



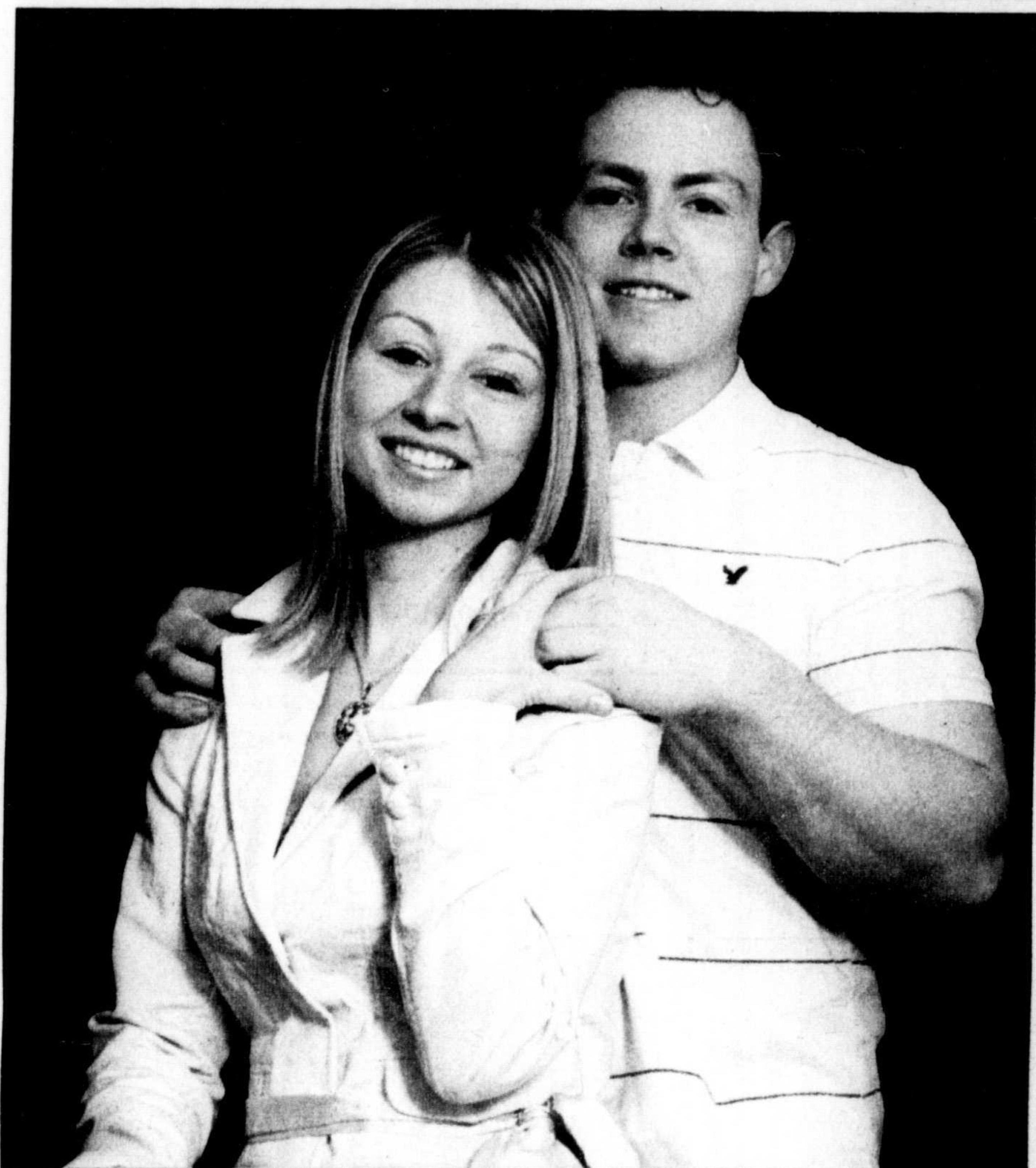

According to most travel agents, Hawaii, the Poconos, Niagara Falls, the Caribbean Islands and Florida are among

