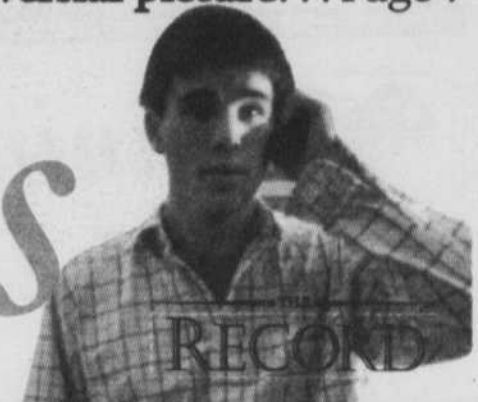

Homebrewed jazz quintet gets local

Summer's almost over, but things will still heat up tonight at the historic Haskell Opera House as the local Homebrew Dixieland Jazz Band hits the stage as part of their CD release party.

The quintet, composed of Stanley Lake on trumpet, David Gray on tuba, Chris Nicotera on guitar, Jean Lavigneon on percussion and David Sutherland on clarinet, currently reside in the Eastern Townships, with the exception of Nicotera, who lives in Vermont.

The band plays traditional jazz that originated in New Orleans, and as band members admit, the influences of Louis Armstrong and Jelly Roll Morton on their music are profound.

'Homebrew' has been together for six years, performing across the Townships and Vermont, including Montreal, Cowansville and Sherbrooke.

"We knew each other before. We were all involved in other music projects," Sutherland said. "Stan, (Gray) and I are the original members. Chris and Jean are new. We have had a few dif-

ferent members.

The CD launch is taking place only at the Haskell Opera House. We are keeping it local. It's all traditional tunes."

Beyond music, band members have lots to keep them busy. Lake, who is originally from Cleveland, Ohio but now calls Mansonville home, is a potter of 25 years, while Sutherland, also a Mansonville resident works as a graphic designer.

Gray, who resides in Beebe, works in the granite industry, and is a member in various classical groups. Nicotera, from New York now resides in Morgan, Vermont, and is a music teacher at Derby Elementary School.

Lavigneon, who lives in Rock Forest and is originally from Quebec City, is also involved in music. He teaches in Sherbrooke, and pursues other musical ventures in his spare time.

Sutherland explained that the band plays numerous outdoor concerts and events. After the CD release party they are scheduled to play over the Labour Day weekend at the Brome Fair as well as the upcoming Duck Festival in Knowlton.

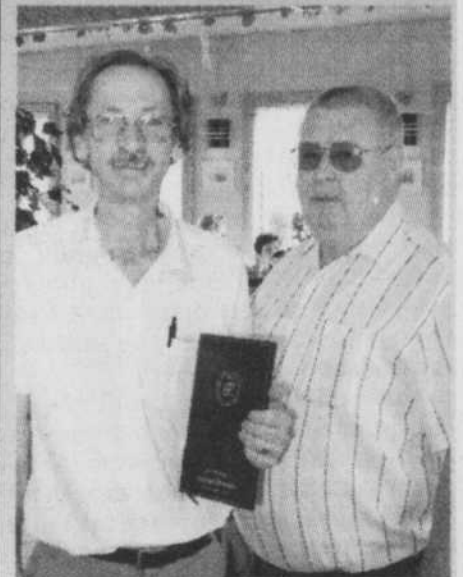
"It's old music. People that are in their 50s or older identify with it from their early years," Sutherland said.

"Kids pick up on it, not because they are familiar with it but because it's something different. Our audience is very mixed.

Come out for a surprise. You will hear a kind of music you would not normally hear. It is something out of the past that is being played today."

dining out Let your taste buds do the walking – fine dining is a Townships tradition

Le Papillon is a friendly place

Familiarity rules at popular local restaurant

Driving along Knowlton Road to Cowansville, I have passed Le Papillon for years and always wondered what this large concrete building looked like inside and, particularly, what the food was like.

Last weekend, I decided to put my curiosity to rest. My companion and I discovered Le Papillon is a popular neighbourhood restaurant where familiarity rules and where the service is most friendly.

The solid yet bland exterior gives no indication of what awaits patrons upon entering the dining room. From the moment you walk in, it is an experience. Easy listening instrumental music floats through the air and just when you're trying to figure out whether the piece currently playing is a Bee Gees tune or the theme song from Dirty Dancing, you notice the decor around you is pink – all pink. Different shades of pink, of course, but pink nonetheless.

