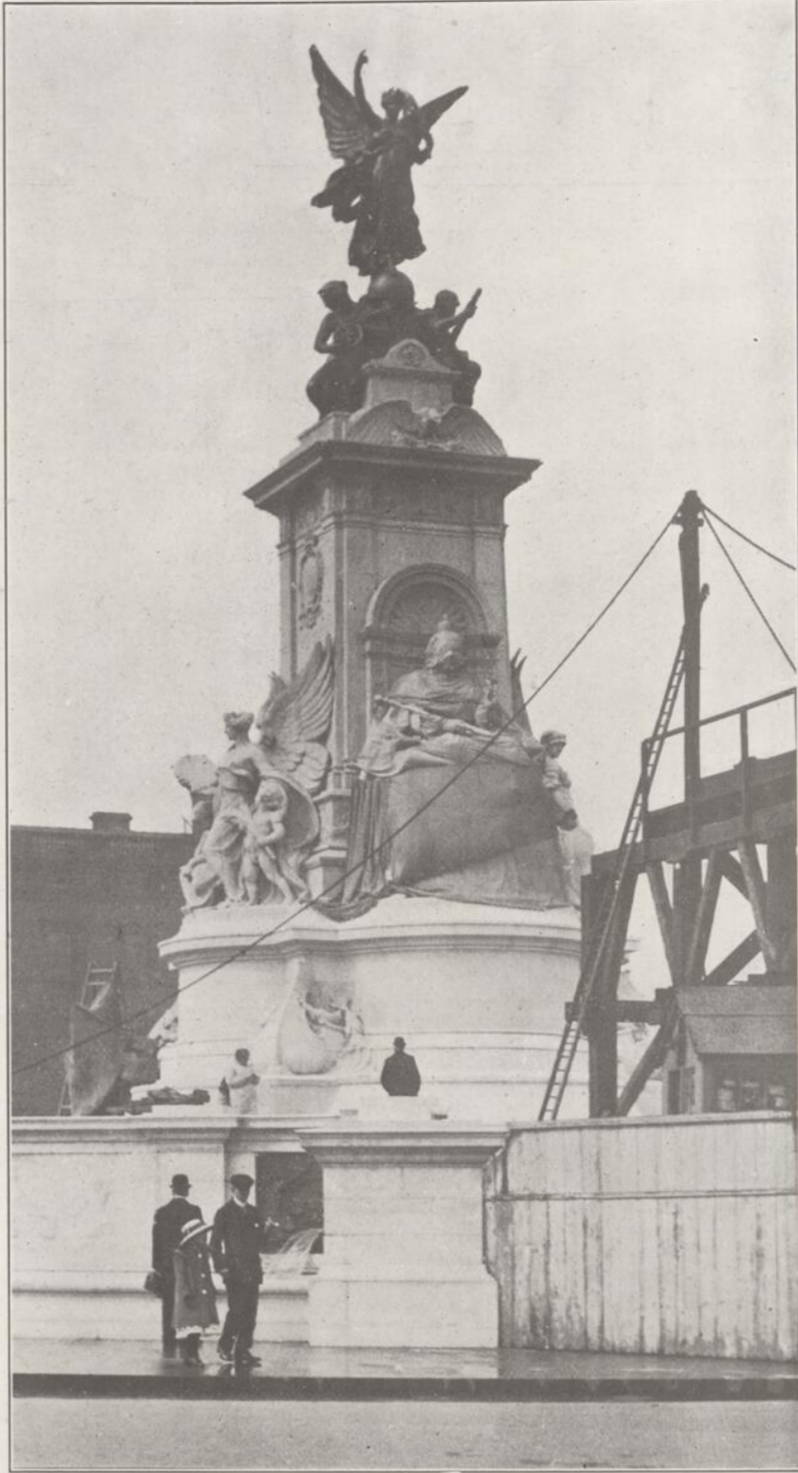
Soccer Football is Now in Full Blast; Montrealers Who are Prominent Players in the Highly Strenuous Game

