Heavy metal fan turns classical pianist

For Rushdie, success is the best revenge

Eight years ago, on St. Valentine's Day 1989, the Ayatollah Ruhollah Khomeini instructed 500 million Muslims world-wide to murder Salman Rushdie at the earliest opportunity.

The Ayatollah (bless his little cotton socks) is dead and buried but Salman Rushdie, 50, is still producing books year after year. And what books they are!

Rushdie's most infamous novel, *The Satanic Verses*, won the Whitbread Prize for Best Novel, was short-listed for the Commonwealth's most prestigious

literary award The Booker Prize, and captured Germany's coveted Author of the Year Award in 1989. In 1993, *Midnight's Children* was named the Booker of Bookers

— the best novel of its first quarter century. That same year Rushdie won the Austrian State Prize for European Literature. *Haroun And The Sea of Stories* won a Writers' Guild Award. Shame won the French Prix du Meilleur Livre Etranger.

Rushdie continued to write best-sellers long after he received his many awards. *East West*, a collection of short stories bubbling with a zest for life, includes the writer's characteristic magic

realism which makes dreams and imaginations a part of daily life. The book has the sort of relish and sheer joy in the English language that marks Shakespeare and James Joyce.

After *East West* came a collection of essays called *Imaginary Homelands* and a work about a journey to Nicaragua called *Jaguar Smile*.

Since then, Rushdie's *The Moor's Last Sigh* has been hailed by novel critics as his best ever.

Rushdie's work has been published in 25 languages to date. Readers will honour his name long after the Ayatollah Ruhollah Khomeini is forgotten.

Success, they say, is the best revenge.

Disney lets Hugo's *Hunchback* ride off in sunset

Call me naive, but I honestly can't understand why so many adults have such a hate-on for all things Disney.

Really, you'd be amazed at how often I find myself defending the Mouse-Earned Crest of Disney whenever the subject comes up in conversation. And it comes up fairly often, considering I walk around proudly with a Mickey Mouse purse.

Now if you listen to some of the people I've spoken to, Disney is the very epitome of corporate capitalism. While I'm as tired as the next parent of hearing my kids ask for all the great movie-related paraphernalia that's out there—the 101 Dalmatian pencil case, the Hercules Easter chocolates, the Toy Story lunchbox and knapsack, among other goodies—I can't exactly blame Disney if I'm weak-kneed enough to buy all this stuff.

Others dislike the way Disney manipulates classic children's tales in order to make them more child-and animation-friendly. Case in point: the newly-re-

leased *Hunchback of Notre Dame*.

Well, I own it, I watched it, I enjoyed it—but I'll forewarn any fan of the Victor Hugo's novel to steer clear. The novel and the movie are as different as night and day.

Disney's *Hunchback* features three singing gargoyles, a cuddly and benign Quasimodo; never does the movie explore the religious hypocrisy and corruption that was so central to Hugo's novel. Oh well.

DESPICABLE VILLAIN

The evil Judge Frollo is a despicable villain, but his obsession with the gypsy dancer Esmerelda is seriously watered down. Disney never touches the subject of why exactly it's wrong for Frollo, one of the church's head honchos, to lust after Ezzi, but his love, hatred and passion for her is still disturbing enough for a kid's movie. Check out the scene where Frollo sings about his lust in front of a blazing fire which, of course,

represents the flames of Hell. Okay, it's nothing to a 31 year-old mother, but it's pretty heavy-duty for kids.

I genuinely like Esmerelda. We own the Barbie Esmerelda, and I'm always battling my five year-old daughter for the right to dress her and fix her hair. Now THAT'S obsession, Master Frollo!

Quasimodo is just a tad too cute and adorable for my tastes, but there are certain moments in the movie where he shows some actual grit and sort of resembles the complex Quasi of the novel. There's a great scene in which Quasi saves Esmerelda from being burned at the stake for witchcraft, then scrambles up the walls of Notre Dame and holds her lifeless body above his head, shouting "Sanctuary! Sanctuary!" to the crowd below. Wow! This is great Disney melodrama that tugs at the heart-strings with a vengeance.

