Bishop's ideal location for Hallowed Halls

School may be out for the summer at Bishop's University in Lennoxville, but there has been a lot of action over the past few weeks.

It's where feature film *Hallowed Halls* was made. Filming wrapped up this past Wednesday night.

"It's a thriller set in the 1980s about a group of kids that go to a private school, and decide to break in over the course of a long weekend and spend the weekend inside the school," said producer Bill Lee. "One by one things start happening to them, and they're not sure why. I guess in some way it's a cross between *The Breakfast Club* and *Friday The 13th*, except without a lot of the gore."

The low-budget production features a cast of seven principals, along with secondary characters and extras. There were also 16 crew members — all of whom are from Quebec.

Nineteen-year old Nancy Gillard plays one of the lead characters — Molly.

"It's the first movie I've done. Before this I was in many plays and musicals," said Gillard, who just finished her second year in drama at Bishop's. "I realized the first day of filming how different the two really are. In theatre, you're used to overacting. In

film however, you're supposed to act as though nothing is there, even with the camera in your face. It's a lot of fun!"

Director Domenic Marceau, who also wrote the screenplay, said Bishop's was the perfect location to shoot the movie.

"Just look around, the campus looks extraordinary. When Bill told me there was a possibility we would be shooting there, I knew right away this would be the place," said Marceau. "We utilized the entire campus and disguised it as

different locations, so we literally never had to step foot off campus. So really — it turned out to be wonderful."

Marceau added the biggest advantage during filming was the entire cast got to stay on campus.

"Most of them are inexperienced actors — for them to live on set, they never let go of their character. There was never a re-adjustment period in the mornings, where you have to get back into character," said Marceau.

"Since they play a group of friends that have known each other throughout high school, there has to be a certain chemistry between them. A special bond formed as they lived together. There are real friendships that have been made over this production; you can't fake that kind of chemistry."

Lee, who has been a North Hatley resident for 16 years, hopes *Hallowed Halls* is the first of many English films to be produced in the

Eastern Townships. "We are doing two other films. *House of Darkness* starts next week, with another movie scheduled for the fall," said Lee. "For the Canadian rights, we're

Couscous delicious and versatile side

Every week I try to share with you recipes that are uncomplicated, with as few ingredients as possible, so that you may try them out without having to go ingredient hunting at the grocery store.

I apologize in advance: This couscous is an exception to the keep-it-simple rule, albeit a worthy one. It calls for 15 ingredients, plus chopped mint if you really want to go the extra mile (is it just me, do you also sometimes drop a herb out of a recipe out of sheer unwillingness to chop for another 10 minutes?).

Once the assembling of all the ingredients and the chopping are out of the way, the rest of the recipe is a breeze. This goes wonderfully with almost anything you might have barbecued (in my case it was a rack of lamb marinated in garlic and sage overnight).

The dish can be reheated in the microwave or served lukewarm, and keeps well in the fridge for up to three days. It's worth the extra work, believe me!

SUMMER COUSCOUS WITH APRICOTS AND PEPPERS (FOR SIX)

1 cup couscous



ALEX'S
PANTRY

1 1/2 cups water
1 cup extra-virgin olive oil (not the light kind, please)
2 tbsp. vegetable oil
1 zucchini
1 green pepper
10 dried apricots
large onion
3 garlic cloves
1 tsp. cumin
1 tsp. cinnamon
1 tbsp. salt
1 tbsp. soy sauce (Tamari, preferably)

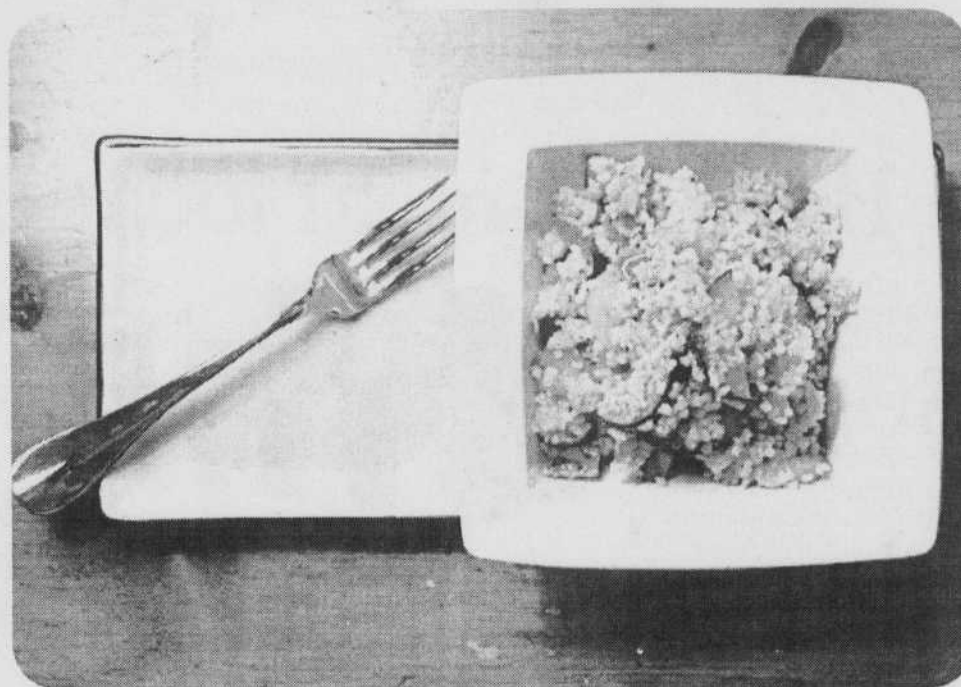
lime
2 tbsp. mango chutney
freshly ground pepper and chopped mint to taste (optional)

Directions:

Bring the water and olive oil to the boil in a sauce pan. Turn the heat off, stir in the couscous and let it sit, covered, for 10 minutes.

