Varda Burstyn's ecothriller is making waves

West Bolton writer looks at the power and politics of water

In a summer which seems to be a showcase for global warming, West Bolton writer Varda Burstyn's debut novel offers a glimpse into the very real, very dry possibilities of the future.

"The premise of the book is factual, global warming leading to trends of drought in Spain, Portugal, France, in the U.S. south, the Midwest and the high plains," Burstyn said in an interview with The Record. "Water will become blue gold, it will surpass the value of oil. Wars will be fought for water."

In *Water Inc.*, Burstyn's debut novel, a group of extremely wealthy U.S. businessmen see the looming water shortage, and see opportunity. They devise a plan to pipeline billions of gallons of water from northern Quebec to the U.S. Midwest, using Quebec's relative political isolation from the rest of Canada as leverage. "It's a Parti Québécois government, but it could be either one," she said.

On the other side of the issue are the oppositionists, an unlikely band of environmentalists, rogue police officers, a feisty British journalist and a Vermont governor hated by the water consortium and the White House.

Though a newcomer to the fiction scene, Burstyn has made a living as a non fiction author, political writer, cultural critic and public policy consultant. Over the years her focus has been primarily on Israeli and Palestinian pol-

itics, health care, feminism and the environment. Burstyn readily admits she's a political junkie, taking in the news and devouring political thrillers by the likes of authors like John LeCarré, her personal favourite.

Burstyn's varied life experiences have taken her from the inner workings of the women's movement to Greenpeace to the leading edge science of human reproduction.

On several occasions she has made predictions about what will happen next, and has been on target. Water Inc. has all the appearances of hitting the mark once again, if nothing is done.

"My sense of environmentalism goes back to the 1960s," she said. "More and more my writing has been looking at environmental issues."

While the story itself is fiction, many of the facts will leave the reader decidedly dry mouthed. In the past 50 years world water use has tripled; more than one billion people do not have access to clean drinking water; water pipeline projects are already underway in China, India and Libya. The president of the American Farm Bureau predicted that by 2050 water will be the most critical resource issue in the world. And yet the human race continues to consume more water than the planet can provide.

Those facts and many others are woven into the fabric of this fast-paced thriller, filled with numerous twists and turns and a cast of memorable characters. Along with the feeling of thirst the reader may well find themselves on the edge of their seats.

Shrimp salad a nice break from Caesars, slaws

Food

Some salads — think Caesar, pasta, coleslaw, spinach — are so good that we keep making them again and again.

Yet sometimes too much of a good thing can get tiring — which explains why I am always trying to come up with different salad ideas.

This week's recipe is fresh, colourful and dressed-up enough to serve at a formal dinner party. The ingredients work well, mainly because each one has a different texture.

The meaty shrimp, toasty pine nuts, juicy tomatoes and crisp green beans really complement one another. I would dress this salad a couple of hours before serving, so that the dill and sesame flavours are properly absorbed, and serve it chilled.

SHRIMP AND TOMATO SALAD WITH TOASTED PINE NUTS

Ingredients (for six):

4 cups cooked and peeled shrimp (buy it frozen)
4 cups green beans chopped into long pieces
1 cup pine nuts

2 cups cherry tomatoes

For the dressing:

sesame oil

1/2 cup vegetable oil

1/2 cup vinegar

1/2 tbsp. salt

1 tsp. dried dill (or 2 tbsp of chopped fresh dill)

freshly-ground pepper

Directions: Let shrimp thaw on the counter overnight. Drain all the liquid, pressing shrimp against a colander over the sink. Wash green beans, discard stems and chop them up. Wash tomatoes, pat dry and slice in half lengthwise.

Bring water to a boil in a pot. Add the baking soda. Cook the beans for four minutes. Drain, and run under cold water for a couple of minutes to stop the cooking.

Toast the pine nuts in a non-stick frying pan, stirring, until golden brown (don't use any oil). Reserve. Whisk all the ingredients of the dressing.

Refrigerate tomatoes, green beans and shrimp until a couple of hours before dinner. Toss all ingredients in a large bowl and refrigerate until you're ready to serve dinner.

Make salmon the star ingredient

Salmon has long been the home-run fish on a chef's menu, says author and chef Bill Jones, whose new

book, *Salmon: The Cookbook* (Whitecap Books, 2005), will surely make the pink fish a household favourite.

The collection of recipes from some of

the country's acclaimed chefs serves up culinary cheat sheets on poaching, roasting, grilling, curing and smoking salmon. There's marinades, stocks and soups with salmon as the star ingredient.

Dee Hobsbawn-Smith, a Calgary chef, offers her Brined Atlantic Salmon with Wine Gastrique. Fillets are blanketed with a mixture of coriander, fennel, mustard seed, peppercorns, lime leaves and ginger.

