Generation Rock ready to ambush the airwaves

The ever expanding Sherbrooke radio market just added another contender, Generation Rock 104.5 FM hit the airwaves this week.

While the radio station is still in the early stages, it's already clear that this is one FM station that is nothing like the region has ever seen before. While the area has been missing a 100 percent rock and roll station for quite some time, Generation Rock will also dedicate a significant portion of its air time to talk radio, discussing issues facing the region alongside current election and political talk.

The station is the brainchild of Jean-Pierre Beaudoin, who owns a portion of Generation Rock and doubles as the Director General of the station. For a number of years Beaudoin says he waited on the CRTC to grant him the opportunity for a new rock station.

The process for Generation Rock started three years ago, and Beaudoin is excited at the possibilities as his new station hits the airwaves.

"This is something that I have wanted to be part of for sometime, and it's an exciting time for the station," said Beaudoin this week. "We will have about 39 hours a week of talk radio and take calls from our listeners during that time. We are going to be about one third classic rock, one third modern rock — which I would call rock from the past five to 10 years — and one third current rock that is just being produced."

Beaudoin believes that the Sherbrooke market is ripe for a new rock and roll station and has done the market research to back his investment. He says that 23 per cent of listeners in the Estrie region are actually listening to music that is coming from outside the region, like WHOM 94.9 which covers most of New England and trickles into this region.

"The opportunity is there to win those listeners back, when things outside the market are having such a big effect like that," said Beaudoin of his 1,300-watt station. "We are going to cover the entire region from Coaticook to Weedon, with the best rock from the past three decades and I think that people are going to listen."

The station promises a mix of 65/35 French rock to English rock rotation and features a morning show hosted by Pierre-Yves (Peewhy) Renaud entitled *Debout Sherbrooke*. Marc Bryson will be the sports journalist for the station, while The Boss will host *Un Truck de Rock* and *Le 666* in the afternoon and on weekends. The station also hopes to have an online broadcast available in the coming weeks at its Web site, www.generationrock.fm.

"It's an exciting time right now," concluded Beaudoin, who also doubles as the Director General of Sherbrooke's *Fête du Lac* summer festival. "It has been a lot of hard work to get to this point, but when we first went on the air (Monday) their wasn't a better feeling."

Brazilian appetizers perfect by the pool

I write this as I get ready to pack up and fly off, tomorrow morning, to my native Brazil, for the launch of my recipe book — *Jantares de Mesa e Cama*.

It'll be a truly Brazilian affair, with enough food and drinks for all of the 400 guests (I hope, anyhow)! As my mind wanders off to that side of the world, I can't stop craving my favorite Brazilian beach food, called *Casquinha de Camarão*.

These hearty little appetizers are in-

credibly popular in all regions of that vast tropical country, because it successfully marries three crowd-pleasing ingredients: Shrimp, coconut milk and lime.

And yet it is not too exotic at all for most Canadian palates. Serve it on its own, as a poolside snack on a lazy, sunny Saturday, or as a very elegant appetizer, sure to make a big impression on even the most well-traveled of your friends.

BRAZILIAN SAUTÉED SHRIMP AU GRATIN WITH LIME

For 12 portions

Ingredients:

1 kg shrimp, thawed and deveined

6 limes
2 medium onions,
1 red pepper
1 yellow pepper
5 tomatoes
2 tbsp. finely chopped cilantro
1/2 cup olive oil
2 cups coconut milk
3/4 cup (75 g) bread crumbs
2 tbsps. all-purpose flour
6 limes
salt and pepper

Directions: Peel onions and finely chop. Wash, core and de-seed peppers, and dice them very finely. Sauté the onions and peppers in the olive oil. Once the onions have turned golden, sprinkle the flour over them and stir.

Give two or three minutes so the flour fully dissolves and loses its floury taste.

Wash tomatoes, remove their stems and chop them coarsely. Add them and the coconut milk to the pan and let the liquid dry up a bit, until the mixture thickens to the consistency of a cream.

Add the shrimp and keep on stirring. Spice with salt and pepper. Remove from heat, add cilantro and pour the shrimp mixture into ramekins (small ovenproof ceramic containers). Sprinkle bread crumbs and gratin in the oven until there is a golden crust.

Very important: Serve each portion with at least two wedges of lime.

It's a knife and fork sandwich

The following recipe for a vegetarian main course uses a new caramelized onion sauce as a marinade for vegetables, which are grilled and then stacked between slices of polenta.

It's a knife-and-fork sandwich. Prepared polenta is available in a tube at most grocery stores.

RENEE'S GRILLED VEGETABLE SANDWICH

Serves 4

1 bottle caramelized onion grillin' sauce, divided

1 small tube polenta
1 Italian eggplant
4 portobello mushrooms, stemmed and cleaned
12 fresh basil leaves, plus extra for garnish
2 sweet red bell peppers
1 medium Spanish onion
4.2 ounces (120 grams) goat cheese, divided into 4 equal portions

Directions: Cut ends from eggplant and discard. Slice eggplant into 8 rounds of equal thickness. Slice onion into 1/4-inch rings. Cut eight 1/4-inch (6 mm) slices of polenta.