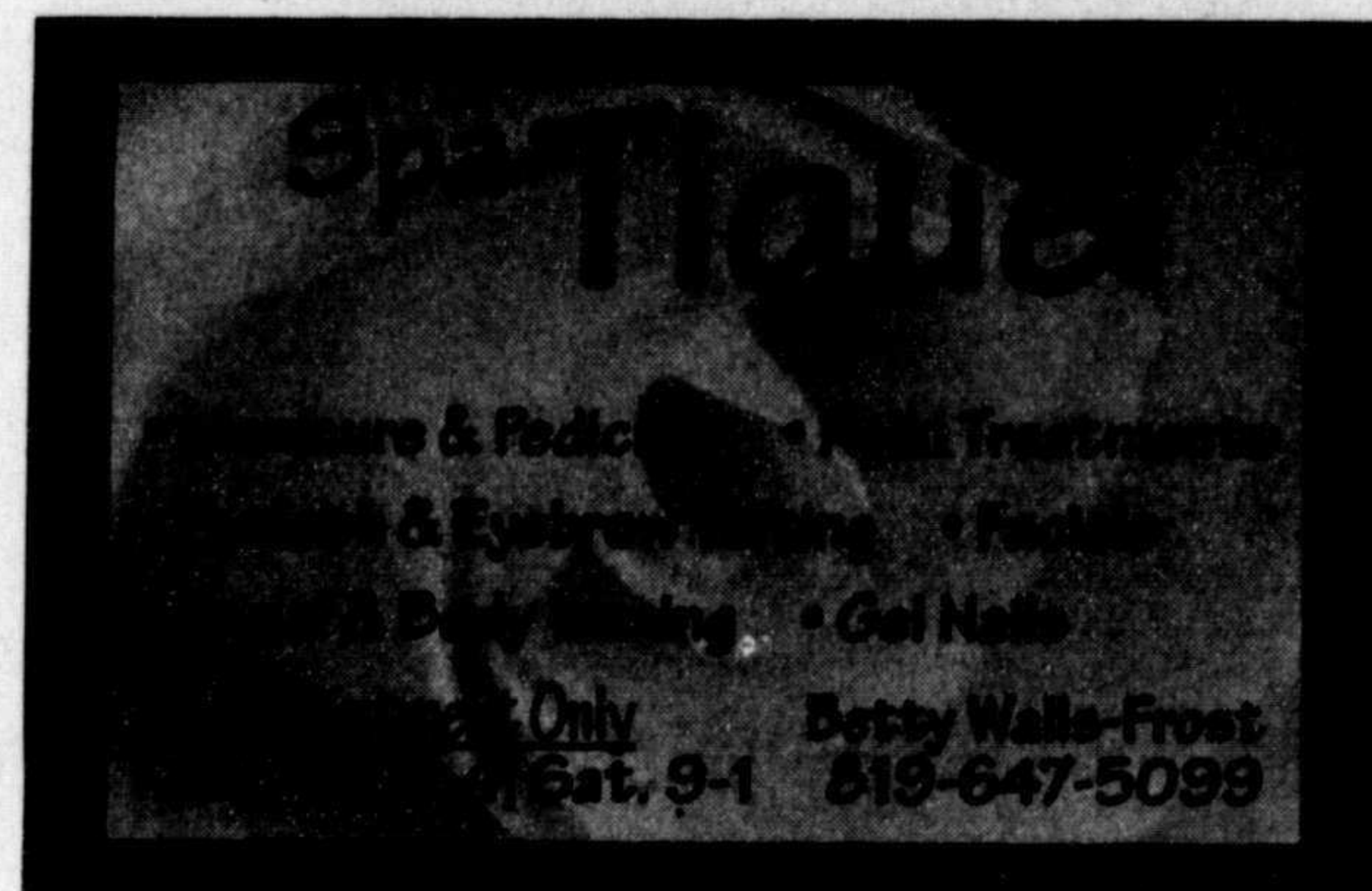
the most popular spots for honeymooners. Cruises of any type are also favourites. Wherever you choose to go, remember to relax, enjoy each other's company and have fun.