Hobsbawn-Smith's Spring Asparagus, Salmon and Hazelnut Salad is a refreshing starter for summer meals. Her simple but delicious recipe for cedar-planked salmon appears below.

Try Seafood Hot Pot with Saffron Aioli by Anna and Michael Olson, the husband-and-wife culinary duo from Inn on the Twenty in Jordan, Ont.

CEDAR-PLANKED SALMON WITH HONEY AND MUSTARD

Serves 6 to 8

3 tablespoons (45 mL) canola oil
1 3-pound (1.5-kg) piece of salmon, skin on
1/2 cup (125 mL) honey
4 tablespoons (60 mL) mustard
Zest of 1 lemon
Hot chili flakes to taste

4 tablespoons (60 mL) minced fresh thyme or sage

Salt to taste

Lemon, cut in wedges, for garnish

Sprigs of thyme or sage for garnish

Directions: Use an oven or outdoor grill, and ensure wood is unsprayed and pesticide-free. If grilling, soak the plank to minimize flaming. Preheat oven to 450 F (230 C) or heat the grill to medium-high.

Brush the wood with the oil and lay the fish skin side down on the wood. Mix together the honey, mustard, lemon zest, minced herbs, hot chili flakes and salt.

Brush the exposed surfaces of the fish with half the glaze, then transfer it to the oven or grill.

Don't overcook: allow about 7 minutes per inch (2.5 cm) of thickness. To test, use a sharp knife to separate several flakes at the thickest part. When done, it should no longer be transparent, but opaque.

Remove the fish from the heat and brush with the remaining glaze. Serve from the board. Garnish with lemon wedges and sprigs of fresh thyme or sage.

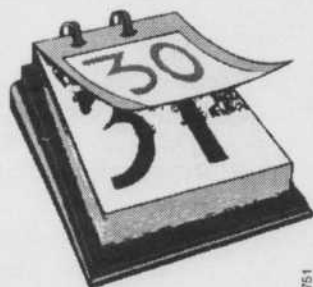

"In my other work there were always constraints, there were things you could not say," she said. "I think for me it's easier to tell the truth in fiction. You have none of the restrictions and you can tell people's stories."

Water Inc. has not gone unnoticed, garnering glowing reviews from the Kirkus Review, Orion and Booklist among many others. Booklist reviewer Donna Seaman called it "... a smart, sexy, witty and hard hitting ecothriller."

Burstyn is particularly proud of a review from the Durango Herald, a Colorado publication in the heart of U.S. water shortage country. It refers to Water Inc. as "... entertaining, swiftly paced and altogether unsettling." It goes on to say "... the fictional narrative is buttressed by a mountain of alarming facts."

Not bad for a city where half of the lawyers specialize in water rights.

Having lived in Israel, France, the U.S. and Canada, Burstyn and her husband David Fenton have spent the last five years living in the pastoral beauty of West Bolton.

Though business and family obligations will take them out of the region for longer periods in the years to come, the couple plans to be here as often as

possible.

"My closest friend rented a farmhouse in Mansonville in the summer of 1978, and we came out and drove off the highway into the country," she said. "I will never forget that summer."

"To write books this is perfect, peace and quiet," she said of her country surroundings. "To write you have to take big chunks of time away."

Time away can be hard to come by sometimes. Burstyn spent five years on Water Inc., finding time between other projects that paid the bills. The manuscript was picked up by Verso Press, and is distributed in Canada by Penguin Books.

Water Inc. has now gone into its second printing, with a French language version (H2O Inc.) coming out this fall.

"It has been really well received, I've succeeded in grabbing a lot of people's attention," Burstyn said. "What makes me feel really good is how much readers love it."

Buoyed by the success of her debut novel, Burstyn is ready to get back to the keyboard. Expect more environmentally-minded thrillers from this West Bolton writer in the years to come. Work on her next novel will begin this winter, once some other obligations have been taken care of.

"I have decided this is what I would like to do for the rest of my life," Burstyn said.

Harpsichord brings Bach music to life

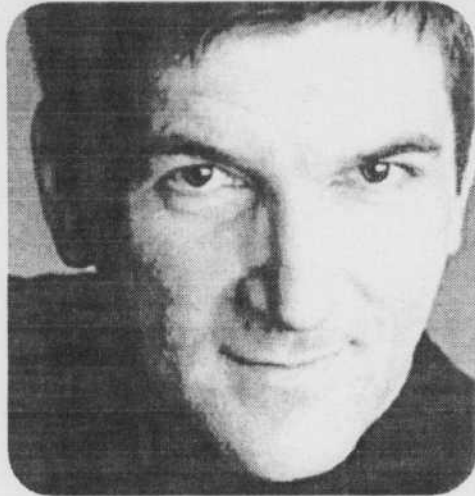
When Luc Beauséjour sits behind the harpsichord at the Orford Arts Centre on Friday evening, it will be a homecoming of sorts. Beauséjour was raised in Rawdon, north of Montreal, but it was in Orford where, 30 years ago, the budding musician first fell in love with the instrument.

