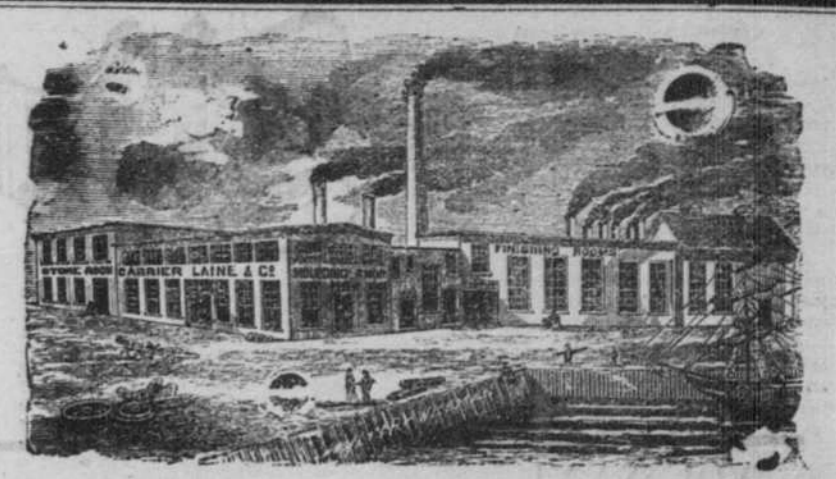
London, May 6.—In the House of Commons to-night, Sir Wm. Hartout questioned the right of the Government to employ Indian troops without the consent of Parliament.