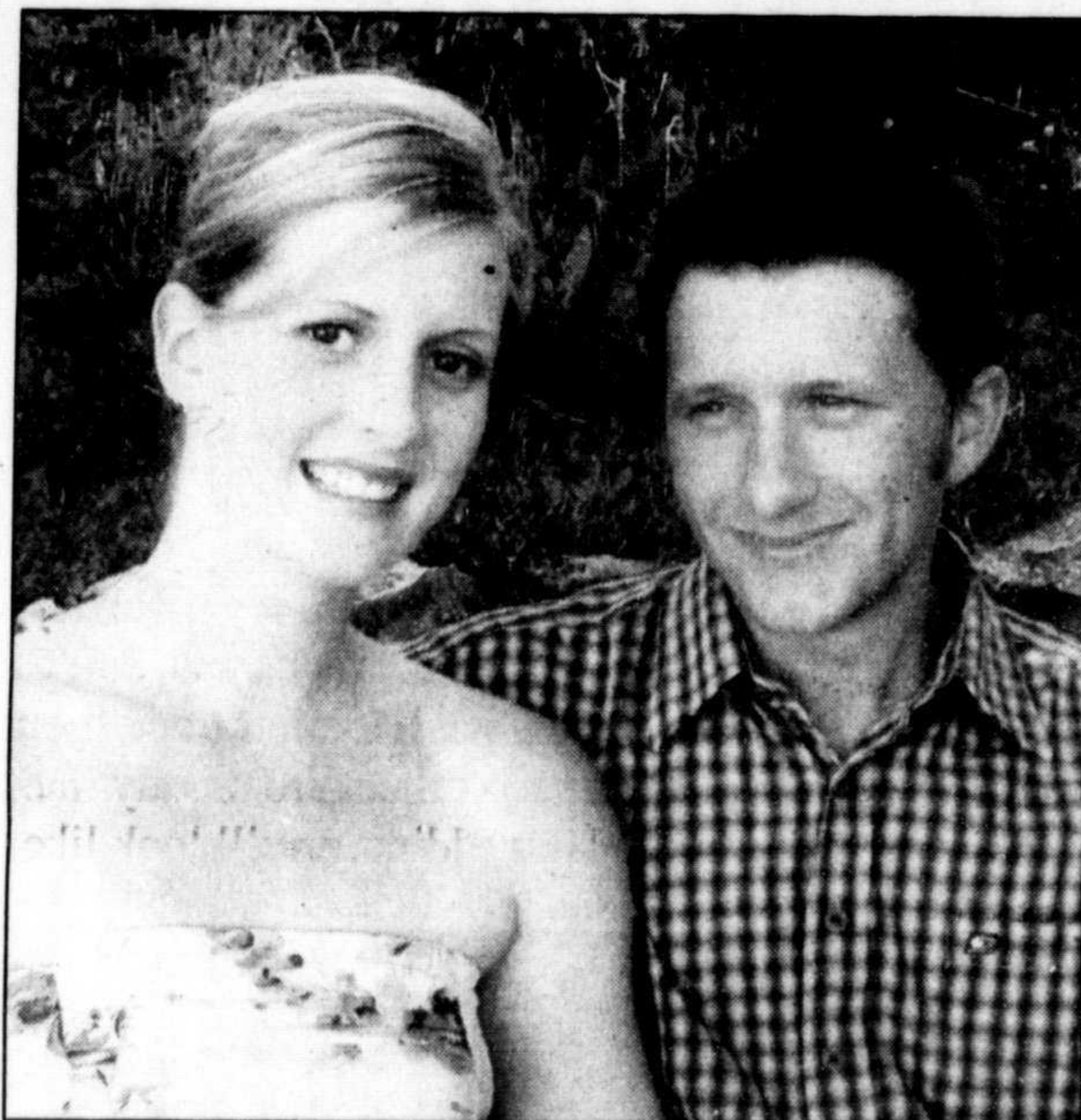
### Offer to put them up on their wedding night

