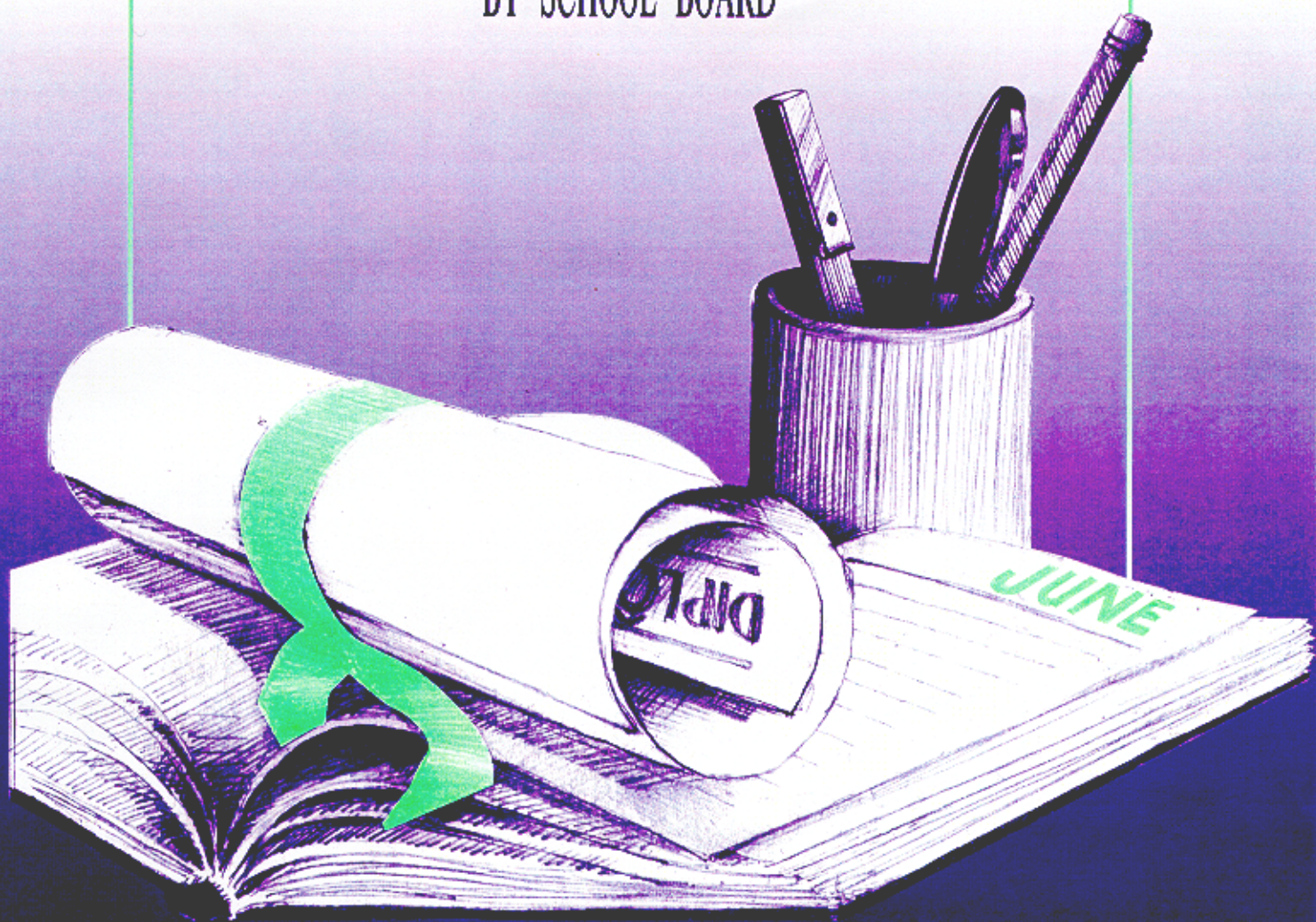

INTRODUCTION

For several years, the ministère de l'Éducation has been publishing a statistical report on the results on the June uniform ministry examinations and on graduation rates. This information reflects the Ministère's desire to facilitate access to information that is in the public domain.

The report, which is also available on the Internet, is divided into three sections: organization of the examination session, results on the uniform examinations, and graduation rates by school board and by administrative region. The document combines the results for both the public and private school systems in one document. To make it easier to locate information, educational institutions are listed in alphabetical order for each administrative region.

