## Cherry chronicles rise and fall of Nomads

Don't try and tell crime reporter Paul Cherry that the Hells Angels are just a bunch of motorcycle enthusiasts who like to attract a little attention by riding around on noisy Harleys wearing black leather.

The organized crime reporter for The Gazette in Montreal has just completed a book about the recent biker trials that brought down the most violent chapters of the criminal gang in Quebec history.

In *The Biker Trials, Bringing Down the Hells Angels*, Cherry chronicles the rise and fall of the Nomad Chapter of the Hells Angels, whose war against competitors in the drug trade led to the murders of dozens of gangsters and collateral damage including the death of an innocent 11-year-old named Daniel Desrochers by a car bomb on Aug. 9, 1995.

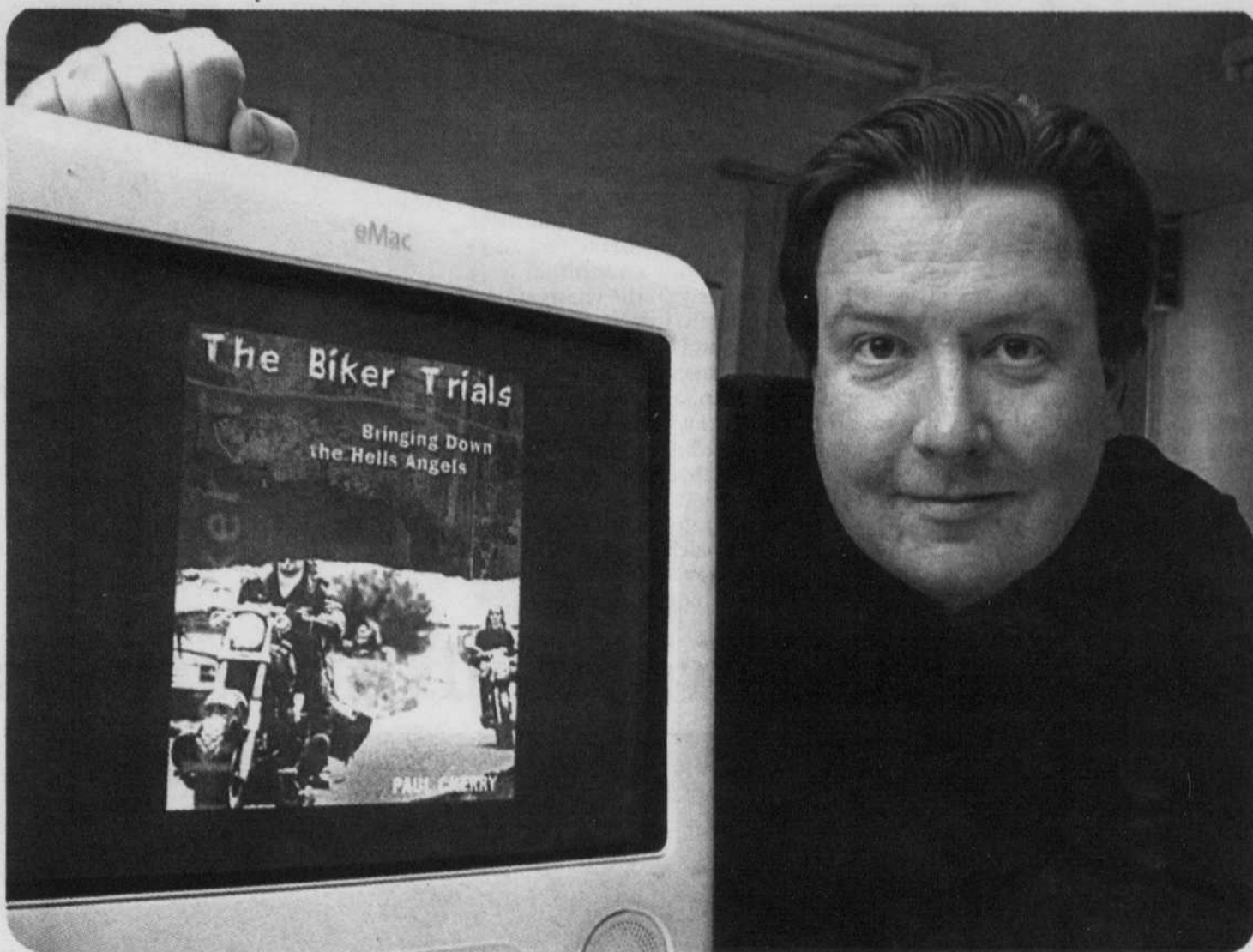
The war waged by the Nomads, and its puppet gang the Rockers, against rivals including the Bandidos and Rock Machine biker gangs lasted six years and according to one estimate, led to 164 casualties.

It ended in the spring of 2001 with Operation Springtime, a province-wide police crackdown on the Hells that led to dozens of arrests and a handful of trials that were a major test of Canada's anti-gang legislation.

Using details exposed during the biker trials, including the main two that became known as the megatrials, Cherry gives readers insight into a ruthless organization that would stop at nothing — assault, extortion, murder — to control the lucrative drug trade in and around Montreal and expand it far beyond.

During the trial presided by Justice Pierre Béliveau — one of the longest criminal trials in Canadian history — nine members of the Hells Angels and their puppet gang, the Rockers, were accused of conspiring to kill members of rival gangs. They were also charged with conspiring to traffic in drugs and participating in the activities of a criminal gang.