"I was in Orford, and Mireille and Bernard Legacé were here," said Beauséjour in an interview with *The Record* from the Orford Arts Centre. "They invited people, especially pianists, to try the harpsichord, to play Bach. I went to the class and played the preludes and fugues. It was over for the piano. At that moment, I decided to study harpsichord."

Beauséjour, 47, has become something of a virtuoso on the harpsichord. His playing has garnered several international awards, including a first prize in the Erwin Bodky international competition in Boston in 1985.

He has a long list of recordings on harpsichord and organ, many of them retakes on the works of Johann Sebastian Bach.

Beauséjour is no stranger to the Orford stage as a performer. He has made a handful of appearances since he was first taken with the harpsichord in the

mid 1970s.

This weekend's performance, entitled *Bach to the Nth Degree*, will offer a look at a variety of Bach's works from different time periods.

"It will be a pleasure to play this beautiful repertoire," he said. "With Bach we always think about something spiritual. There's a lot of grandeur in his work."

Beauséjour will be joined by Robert Langevin on flute, Masuko Ushioda playing violin, and Laurence Lesser on the cello.

Along with Beauséjour's love of the harpsichord came his love of music from the Baroque period.

"It's the golden age for harpsi-

chord," he said.

Beauséjour is fast to sing the praises of his instrument of choice: "With the rhythm you can do a lot when you play harpsichord. You can create the illusion that the harpsichord has dynamics or that it can sing as well as a cello."

History was not so kind to the harpsichord. Its popularity died out in the wake of the Baroque period as its cousin — the piano — stole the spotlight and rose to prominence.

The revival of the harpsichord came about with the desire to recreate performances by music's old masters.

Beauséjour has been doing his part to turn young musicians on to the instrument.

"I have many schools," he said laughing, referring to his teaching positions with the Montreal Conservatory and at the CÉGEP de Saint-Laurent. Beauséjour also teaches harpsichord to a handful of private students.

"Young people like it," he said of his pupils. "Even after many years, they still play harpsichord and some have become professional. It's a good sign for me."

Beauséjour said

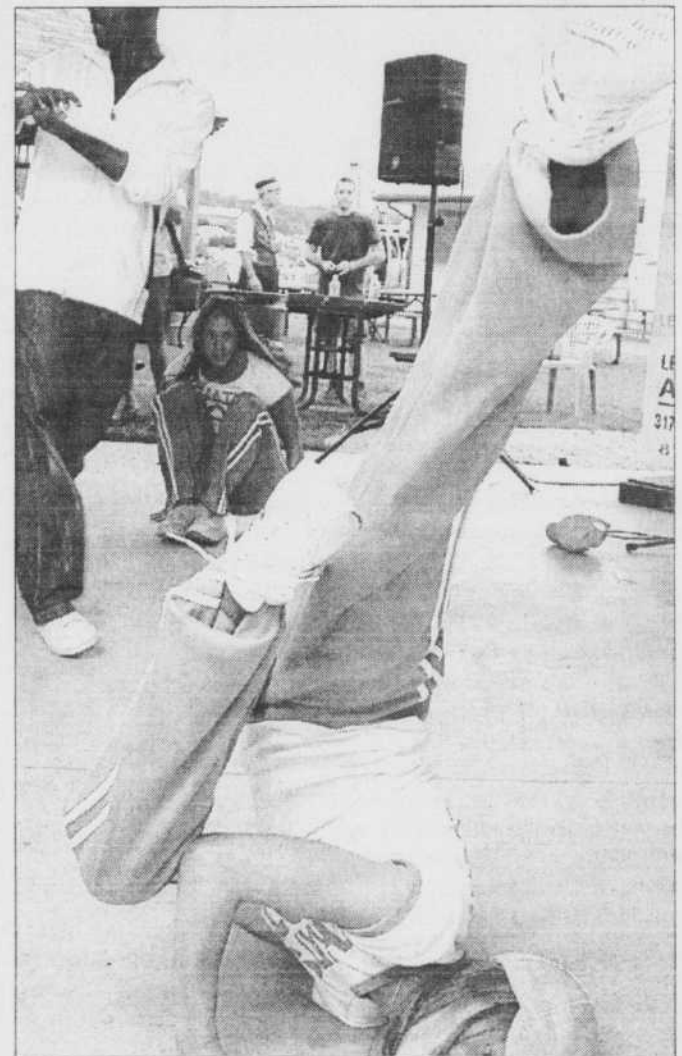
it also bodes well for the future of the instrument. The harpsichord, he said, fills a musical void that other keyboard instruments simply cannot.