Of course, the ending in Disney's version is slightly different from the one in Hugo's novel. In the movie, Frollo dies

an appropriately gruesome death (he falls off Notre Dame Cathedral into a fiery pit below—no symbolism there, huh?); Esmerelda and Phoebus, the handsome soldier, are destined to live happily ever after, emerging from Notre Dame to the cheers of the assembled crowd; Quasimodo is released from his bell tower prison and steps into the sunlight, finally, to have a little girl run her hand down his cheek, unrepulsed by his appearance.

Quasi is proclaimed a hero and the movie ends with him leading the crowds of Paris away from Notre Dame and towards—Well, I dunno where they're going, really, but I'm sure one of the followers must ask that question eventually.

This is a far cry from the novel, where Esmerelda is hanged and Quasi goes to her tomb to die by her side.

Well, my kids can find out THAT ending in ten years or so when they read the novel in high school.

In the meantime, I'll let them have their Happily Ever After, Disney-style.

'World music connected' – Karen Young

Musical experiments pay off for independent artist

Don't call Karen Young a jazz musician. Though Young built a name for herself as a jazz singer throughout the 1980s, the 90s has brought an expansion of her musical horizons.

Born in Hudson, Quebec, Young moved to Montreal at the age of 20 as a folk singer. By the age of 22, she had evolved into a jazz singer and was singing with the Bug Alley Band. She stayed with the group, which performed jazz in vocal four-part harmonies, until 1980. From there, Young performed on her own, accompanied by a bass player, for the better part of eight years.

In 1990, Young decided to expand her musical horizons. She started to experiment with world beat, country, classical, and blues.

"It wasn't because I wanted to reach a wider audience. If that was the case, I would have been a pop star," said Young, who recently performed at an International Women's Day benefit concert at the Granada Theatre in Sherbrooke.

Young's research into different sounds led her to playing African, Bulgarian, Greek and Latin music. Though she enjoyed experimenting with different sounds, she was known for her jazz music and finding a record label to support her proved to be difficult. So she

decided to form her own independent record company, Ursh.

"I'm able to do my own music now, not what is imposed upon me," she said.

"People like to put you in a category. They find it hard to figure out what I'm going to be doing next," she said, explaining it is difficult for a record company to promote an artist who experiments with music.

Young has produced three albums for Ursh, experimenting with her own compositions and interpretations of both classical and world beat music. She is currently planning for her future albums. A jazz record is on the horizon. Another project in the works is a Christmas album using medieval sounds.

Her devotion to embracing different styles of music is based on a belief that any artist can benefit from tasting different cultures.

"Life is short and I wanted to expand my culture," she stated. Young said that with today's technology, information about different cultures is at our fingertips, and that an effort should be made to learn as much as possible about different civilizations.

"All music is connected," she explained. "Country can be connected to jazz... by its vocal harmony."

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Snappy answers to country questions

During the last few weeks, I have received many letters through e-mail full of questions, comments and encouragement. I want to thank you all for your support and I'll try to answer your questions using the best of my country knowledge. Here we go:

I'm a new country music fan and I love LeAnn Rimes' "Unchained Melody", but my father tells me this is an old pop song. Please tell me more if you can? - F. Klemmensberger, Rock Forest.

Hy Zaret and Alex North co-wrote this song back in 1955 as the theme song for the movie *Unchained*, a drama about life at a prison farm in Chino, California. This heart-wrenching song was indeed a Top 40 hit for several artists, including Les Baxter, Al Hibbler, Roy Hamilton, June Valli and The Righteous Brothers. On the country side, Joe Stampley was the first to record "Unchained Melody" in 1975, followed by Elvis Presley in '78 and Ronnie McDowell in '90. Many people will remember this song from the movie *Ghost* starring Demi Moore, Patrick Swayze and Whoopi Goldberg. I agree with you that LeAnn Rimes does a very good job covering this tune. And what a powerful set of pipes she has!

I'm a Dottie West fan and have been for a long time. Is it true that she's not a member of the Grand Ole Opry or the Country Music Hall of Fame? We never get to hear about older artists anymore. Can you help me? - G. Daigle, Sherbrooke.

