Drummondville Welcomes the World

The world is about to arrive on Drummondville's doorstep.

Organizers are preparing to kick off the 28th annual festival Mondial des Cultures, where culture from around the world will take the stage for 11 days of entertainment, starting July 9 and running until the 19th.

Every year, the festival pulls together hundreds of artists, musicians and dancers from the four corners of Quebec and beyond; this year's line-up will highlight the tradition and folklore of the Ivory Coast, Scotland, Ecuador, Hungary, Israel and Serbia, to name a few.

The festival comes to life on the streets of downtown Drummondville on July 9 at 7:00 p.m., when the Défilé International presents a number of folk group performances. Crowds can move on to the Parc Woodyatt for the 11:00 p.m. musical pyrotechnic display known as Bal des Nations, which is free of charge.

Visitors to this year's festivities can participate in workshops on anything from martial arts to hoop dancing, ethnic cooking classes, a beauty salon, face-painting as well as multi-cultural spiritual celebrations.

Besides the traditional world music that will fill the festival's programming every day, music enthusiasts can catch more familiar acts like Mackinaw, Kain, Chloé Saint-Marie and Harry Manx.

The festival's closing event will host Mystika Circus on its main stage July 19.

Mondial des cultures was the recipient of one of the 2007 Grands Prix du tourisme Québécois. Last year's programming drew some 300,000 spectators.

Festival-goers can purchase an open pass for the 11-day schedule in advance for \$25 or next week at the gate for \$30 per person.

One-day entry is \$17 per person and children under 12 are admitted free.

Countdown to the Eclectic Carnival ShazamFest

The countdown has begun for the fourth annual eclectic and original summer festival, ShazamFest.

In just 21 days the diversity of arts and entertainment is celebrated in a three-day long unique family event with a carnival-like atmosphere nestled in a natural amphitheatre.

ShazamFest is the brainchild of organizer Ziv Przytyk and his brother Sasha who host the event on their family's organic farm, Shazam Farm, in Way's Mills, West Barnston.

"Basically I started this to have a place where we could showcase local artists and artists people wouldn't often see in a rural setting," said Przytyk. "It's a little bit of everything; some (artists) little known and some are very well known. I was trying to get people to do art on site but it's not happening this year, maybe next."

A clothing designer by trade, Przytyk has had an interesting background in the arts. He operated an art gallery for four years in Ayer's Cliff and now does renovations when he is not working on the festival.

"I work on the festival six months out of the year. I would really like to be doing this all the time," said Przytyk, who self-funds the event. "I've invested my own money into this, the entertainment costs \$10 grand alone, and advertising is about five grand and another five grand for materials. I usually spend the next six months paying it off. But this is how I can offer the tickets for \$50. Try to find another weekend festival in Quebec for that cost."

The reasonable ticket price helps ShazamFest, a non-profit organization, to cover the entertainment and security costs. They receive no funding from the

government but Przytyk hopes that will change next year. The wild weekend draws in crowds from all over who stay at the 25 acres of on-site camping, while enjoying a diverse line-up of entertainment and musicians, like Nils Maetof who comes from as far away as Denmark.

"We have people from Western and Eastern Canada and friends from Europe and the northern States come in," said Przytyk. "I'd say eighty percent of the crowd come from the Montreal and Sherbrooke area."

In its first year, ShazamFest drew in a modest crowd of 400, the following year word spread and it hosted about 700 visitors. Last year, the festival was rained out but if the sun is shining Przytyk hopes

many more will come and he will finally break his attendance record allowing the event to start funding itself.

"If its beautiful weather we could get 1,000 easily," he said. "I can fit up to 2,500 if I had to. Wouldn't that be nice."

Despite the large crowds Przytyk says he's never had a problem.

"Not one complaint or one incident," he said. "I invited the cops in the first year but we haven't felt the need to have them back. I'm very good at controlling crowds. You don't let things escalate."

The festival site is vital to its ethereal and festive feeling. Set in a wonderful natural amphitheatre surrounded by forest bordering the Niger River the site was once used by the area's First Nations peoples. Now it has morphed into a tiny village with a well to provide fresh water and seasonal structures built by Przytyk and friends.

"We try to get as much stuff as possible locally," said Przytyk. "It's important for us to work locally to make this event something we can all be part of."