Marinate vegetables and polenta with half bottle of the sauce, reserving other half for later. Preheat grill to medium-high. Grill polenta for one minute per side and set aside. Grill all vegetables until desired state. Set aside.

This could be done an hour ahead of dinner.

Preheat oven to 350 F (170 C). On a lightly oiled baking pan, make four stacks: one slice of polenta, 1 mushroom cap, 1 onion, some red pepper, the goat cheese, and basil. Place a second slice of polenta on top. Bake for about 10 minutes, until the cheese begins to melt.

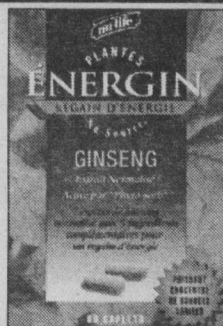
Meanwhile, pour the remaining half-bottle of caramelized onion sauce into a saucepan and simmer, reducing to 1/2 cup (125 mL) about 10 minutes. Plate each sandwich and drizzle reduced sauce over it. Serve, garnished with extra basil leaves.

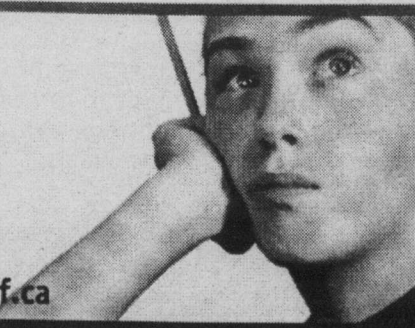

Jennifer Allen Trio goes underground

A sweet-voiced trio of Sherbrooke vocalists is set to offer a unique experience to a small audience... in a subterranean region near you.

The Jennifer Allen Trio, in existence since 1995, has done this before: Last year, on two occasions, the trio performed two subterranean concerts at the Capelton Mine, in a rock-walled room where the lighting is decidedly low-tech.

The trio members, Danielle Carpentier, Suzanne Lafontaine and Danielle Tremblay, were rehearsing on Monday evening, but were happy to take a break to talk with *The Record*.

This is one group whose decidedly non-commercial and friendly approach matches its repertory of songs. Originally known for its medievalist repertory, the Trio has expanded its musical reach to include traditional québécois as well as international folk songs while hanging on to a style that is characterized by polyphony and theatrical innovation.

Which brings us to the mysterious identity of Jennifer Allen. None of the trio members go by that name, so their moniker begs the question: Who is Jennifer Allen?

"She was a woman in theatrical circles, from England," says Lafontaine. "All three of us came to know each other through Jennifer: She died very suddenly in 1994, from cancer — within a week of her diagnosis she was gone. We had all worked very closely with her, doing vocal exploration, ways of liberating the voice and using theatrical means to explore all registers."

Although the trio is well-known for its abilities in a cappella vocalization (they first hit the stage at the Québec Médiéval festival in 1995), many Sherbrooke residents will remember seeing posters advertising the group's concert this past April, in which they performed with three musicians at the Petit Théâtre de Sherbrooke. It may have been a turning point in their career.

"We're definitely at a point in our experience where things are happening, and we're open to change," says Carpentier. "The show in April was a new experience for us: We did solos, duos and we were accompanied by musicians. We love a cappella music, and we enjoy being accompanied as well — we love to do both. But we're definitely moving forward in our repertory."

"We don't want to be pigeonholed as a 'medieval-style group.'"

Adds Tremblay: "We want to do the most a cappella possible in the best possible circumstances. We have important objectives regarding what we wish to create, but not necessarily to market it — but yes, we want to get our music out there."

Tremblay, who was until this spring

musical director of the Choeur Pop de Sherbrooke, is ready for new musical experiences, and all three members are hoping that they will increasingly involve their participation in the Trio.

"We have so many projects — but everything has to be done at our rhythm."

she adds, noting that their ages place them fully in the prime of their careers — they are what she likes to refer to as the "second-youngest of the future guard."

The three singers then offered a musical selection: A Czech folk song from another century, that captured the thoughts of a peasant woman out working in the fields.

Their combined voices sounded like a small choir, and although the words were unfamiliar, there was an unmistakable Eastern European spirit to the rhythm and register "please God, don't let the sun shine too hard on my head and back... my son is faraway in another land, if he doesn't return, what will become of me?"

In addition to international folk songs and the medieval/Renaissance madrigals they have perfected over the years, the Trio wants to incorporate songs from closer to home into their repertory. The music of Gilles Vigneault appears to be particularly suited to their style.

"We use a lot of (vocal) movement in our singing," says Lafontaine. "We have a variety of registers, and we aren't each bound to the role of soprano, alto, and so on."

"Instead, each vocal personality has its place, and we navigate throughout the registers. We also explore different types of sounds, and our repertory enhances this approach."

Not only the repertory, but the underground of the Capleton Mine enhances the Trio's style.

"The mine offers very pure acoustics. The sound comes through very clear and we can hear ourselves and each other perfectly. It's like singing in a chapel," adds Lafontaine. "The ambiance is very somber, with candles lighting it up. And the audience arrives in wagons. It's an experience where you place yourself inside of the sound and it becomes very mystical, even a little magical."