With details gleaned mainly from in-

formant testimony, the book gives the reader the inside story of the biker wars and insight into the history of the powerful biker gang. In doing so, Cherry exposes the Nomads and their leader, Maurice "Mom" Boucher, for the greedy and merciless criminals they really are.

Veteran organized crime reporter André Cédilot of La Presse, who covered the trials day to day, describes Cherry's book as an accurate portrait of the Nomads. He told The Record that Cherry

brought the pieces of the puzzle together, explaining the rise and fall of the Nomads.

While Boucher was not on trial with his associates, the story centers around the brutal thug whose appetite for control and indifference to violence and murder led to the bloody turf war that terrorized the Montreal community.

Cherry began his reporting career almost a decade ago here at The Record. He covered everything from town coun-

cils to the ice storm.

One fateful day, Cherry was the only reporter in the office when arrests were made in the brutal murder of Isabelle Bolduc.

"It was my first big story and it had an influence on me choosing what I do now," he said. "I sort of joke with people that it was my baptism by fire."

Cherry said he was in the office when the police pager went off.

# Treat friends to home-made chocolate sweets

**B**aking is not exactly my cup of tea, as I'm sure I've told you before, since I am not patient enough to measure out five or eight ingredients with the necessary precision.

I love to improvise, and that doesn't usually work as well with sweets as it does with savoury dishes. That's why I am very selective when it comes to the few cookies and desserts I do make at home.

They must all contain very few ingredients, so the measuring is kept to a bare minimum. That suits my short attention span just fine!

This week's recipe is the perfect example. These chewy and decadent chocolate treats are typical of Brazil, where they're served at virtually every birthday party.

The chocolate balls are called brigadiers, like the army officials — don't ask me why! Although they look like truffles, they are softer and fudgier.

The actual cooking part takes about 10 minutes, followed by another 10 min-

utes of hand rolling. Piece of cake!

These are great treats to bring as a gift when you're invited to a friend's house for dinner. They keep for days, even out of the fridge.

PANTRY

Ingredients (for about 21 brigadiers)

1 can sweetened condensed milk

5 tbsp. powdered chocolate

2 tbsp. maple syrup

1/2 cup chocolate sprinkles

**Directions:** In a non-stick saucepan, cook the first three ingredients on medium heat, stirring vigorously so the chocolate dissolves completely into the mix. Let it come to a boil and keep stirring.

When you can clearly see the bottom of the saucepan, and it has thickened and turned sticky, it's done. Let it cool completely, which should take about an hour. Pour the chocolate sprinkles onto a plate.

Roll the dough into one-inch wide balls, then roll each ball onto the sprinkles until they stick. Place each brigadier in an individual paper cup.

## The weather is frightful? The stew is delightful

**D**ark and dreary January weather really gets me stewing. Not in a heated "when will spring be here?" kind of way, mind you.

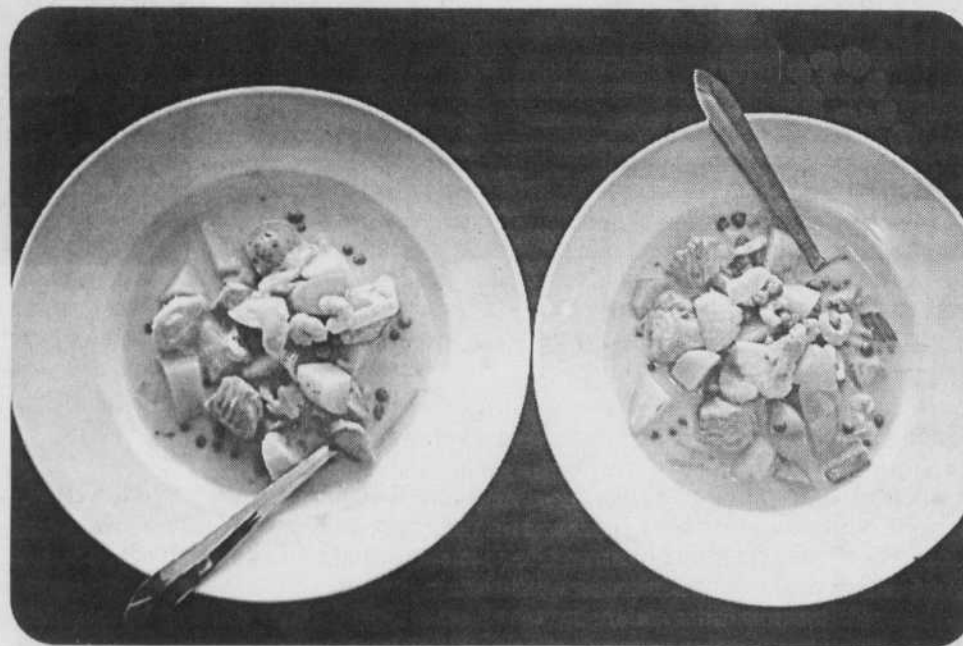
It's my culinary juices that bubble this time of year, and the best way to release them is to create a heart-warming stew. What better dish to lift your sprits when the next storm system moves in?

Move from the Middle East to coastal Italy and seafood becomes the heart and soul of a stew called pesce spada in umido, swordfish in tomato sauce with potatoes, which I found in a tasty cookbook called Alvaros' Mamma Toscana.

When many Canadians think of stew, a simple, seasoned, thickened mixture with cubes of beef or chicken and a few vegetables is what simmers to mind. But as our population changes to reflect the global community, that generic model is being infused with a world of other flavours and ingredients.