This well-loved singer was a member of the Grand Ole Opry from 1964 until her death in the summer of 1991 (West died in a car crash as she was on her way

to the Opry). West is not part of the Country Music Hall of Fame yet, but she's still eligible for induction. You'll be glad to hear that *Big Dreams & Broken Hearts: The Dottie West Story* will air on April 19 at 8 p.m. on The Family Channel. Don't miss it.

I love the (Garth Brooks) song "Shameless" and I'm wondering if it was ever a number one song. I started liking country after it came out. - Nicholas Roberge, Lennoxville.

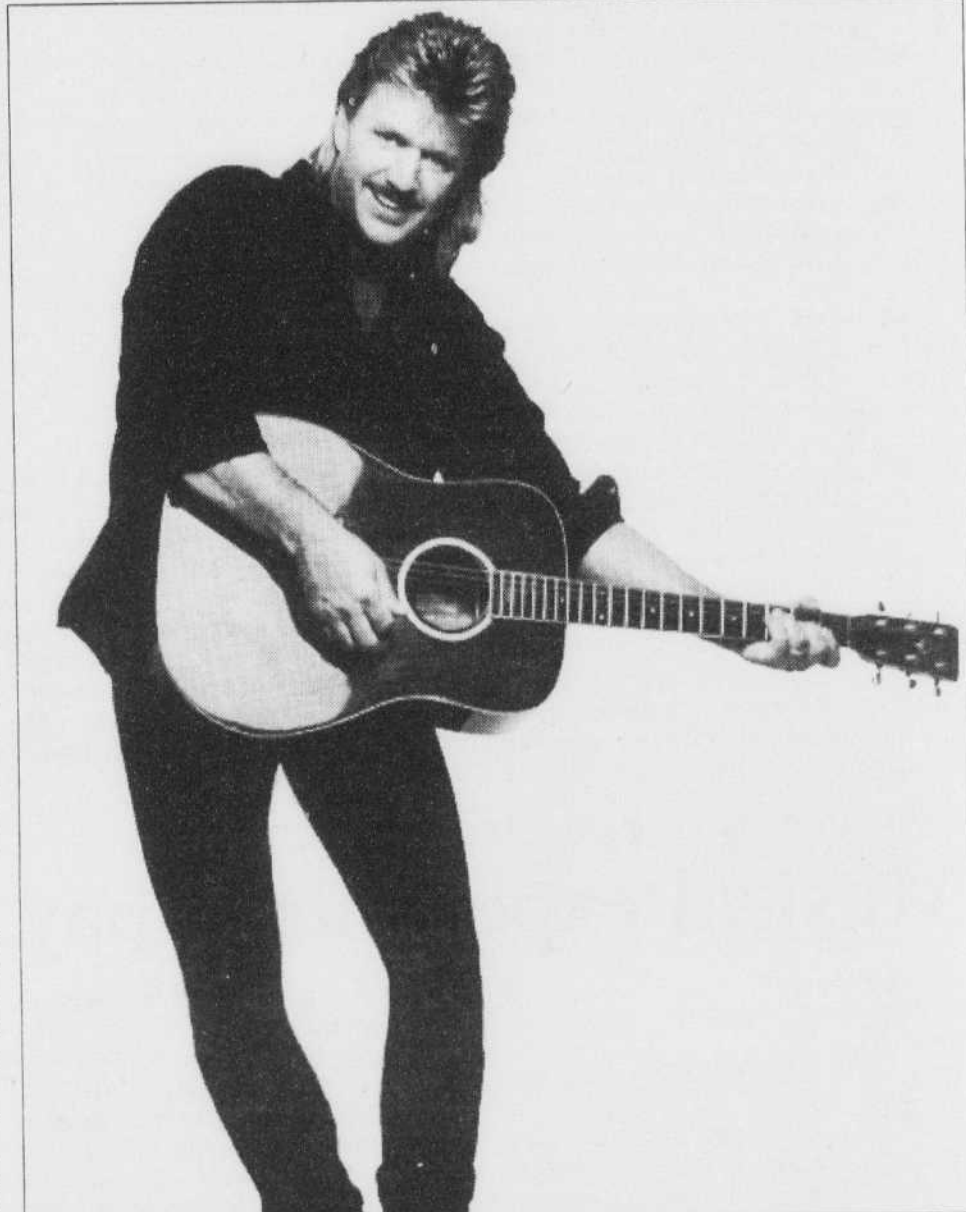
"Shameless", a song penned by singer Billy Joel, hit number one on November 16, 1991, on the USA charts and stayed there for two weeks.