The Jennifer Allen Trio will present their concert at the Capleton Mine on Saturday, June 5 at 8 p.m. The mine is located at 800 route 108 (Capleton Road) in North Hatley, and the number to call for reservations is 819-346-9545 (only about 60 places are available).

Organizers suggest audience members dress warmly, as the temperature underground is approximately 10-12 C.

Loverboy to headline Fête du Lac

There are a few changes, but all in all, it's the same Fête du Lac des Nations Sherbrooke will once again host this summer. That's a good thing, after discussions last year about the fate of the festival, which was suffering from an operating deficit.

The 2003 edition was a good one, aided by the IAAF World Youth Track and Field Championships, with 148,000 attending the six-day fireworks and music festival at Jacques-Cartier park. This year's edition, which runs from July 13 to 18, has the usual formula: Rock concerts on the Molson Dry Live stage, jazz and blues on the Loto-Québec terrace, and music for more sophisticated tastes at the SAQ Bistro. There's also the rides and a children's park, this year featuring performances by Ronald McDonald.

New this year is the Skateboard KC Project. The competition, which tours Quebec, has moved its annual Sherbrooke stop on to the festival grounds in a bid by organizers to provide more entertainment for teens coming to the site.

Eighties rockers Honeymoon Suite and Loverboy, who have been on a

comeback/reunion tour most of the spring, will hit the festival on Wednesday, July 14, as the pre- and post-fireworks shows on the Molson Dry Live stage respectively.

As well, the festival will feature performances by La Chicane, Sherbrooke punk band Les Respectables, Andrée Waters, Vincent Vallières, Plume, Seffie Shock, Ariane Moffat with special guests Daniel Bélanger and Marc Déry, comedy group Les Denis Drolet and André-Philippe Gagnon, the man of a 1,000 voices.

The secondary stages will feature Dorothée Berryman, Ensemble Montréal Tango, who were a hit at last year's festival, Pat The White, and the Stephan Bary Band, as well as many others.

As well, the organizers have added even more family value, with a new skateboard competition and special passports to the entire festival for teens.

Also new this year are the giant puppets from La belle perdrix verte that will be on scene, giving workshops on puppet construction and providing entertainment.

Family passports, which are good for two adults and two children for the six-day festival, are \$65, available at McDonald's locations in Sher-

Five questions with Yvonne Gosselin

Q & A

Yvonne Gosselin is proud to be considered a member of the Eastern Township art community. Although she divides her time between her residence in Montreal and her family home in North Hatley, anyone looking at her work will soon realize that her true love is for North Hatley and the surrounding region. Gosselin is currently displaying her work at the North Hatley Library in unison with work by North Hatley's "Group of Seven".

Recently *The Record* sat down with Yvonne Gosselin to discuss her passion for art and the importance of preserving that all important 'moment in time':

THE RECORD: How did you get started as an artist?

GOSSELIN: "I guess I always had a tendency to create things in my mind's eye. I remember when I was a child, my mother would send me to my room as a punishment, but, little did she know, I didn't regard it as a bad thing. I would pass my time staring at the cracks in my wood ceiling and envision all sorts of shapes and scenarios. I remember entering a contest sponsored by the SPCA when I was only 10 years old. My prize was a set of everything I would need to get me started as an artist. I have been painting ever since. I guess you could say that is when I really became more serious about my work."

THE RECORD: What is your medium of choice?

GOSSELIN: "I began painting in oil,

but then I became allergic to something in the turpentine mix that I used to clean my brushes with. So I changed to using watercolours to create my work. I am tempted to try again one of these days; maybe they have changed the recipe for the turpentine. As long as I can continue to paint in some way, I'm happy!"

THE RECORD: Am I correct in assuming that North Hatley is one of your favourite subjects to paint?

GOSSELIN: "North Hatley to me is as important as taking a breath of air. Someone who is a musician lives for his/her music, I breathe colours and art. There is something special about the area and the people who live here. Even though I spend part of my time in the Montreal area, I just have to return to North Hatley on a regular basis — like recharging a battery. I'm just not happy unless I feel connected to this wonderful place. It is like something seems to be missing in my life!"

THE RECORD: Where do you get your ideas for your paintings?

GOSSELIN: "Sometimes I work from pictures but mostly from my mind's eye. Someday I would like to try working with live models. I like to paint many different subjects. Sometimes I choose them for sentimental reasons or sometimes for historical value. It is so important to capture these moments in time. They will never happen or exist again. Paintings and photographs are a way of preserving our special moments and architecture for those in our future to enjoy — like the Capleton and East

Angus bridges. I worked especially hard on the view of the center of North Hatley. If that makes me a perfectionist, that's fine, but when something means as much to me as the North Hatley area, it has to be just right!"

THE RECORD: You have mentioned two other things that you are very passionate about. Would you tell us about

them?

GOSSELIN: "I enjoy working with children. Whether I am teaching art to them or working with autistic children, I find it so rewarding, exhausting at times, but very rewarding. I also adore animals and thoroughly love the fact that you can scold them and they will never scold you back!"

