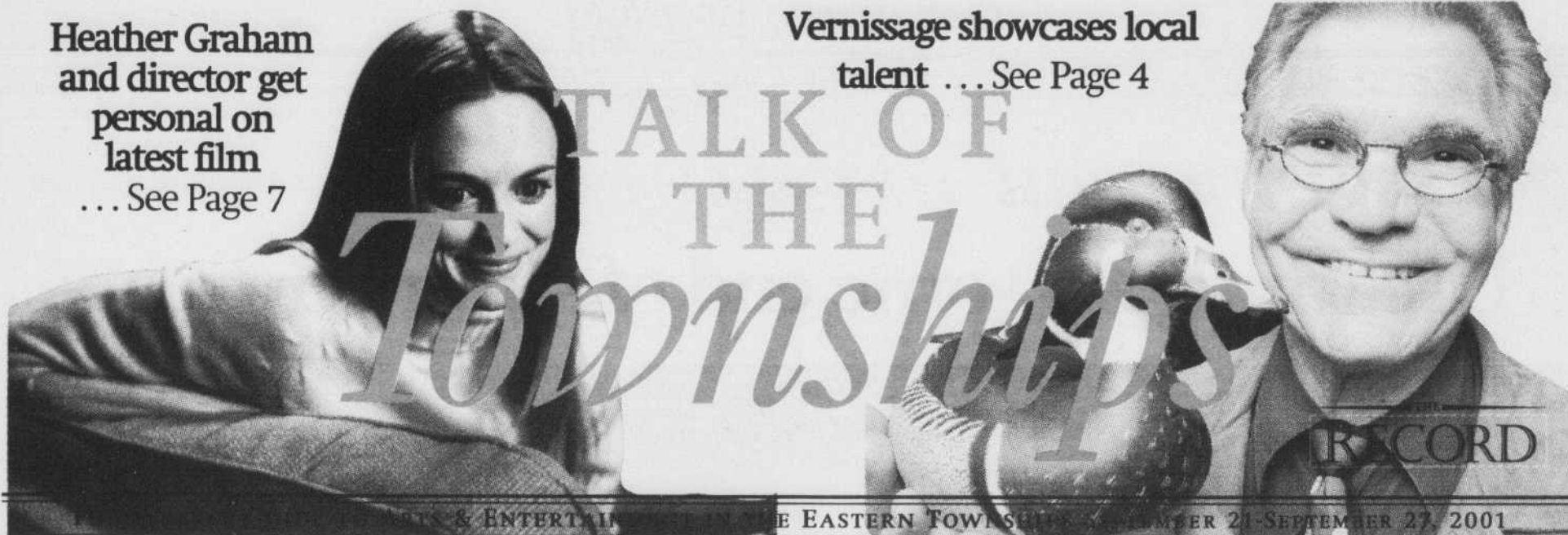

## Knowlton exhibit's gone to the birds

Windows Gallery of Knowlton will be featuring a multimedia show on the theme of birds, showcasing among others, the work of Martin Persky, 57, a pharmacist from Montreal who has been delicately interpreting waterfowl in wood for 20 years.

Persky, with four other Montrealers and nine from the Townships will be impressing bird lovers and fine art lovers at the Gallery from Saturday Sept. 22 through Oct. 14.

Presented in collaboration with the Knowlton Duck festival, the exhibit runs from 5 to 7 p.m.

Persky will be demonstrating his art on site both Saturday and Sunday. Lovers of detail will feast their eyes on Persky's master hand at detail with feathers so real it looks as if the bird could take off.

Initially a miniaturist, Persky has been carving for 10 years after evolving through art in oils and sculpted works to his present love for fine wood carving. His works in the show will include decorative birds, decoy ducks, song birds and shore birds. At his Montreal home studio, Persky does heavy research into the details of the birds. He also observes the bird in the wild, looks at taxidermist preservations, uses reference books and carefully measures the anatomy of his subject with special attention to the proportion of the bill to the bird's face,

whether it be a miniature or full-size rendition.

Persky, who learned his craft from three Montreal art teachers, is a regular Blue Ribbon winner at the annual Ocean City, Maryland art show where some 18,000 bird renditions are judged.

"Most of the art you will see at the gallery will be the best of the best, and most of them Blue Ribbon winners," Persky said.

"We are not just artists," Persky added. "All the exhibitors you will see at the vernissage are involved in a love affair with birds, and above all, we are all avid conservationists."

The Rose Windows Gallery is located at 91 Lakeside, Knowlton and open seven days a week from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.

