Something for everyone on the Circuit des Arts

SHERBROOKE — Some 8000 visitors are expected to invade the Magog-Orford region as the 1996 edition of the Circuit des Arts Memphrémagog gets underway July 27.

One hundred and five visual artists will display their works in 62 different locations daily from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. through August 4.

Townshippers and tourists are invited to visit artists in their workshops or at collective exhibition sites, ask questions and purchase the art displayed.

"The tour really has something for everyone — and for every wallet," said John Di Nezza, president of the organizing committee.

Artwork will be sold for between \$10 to \$10,000, he said.

Overall, 20 different fields of art will be represented, including painting, sculpting, floral art, pottery and photography.

One of the innovations this

year is a draw which gives ticket holders the opportunity to win one or more works of arts. To participate, 99-cent tickets can be purchased at any exhibition site. Each holder is given the chance to win a certificate to be exchanged for works of art totalling \$500. The winning ticket will be drawn one week after the event and the winner contacted by phone. The proceeds collected from the draw will go directly to the artists.

"The Circuit des Arts de Memphrémagog is very good for the tourism industry in the region and is an excellent way to promote local artists," said Di Nezza. "It is also a very good way for people to initiate themselves to the world of arts. A workshop setting is always less intimidating than visiting a gallery. Visitors are able to see artists at work and ask questions on the spot."

Di Nezza is also one of the artists who will be displaying work on the tour. His photographs will be exhibited in his barn in Magog Township.

Other artists on the tour include painters Mimi and Claude Castonguay, Madeleine Audette and Marcel H. Poirier, ceramists Rosemary Voyer and Thérèse Savard and potters Jean-François Desrosiers.

De Nezza said with the growing popularity of the Circuit des Arts, this year they decided to create a Web site on the Internet.

"Information about artists participating in the event and a map of the tour sites is some of the information which is available on the Web site," said Di Nezza.

After 12 volunteers spent eight months organizing the event, Di Nezza is enthusiastic about its imminent arrival.

"We expect a great turnout this year," Di Nezza said. "That is, weather permitting."

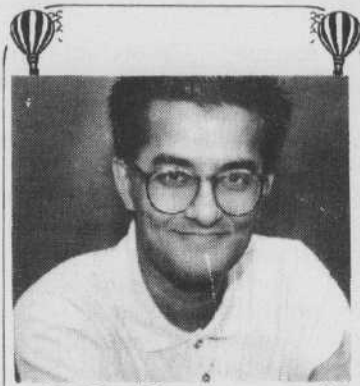

Friday, July 12 — Day 36: Hit astronomical heights during this weekend's stargazing fest at Mount Megantic, the second-highest Appalachian peak in the Townships. While you're in the area, don't miss the newly opened Astro-

This event is part of a summer-long series which will end in August with events at the Dum Corps International World Championships at Disney World and the Citrus Bowl in Orlando, Florida. Monday, July 15 — Day 39: Don't let Mondays get you down. Call up a friend and stretch your weekend out.

Tuesday, July 16 — Day 40: Check out a film today. There are finally a couple playing in English at Maison du Cinema in Sherbrooke, including the action flick *Independence Day*.

Wednesday, July 17 — Day 41: See a new exhibit of folk art objects by Townships favorite Naisi LeBaron at the North Hatley library. It is open from 10 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. and 6:30 to 8:30 p.m. tonight.

Thursday, July 18 — Day 42: Check out a retrospective exhibit of paintings by Ruth O'Donnell at the Haskell Free Library on the border of Rock Island, Que. and Derby Line, Vt. On display are portraits, landscapes and depictions of Townships landmarks spanning 40 years, captured in oils and watercolors by O'Donnell, of Maple Grove, Que.

Festival Orford's new director tries his winning methods in the Townships

Yuli Turovsky demystifies the creative process

ORFORD — Yuli Turovsky seems as informal as the atmosphere he is creating at the Orford Arts Centre.

Looking terribly relaxed on the patio just outside the cafeteria at the summer music school, the soft-spoken new artistic director said there is one thing people should realize about the concerts presented during its annual music festival.

"I wanted to make it more intimate, I would say less formal," he said of the 45th edition of Festival Orford, currently running through August 16.

"Right from the first concert (last week) I would present the artists and before they play I ask them some questions about the piece, about themselves, about their way of playing," said the Moscow-born cellist. "This I call demystifying the profession, because I think for the public the music is very important, but it's also very interesting to see how it's done."

WINNING METHOD

Turovsky said the method seems to be a winner with music-lovers.