Fahrenheit 9/11 too hot for Disney

Michael Moore's explosive documentary *Fahrenheit 9/11* has been pulled from the Disney pyre and will hit theatres this summer thanks to a new distribution deal with Lions Gate Films, the company founded in 1997 by Vancouver's Frank Giustra.

But this isn't a case of Canadians riding to Moore's rescue — again.

Unlike Moore's *Bowling for Columbine*, which was produced through Canada's Salter Street Films, *Fahrenheit 9/11* found new life when Miramax founders Bob and Harvey Weinstein re-acquired the rights to the film after Disney, Miramax's corporate owners, refused to give it a theatrical release.

Once in the hands of the Weinsteins' new company, Fellowship Adventure Group, Moore's film found new distribu-

tion partners in Lions Gate and IFC Films. The film will be released in the United States on June 25.

Canadian distribution of the film has yet to be confirmed, but the Canadian releasing arm of Lions Gate may steal it away from rival Alliance Atlantis, which previously had the rights to distribute the film through a deal with Miramax.

"I can't comment on what will happen to the Canadian rights," said Peter Wilkes, corporate spokesman for Lions Gate Entertainment.

"All I can tell you is that we see *Fahrenheit 9/11* as an important movie from a brilliant and creative filmmaker. Lions Gate has a strong track record for showcasing creative talent regardless of the content, and this falls in line with the tradition that includes *Monster's Ball*, *Irreversible* and *Dogma*."

As for the Canadian angle on the

Lions Gate deal, Wilkes says the company is not distinctly Canadian, or American.

"We feel we have a strong identity in both countries," he said.

Although Lions Gate continues to trade publicly in Canada and owns Lions Gate Studios (formerly North Shore Studios, a large soundstage facility in Vancouver), the majority of the company's executive power resides in Los Angeles.

Former CEO Guistra left the

company several years ago, and the only remaining Canadian executive is chairman Andre Link, who lives in Montreal.

An art that is old as the wheel

One of the advantages of paying attention to the world of the arts is to discover the existence of art forms that one couldn't have imagined — that is, unless one sits down and contemplates the form of a pole, or a wheel axle, for example. Then it becomes obvious that the practice had to exist.

Wood turning is a perfect example of a practice where art and craft meet — where form and function are synonymous and where necessity can sometimes turn into fantasy.

It's not easy to say exactly when man started producing cylindrical objects from wood. Little evidence is left from our distant ancestors — because wood decays very quickly compared to stone and iron.

However, logic dictates that once humans discovered the advantage of

rolling motion instead of pulling/pushing, then their desire for round objects grew. In all probability this was around 3,500-3,000 BC, about the time when the wheel was invented in the country that today we call Iraq.

And for everyone out there whose surname is Turner (or Tournier, Turney, Dornier, Durner, Tarnier, Ternier or Tourneau for that matter), they need to know that it's another one of those occupational names that means "one who works with a lathe" — doing wood turning.

Luc Ducharme of Deauville is co-ordinator of the Estrie chapter of the Quebec Association for Wood Turners (l'Association des Tourneurs sur Bois). He wants to make it known that wood turning "is much more than just making poles, or salad bowls. This is an art form that people generally aren't aware of."

So he has proposed a weekend where wood turners from all over the province

will gather for conferences and training sessions on Saturday, June 5, and the public is invited the following day to view the variety of art and craft works made by wood turners using a panoply of instruments: Gouges, termites, scrapers, and others.

"In Quebec, art has just begun to take its place," says Ducharme. "In Europe, many different art forms are well-known and widely practiced, but here we're just starting to share our knowledge among individual craftspeople and artists."

One of the subjects at hand is how to recognize different species of wood from their grain, and how to work them. In wood turning, an advantage over other crafts involving wood is that the turner can work with "green" wood as well as with dry wood. Among the best types of local wood, Ducharme enjoys working with cherry wood and a

local species known in French as "vinaigrier", or sumac.

Among the pleasures of the wood turner, says Ducharme, is "the artistic side of turning. You get to know the wood very intimately, by its shape, its knots and its colours, sometimes a melding of two or three colours that is unique to a given piece of wood."

Ducharme notes that many accomplished turners will be on hand to demonstrate their works and to talk about the kinds of materials and tools they use.

"Wood turning dates back to prehistoric times," he affirms. "And even today, it's not at all about automatic machines."

The Association of Wood Turners will display its works to the public on Sunday, June 6 at the Centre Récréatif in Rock Forest, from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Admission is \$2 per person.

Celtic Way gears up for summer tourists

Summer is around the corner and so are the downhomers, those special Eastern Townshipers from the Inverness, Kinnear's Mills, St-Agathe and Thetford Mines areas who like to go back to where they came from.

Smack in the middle of this visiting frenzy is the Celtic Way historical tourist project. Co-ordinator Marie-Eve Adams says those wanting a more historical context to their visit to the area can learn a lot from their walking tours and the Celtic Way store.

"Inverness was one of the first settlements in the townships for many people of Scottish and Irish backgrounds," she said.