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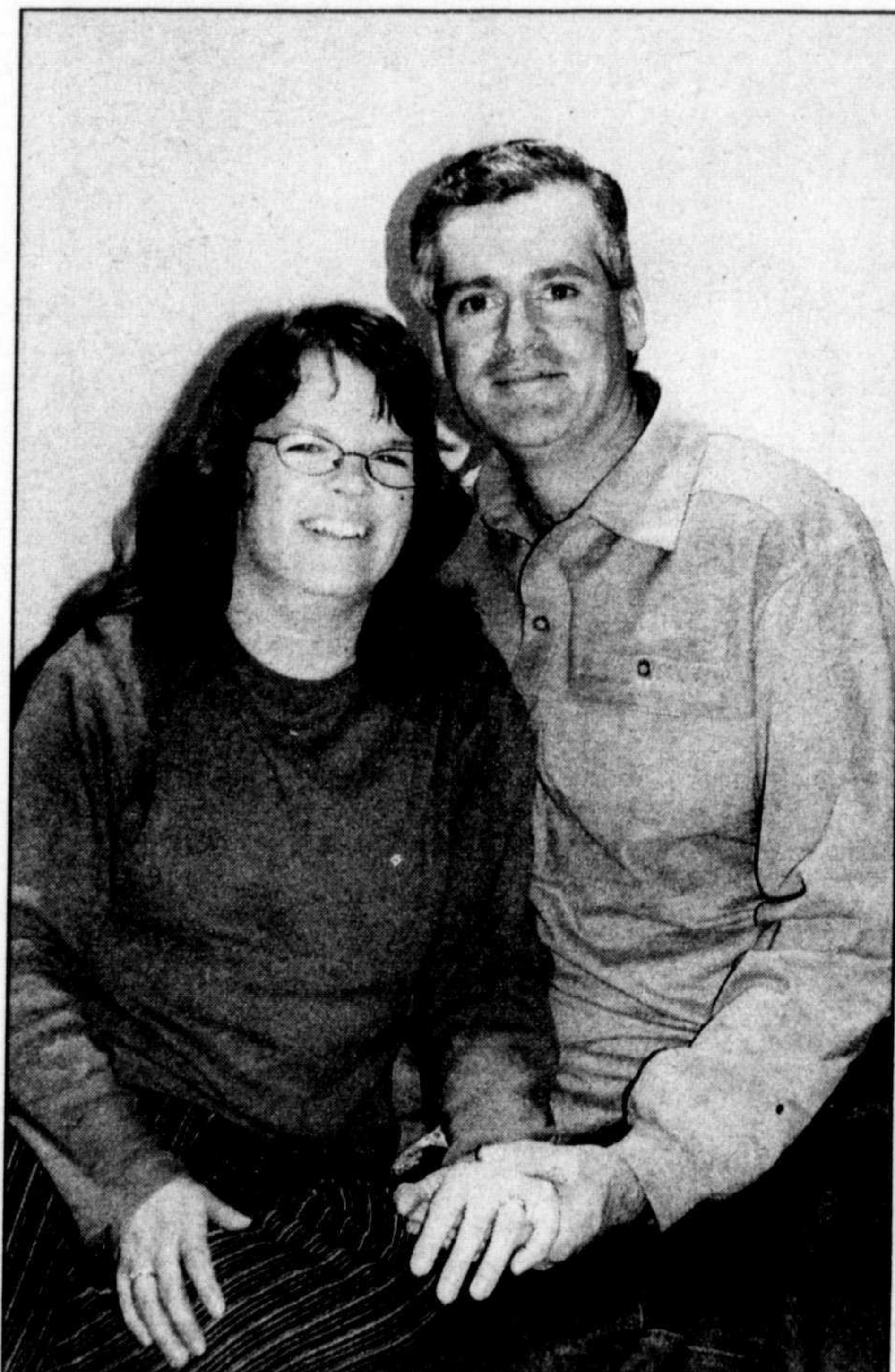