As you're seated on your pink chairs, the table has been attractively set for you with a plate of party mix, bread sticks, crackers and a house dip atop a pink tablecloth. There's also an oil lamp on each table with a pink shade, and similar oil lamps on every window sill. The concrete walls are also pink.

Just as you're taking this in while munching on your party mix, you notice that the Christmas tree in the centre of the restaurant is no Christmas tree, but instead a tree of multi-coloured butterflies. In fact, these motley-coloured butterflies are everywhere – on the tree and on the walls close to the ceiling. Les papillons are more than the restaurant's theme, they are a way of life!

Red, white and, of course, pink flowers and small postcard-size prints in frames complete the whimsical decor.

The lighting is subdued and the tables well-spaced, both elements conducive to a pleasant evening meal.

The gracious Gracia explained what the table d'hôtes were that evening. It began with soup of the day (chicken noodle) or a chef's salad. The three

main courses were Italian-style chicken supreme (\$13.95), veal with mushroom sauce (\$14.95) or a fisherman's platter (\$19.95). These weekend specials, incorporating chicken, seafood, pork, veal and sometimes lamb, change each weekend. During the week, different specials are offered.

The soup featured nice little chunks of chicken and a large variety of noodles – shells, stars, alphabet noodles, you name it, it was in there – in a peppery broth. The salad was unusual, made with mixed greens, tomato wedges, blueberries, orange and served with a ranch-style dressing. Both were attractively presented on white dishes on top of larger white plates separated by a doily – a stab at elegance that works.

The seafood platter was a revelation, a well-constructed dish featuring four jumbo shrimps, five jumbo scallops, five scampis and six mussels on a bed of chicken-flavoured rice mixed with chopped vegetables. Seafood can go very wrong, but here it was all baked to just the right tenderness.

The shrimps, scallops and scampi were terrific dipped in the melted garlic butter served with it. The mussels have quite a different texture when baked dry and not cooked in a sauce, but they were also good.

Beets, green and yellow beans, carrots and brussel sprouts were served on the side – here they certainly believe in giving you your vegetables. A generous, delicious dish.

The veal was tender cubes of meat covered in a

mushroom sauce, served with your choice of mashed potatoes and rice or french fries, along with the same vegetables as the seafood platter. The sauce was somewhat bland, unfortunately, and needed a bolder taste.

After the main course, a veritable chariot of desserts was rolled out featuring peanut butter pie, three-chocolate mousse cake, fruit mousse cake, hazelnut cake, mandarin-pineapple cake, maple mousse cake and pecan pie – we thought we died and went to heaven!

The hazelnut cake was a moist

three-layer cake with layers of hazelnut cream and iced with chocolate. The maple mousse cake featured two layers of spongy cake with a creamy mousse on top and in the centre. Both were delicious. Coffee and tea are included with the table d'hôte.

Leaving no stone unturned and ensuring everyone is kept happy to the very last second, with our bill came four mint chocolate spears and a handful of mint candies.

Dinner for two, not including wine or gratuity, was \$40.

The restaurant also offers a full menu featuring soups, salads, steaks, barbecue spare ribs, trout, pasta and omelettes ranging from \$4.50 to \$16.95, certainly something for every wallet and taste.

Le Papillon, a 15-year institution in West Brome, is a friendly, pleasant, anytime kind of restaurant where you're sure to find something to tempt your taste buds.

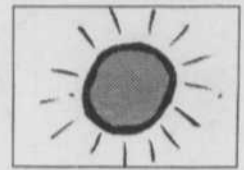

Summer Fête set for Saturday in Stanstead

Historical society and museum team up for annual event

The Colby-Curtis Museum and the Stanstead Historical Society will host their annual Summer Fete this Saturday, Aug. 25.

Organizers have already rounded up David Brown, professional dealer and appraiser of antiques, to give a slide presentation and discuss 18th and 19th century silver, porcelain and quilts. He will be on hand afterward to answer questions at 2 p.m. in Pierce Hall, Stanstead College.

Also, starting at 3:30 p.m., Michael Goudreau, a well-known jazz guitarist, and his trio will be on hand with a selection of jazz and blues in museum's garden.