The structures include a massive main stage, rustic Shazam Bar-Saloon including a smaller second stage, monster skateboarding ramp, a gourmet Organic Kitchen, and the Shazam Burger hut. Shazam Farm's vision of biodiversity dic-

tates that the event be run in a sustainable manner. In order to generate little waste and keep the site unspoiled for the future the three R's - reduce, reuse and recycle - are applied in every way.

"We recycle everything. It makes the site easier to clean up," said Przytyk. "I don't serve anything on plastic. When people order something they are given dishes they have to wash and reuse for the weekend."

The event includes kids' activities including circus workshops and juggling, a farmer's market and a variety of on-site artisans and local vendors. Featured musicians include many locals and imported talent such as the progressive rock group Metao, swing rock musings of Réjean Turbide and the hard rock explosion of Pete Möss. From reggae to rock, jazz to bluegrass.

Unique to the festival is the Shazam Karaoke Idol contest and the Jam@Shazam big trick skateboarding competition. Workshops are also scheduled, Micheal Jensen will host a circus and unicycle workshops and master knife smith Dave Macdonald will teach the finer points of forging. Diverse acts are also on the menu, such as Montréal's Hoop Troup that will present incredible acrobatic stunts, the Eastern Townships Wrestling Association will host extreme sport displays and Dead Dolls Burlesque, also from Montreal, will dazzle the adult crowd late into the evening.

"I went to lots of festivals growing up so you could say I got my master's in festivals," said Przytyk. "It's a hippie kind of event. I try not to push that forward because it's not what I want it to be. To me it's more of an exchange."

For Przytyk his vision has been building over the last few years and he says the event is truly something that must be experienced by all.

"I'm doing something I love doing," he said. "I love working with people and it's important to me that we combine all walks of life and it's amazing we get such a mix of people". Even though this year's event hasn't yet started, Przytyk is already thinking ahead for next year. "I want to improve on the kids stuff and on offering more workshops," he said.

ShazamFest is scheduled for July 24, 25 and 26 at the "Shazam Farm" located on 2722 Ch. de Way's Mills, in West Barnston. For more information on tickets, call 819-580-4118 or visit www.shazamfest.com.

We all enjoyed having such a well-run club. We took it for granted, like young kids who say "Ma, what's for supper? Dad, can you drive me to the arena? I need new shoes," etc., etc.

But we were not kids, so how come nobody ever thought to say thank you to Bill and Dora, who were doing it for the love of the game, not making a cent, and giving us all a place we could go and play bridge. I offer sincere and belated thanks to them now, two of the nicest people I have ever known.

At CIDI, we have a whole lot of people working behind the scenes, making the station run and the shows sound good. Dewey Durrell is the president, but he also spends many hours at the station, working in the office, answering the phone, attending meetings and early one Sunday morning, he came racing to Knowlton to open the doors for Maurice, who had forgotten his keys.

His wife Marilyn helped organize the CIDI party in March and regularly sends in a batch of freshly baked muffins every week. David Anderson is our photographer, Eric Wabant creates wonderful websites, Chuck Christie is a whiz at

selling ads for our much needed revenue, Bob Farnham and his wife Deborah Williams come in every week to do the books, Ralf Bushenbaum provides accounting services, Charles O'Brien legal advice and Tanya Tkach comes to help out in the office from time to time. All these invisible yet very essential people working behind the scenes, we gotta thank them for letting us be who we are, before it's too late.

Being who we are is CIDI, lots of great shows, lots of wonderful hosts and terrific volunteers. Give us a listen, send us your comments and suggestions, we always want to hear from you all and play the stuff you want to hear.

Your nose is too big. Most people wouldn't notice, but you do. And when you look in a mirror, your eyes are like two tiny marbles in a pile of dough, and your hair is just... ugh. Everybody tells you how gorgeous your smile is, but you're pretty sure they're just being nice. You even hate your ears, if that's possible.

Don't even start on your thighs or your tush.

Do you ever wish someone had a magic wand and would - poof! - make you look like a model? In the new book *B as in Beauty* by Alberto Ferreras, a young woman wants exactly that, but she has other lessons to learn first.

As if being fat wasn't enough, Beauty Maria Zavala's Cuban-born parents saddled her with a name that definitely didn't fit. Beauty is willing to acknowledge the fat - it's kind of hard to hide - but the name? Not so much. She tells everyone to just call her B. It avoided so much embarrassment.

And as if being fat and having a weird name wasn't the end of it all, B has a rotten job. For several years, she's killed herself to do a good job for her evil boss, Bonnie, in the hopes of getting a nice, fat promotion and a corner office. But when B overhears a nasty conversation in the ladies' room, she realizes that 's never going to happen.