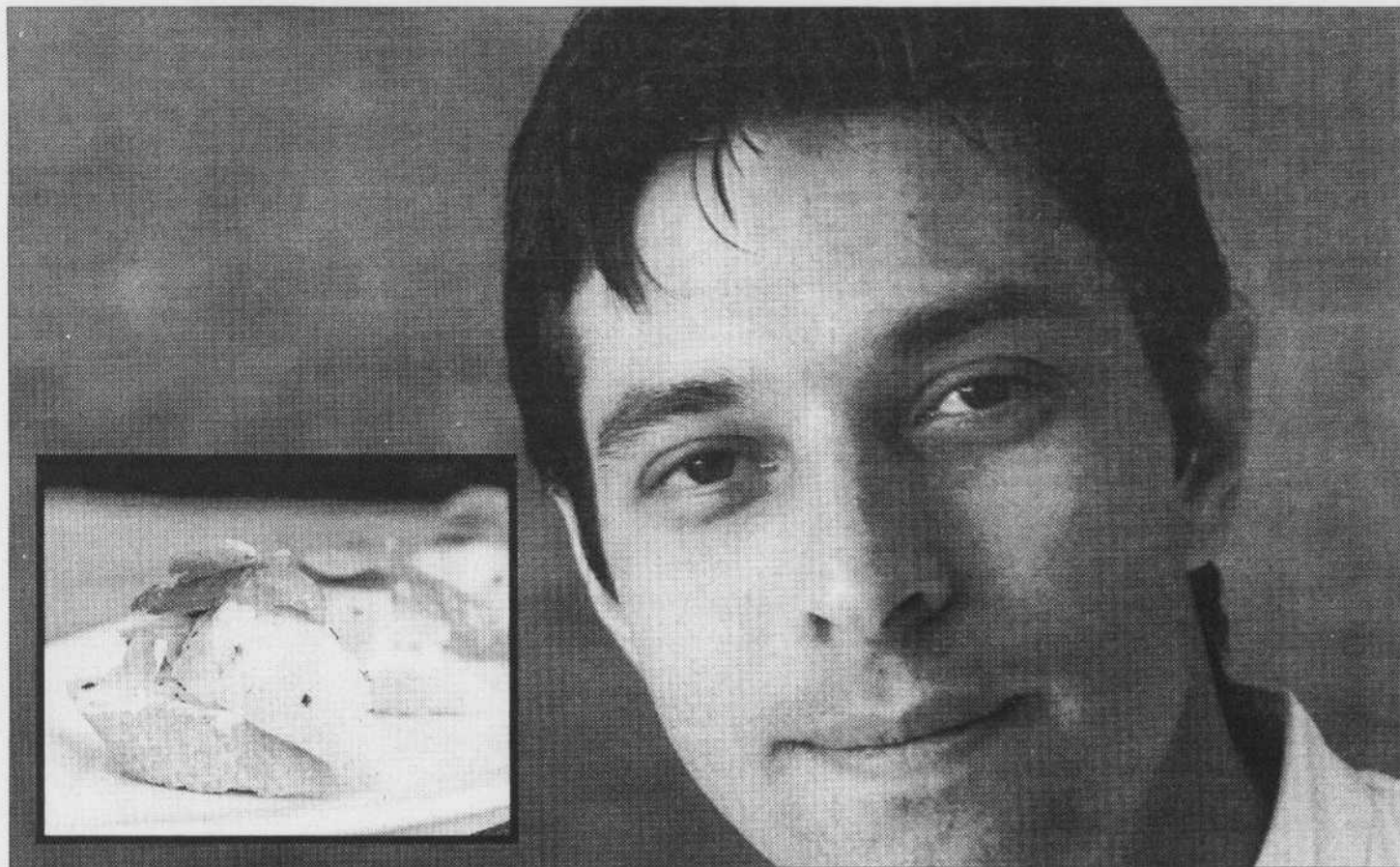

## Dreaming up some end of summer treats

Even though autumn is still days away, I'm not ready to say good-bye to summer just yet.

Dream up an excuse for one of the final soirees of the season on the patio, I say, then slap together these fast yet elegant finger-foods. After tucking into these eats, I'm betting your guests will think you're the host with reason to boast.

We're talking about upscale finger foods, here, not a platter of raw broccoli and yogurt dip. Think of it as our affectionate farewell to a truly fabulous summer of heat and sun, sun and heat.

We asked Rene Rodriguez, recently appointed chef de cuisine at the trendy ARC the hotel in Ottawa, to create these inspiring delicacies with flavour combinations you don't taste everyday.

Rodriguez, 29, was previously sous-chef at Ottawa's eclectic Cafe Luna and Ironwood Cafe, where he honed his skills acquired at the prestigious Le Cordon Bleu Paris Cooking School. His love of cooking began as a child in Mexico.

"It's been a wonderful summer and we don't want to see it go," Rodriguez says.

"So, here we have four easy recipes that anyone can make using simple ingredients for a garden party on the patio or around the pool."

If you're a sushi fan, you're going to love Rodriguez's Marinated Ahi Tuna and Salmon with Blood Orange Oil. Even better, this raw-fish treat doesn't come with any of that annoying, sticky rice so often used as cheap filler in the centre of sushi nibbles. A kiss of California blood orange oil, which is actually olive oil infused with the essence of orange, gives the fish a light and unique citrus kiss.