The day's activities include croquet games for the adults and three-legged races and spoon/egg races to delight the children. Adults and children alike will also be encouraged to add their personal touch to a collective mural on the subject "Your Museum", which will later be displayed in the museum. Light refreshments will also be served.

"David Brown is a member of the Canadian Antiques Society," said Monique Nadeau-Saumier

Director/Curator of the Colby-Curtis Museum.

"He had a successful business career as a professional dealer and appraiser before making his love of antiques a full time occupation. He spoke to us a few years ago and is being asked back by popular demand.

We are trying to bring something to our community and hopefully bring members of our community to our Museum. We rely a great deal on volunteers to run the Museum. Without them we couldn't do it. This is our way of saying thank-you.

"The Colby family were an upper-class family with a huge old house that might tend to intimidate many people, but we have found that once they set foot into the family kitchen, they see things that remind them of home and they realize that maybe they had something in common with these people after all."

The beautiful Victorian garden will act as the centre of entertainment for the afternoon. The idea to build the garden on the lawn was sparked from a gift by Maud Curtis, who donated a birdbath and a collection of rose bushes in memory of her late husband, Arthur Curtis, a founder of the Museum and President of the Society from 1972-1978.

Planners attempted to duplicate plants and flowers, which were available in the days of the first Colby families. For the family, afternoon tea was a pleasurable ritual. During the

summer, they often sat on the veranda of Carrollcroft.

This veranda was eventually enclosed with glass, and is now a tea room where visitors can experience the charm of the Victorian era and the tempting array of jams, scones and cookies made and served by Natalie Duncan, who is in charge of the tea room.

Vice-president Elsie Sullivan has been with the museum and historical society for eight years. Before retiring with her husband to Georgeville, Sullivan was founder and director of the Marseil Museum in St. Lambert and a guide at the Montreal Museum.

"I guess the historical value of things had gotten into my blood by then so it seemed logical to get involved here," said Sullivan.

"We held an event similar to this one for the 70th anniversary of the museum, which received very favourable results. When the summer

fete committee started to make plans, we decided to try again.

I had seen Michael Goudreau and his group performing at the July 1 celebration in Georgeville and thought they were terrific. Everything seemed to fall into place easily and everyone was very co-operative.

Inter-Marche's donation of ice cream, chips and drinks was a big help.

"We do so hope that the children will attend. The collective mural will be set up in the Pagoda in the center of the garden. I hope everyone will come and join us for a last fling of the summer."

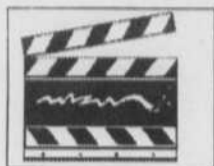

WFF gets underway this weekend

Twenty-five years ago, in 1977, something very special happened in Montreal — the city got its very own world class film festival.

A quarter of a century later, the Montreal World Film Festival is still going strong as it prepares for its official opening today.

The WFF has never ceased to illuminate its screens with a phenomenal range of films. Granted, the WFF is not the glitzy Hollywood celeb-fest that Toronto's Festival of Festivals has become, but, as has often been said, the WFF is a capital F for film fest, while Toronto is merely a "movie" fest.

This week the WFF jump-started its projectors, beginning with Thursday the 23rd's gala presentation of Montreal director Denis Chouinard's *L'Ange de Goudron* (Tar Angel).

The movie follows Ahmed Kasmi, an Algerian refugee, and his family. Three years settled in Montreal, Ahmed is just weeks away from getting his Canadian citizenship. But the fanatical activism of his eldest son, Hafid, threatens to shatter Ahmed's hard-won dreams.

Hitting the wintry streets in hopes of finding his son before it's too late, Ahmed is confronted by the society he is about to join. What ensues is a mixture of suspense and surprise.

This year's tributes and homages will honour the ever-alluring Sophia Loren, director Roberto Rossellini, kung fu comedy genius Jackie Chan, director Fernando Solanas, and Spanish acting hallmark Francisco Rabal.

With upwards of 300 films from every corner of the world screening, it can be intimidating to think about attending the event, but its worth every nervous, schedule ruffling, moment.

