, of course. We get to watch McCoy disintegrate mentally, from being uptight about his hands locking up, to repeating the same story several times over, delirious, dehydrated and sun-stroked.

At times, Brown's cameras almost feel too detached. After all, these may be experienced racers who understand the risks, but when someone is making potentially suicidal decisions as a result of fatigue, any responsible viewer feels a need to intervene.

Fortunately, Brown is a man of conscience. The son of legendary surfer and filmmaker Bruce Brown, Dana Brown has made movies about extreme sports before.

He followed in his father's footsteps and made Endless Summer Revisited, the sequel to his dad's Endless Summer surf documentary.

He also made the recent Step Into Liquid, which explored the everyman's love of surfing around the world.

Dust to Glory works on the same principle as the first two. It finds a few charismatic characters who push themselves into death-defying, but photogenic, situations.

It also delves into the larger "meaning" of the activity from a pop culture perspective by excavating archival footage, literary connections and celebrity appearances.

The film is paced more like a TV show, with regular breaks and fade outs, but as a feature, it proves Brown is more than a one-trick pony emulating his dad.

It proves he is a filmmaker in his own right, and one who's doing more than exploiting extreme sports for his own selfish gain. Brown is making movies about the dark side of the human psyche and its romance with death — in a fun, unaffected way.

That's a lot to balance on two wheels going 100 mph, but Brown kicks up a wheelie and makes you go "Wheeeeeee!"

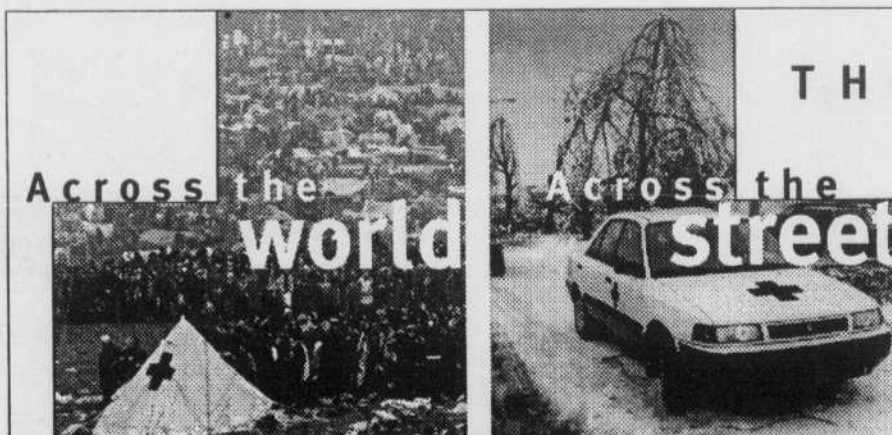