"It's a perfect summer dish for people who enjoy sushi but may not want the rice," Rodriguez says. (Hear, hear!)

"You're getting the freshness of marinated raw tuna, while the oil adds citrus notes to the taste - again, very simple to make. It takes maybe five minutes to put the dish together."

A word of advice to home cooks: Be certain to buy sushi-grade fresh tuna and salmon from a good fishmonger. This is not the occasion to use plastic-wrapped fish in a plastic tray.

Prosciutto-Wrapped Figs are another crowd-pleaser you can make in a snap. Fresh figs are in season now, and taste so sweet you'll never bother again with those dried-out cousins from the grocery store.

The fig hors d'oeuvre is no more complicated than wrapping paper-thin Italian prosciutto around succulent fresh figs. "The figs are very sweet, so the salty prosciutto ham acts as a complement," Ro-

driguez says.

If you got the idea Rodriguez likes to have fun with flavours, you'd be right.

His Crab and Avocado Salad with Grapefruit and Jalapeo offers a symphony of taste and texture not often seen performing together on the same plate. Go ahead, use canned crab for convenience (who wants to mess around with crab shells anyway?); prepare the salad a day ahead by placing the crab ingredients in a ring mould, then refrigerate until ready. (Where to get a rim mould, you ask? They're as easy to find as a small can of tuna - simply cut off the top and bottom.)

"You have the sweetness of crab balanced nicely with the sour tang of grapefruit," Rodriguez says. "I find the Jalapeno introduces a little heat to the dish, while the avocado adds creamy richness."

As for the Marinated Artichokes with Herbs, Bread and Goat's Cheese, look closely and you'll see it's basically a bruschetta that's as easy to assemble as it is to pass around. "It's a provencal-inspired dish with the herbs de Provence - that's thyme and rosemary - olive oil and goat's cheese. The cheese adds creaminess with some nutty tang - certainly it has more of a presence than if you used ordinary cream cheese."

Oh, may summer never end.

### MARINATED AHI TUNA AND SALMON WITH BLOOD ORANGE OIL (Serves 4)

- 8 squares of sushi-grade ahi tuna loin, each about 2 1/2 inch by 2 1/2-inch (6-by-6-cm) and 1/4-inch (5-mm) thick
- 8 squares of fresh Atlantic salmon (bones removed and cut same as tuna)
- 4 tablespoons of California blood orange oil (available at La Bottega Nicastro Fine Food Shop)
- 1/2 tablespoon (7 mL) fresh lemon juice
- 1 teaspoon (5 mL) juice from pickled ginger (at Oriental food markets)
- 4 fresh purple basil leaves, thinly shredded
- Sea salt

1. Place 2 pieces of tuna and 2 pieces of salmon on each of four dinner plates to form a checkerboard.

2. In a non-metallic bowl, whisk together the oil, lemon juice and ginger juice; drizzle on top of fish and all to marinate a few minutes, then lightly season with salt. Sprinkle shredded basil on top and serve cold.

### MARINATED ARTICHOKE WITH HERBS, BREAD AND GOAT'S CHEESE (Serves 4 (2 pieces each))

For the artichokes:

- 10 canned artichokes in water, drained and cut into quarters
- 1 tablespoon (15 mL) of finely minced garlic
- 1 tablespoon (15 mL) fresh thyme, minced
- 1/2 tablespoon (7 mL) fresh rosemary, minced
- 4 tablespoons (60 mL) olive oil
- Salt and pepper, to taste
- Extra-virgin olive oil

For the bread and goat's cheese:

- Eight 1/2-inch (1-cm) thick slices of French baguette
- 4 tablespoons (65 mL) soft goat's cheese

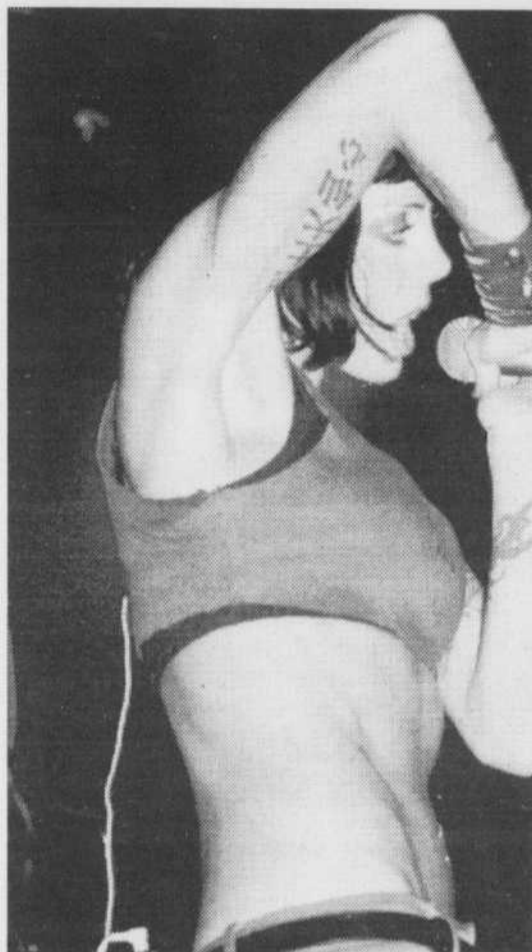
1. In a non-metallic bowl, combine all artichoke recipe ingredients and season lightly with salt and pepper. Cover with plastic wrap and let marinate at room temperature for one hour.