I explore some of the possibilities in the recipe I cooked up for today, it celebrates Canada's fine seafood in a dish that should generously feed two.

Canadian salmon, scallops and shrimp combine in this hearty, delicious stew. Serve with warm slices of

baguette and, if you must, a good bottle of buttery Canadian chardonnay.

### CANADIAN SEAFOOD STEW FOR TWO

Cooking time: 20 to 25 minutes

Preparation time: 25 minutes

Serves two

1 1/2 tablespoons (22 mL) butter

1/2 medium onion

1/2 medium carrot

1/2 celery rib

1 small garlic clove, chopped

1 1/2 tablespoons (22 mL) flour  
1/2 cup (125 mL) dry white wine  
2 cups (500 mL) chicken or fish stock  
1 cup (250 mL) cubed white or red-skinned potatoes  
Pinch dried thyme  
6 large East Coast scallops, each halved  
7 ounces (200 g) wild salmon, cut into cubes  
3/4 cup (175 mL) salad shrimp (1/4 pound/125 g)  
1/4 cup (50 mL) frozen peas  
2 to 3 tablespoons (30 to 45 mL) whipping or light cream  
Salt and white pepper to taste

Melt the butter in a medium-sized saucepan over medium heat. Add the onion, carrot, celery and garlic and cook 3 to 4 minutes. Mix in the flour until well-combined. Slowly whisk in the wine. When the mixture starts to simmer and thicken, slowly mix in the stock. Add the potatoes and thyme. Return to a simmer; simmer until the vegetables are just tender, about 10 minutes.

Mix in the seafood and peas and simmer until the salmon and scallops are just cooked through. Mix in the cream. Season with salt and white pepper and serve.

It's the art work of 26 Magog high school students at its best, and it's on display at Le Centre d'artistes Creatio until Feb. 5.

Sentiments features the work of La Ruche students Étienne Audet, Gabriel Breton, Jennifer Bullard, Nina Bureau-Oxton, Amélie Chainey-Desautels, Cassandra Corriveau, Audrey Côté, Geneviève Désilets, Karl Desmarais, Élyse Gagnon, Sarah Gendreau Simoneau, Kacendra Girard, Emmanuelle Harvey, Fanny Houle, Nadia Jacques, Noémie Labranche-Monition, Alex Langlois, Véronique Lavoie, Jessica Lévesque, Claudine MacLure, Mylène Moliner Roy, Léa Oddo, Sabrina Pomerleau, Joanie Provençal, Joany Roy, Trisha Roy, and Gabrielle Therrien.

"It's the first time we are displaying our work in a solo show outside of the school," said La Ruche art teacher Guylaine Thibodeau. "The theme was decided on collectively with students because we wanted a theme that would allow them to express themselves, and not feel limited. I invite the community to come appreciate the talent and hard work of these students."

All of the young artists are in secondary 2 to 5, and are part of the art and sports program. They attend seven periods of specialized art classes a week, which totals more than eight hours.

"The show showcases the young

artists' creations in four different mediums: Watercolour, acrylic, latex, and pencil crayon."

Bullard, a secondary 5 student, has three pieces in the show: Beauty, an acrylic painting; a purple and yellow latex mask, which is untitled; and Sphere, a watercolour drawing.

"Beauty is the first project I've done that I really appreciate," said Bullard, who dedicated an entire month of classes to it. "I was able to create it the way I wanted it to look. It's a painting of a woman with a hand on her face, with flowers and bubbles all around her. You need to use your imagination a bit when you look at it, because it's mystical and fantastic."

"I used to have a lot of trouble drawing faces, and this time I really wanted to prove I could do it. It's tough because of the shades — and eyes are tough to do, but when I saw I was able to do it, I was thrilled."

As is the case at most professional art shows, the work is for sale — with some exceptions.

"I want to keep Beauty in memory of the first project I'm really proud of," said Bullard, who plans to study art in college and university to become an art teacher. "I'm proud that we, high school students, got to have our own show at a professional gallery. It really makes you feel like a real artist."

## Cavanagh, Love Monkey crew keep busy

While others may want to describe the new CBS show *Love Monkey* as a male version of *Sex and the City*, viewers shouldn't expect the same show.

At no point in the opener do you see the four buddies sit down for brunch at a trendy Manhattan eatery and sing the praises of their new Bruno Magli shoes, bemoan being over the age of 30 or share advice on the subtle ways to encourage oral sex.

These guys are guys, plain and simple. They operate strictly on the surface. So much so that three of them have no idea their ex-pro athlete best pal is gay.

Adapted from Kyle Smith's novel, the story focuses on Tom Farrell, a kindly, idealistic record label A&R guy who gets fired from his job at Goliath Records (that name's a hint at what this company's mission statement reads like) after he gives a speech about doing it for the love of music, not the love of bigger profits.

Played by the very likeable

Lennoxville native Tom Cavanagh (Ed), Tom finds himself not only out of work but out of another relationship.

"What do they say? When you love someone set them free?" says Tom's girlfriend.

"Did she just quote Sting while breaking up with me?" says Tom, who you can imagine is loaded with quick music-based quips and references.

In case you haven't yet figured it out, Tom is a full-fledged member of the Peter Pan fan club. He spends all his time searching for the new musical talent. And in Tom's mind that would be artists like like Bob Dylan, David Byrne or KT Tunstall — not Ashlee Simpson, Chris Brown or The Pussycat Dolls.

When he's not organizing his record collection, Tom hangs with three pals. Two of those pals (Larenz Tate and Christopher Wiehl) are single and the other, played by Vancouver's Jason Priestley, is married to Tom's pregnant sister.