Wash the zucchini and pepper and chop them up. Peel the onion and garlic cloves and chop them finely. In a wok or large non-stick frying pan, heat up the vegetable oil. Sauté the green pepper on high heat, stirring once in a while. When it starts to brown, add the zucchini and mix. Two minutes later, add the onion. Keep on

stirring, being careful not to char the veggies. Finally, add the chopped garlic, the chutney and all the spices. Sauté for another two minutes or so,

then remove from heat.

Fluff up the couscous with a fork. Add the sautéed mix and toss. Taste and add salt or lime juice if necessary.

Beet it! Rich in taste, and good for you, too

Bursting with flavour and full of sugar (yet low in calories), the beet's finest hour has arrived

While they may seem like a bit of a contradiction for the diet-conscious — loads of sugar, yet low in calories — the little vegetable with a prehistoric past, is about to make its annual debut at local farmer's markets across Canada.

For all they say about the humble beet, from heart protector to cancer preventative, what it all boils down to is one of the tastiest and most popular veggies of the season. It's sinfully healthy and only 74 calories per cup.

One of few root vegetables that can be consumed in their entirety — leaves and all — beets are loved the world over, especially in Eastern Europe, where no beets would mean no borscht.

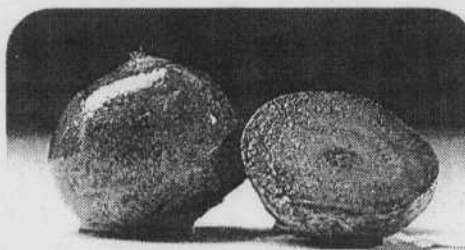
And Europeans can thank Napoleon for his foresight in popularizing the beet initially as a substitute for sugar cane when British warlords cut the cane. The little vegetable also found its way to American shores at about the same time. Beets, of course, had been around for eons by then, with origins linked to prehistoric Africa, Asia and Europe. The Romans are believed

to have been the first to bring beets to the table.

And not a bad decision, as nutritionists now tell us. Beets are rich in such things as folate, manganese, potassium and vitamin C. What they serve up is a smorgasbord of nutrient compounds and antioxidants said to protect against some cancers (colon cancer especially), heart disease and even birth defects.

Beet juice, a devil in the world of stain power (it will indelibly mark even gloss paint), is also said to act as an antidote to nitrates, that chemical preservative processed meat producers love to lard on their products.

Apart from the reputed health benefits of the vegetable, beet lovers, for the most part, buy them for no other good reason than their taste. Whether boiled and served whole, sliced and mayonnaised into a salad or pickled, the taste is sublime. Having the highest sugar content of any

vegetable could also have a lot to do with their popularity.

Better still, they are a cinch to grow. Planted as seeds in late May — and relieved of their baby leaves for salad fixings as they grow — beets are generally ready for harvest by the third week of July. Few bugs at-

tack beets and you can grow enough for regular summertime meals for a family of four in a concentrated patch.

A cool weather plant, which produces its best crop when planted in late spring, beets can still be planted through July, although don't expect much more than marble-sized results before the first frosts arrive.

Beet greens are, for many, as good as the root and taste a lot like spinach, with all its nutritional goodness. They contain oxalic acid, a naturally occurring substance in plants and humans.

The beets themselves must be handled with kid gloves before being assigned to

the pot. Bruises or nicks will allow them to bleed into the water. For the uninitiated, leave the beets whole (never, peel before boiling or steaming), and leave several inches of stem at the top. Beets can also be roasted whole (in tinfoil) on the barbecue. Only peel beets after they're cooked.

Beets store well, too, although you should remove all but a few inches of the stems of flavour-draining greens before packing, unwashed, into a plastic bag. They'll last up to six weeks before softening (but can still be cooked even in that state).

Chefs offer this little bit of culinary advice: You can modify the colour of beets to suit the course by either adding lemon juice or vinegar (to brighten the colour) or baking soda (to turn them a deeper shade of purple). Keep the salt (if needed) till the end since it will "blunt" the colour.

A word of warning for beet initiates. Don't look down and panic in the rest room after a dish of this vegetable. You are experiencing a condition known in medical circles as "beeturia." You'll live to enjoy another plateful. The condition is colourful, but harmless.

Silverman presents challenging program.

Music

Robert Silverman is well aware that a career in classical music is not the easiest path to fame and fortune.

In fact, the 67-year-old Montreal-born pianist says his aim in music is not to strike it rich but to "bring the notes on a page to life as vividly as possible, while neither adding anything that is not there, nor subtracting anything that is there."

Silverman, whose discography includes 25 CDs and a dozen LPs, will perform variations of works by Rameau, Hétu, Liszt and Beethoven at the Orford Arts Centre tonight (July 29).

The distinguished pianist has performed in concert halls throughout North America, Europe, the Far East and Australia. Under the batons of such renowned conductors as Seiji Ozawa, John Eliot Gardiner, Gerard Schwarz, Neeme Järvi, Sergiu Comissiona, Zdenek Macal, and the late Kiril Kondrashin, he has performed with orchestras on three continents, including the Chicago Symphony, the Sydney Symphony, the BBC (London) Symphony, the St. Petersburg Philharmonic Orchestra, and every major orchestra in Canada.

His recording of Liszt's piano music received a Grand Prix du Disque from the Liszt Society of Budapest, while his widely-acclaimed 10-CD recording of all 32 Beethoven sonatas was nominated for a Juno Award.

