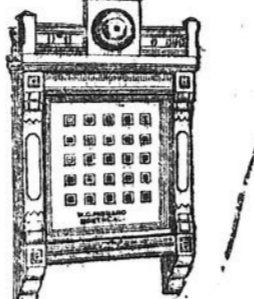

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GLAUSTONE ON FORSTER. MODERN ENGLISH POLITICAL HISTORY. The Liberal Leader Discusses His Late (As League—Proposed Federation of England—Irish, Scotch and Wales.

[SPECIAL TO THE STAR.] LONDON, August 30.—Mr. Gladstone's review of Mr. Reid's life of Forster is an important contribution to our knowledge of modern English political history.

Mr. Gladstone gives Mr. Forster credit for having been the first to urge the necessity of a policy that resulted in the compensation for disturbances laid. Respecting the so-called Kilmahanna treaty, Mr. Gladstone shows that Mr. Parnell gave every consideration to the Government had a right to demand by the wording of the agreement.

Mr. Gladstone's opinion is that Mr. Gladstone's resignation, and the passage of Mr. Gladstone's article in the "Times" on the subject of speaking of Cabinet secrets, is "in the opinion of no person of sound sense and high character" a "gross and unwarrantable" violation of the duty of a Minister of the Crown.

Another important passage is that which refers to the action of the late Lord Salisbury in the House of Commons. He says: "The Cabinet of 1888 was unanimous in the judgment that the late Lord Salisbury was guilty of being associated in crime, although six members of the Cabinet in 1888 are actively or tacitly responsible for the crime."