"So far, I've got positive reaction from people who said they really were looking for this kind of thing, especially in the atmosphere of a festival in the

summer — everybody should be relaxed. And at the same time, it's very educational. Even the connoisseur, they cannot know everything. Even if they know everything, they don't know what this particular artist thinks."

For Turovsky, founder of the prestigious chamber orchestra I Musici de Montréal, it is important to allow the public in on the process of making music.

A musician since he was seven years old — and a teacher since 18 — Turovsky has played with numerous orchestras and ensembles in his career, recording upwards of 100 albums — as a soloist with the Moscow Chamber Orchestra, in a duo with his wife, violinist Eleonora Turovsky, with the Borodine Trio, which he founded in 1977, and with I Musici de Montréal which he founded in 1983.

He said a natural progression led him to Orford at this stage of his life.

"Two things were interesting for me — it's a school and a festival," he said. "With I Musici, we were thinking of creating some kind of school and some kind of festival, so here it came together."

SOLID REPUTATION

And Orford's reputation is built-in. Under its founder Gil-

les Lefebvre and most recent artistic director Agnès Grossmann, the centre has gained the recognition and respect of the international music community and attracts some of the most promising music students in the world to its school.

This summer, close to 300 students will spend one or more weeks at the institution located in the Mount Orford Provincial Park.

An array of international artists make time in a busy summer touring schedule to conduct master classes at Orford, sharing their knowledge and expertise with a new generation, as well as performing in its public concert series.

Turovsky said this is exactly as it should be.

"I like when the students are practising and the teachers and students get together and discuss things, make jokes, the atmosphere is more relaxed," he said.

NEW COMPETITION

Least one thinks this is an easy ride, there is some serious studying going on at Orford. Turovsky has upped the ante this year by creating the centre's first music competition.

Students who are studying there for at least four weeks will compete in three categories — violin, cello and piano — to win a chance to record a compact disc with I Musici de Montréal and get worldwide distribution on the Chandos music label.

The competition, taking place from August 12 to 14, is open to the public free of charge.

On August 16, a gala concert to close the season will feature the three winners playing with I Musici de Montréal and members of the Sherbrooke Symphony Orchestra.

"It's a great promotion of young talent," said Turovsky.

Students spending their summer studying at Orford will also play free concerts on Thursday evenings and Sunday mornings, followed by country brunches.

DISCOVERY

Turovsky said this year's festival, which he subtitled *Hidden Treasures*, is all about discovery.

Visual art exhibits complement the music

ORFORD (SM) — The Orford Arts Centre is hosting more than music students and professional players from around the world this summer. It is also home to great works of visual art by some of Quebec's most respected names.

Five exhibits are taking place concurrently at the centre located at Mount Orford Provincial Park through October 15, highlighting the strong connection between music and the visual arts.

"All the artists are working with the theme of nature," said Suzanne Fortin, who is in charge of the exhibits. "They are trying to integrate nature into our world, and show us how we can work with nature."

In the art gallery of Orford's Man & Music pavilion, *Of Colours and Words* is a retrospective exhibit of works by Madeleine Audette, including her acrylic paintings on canvas, oils, pencil drawings and prints. The Cherry River artist's works are displayed alongside unpublished recent poems by award-winning writer and playwright Marcel Dubé.

Audette and Dubé aren't the only duo exhibiting at Orford. In the rotunda of the Gilles Lefebvre pavilion, *Earth To Earth* is an exhibit of paintings by Jo Cooper and mixed media artist Benoit Héguay.

Cooper, who lives in Lake Megantic, said the environment at Orford is inspiring.

"The mountains in the background, the trees everywhere. Everywhere you turn you set your eyes on art," she said enthusiastically.

Cooper, who has also exhibited with Val-Racine resident Héguay in Quebec City, St. Jerome and Lake Megantic, said it

is also a pleasure to walk through an exhibit to the sounds of students rehearsing in the background.

Although their works seem quite different at first glance — Héguay working with watercolors on paper; Cooper with acrylics on canvas — she said there is a significant connection.

"We talk about the earth as our home base," said Cooper, whose rich canvases are composed of earthy colors and

natural mineral pigments that have been layered onto each other.

"I try to experiment as much as possible with different materials," Cooper added. "Each painting has about 20 lives."

Originally from Manitoba, Cooper is still reminiscent of the warm winter winds she experienced there, and captured the feeling in her painting "Chinook".