The Vancouver resident, a faculty member at the University of British Columbia for 30 years, is not new to the Eastern Townships. In fact, besides teaching at the Orford Arts Centre for the past

few summers, he won a music contest for young performers here in 1967.

Silverman's recent projects include an eight-concert series encompassing all 32 Beethoven sonatas.

"(Diabelli variations) are challenging — so demanding for the pianist and the audience," he said of the Beethoven works he will spend one hour performing during the second half of tonight's concert. "You can't (as a pianist) just sit back. There are no moments to relax. You've got to concentrate throughout."

"However, if there's a better hour of piano music out there then I don't know what that can be."

For the audience, the Beethoven variations can also be challenging, and long.

"There are huge demands on the audience. They have to sit there and let a genius (Beethoven) just reveal himself to them," explained Silverman.

Vicki Tansey and the News

*Dance, improvisation,
poetry, prose, and
puppetry come together
with The Physical Choir
Theatre Project*

To get to Vicki Tansey's latest show, entitled The Physical Choir Theatre Project: The News, at her home and performing arts centre nestled at the end of a narrow dirt path, you must first pay a visit to the box office/refugee camp.

As your name is checked off a list retrieved from a tin-can trailer next to a rusty old truck while a "gypsy" wrapped in layers of colourful shawls plays the accordion, it becomes clear that this is to be an evening of the slightly surreal.

Saturday night was the first performance of The Physical Choir Theatre Project. The show con-

sists of three "sideshows" — Soap Box News, The ABCs of Africa, and Les Nouvelles S'Emmêlent — and the main event: A combination of poetry and "wild mind" readings, short skits, a choir, and interpretive dance in Tansey's theatre, a converted barn.

The concept of a "physical choir" essentially consists of dancing, reading, or acting used to represent or accompany another art form. The idea first came to Tansey when she was studying for a Bachelor of Fine Arts at Concordia in the 1990s, and, as she says, it "just hung with me (and) I knew I wasn't done with it."

Given the trajectory of Tansey's career in art, it is not surprising that she spent the last year and a half immersed in the development of this interdisciplinary performance.

Born and raised in Montreal, Tansey has been dancing since age nine, and she has received formal training in both classical and modern dance, in New York, on a scholarship with the Grand

It's an event produced by theatre lovers for theatre lovers. A group of Bishop's University students and alumni, along with their friends have put together an evening of drama purely for the love of theatre...A Dramatic Evening in Two Parts Aug 5, 6, and 7 at 8 p.m.

The small cast of seven will be performing a staged reading of William Blake's *The Marriage of Heaven and Hell* followed by the one-act play *The Bald Soprano* by Eugene Ionesco.

"It's the reconciliation of supposed contrasts," said director Steven Bourque. "We have a classical English poem and a modern French absurdist drama — even though it's a translation (it will be done in English)."

Bourque said *The Marriage of Heaven and Hell* is probably the most influential of Blake's works.

"It is a series of texts written in imitation of biblical works of prophesy, but expressing his own intensely personal Romantic and revolutionary beliefs. Like his other books, it was published as printed sheets from copper plates etched with both texts and illustrations," he explained.

"Blake's conception of Hell is not as a place of punishment, but as a source of unrepressed energy, opposed to the authoritarian and regulated perception of Heaven."

The reading is followed by a full production of *The Bald Soprano*.

"This play is about the constant struggle to make sense of what is going on within the immediate present. The idea for the play came to Ionesco while he was trying to learn English, Bourque added.

"The banality of the expressions used in an English-language phrase book inspired him to write the first of his anti-plays.

"Despite playing to empty houses when it first premiered in 1950, *The Bald Soprano* has gone to become a cornerstone of the modern theatre."

For the *Love of Theatre* began three years ago and has become an annual event.

Many of the young cast members involved in the evening have performed in its previous shows — Oscar Wilde's *The Importance of Being Ernest* in 2003 and George Bernard Shaw's *Arms and the Man* in 2004.

This year's actors are Jessica Cady, Ryan Cook, Matthieu Doell, Amber Tapley, Jonah Lerner, Phil Vivien and Dave Ito.

"We're hoping to appeal to any academic or English Literature fan," said Bourque.

"Being as Ionesco is a French icon writer, I hope to branch out to francophones in Sherbrooke as well."

Murderball reflects the toughness of its players

The ads for *Murderball* would lead you to believe the movie features non-stop, demolition-derby style armoured-wheelchair collisions and to-the-buzzer action like you saw in *Miracle* or *The Mighty Ducks*.

It's not, and the film is a more compelling piece of cinema as a result.

"People have been calling it a sports film, but it's only about 10 per cent sport. It's a movie about what it's like to break your neck; what it is like to lose everything, especially for these guys. They didn't break their necks in the library. They were athletes before. Their physicality was such a huge part of their identity and to lose that was beyond tragic for all of them," says *Murderball*'s producer and co-director Dana Adam Shapiro, who is a novice filmmaker but a veteran writer for publications such as

Spin and *New York Times Magazine*.

Murderball — the name its Canadian inventors gave the sport that is compared with rugby — is grounded in the lives of athletes whose lives were upset, but not shattered, by accidents or illnesses that left them quadriplegics.

What Shapiro learned and what many viewers will be surprised to find out is quadriplegia does not necessarily mean complete paralysis from the neck down like the late actor Christopher Reeve had from his horse-riding fall.

Shapiro says even the way the film was made was meant to reflect the toughness of the players in the sport.

"We tried to reflect the esthetic of the guys. You hang out with them. You see their chairs. They're metallic. They have tattoos and shaved heads. The camera work was trying to reflect the esthetic of the game and their lives,

which are kind of rough and metallic."