## 24's Jack Bauer here to stay, says Sutherland

The bad news: Kiefer Sutherland says 24 can survive perfectly well without Jack Bauer. The good news: That isn't going to happen any time soon, if Sutherland has anything to do with it.

While his castmates Mary Lynn Raskub, Carlos Bernard and Gregory Itzin had interviewers in stitches at the winter meeting of the Television Critics Association on Tuesday, Sutherland was pensive and thoughtful, allowing himself the occasional wry remark as he talked seriously about the five-year evolution of his career-defining role.

"I think that this series, like *Law & Order*, is about the idea," Sutherland said. "The idea is fantastic. We all, as actors, have talked about it. The real star of the show is the real-time format. I believe that very strongly.

"(Leaving) is not something I'm in a hurry to do, however. I think the show is working. I think the character is growing on many levels. I think one thing we have all discovered is that every season has had an impact on the character, and the character has grown. And the character has been allowed to carry with him what he has suffered the year before."

That character — counter-terrorism agent Jack Bauer, constantly on the run and hardly ever in need of a sandwich or a bathroom break — is both physically and emotionally draining, but Sutherland himself insists he is infused with renewed energy.

"I'm committed to the show as long as we're moving it forward. And I'm committed to the show as long as an audience will allow me to do it. And I think they will be very clear in the end, as will (the reviewers), when it is no longer effective.

"This is really from an actor's perspective but the audience that we have, and the audience that we had from the beginning, understands that, every time they tune in to watch, they're going to have to take quite a leap of faith with us — and they have done that.

"This is one of those rare instances when a show hit at the right time in the right place with the right audience. Whether that audience would have taken that leap of faith 10 years ago, or 10 years from now, I don't know. But at the moment, they are certainly prepared to be with us, and we rely on that.

"We've been very fortunate to have an audience that is willing to stay with us when we try to do something new."

Speaking with Sutherland for only a few minutes is like being invited inside the inner sanctum of *Inside the Actors Studio*, only without the grating host.

"One of the things I have learned more on this show than at any other time in my career is that when you go from film to film, you can make very broad choices from one show to another. This has taught me about working with minutiae, making 15 small changes over the course of one season to the next. The unique aspect for me this year, and the challenge this year, is that Jack does not work for anyone — he does not work for the Defence Department, he does not work for CTU.

"Everything that he is doing this year is an emotional response to a series of events. This is not about duty. This is not about the sense of responsibility. And how to inject that change into this character and separate this character, on a very small level, from the year before, is an incredible challenge. It is something I'm enjoying immensely, however."

A future feature film is not out of the question. The problem, Sutherland says, is that every time 24's writers come up with a story idea that will sustain a full-length feature film, "we need it for episode 18."

Also, it's tough to come up with a story idea that will keep the audience inside the theatre for a full day.

As for the seeming lack of levity in 24, Sutherland scoffs at the very suggestion.

"We think Chloe is very funny," he says, deadpan.

# Pieces finally falling into place for guitarist

Danny Rood plays a mean blues guitar but when he performs at the Vieux Clocher in Magog this weekend, the audience will get a different take on a traditional style.

"It's very positive blues," said the soft-spoken Rood in an interview. "It's not the traditional blues with all those never-ending solos. It has a lot more flavour to it."

While his guitar swells with blues rhythms, Rood's musical interest was sparked more by the British Invasion of the 1960s and less by the old bluesmen from the Deep South.

Rood's British influenced blues radiates on his first full-length album, *You Shine like the Sun*.

"I was brought up in a lot of the music of The Beatles and the British thing. The album is really based on peace and love," he said, adding he was part of an ensemble performing the long running British Invasion show at the Montreal Casino in 2001.

Rood's love of music stirred in him when he was a child growing up in Boucherville on the south shore of Montreal.

"My first goal was to be the best guitarist in the world," said Rood. "When you're 10 you say you want to be the best guitarist in the world, the Jimi Hendrix, the Jeff Beck, and all these people I really admire as guitarists."

Thirty-seven years after he first picked up the guitar, Rood said he never expected to become a singer or a songwriter. He spent many years working as a back-up musician, notably with artists such as Aldo Nova and Nanette Workman.

On *You Shine*, Rood wrote the songs, plays several instruments, and sings lead. He also added a producer credit to his credentials.

Though Rood plays his own style of not so moody blues, it isn't to say he hasn't weathered his share of hard times. This album was released under the cloud of personal tragedy.

"I wrote the album while my mom was dying of cancer," he said, noting today marks one year since his mother, Gisèle Babin, passed away.

"Emotionally it was really big. I was accompanying my mom, and saying 'don't worry about it, you won't suffer anymore. They're out there waiting for you.' I wanted her to feel good about it, not to be scared."

"It was a big journey."

Rood said his album was all but finished when his mother died. She had a chance to hear it. Her dying wish was for this album to be the break her son needed to make in the music business.

"I told her that I would go around the world playing it."

The final track on the album — 'Home' — was written for her.

'Home', which appeared on a compilation album benefiting the Canadian Cancer Society, was the first song to be released off *You Shine*. It will be released in English and French in Canada, and in English and Spanish in the United States.

Putting out this album is the end of a long road for Rood. Previously, he attempted to release a French album, but the project died when the production company went bankrupt. Then he struck out on his own.

The day of his mother's funeral, Rood met Eric Pominville. Rood was passing out lyrics to the song he wrote for his mother. That caught Pominville's attention. The two went on to launch their own production company — Shine Productions.