It was on the charts for five months and was Garth Brooks's 10th consecutive top 10 hit. It also stirred a bit of controversy since Brooks recorded a country song penned by a pop singer. I'm very sorry but I don't

have the Canadian information for the moment but if I come across it I'll let you know. Keep on discovering country.

I just love Shania Twain, everything she does and sings is terrific. Why did she have to get married? Please tell me more about her husband. How was he able to win her heart? - Michael Hamman, Magog.

There are many men who have fantasized about the beautiful Shania Twain. She married Robert John "Mutt" Lange on December 28, 1993. She sparked this well-known producer's interest when he saw her video "What Made You Say That" from her self-titled debut album. 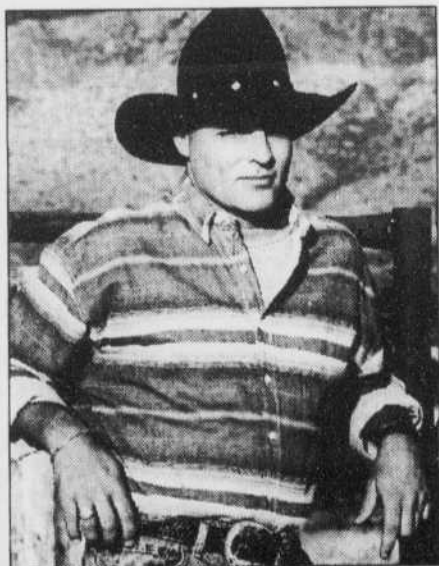
Trevino is a classically trained piano player. He began lessons when he was only five years old. The young artist gave his first piano recital at the age of six playing the theme from *Star Wars*. As for Joe Diffie's "Third Rock From The Sun", it was originally titled "Lives Will Change" but writers John Grenebaum,

Sterling Whipple and Tony Martin added the words "Welcome to Earth, third rock from the sun," and changed the name. It's hard to know exactly where writers get inspiration for their work. Earth is the third planet from the sun, and it seems the song inspired the title for the NBC sitcom, but it could all be a coincidence.

The musical journey of pianist Alexandre Nadeau From heavy metal to classical

In the classical music world, Alexandre Nadeau is considered a late bloomer. The 24-year-old Asbestos native first became interested in classical piano at the age of 16.

Prior to that, he was more interested in heavy metal music, playing electric guitar and bass in school. His curiosity about classical music began when he learned that some of his favorite heavy metal guitarists, such as Vinnie Moore, were influenced by classical pianists.

He decided he would give it a try.

Coming from a musical family, encouragement for music lessons was easy to find. "My mother played piano, my father played guitar," he said. "It was an amateur musical family."

While many pianists first start learning to play at the tender age of seven or eight, Nadeau believes his guitar playing helped him learn more easily.

"Since I started with the guitar, my left hand was well developed," said Nadeau. "This made learning the violin and piano a little easier."

After studying music in Three Rivers, Nadeau went to Laval University in Quebec to major in composition.

"Since I started so late, I wasn't sure I would get to the level and caliber to be able to play concert piano," he said. "I knew I liked music, but exactly what I would be doing in music, I wasn't sure about."

Now studying music interpretation at the University of Sherbrooke, Nadeau believes he is attaining the caliber required to be a concert pianist. He credits hard work and the encouragement from his music professor, Michel Fournier, for his personal development.

"He gave me the desire to go farther with my music," Nadeau said.