2. For the bread and goat's cheese, spread about 1/2 tablespoon (7 mL) of goat's cheese on each piece of bread. Place bread slices in a preheated oven at 375 F (190 C) and warm for about six minutes.

3. To assemble, remove bread from oven and place the marinated artichokes on top of the bread; drizzle some extra-virgin olive oil on top and serve

All the way from British Columbia, Bif Naked rocked the Granada Theatre on Friday, Sept. 14 as part of the start of her tour to promote her new album *Purge*.

Her energy and enthusiasm for her music showed through in her live performance, keeping the audience jumping and singing along to her mix of rock and punk.

After having been the only woman to perform a few years ago at Edgefest, with the likes of Green Day and the Foo Fighters, and one of the few female acts on the Warped Tour in 2000, there have been numerous occasions for Bif Naked to demonstrate that she can more than hold her own against the boys.

To get the evening underway, opening guest LiveonRelease played an energetic half hour set with songs from its debut album, *Seeing red*.

Best known for the single, 'I'm Afraid of Britney Spears', which is also on the soundtrack for the movie *Dude, Where's My Car?*, the band offered a lively performance of their own.

It was a wonderful sight to see young women playing rock n' roll laced with punk sensibilities and attitude. All of the members of LiveonRelease, though no more than 16-years-old, have been involved in the music scene for many years now, with parents that introduced them to the world of rock at a very young age.

Their performance was pleasing, though one could

sense that they were somewhat reticent about conversing with the audience between songs.

The atmosphere before Bif Naked arrived on the scene was set by the instrumental version of 'Lucky' off her album *I Bificus*.

As performance time neared, band members filed out in the dark, followed shortly thereafter by Bif Naked. Up came the lights and the crowd was ready for an amazing performance.

Bif knows how to rock, looks fabulous and sounds even better. From the moment she stepped on stage until the end of the two song encore, it was clear that she enjoyed being in Sherbrooke for the first time despite, the small crowd of less than 100 people.

From hits on her first album including 'Daddy's Getting Married', to numbers from her second album *I Bificus* like 'Spaceman' and 'Moment of Weakness', the Vancouver native played a wide assortment of hits that have made her famous.

She also played her new single 'I Love Myself Today' from her third album *Purge*, which was released on Sept. 4.

In finishing off the show, Bif Naked told the crowd that they should stand up for what they believe in and to make sure their voices are heard. With that, she performed Twisted Sister's smash hit 'We're Not Gonna Take It', a song she re-did for the movie soundtrack *Ready to Rumble*.

It was a delightful way to end to splendid performances by LiveonRelease and Bif Naked. One left fans smiling, still singing along with the songs and hoping that even though the turnout was meagre, that Bif Naked would not hold it against us and return to Sherbrooke again one day.

## Musikgarten program is a lesson in fun

Musikgarten, an international early childhood music and movement education series, is being offered for the first time this fall, to children of the Eastern Townships.

The programs, which include children from 18 months through nine-years-old, is highly respected for its passion for excellence in printed materials and recordings.

Three of the five Musikgarten programs will be offered this year, the most recreational being 'Family Music' for children 18 months to three-years-old. These children are accompanied by their parent/caregiver for the 30 minute class.

The next level is 'Cycle of Seasons', for three to five-year-olds. Finally, 'Music Makers' is for four to seven-year-olds. Each level is comprised of age-appropriate songs, exploration of instruments, poetry, soundscapes for acting out and a variety of musical games.

The programs provide learning through fun. They are not performance-based, but focus on allowing each child the opportunity to awaken and develop their inborn joy and talent for making

music.

It encourages children to make sense out of sounds, develop their listening skills and refine motor skills, balance and coordination. Music engages the whole child and not just physical skill. Early childhood is the optimal time to begin this musical journey.

The instructor, Gloria Scott Wheatley, has been teaching similar music groups for young children since 1995. She was raised in the Townships, received her Bachelor of Music from Queen's University in 1994 and has been teaching private music lessons since 1989.

In 1995, Studio Massawippi was created to offer music instruction to Ayer's Cliff residents, and another studio opened in 1997 for residents living in or around Lennoxville.

The classes are offered in English, French or bilingual according to the demand.

An open house will be held in Lennoxville on Saturday, Sept. 29. Spaces are limited so please call (819) 566-6084 in advance to reserve a spot.