Mark Zupan was a college soccer player before he was thrown from the back of his friend's pickup truck and was partially paralysed. *Murderball* became an athletic outlet for the naturally aggressive Zupan after his accident, and he says the message of the movie is fundamental, and he hopes people get it.

"The film pretty much breaks every misconception about a person in a chair. You see it and you're like, 'Oh wait, these guys aren't fragile, don't treat them like something is seriously wrong with them. Yeah, we might have mental problems. But I mean, treat me like a normal person,'" says Zupan, 31, who works as an engineer when he's not zipping about the court.

The drama of *Murderball* centres on the rivalry between the U.S. and Canadian wheelchair rugby teams. A former

member of the U.S. team who was cut, sued the U.S. association and then joined the Canadians as their coach, causing his one-time teammates to revile him for his defection. Zupan's hatred for Joe Soares is still visceral, and it's one of the most compelling and disturbing aspects of the documentary.

Scottish and Irish fiddle tunes in Compton

What do you get when you put a retired biology teacher and an experimental farm employee on the same stage as a young occupational therapist with a fiddle?

A well-tuned folk trio that many anglophones are looking forward to jiggling to this Sunday at the Louis St-Laurent Museum in Compton.

Compton own's retired biology and photography teacher Bruce Patton has been practicing his piano notes for his accompaniment with well-known fiddling father-daughter duo Lise and Lucien Beauchemin, and he says that he is looking forward to the 'Down-East fiddling tunes', aimed as a tribute to Don Messer.

"I have to be on my toes at all times because Lise is an extraordinary fiddle player," said Patton, who has devoted most of his retired years to music and photography. "We played together last year and it went really well, so when they asked us this year I knew I wanted to be there."

Patton is known for his musical flare from his teaching years at Alexander Galt when he produced musical variety shows that would pack the auditorium. He has performed at dozens of community events with his piano that he has been playing for over a half century.

"I retired from Galt ten years ago and there have not been very many opportunities to play," said Patton who first performed in public at the age of 10 in Lennoxville's Gertrude Scott Hall. "Good old fashioned dances don't happen as often these days so I am looking forward to Sunday."

Lucien Beauchemin, a retired experimental farm employee, has played the violin since early childhood. He didn't learn by reading music, in fact, he would listen to his records and play by ear. He was so dedicated to play his fiddle as good as legends, like New

Brunswick's Don Messer, that when his record player broke he would rotate the record with one hand and continue practicing his fiddle with the other.

"I'm retired now so I do music for fun," said the French musician, who is better known in the anglophone community than the francophone. "My daughter Lise and I have harmonized together since she was a little girl. I enjoy playing with her when I can."

Lise, now 32, says that she takes every chance she gets to play with her dad.

"My father plays in two other bands and we both have different interests so getting a chance to play with him is special," said the violinist who played the piano at the Survenant movie debut at Cinema 9. "I started playing the violin at the age of 10, but I started on the piano first. In the last couple of years I mostly play my violin, but I still like to play the piano when I can."

Though the Beauchemins are francophone Lise says that she is practicing her English in light of how many anglophone visitors attend their performances.

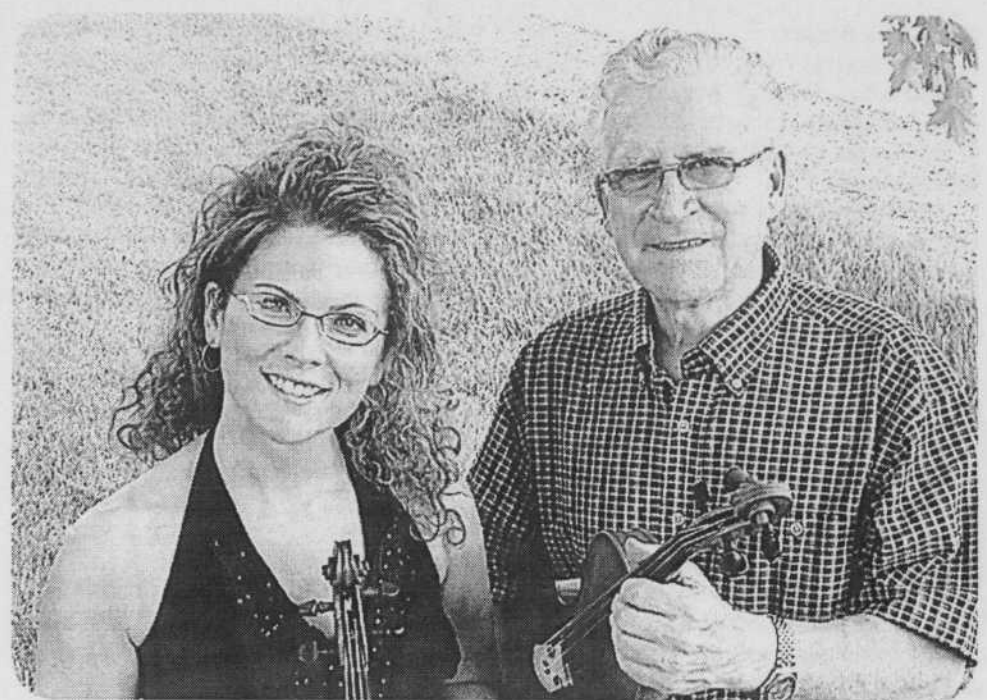
"I like to talk in between songs so I want to make it bilingual," said the Youville Hospital therapist.

Patton says it really doesn't matter what language you speak because the music is traditional and everyone is familiar with some of them.