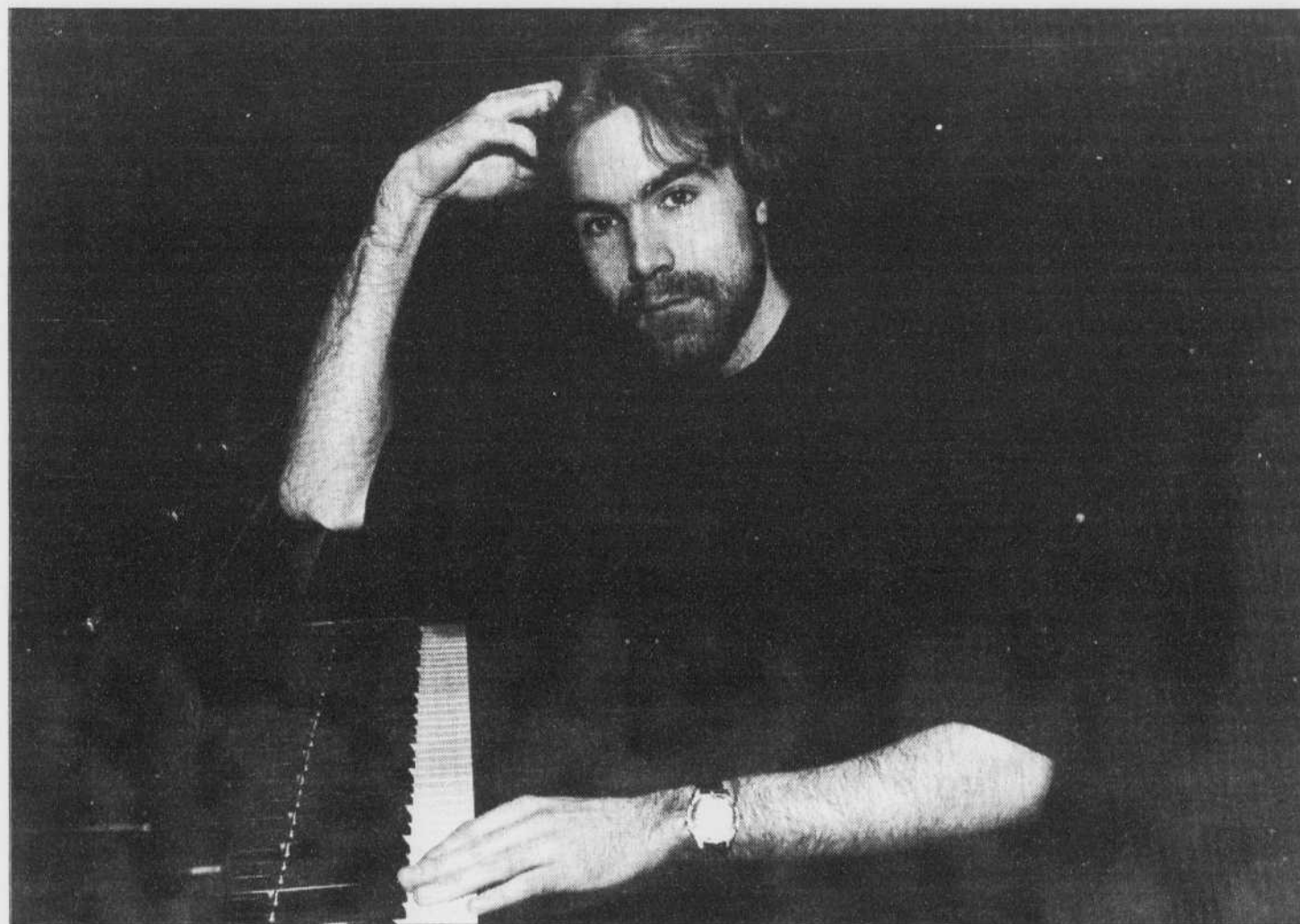
Fournier praises his young student.

"He plays very powerfully," said Fournier. "It's very rare that someone who started so late gets to that level. He's very intelligent, and learns quickly."