UNVEILING OF THE VICTORIA MEMORIAL

THE unveiling of the Victoria Memorial took place in London on Tuesday last in the presence of the German Emperor and Empress, and of a gathering representative of every phase of life within the Empire. His Majesty the King officiated. Queen Mary, the Prince of Wales, the Duke of Connaught, the Princess Royal, and all the surviving children of Her late Majesty were present, as well as other prominent princes and princesses of the blood royal. The scene was one that shall always live in the memories of those who saw it. The crowds were enormous, reverent and sympathetic; the display of military pomp was truly regal and magnificent; and the list of invited guests included the highest and mightiest in the land. The function practically ushered in the coronation festivities, and was a great success throughout. In the forecourt of the palace was posted a guard of honor consisting of the King's Company of the Grenadier Guards. In the Mall, facing the statue of Queen Victoria, were the massed bands of the Guards. The troops on parade included the 1st and 2nd Life Guards, the Royal Horse Guards, the 7th Hussars, and the Grenadier, Coldstream, Scots, and Irish Guards. The

ed the monument for the ceremony the standards and colors were lowered to the ground in a royal salute, while the troops presented arms. Then, after the ceremony, the whole of the squadrons and companies marched past the monument, saluting the white figure of the great Queen. The German Emperor and Empress, and their suite, were keenly interested in the movements of the troops.

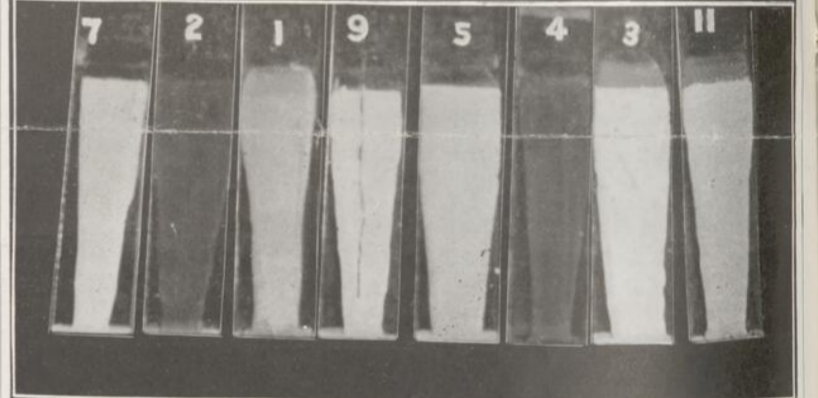

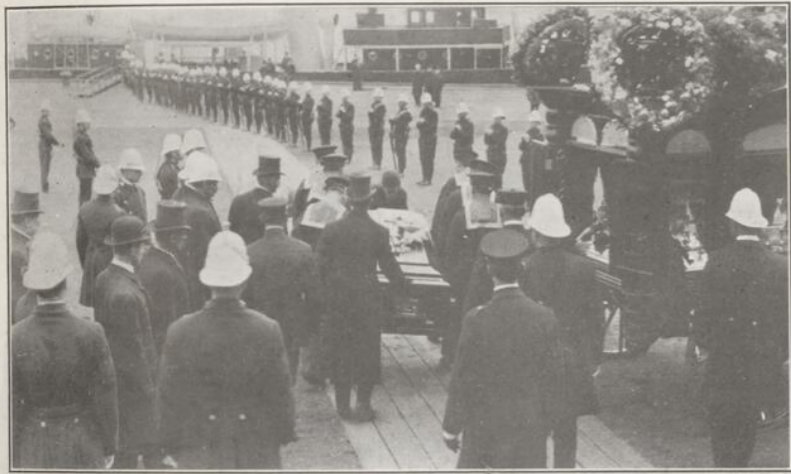

QUEEN VICTORIA.

The largest picture on this page records an impressive incident that occurred at Windsor Castle a few weeks before the death of Queen Victoria, when Her Majesty reviewed the officers and men of the First Canadian Contingent, who were then en route from South Africa to Canada. On their arrival at Windsor the Canadians were enthusiastically wel-

comed by the Mayor and Corporation. They then proceeded to the Castle, headed by the Grenadiers' band. The Queen, accompanied by Princess Henry of Battenberg and Princess Alice of Albany, arrived at the Quadrangle Court sharp at noon, and received a general salute from the troops. Her Majesty then sent for Colonel Otter, and congratulated him on the excellent showing made by his command in South Africa. On the conclusion of Her Ma-

jesty's remarks the Contingent marched past the royal carriage. The officers were then presented to Her Majesty, after which the Queen summoned Private Armstrong, of New Brunswick, who had lost a leg during the campaign, but who had joined in the march on crutches. She expressed the greatest sympathy with him in his misfortune. The Contingent then advanced in review order close to the royal carriage.