"I think it's marvellous. We're making decisions, and we're doing things the way we want to do them," said Rood.

"I told Charlie (editor Charles Bury) I was not covering the case. He told me 'Guess what. You're it."

"I had no idea at the time it was a major crime story for all of Quebec, not just Sherbrooke."

Cherry freelanced that story and others to The Gazette and eventually landed a part-time job working weekends as a cub cop reporter. A few months later, he left The Record for a full-time job at the Montreal daily during which time he was a general assignment reporter and worked a stint in Quebec City covering the National Assembly.

Shortly after he returned from Quebec City, he was offered a crime reporter job.

a stolen vehicle that was later torched.

Cherry said the book's publisher contacted him out of the blue and asked if he was interested in writing a book with highlights from the first biker trial that was aborted in 2002. Cherry convinced the publisher an account of upcoming cases where more than a dozens Nomads and Rockers were charged with more than a dozen murders and other crimes including conspiracy, drug trafficking and gangsterism would be more interesting.

While Cherry did not cover all the hearings, he spent hours pouring over digital tapes and mountains of evidence.

While most of the biker cases ended in guilty pleas, Béliveau was the first gangsterism trial to go to verdicts. Cherry said that is important because a jury of ordinary Canadians determined the Hells were a criminal gang.

As he did research for his book, one thing that kept coming up was the independence of the Sherbrooke Chapter of the Hells.

"Police often refer to it as one of the most powerful and influential Chapters in Canada," Cherry said, noting he could see Sherbrooke's fingerprints on what was happening with Hells Angels gangs across Canada, including Vancouver where they were growing more and more powerful.

While the megatrials had little effect on the Sherbrooke Chapter, Sherbrooke played an "important role in a strange way," Cherry said.

He notes the purge of the Laval Chapter in Lennoxville in 1985, commonly referred to as the clubhouse murders, would have an influence on the future of the gang.

"After that, they had to go on a heavy recruiting process in Montreal," he said, noting one of the bikers that got recruited was Maurice "Mom" Boucher. Most of the others recruited in that period, including Normand "Biff" Hamel would also play a major role in the biker wars.

Cherry said he wonders about those

who joined the gang in the wake of the Lennoxville purge.

"You were joining a gang you knew kills its own," he said. "You have to wonder what mentality a person has when you agree to that."

Sherbrooke also has another interesting link to the biker wars. During a Hells Angels anniversary party in town in 1999, the Hells Angels stole a computer from the hotel room of an Ontario Provincial Police officer who was in town to observe comings and goings with members of the Sûreté du Québec's anti-biker squad.

"It shows their audacity," Cherry said, noting the information on the computer led them to a police informant who was murdered. That fact, he adds, was material in getting convictions on gangsterism.

While he was in Sherbrooke, Cherry never covered the Hells.

"They were quiet," he said, noting the Sherbrooke Chapter is good at keeping under the radar. "But don't think because you don't see anything, that nothing happens."

Cherry said the Nomads were an exception to bikers who, for the most part, abhor any kind of publicity.

"They went around with their jackets and coached their underlings to go around and sell as many drugs as they could in as many cars. If anyone disagreed first they beat them up and then they killed them."

Cherry said that Boucher was a "once in a lifetime" character and that if there had been no "Mom" Boucher there would have been no biker war.

"Violence very often is the last option for drug traffickers but with Mom Boucher it was always an option," he said.

Rood said things have really fallen into place since Shine Productions came into the picture. He has hundreds of songs from years of writing. He's already outlined his second album, and hopes to do a French album. Rood is even considering a concept album based on the music of Pink Floyd.

# Female emperor steals show in latest Kwa novel

**W**u Zhao, better known as Nu Huang, is the only "female emperor" in China's history.

There were various empresses and dowager empresses who ruled in a fashion. But there was no one like Nu Huang, who seized power in the 8th century and declared herself "female emperor," believing that was a more fitting title, a more powerful title, than "empress."

"She was a feminist gone bad," says Vancouver author Lydia Kwa.

And Nu Huang could be bad. Those who displeased her were tortured in ingenious ways. She was self-indulgent and egocentric, although what emperor wasn't? She was also something of a sexual libertine, according to Kwa's new novel, *The Walking Boy*, a fascinating romp through 8th century China during the Tang Dynasty with a cast of sexually ambiguous and sexually adventurous characters that would make all those anti-degenerate prudes of the Chinese Cultural Revolution 40 years ago blush with embarrassment.

Nu Huang was not meant to be the star of *The Walking Boy*, a novel demonstrating that Chinese culture and history have more "queer" streaks to them than contemporary historical revisionists would have you believe. Instead, the star of Kwa's new novel from Key Porter is Baoshi, the "boy" of the title.

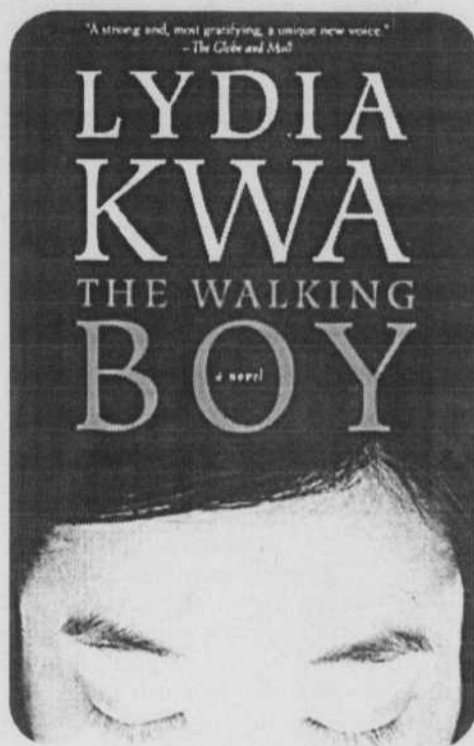
Baoshi was born with both male and female genitals. His parents declared him to be a boy but he was not boy enough for them, so he was given away to an old hermit who, it turns out, was gay.

