Rabu recreates Piaf's passion

Fans of Edith Piaf who will doubtlessly thrill to the tribute now playing at The Piggery Theatre have three things to be thankful for: Joëlle Rabu, her love for Piaf and plain old luck.

Rabu, bringing her award-winning *Tonight...Piaf* back to the summer theatre for its third run in eight years, stumbled across the role — and an entire career — by chance.

"Back in 1983, I was working in the restaurant-hotel industry," she says. "My brother, a big fan of my singing, bragged to someone in the restaurant I was working at. He knew [director] Ray Michal. I met with him, sang some Piaf songs I knew and got a three-week contract, which turned into a year."

Rabu hasn't looked back for the last 16 years. And as much as Edith Piaf is one of her musical idols, Rabu is a fully developed singer and songwriter in her own right. Rabu credits her musical director, J. Douglas Dodd, as being one of the main factors in moving her towards her own music.

"After doing a full year of Piaf, I had people in the streets calling me Edith," she explains. "The musicians I worked with flagged me, and asked if this was what I really wanted to do —

to play someone else for life? It's a dangerous path for any actor."

Rabu has recorded several albums under her own name and continues to enjoy putting on shows as Piaf — a role she loves, but doesn't lose herself in.

"What holds me together is reverence," Rabu says. "Piaf's passion and voice — you don't hear that these days."

There is also a marked difference in the lives of Rabu and Piaf, Rabu says.

"My autobiography would be too happy to make good reading," she laughs. "But Piaf's would."

The French singing legend's life was turbulent and hard, from her birth to a prostitute and street acrobat to her death in 1963, addicted to morphine and a shadow of her former self.

It is this Piaf that Rabu and her crew recreate, the Edith Piaf who performed at the Waldorf Hotel in 1961, her last performance before her death.

"I wanted to say more about Edith, but I didn't want to dwell on her darker side," Rabu explains.

Through the show, Rabu as Piaf explains Piaf's life between songs, shedding light on all facets of the great singer.

"I wanted to balance it so younger generations would know who she was, but older generations could still respect her," she says. "Piaf wants to set the record straight, so she sits and talks to the audience between songs, about her life."

Despite the obvious physical differences between Piaf and Rabu — Piaf was slight, even tiny, and Rabu is almost five-foot-eight and "not at all weak and tiny" — audiences still find her performances utterly convincing.

"At our last run at The Piggery in 1993, I met an elderly woman who had seen Piaf in 1961. She came backstage, overwhelmed, and said it was exactly the way it was. It did my heart good," Rabu laughs.

After countless performances as the 'French Sparrow,' Rabu still loves to put on the black dress and perform as Piaf for an appreciative house — especially in the Eastern Townships, which she says provides the "ideal audience, a mix of French and English."

What she hopes is that audiences will leave with more than just good music in their heads, but an appreciation for the singer as a whole entity.

"My quest is not to be like an Elvis impersonator," she says. "My goal is to present the music, but also to help you learn about her and her life, rather than to just be a cabaret act."

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Record number of English films at cinema fest

The movies of the world are coming to Sherbrooke in just one week, and both cutting-edge and classic films in English are prominent in the schedule.

Once again, the L'International Du Cinema De L'Estrie will be lighting up the screens of Cinema 9 from Sept. 9 through Sept. 19. This year, however, the festival is boasting more movies in English than ever - 11 of the films will be English, from monster movies to world cinema.

As festival organizer Hélène Quigley puts it, the decision to include so many English films was not a political decision as much as an artistic one.

"It wasn't a deliberate effort to find English movies," Quigley explains.

"We want to give the people of the Eastern Townships the best selection, and among the movies we had chosen, several were in English - two movies were from England, and three more were classics that were only available in English."

Quigley does hope, however, that both francophones and anglophones will join in the appreciation of fine movies. "What we want to do is reach the most people," she says. "We don't want this to be an elitist event - we want to include a wide variety of choice."