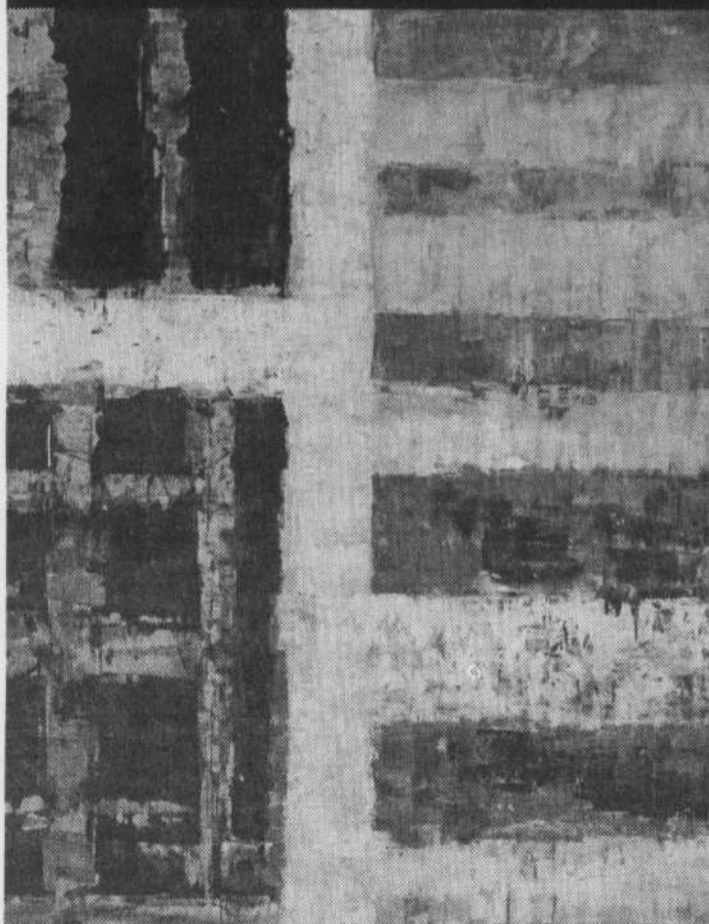

Returning to the roots with thrash-metal album

**DROWNING POOL**
*Sinner**(Wind-up and Epic)*

Sinner, Drowning Pool's recently released 11-track CD, is a hard, thrash-metal album that leaves fans moshing in mobs and neighbours with headaches. What initially comes across as a mix between Moist and Metallica in the title track 'Sinner', Drowning Pool is neither — the rest of the album's vocals are harsher, acoustics harder and music louder. Instead, Drowning Pool could easily be confused with bands like Megadeth and Mudvayne for its drowning lead vocals and elastic guitar solos. 'Bodies', has already had significant airplay nationwide, aided in part by its increasing play on WWF's Raw is War and Smackdown. Also, 'Tear Away' is a stand-out single complimented by epic guitar work, courtesy of C.J. Pierce, and Dave Williams' distinctively-ragged vocals. Produced and mixed by Jay Baumgardner, Drowning Pool returns to the roots of hard metal music — there's no messing around as the band starts off hard and doesn't let up. Don't call them peppy, positive or even peaceful. Drowning Pool is what one would expect from a traditional metal band short of mutilated bodies on the jacket cover.

Self-titled
(Universal Music)

Straight out of the popular television series Pop Stars, to airwaves across the nation, the Canadian edition, Sugar Jones, cashes in on both the girl-band craze and fashionable 'making-of-the-band' reality shows in unprecedented fashion with their full-length, self-titled debut album. The band — which was literally created out of a corporation think-tank, nation wide auditions and a "reality" television series — has taken the Canadian audience by storm with a freshness that the pop music industry has not seen as of late. Several singles including 'Days Like That', 'How Much Longer', and 'Never Leave Hurt Alone' touch on the untainted talent of these five Canadian women, who, in their pursuit of fame, have collaborated to create the most unlikely collection of stand-out pure pop singles. But to go that one step further, Andrea, Maiko, Mirella, Sahara and Montreal's own Julie are not the modern-day one-hit wonders that many would expect from a "manufactured" group featured in a reality television series. Every original single on this album presents a uniqueness and creativeness that is untouched in today's industry, and which also sets a precedent for future successes.

Stratford's Twelfth Night has its moments

Tara Rosling as Viola and Sean Arbuckle as Duke Orsino... looking good but no chemistry.

Style reigns over substance in Stratford's latest production of Shakespeare's comic gem *Twelfth Night*.

But what style it is! Director Antoni Cimolino and his artistic team have conspired to create an enchanting vision of post-World War I Greece.

