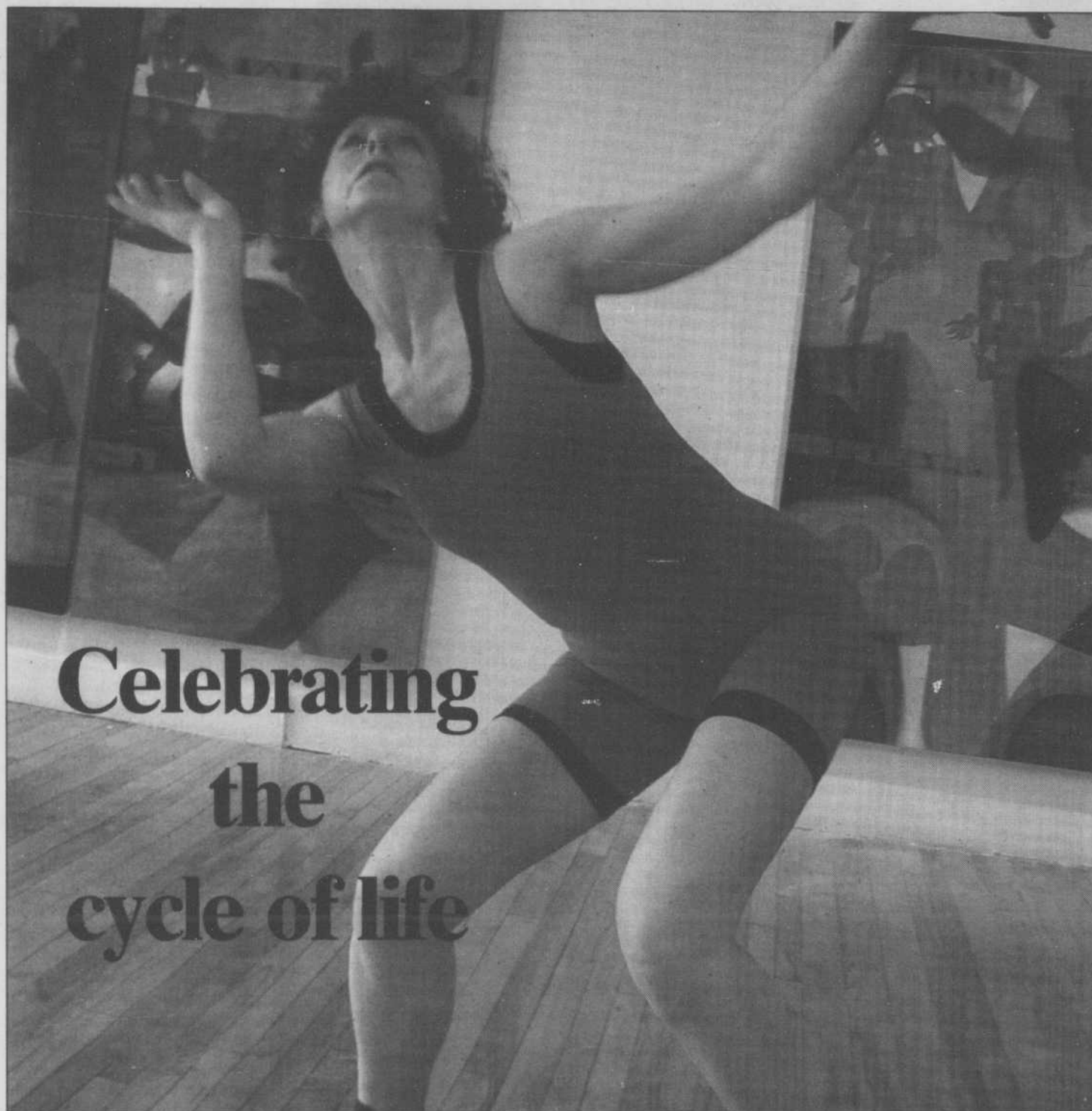

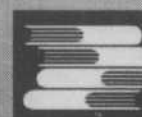

Enigmatic Sutherland returns to Toronto stage

Enigma Variations is a Sutherland family project

Donald Sutherland, a resident of Georgeville, is in Toronto for the month of March, starring in *Enigma Variations* at the plush Royal Alexandra Theatre.

