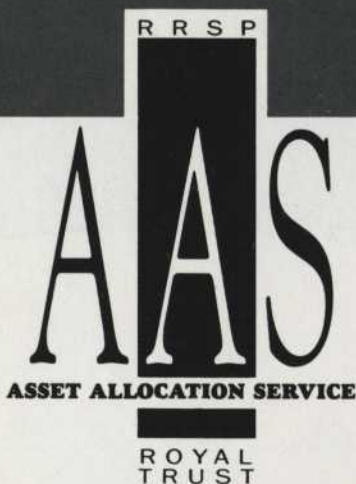

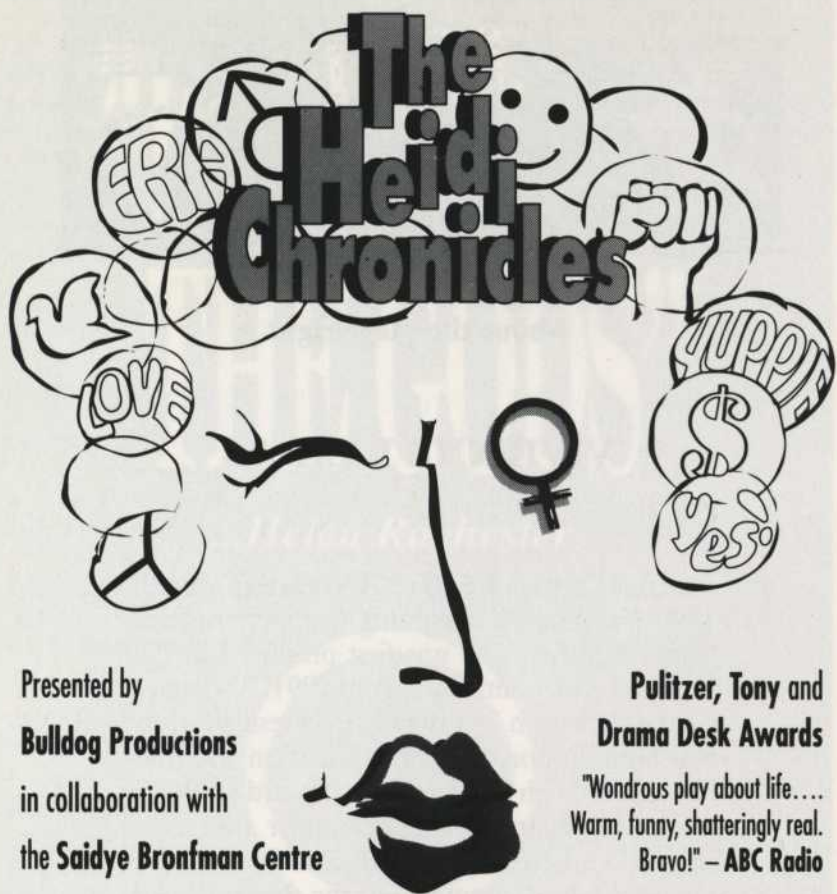


About the playwright

VIVIENNE LAXDAL

Vivienne Laxdal's **KARLA AND GRIF** won the 1990 National Playwriting Competition: full-length category; and was first produced by The National Arts Centre Atelier in 1991. Vivienne is Centaur's Season 23 playwright-in-residence; and has been honored by the Canadian Authors' Association with the Air Canada Award (1991) for accomplishments of a writer under the age of thirty. Her newest play, 'Personal Convictions', premiered in November at the National Arts Centre, and 'Goose Spit' was produced by the Great Canadian Theatre Company in 1988. Vivienne has also written a number of plays for children, and several episodes for the children's television series, 'Under The Umbrella Tree' for CBC. 'Angel's Goose', her first radio drama, will soon be heard on CBC's 'Studio '92'.

Mr. Cameron's recent work includes set and costume design for Doug Greenhall's 'Dead Serious' at The Piggery Theatre, and THE AFFECTIONS OF MAY at Centaur. Other credits include Kurt Weills' 'Street Scene' at McGill Opera and the premiere of Vivienne Laxdal's KARLA & GRIF at the National Arts Centre. While a student at the National Theatre School, Mr. Cameron designed sets for Caryl Churchill's 'Cloud Nine', Judith Thompson's 'I Am Yours', and a new opera by Edward Bond and Paul Keenan: 'The English Cat'. Mr. Cameron is a founding member of Les Productions de la Lune Verte; he designed sets and costumes for 'Berliner Songspiel' and 'Zweiter Berliner Songspiel'. After KARLA & GRIF, Mr. Cameron leaves for Halifax where he will be designing sets for the Neptune Theatre production of 'Fiddler on the Roof'.

REBECCA DEWEY (Kathy)

Rebecca is a graduate of Concordia University where she received a B.F.A. in Performance. She has performed as both an actor and dancer in film, television, and stage. Most recently, she worked as a dancer on the Céline Dion tour produced by Donald K. Donald. Her film credits include a lead role in the First Choice production of 'The Man Who Guards the Greenhouse'. For television, she has appeared in many Radio Canada and CBC productions including 'Les Beaux Dimanches', the annual 'Bye Bye' shows, 'Gala des Prix Gémeaux', 'L'Adisq', and 'Urban Angel'. Rebecca last appeared on stage in Montreal as Teresa in the Bulldog production of 'Italian American Reconciliation'.