"I think the sound of the harpsichord is very rich because the string is plucked," he said. "It's a little like a guitar. You have a lot of high harmonics in the songs. It's brilliant."

This is the final weekend of concerts at the Orford Arts Centre. Luc Beauséjour will perform Friday night at 8 p.m. in Salle Gilles-Lefebvre. Tickets are \$28.

There will also be a pre-concert lecture by Carol Bergeron. It begins at 7 p.m.

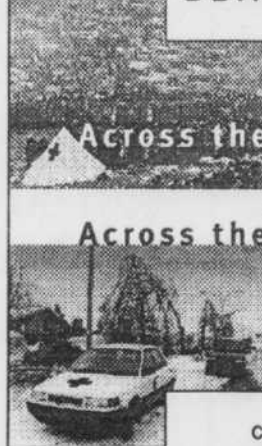

Four Brothers take on the streets

There's real trouble in Detroit. Not only are sweet-natured old ladies being gunned down while correcting wayward children at the corner candy store, apparently at random and practically in mid-moral lesson, but the crimes are being solved, not by a corrupt police force, but by a gang of charming rogue hoodlums who bicker and fight and amusingly whomp the tar out of potential witnesses to get to the truth.

And as if that wasn't enough, the Motor City has the suspiciously artificial atmosphere of southern Ontario. What's going on here?

It's Four Brothers, a family drama directed by John Singleton, who established a gritty street style with *Boyz n the Hood* and has let it drip slowly away in every movie since (including *2 Fast*, *2 Furious* and *Shaft*).

The record continues in this knock-off of the old John Wayne western, *The Sons of Katie Elder*, in which a group of cowpokes gather to investigate the murder of their beloved mom, not forgetting to bring along their six guns and plenty of angry attitude.

This time, the mom is Evelyn Mercer (Fionnula Flanagan), a foster parent who is shot dead in a corner store robbery in the opening sequence but who pops up as a ghostly figure throughout the movie, scolding her boys for putting their elbows on the table.

Significantly, her spirit is not around when they pour gasoline over people and hold lighted matches, or engage in a full-bore gun battle with a street gang from her living room.

Four Brothers mixes the sentimentality of death with a callous disregard for murder, and we're meant to feel the sadness of mom's loss and cheer the slaughter of the multitudes behind it.

The boys are all adopted sons, former tough kids who — as we're told in a series of clunky introductions — were "four delinquents so far gone she couldn't find anyone to take them."

They grew up to be tough kid Bobby (Mark Wahlberg), ladies' man Angel (Tyrese Gibson), sensitive musician Jack (Garrett Hedlund), and family man Jeremiah (Andre Benjamin), the son who stayed behind and tried to make a go of the middle-class world.

Realizing that the police aren't going to do much, the brothers take on the investigation themselves.

Despite the artificial-looking surroundings — you can somehow tell that this is Hamilton and Toronto rather than anywhere that, say, Eminem would consider coming from — *Four Brothers* starts with a nice mix of chemistry among the brothers.

Wahlberg is especially strong as the ex-con who is most likely to take on the heavy punching-out duties called for in the plot, but all of them have their moments in the first half hour of horseplay and grieving that follows Evelyn's untimely demise.

After that, though, the screenplay by David Elliot and Paul Lovett goes off into a complicated tale of corruption, highlighted by the late arrival of the villainous Victor Sweet (Chiwetel Ejiofor of *Dirty Pretty Things*), a gang boss who doesn't seem as dangerous so much as churlish.

He's about as tough as an errant schoolboy, and his wimpy gang members, whom he enjoys humiliating, would last about five minutes on the world of *Boyz n the Hood*.

By the time classy police Lt. Green (Terrence Howard) decides to overlook a mass shooting in a residential neighbourhood, *Four Brothers* has lost all its believability; even the relationship among the brothers seems strained, and the climactic reckoning plays more like parody than drama.

For one thing, you can't really have the payoff of an inner-city crime drama at an ice-fishing hole.

On the plus side, there's a good Motown soundtrack to all this nonsense. It's about the only part of *Four Brothers* that's worth listening to.

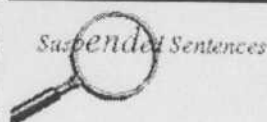

Rankin among best of British Noir

For many readers, this week's pick will be a change of pace. A temporary tale with vestiges of 1940s crime fiction popularized by the likes of Raymond Chandler and Dashiell Hammett — but set against the city of Edinburgh, Scotland, in a genre known as Scottish (or Tartan) Noir.