Sutherland hasn't performed live in Toronto since his student days at the U of T. This play by Eric Emmanuel Schmitt, a hit in Paris, is the first to woo him back to the stage in 20 years. The involvement of his wife, Francine Racette, who co-produced the English-language version, and their son Roeg Sutherland, who polished up his Princeton thesis translation for the Toronto production, makes this something of a family affair, says Sutherland.

Torontonians have been thronging to see the respected movie actor in the flesh, boorishly applauding him as the curtain rises. (The couple next to us even came equipped with binocs.) Would this two-man play be drawing crowds if not for Sutherland and, secondarily, Tony Award winner John Rubinstein (son of conductor Arthur)? Probably not. Does the experience live up to hype? As its title suggests and its author intended, it's debatable.

Enigma Variations is named after Sir Edward Elgar's composition, which has both a musical and thematic presence in the play. The story is intriguing, although as preposterous as its pompous main character. The debate on the nature of love is a provocative philosophical exercise - it's the serious 'purpose' of this wordy one-actor. Not completely a comedy, tragedy, philosophic treatise or mystery, *Variations* has many themes. Above all, it is a love story.

Abel Znorko is a Nobel Prize-winning novelist who, for 15 years, has hermitted himself on an remote island. His latest book, a correspondence between two lovers voluntarily separated to preserve the love they fear will

otherwise die, is admired far and wide. It draws the interest of Erik Larsen, a self-proclaimed journalist who succeeds in arranging an interview with the reclusive author.

The ensuing encounter between the two men at first taxes one's patience. Znorko is insufferably condescending, Larsen comes on meek and reverent. But, once the subtext begins to surface, the audience finds itself on a roller coaster of a plot which gives way to a series of twists and turns, each more surprising than the last. The servile quietly masters, or does he?

The distinguished looking Sutherland, a fine figure of a man with shoulder-length white hair and speckled beard, physically embodies the arrogant Znorko. But Znorko needs to be even more bombastic than Sutherland could muster the night we caught the show. Only when Larsen's succession of revelations shattered Znorko's ivory tower existence did Sutherland fulfill our expectations. His whole body crumbled in upon itself as Znorko faced the illusions which had sustained him for so many years. It's an arduous balance (that, on other nights, has apparently shifted in the opposite direction) - but Znorko must be big enough in the first half to fall really hard at the end.

Like *Art* before it, this play reflects the philosophic preoccupations of a modern French playwright but North American audiences are less accustomed to following complex arguments. They become restless in their seats until the actors show them what it all means. *Enigma Variations* makes demands on its audience, a rarity these days. For those who hang in, for those willing to enter into the debate, it will pay off. Good to the very last line. *Variations* runs at the Royal Alex to April 1, after which it may be heading to Broadway. For tickets, call 416-872-1212.

Last chance to see Move Over, Mrs. Markham

Move Over, Mrs. Markham, a comedy by Ray Cooney and John Chapman, is the latest staging by the Knowlton Players being performed at the Knowlton Pub Playhouse through March 19.

The farce marks the second time in the director's chair for Bill Jarand, whose other talents include acting and stage design. The current production, which began with auditions scarcely six weeks before, pulled together a cast, crew, set and publicity in that short period of time.

The ability to do so, said Jarand, is a tribute to the talents of the cast and crew, which includes Elaine Cooper Marsh, Sarah Hoblyn, Lucy Hoblyn-McAuley, Renée-Louise Law, Frank Johnston Main, Roger de la Mare, Steve Trew and Kate Wisdom.

Pulling together all of the elements of an ensemble production was a challenge. After selecting a cast of nine from more than 20 hopefuls, Jarand began rehearsals with exercises to help cast members discover the basics of wackiness for this high-speed farce.

"The challenge was to try to make everyone feel at ease before the pressure of learning lines and learning blocking set in," he said. "Everyone was receptive."

Jarand put them to work discovering the elements of slapstick through intensive workshops practicing exaggerated motions and physical contact, not easy for people whose daytime occupations include, among others, two school principals, businessmen, a broadcaster and an engineer.

Not so easy also was the task of slipping upstanding citizens into the roles of the various philandering couples whose destinies converge in the small walk-up apartment.

Jarand is most impressed with Frank Johnston Main as Phillip Markham, the wayward publisher, who is hit, thrown and tripped on stage.