DON FINLAYSON (Lighting Designer)

Most recently, Don designed lighting for Vivienne Laxdal's latest work 'Personal Convictions' at the NAC Atelier. Other National Arts Centre lighting design credits include 'Songs from Both Sides of the River', 'Terminal Blues', 'Narrow Road to the Deep North' and 'Valentine Browne'. Other design credits include the Opening Gala for Expo '86 World Festival, Moscow Circus, Judith Marcuse Dance Co., and numerous productions for Toronto Free Theatre, Shaw Festival and Toronto Workshop Productions. His lighting design for the Shaw Festival / Toronto Free co-production of 'Delicatessen' was nominated for a Dora Mavor Moore Award in Toronto. Don makes his home in Ottawa where he is currently Production Director for NAC Theatre.

DEAN HAWES (Danny)

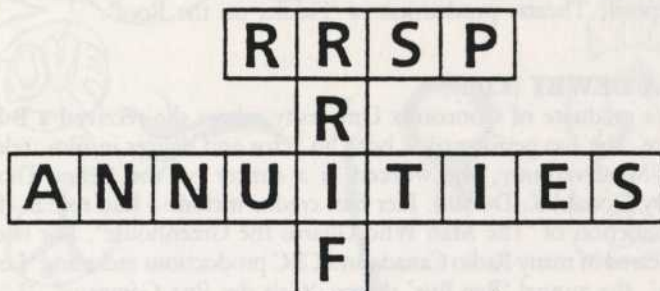

Brooke appeared in The Piggery production of 'Noises Off' at Centaur in 1986, while she was studying at the National Theatre School. Since graduating, she has performed in various cities, playing Shakespeare, title roles in 'Educating Rita' and 'Medea', as well as originating roles in several Canadian works, notably Jhana in Joan MacLeod's 'Toronto Mississippi', for which she was nominated for a Dora Mavor Moore Award in 1987. Brooke has recently appeared in the CBC mini-series 'Conspiracy of Silence' and 'The Valour and the Horror'. She originated the role of Karla at the National Arts Centre's Atelier in Ottawa.

CATHERINE MACKENZIE (Grif)

A resident of Ottawa, Catherine is making her first appearance at Centaur. Most recently, she appeared in Vivienne Laxdal's 'Personal Convictions' at the National Arts Centre's Atelier. Credits for the Great Canadian Theatre Company in Ottawa include 'Lion in the Streets' by Judith Thompson, 'Better Living' by George Walker, and 'The Adventures of Emily Brontesaurus' by Ian Tamblyn. Other Ottawa credits include The Actors' Co-op production of 'Cold Comfort' and the Soaps on Stage production of 'The Vapid, The Vacuous, and The Venomous'.

LYNN MCQUEEN (Stage Manager)

KARLA & GRIF is Lynn's second show this season as Stage Manager in Centaur 1. She recently completed GOODNIGHT DESDEMONA (GOOD MORNING JULIET), and last season, she stage managed THE DEATH OF RENÉ LÉVESQUE and THE AFFECTIONS OF MAY. Previous Centaur credits include GUYS AND DOLLS, THE MURDER OF SUSAN PARR, HANK WILLIAMS: THE SHOW HE NEVER GAVE, and OUR COUNTRY'S GOOD. Lynn was Manager and Assistant Director for Les Productions de la Lune Verte's production of 'Zweiter Berliner Songspiel'. Last summer, Lynn stage managed 'The Perils of Persephone' at The Piggery Theatre.

ELAINE NORMANDEAU (Apprentice Stage Manager)

Upon completion of her law degree in Quebec City, Elaine realized the error of her ways and ran off to join the theatre. A second degree, from Concordia University, was followed by THE DEATH OF RENÉ LÉVESQUE, THE AFFECTIONS OF MAY, and GOODNIGHT DESDEMONA (GOOD MORNING JULIET) at Centaur, for which she worked as an Apprentice Stage Manager. In her spare time, Elaine is Writer Relations Coordinator at Playwrights' Workshop Montreal.

JOHN PALMER (Director)

Since TOOTH OF CRIME for Centaur's Season 5, John Palmer has directed at the Glasgow Citizens' Theatre, the Brooklyn Academy of Music, the Juilliard School, the Stratford Festival, and schools and theatres across Canada. Mr. Palmer is also a playwright. He is currently teaching a Playwrighting Course at York University; and two of his works, 'The End' and 'A Day at the Beach', have recently been released by Coach House Press Publishers, Toronto.

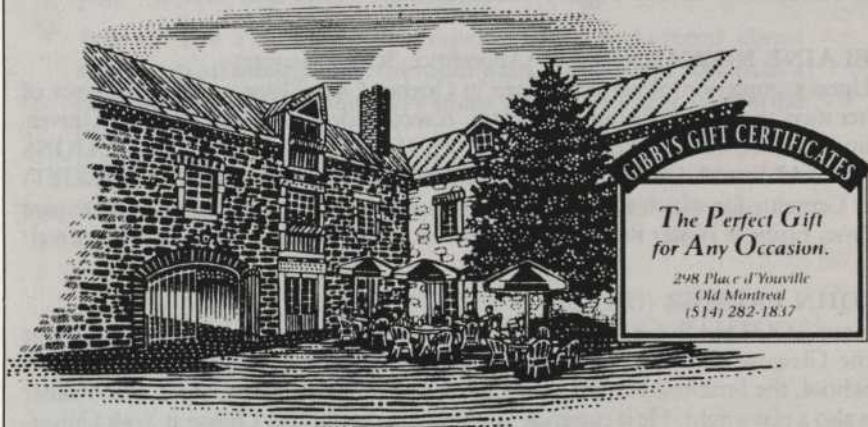