Noir is about alienated people trying to function in a dysfunctional society: Some are villains, more are victims, and even the heroes are flawed. Justice, if it happens at all, tends to be of the cosmic variety, the legal system often falling short.

As you might expect, there is a liberal dose of cynicism, leavened by a dark humour. The Wizard of Oz it ain't, but in the hands of a master, noir crime fiction makes for compelling reading.

THE AUTHOR

In a 20th century version of the Renaissance Man, Ian Rankin has been, by turns, a grape-picker, a swineherd, an alcohol researcher, a taxman, and a punk musician. Fortunately for mystery readers, he turned to crime writing.

It's now been almost 20 years since Rankin burst on the crime fiction scene with his first Inspector Rebus novel, *Knots and Crosses*; since then he's gone on to win an Edgar (the Mystery Writers of America award) for Best Novel of the Year (*Resurrection Men*), two Daggers (the British Crime Writer's Association award) for short stories, a Gold Dagger

for best crime novel of the year (*Black and Blue*), and a Diamond Dagger for lifetime achievement in crime writing.

He is the only author who has had seven novels among the top 10 best-sellers in Scotland at the same time. His books have been published in 22 languages, and he is currently the UK's bestselling crime writer world-wide.

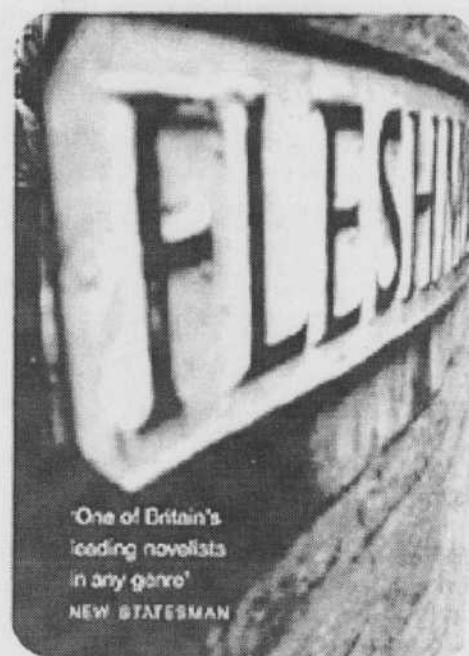
In 2002, Rankin was also awarded an OBE for his services to British literature (this for a man who has just turned 45). He and his wife Miranda and their two sons split their time between homes in Edinburgh and France.

FLESHMARKET CLOSE (ORION BOOKS, 2004)

Rankin is notorious for devising multi-layered plots, weaving together several mysteries at a time with contemporary social issues.

His stories have involved serial killers, ex-Nazis in hiding, and turf wars between rival criminal gangs; in between he has not neglected the worlds of cops gone bad, school shootings, and Internet predators.

His 15th Rebus novel, *Fleshmarket Close*, is no exception. Detective Inspector John Rebus is called to the scene of a homicide: A man is found in a passageway on a public-housing estate; he has been stabbed multiple times. Before Rebus can even begin to unravel this case, two skeletons are unearthed during renovations to the basement of a



local pub.

Meanwhile, his assistant, Detective Sergeant Siobhan Clarke, has been asked by the parents of a dead girl to find their other daughter, who has disappeared. She feels a special obligation, as the dead sister had been raped, and committed suicide soon afterwards.

Rebus' investigation leads him into the shadowy world of immigrants and asylum-seekers, some legal and others not, who have been caught between modern-day slave-traders and a callous bureaucracy.

Just as surely, Siobhan's quest for the missing girl leads to another sort of slavery: A world of lap-dancers who can-

not turn to the law for help.

All of these stories come together in an intricate and ingeniously-plotted tale that manages to combine a perfectly believable chain of events with surprises on every page.

RECOMMENDATION

Ian Rankin is one of the freshest voices to surface in crime fiction in a very long time. His eye for setting and his ear for dialogue are uncanny. These are real people: Cops wearied by their jobs, but unwilling to be ground down; petty villains striving to stay a step ahead of the law and their rivals; victims trying desperately to steer their way between an exploitive underclass and the authorities, whom they fear will send them back to an even more appalling world.

It would be very easy for a writer of such themes to revert to the comfortable world of clichés; but Rankin manages flawlessly to avoid this, every page sounding an original note, carrying the reader effortlessly and enjoyably toward the conclusion.

To my mind Rankin is the finest living crime writer bar none; and his huge sales and distinguished awards suggest that many others share my view.