The scope of the choices available, even among the English films, is staggering. An Ideal Husband is an elegant comedy based on an Oscar Wilde play, Earth is Deepa Metha's powerful film about India's partition in 1947, and Akira is a hard-core Japanese animation cult classic from 1988.

In fact, three of the eleven English movies - Akira among them - will not even be shown in a conventional theatre. "Last year, we noticed a big trend towards 'psycho-tronic' movies," Quigley says. "Last year we showed Godzilla Versus Monster Zero, and it was a big success." Based on that hit, Quigley says the festival will be showing Akira, a British Godzilla knock-off called Gorgo, and the 1978 version of Invasion of the Body Snatchers at the downtown bar Les Graffiti. "It's really fun," Quigley says. "People aren't in a

cinema, so it's more relaxed."

Other 'classic' films of a more conventional nature are being presented in their original language, as well. "Alfred Hitchcock would have been 100 years old this year," Quigley says, explaining the festival's decision to run the Hitchcock classics The Birds and Vertigo. "His movies are timeless."

His style has been copied over and over again, but nobody ever came close to the master." The Birds is one of Hitchcock's hallmark horror films, a snapshot of man versus the inexplicable fury of nature, and Vertigo is perhaps his best-regarded film, a complex suspense starring James Stewart and Kim Novak.

Another classic, The Bridge Over The River Kwai, was selected by local personal-

ity Jake Eberts, an independent producer from North Hatley whose films hold, to date, 27 Oscars. This is one of two 'celebrity picks' in English at this year's festival - the other, by the Record's Correspondents Editor Sunil Mahtani, is the aforementioned Earth. In French, Marina Orsini has selected a dubbed version of The Red Violin as her 'celebrity pick.'

"It's something we've thought about for a long time, we've wanted to involve people in the area," Quigley says. "Sunil loved Earth as much as we did, and we suggested this thing, then approached Jake Eberts."

Also among the English films being shown are Spike Lee's newest, Summer of Sam; This is My Father is literally a family event, with members of the Quinn family (Paul, Declan and Aidan) filling the principal roles of writer, director, cinematographer and principal actor; My Son The Fanatic is another film from My Beautiful Laundrette writer Hanif Kureishi.

The French side of the festival has much to offer, too - there are 15 more films slated to be shown, including Les 4 Saisons D'Espigoule and Cours Lola Cours, the dubbed version of the independent German phenomenon Run Lola Run.

"We tried to get the best films we could," Quigley says. "Some were available in French, but movies like My Son the Fanatic and An Ideal Husband were not, and we wanted the people of the Eastern Townships to see them."

She says festival organizers are aware that the English may turn some potential viewers off, but that cinema lovers - particularly the young and bilingual - will come anyway. "My perception of things is that many younger people, the ones that have some English, often prefer to see the original version of films," she says.

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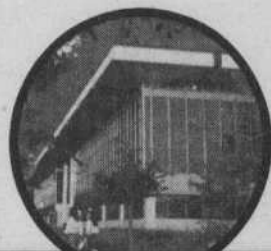
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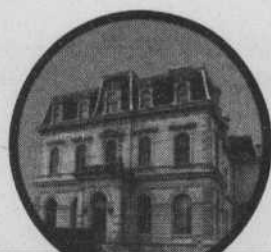

Visit Village D'Antan

Le Village Québécois D'Antan in Drummondville is a recreation of a typical Canadian rural village from the 1810 - 1910 era. Forty authentic farm buildings and living quarters were transported from the Central Quebec Region, while another 20 are replicas built by artisans.

The Village features craftsmen and their wives dressed in traditional clothing, using old-fashioned tools and equipment to demonstrate the trades that were essential for survival in a 19th century rural community.

A highlight at the Village is the little church, a beautiful temple which is a

replica of Sainte-Frederic's church in Drummondville built in 1822. The original was demolished in 1880.