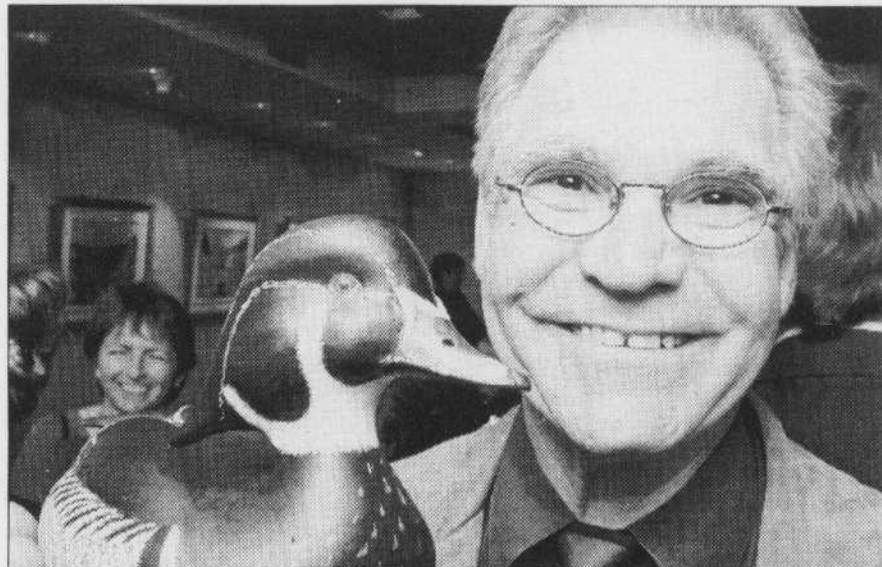
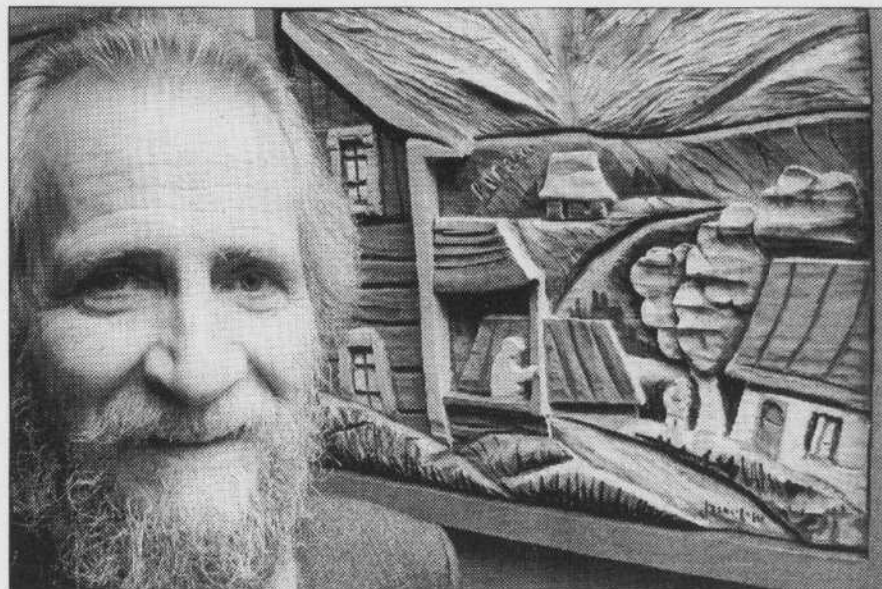

With a loyal legion of fans and just as many rip-off artists left in the wake of the mid 90s, it was only a matter of time before Babyface stormed back into the music spotlight, and with the recent release of *face2face*, the singer/songwriter doesn't disappoint. True to Babyface fashion, many of the album's singles are a smooth, pop spin-off of a lingering R&B backbeat. From his distinctive powerful lyrics, showcased in 'What If', to his characteristically catchy pop melodies, formulated in 'Inside Out', *face2face* will satisfy many the popular songwriter's fans. Perhaps more striking than another return hit album, however, is the hip-hop/rap influences throughout *face2face*. The guest appearance by Snoop Dogg on 'Baby's Mama', is not only surprising, but fresh and exciting, the result resembling George Michael's 'Faith'. Already widely respected within the musical community, Babyface is sure to gain even more supporters with *face2face*, a testament that this baby is still growing.

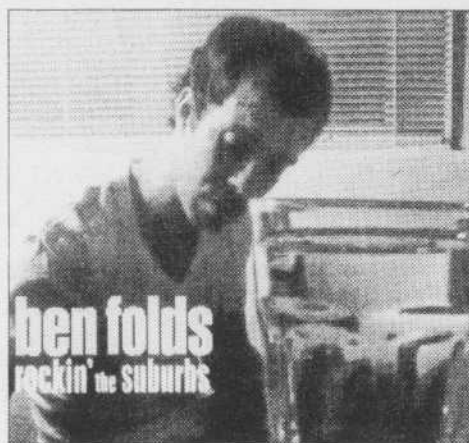

**MACY GRAY**  
*The Id*  
(Epic/Sony)

2001 brings the Id, just as 1999

brought Macy Gray's debut album *On How Life Is*. She has changed somewhat. No longer is the disc strictly soul and R&B, there is disco and funk tossed into the mix on the first few tracks of the album. Polished was one word to describe her '99 release. Macy Gray's own words describing *The Id*, "what you do before you think, the real you...unedited." Much thought must have gone into the record with her roles in co-production, writing all but one song and contributing to the music in a couple of instances. She was able to show her real self to a greater degree on this disc. Macy Gray has some talented guests on the disc, including Erykah Badu, Angie Stone and Mos Def. Sweet tracks are the first single, 'Sweet Baby', 'Harry', 'Don't Come Around' and the bonus track 'Shed'.