The trio, who does not have an official name, will take the Museum's stage at 2 p.m. on Sunday for the first of two sets, and they say that any amateur spooners should attend.

"We are going to have a small spoon contest," concluded Patton. "Anyone who knows how to play, even a little bit, or anyone who likes to hear the spoons are welcome."

The cost for the traditional Scottish, Irish, French-Canadian, and Down-East concert is \$5 each, or \$4.25 for seniors, and families can dance together for \$12.

Five artists, five visions

Five artists from the south shore's Studio Visions d'Art are exhibiting their work from July 28 to August 10 at the Brome County Historical Society in Knowlton.

The five women stress that thanks to their differing styles and preferred media — including acrylic, aquarelle, oil, and pastel — there will be something for art-lovers of all tastes at the exhibit, which is entitled "Visions".

Marcelle Simard-Dupuis is the coordinator of the exhibit and one of the featured artists. She teaches at her studio in Mont St-Hilaire, exhibits throughout Quebec and is a signatory member of the Eastern Canadian Pastel Society. In addition to several pastel works, Simard-Dupuis will be exhibiting some oil and acrylic paintings. In all three media, she is passionate about intimate, everyday still-life scenes, and, she is quick to add, "I love colours."

Fellow artist Francine Côté from Brossard is trained in interior design, and her fascination with physical spaces is reflected in her architecturally de-

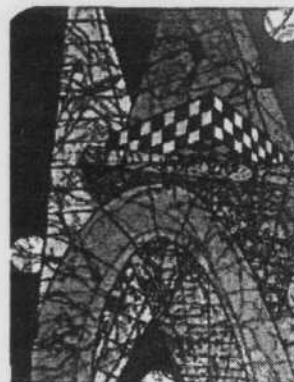
tailed cityscapes. Côté has been painting for a dozen years, and as a cursory glance at her work makes clear, she is passionate about deep, vivid colours. She specializes in the unusual technique of acrylic on wood, and she has exhibited throughout Quebec, as well as in Vancouver.

Denise Simard from Laprairie has been a professional painter for about 20 years, and she has won several prizes for her work. Like Côté, she specializes in a rather unorthodox technique, in her case "marouflage", which involves pasting and varnishing bits of paper onto a canvas. It is a style which, like her subject matter, is influenced by her frequent visits to Asia.

"My artistic vision is very Oriental, or Zen," Simard notes.

Also taking part in "Visions" are Marie-Pierre Vallet and Monique Jolicoeur. Ballets Canadiens, and, later, with the Groupe de la Place Royale. She has been making her living by producing shows and giving dance workshops since the late 1960s.

It was also during the late 1960s that she met Roy Kuka while living on the West coast for a year with her husband, Richard Sommer. Kuka was an accomplished painter, photographer, and musician, among other things, and as Tansey explains, "he made me yearn to be in an art world that wasn't exclusive, that crossed borders."

Back in Montreal, Tansey and Kuka did many shows together at the Parallel Galleries, a venue for alternative performances. For example, she remembers, "one time I sat at the top of a ladder while he read Beckett... we did some really crazy stuff."

Thanks especially to Kuka, and her role in a "happening" at Sir George University (now Concordia) in 1966, improvisation became Tansey's passion. Throughout the late 1960s and the 1970s, she continued to do interpretive dance and improv shows and workshops in Montreal.

In 1980, she and Sommer finally found a home in the Eastern Townships — just outside of Sutton — that allowed Tansey to maintain her connection to the art world while living in the country, "where I knew I

needed to be."

Another piece of the puzzle that led to Saturday's current events-themed artistic happening is Tansey's spiritual background. A long-time Buddhist and accredited Tai Chi instructor, Tansey has an abiding interest in forging connections between local news, world events, and people's reactions to them.

"I'm happiest when (art) goes beyond art, when it starts to affect people's lives," Tansey explains.

Certainly, one of the strong points of the Physical Choir Theatre Project is the opportunity it provides for its viewers and its nearly 30 "sounders, movers, and writers" to explore the psychological effects the news has on us.

Although Tansey created and directed the show, she is quick to credit all the artists and performers who contributed boundless creative energy.

The sideshow performers wrote their own material, in consultation with Tansey, and most of the text of the main show came from wild-mind writings produced by the participants in response to the daily news and edited together at rehearsals.

"I've decided there has to be a book of all these writings," Tansey says enthusiastically. Putting together this book is one of the many projects Tansey intends to take on in coming weeks and months, and one of a slew of ideas she has brewing on the theme of current events.

"This is only a first version, a first performance — I plan to spend at least the next 10 years on this subject," she says.

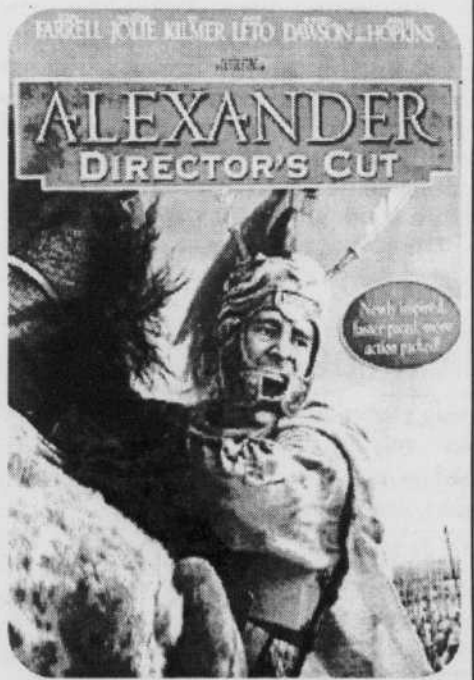
DVD of the week

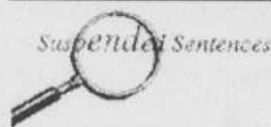
A serial killer stalks cops

In recent weeks we have looked at an Anne Perry mystery set in Victorian London and a Yorkshire mystery by Canadian author Peter Robinson.