The chapel is an architectural beauty as the builders used the same blueprints and found the same materials that were used in the construction of the original church 177 years ago. The chapel is sometimes used for special religious ceremonies and weddings. Choir performances have also been offered in the chapel as part of the choral festival 'Choeurmania' for the third year in a row. The Village is open to the end of September.

Luce Couture, director of programming for Centennial Theatre, is proud to be offering an eclectic and exciting program of music and dance at the turn of the millennium.

The entertainment at the theatre located at Bishop's University is divided into a jazz/world beat music series, a classical series and contemporary dance.

The Susie Arioli Swing Band launches the fall season this Saturday, Sept. 5, at 8 p.m. Last summer, Arioli and her band opened for Ray Charles at the Montreal International Jazz Festival.

Couture said the audience can expect great music and a good rapport with the band.

"Susie is a lively person and talks to the public and she's quite animated," said Couture. "They're so good. They're going to play at the Millennium Celebrations for the Montreal International Jazz Festival Dec. 31 at the Palais de Congres de Montreal with Dee Dee Bridgewater and Oliver Jones."

Locally, listeners can also tune into CJMQ and CFLX to hear their music.

The African rhythms of Guinea-Bissau dominate the gentle but passionate vocals of Lilison Di Kinara. Lead vocalist Lilison Cordeiro has been living in Montreal for the past 10 years.

"His music is soft and he sings in Creole Portuguese," Couture said. "He's a very peaceful man."

Their CD 'Bambatulu' has taken off on the music charts.

Couture said she is also happy to present respected jazz singer Jeri Brown.

"She's from the United States and she's played with the greatest jazz men."

She left the States to go to Europe for 10 years. There, she released three or four albums and now she's back and touring North America.

"She's one of the best singers right now. You feel everything from her voice," Couture enthused.

A duo from Switzerland caps the jazz/worldbeat series. Jael, originally slated to perform Nov. 20, will play Nov. 3.

Couture said Jael has a beautiful vocal and performing style. "Thierry Chatelain plays accordion and Coline Pellaton plays violin. She also sings - not words, just accompanying both instruments. The duo is very romantic and very passionate. On stage, they're very dramatic."

The classical music series starts off strongly Oct. 23 with I Musici de Montreal.

"People here in the Townships will be very privileged this year," Couture enthused. "They're going to get to see the best chamber orchestra of Quebec. They've released 36 albums with Chandos in England."

L'Ensemble Amati also offer an accessible program.

"They're popular - the popular side of

chamber music in Quebec," said Couture. "They mix popular music with classical music quite well. The conductor likes to talk with the people. They released quite a few albums on Analekta with soloist Angele Dubeau."

In February, Centennial Theatre marks the 250th anniversary of the death of Johann Sebastian Bach with a performance of the third through sixth of the Brandenburg Concertos.

"L'Ensemble Arion have been known for many years for playing Baroque music on ancient instruments. Originally comprised of four musicians, they are enlarged by a chamber orchestra of 15 musicians so they can play the Brandenburg Concertos by Bach - one of the most popular works in classical music," she said.

In springtime, romance blooms with Les Violons du Roy, a chamber orchestra of 15 musicians conducted by Bernard Labadie.

"They're going to design a program called 'Springtime Romance,' so we can expect romantic composers," said Couture. "They're the only ensemble from Quebec City and they're getting quite a lot of recognition since playing in the States. They had rave reviews in the New York Times. People are amazed at the way they interpret classical repertoire."

The dance series is a shared venture by Bishop's University and l'Universite de Sherbrooke and is part of a special program.

"The series itself is four shows," Couture explained. "Two here and two at the Centre Culturel at l'Universite de Sherbrooke. It is offered at \$40 only, but it's worth much more than that. We offer it at this price because it's part of a three-year program funded by the Ministry of Culture and Communications."

"We raised the number of subscribers for dance in the region," Couture proudly proclaimed. "In the province, they consider us the most successful of the program."

L'Universite de Sherbrooke inaugurates the dance series with the acclaimed O Vertigo appearing Sept. 28. In March, they present a new work by Compagnie Marie Chouinard.