Being a quick learner was the edge that got Nadeau the job of performing with the Ensemble à Vents de Sherbrooke at its latest concert at Centennial Theatre in Lennoxville on Saturday.

Nadeau will be the featured soloist for the piece "Warsaw Concerto." The ensemble will also play "The Lord of the Rings".

When the musical director of the ensemble phoned Fournier and asked if there was a student who could handle the "Warsaw Concerto" with only one

month's rehearsal time, Nadeau was the natural choice.

"He was the only student who could learn and memorize such a piece so quickly," said Fournier. "He also has a natural affinity for this type of music."

Nadeau is looking forward to the experience.

"It's my first large-scale performance, as well as my first experience playing with an orchestra," he said. "Just by going to the rehearsals I felt that I found

my place. I know I'm not finished learning, but it felt good."

The powerful energy of his past love of heavy metal music still influences his choice in classical composers.

"Lizst's piano is very imposing and powerful," he said. "And Scriabine has a lot of harmony. There is a lot of energy in both."

Nadeau also likes to let loose with a little bit of jazz.

"Jazz is my heavy metal side coming

out. These days I listen to a lot of jazz because I'm preparing for the concert. It helps me let go."

The future holds many choices for Nadeau. Whether he performs as a solo pianist or as a member of an orchestra, he knows he will be happy as long as he plays music.

"I just love music. If I can travel, well, that's all the better," he said. "I hope that I will go to where I'm meant to go."

"The Lord of the Rings" in concert

In a concert likely to please people of varied musical tastes, the Ensemble à Vents de Sherbrooke will be playing "The Lord of the Rings" at Centennial Theatre in Lennoxville Saturday night.

The orchestra will be performing the Symphony No.1 "The Lord of the Rings," by Johann de Meij. In this peice, the Dutch composer recounts the story behind J.R.R. Tolkien's trilogy: "Gandalf," "Lothlorien" and "Gollum and Hobbits."

Conducted by René Joly, "The Lord of the Rings," has very strong percussion for a piece written for a wind orchestra.

"René Joly chose the music," said Mary O'Keeffe, general manager of Les Concerts Symphoniques. "He likes very

elaborate percussion."

O'Keeffe said the performance will be as exciting for the audience as it is for the performers.

"There are more different instruments doing challenging solo parts," she said. "Even the lowest instruments get some attention. The musicians have to be sharp."

O'Keeffe also said that audience members will not have to be musical experts to enjoy the concert.

"It's a very accessible performance," she said. "Because of the melody and rhythm, it's very easy to listen to."

The ensemble will also be playing "Warsaw Concerto", with featured soloist Alexandre Nadeau on piano.

Ayer's Cliff painter featured in Lennoxville group show

Mitchell seduced by the diversity of art

Among the 34 diverse artists currently presenting an example of their work at the Art in the Present Tense show in Lennoxville is Antonia Mitchell.

The Ayer's Cliff artist is displaying an example of her portrait painting at the fifth annual members-only show taking place at the Bishop's University Artists' Centre through April 5.

But there is much more to Mitchell than portraits.