"The Chinook winds — you can wear t-shirts in the middle of winter. I love the wind on the Prairies. There's space and there's vastness. It's the total universe. It's something mariners feel on ships, when they

just see the ocean and the sky, well, it's the same thing on the Prairies. Then you get this wind, this constant wind and that's what it does to me," Cooper said wistfully.

Other exhibits at Orford this summer include a show of prints and works on paper from the collection of Loto-Québec, housed in the hall of the J.A.-De Sève pavilion, and in the bar of the pavilion, sculptor Camille Racicot, of Valcourt, presents his carved medallions, faces of musical masters from the 17th century to today. His striking sculptures depict luminaries such as Beethoven and Chopin, Duke Ellington

and Miles Davis.

And last, as they say, but certainly not least, in the Corylus Water Garden, nestled among the water-lilies, stands a glass fountain by sculptor Gilles Payette.

Art at Orford, as soothing as the sounds emanating from the concert and rehearsal halls.

The exhibits are open to the public Wednesdays through Sundays from 10-5 and Thursdays through Saturdays from 1-8 to August 23. From August 23 to October 14, the public may visit Wednesdays through Sundays from 10 to 5. For more information, call (819) 843-0909 or 1-800-307-3706.

"There are a lot of things which are not very often played, not because they are not good but because that is the history that just happens," he explained.

"One piece which is very interesting, a big project, is the 'Cantata Criolla' by the Venezuelan composer Estevez, which is a fantastic piece, never been done in Canada at all," said Turovsky, who will be one of the featured soloists — with pianist Gregory Shaverdian — at the concert on August 10 featuring Canadian James Campbell on clarinet.

On the program for this concert, presented at Saint Patrick's Church in Magog, will also be Mahler's "Symphony No. 4".

"This is quite an ambitious project and also a collaboration with the Sherbrooke Sympho-

ny, and the teachers, students and I Musici de Montréal will be all together on this," added Turovsky.

Turovsky has also made sure to program pieces that feature unusual combinations of instruments, such as the cello and guitar, and trumpet and trombone, to counterpoint the more traditional repertoire.

'SOMETHING SPECIAL'

This is his debut season as artistic director, and Turovsky has already grown quite attached to the arts centre.

"There's something very special about this place, something from the heaven," he said with a warm smile, glancing around at the trees which surround the centre and the mountain beyond it.

"We had one little boy here, 11 years old, from Quebec City,

fantastic, an incredible talent. He was at Orford on a scholarship which we give to four students from the system of Quebec conservatories. He said, 'I'm ready to live the rest of my life in this place'. Eleven years old! So there is something very calm here, a perfect place to work and to learn."

Turovsky, who played at Orford with I Musici many years ago, said you have to live there to truly appreciate it.

"I played here, but it's not the same, just when I would come and play and go. I know that my daughter, when she was 16, she sent almost the whole summer here and that's when she started to really work very seriously. At that time, there were still these cabins in the woods for practicing and she would get up at five in the morning and from 5:30 she would be there practicing six, seven,

eight hours a day and I think this place can do this trick."

Today, music is his life, but Turovsky said he simply fell into his vocation and didn't even choose his own instrument.

"I was seven years old, and this woman, a professor from the central music school, spoke to my father about entering me. She tested me out, said I had a good ear, and she must have said, 'On his forehead it's written *cellist*.' She decided I am a cellist, so that decision was made for me. I had nothing to do with this."

He said it was a bumpy road, but he eventually grew to love the instrument.

"At the beginning it was very good, then my teacher was not so great. Then something like five, six, seven years after I felt it's really my instrument and I started to work very much, and

I still love it. It's interesting, you play one piece, you study it, perform it, you do it for several years and let's say you don't play it for one year, and you come back, it's like a new piece."

"I think that's what's great about music," Turovsky added. "There's nothing set forever. It's a living process."

With his genuine concern for patrons and students alike, a strong desire to pass on accumulated knowledge and his infectious enthusiasm for the art of making music, it seems one of Orford's most valuable treasures isn't hidden at all — it's Turovsky himself.