"One of our goals here is to preserve that pioneer history and make it come alive again for downhomers and other visitors."

The project offers walking tours of the town and the surrounding area, including historic buildings and monuments that represent the pioneering past.

A new walking tour offered this summer is a 2-km path behind the present day Bronze Museum (formerly the first area courthouse) that leads up a small hill to a belvedere at the tree line of the nearby forest.

"From the belvedere, you can see most of Inverness," said Adams.

"This path also brings the visitor through the field where many area residents came to on Sunday afternoons for local political and community debates.

"It was a perfect spot for local leaders to ponder the questions of the day and sometimes of the province or the nation, while looking over the town that they loved."

Adams said the tours can be set up based on the number of people who want one. She said the project is flexible within reason.

"We can just sell maps and let the visitors make their own quest, or we can have walking tours through town or bus tours throughout the area," she said. "We plan to have guides ready for whatever request is made."

Some of the sites being offered on the maps and the tours include past and present churches, the two bronze shops, the bronze museum, the Inverness Academy (now a private home), the famed Lysander Falls and the former Chicken Coop dance hall.

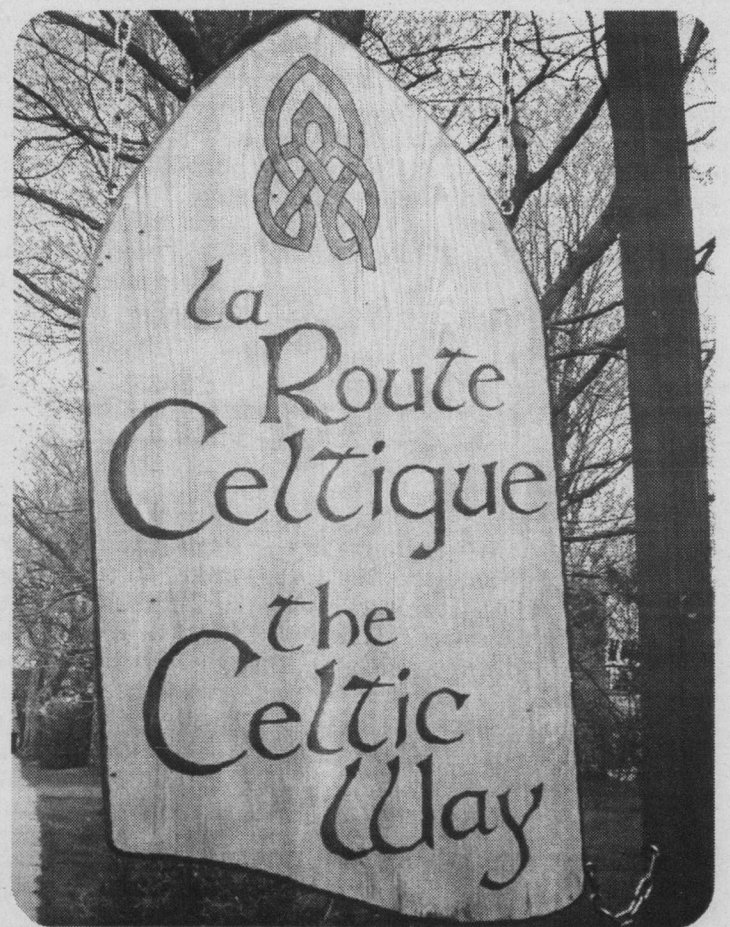
At the store, recreations of Celtic artifacts are presented for sale, including a bust of King Arthur's magician Merlin, tribal combat masks, ceremonial daggers and swords, keepsakes, jewelry and various stone carvings and clay plates.

Adams said the store, located on Gosford Rd. in town across from the Anglican church, could also be the site of a future tea room in the back.

"We also have an old garage in the back that, with some work, can be used as an artisan shop," she said.

"The idea is to show visitors what local people were capable of — from making furniture and shoes to metal works and weaving."

Apart from tours, the Celtic Way also provides information on smaller historical sites of the area, many of which were small hamlets long since abandoned for the larger towns and cities. They include Milanville, Asserfey, Clapham, Bullard's brook and Lipsey's Hill. Books on the area's history are available, which document the existence of the native Abenaki Indians, the arrival of the settlers and the continued tradition of the annual Orange picnic, held the nearest day to July 12 in the MacRae grove