The results are presented for the examinations as a whole, by language of instruction and by ranking of educational institution for each uniform examination. The section covering graduation rates contains only one indicator presented in table form: graduation rates by cohort, observation period and sex. Additional information on the results on uniform examinations and graduation rates are available at the Ministère's Web site (see Appendix 1).

This information document is intended for educational institutions and the general public with a view to allowing:

- school boards and private schools access to information that they can use to evaluate their educational practices, to compare their effectiveness over time, to identify their strengths and weaknesses, and to compare their performance with that of other educational institutions;
- the general public access to official Ministère information.

1. ORGANIZATION OF THE EXAMINATION SESSION

1.1 Coordination

One of the responsibilities of the Direction de la sanction des études involves defining and applying rules regarding the certification of studies in general education. Consequently, one of its activities includes coordinating the administration of uniform examinations, the correction of the examinations and the publication of the results.

1.2 Certification Requirements

The application of the certification rules in section 69 of the *Basic school regulation for secondary school education* is suspended and replaced by the rules under transitional certification system 3,¹ which means that to obtain a Secondary School Diploma (SSD):

- students must have accumulated 54 credits, 20 of which must be at the Secondary V level or in vocational education;
- only Secondary IV and V credits count toward the SSD;
- the pass mark is 60 percent;
- a pass mark must be obtained in the following subjects:
 - Secondary V language of instruction (6 credits)
 - Secondary IV or Secondary V second language (French sector) (4 credits)
 - Secondary V second language (English sector) (4 credits)
 - Secondary IV history of Québec and Canada (4 credits)

1. In September 1996, all students were subject to the rules of certification system 3, except for students enrolled in Secondary V in 1995-96, who had an additional year to complete their SSD.

1.3 Preparation of Uniform Examinations

In Québec, the responsibility for preparing examinations for the certification of studies is shared by the Ministère and the school boards and private schools. Each year, the Ministère selects a certain number of subjects for which it will prepare uniform examinations. Evaluation in the other subjects is the responsibility of school boards and private schools.

The uniform examinations are summative examinations used for evaluation purposes in subjects that are compulsory for the certification of studies or the recognition of prerequisites for certain college programs.

The following are some of the characteristics of the uniform examinations that are used to certify secondary school studies:

- The examinations are prepared by teachers and educational consultants in the English and French sectors of the education system. Every year, many people partake in a process to develop uniform examinations and the Ministère coordinates the entire operation.
- These examinations are not field-tested prior to being administered to students in Québec schools; however, this does not preclude the field-testing of certain items that appear more problematic. A new examination is developed for each subject and each examination session. The Ministère strives to develop examinations that are comparable from one session to another.

1.4 Administration of Examinations

Every year, the Ministère publishes an official timetable for the examination sessions. Educational institutions must respect this timetable in full: school boards and private schools may not hold a uniform examination at any other date than the one indicated in the official timetable. Educational institutions are responsible for administering the examinations and must provide the required premises and supervisory personnel. The Ministère provides the examination materials.

1.5 Correction of Examinations

Uniform examinations may contain a certain number of multiple-choice items and a certain number of constructed-response items. The multiple-choice items are corrected by the Ministère and the constructed-response items, by the educational institution. The French, language of instruction, examination (with the exception of the French writing examination) and the English Language Arts examination are corrected in full by the educational institutions in accordance with the Ministère's instructions.

1.6 Processing of Results

For the reasons specified below, the Ministère may use two procedures called *conversion* and *moderation*, which can affect examination results and school marks. However, under no circumstances does the Ministère normalize results in the statistical sense of the word. If it were to do so, it would have to change the raw scores for each of the examinations so that the distribution of the scores would follow a normal (bell-shaped) curve.

Conversion

To ensure that the examinations are fair, the Ministère endeavours to prepare examinations of comparable difficulty from one year to the next.

Despite the customary precautions taken during the development of the examinations, abnormally high failure rates may occur. In this case, the Ministère may either take corrective measures—for example, by removing a poorly worded question—or convert the results. Conversion is a procedure that involves raising all the scores of an examination slightly, thereby lowering the failure rate. In this respect, the first paragraph of section 470 of the *Education Act* stipulates that, "The Minister may, to avoid penalizing students unduly, revise the results obtained by them in the examinations he imposes, to compensate for any error or ambiguity in the examinations brought to his attention after they are taken."

Recourse to this measure is exceptional. In June 1997, the scores for the examinations for history of Québec and Canada (085-414 and 585-414) and physical science 416 (056-416 and 556-416) were converted.