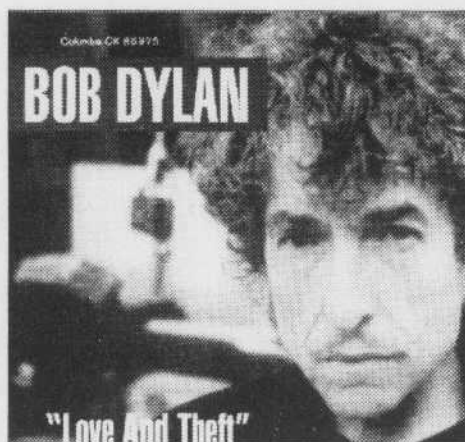

**BEN FOLDS**  
*Rockin' the suburbs*  
(Epic)

In his first solo album since dissolving Ben Fold's Five, Ben Fold's latest, *Rockin' the suburbs*, a 12-song compilation is simply an attempt to ride on the success of the former band, but inevitably falls short. From Chapel Hill, North Carolina, Fold's undeniable talent is awesome, as the multi-gifted artist co-wrote every song with Ben Grosse (Filter, Fuel), as well as singing and playing almost every instrument. Yet,

what made Folds so good was his supporting cast, and with bassist Robert Sledge and drummer Darren Jessee now gone, Folds' lyrics are flat, and his music is uninspiring. The lone exception lies in 'Not the Same', an enlightening alternative track that has a spunk and attitude comparable to Ben Fold's Five hits 'Brick' and 'Underground'. Otherwise, Folds' latest album just does not have that same liveliness that quickly made Ben Folds' a household name. Love him for his talent if you must, but don't love this album just for the sake of patronage - you will be disappointed.

**BOB DYLAN**  
*Love and Theft*

After 43 albums, Bob Dylan has the experience and talent to meld several different musical genres together in a clever fashion. On his latest disk, *Love and Theft*, this is no more apparent as Dylan mixes folk with country, rock, blues and bluegrass. As always, Dylan also presents a diverse lyrical lineup, often weaving tales and telling stories. Highlighting the album is the single

'Summer Days', which starts off with a very upbeat rocaabilly feel, later melding into a traditional blues number. Also, 'Cry A While' is the tale of a man who cried for his love and now she must cry for him - a song that would fit in perfectly on the play list of Saturday Night Blues on CBC Radio One. The album is palatable, easy on the ears - provided you dig Dylan's trademark voice - and most certainly bears the smoothness of someone who has been in the music business for many years.

**CARMEN LUNDY**  
*This is Carmen Lundy*  
(Justin Time)

From acting to singing, Carmen Lundy is undeniably a multi-talented performer, and in her latest album, *This is Carmen Lundy*, Lundy continues this tradition in fine form. In addition to her amazing vocals, the instrumental arrangements on the album complement Lundy's performance, as solos on trumpet, saxophone and piano dominate the musical landscape. The disc is a mix of contemporary, easy listening jazz. All of the album's songs feature lengthy titles, placed carefully to detail a grand story of making instead of losing love. 'Better Luck Next Time' - one of the better and livelier tracks with some scatting - is a tale of love lost, as told by a narrator. On another track, Lundy calls out for love and once found, wonders if it is true. Love, in fact, is the focus on seven of the nine tracks, and although they all flow nicely, sound solid and tell varied stories of love, there is no revolutionary material here.

# Artistic endeavours showcased at Art-circuit

Prepare yourselves for wild cultural trips in Sherbrooke on Saturday, Sept. 23 as fresh artistic endeavours are on the menu for the second edition of Art-circuit.

Designed to showcase new talents in all fields of music, dance, theater and visual arts, Art-circuit offers unique opportunities for more than 70 young artists to express and produce themselves on stage.

Let me guide you through my own itinerary in meeting several promising voices.

Our first steps take us to the Galerie d'art du centre-ville at the heart of old Sherbrooke, next door to Galerie Horace. Starting at 11 a.m., discover the work of sculptor Marine Delorme. Delorme attended CEGEP in Sherbrooke where she studied several arts and crafts, among them photography.

"For five years I've been developing surrealist imagery," Delorme said.