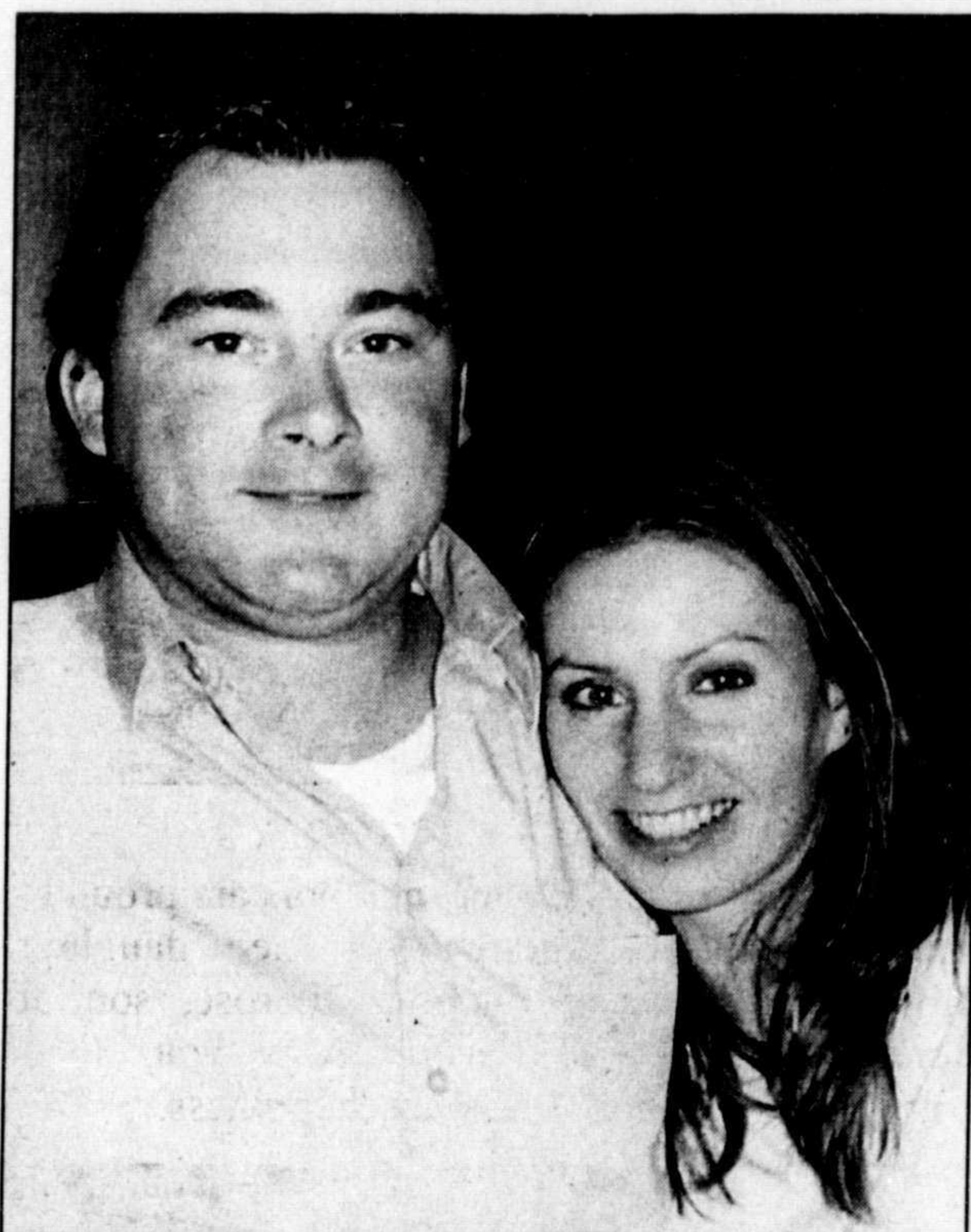

## Wedding guest attire

### Black tie

**Her:** A formal dress, usually to the floor. Coordinate with a beaded purse and elegant wrap. Expect to dance, so don't wear anything too revealing or constricting.

**Him:** A tuxedo is the only appropriate thing to wear.

### Evening wedding

**Her:** Dress as if you were going to the theatre or a fancy restaurant. Cocktail dresses are appropriate, or dressy suits. Avoid anything with sequins or too flashy. Suits shouldn't be too stuffy or "corporate."

**Him:** A dark suit is always a safe bet. If you suspect it is semi-formal, you may be able to wear a blazer, slacks and a tie.

### Daytime wedding

**Her:** A conservative but fun floral dress or light-colored suit.

**Him:** A light-colored suit if it is a summer wedding. For winter, dress warmer in a blazer and slacks with either a dress shirt or sweater underneath. Tuxedos should not be worn before 6 p.m.

It is safe to assume that the following are not

appropriate to wear to a wedding.

- Black to a daytime wedding, you'll look like you are in mourning
- White, it competes with the bride
- Jeans
- Anything torn, dirty or ill-fitting
- Anything too revealing.