This being the ninth production of *Twelfth Night* in Stratford's history, features lively music inspired by traditional Greek melodies by composer Berthold Carrière; the play in fact opens with the alcohol-induced Greek dancing of military men during a late-night rainstorm and Duke Orsino's cry, "If music be the food of love, play on!" It's always a fascination at Stratford to hear Shakespeare's words in entirely different contexts.

The characters are lushly costumed in 1920s apparel by Francesca Callow — linen suits in white and beige tones, blue shirts,

red ties and hats for the men; light, sheer feminine fabrics for the women. The farcical Sir Andrew Aguecheek is outfitted in a gold suit with black stripes and plaid socks (his wild hair is a costume itself) and a musician wears an authentic Greek costume with pleated kilt.

Set designer Peter Hartwell says more with less with a strikingly simple set fea-

tured Mediterranean blue shutters surrounded by flowers and a hedge, as well as gates and draperies on the balcony.

Viola and Sebastian, sister and brother, are shipwrecked on the island of Illyria, each believing the other is dead. To protect herself, Viola pretends to be a man, Cesario, and goes to work for Duke Orsino, who puts Cesario/Viola to work as a go-between as he woos Countess Olivia.

The Countess, not interested in Orsino, develops an immediate attraction to this different sort of man. The queer triangle is complete when Viola falls in love with Orsino herself.

The cast of highly accomplished actors have their moments. Tara Rosling, simply transformed here from her shy teenaged character in *Tempest-Tost*, is impressive as Viola and particularly so as Cesario, the man she pretends to be.

Rosling's first scene with Michelle Giroux as Olivia was superbly done, full of understated sexual frustration, with Olivia falling for Cesario and Viola secretly in love with Orsino.

Midsummer madness reigns on the Greek isles! Donaldson is unapologetically exaggerated as Malvolio and he still manages to evoke sympathy after he is incarcerated, the subject of a nasty prank.

Michael Therriault has a great deal of fun with the role of Sir Andrew Aguecheek. He blasts onto the stage, full of energy and dynamism. His dueling scene with Rosling is priceless: neither knows the other is scared to death of the fight.

Bishop's University graduate and veteran actor John Dolan is bedraggled and sweet as Feste. Donned in loose-fitting clothing — beige pants, white shirt, an au-

turn-coloured quilted vest and hat of the same material, and a long scarf hanging down from his neck — he is a bumbling yet wise clown that is more thoughtful than comical.

Dolan is the alternate Feste, otherwise played by William Hutt, but he is no understudy — he makes the role his own.

In a world where Rudolph Valentino is the male model of style and sexiness, Sean Arbuckle's Duke Orsino is disappointing. He lacks the charisma needed for a man who is the subject of Viola's strong affections. There is not enough chemistry between them to result in the kind of sparks needed to sustain this storyline to its inevitable conclusion.

This main storyline lacking pizzazz and sparks between the actors is one of the reasons why *Twelfth Night* is a little flat. Many of the other actors also seemed to be going through their paces, and the substance of the play's relationships was glossed over.

Theatre buffs may be interested in noting that the title *Twelfth Night*, never mentioned in the play, refers to the festival of Epiphany, marking the visit of the Magi to the infant Jesus 12 days after Christmas.

Shakespeare probably had this festive celebration in mind when he infused his play with such a sense of fun.

Star stays grounded by returning to roots

The Hollywood hype machine is working overtime on his behalf. The entertainment media, ever restless in its quest for someone new to crown Tinseltown's latest hot new star, has lately selected him in the wake of his starring role in Pearl Harbor.

And, of course, with this comes the predictable baggage of also being labelled Hollywood's hottest new sex symbol.

So how is Josh Hartnett dealing with all this? Well, he's given up his Hollywood digs and gone back home to Minnesota — the state immortalized by the Coen brothers in Fargo as some sort of quirky backwoods outpost. You might say he's resisting the trappings of stardom.

To Hartnett, the twin cities of Minneapolis and St. Paul are infinitely preferable to the artificial lifestyle which prevails in Hollywood.

"I don't live here anymore," he shrugs. "I live in Minnesota where I have family and friends — and a sense of reality. There are four full seasons. Winter is as cold as it gets. Summer is as hot as it gets. And autumn and spring are just beautiful."

Besides, he's discovered that living outside Hollywood is no impediment to pursuing an acting career if that career is already taking off.