IF YOU LIKE THIS BOOK....

By all means read the other Inspector Rebus books. The characters do evolve, however, so begin with his first, *Knots and Crosses*. I'll be very surprised if you're not hooked.

Canadian writers snubbed for Booker

Canadian authors were shut out this year from the longlist of Britain's annual Man Booker Prize.

The 17 names on the longlist include such prominent British writers as Kazuo Ishiguro (*In the Fold*), Ian McEwan (*Saturday*), Salman Rushdie (*Shalimar The Clown*), Zadie Smith (*On Beauty*) and South Africa's J.M. Coetzee (*Slow Man*).

Canadian authors have generally been enjoying tremendous international success in the past decade, showing up on every important longlist or shortlist going. A snub like this is rare these days.

Only writers resident in the Commonwealth and Ireland are eligible for the prize, which is worth almost \$109,000 Canadian.

The shortlist for the prize will be announced Sept. 8. The winner will be an-

nounced Oct. 10.

Only three Canadians have ever won the prize, which is considered among the most prestigious in the English-speaking world and often turns winners into international mega-sellers. Even just being nominated can do wonders for sales.


The Canadian authors who have won were Yann Martel (*Life of Pi*) in 2002, Margaret Atwood (*The Blind Assassin*) in 2000 and Michael Ondaatje (*The English Patient*) in 1992.

The other names on this year's Booker longlist are Tash Aw (*The Harmony Silk Factory*), John Banville (*The Sea*),

Julian Barnes (*Arthur & George*), Sebastian Barry (*A Long, Long Way*), Rachel Cusk (*In The Fold*), Dan Jacobson (*All For Love*), Marina Lewycka (*A Short History of Tractors in Ukrainian*), Hilary Mantel (*Beyond Black*), James Meek (*The People's Act of Love*), Ali

Smith (*The Accidental*), Harry Thompson (*This Thing Of Darkness*) and William Wall (*This Is The Country*).

Pianist Fred Hersch has written what he likens to a small-scale oratorio, setting to music selections from Walt Whitman's *Leaves of Grass*. At its best, this 66-minute suite adds colour and mood to the poetry. The 11-member ensemble includes such skilled musicians as trumpeter Ralph Alessi and trombonist Mike Christianson. Both make solo improv contributions in which they converse with Whitman's poems while giving the CD some of its best jazzy moments. Kurt Elling, the principal vocalist, is more entertaining when he is singing rather than reciting, which can get tiresome. Vocalist Kate McGarry sparkles in her musical sculpting. This CD is a must for Whitman fans,



but for others it can drag on.

Vol. 1 contains Concertos Nos. 1 & 7, Brandenburg Concerto No. 5, and Triple Concerto in A Minor. Vol. 2 contains Concertos Nos. 2, 3, 4, 5, 6. Hewitt's playing in the fast movements of the concertos runs smoothly like clockwork; in their



slow movements, she tends to go extra slow. Her touch on the Fazioli grand is light and consistently detached, making it sound slim rather than commanding. Perhaps with the dynamic limitations of the harpsichord in mind, she did not bring much of the piano's wide dynamic range into play and, since her interpretations do not offer special insights or surprises, these concerto recordings are not strikingly expressive or exciting. Sound is not of top clarity, and dynamic control is sometimes uneven. Nonetheless, either of these two sets offers cheerful music for easy listening.

Creepy things haunt The Skeleton Key *Movies*

Camera equipment is supposed to behave reliably during the shooting of a big-budget movie — but don't expect things to go smoothly if you're filming in the mysterious Bayou region of Louisiana where superstition and folk magic are taken seriously and things go bump in the night.

Iain Softley, the British director of *The Skeleton Key*, says that he and his crew became accustomed to ghostly, inexplicable events.

"The camera crew reported that every time we did a scene that involved Hoodoo, the camera would kind of flick off with alarming regularity," Softley reports. "So that freaked us out."

There was also the fact that actress Gena Rowlands broke her shoulder in a bizarre accident near the end of shooting — although Rowlands herself insists that she simply slipped and fell.

Then there was the mysterious plantation house which is the focal point of this story about a young hospice worker (Kate Hudson) who is plunged into an eerie mystery when she goes there to care for a terrified patient played by John Hurt.

This is an actual place: A faded white Greek Revival house built in 1847 by the wealthiest man in the state, it looks like the repository for a myriad of strange secrets. But is it also haunted? That question was being asked by a special film crew which recently returned to the house to do some new scenes for a future DVD feature.

"The camera man, who's a friend of mine from England, claimed that he was followed up the stairs," Softley reports. "He would turn around and there was nobody there."

Writer Ehren Kruger knew what he wanted to achieve with his screenplay.