"I often listen to music when I work because it helps me uncover my emotions. I shape my sculptures in an instinctive fashion and I want my art open to all, climates and emotions are most important to me."

Aside from Delorme's work, the gallery will feature paintings, drawings, engravings and photographs by 10 other artists, as well as some performance art.

Galerie d'art du centre-ville is situated at 66 Albert St. in Sherbrooke, and it opens at 11 a.m.

Our next destination is Le Petit Théâtre de Sherbrooke, a great stage for acoustic and intimate shows with its

115 seats. Shows start at 1 p.m. with a dozen young men and women singing, playing, composing, dancing, writing poetry and/or making magic in every sense of the word.

I won't let you in on all the surprises. For now I want you to meet charming Thai Hoa Tran, a bit of a 'Renaissance man' who has been involved with performance arts for the sheer love of it, including music, theater and stage production for benefits and social occasions here and in Montreal.

### FRENCH CONNECTION

This Saturday Tran will sing in English and Vietnamese, a cappella and with a pianist and cellist. Fond of many styles of music (classical, pop, folklore), Tran does it for fun

"I want to perform the songs with all my spontaneity and sincerity," he said. "I don't really have a big musical background, but I'm taking on the new Science, arts and humanities program in college (CEGEP de Sherbrooke) because I always like to broaden my cultural interests. That is my only ambition."

Petit Théâtre de Sherbrooke (Salle Kinsmen) is situated at 174 du Palais. Seven showcases beginning at 1 p.m.

Off we go to the beautifully renovated Théâtre Léonard Saint-Laurent, part of Sherbrooke's Saint-Charles Seminary. Beginning at 4 p.m., five music and dance bands await us in colors as varied as Québécois songwriting, classical music with amplified instruments, folklore on a new beat, daring rock'n'roll dancing and finally, a peculiar musical theater

concept by the group O3.

Members Dominic Jean (percussionist, composer) and David Rouso (writer, painter, singer) explained that they've known each other since childhood and have worked on many projects together before. They believe in developing strong affinities between music, painting and dance, three fundamental dimensions of human expression.

Characterized as a "musical dancing theatre" by the band members, the show will feature songs from their first CD, Drum poetry. The song called 'Eco', evokes the search for equilibrium between Man and Nature, they explained. O3's third member, Benoît Fisch, dancer and acrobat, is currently studying at Montreal's École Nationale du Cirque. Need I say more?

See them and many others at Théâtre Léonard Saint-Laurent, 222 Frontenac St.. Five showcases starting at 4 p.m.

Our journey ends at Théâtre Granada on Wellington Street, where six artists and bands will play and sing their hearts out in Spanish or French and in different landscapes, Latino, French pop, jazz, international percussion and underground rock.

Meet Sébastien Hinse, co-founder of two of those bands: polyrhythm percussion group Tribal and jazz quartet Vizzaj.

"Tribal is born of many exchanges between friends and musicians over the years," Hinse said. "Especially with my friend Jonathan Préfontaine and others like Sébastien Côté, from the beginning we wanted to explore percussions of all kinds and in all circumstances of playing, dancing, celebrating with people.

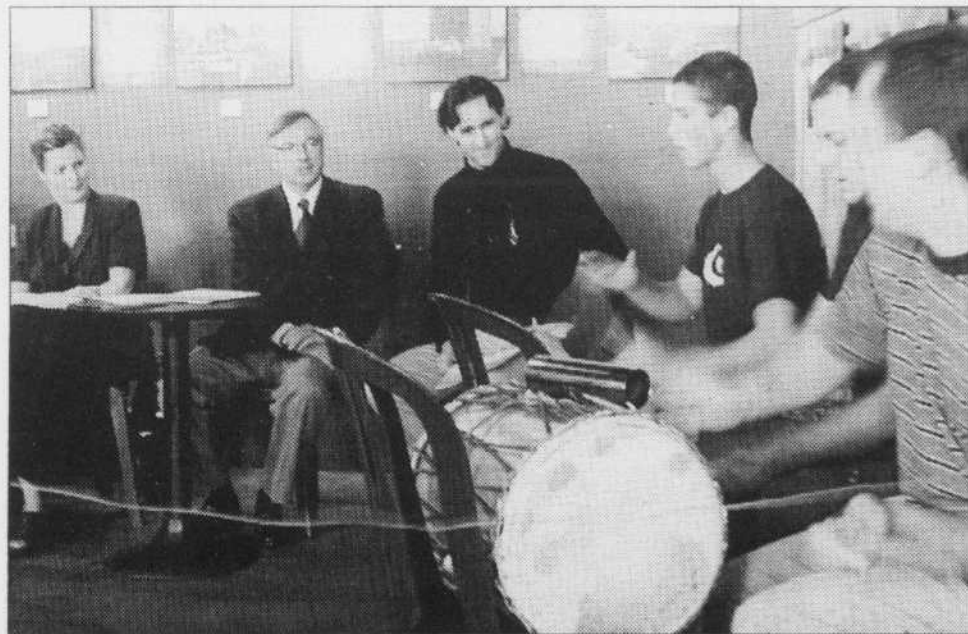
We love African and Latin traditional beats as well as we love creating new opportunities for the instruments.