"Frank is the least experienced of the performers but he is fantastic," said Jarand. "I'm flabbergasted by his performance."

Move Over Mrs. Markham differed from Jarand's first directorial project, Neil Simon's Plaza Suite, a series of three short plays with few supporting characters.

He said the current ensemble production required his actors develop their characters to make them believable and sympathetic, as well as funny.

Final evening performances take place March 17 and 18 at 8 pm. A matinee performance will take place on Sunday March 19 at 2 pm. Tickets are available at the door but reservations are recommended. For reservations or ticket prices call (450) 263-1061.

A symphony for the senses

Multi-media 'Orifices' at Galerie Horace

Now is the time to open one's mind to 'Orifices'. Third in a series called, 'Cycle de vie et de mort III', this multi-media show at Galerie Horace is literally sensual.

Centred around the bold polyptychs of Monique Girard, it combines dance, performed and created by Brigitte Graff, the music of Allyn Harris and photography (in the form of a slide show) of Stéphane Fiore.

Everywhere, the eye and ear are enlightened, whether by the painted hanging glass (moulded by Girard and fired by Gilles Payette) sculptures of mouths, breasts, vaginas, penises, rectums, the bold textured polyptychs in

primary and complementary colours containing their own mythology.

In front of each group of paintings is a coloured urn with mythological details from the paintings inscribed on each. Enveloping everything is the sound of sniffing which is transformed into breathing then crying and sounds of passion.

As Brigitte Graff, in an orange and black leotard, sinuously danced out the paintings, the harmony among the different elements was in evidence. Each sense is represented by a group of paintings comprised of three large canvases and five smaller ones mounted above. Each group of paintings mixes a different kind of bird life, indigenous to Quebec with bodies congregating, expressing a sense.

The five tryptychs are: Les Regardantes Observées (sight), Les Langue Savoureuse (taste), Les Gracieuses Odorants (smell), Les Entendants branchés (ears) and Les Caresses bienaimés.

For Monique Girard, art is not a frivolous endeavour.

"Humans and nature are fragile," she said. "It is necessary to have our eyes opened to keep humanity and nature together. It's the responsibility of each person and the artist too. It's the artist's responsibility to have something to tell, not just to create for fun. The work is not a decoration but a harmonization of music and dance

and photography together."

Brigitte Graff concurs. "I'm in communication with the picture. I don't just look and do. The work is a long process. The body lives with the material in communication," Graff said. "It is important for us all to develop complicity if we use different media. Nothing is separate. Everything is done together."

Allyn Harris, composer, explores a new world.

"This work is experimental, much more in the realm of a soundscape. I started by recording footsteps as the basic track. The first sounds that came to mind were footsteps - something which could trigger memories of experiences we have had with different senses. Other sounds are layered on top of it."

This multilayered sound is the perfect accompaniment to Girard's paintings created through layering acrylics and polymers to achieve visual and mental depth.

The Fox Family plays Adirondack bluegrass

The Fox Family will be the lead band in the second concert of Townships Bluegrass and Old Tyme Music Society's Winter Concert Tour on Tuesday, March 21 at 8 p.m. at the Waterloo Royal Canadian Legion.

Hot on the heels of a spectacular opening by IBMA Award winner Mountain Heart, this family trio from Old Forge, NY will perform its distinct mix of bluegrass, country, gospel and folk on the winter Canadian tour that will take them across Ontario from North Bay to Ottawa en route to their single Quebec performance in Waterloo.

Upstate New York has proven to be fertile ground for bluegrass talent, including the Gibson Brothers Band, who recently went on tour with Ricky Skaggs.

The Fox Family, who hail from the heart of the Adirondacks, have been touring together since 1982. The group was nominated for IBMA's 1994 Emerging Artists of the Year and has performed in IBMA's showcase in 1992 and 1995. They have released two CDs (available from Sierra Records): "Follow My Lead" (1995) and "When It Comes to Blues" (1996).

For those who are avid followers, since 1990, they have staged their own Fox Family Festival hosting performances by established and emerging bluegrass talent, including The Osborne Brothers, the Lonesome River Band and the Nashville Bluegrass Band.