The dance series begins at Centennial Theatre with La Fondation Jean-Pierre Perreault.

"The dance is choreographed with music by Franz Liszt," said Couture. "Jean-Pierre Perreault is also a visual artist and the art gallery will present an exhibition of his work."

In February, Sylvain Emard Danse will perform "Mensonge Variations," a choreography for six dancers.

"Sylvain was here for the dance residence, so people got to know him," she said. "He is a very soft, very classical dancer. Even if you think contemporary dance is inaccessible, Sylvain's work is always accessible. It's so soft and beautiful."

This year, workshops and gatherings with the artists will be encouraged, including a lecture on sound by Larry O' Malley, who has recorded the monks at the St-Benoit-du-Lac Abbey, and a percussion workshop with Lilison di Kinara. Other events are being planned.

"We want to make events out of the coming of the artists. When you have an event, you tend to remember the experience," said Couture. "This year, we are going to get sponsors to put on a wine and cheese after the concerts. We want people to enjoy coming here."

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Subscriptions can be ordered from a specially priced 'a la carte menu' available in September only. For an additional \$10, dance enthusiasts can see the Ruth Cansfield contemporary dance company from Winnipeg. A package available to CEGEP and university students offers four shows at \$7.50 per show. For more information, call the box office at (819) 822-9692.

Stratford's Tempest soars

Dark clouds drifted across the sky turning it grey. Winds began climbing to high speeds, dancing with trees. The sound of thunder filled the air. Lightning struck. And it rained - hard and fast - causing all action to take a new direction as the sheer force of Mother Nature's power was realized.

Yet the performance of *The Tempest*, in which the protagonist Prospero conjures up a storm at sea, had not even begun. One hour before a matinee performance of Shakespeare's final play, a summer storm took hold of picturesque Stratford and turned it into an 'island of sound' Prospero would be proud of, creating an unbeatable atmosphere for a viewing of *The Tempest*.

As the wet patrons sat down - after they finally escaped nature's wrath and made it to the Festival Theatre for the show - the lights dimmed and the tempest in *The Tempest* began. The audience couldn't tell the difference between the rain that pounded on the roof of the theatre and that blaring from the speakers; and the lightning - was that inside or outside? It was total theatre.

One couldn't help a momentary flight of fancy and wonder if Richard Monette, Stratford Festival's artistic director, had something to do with creating the tempest in this charming teapot of a town for the benefit of his patrons. After all, nothing seems out of reach for the man with the Midas touch. His tenure as artistic director, now in its sixth year, has been among the theatre's most successful, with ticket sales reaching new heights as younger audiences discover what the 46-year-old festival has to offer.

Monette seems to have the magic touch and an uncanny ability to merge the artistic with the commercial. All of this is punctuated in the 1999 season, one Monette calls a season of dreams and magic.

The play that opened - and will close - the season is *The Tempest*, in which magic is used to fulfill human desires and the relinquishing of magic as a means to human salvation.

Twelve years before the play's main action, Prospero, the Duke of Milan, was deposed by his brother Antonio and Alonso, King of Naples, and cast out to sea with his daughter Miranda. They landed on an island and Prospero used his magical art to establish himself as ruler. Now he has conjured up a

storm at sea to bring his brother and his followers to the island for his final revenge.

Although *The Tempest* begins with a storm, this isn't the only awesome power at work in Stratford's fifth production of the play. William Hutt brings his indelible presence to the role. Hutt, who also played Prospero at Stratford in 1962 and '76, is a master of subtle expression and he held the audience firmly in the palm of his hand each time he was on stage. His measured speech and movements are appropriate for Prospero and Hutt clearly interpreted the universal themes present in the play - fatherly love, sibling rivalry, self-examination.

Wearing a long, white robe that was a stark complement to his snow-white hair, Hutt was the very essence of strength and majesty.