# Making a masterpiece with nothing

Six years ago, Edward Burns was the darling of the Sundance Film Festival because of *The Brothers McMullen*, a comedy about the romantic tribulations of three Irish-American brothers. Not only did he fulfil the triple function of writer, director and actor on this project, but he managed to deliver it for an unbelievable \$25,000 US.

That movie went on to earn more than \$14 million US in North America alone; in terms of the ratio between budget and revenue, this made *The Brothers McMullen* Hollywood's most profitable film of 1995.

Burns remains proud of this achievement, but he doesn't want to be remembered only as a whiz kid who made a successful movie for peanuts.

Equally important to him were his reasons for making *The Brothers McMullen*. He wrote the film because he was so fed up with a Hollywood product that didn't speak seriously to his generation.

"The reason I made *The Brothers McMullen* was out of this anger and frustration. I was not seeing any characters on the screen that I could identify with."

Essentially, he was writing for himself and his friends. He continued in this vein with his next two movies — 1996's *She's The One* and the 1998 *No Looking Back*.

And he pursues it again in his latest movie, *The Sidewalks of New York*, opening Sept. 28 in Toronto and Montreal, Oct. 12 in Vancouver and Oct. 5 in other cities.

The new film is reminiscent of the 1950 Max Ophuls classic, *La Ronde*, with its examination of the interlocking relationships of several young New Yorkers. It has also been likened to several of Woody Allen's rueful romantic comedies of the '70s and '80s — a comparison that makes Burns uneasy.

"I think that people always need to compare you to something. So if I'm going to be compared I guess I'll take Woody Allen. You could have compared me to someone a lot worse."

What bothers Burns about the Allen parallel is that Allen was the quirky spokesman for a different generation. Meanwhile, Burns reiterates the belief that his own generation is being short-changed.

"I don't see anybody making films that have anything to do with my life or what my friends are going through as far as their personal lives are concerned."

More specifically, he's scrutinizing the perilous "course of true love" in the late '90s and the new millennium. His film poses the question: Does anyone care about love anymore?

On a strictly personal level, Burns has been asking himself that question a lot. When he started filming *The Sidewalks of New York*, he and actress Heather Graham were a romantic item, and he cast her in the role of a young Upper East Side wife who's being cheated on by her chauvinist dentist husband (Stanley Tucci) and finds potential solace in Burns's character, a street-smart New Yorker named Tommy who loves the chase and the seduction.

Graham and Burns have since split ("Fortunately we broke up friends and have a nice relationship, so it's not a big deal."). But Burns also knows that his romantic life is a reflection of the culture he's attempting to examine on film: he's previously been linked with two other ac-

tresses, Lauren Holly and Maxine Bahn, and is currently engaged to supermodel Christy Turlington.

The movie, he frankly admits, is about falling in and out of love, about relationships coming together and then disintegrating.

The seeds for *The Sidewalks of New York* were planted three years ago when Burns was working as an actor for hire in Steven Spielberg's *Saving Private Ryan*. He became fascinated with the way Spielberg worked.

"We're sitting there on the set and watching Spielberg with hand-held cameras and available light and the camera is flying all over... and we're knocking off a lot of work real quickly. I thought to my-

self: 'I make low-budget independent films, and if I used hand-held, I could make them much more independently.'"

In addition, Burns and some of the other "guys" on set spent a lot of time sitting around talking about "relationships and all the crazy things that can happen."

Somewhere in one of these conversations the idea was born of doing a hand-held film which wouldn't be the traditional boy-meets-girl, boy-loses girl, boy-gets-girl-back romantic comedy.

"I would do more of a relationship movie that deals with things you probably wouldn't see handled in a Hollywood romantic comedy — whether it's a young girl getting pregnant and having the baby without telling the guy or a character like Heather Graham being trapped in this miserable relationship and turning a blind eye to it for a couple of years."

When Burns finally started shooting the movie last year, the hand-held camera served his purpose beautifully. Not only was it fast — the film had to be done in 17 days on a budget of less than \$1 million U.S. — but it also helped him achieve the intimacy he needed.

"I wanted... to show people in the midst of their lives, making choices, making changes. I wanted to have the feeling of an investigation — to tell the story of a wide range of characters, but to still get close to each one of them. Shooting a tight-knit story in an immediate style, drawing the audience into the process — it seemed to me the way to go."

Burns has said more than once that if someone handed him \$75 million to make a movie, he'd be terrified because he wouldn't know how to spend such an amount.

Since then, he's become reconciled to the fact that he'll have to go with a substantially bigger budget than his normal ones if he's going to carry out his dream project — a multi-generational period piece about New York cops. That, he figures will cost at least \$40 million — a prospect he dreads. But it's a movie he's determined to make, once he manages to raise the loot necessary.
