Skin beauty tips

Discussing finances an important first step

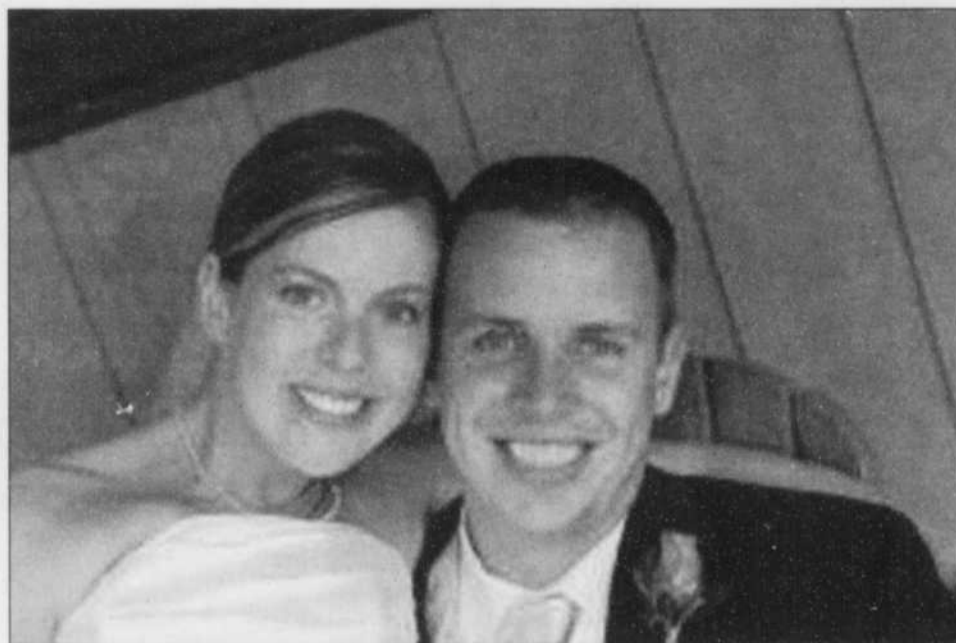
- **Discussed debt?** While most couples have discussed longterm financial goals before

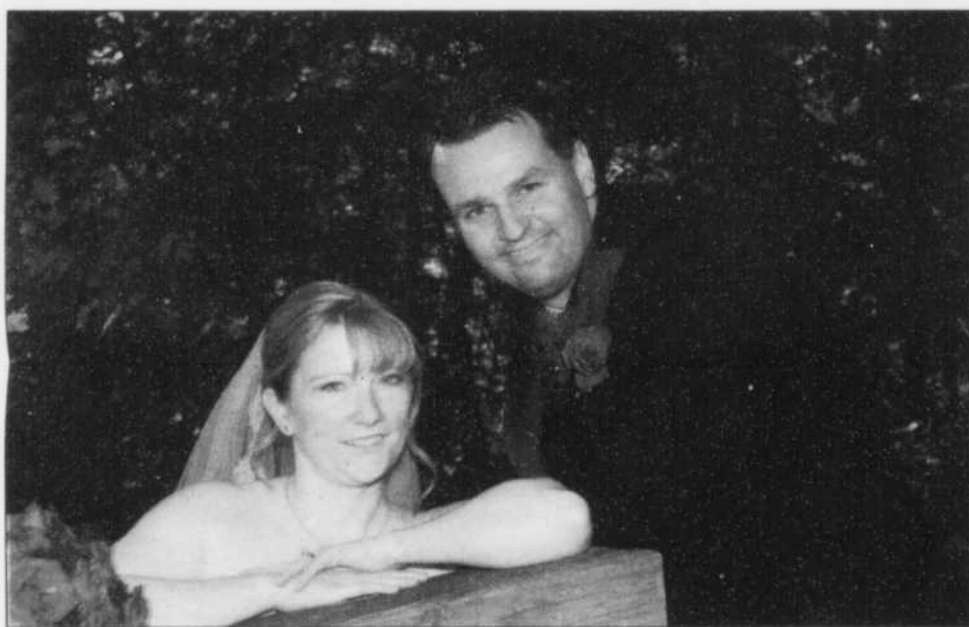