This week I want to share with you a suspense thriller by the gifted American author, Michael Connelly.

THE AUTHOR

A former crime reporter in Florida and Los Angeles, Connelly occupies cen-

tre stage among the current writers of suspense thrillers. His Harry Bosch series now runs to 13 books which have been translated into 31 languages, and he has won virtually every international crime fiction award going.

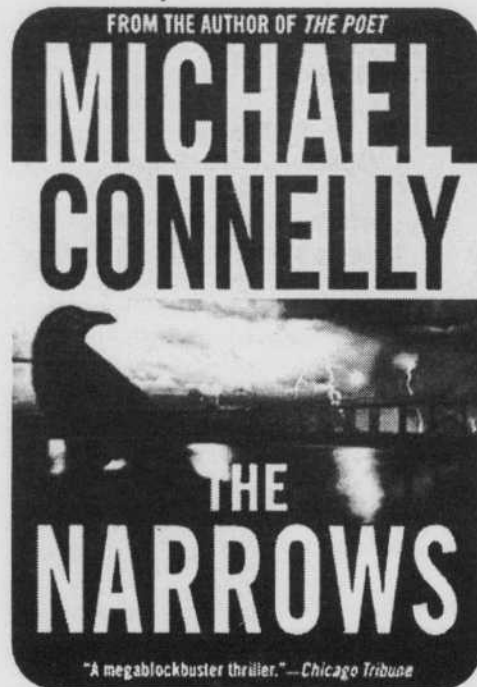
He was president of the Mystery Writers of America in 2003 and 2004, and his previous novel, *Blood Work*, was made into a film starring Clint Eastwood, that has helped Connelly to attract a global following.

He is an unabashed fan of the novels of Raymond Chandler, and a great deal of Chandler's dark world informs his writing.

THE NARROWS

Harry (short for Hieronymus) Bosch is a former cop with the Los Angeles Police Department, who quit to become a private investigator. A retired FBI agent's widow has asked him to look into her husband's death from an apparent heart attack; his medication had been tampered with. Checking his files reveals that he and his family had been the victim of a stalker, and Harry pursues the possibility that the former agent's death was connected to one of his earlier investigations.

The case leads Harry to Las Vegas,



where his young daughter lives with his ex-wife, and Harry struggles to get to know his daughter while pursuing leads to his friend's death in the seamy underbelly of the City Built On Sin.

Meanwhile, FBI agent Rachel Walling is facing problems of her own. Five years earlier FBI agent Robert Backus, Walling's former mentor at the Bureau, went over to the dark side, turning from crime-solver to serial killer. Fellow FBI agents had been among his victims, each body accompanied by bits of poetry.

The embarrassment of the FBI had been compounded when agent Walling had slept with a reporter, who broke the story of the rogue agent, and she had been sent to a field office in South Dakota as punishment.

Based on badly decomposed human remains, "The Poet," had been presumed dead; but similar crimes begin occurring in Amsterdam, and the case is reopened. When a Global Positioning System recorder is anonymously sent to the FBI, identifying the locations of half a dozen bodies buried in the Mojave Desert. See *Crime*, P. 16

Burney's memoir a modest self-portrait

A friend once invited me to a party at a remote cottage in Quebec. Most of the guests were Canadian diplomats between assignments and senior advisers at the External Affairs Department.

I'd met scores of diplomats, usually at drab and painfully orchestrated receptions where conversation is polite and restrained. Travelling to the cottage, I envisioned pale guys wearing sandals and business socks, pulled to just below the knee, boring each other, and their guests, with shoptalk.

I wore a Harvard University rugby shirt that I had picked up on a visit to Cambridge, and although two or three guests approached optimistically to ask when I had attended ("one day, five weeks ago" I replied), I think it helped me to blend in.

After swimming and after food — the drinking never stopped — a large group gathered on the vast deck to swap stories. It quickly became obvious they were trying to out perform each other with tales of diplomatic faux pas, of doing battle with fretting government ministers, smoothing feathers of foreign governments and massaging fragile egos — daily tasks of diplomats and

senior government advisers.

The afternoon was less a diplomatic cocktail party, more a just for laughs comedy festival. There were tears of laughter as the stories and anecdotes kept coming. I just wish I could re-

member one or two.

That party came to mind while I was reading *Getting It Done* by Derek Burney. The memoir is no knee slapper, but in an easy style he offers many fascinating and entertaining glimpses of back-room life in the diplomatic and bureaucratic fast lanes.

Among other roles during his 30-year government career, Burney was chief of staff to prime minister Brian Mulroney from 1987-88 before he was appointed ambassador to the United States, a plumb job that he held until 1993. He moved in the highest echelons of government and among some of the world's most powerful men and women. Indeed, in the Canadian context at least, he was one.


While the "Mulroney decade" ended in disaster, it was one of the most policy-driven, active administrations in recent Canadian political history. Most significantly, it was the era of the North American Free Trade Agreement, Canada's first G-8 summit and the Meech Lake accord. It was also responsible for the Goods and Services Tax, a measure that conflicted with Mulroney's sharp political instincts, was a source of great damage to his reputation and is still a chronic irritant for most Canadians.

Internationally, there was a lot happening, including German re-unification, the first Gulf War and the battle against apartheid.