"You want to feel someone breathing down your neck," he commented during filming. "Now it seems as though key moments in his story were turning into the real thing."

Kruger, best known as the man who scripted the two *Ring* films, wanted to write "a distinctly American, non-traditional ghost story" — but also one which

pursued some traditional themes, most notably the age old desire to find out "what is behind the forbidden door."

In the case of *The Skeleton Key*, it is the attic door which casts its lure on the Hudson character and leads her into a series of nightmare discoveries.

Softley — whose previous films include *The Wings Of The Dove* and *Backbeat* — points out that the horror in *The Skeleton Key* is as much psychological as it is physical, and he argues that the events it depicts could only have happened in the Deep South. Yet, at the same time he wanted his movie to have an almost documentary feel — which is why he spent so much time in Louisiana before the start of shooting.

"I think the first thing I did was to come and see as much of it myself as I could. I wanted the film to be grounded in reality. I wanted it to be recognizable."

But it would be a reality in which folk magic and belief in the supernatural were woven into the cultural fabric. The practice of Hoodoo — a fusion of witchcraft, spells, potions and conjurations —

forms the core of the story and Softley stresses that it is markedly different from Voodoo.

"Voodoo is actually a religion. It's quite familiar to Christianity in a way — it's monotheistic, and the ancestors that are prayed to have a sort of equivalent to Catholic saints. Hoodoo is very different. Hoodoo is a mixture of African American, Native American and White European folk magic."

The Cambridge-educated filmmaker says Hoodoo belief permeates southern culture in unexpected ways. He cites the novel, *To Kill A Mocking Bird*, in which Boo Radley puts Hoodoo paraphernalia in a tree trunk, and one of the youngsters in the story immediately says: "I don't believe in that hoodooing."

Softley notes that the word "hoodooing" has become "part of the colloquial language." It's also an integral part of the music of the Mississippi Delta: Softley points out that blues great Robert Johnson sings about a "hellhound" on his trail, and that the true meaning of the word "mojo" — in spite of what

Austin Powers might think — is "a sack of charms for warding off evil spirits."

For one crucial scene, in which Hudson listens to a mysterious record she has discovered in the attic, Softley brought some actual Hoodoo practitioners into the recording studio where they lit candles and muttered Hoodoo incantations.

"It's that interface between the real and supernatural that I was interested in — the point at which one becomes the other," Softley says. So he was prepared for that interface to be actually occurring during shooting.

He stresses that the house itself is a key character. At one point, Softley thought he would have to construct the exterior back in California because he and his advance scouts couldn't locate the kind of house the film needed.

"I knew it was a really important character in the film and had to have the right aspects. I had in my mind's eye the idea of those homes I'd seen in a research book called *Ghosts Along The Mississippi*, and either they had all been torn down or had been renovated or were too close to the town and suburbs that encroached them."

Softley wasn't happy at the idea of building a house from scratch just for the movie. He figured the Hoodoo vibes would be wrong.

"I just had this niggling feeling that in order to get the authenticity I wanted that we needed a location house."

Yet, the house in question would never have been found without the intrusion of an unexpected event: Hudson found herself pregnant, and that meant a delay of nearly a year. Softley used that delay to conduct one final search in the remote Bayou regions for the house of his dreams. And that was how he found Felicite Plantation.

When he and line producer Clayton Townsend saw this mysterious house shrouded in oak trees, his reaction was immediate. "Stop the car!" he ordered. "This is it! We are there!"

It turned out that the elderly owners had been resisting the approaches of film crews for 25 years, but this time they said yes.

Faith Hill still trying to please everyone

Music

It has been a long three years without releasing an album for country diva Faith Hill. The Mississippi native is undeniably one of the most genuine talents in any spectrum of the music business — country, pop or even adult contemporary.

The beautiful blonde singer burst onto the country music scene in 1993 with her debut album *Take Me As I Am*, which won her an instant legion of fans. The multi-platinum record produced hits such as 'Wild One', a remake of Janis Joplin's 'Piece Of My Heart' and the title track.

The albums that followed slowly brought her fame and glory while 'This Kiss' made her a crossover success practically overnight. That success went a step further with 'There You'll Be', a Diane Warren-penned ballad, also part of the soundtrack for the 2000 blockbuster *Pearl Harbor*.

In 2002, Hill released a fifth album, *Cry*, which offered a mix of different styles. For some fans, it was Hill's desertion from country music while for others this album was an artistic journey that enabled her to showcase her ability to connect with a variety of mu-

sical genres.

The album did not do well, so Hill took some time off to play a small role in the remake of *Stepford Wives* which also featured Nicole Kidman, Bette Midler and Glenn Close.