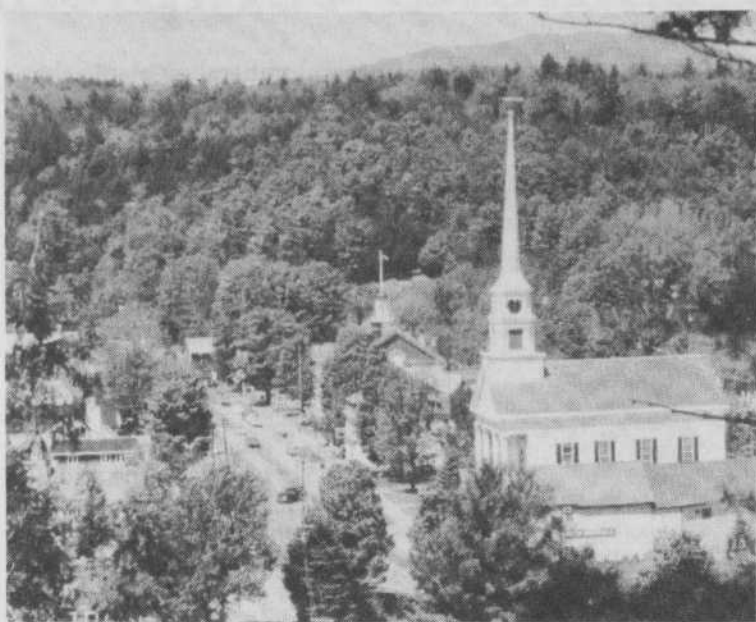

CENTRAL VERMONT — After enjoying a delicious tasting tour along Route 100, several calories and fat grams will have to be burned off. There are plenty of activities in the area that can be planned at a moment's notice.

Golf lovers can enjoy the facilities at the Sugarbush Golf Course or the Stowe Country Club.

The 18-hole, par 72 Sugarbush Golf Course in Warren is spread over 6,524 yards. Designed by Robert Trent Jones Sr., the course has 23 hidden traps, many doglegs, sharp elevation changes and tree-lined fairways. The course is open to the public as well as guests of the Sugarbush Resort.

The Stowe Country Club features a par 72 championship golf course on 6,213 yards. Located on Mount Mansfield, Vermont's highest peak, Stowe's club also has a 40-acre practice facility. This is superb for those who might be a little rusty or who want to perfect a swing.

Getting from one place to the other on foot is another popular option.

In Stowe, a historic walk provides gentle activity as well as an interesting educational experience. On a walking tour around Stowe village, visitors will learn about its history and architecture. Featured along the tour is the Green Mountain

Inn on Main Street and the Stowe Community Church. This church is the most photographed building in Stowe, and its image is used in many Vermont information pamphlets. Before starting the tour, stop at the Stowe Historical Society on Main Street for a walking map.

Hiking is one of the best ways to see the views of the Heart of Vermont. Hikers can enjoy the views from the ridge of Mount Mansfield. Mount Mansfield's trails along the tundra ridgeline can be reached by driving up the Toll Road to the Summit parking lot or by going up the Gondola.

From the Summit parking, the trail is a moderate 1.4 miles to the highest point, the Chin. Those who choose to ride the gondola to the ridge will have a very challenging 0.7-mile hike, along which hikers will get to see rare and fragile vegetation. The view is spectacular and, on a clear day, one can see the Adirondacks to the west and the White Mountains to the east. From Frenchman's Pile, the reward is a 360-degree view.

Hiking can also be a way to visit different neighborhoods in the area. North Wind Touring in Waitsfield will help those who love to hike get on their way. Along with getting you started on nature trails, North Wind Touring also provides Inn to Inn tours and luggage transportation, so you won't be loaded down with your suitcases as you hike to the next inn.

A sport that is gaining popularity by leaps and bounds is mountain biking. The Green Mountain area has many outfitters to provide enthusiasts and newcomers to the sport with a variety of services to help them enjoy the trails of Vermont. In Stowe, Action Outfitters and the Mountain Bike Shop offer bike rentals, self-guided tours and maps to help tourists find their way. The Mad River Bike Shop in Waitsfield and the Sugarbush Resort will also be glad to help riders. Trails in the area will provide spectacular views along easy and challenging trails.

For a hot, summer day, canoeing in Vermont is a refreshing alternative. Umiak Outfitters provide tourists with guided and self-guided tours. Inn-to-inn tours are also available with luggage transportation. To provide a fun and safe environment on the water, Umiak has classes for both canoeing and kayaking. Tours can be arranged for Lake Champlain, the Connecticut River, and the Winooski River. Also offered are "corporate challenge" packages to keep business gatherings fun, or to help employees learn about working relationships.

The sight of such beautiful waters might whet your appetite to try a little fishing. Uncle Noel's Guided Fishing Tours in Stowe and Streamline will teach you the secrets of fishing and, more importantly, the spots of biting fish.