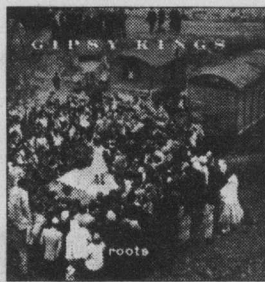

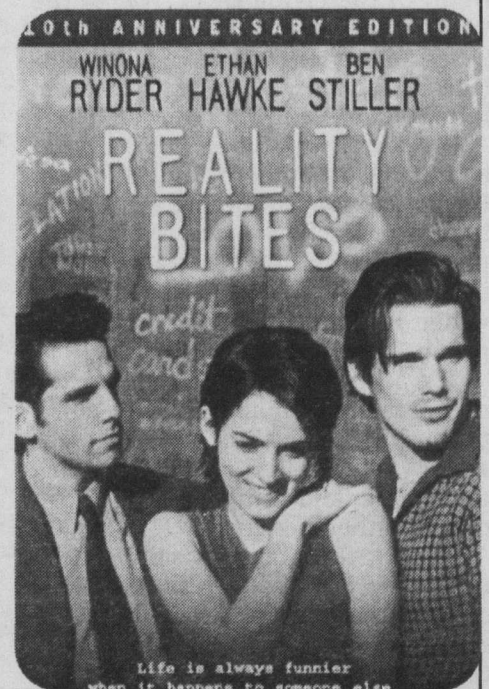

Koontz thriller guaranteed to shock and horrify

There's the luminous, almost sexually scented rain, fearful coyotes crowding onto the isolated farm porch in the dead of night and a mountain-sized starship vibrating overhead. But for some readers, the most unnerving element in Dean Koontz's latest thriller may be the injection-moulded doll.

When this machine-made, painted minikin in pink pedal pushers breaks into tears in *The Taking* (Random House, \$38), sits up at the bar and declares "Hungry. Eat," it finally sinks in that the fate of the world is at stake.

The war of the worlds is upon us and there's nowhere to hide. Koontz makes sure of that as he invites fans into this twilight zone with a story guaranteed to shock and horrify.

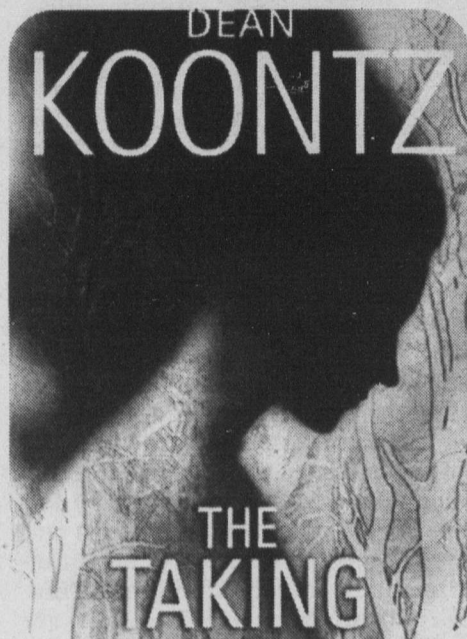
While *Odd Thomas*, with its "I can see dead people" motif, was a leap of faith for the meteoric author earlier this spring, fans — and the bestsellers lists — mostly gave it two thumbs up.

The Taking is part *Alien Invasion*, *Night of the Living Dead*, *War of the Worlds* and *Twilight Zone*. Koontz clearly has come a long way from his psychological blockbuster of a few years ago, *False Memory*.

His story, which begins in a farmhouse high in Southern California's San Bernardino before shifting to the nearby town of Black Lake, stars a young couple, Molly and Neil Sloan — she an insomniac and self-described failed writer; he a failed minister turned carpenter.

The September night is beset by torrential rain, a luminous, scented downpour that leaves Molly heavy with anxiety, pushes Neil into a screaming nightmare, and brings dozens of coyotes onto their porch.

Satellite-feeds on television tell horror stories of flooding along the west coast of the Americas, then across Europe, Asia, Africa and the Middle East. Giant waterspouts, miles wide, feed the rains that lay waste huge parts of the world. When the International Space



Station is attacked by unknown forces, the world finally realizes this is no natural catastrophe. It's an invasion.

Communications systems die, electrical appliances take on a life of their own, clocks spin crazily, computers spew hieroglyphics and ideograms from unknown languages, CD players roar exotic, discordant music without being plugged in and, finally, power grids fail, plunging the world, and Black Lake, into darkness and anarchy.

Koontz focuses on Black Lake, cut off from the besieged world as the small community prepares to fight for its own survival against an unseen enemy that can morph through walls and control any mind.

As Neil and Molly hunker down at the local bar with a disparate group of locals who are torn between battling the invaders or accepting their fate, the couple decides, instead, to fight for the community's children.

This apocalypse at Black Lake is certainly the most unusual Koontz tale fans will ever have read. Unlike *Odd Thomas*, which the author describes as "a gift to me" that "entered his mind already a finished piece" and drew ecstatic reaction from publishers and editors around the world, but didn't set the lists on fire, Koontz is hoping *The Taking* may have the heft to break Dan Brown's grip on the bestsellers lists and send his *Da Vinci Code* packing.

At least seven of Koontz's novels have made the *New York Times* list, a feat shared by only nine other authors in the world. His book sales too are reaching into the stratosphere, with more than 200 million sold and 17 million more a year adding to that total.

Book captures spirit of Johnny Cash

"He was a Baptist with the soul of a mystic. He was a poet who worked in the dirt. He was an enlightened being who was wracked with the suffering of addiction and grief," Rosanne Cash writes of her father, Johnny, in the foreword to *Rolling Stone's* coffee table tribute *Cash*.