When Baoshi is old enough, the hermit sends him on an errand to track down a long-lost male lover. Baoshi has many adventures on this pilgrimage with both romantic and religious overtones, eventually landing in Nu Huang's court.

The two characters are a study in contrast. One is a boy with feminine qualities. The other is a woman playing the role of a man. Both are meant to make the reader ponder sexual stereotypes, what it means to be a man and what it means to be a woman.

It is also meant to illustrate that Chinese culture is not just peopled by hordes of monogamous heterosexuals stuck in the missionary position.

Nu Huang is a definite scene-stealer. Kwa calls her a "drama queen." She wants to write the history of her own reign because she fears male historians won't get it right. And, in fact, as Kwa



discovered in her research, historians have not been very kind to the female emperor.

Nu Huang, more than anyone else, sticks in your mind at the close of *The Walking Boy*. Many may find her story more interesting than that of Baoshi. Thus, Kwa should be applauded for deciding to make Nu Huang the star of her own book, a planned prequel to *The Walking Boy*. There will also be a sequel, turning *The Walking Boy* into a trilogy.

"I hope I live long enough to do that," Kwa says over lunch.

Kwa came to Canada from Singapore 25 years ago to study psychology. She has been here since. But writing, both poetry and fiction, seems to be her real passion.

She previously published, both to much acclaim, a book of poetry, *The Colours of Heroines*, and a novel, *This Place Called Absence*.

In addition to *The Walking Boy* trilogy, Kwa is working on experimental long poem called *Roadbook: Suite of Hands* and a novel set in Singapore in the 1960s and 1970s.

*The Walking Boy* is not a typical Canadian novel. It, frankly, seems more Asian. The story appears in fragments, like a series of brush paintings heavily loaded with symbolism and points of meditation.

The characters are larger than life, as if lifted from fables and not quite grounded in reality.

*Ain't Nobody Worryin'*  
(Arista)



Anthony Hamilton is hip-hop's indispensable side man, the soulful singer who adds old-school grit to tracks by Nelly, Nappy Roots and Jill Scott, among others. He's stepped to the front on this album of straight up R&B, steeped in the flavour of his native North Carolina. 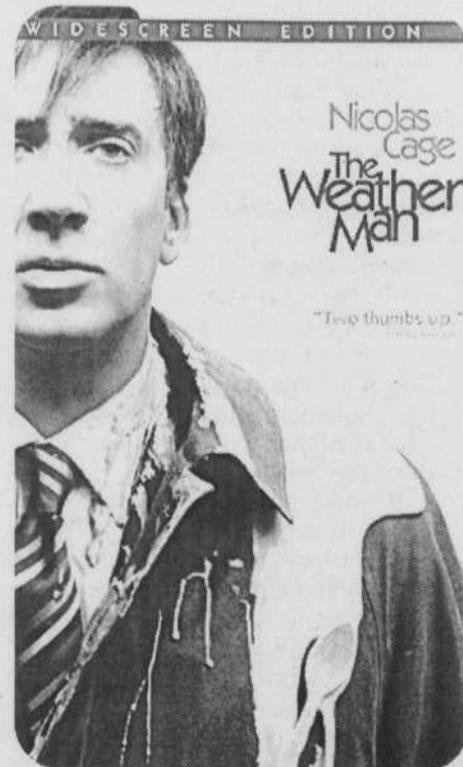
## DVD of the week

# Different views of The New World

# Movies

It's long. Some might even say Terrence Malick's latest film, *The New World*, is tedious. Yet behind each lingering shot of an untamed and natural landscape, each extended silence between the two leads, and each carefully photographed image of European comforts caked in mud, Malick crafts a film about first-contact that slows down long enough to catch the throbbing rhythm of the human experience.

Built around the familiar story of Captain John Smith and his love for aboriginal princess Pocahontas, Malick's film would seem to offer nothing new in the way of narrative, but even there, he comes at the whole premise from a different angle.

This is not the four-hanky story of doomed love between a white European male and his exotic muse. If anything, it is a story of courage and cowardice, and the real meaning of being "who you are."

The American Ideal, as we've come to understand it through Hollywood pictures and political rhetoric, revolves around the notion of personal realization. The 'New World' was founded on the emotional desire to be free, and to express oneself without fear.

So when Malick makes a movie that deals with what it means to "be who you are," he's making a movie that not only points to our current reality as well as our colonial past, he's creating a film about the things that make us individuals, as well all the things that hold us together as a shivering and naked species of smart apes.

It's a lot to contend with, but somewhat miraculously, Malick fuses every single component to each and every drop-dead gorgeous frame, resulting in a continuous, shimmering arc of story.

For the actors, who include A-list stars such as Colin Farrell and Christian Bale — as well as newcomer Q'orianka Kilcher, who plays the perpetually unnamed Pocahontas — the world around them becomes a dramatic partner in every scene.