And in the case of the 23-year-old Hartnett, his career is very definitely in the ascendant. Producer kingpin Jerry Bruckheimer was so impressed with Hartnett's work in Pearl Harbor that he dispatched him to Africa to star in the military thriller, Black Hawk Down. Next year, Hartnett will star in the romantic comedy, 40 Days and 40 Nights. But right now, he has a more immediate movie — the controversial *O* — coming out, and that's the reason he's talking to the media this afternoon.

In the new Lions Gate release opening Aug. 31, he takes on the distinctly unsympathetic role of Hugo, a young student who — driven by malice and jealousy — systematically sets out to destroy the school's only black student (Mekhi Phifer), who also happens to be its star basketball player and Hugo's best friend.

The film is screenwriter Brad Kaaya's contemporary retelling of Shakespeare's Othello, with the action transferred from 16th-century Europe to an elite private school in the American South. Phifer plays Odin, the Othello character. Julia Stiles is Desi, the contemporary stand-in for Desdemona — a white beauty with whom Odin is madly and jealously in love. And Hartnett's viciously

scheming Hugo is an updated version of the Shakespeare play's monstrous Iago.

O, which is directed by Tim Blake Nelson, has had a troubled journey into theatres, not only because of the sexual explicitness of one scene but because it parallels the original play with a blood-drenched display of violence. Because the violence in this case involves students, Miramax Pictures — nervous about distributing it in the shadow of the Columbine high school shootings — delayed its release twice and finally turned over distribution to Canada's Lions Gate.

This rangy, prepossessing figure in the casual slacks and grey sweatshirt is polite and attentive to reporters' questions. He talks thoughtfully about transferring Shakespeare's themes to a modern idiom while also stressing his admiration for the playwright.

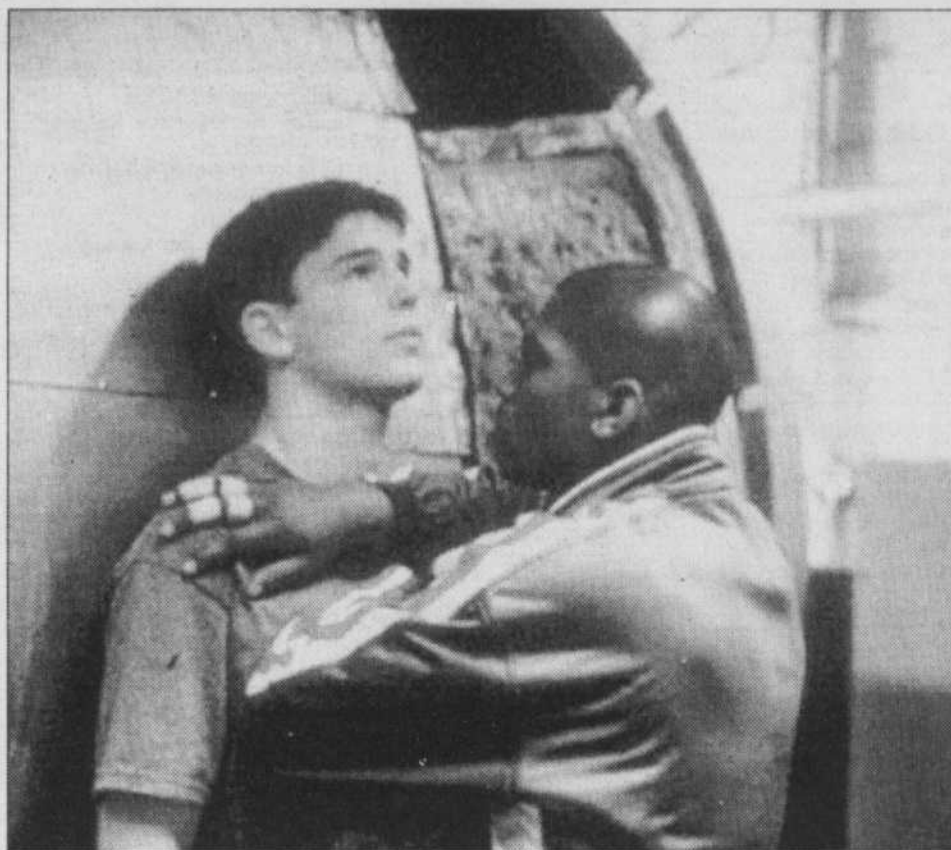
"I don't know if I consider myself a Shakespearian person but I really love Shakespeare . . . the comedies, tragedies, everything. I love poetry in general."