Acoustic guitarist Kim Fox also provides lead vocals for the group and was nominated for IBMA's 1994 Female Vocalist of the Year. Barb Fox plays bass and provides vocal harmony, while Joel Fox plays banjo. L'Estrie, baromètre culturel

Nous l'oublions parfois, mais il est une caractéristique bien particulière à notre région qui nous confère, à titre de spectateurs estriens, certains privilèges. L'un d'eux est d'avoir régulièrement la chance d'assister à des premières. Le fait est que les promoteurs - en tous genres, évidemment - considèrent l'Estrie comme une région "baromètre". Nouvelle gueule, nouveau concept, nouveau numéro, nouvel album..., c'est souvent à nous que revient l'insigne honneur de décider de certains détails, voire du sort entier d'un tout nouveau spectacle.

En fait, pour peu que nous soyons curieux, il nous est souvent loisible, avant même la métropole, de découvrir les créations toute chaudes et les éventuels grands succès de nos artistes préférés. C'est précisément ce à quoi nous avons droit, ces temps-ci, avec le dernier spectacle de l'un des auteurs-compositeurs québécois les plus aimés et les plus respectés. C'est en effet en Estrie que Paul Piché a décidé d'offrir les premiers moments de son *Voyage*, titre de son dernier spectacle et album.

Après une escale dans la petite et charmante salle du Pavillon des arts et de la culture de Coaticook le mois dernier, il

nous arrive ce soir au Centre culturel de l'Université de Sherbrooke. Qu'indiquera votre baromètre durant *Le Voyage*?

Mais l'institution estrienne par excellence, pour la découverte de nouvelles têtes d'affiche ou le rodage de spectacles, demeure incontestablement le Vieux Clocher de Magog. Avec l'ouverture de celui de Sherbrooke, cette vocation s'est encore accentuée, comme en fait foi la présence, tous les samedis de mars, de Guy Nantel, un humoriste qu'on dit très prometteur. Ce nom vous est familier? Dans ce cas, vous étiez sans doute un fidèle auditeur de la regrettée émission de télé *La course autour du monde*, alors que ce dernier était un participant fort apprécié, et justement pour son humour.

Quelle note lui accorderez-vous cette fois?

GIGUE CELTIQUE OU SYMPHONIE ROMANTIQUE

Toutes ces histoires de baromètre accentuent ma hâte de voir arriver le printemps! En fait, j'oserais même dire que le "paysage" m'apparaît aujourd'hui un peu plus vert qu'à l'habitude... pas vous? C'est aujourd'hui la Saint-Patrice, fête des Irlandais, et nos Cantons-de-l'Est se promettent, samedi soir, de la célébrer gaiement et vertement dans au moins deux lieux on ne peut plus propices. Le Café de Lafontaine de North Hatley sera l'hôte du trio celtique Alan Jones, avec flûtes irlandaises, cornemuse et harpe celtique, alors que le Centre d'art de Richmond propose le groupe Orealis, qui donne dans la tradition irlandaise mais aussi dans l'interprétation de pièces écossaises et québécoises, dont quelques-unes en français.

Dans un registre bien différent, l'Orchestre symphonique de Sherbrooke nous convie demain, salle Maurice-O'Bready, à une soirée consacrée aux *Grands romantiques*. On pourra y entendre, entre autres, l'*Ouverture Rosamunde* de Franz Schubert ainsi qu'une interprétation dite fantaisiste sur le thème de l'opéra *Carmen*, de Bizet, par

le flûtiste Denis Bluteau. À noter que ce concert, qui est aussi le dernier de la saison régulière, sera enregistré par Radio-Canada.

TOMBER SOUS LE CHARME

Il ne reste plus qu'une semaine pour tomber sous le charme d'une exposition qui, à mon avis, vaut le déplacement. Il s'agit de *La tombée des nues* d'Alain Provencher, présentée jusqu'au 25 mars, à la galerie ArtAzo, située rue Wellington Nord, à Sherbrooke. Allez admirer la précision presque photographique et la tendresse qui émane de ces magnifiques dessins exécutés au fusain et que l'artiste a créé en "hommage à la beauté de la femme". Les textes touchants de Luce Bellavance accompagnent fort bien ce travail d'une rare délicatesse, me semble-t-il, et d'une grande beauté.