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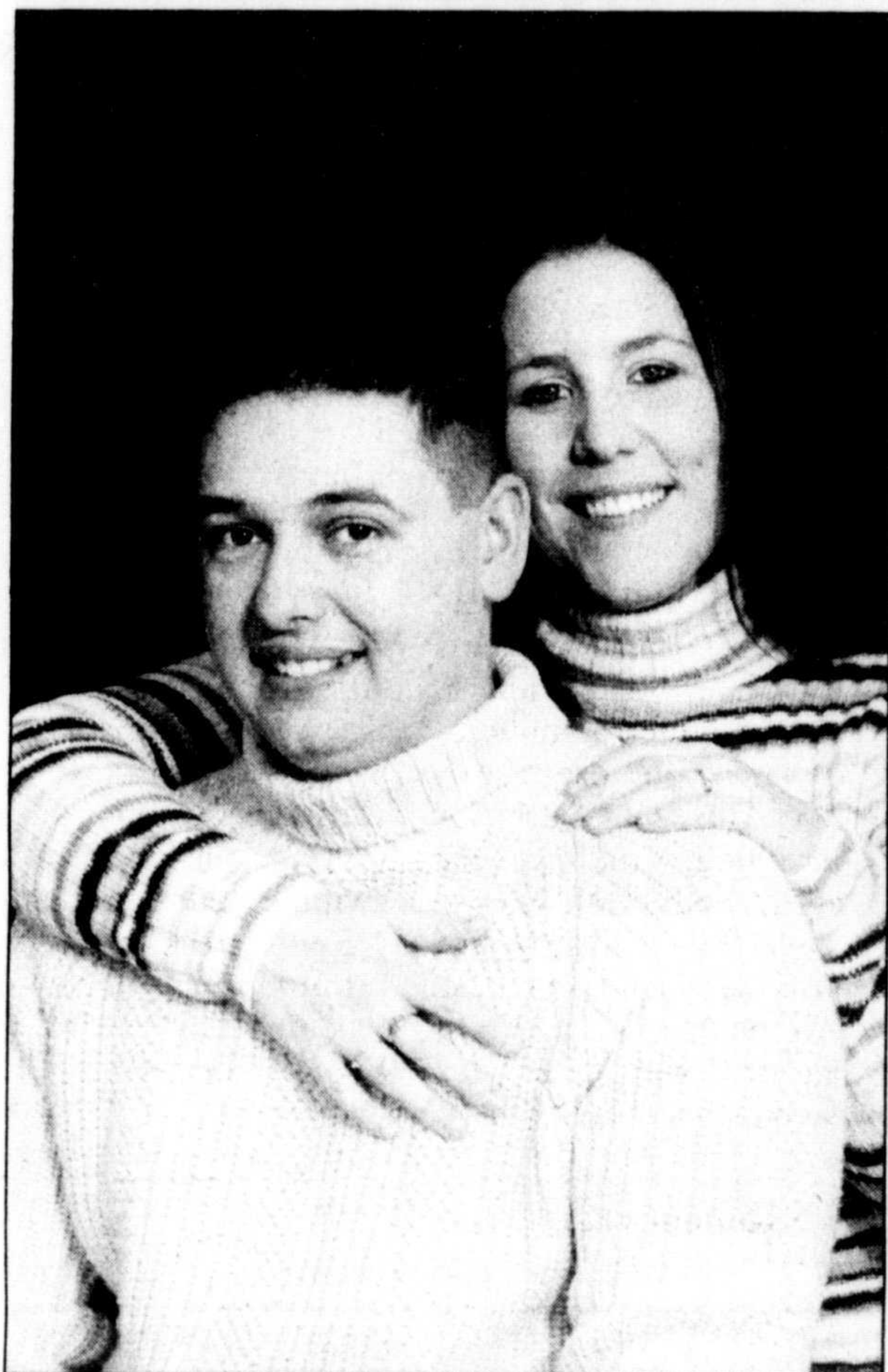
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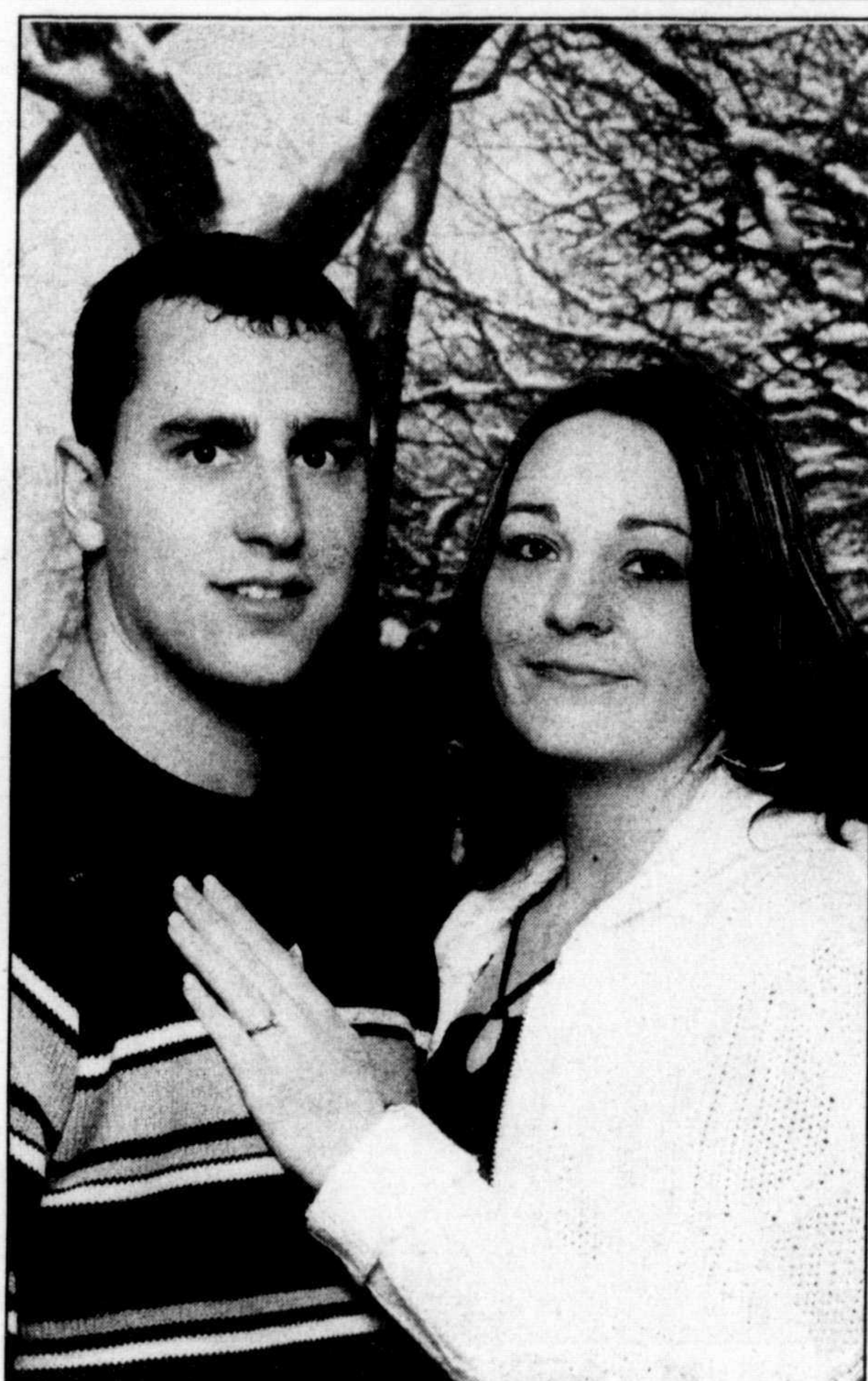