He's also revealing about himself. There's a sense that he's guided by his own tough code of conduct. For example, he's markedly reserved when asked to comment on the much-publicized alcohol problems of his Pearl Harbor co-star Ben Affleck.

"It's none of my business, and it's definitely not anyone else's," he says curtly. "I feel that when a guy hits a hard spot and tries to get his life back together, having everybody sitting there and judging him is not going to make it any easier for him. I know he's a good guy. I know he cares about things and he cares about people."

However, Hartnett has a larger point to make: he himself is a fallible human being.

"I'm not trying to keep myself on a straight path. I'm just trying to live and make my life interesting and hopefully do the right thing in the long run. But life is an exploration, so if you cut yourself off from everything in order to be what your parents or grandparents think is a good person, you don't necessarily grow. . . . I've done some things which are

not the best things in the world., so I try not to judge people when they screw up. There's a lot of temptation for me now, and I'll screw up many times in my life. That's the way it goes. Everybody has some wild years."

Hartnett made his feature film debut in 1998 in Halloween: H20, and followed that up with roles in The Faculty and The Virgin Suicides. But it was Pearl Harbor that changed things dramatically for him.

"I was in Africa when it all went down and I was in Africa for a month and a half after it was released. By the time I got back, everything had mounted up a bit. Now, I go to the grocery store at a different time, but all my friends and family treat me the same."

Meanwhile, he sees *O* as an important test of his acting abilities.

"He is able to pull off a diabolical char-

acter and still make him charming," enthuses producer Dan Fried.

But Hartnett says his big challenge lay in trying to figure Hugo out — to define what makes him tick. The actor is aware that Shakespeare scholars have been brooding for centuries over the seemingly motiveless malice shown by Iago in the original Othello.

"We tried to offer more of an explanation for his actions in this one. The jealousy, the envy, those things came into play, definitely. But then you have to find out what you like about the guy. He's very intelligent and with that comes manipulation. He's very emotional and very passionate. He seems to care very deeply, but his priorities are very mixed up. He obviously cares about himself more than anyone else because he feels that he's been wronged."