Another way to enjoy the Vermont fresh air is on horseback. Lessons and trail rides can be found at the Topnotch Equestrian Center in Stowe and Vermont Icelandic Horse Farm in Waitsfield, which also provides inn-to-inn tours.

Finally, for real thrill seekers, a breathtaking option is to go gliding. At Sugarbush Soaring, located at the Warren—Sugarbush Airport, glider tours allow for a beautiful scenic view of the Mad River Valley. Professional instructors and pilots will take you to dizzying heights thanks to the amazing "lift" provided by the surrounding mountains.

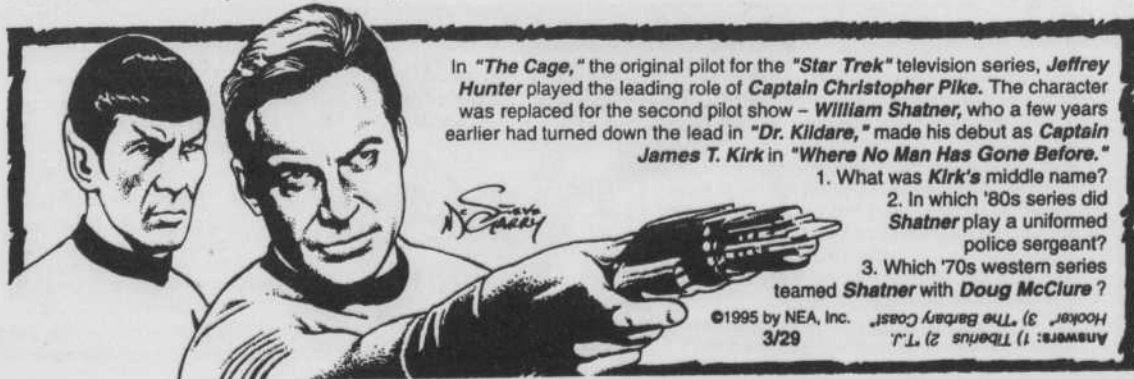

Bogguss: A fast car and the dream to reach the top

Suzy Bogguss is back with another great album, *Give Me Some Wheels*.

It is her seventh album and her first full-studio project in almost three years.

"Give Me Some Wheels", the first single, is without a doubt a reminder of her beginnings in the music industry.

Bogguss used to travel back and forth across the country with her dog, Duchess, as her only companion and her spirit of adventure her only guide.

This wildflower was born in Aledo, Illinois, a typical American small town and Bogguss was involved in everything from the Girl Scouts to high school musical productions.

Her dad worked in a factory and was a big country music fan, while her mom was a secretary for a grocery chain and a huge fan of the big band era.

Bogguss' older brothers and sisters were into everything from the Beatles to James Taylor, and it all rubbed off on her.

SISTER'S GUITAR

The marriage of her older sister Sally would change Suzy's life.

"When she moved out of the house, she left me her guitar," Bogguss recalled. "I basically

just picked it up, and that's how I ended up doing what I'm doing today."

Her first solo performance was in a senior high school talent contest, which she lost. It was not until she was studying art at Illinois State University that she began to seriously pursue a career in music.

While she completed her studies, Bogguss booked herself into coffee houses and night clubs, then headed out on the road.

It was 1980 and she was discovering the sheer exhilaration of both making music and the freedom of being on the road.

Before her arrival in Nashville in 1985, she spent a good part of five years roving the country from Wyoming to Massachusetts as an itinerant folk singer.

"I started out traveling in a Datsun hatchback with my p.a. in back and my dog in front with me," she remembered. "I'd tour the West for about nine months every year, and every fall and spring I'd go to New York and Cambridge (Mass.) and play all the folk clubs there, because that time of the year is just so beautiful in the Northeast. There was no career plot involved. I just did it to make myself happy."

With five years of musical dues often paid in tiny clubs under her belt, she rolled into Nashville in her camper with an uplifting attitude, freshness and unflinching humor.

DOLLYWOOD

After playing a few gigs, she signed on as a headliner at Dollywood, where she was ultimately heard by a Capitol Records scout.

Country fans would soon discover this artist whose voice is smooth and gentle with an underlying power, an artist who would soon be established as the formidable front-runner among country's new female artists.

In 1989, the Academy of Country Music voted her Best Female Vocalist and, in 1992, she won the Country Music Association's Horizon Award.

With her signature songs "Outbound Plane", "Drive South", "Aces" and "Hey Cinderella", she has proven to be not just an expressive songwriter and a vivid interpreter, but also one of the women in the business who is in total control of her music and her career.