The last speech is the play's best and it resonated here with multiple meanings. It is in the final moments of the play that Prospero 'closes the book,' forgives his brother even though he displays no remorse and puts away his magic, reverting to his essence, a human being.

The Tempest is Shakespeare's final play and many scholars have interpreted this scene as the playwright putting away his own 'magic,' his craft. Shakespeare also deals with the power of the audience to set any actor playing Prospero free from the role by simply putting their hands together at the end of the play.

Also, this may be Hutt's final performance and what more beautiful way to end a rich and varied career than by asking the audience to set him free from acting. These final moments of *The Tempest* were so moving that many in the audience brushed away tears as they gave Hutt a long, well-deserved standing ovation.

Although Hutt had the power, he doesn't get all the glory: He is joined by a fine supporting cast, including Michael Therriault, who plays Ariel, the free spirit who executes Prospero's bidding. Therriault is simply excellent in the role, his physique ideal for the spirit. Wearing a tight-fitting tan body suit, his face and hair also coloured tan, and leaning his upper body and his head forward with his arms behind him, Therriault created the illusion of flight. He is also a thoughtful actor who held his own against the towering Hutt.

Claire Jullien as Miranda and Graham Abbey as Ferdinand, son of Alonso, were charming as youngsters experiencing a first romance. Their love scene which opens Act 2 was wistful and sweet, the actors capturing contradictory emotions well.

Peter Hutt, William's nephew and a solid actor in his own right, does not interpret the deformed slave Caliban, who turns against Prospero, as a powerful character. Hutt's Caliban is almost like comic relief and the interpretation doesn't quite come off.

Directed by Monette, *The Tempest* is a treat. It is also, however, a slow-moving play. Taking place in 'real time,' the action unfolds at a leisurely pace which can be a bit off-putting. Hutt's performance compensates for this a great deal.

Prospero has the power to make things happen, but he realizes that the greatest power is the power to forgive. That was Shakespeare's final message to the world as he put away his magical art for good. It is a message that will remain with audiences long after they've left the storm for the sun.

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Shakespeare's *The Tempest* continues at the Stratford Festival in Stratford, Ont., through Nov. 7.

Clay Walker's music improves through adversity

Stacy Dean Campbell has new batch of hurtin' songs

Listening to a new album is in many ways like reading a book that includes many little stories. Some are tales but most of them have been written from real life experiences which makes it more interesting. Life experiences is what country music is all about.

Here's my review for this week:

CLAY WALKER: Live, Laugh, Love (Giant Records)

This is a fifth album for Clay Walker and judging by the title he has figured out the secret for a life well-lived. Many thought that Walker's personal life and career would be drastically disrupted when he was diagnosed with multiple sclerosis in 1996.

But it seems it might have made him stronger and more aware of the real values in life, somewhat of a blessing in disguise.

What he went through over the last three years is palpable in this new CD giving it a feeling of warmth and sincerity. The album offers 11 memorable cuts (three co-written by Walker) with producer Doug Johnson.

From the beginning, Walker has earned a reputation as a stylistic romantic with a fun-loving streak with songs such as "Hypnotize The Moon," "This Woman and This Man," "One, Two I Love You," "If I Could Make a Living."

He also has a knack for being able to deliver a lively song with exuberance on numbers such as "What's It To You,"

"Dreaming With My Eyes Open," "Rumor Has It," "Then What."

On this new album, he touches both sides of his musical personality. For those who like to kick up their heels, there's the cowboy rock'n roll of "Cold Hearted," "It Ain't Called Heartland (For Nothing)," and the title track.

There's also the poignant "She's Always Right," "Once In A Lifetime Love" and "This Time Love" all songs which will appeal to the sentimental streak in us.

"Woman Thing," is a traditional country number about the behaviour of a woman which is not necessarily understood by a man and the waltz beat of "If a Man Ain't Thinking ('Bout His Woman)."

This is an excellent album showing once again what a great artist Clay Walker is and Live, Laugh, Love could be a perfect recipe for a good life. Country style it is!