## Responsibility of being best man

Before making the decisions based solely on who is a best friend or favourite cousin, consider the responsibilities the best man must uphold according to tradition. This may make pairing the right person with the job that much easier.

### Best man

This is the groom's right-hand man. He has a series of responsibilities, none which should be taken lightly:

- Oversees the groomsmen, making sure they are on time for the ceremony, properly dressed and have their boutonnieres on the left lapel.
- Ensures that the groom is dressed and ready for the ceremony. The best man may actually help the groom to dress in his tuxedo.
- Introduces people and breaks the ice.
- Holds the wedding rings until they are blessed. If a ring bearer will be used, it is sug-

gested that faux rings be tied to the pillow and the best man continues to hold the real things.

- Takes care of payment to the clergy and other financial contributions after the ceremony. He may also tie up any loose financial ends with the reception staff.

- Ensures that the groom has the marriage license and will subsequently be one of the signatures on that document as a witness to the marriage.

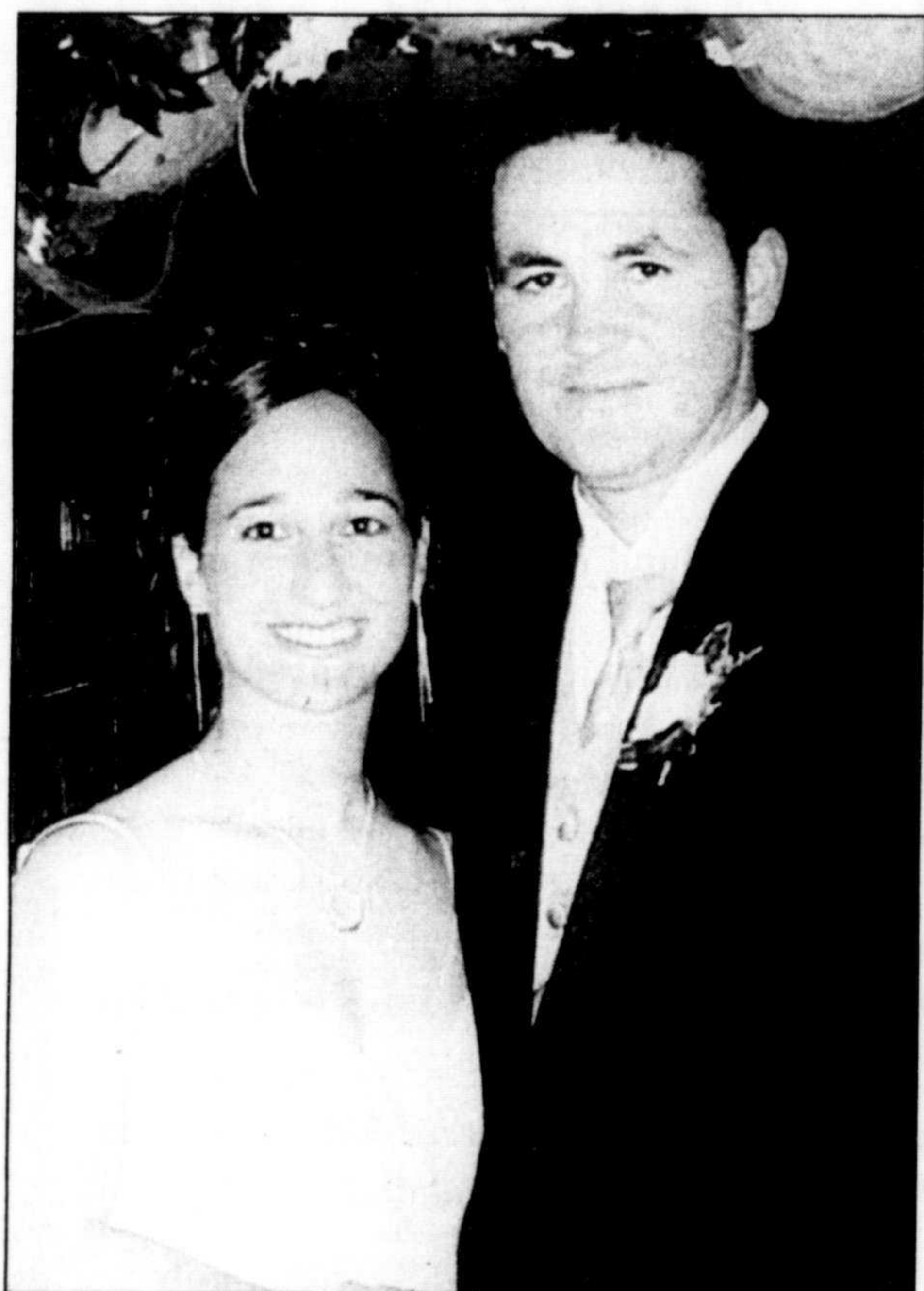
- Makes sure that honeymoon travel arrangements have been made and may transport the couple to the airport.