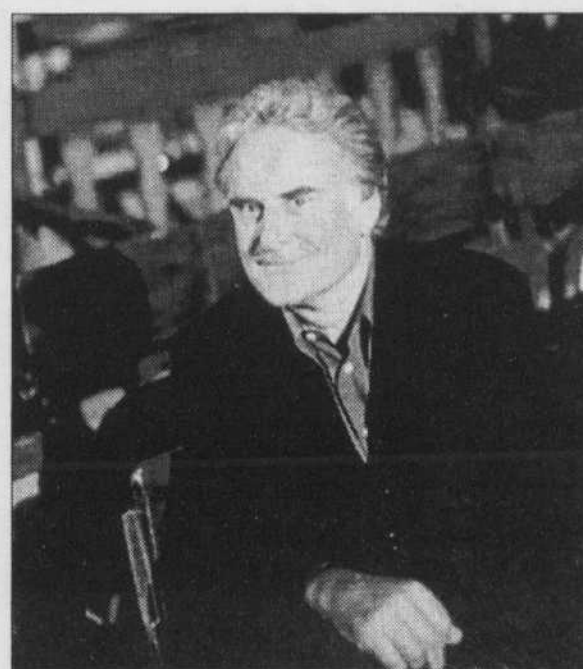

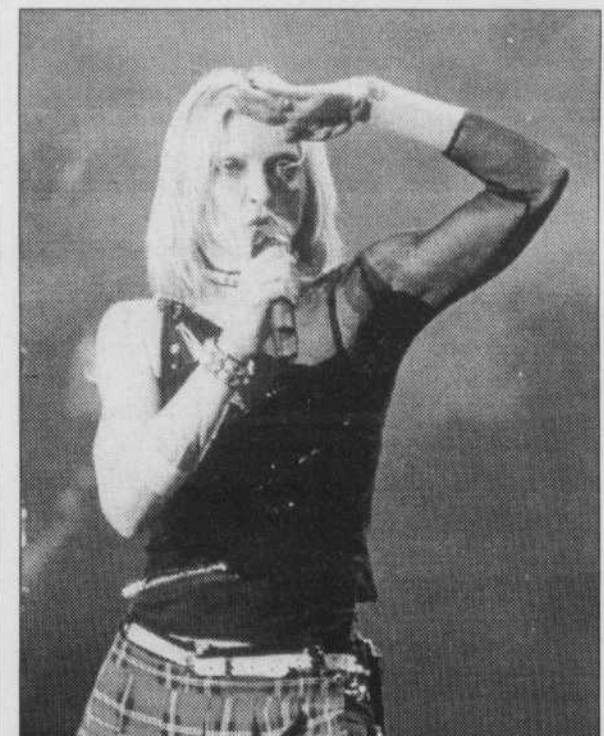

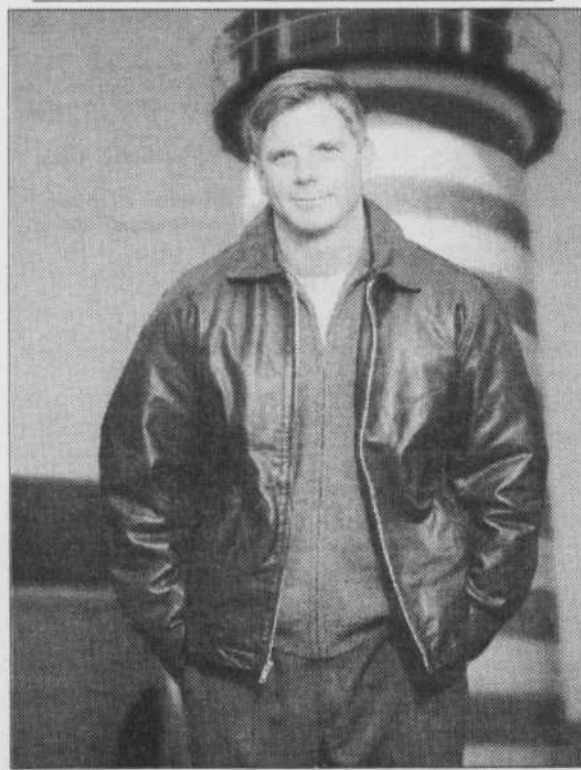

Old Orchard Beach: Become part of history (Part 1)



Earliest records of the Old Orchard Beach area date back to 1653. The first settler, Thomas Rogers, established "Garden by the Sea" in 1657. A few years later ten militiamen repelled 150 attacking Indians near the beach, but a relief party of townspeople coming to support the militiamen were killed in an ambush, and Roger's home was burned.

The "old" apple orchard, from which the town took its name, a landmark to sailors for many years, was on high land above

the long sand beach. In 1820 Maine, formally part of Massachusetts, became a State by act of Congress. In that same year the first Publick House (inn) was opened serving coach travelers and other transients year round. In 1837, E.C. Staples was coaxed into taking summer boarders at his farm for \$1.50 per week. Convinced of Old Orchard Beach's potential as a summer resort, Staples built the first Old Orchard Boarding House near the top of today's Old Orchard Street.

1842 brought the first steam railroad from Boston to Portland with a station just 2 miles west of town. The first restaurant to sell seafood treats and "shore dinners" opened in 1851 near Staples Street. The Grand Trunk Railroad opened in 1853 connecting Montreal to Old

Orchard Beach, enabling Canadian visitors to flock to this closest beach to Montreal and avoid the long carriage trip.

The Civil War began in 1861 followed by years of growth and building of homes, streets, stores, livery stables, and beachfront hotels. 1873 brought the Boston & Maine Railroad passing right through Old Orchard Beach and stopping on the site of today's Chamber of Commerce. In that same year a group of Methodists formed the Old Orchard Campground



Association. The Ocean Park Association built "The Temple" in 1881, and nationally known speakers were heard every Sunday all summer.

In 1892 electric trolley cars replaced horse cars to Biddeford and Saco. 1898 proved to be an unfortuitous year to complete the first Pier. Built of steel and measuring 1,770 feet long and 20 feet above the tides, their Pier was severely damaged in November of that same year. 1900 brought the first town hall and 1902 the first amusement area complete with roller skating, merry-go-round, rides, games, and refreshment stands. The Portland to Old Orchard Beach Electric Railway opened in 1903 where 14 miles of track were traveled in under one hour for \$.20.