STACY DEAN CAMPBELL: Ashes of Old Love (Paladin)

This is Stacy Dean Campbell's first project with a new label. He didn't achieve much commercial success with the two previous albums for Sony/Columbia but this one might get him more attention.

His sound is different than what it was with his earlier rockabilly-influenced tunes. This CD benefits largely from the production touches of Frank Liddell and Campbell's multi-talented brother, Spencer.

Lee Ann Womack, Jamie O'Hara and Buddy Miller contribute all the back vocals and Campbell wrote or co-wrote eight of the 11 numbers which he delivers well.

If you give this album a good listen you'll find that most of the lyrics are

about women and love. It might be one night of intimacy, as in "Some People," or a convict missing his woman in "I'm Gonna Fly."

You find a miner fighting for his wife in "One False Move," with lyrics such as - "She's my everything/ and that's a lot to lose." Everything he sings comes down to love and its different emotions and the tie with each of these women can be compared to hope, loss or failure in a larger sense.

There's no celebration in these lyrics and that gives this new album a sense of loneliness but it is thought-provoking and very well made. It might not be a very commercial collection but this is an album that will strongly enrich your country music collection.

JOHNNY PAYCHECK: Live at Gilley's (Q Records)

This CD as well as one by Carl Perkins are the first in a series of sessions taped at the well-known honky-tonk Gilley's. There will be other releases featuring Jerry Lee Lewis, Bobby Bare and Fats Domino, a very interesting collection.

PayCheck has been singing about drinking, cheating women, love good or bad, and the pleasures of quitting a bad job. Everyone knows about his stone-country style and vocals.

This 20-cut live album was recorded Oct. 19, 1985, at Gilley's, the legendary Pasadena, Texas, nightclub operated by country star Mickey Gilley. It covers 20 years of a rather successful career.

You get "She's All I Got," "Slide Off of Your Satin Sheets," "I'm The Only Hell (Mama Ever Raised)," "11Months and 29 Days," and it wouldn't be complete without "Take This Job and Shove It."

There are less familiar tunes such as "Colorado Kool-Aid" as well as the highly personal "(Stay Away From) The Cocaine Train." He's backed up by a good band and the engineers did a wonderful job in blotting out fans yelling in the background. PayCheck's rowdy style lends itself to that type of recording, so those who like the edginess of a live show will love this album.

This is PayCheck at his best.