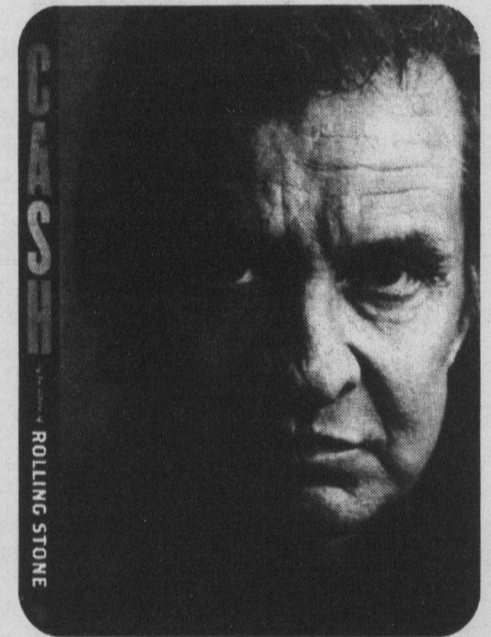
"He was real, whole and more alive to the subtleties of this world and the worlds beyond than anyone I have ever known or even heard of. He was the stuff of dreams, and the living cornerstone of our lives."

It's nearly impossible, in any number of words, to explain everything the late Johnny Cash was during his remarkable life, but his daughter's foreword and the *RS* editors, through words and pictures, come as close as could reasonably be expected in *Cash*.

Writer and author Mikal Gilmore remembers a "man who had always represented courage and dignity" speaking with him by phone the day after Gilmore's brother, Gary, a convicted murderer, was put to death. Gary had sought the execution and it was Cash, upon hearing of the request, who had tried to change his mind. Having failed, he asked Mikal to call him.

"I'm sorry for what has happened," Cash said in his trademark growl. "I know how much this must hurt right now, but I hope in time you can find some peace. Our prayers are with you."

Elsewhere, *Rolling Stone* contributors and editors, including David Fricke, Anthony DeCurtis, the late Ralph J. Gleason and Jason Fine (whose interview with Cash less than a year before the music legend died is printed here) lovingly investigate and explain Cash's



complicated life and legendary music.

From one page to the next he's cavorting with Elvis, embracing his wife June, being led away in handcuffs, playing on stage in San Quentin, and frolicking in the pool with his children.

Chicago Tribune music critic Greg Kot assembles an exhaustive discography, while tributes from friends and peers such as Bob Dylan, Jerry Lee Lewis, Bono, Merle Haggard and even Al Gore are also appended. The last word is left to the man in black himself:

"I love songs about horses, railroads, land, Judgment Day, family, hard times, whiskey, courtship, marriage, adultery, separation, murder, war, prison, rambling, damnation, home, salvation, death, pride, humour, piety, rebellion, patriotism, larceny, determination, tragedy, rowdiness, heartbreak and love. And Mother. And God."

Potter movie is darker and more mature *Movies*

The latest Harry Potter movie starts with Harry (Daniel Radcliffe), having grown from pre-adolescent wizard into a 13-year-old magician of near-adult promise, hiding under the covers of his bed, illicitly playing with his magic wand.

Now, while it doesn't pay to read too much into the various symbols and metaphors that present themselves in family movies, it is clear that we are dealing with something of a coming-of-age story in Harry Potter and the Prisoner of Azkaban.

As directed by Alfonso Cuarón — who earlier brought us the slightly more lurid coming-of-Latino-age film, *Y Tu Mama Tambien* — Azkaban is a darker entry in the Harry Potter canon, and a fuller one. Magic wands remain pretty much as magic wands in the movie, but there is something spookier in the air, and it's not all testosterone.

Azkaban is Chapter 3 in a story that has become so familiar it is beginning to play like myth. In parts one and two, we met the orphan magician with a mysterious past that involved dead parents and a supernatural future that involved the wonders of Hogwarts school for young wizards. Now it is time for the tale to really begin.

Harry Potter and the Prisoner of Azkaban assumes we're up to speed on the tale. It skips past all that and puts us into the adolescent world of a young man who is ready to take his place in the world.

Gone is most of the charming gimmickery, the toot-toot Victoriana, of the earlier movies. Instead, we get monsters and werewolves and a story of a son's revenge on the killer of his parents. Like all fantasy — and most murder mysteries — Harry Potter finds its answers in the long ago.

We start with a bit of comeuppance. Finally fed up with the avarice and thudding overeating of his guardians, Harry inflates his Aunt Marge into the hot air balloon she so fully resembles and sends her floating over the never-landscape of suburban England. Our lit-

tle boy is all grown up.

Harry then runs off to London with the aid of purple three-decker bus that has the magic ability to squeeze itself into tight spots. The Harry Potter stories have always had a Dickensian sense of the big city and the mean relatives who send one there, and these opening scenes are filled with imaginative characters and hunchbacked menace.

Back at Hogwarts, the big news is that Sirius Black (Gary Oldman), a convict linked to the death of Harry's parents, has escaped from jail and has Harry in his sights. This is both serious and black, and Hogwarts is being guarded by giant Dementors, caped creatures that sneak up and suck the soul right out of you unless you can toss up good memories to fend them off. They're good and bad, like much in Harry Potter.