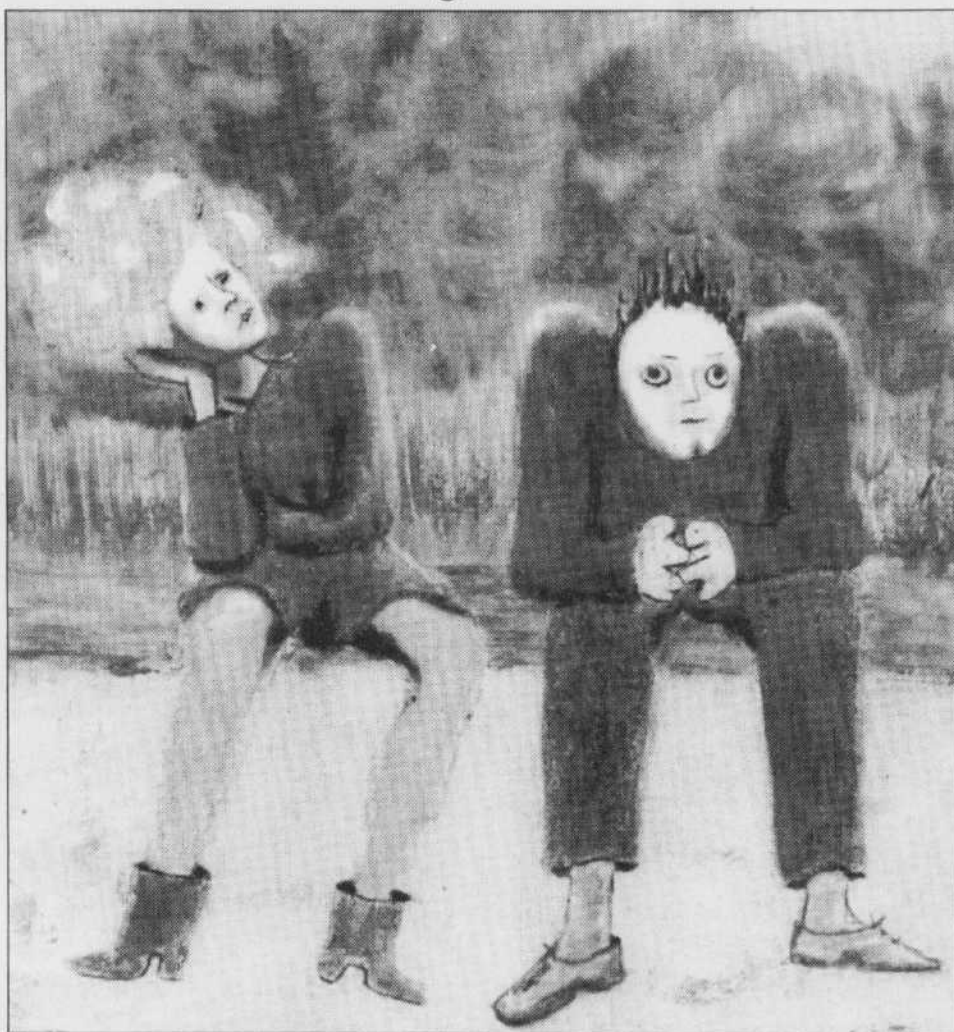
Mitchell typifies the artist struggling to find a niche in today's market. The information age, where an increasing amount of stimuli bombards us at an ever increasing speed, no less concerns the artist.

"Having an infinite amount of choices in art can have its ups and downs," said Mitchell. "Some people seem to find their calling in art right away and go with that, while others take a lot longer because they are distracted by too many artistic choices, too many techniques and too much knowledge."

One only needs to look at this artist's body of work produced over the past few years to realize that she has been, for better or worse, seduced down several avenues of expression.

Mitchell began her eclectic art in 1980. Her earliest attempts at painting were portraits of family members and self-portraits. After realizing art was going to be more than a hobby or passing phase in her life, she moved to New York to study at the Student Art League.

Mitchell took advantage of all the

fast-paced New York art scene had to offer - the galleries, the museums and the company of other artists. It was in this environment that she began working with a variety of media and subject

matter. Yet Mitchell was never truly inspired by the cityscape itself, and it was partly with her experience in the genre of portrait painting that helped her land a solo exhibition in the more familiar surroundings of the Eastern Townships.

Since the mid-'80s, Mitchell has hung her work several times at both the Piggery Theatre in Ste-Catherine-de-Hatley and the North Hatley Library.

Private commissions for her portraits have also come now and again, both in the United States and Canada.

Mitchell's portraits have no doubt appealed to many for the simple reason that her love for people always shines through in her work. She enjoys the personal connection involved when painting a human subject. The result is far from formulaic, involving constant experimentation with every aspect of the work, be it the human form, the palette or the background composition. She may prefer in one instance to superimpose her subject onto a very flat, decorative, background of bright, even fauvist, colours. Then again, she is just as comfortable with a more realistic rendering of the subject in a close-up action pose, sports-magazine style.