Bogguss is also on top of her private life. Married to songwriter Doug Crider since 1986, they recently teamed up to produce the number one hit in their hearts — a baby.

Of course her pregnancy slowed her down a bit, but now Ben is 16 months old and Bogguss is back full speed.

Her new album exhibits the vitality, exhilaration and renewed energy Bogguss has to offer.

"What I really set out to do with *Give Me Some Wheels* was make a great driving album," said Bogguss. "I really tried to make a record that moves right along and sweeps you up and makes you want to get out and drive somewhere or move your feet."

Yet there's more here than just mere "drive time" music. With material from veteran writers such as Crider, Don Schlitz, Marcus Hummon, Trey Bruce and Tom Shapiro, you'll find high quality songs filled with deep lyrics.

Beneath the irresistible rhythms, soaring harmonies and spirited vocals, you'll go through a wide emotional range.

From the quest for honesty in "Let's Get Real" to the sweet resignation of "No Way Out" and the sadness of "Saying Goodbye To A Friend", Bogguss' voice soars.

There's "Traveling Light", about starting over, and the inspiring "Far And Away", co-written by Bogguss and Crider.

On most of her albums, Bogguss was also the producer but this time around she left the job to Scott Hendricks (Brooks & Dunn, John Michael Montgomery) and Trey Bruce, both well-known in the industry. They've brought a new and interesting perspective to her music.

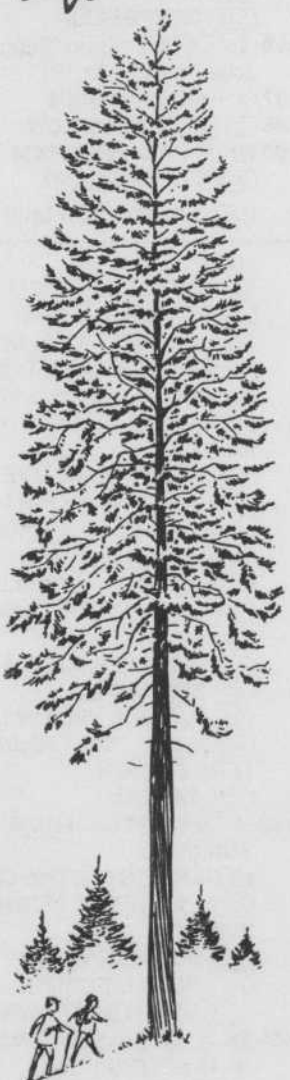

SHERBROOKE — Coaticook celebrates the yuletide holiday a little early with its fifth edition of Christmas in July this weekend.

Friday evening activities include a Santa Claus parade with the jolly old man from the North Pole himself.

The parade kicks off at 9:30 p.m. and organizers promise to provide a few surprises along the route which begins on Child Street and continues on to Main and Wellington streets.

New to the celebrations is

local merchants will have Boxing Day specials on Saturday, July 13.

The Beaulne Museum has got into the act this year with an exhibit on the History of Santa Claus taking place all weekend long.

Organizer Alain Hallé said the Christmas in July concept began in 1991 to try and give people in Coaticook a reason to smile.

"With problems like a high unemployment rate and businesses closing, we wanted to give the people in the Coaticook area something to be hap-

py about," said Hallé.

The festivities were also established to bring some life into the local economy.

"The celebration is also a chance for us to get people to notice Coaticook on their way to such places as Hampton Beach and Old Orchard for the construction holiday," Hallé said.

Christmas in July organizers thought of the parade as a way to get the traffic on highways 141 and 147 to stop a while.

"The parade has grown into much more than that," Hallé

said of Coaticook's tourist attraction. "We are finding out that people in the Coaticook area plan things like family reunions around the weekend. It's interesting to see how the local people are making this a tradition for themselves."

Hallé said roughly 10,000 people attended the event last year, but he admits it's not easy to tell exactly what kind of tourists the event is drawing.

"We know that about 25 per cent of the people who come are from the greater Sherbrooke area," said Hallé. "It is hard to tell though if we are starting to get the kind of tourists who will

spend the night in Coaticook and maybe do some shopping."

The parade is only a part of a busy Friday evening. The Harmonie de Coaticook band start off Christmas in July with a performance at Chartier Park.

Performances in the park will go on throughout the night with Les Tourbillons de Coaticook, Les Princesses de Valleyfield, Les Stentors de Fleuri-mont and Les Sénateurs de Joliette providing the entertainment.

Most of the stores and shops in Coaticook will remain open throughout the night Friday.