Now the diva has released her sixth studio album — *Fireflies*. She is back with a more rootsy and earthy sound, which seems to be a compromise between the sophisticated last two albums, *Breathe and Cry* and her more raw early work.

The sound on the new album is a lot less polished, a lot more reminiscent of the days before she was a crossover success. At the same time, the new collection is far from just a copy of what she used to do.

She displays here the quality that made her the great artist that she is. I mean her desire to take chances and grow musically can be felt with every listen.

The first single, 'Mississippi Girl', is an up-tempo number that everybody loves and that's really radio friendly.

'Sunshine and Summertime' is a fun, upbeat song about the joys of summer, that has a slight feel of pop, but there's nothing disturbing about that for country music fans. 'Dearly

Beloved' is a hoe-down country number about marriage and its flaws and downfalls. Hill nails it perfectly and this is the type of song that she should cover more frequently.

There is something particular about Hill, she is able to sing any kind of song about any topic and still get the perfect emotion. She proves it with 'I Ain't Gonna Take It Anymore', a ballad about leaving — reminiscent of a variety of Tammy Wynette or Dolly Parton ballads from the 1970s and 1980s. She will go down in history as one of the greatest artists of the 20th and 21st centuries.

Songwriter Lori McKenna contributes three new songs on this new album, 'Stealing Kisses', 'If You Ask' and 'Fireflies'. There's a folksy feel to these numbers and they suit Hill perfectly as well.

'Stealing Kisses' is all about a woman who is unhappy with her marriage and looks back at her younger days when everything was so easy. 'If You Ask' is a heartbreaker about a woman's dedication to her alcoholic husband. 'Fireflies' offers a lullaby feel that you can also find in the poignant 'Wish for You.'

'Like We Never Loved At All' might be one of the strongest cuts here. Of course it features Tim McGraw, Hill's husband, on a great duet.

The number is sexy and sensual and the vocal chemistry between Hill and her husband makes it a powerful ballad.

There's also a bonus (hidden) track, 'Paris', which is one of the most stunning numbers ever recorded by Hill. It is a real torch song like nobody has recorded in country music since the days of k.d. Lang.

I think there's something here for fans who like Hill when she sounds country but also something for those who like her to be more pop. It is a solid album but Hill should stop trying to please everyone with her style and let her artistry take all the place.

Mulroney is force to be reckoned with on TV

Facing his first Canadian Idol audience on live TV three years ago, show host Ben Mulroney got courage from five cups of coffee and eight or nine Diet Cokes.

Revved and nervous, he faced millions of Canadians, who perhaps expected the inexperienced son of former prime minister Brian Mulroney to fail — or at least stumble. For 30 seconds, the admittedly jumpy younger Mulroney stood before the assembled in the John Basset Theatre in downtown Toronto, running through his lines but feeling as if he were flying without a net.

Then, suddenly, "I got it."

"After 30 seconds on stage, I figured out what live television was all about," Mulroney says about the job that has

made him arguably the most popular television host in the country, anchoring a show that is more popular than any in Canadian history. "You tell a joke and they laugh. When you start talking, they stop applauding because they want to hear what you're saying. If you screw up, as long as you recover with a modicum of comedy, they'll laugh. They will help you through it. They want to be entertained. They want to like you. You're going to have to really blow this for them not to enjoy this experience.

Three years on, it's a much calmer, seasoned Mulroney who strides on to the stage every Tuesday and Wednesday evening to host Canadian Idol, which, now that it's started counting down the top 10 contestants, is drawing more than two million viewers each night.

A bit Canadian yokel and a lot of showbiz glamour, Mulroney offers the perfect balance of high energy and calm confidence, schmaltz and polish, humour and compassion.

Mulroney also seems to be the perfect blend of his sophisticated, beautiful mother and his charming, slick father. In the words of a Toronto magazine writer, he's good-looking in "the way that people bred in petri dishes in the future will be good-looking."

Legions of viewers adore the young Mulroney, in large part because he resolutely sides with the underdog contestants after one of the judges — usually Zack Werner — has savaged an off-key performance. Female fans routinely declare their love for him on CTV's Canadian Idol online chat room.

But he also rubs many fans the wrong way. This may be the lot of any television host. Or perhaps the son of an unpopular former prime minister will inevitably reap harsher criticism.

Mulroney, 29, shrugs it off. He's the first to admit he's "cheesy." He also knows people are suspicious of his success: "I know what people think when they see me."

The boy who grew up watching his parents live under the constant criticism of the media is thick-skinned. He has also learned not to put too much stock in what journalists report.

Still, he remembers a wonderful childhood, filled with friends and enjoyable trips to the prime minister's summer home at Harrington Lake.