The artist's other accomplishments over the years have included works on paper in the form of monoprints, as well as mixed media projects out of wood and plaster. The monoprints serve as a vehicle for Mitchell's more expressionist works, often simple gestural exercises with bright oils which may at times have geometrically drawn figures, particularly birds, imbedded into them.

On some occasions, the monoprints feature people with more of the stylized backdrops seen in some of her portrait work.

The mixed media projects have certainly been well received. Most popular are the painted wooden sculptures that come across as decorative objects one would find at a crafts show. Her favorite use for wood is to create figures she calls "creatures" or "critters." These so-called "creatures" are hard to describe except that they are cartoon-like and semi-human in form.

"They're something you would see from another planet," the artist said. "These sculptures are very versatile and may be hung on a wall, or if free-standing, interact with a found object or even hold a lamp."

It is here where the artist blurs the line between arts and crafts. It is probably for this reason that the pieces do best for her in an economic sense. There has been a commission for a garden "creature" made of granite.

In 1992, the Mitchell finally decided to return home to Massawippi after 10 years of living in New York. Since her last show in 1994, she has been sidetracked from her usual creative output. Teaching from her studio in Ayer's Cliff, Mitchell has found it somewhat difficult to carry on with her own work.

Only recently has she felt herself coming back on track, confessing that "starting and stopping really doesn't help one's art and that one should make it part of daily living."

Mitchell promises something more focused in her next show than what was shown at the North Hatley Library in 1994. People can look forward to a much more in-depth project, involving a concept developed over a longer period of time.

"I'm beginning to formulate one or two ideas that will take on a definite direction," she said.

Although one can expect more focus in her next exhibition, it will probably move further away from portraits per se and more towards mixed media. She is reluctant to say too much about her upcoming work, however, for fear of putting into words what she wants to put into art. The only hint has been the possible use of more "creatures."

Until then, gallery goers will have to be content with Mitchell's single portrait at the Bishop's show.

Art in the Present Tense continues through April 5 at the Bishop's University Artists' Centre in Lennoxville. Opening hours are Tuesday to Saturday from 12 to 4:30 p.m. and during performances at Centennial Theatre.

The Special Edition of *Star Wars* achieved these goals. The revised *Empire Strikes Back*, however, disappointed many people for its lack of new improvements.

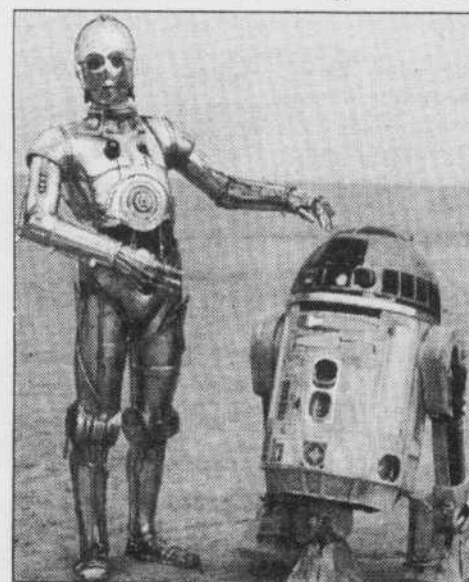

was the first movie in history to draw as many people as it did and it continues to attract a following 20 years after its initial release.

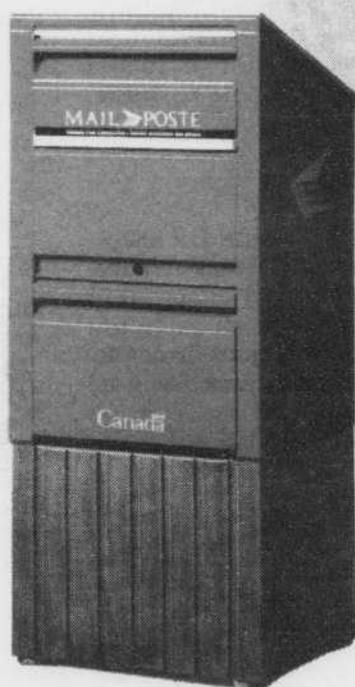
Its opening at Sherbrooke's Maison du cinema was sold out, with many still wanting in.