Enfin, pour une deuxième semaine, Presse Boutique Café poursuit ses projections des Nouveautés de l'ONF. Pour ceux que la question des aliments modifiés génétiquement préoccupe, le documentaire *Main basse sur les gènes*, présenté mardi à 19h30, promet d'être particulièrement intéressant. Réalisé par la chercheuse Louise Vandelac et Karl Parent, réalisateur à la Société Radio-Canada, ce reportage fort documenté a mérité le Prix du président lors du Festival télésience.

Tales from home fires in Compton inspire author

Oscar Dhu comes to life in a new book

On September 16, a few months after the establishment of the Sherbrooke Record in 1897 this item was inserted in print:

"Mr. A.B. McKay, of Gould, better known as "Oscar Dhu," has joined the staff of contributors to the Daily Record. He will also canvas the eastern portion of

Compton County for new subscribers to the paper. He is a young man with considerable natural ability, and a distinct style of his own, his few pieces published in the past having made for him a name beyond his own immediate neighborhood. In the future "Oscar Dhu's" best writings will be published in these columns.

Oscar Dhu, that is Angus MacKay, was of the Highland community in Lingwick of Compton County, but spent his early years at Capelton where his father worked in the copper mines in the 1860s and 1870s. Later he worked as a lad for in the Sherbrooke woolen mills of the Paton Manufacturing Company where his older brother-in-law was a finisher. In the late 1880s, while in his early twenties, he began to assert a role among the Highlanders as a bard singing his poetry at their local ceilidhs, and gradually he es-

established himself as a writer with columns in the Sherbrooke newspapers. His name became well known during the Donald Morrison affair of this time when he in 1892 published his book-length poem Donald Morrison, the Canadian Outlaw. With the exception of the Bible, this work was to become the most highly prized book among the Highlanders. Several times it was copied out by hand by individuals who could not obtain a copy.

Oscar established quite a name for himself among the Highlanders of Compton County. In fact, this accomplishment was quite remarkable when one considers the poverty of his people coming from their remote corner of the Isle of Lewis. Despite this poverty and the lack of any family background in literacy, Oscar became quite well read for his day, and well known for his skills with the pen and his talents for entertaining both on the piano and with his poetry, which he sang.

After a trying ordeal where he was sued by the British American Land Company for expressing his sympathies for suffering Highlanders, he left for the American southwest in 1898 and then for

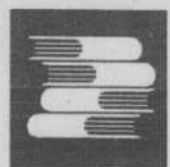
Seattle where he spent his later years. But his name lived on among the Compton Highlanders. Besides the above volume, in 1918 in Seattle his nephew printed another book of his poems, *By Trench and Trail*. But still much of his work was unknown and unavailable to the public. To this end, the present writer, a grand-nephew, has spent some eleven years researching and writing a new volume *Oscar & Finlay, Bards of Scottish Lingwick*. To this end he canvassed sources across the continent for writings of Oscar's and also researched old newspaper files to glean out remnants. The *Oscar & Finlay* volume devotes a hundred pages to Oscar's poetry and on the poetry of those who remained, "the Compton survivors." The work's 400 pages pay high tribute to the oral culture and ceilidhs of these Highlanders. To the author it appears that much of their strength and quality was due to their becoming deeply bonded through their singing and storytelling around the peat fires in their Lewis blackhouses and around their stoves in the log cabins and farm houses of Compton.

Disgrace: a beautifully structured, passionate story

Coetzee's Booker Prize winner packs an emotional wallop

Every so often, one comes away from reading a book in such a state of awe that to describe it seems a superficial gesture. Book jacket clichés like profound, poignant, astonishing and harrowing have of late become more eulogistic than praiseworthy.

So it is no wonder I am at a loss for words in describing 'Disgrace' by J.M. Coetzee, winner of the 1999 Booker Prize.

Having said this, I will however proceed. On one level, 'Disgrace' is the story of a twice-divorced university professor who pursues a beautiful student in his class. Their affair which is as much a contrivance on the part of middle-aged David Lurie as anything, results in the convening of an inquiry.

It is telling that waif-like Melanie never exchanges more than a few words with him. When Lurie admits his guilt, but refuses to go through the kind of public mea maxima culpa pantomime required by the university, he is fired and leaves the university in disgrace.

Lurie leaves Capetown to live with his daughter Lucy in the uplands of the Eastern Cape.

She leads a completely different life from her father, with a farmhouse, a market stall and her kennel of dogs, aided by her friend Petrus, who has bought some of Lucy's land.