Burney clearly admires Mulroney as both a prime minister and a family man. He tells a cute story of a B.C. visit where the prime minister launched the Bathtub Races in Nanaimo and a Sandcastle Festival in White Rock. The prime minister and entourage, dressed in business attire, arrived with the Mulroney

Russell enjoying 40-year fling with Disney

He was a 14-year-old kid just starting out in the movies when Disney signed him to a 10-year contract and promptly began casting him in a succession of family hits.

Those movies continue four decades later to have a healthy life on video and DVD. And as Kurt Russell celebrates the 40th anniversary of his first association with Disney, he can still see those old titles on the shelves — titles like *Follow Me Boys* (1966), *The Horse In The Grey Flannel Suit* (1968) and *The Computer Wore Tennis Shoes* (1969). And yes, the awareness that his younger self is still captivating today's viewers does make him feel ancient at times.

"It's amazing how time flies," he says reflectively. "I started acting in 1961 — that's 44 years ago or whatever — and then I went over to Disney to do *Follow Me Boys* with Fred McMurray and Vera Miles and Charlie Ruggles."

He laughs at the memory of a conversation he had years later on the set of *Tombstone*, a Disney movie he did when he was old enough to play Wyatt Earp. A friend incredulously reminded him that in *Follow Me Boys*, he'd worked with an actor (Ruggles) who had been born in 1885.

When Russell first started working for the Mouse House, founder Walt Disney was still alive, and the actor retains happy memories of a man who gave him constant encouragement as a youngster.

"I spent a lot of time with Mr. Disney as a kid," Russell commented a few months ago on the set of his new film, *Sky High*. "He took the time to really talk to me and teach me at a very early age about script and character and story arc — things that later in my life would be very, very important to me. It was a long time ago, but he was a great filmmaker, a great man and a great student of his game."

So whenever he returns to the old Disney lot in Burbank to make a film, Russell always feels that he's back in a comfortable place. *Sky High*, which opens July 29, is no exception.

"It's a lot of fun to be able to do this movie that has his brand on it."

The fresh-faced youth of 40 years ago

has long gone. Even the Kurt Russell who managed a stunning image shift with such gritty thrillers as *Escape From New York* and *The Thing* is no more. He's 54 now. The hair is greying and the face is lined.

And in *Sky High*, he's playing a dad — admittedly a Super Dad, but still a dad. And an engaging young newcomer named Michael Angarano is playing his son, taking exactly on the kind of role that made Kurt Russell's name as a teenage Disney star back in the 60s.

He likes the idea of the wheel having turned full circle for himself and the Disney studio. And he's extremely happy that *Sky High* — an action fantasy about a secret school in the clouds which educates teenagers who are born with super-human powers — came along when it did.

"I liked the script. I thought *Sky High* had the potential to be a sleeper. I thought *Sky High* said something and that it was entertaining and funny."

And it reminded him of the movies he used to do at Disney as a teenager — movies that were "sight gag-oriented,

laugh-line-oriented, character-oriented but which at the end of the day had some kind of message."

Perhaps such movies seem old-fashioned today, but Russell for one is glad Disney still makes them. So he looks back affectionately on those innocent films of his youth.

"They had something to say. They weren't nasty or mean. They weren't post-modern."

Russell saw these same qualities when he read the script for *Sky High*. He and Kelly Preston play Steve and Josie Stronghold — aka The Commander and Jetstream — who are the world's most legendary superheroes, ready to travel faster than the speed of light to any trouble spot.

Both are products of the *Sky High* School themselves and they have the highest hopes for son Will when he enters the school to perfect his own super powers.

Trouble is that so far Will has discovered no such powers in himself. He's not like classmate Gwen who can control technology with her mind, or his surly

enemy Warren who's a human flame-thrower, or Lash who can stretch his arm's to any length.

He definitely doesn't qualify as a "Hero" in the school hierarchy; in fact he scarcely qualifies as a "Sidekick" — the name bestowed on student geeks who belong at a lower level.

Will appears to possess no special powers at all and he's terrified of telling his proud father the truth. Still, being a Disney movie, the time will come when Will's unique talents will surface.

Russell sees The Commander as the equivalent of an aging jock obsessed with seeing his boy follow in his footsteps. But he was also determined to have fun with the part.

"What's fun about playing Steve Stronghold is that there's not a lot of intelligence going on there," he laughs. "To me, he's a buffoon who loves his son so much and loves his wife so much and loves his life. He's such a good man and he's so proud of himself. The only problem in his life is the constant awareness of trying to remain humble."

Russell has had a lot of experience in parenting, thanks to the four children (including actress Kate Hudson) he and his longtime partner, Goldie Hawn, have raised together.

"I'm certainly glad I haven't handled it the way Steve Stronghold has," he says.

On the other hand, he was once a teenager and knows that "everybody has parents that they have to live up to — or get away from."

"So I liked putting this kid in the position of being the son of the two greatest superheroes on the planet — which is the most pressure you could possibly have. With them being loving and wonderful people, it adds even more pressure — it becomes impossible."

The lesson, he suggests, is not to use your children to fulfill your own dreams. On the other hand, he knows he and Hawn would never try to block any of their children from entering show business.

"What are you going to do? Say — this is not good, don't do it? You'd be crazy to say that."

Daniels still awing country music fans

Music

Country music favorite, Charlie Daniels, will be performing at the Lancaster Fair in Lancaster, New Hampshire, on Saturday, September 3, at 2 p.m. and 7 p.m.

He's a 'Son of the South' and it rings true with all the songs he writes and sings. Often referred to as the rebel of Southern Rock, he's also the king of the genre.