There's a message here somewhere,

but the film doesn't linger: Azkaban plays like a junior-league Lord of the Rings, with creatures and magical powers being thrown in wherever they're needed. Cuarón showcases the monsters and lets the tropes take care of themselves.

Harry seems to be the main target of Sirius, being the last of his line, but meanwhile, there are the day-to-day lessons to absorb. The magic of Hogwarts has become matter-of-factly inventive: Ghostly horses and giraffes run through study hall; pictures on the wall yell at you; and a marvelous new creature, a half-horse-half-bird called a Hippogriff, flies realistically over the magnificent countryside, more exciting — and more grown-up — than any Quidditch game.

The backbone of the Harry Potter stories is still in place, but it is starting to seem beside the point and shopworn. Malfoy, the school bully, has become a

minor irritant. The spooky Prof. Snape (Alan Rickman) is back to confuse us as to which side he's on, but he also seems retrograde in Harry's new world.

Hermione (Emma Watson) is also back, but contrary to expectations, her relation with Harry and Ron (Rupert Gint) has not turned romantic, although that seems to be on the horizon.

More important in the tale is Harry's new goal of coming to terms with his family past. Harry Potter is still a film for children — although the scary monsters may be too much for the youngest fans — but in Radcliffe's maturing face and demeanor we see a franchise that is moving toward the kind of reconciliation that made the Star War series mythic.

In this third film, Harry has been reinvented as a fantasy that moves into deeper woods, where the real frights lurk.

Pat Green is finally turning some heads

Music

Many people were surprised to see Pat Green nominated for New Male Vocalist of the Year at the recent Academy of Country Music Awards (ACMA).

Some critics think he has not been around long enough to get a nomination, while those who follow country music really closely know that Green should have also been nominated before this year.

Wave on Wave is actually Green's second major label release. His previous album, Three Days, debuted on The Billboard Country Albums Chart at number 7 and it stayed there for over a year.

The San-Antonio-born singer has no problems filling arenas in Texas where he is already a legend. In fact, Green has been releasing albums and playing his unique and energetic country-folk-rock style since the mid-90s and has managed to create a nice, huge base of fans.

His last three shows in Houston were attended by over 134,000 people. The singer/songwriter was already doing pretty good in his own state before he signed with Republic/Universal.

Now what is good about that deal is that Green's music is being brought to more people. He wrote or co-wrote 12 of the 13 songs found on Wave on Wave.

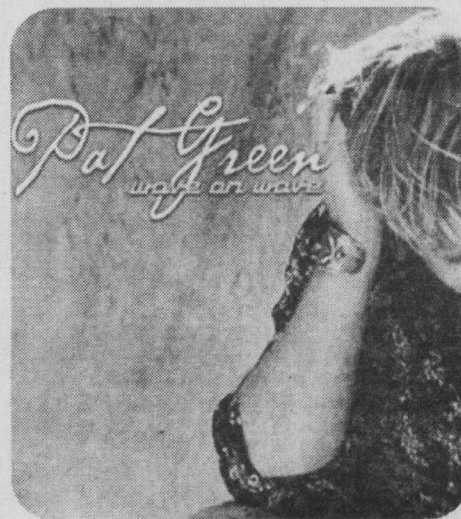
Green's style presents many similarities with the style of another great artist, Robert Earl Keen. His material stands on its own and his edgy voice and vibrant performances are appealing.

From start to finish, Wave on Wave offers straightforward lyrics, charming melodies and great musicianship. Most of the numbers are extremely catchy which makes it a collection you want to listen to, over and over.

A lot of the songs are about matters of the heart. Love of course is a topic artists can write about indefinitely.

'Guy Like Me' is about a man who is concerned that love won't find him soon. There's also the beautiful 'Poetry' about Green's view of the world.

On 'California,' Green finds himself in Los Angeles, longing for his Texas home. There's also the dark and surpris-



ing 'If I Was The Devil', about the Prince of Darkness plotting ways to scare children, kill livestock and corrupt preachers.

It is an unusual but interesting song that sounds like an old Ozark folk song. It features a Green-Ray Wylie Hubbard duet.

'Sing 'Til I Stop Crying' and 'Run' are songs dealing with the ups and downs of life and love. There are also songs about falling out of love and hitting the bottle.

This is the perfect example of Green exploiting classic country musical themes.

Green invites fellow singers Willie Nelson, Waylon Payne, Trish Murthy and Ray Benson — all Texans like him — to share vocal duties on the fun and funky 'Elvis.' The vocal collaboration proves to be interesting for listeners.

For fans who have been following Green's career closely, they will notice he has strayed away from his typical brand of Texas country music based on going to parties, drinking beer and just having fun.

But Green — since his last album — has matured musically and in his private life as well. The topics are now a little different.

Artistically, the musician has made a giant step toward more mainstream country, but he is still faithful to his roots.

The title track, 'Wave On Wave,' offers one of the album's great moments, set to a rock-laced guitar arrangement and produced by Tony Brown himself. It is also the current single of the album.

I can honestly recommend the album. It is a great addition to your collection of country records.