Powerless to prevent an attack on Lucy's home and Lucy herself, her father, burned and somewhat disfigured tries to look after his daughter, who will not be cared for.

When Lurie learns of Petrus' connection to the assailants, he is beside himself and begs Lucy to leave. Lucy refuses to give up her home, even at the cost of humiliation. Lurie's gentle daughter is a stranger to such concepts as vengeance and humiliation which overflow in her

father's world.

Spare, but never sparse, this story packs an enormous emotional wallop.

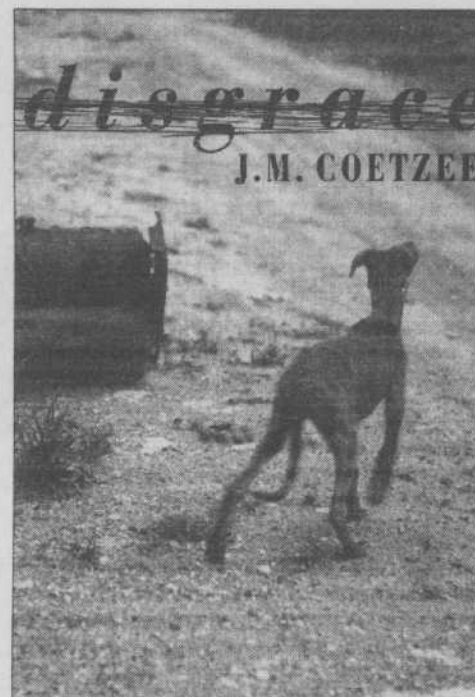
It takes on the large themes of loneliness, death, disgrace and forgiveness effortlessly. Completely lacking in literary tricks or artifice, the story takes precedence over ostentation.

'Disgrace' is beautifully structured, with the story of Lucy mirroring David Lurie's own, then coming together and breaking apart and finally coming together.

Professor Lurie has much to learn about ownership, entitlement and position in society. He's never painted as a villain, in fact most readers will relate above all to his sensibilities.

All characters are portrayed with honesty, humanity and conviction.

Coetzee never gets overly sentimental and never fails to address the complexity of human thought and action. This is a book to be cherished again and again and will send many of us out to look for Coetzee's seven other books of fiction and five works of non-fiction.

Mission to Mars is moronic

The crew sets off and things are rocky from the get-go. The shuttle (which comes complete with talking computer systems strangely reminiscent of a certain Stanley Kubrick film) starts springing leaks, their Van Halen zero-gravity dance sequences get interrupted, and they just can't seem to drink enough Dr. Pepper!

To no one's surprise, alien life figures prominently in this spatial scandal. All

Sinise and friends had to do was drop some M and Ms (product placement is big in this sucker) on the floor to figure out something to do with a DNA double helix getting the adventurers into the big party at the end. Did I mention Mission to Mars is pretty dumb? Anyway once we meet the aliens things go virtual reality-style and the audience gets to learn about life, the universe and everything.

This melodramatic, maudlin Mission suffers in all areas. Cast should have been their strongest point, but they're completely misused, Robbins in particular. Story is a write-off (no pun intended) and De Palma should consider reading his scripts before making the movie. Total Recall is a good movie about Mars, this is not.

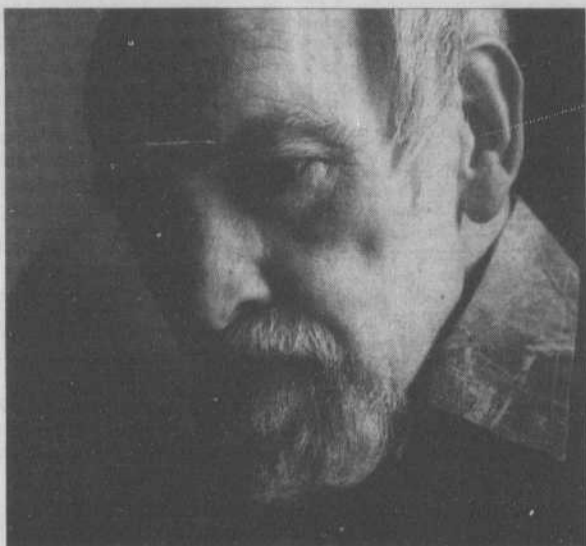