Since his eponymous debut in 1970, Charlie Daniels has been one of the most consistent artists on the country music scene. Many of today's younger artists credit him as the musician who influenced them the most.

Daniels demonstrates musicianship beyond the true meaning of the word. He plays guitar, mandolin, fiddle and banjo. He comes across as a man who loves life and he sure can sing about it. But more than anything, he has a passion for his fiddle, an instrument that he masters and brings to life.

His latest release on Blue Hat Records, Songs from the Longleaf Pine, is a great collection of bluegrass gospel numbers.

It features Daniel's characteristic fiddle as well as his commanding vocals set to spirited bluegrass gospel songs. For

this recording, Daniels has invited some mighty interesting bluegrass/gospel artists to make guest appearances. Included are Ricky Skaggs, Earl Scruggs, The Whites & Ronnie McCoury and the great Mac Wiseman. Quite an impressive lineup!

Most fans have discovered Daniels, with his fiery fiddle-playing duel with the devil in "The Devil Went Down To Georgia" but his catalogue is much bigger than that.

He has tackled country, Southern rock, country rock, gospel and bluegrass, so this new album doesn't come as a surprise, since his music has always been very diversified.

There's never been a clear definition of the music Daniels does with his band. From one album to the other, there was always a new avenue to explore and that's exactly what he did.

The man is actually known as a master fiddle player, a wonderful songwriter and a high-energy entertainer. Another thing about Daniels, is that he's very patriotic and that comes across loud and clear in many things he does.

The new album offers bluegrass versions of classics such as 'I'll Fly Away' (a breathtaking instrumental) and 'How Great Thou Art' which are great. It seems that Daniels has a very special understanding of the bluegrass.

One of the definite highlights is the beautiful 'Walkin' In Jerusalem' as well as the spiritual 'The Old Crossroads'. Daniels will turn 69 in October and he is still extremely active. He tours and he lends his talent and time to many charitable causes.

The North Carolina native was struck by cancer in 2003 but his courage as well as his determination and good treatments nursed him back to health. It didn't take long before he was back on stage doing what he does so well.

In a career that has spanned over five decades, from the time when he started playing the club circuits in the mid-50's through 1967, the year he came to Nashville, he had already built an impressive fan base.

Right from the beginning of his career, his music appealed to fans of many

musical styles, because he always was a versatile performer.

This new album was barely released when Daniels had already started writing for his next album.

and Backus' fingerprint is found on a battery inside the device, there can be no doubt: Robert Backus is very much alive, still killing, and taunting his pursuers.

Agent Walling is recalled to the case to help, though her superior makes it clear that she is there as a source of information only, and not as an agent.

Meanwhile, Harry's own investigation leads him to the burial site identified on the GPS reader. The FBI dismisses any connection between the two cases, and both he and agent Walling are warned off the Backus case. They join forces, unaware that all the time Backus has been following agent Walling, looking to exact his revenge.

RECOMMENDATION

All reviewers have their personal preferences, and I am no exception. I like a good puzzle, one that challenges the reader, with multiple suspects and lots of misleading clues, or red herrings. An essential element of such works is what's called a limited point of view: Readers are not privy to all information as the story unfolds - they are challenged to solve the puzzle for themselves.

How the story plays out after the 'who' (or 'how') is determined is of relatively minor importance.

The Narrows, then, is a not a mystery, but is nonetheless a work of crime fiction. The reader is given access to multiple points of view, including Harry's, Rachel Walling's, and the killer's perspective.

We know 'whodunit' from the very early pages, so the suspense, for the reader, is simply what will happen next, and how, if at all, the killer will be caught. It is, however, a great read.

With flawed characters, crisp dialogue, fast-paced action, and an atmosphere taut with tension, The Narrows keeps the reader's attention from beginning to end, and looking forward to the next in this series. Readers seeking suspense, ingenious plotting, and fast-paced action will enjoy this book.

children by Hovercraft, attracting much attention from the thousands of festivalgoers on the beach.

"Most were in bathing suits and well-lubricated, inside and outside," writes Burney. "They were downright friendly, a slap-happy version of friendly."

Burney says he was "genuinely frightened" because many were drunk and the RCMP was unprepared for such a large crowd. They managed to get Mila Mulroney and the children safely back to the Hovercraft. The prime minister, meanwhile, was beaming from ear to ear.

"You don't understand," Mulroney told Burney, "for a politician, pandemonium is paradise."

To greater and lesser extents, former cabinet driver Burney was involved in most of the momentous Mulroney policy initiatives both as the prime minister's chief of staff in Ottawa and as ambassador in Washington where the warm personal relations between Mulroney and presidents Ronald Reagan and George Bush the first helped his task.

Getting It Done describes his style and widely recognized reputation as a no-nonsense

bureaucrat and diplomat who ran an efficient, well-organized office that managed Canada-U.S. relations through many awkward periods.

In the book's foreword, former Mulroney cabinet minister John Crosbie describes Burney as one of Canada's most influential ambassadors since the Second World War.

Burney seems most proud of the free trade agreement, which he credits to Mulroney.

"The political capital and risk was substantial, especially for the Canadian prime minister," he writes. "I believe the positive results for the Canadian economy will stand as his strongest legacy."

Getting It Done is a relatively modest self-portrait of an important diplomat who rose from Fort William, Ont., to occupy two of the most important seats in Canadian government. As Burney points out, few if any countries offer such egalitarian opportunity.

He also notes, quite correctly, that the public service is little understood outside of Ottawa and not always appreciated inside.

Getting It Done sheds valuable light on the mostly anonymous people and convoluted processes that have such profound and lasting effect on our daily lives. And while not quite the stuff of jovial cottage parties, it is by no means stuffy either.