Moderation

In a good number of subjects, the final mark consists of the student's result on the uniform examination and the school mark. School marks may vary considerably from school to school and from class to class.

These differences may be explained by a number of factors. The degree of difficulty of the local examinations varies from one educational institution to another. Some classes are heterogeneous, while others are more homogeneous and include only the strongest, average or weakest students. Lastly, some institutions normalize their marks.

Thus, two classes in different schools or regions may have identical results on the local examinations, but it is impossible to determine objectively if the students' level of performance is in fact the same. Uniform examinations are administered to all students enrolled in a given course, therefore the results on such examinations are a good indication of the performance of different classes. It is therefore possible to use the marks obtained on uniform examinations to "moderate" the school marks, that is, to minimize or eliminate the impact of the local variables mentioned previously.

When the Ministère uses moderation, it compares, for each class (usually about 30 students), the school marks and the uniform examination marks. Using a statistical procedure, the school marks for each class are changed so that they are consistent with the marks obtained on the uniform examination by this class, according to the mean and the standard deviation (that is, the dispersion of marks around the mean).

Moderation involves adjusting each student's school mark upward or downward. It cannot, however, result in the failure of any student who has obtained a pass mark both from the school (before moderation) and on the uniform examination.

Final Mark

For the uniform examinations, the final marks are made up of the students' moderated school marks and their results (converted or not) on the June uniform examinations.

1.7 Diffusion of Results

The Ministère is responsible for diffusing the results and publishes official documents for students and information lists for educational institutions as soon as possible after the examination session.

In this way, educational institutions may immediately assess their performance and make adjustments to their educational practices in order to ensure academic success for all.

Lastly, the Ministère publishes a report for educational institutions and the general public.

2. EXAMINATION RESULTS

This section presents tables showing the overall results on the June 1997 uniform examinations in terms of the success rates and average marks on these examinations, by school board and private school, for each administrative region. The tables also specify the number of students, the number of examinations taken and the ranking of each institution in the public and private school systems. Educational institutions are listed in alphabetical order for each administrative region in order to facilitate the location of information.

2.1 Overview

In June 1997, eight uniform examinations in French and eight uniform examinations in English were administered to Secondary IV and Secondary V students:

Table 1 presents a few points of general information on the June 1997 examination session for public schools, private schools and institutions falling under the responsibility of or financed by a provincial ministry other than the ministère de l'Éducation or under the jurisdiction of the federal government. The equivalent data for June 1996, June 1995, June 1994 and June 1993 are also included.

Table 2 shows the average marks and success rates obtained in all the schools of Québec (public schools and private schools, as well as institutions under the responsibility of a provincial ministry other than the ministère de l'Éducation or under the jurisdiction of the federal government) for the uniform examinations administered in June 1997. The data presented in this report are based on the students' final marks. The equivalent data for June 1996, June 1995, June 1994 and June 1993 are also included.

2.2 Results by Educational Institution and Administrative Region

The results presented in this section should make it possible for educational institutions and the general public to assess the performance of school boards and private schools with respect to academic success. As indicated in the various factors affecting academic achievement in Appendix 2, this information should be used discerningly: it has its limitations and there will always be factors that are beyond the control of school boards and private schools.

The following tables include the overall results for school boards, public schools, private schools and institutions under the responsibility of a provincial ministry other than the ministère de l'Éducation or under the jurisdiction of the federal government. The Cree School Board and the Kativik School Board are, however, not included and the results for

institutions under the responsibility of a provincial ministry other than the ministère de l'Éducation or under the jurisdiction of the federal government are not published.

3. GRADUATION RATES BY SCHOOL BOARD AND ADMINISTRATIVE REGION

This section sheds light on the situation of school boards and administrative regions with respect to students graduating from the youth sector or before the age of 20 from the adult sector.

Table 9 presents the graduation rates by cohort, observation period and sex, as follows:

- cohort of 1989-90: observation periods of 5 and 6 years; observation period of 7 years, by sex
- cohort of 1990-91: observation periods of 5 and 6 years; observation period of 7 years, by sex
- cohort of 1991-92: observation periods of 5 and 6 years
- cohort of 1992-93: observation period of 5 years

The graduation rates for school boards are calculated by means of a longitudinal method based on the observation of various cohorts of students. These rates are determined for observation periods of 5, 6 and 7 years. This means that students in the 1989-90 cohort obtained a diploma in 1993-94, 1994-95 or 1995-96. Moreover, the probability of obtaining a secondary school diploma, as stated in the *Education Indicators*, measures the total graduation for a single year.