When we see the burly Captain Smith (Farrell) flirt with the chief's soft-

skinned, square-jawed daughter, they run slow-motion through swishing grass fields and giggle in the mossy dampness of the forest.

Malick ensures they cannot relate to each other as actors, and as characters representing archetypes of human history, without sticking their noses in the dirt first.

As in all other Malick films, including *Badlands* and *The Thin Red Line*, there is a palpable "Earth force" humming beneath the tranquil — sometimes violent — frames that maps the whole drama according to a different set of assumed rules.

In Malick's universe, men are small. *The New World* is therefore the perfect setting for the Waco, Texas-born director's masterpiece based on a script he'd written more than 30 years ago.

Dwarfed by the landscape, and

trapped by their own collective fear of the lurking, "savage," dangers beyond the fetid gates of their self-created prison called Jamestown, the first settlers in the New World are reduced to beasts.

Compared to the First Nations people living without any form of western comforts in the woods, the white folk may as well be the walking dead.

Because we venture off with Smith, and witness his assimilation into the natural world once he is saved by the gesture of Pocahontas, we learn to see the New World through his eyes.

From that point on, the film has a dreamy, suspended feeling as it explores a different culture; a different understanding of the world.


Malick not only puts the princess in torturous western heels and a bustle dress, he slaps her into a western frame

and makes us stare as she bumps up against the sides. A former creature of the landscape, Pocahontas is now part of the world inside the fort, and though she could be bitter and victimized by her treatment, she's still looking at the world from a different place. She begins to understand and even embrace the peculiar ways and regimented rhythm of her new world.

This spirit of personal charity that Malick rescues from the wreckage of the larger relationship between Europeans and Aborigines is really the film's biggest, and most beautiful, surprise.

Malick offers up no real martyr. The princess is certainly worthy of sainthood, but she never lifts her eyes to the heavens looking for justice. She is grounded in the real world, and embraces her smallness in the big picture.

# Jones gets second chance to record hits *Music*

George Jones remains one of the greatest country singers alive, after over half a century of performing for music fans.

Jones turned 74 this past September but it hasn't stopped him. On the contrary, late in the fall he released a brand new album.

For this new collection, Hits I Missed ... and One I Didn't, Jones recorded 11 songs he had passed on over the years that went on to become hits for other people. There is also a new version his classic 'He Stopped Loving Her Today', a song he nearly didn't record.

Veteran artist and producer Keith Stegall began work on Hits I Missed ... and One I Didn't late in 2004, then finished up over the summer of 2005 for a late fall release.

The songs were chosen by Jones and Stegall along with Evelyn Shriver and Susan Nadler, with whom Jones formed Bandit Records in 2001. Hits I Missed... and One I Didn't is Jones' fourth release on Bandit Records.

Jones' talent continues to charm as he ages like fine wine. He seems comfortable with his own voice, which in turn sounds beautifully weathered

and mellowed.

The new album probably features the most relaxed, confident vocals ever heard on any of Jones' recordings, and his soulful, easy approach to these classics make them his own.

It's always painful and annoying for an artist to pass up a song, only to see it become a big hit for someone else but this album can almost be seen as a tribute to classic country. Jones was smart to take the opportunity to lend his voice to such a project.

Here, Jones turns 'The Blues Man' into a duet with Dolly Parton. This is a great collaboration

The album opens with Willie Nelson's 'Funny How Time Slips Away' which is suitable because Jones has been performing for over 50 years.

"What can I say about this classic other than I can't understand why I hadn't recorded it earlier?" writes Jones in the liner notes for the album.

Nelson will love this version — it is clear that if Jones had done it first, it would still have been a number one.

Bluegrass star Rhonda Vincent con-

tributes back vocals to a song by another Country legend, Merle Haggard's 'Today I Started Loving You Again'

This is a great cover but I don't think that 30 years ago, Jones' version would have been as good. The way his voice has changed is what makes it possible.

Jones recorded a lot of older songs for Hits I Missed ... and One I Didn't, but also covered more recent numbers such as Alan Jackson's 'Here In the Real World' and Randy Travis' 'On the Other Hand.'

The selection of material on the album is stellar, with covers of songs famously performed by Mark Chesnutt ('Too Cold At Home'), Vern Gosdin ('If You, re Gonna Do Me Wrong'), the Mel Tillis penned and Bobby Bare signature hit 'Detroit City' and Johnny Rodriguez's 1972 debut hit 'Pass Me By.'

There's also the Harlan Howard-penned 'Busted.' On this one, the singer and producer decided to go for a Cajun feel and it works fine. While

the remake of his own 1981 signature song 'He Stopped Loving Her Today' is great with the changes found mainly in the arrangements, it is the remake of other singers' hits that is interesting to hear.

Jones' versions of the songs will come as a revelation to many fans.

The slight changes in phrasing give a new life to golden oldies and lets us discover and love them all over again. Jones has the ability to truly bring a lyric to life without getting in its way.

He has been called the greatest country singer and I think that he proves it by taking a chance covering songs that have been hits for other great artists.

What's surprising here, then, is not so much Jones' performance as the way in which he sheds new light on the material itself.

The cover songs here probably won't replace any of the original classic performances, but the album is enjoyable from beginning to end. It also serves as a nice reminder of what real country music sounded like when lyrical eloquence and emotional depth mattered more than charting and having a crossover hit.

# Mel Brooks still making people laugh *Movies*

Albert Brooks is the sort of comedian who can even find humor in the fact that this morning he suffered a near concussion during a TV interview.