- Returns the groom's tux (and any from irresponsible groomsmen) to the rental place.

- Arranges the bachelor party if one will be held.

- Writes and issues a toast at the wedding ceremony.

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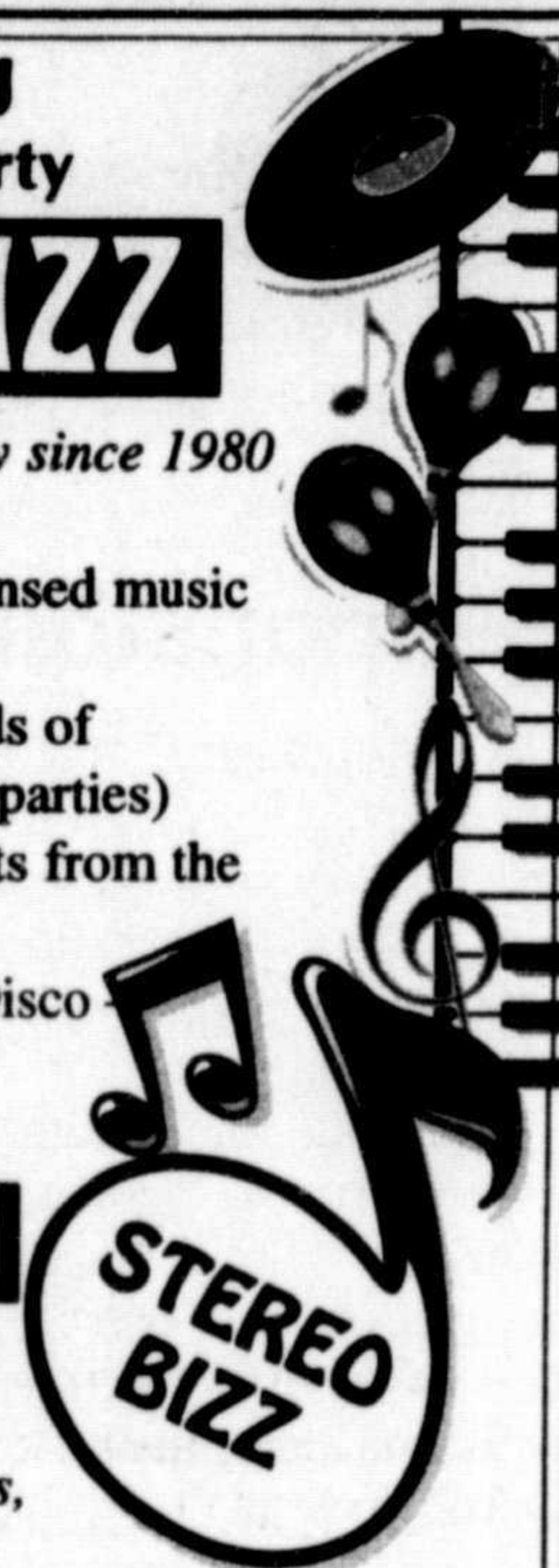

- Assists the photographer with identifying key members of the family who will need to be photographed.

- Witnesses and signs the marriage certificate along with the best man.

- Helps the bride and bridesmaids with dressing.

- Organizes a bachelorette party if one will be held.