Thus, the graduation rate after 7 years for the cohort of 1990-91 corresponds to the percentage of students **newly enrolled in Secondary I**³ in 1990-91, in a given school board, who earned a first diploma⁴ within a 7-year period.⁵

The first diploma may have been obtained at the same school board, at another school board or at a private school, either in the youth sector or in the adult sector (before the age of 20).

3. Only students without a diploma enrolled for the **first time** in Secondary I are included. Students repeating a year are excluded from those considered "newly enrolled" to ensure that they are counted as belonging to one cohort only.

4. Because some students obtain more than one diploma, only the first diploma is taken into account. The following diplomas are considered for the purposes of all graduation indicators in this document: Secondary School Diploma—SSD (general and vocational), Secondary School Vocational Diploma—SSVD, and Secondary School Vocational Certificate—SSVC.

5. This 7-year period is required to measure the graduation rate of students 19 years of age and under, in both the youth and adult sectors, given that 12 is the normal age for entering secondary school.

For example, the following data were used in calculating Québec's overall graduation rate after 7 years for the new enrolments of 1990-91:

- **90 497⁶** students without a diploma were newly enrolled in Secondary I in the youth sector in 1990-91;
- **66 482** first diplomas were granted to these students from 1990-91 to 1996-97 inclusively.

According to the above figures, Québec's overall graduation rate for the new enrolments of 1990-91 after 7 years is **73.5 percent**. Table 9 shows that this result is similar to that observed for the previous cohort. A total of **73.4 percent** of the students newly enrolled in Secondary I in 1989-90 obtained a diploma after 7 years.

Table 9 demonstrates that more girls continue to graduate from secondary school than boys. In the 1989-90 cohort, **80.4 percent** of girls and **66.7 percent** of boys obtained a diploma. For students in the 1990-91 cohort, the rates were **80.5 percent** and **66.8 percent** respectively.

Lastly, Table 9 shows that the graduation rates after a usual period of 5 years decreased slightly. Thus, **59.5 percent** of the 1992-93 cohort earned a diploma after a 5-year observation period (therefore, up to 1996-97). For the cohort of 1991-92, this rate was **62.4 percent** (graduating up to 1995-96), or a drop of almost three percentage points.

APPENDIX 2 FACTORS AFFECTING ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT

Certain factors may affect students' academic achievement. It is important that educators take these factors into consideration when comparing their students' marks with the provincial results. Some factors may be a result of the diversity in the educational and administrative practices of educational institutions, whereas others are considered beyond the institution's control. Such factors include:

- **The number of uniform examinations for which students sit:** The number of examinations for which students sit may influence the results for an educational institution. Thus, the students of a school that does not offer Secondary V instruction would write only examinations up to the Secondary IV level. A school offering Secondary IV and V instruction would have its students write all the uniform examinations for their particular level of instruction.
- **Family situation:** The support and availability of parents, their financial situation and the family's standard of living in general are among the factors that may affect a student's academic achievement. Studies carried out in Québec and elsewhere in the world have shown that the academic achievement of students from socio-economically disadvantaged areas is generally lower.
- **Socio-cultural, support and sports services:** The existence of such services and their ease of access allow students to engage in activities outside of school hours that may stimulate the development and mastery of complementary skills and knowledge.
- **The location of the educational institution:** Learning in some subjects, such as the second language, may be affected by the institution's location. For example, the conditions for learning English as a second language are not the same throughout Québec.
- **The number of students in the second cycle of secondary school:** In educational institutions with relatively few students in the second cycle of secondary school, the choice of courses offered may be somewhat limited and the classes more or less homogeneous. The institution's overall performance may thus be affected.
- **Mother tongue:** In the past several years, some educational institutions have experienced an increase in the number of students whose mother tongue is not the language of instruction, which may have an impact on the institution's overall results.
- **The integration of students with special needs into regular classes:** It is clear that in educational institutions that routinely integrate students with special needs into regular classes, the increased range of disparities among the students sitting for ministry examinations may affect the overall success rates for those institutions.

- **The grouping of students with major learning difficulties or psychosocial integration difficulties:** Such students enrolled in special classes in an educational institution may have a significant impact on academic achievement.
- **Different practices related to admission:** Some educational institutions take in all students, while others base admission on past academic achievement or performance on aptitude tests.