So why should we be surprised that, as his post 9/11 comic riff, he's giving us a new movie called *Looking For Comedy in The Muslim World*?

The 58-year-old entertainer — whose birth name is Albert Einstein, and isn't that grounds for humour in itself? — has delayed his meeting with print reporters for more than an hour in order to make an emergency visit to his doctor.

It's a sensible move, considering that a light stand crowned him during an earlier session with a TV reporter.

"Are people here?" he asks plaintively, peering at the assembled journalists. "I am dilated right now. I don't have my glasses on, but I know people are here."

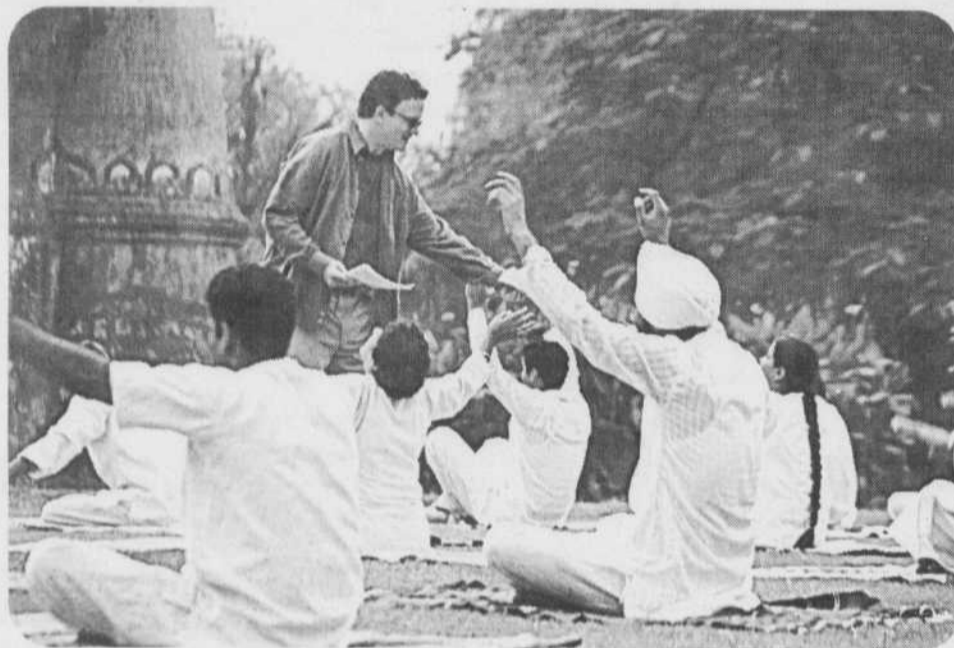
"Let me count!" he insists as reporters start laughing.

He broods comically over the cruel workings of fate.

"I've been all the way around the world and nothing happened. How did it happen in this (expletive) hotel? This is life in a nutshell. I swear to God — this speaks volumes of the world we live in. India, Pakistan, Dubai — no problems."

Brooks also hopes audiences will be laughing when *Looking For Comedy in The Muslim World* opens Jan. 20. He himself is still laughing over the fact that Sony, the original distributor, freaked out over the title and decided to dump the film.

After he finished shooting, Brooks had a meeting with Sony officials and showed them a rough cut of the opening scene.

Brooks sensed a problem when one of the Sony brass commented: "Great title — I guess we're going to add a lot of phones to answer the calls we're going to get on this one."

His fears proved justified five months later when Sony demanded that the title be changed. When Brooks and his colleagues balked, Sony dumped the film and cancelled its scheduled October, 2005, release. The film was picked up immediately by Warner Independent, which had no problem with the title.

"I was so mad that they had wasted our time," Brooks says now. But there's at least one positive note to Sony's involvement: he can make fun of the trail-

er that studio had prepared.

"Not only did they not want the title, but they didn't want to tell anyone what the movie was about. It looked like 'Bill And Ted Go To India.' I really couldn't figure it out."

Missing from the Sony trailer was the scene in which he is summonsed to Washington and asked by the government to help in a new diplomatic effort — by spending a month in India and Pakistan and writing a 500-page report about what makes the 300 million Muslims in the region laugh.

Brooks — a quirky entertainer who writes, directs and stars in his own movies — keeps being told that he's en-

tering a minefield with a project like this. For example, there's a scene in this fish-out-of-water story which sees Brooks, playing himself, visiting the controversial Arab news channel, Al-Jazeera. He thinks he's going to get the low-down on what makes Muslims laugh: instead he's offered a role in a new sitcom called *That Darn Jew* about an American Jewish man who moves into a Muslim neighbourhood.

But Brooks isn't worried about controversy — especially after previewing the film to an appreciative Arab audience at the Dubai International Film Festival.

"The very fact that there are no movies like this is entering a minefield," he comments. But he notes that until recently Hollywood has been shying away from post-9/11 subject matter. "There have certainly not been any comedies and very few dramas — just the few that are coming up now which I call the 'terrorists with a heart of gold' dramas (with) suicide bombers changing their minds."

The bulk of the movie takes place in India, which is essentially a Hindu nation, and there's a key sequence in which Brooks does a stand-up routine before a New Delhi audience and flops. Responding to questions about his choice of India as his setting, Brooks drolly notes that there would have been big problems trying to film in predominantly Muslim countries like Saudi Arabia, Pakistan, Iran or Syria.

"I'm not getting into Iran, I'm not getting into Syria. You can get the Fox News crew into Saudi Arabia, but you can't get a hundred Americans led by a Jewish director."