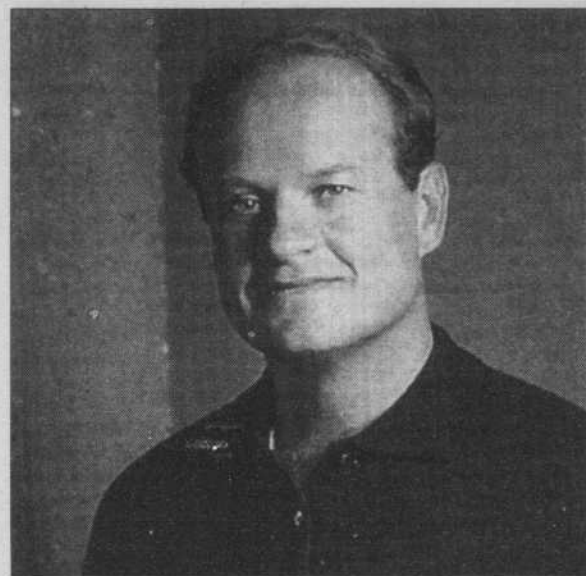

Dog Days of Summer



When Discovery Canada devotes a full week of prime-time programming to a single species, it's usually the kind that inspires fear - the kind that can do serious damage under the wrong circumstances - bears, big cats or sharks. This programming philosophy is turned on its ear beginning Sunday, Sept. 5, when Discovery goes to the dogs. Canines abound in six nights of programming, but not one of them is a threat. You won't see a single pit-bull horror story. Terror isn't the turn-on here. The idea for Dog Week was inspired by enthusiastic viewer response to last season's Fred and Harry at the Dog Show, a good-natured look at the dog-show subculture hosted by TV producer Fred Langan and his bearded collie, Harry. Their behind-the-scenes exploration of a three-day dog show in Toronto will be repeated Wednesday, Sept. 8. Also back for a second look is The Ultimate Guide: Dogs on Tuesday, Sept. 7. This historical survey of the species and its relationship to humans provides a sweeping overview of the subject. Dancing With Dingoes, another encore presentation, airs Friday, Sept. 10. The most original program during Discovery's dog days is a wry history of U.S. presidents and their pooches called First Dogs. Narrated by Kelsey Grammer (pictured), it's scheduled for Sunday.

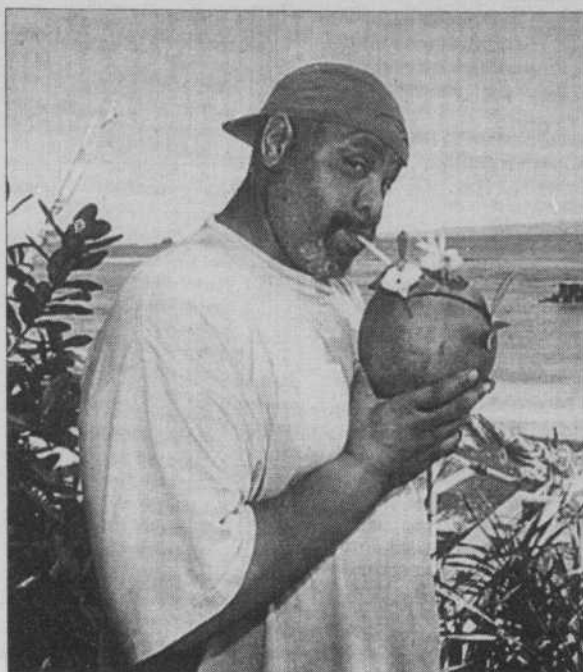

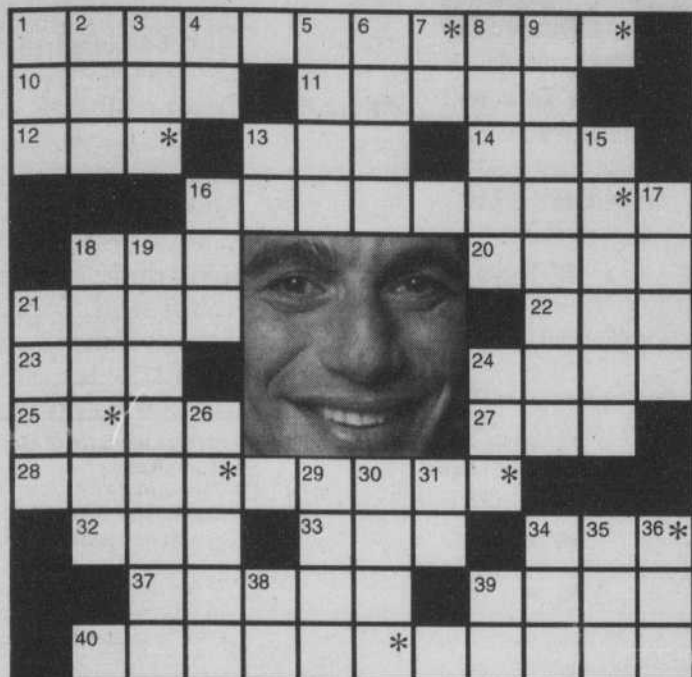

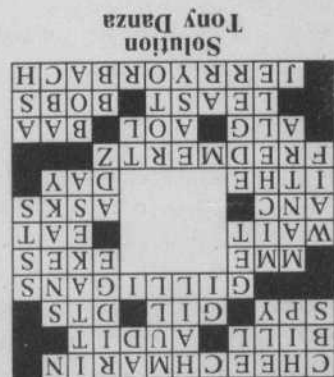
