HOUSE OF COMMONS. (Per Dominion News) OTTAWA, March 3.—The SPEAKER took the Chair at 9 o'clock. Bills introduced.—Mr. McLENNAN introduced the Bill to amend the Act respecting the Red River and Assiniboine Bridge Company.