B hates her job.

So when a Russian tax preparer hands her a business card and calls her "beautiful", well, who could resist calling?

Much like a Fairy Godmother, the Russian woman offers B a new life, with a twist: some men would clearly see past the drab clothes and severe hairdo, and they'd pay to spend time with B. No strings attached. No sex. No long-term involvement.

Cautiously, B takes the job. Then another. And another.

Soon, she sees that her body is worthy of worship. Her shape isn't pleasingly plump, it's just pleasing. Clothes don't have to be drab and curly Latina

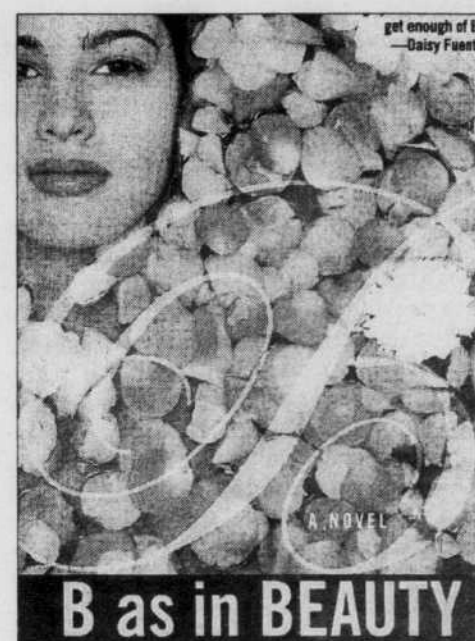
hair doesn't have to be tamed. And a mousy formerly-fat girl really can find happiness by embracing her wonderful name.

Oh, my, but I loved this book.

With a perfectly sweet and funny heroine, a few ugly "sisters", a borderline-criminal fairy godmother, a handsome carriage driver, a flock of flawed and unwitting helpers, and the most unlikely Prince Charming, author Alberto Ferreras has crafted a modern fairy tale that is absolutely irresistible.

Beauty Zavala is the kind of character you wish was real, just so you could borrow some of her attitude. It's hard not to feel sad for her predicament, it's easy cheer for her new-found self-confidence, and her slam-dunk revenge is the kind of stuff that Hollywood loves. Real, unstilted dialogue makes this book an even bigger joy to read.

If you're wondering what to pack in your suitcase or overnighter this summer, stop looking and just get this book. For anyone who loves a happy ending, "B as in Beauty" is positively magic.

The Vermont-Quebec Border: Life on the Line

"From Ottawa or Washington this international community is something that can not possibly exist officially. But it does still exist at the community and personal level. Our fire departments [...] stand ready at all times to assist one another. Our churches and service clubs see no border when someone is in need. We all have friends and relatives on both sides of the border and few of us ever think of the other as a Vermonter or a Quebecer. This is as it should be, and how it can be if we can keep the bureaucrats out of our lives."

So begins the preface to chapter 1 of a new book by **Matthew Farfan**. The title of the book is *The Vermont-Quebec Border: Life on the Line*, Arcadia's latest release in its

"Images of America" series.

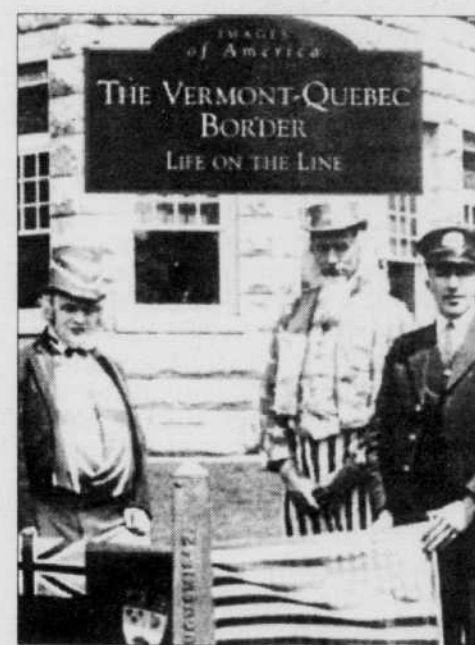
The Vermont-Quebec Border: Life on the Line is a visual record of life in the villages, towns, and countryside in a unique part of the world - the region that spans the imaginary line separating Quebec from Vermont. This book is timely. In recent years, issues relating to the border have been thrust to the forefront as never before. This is due not only to growing security concerns but also to an increasing scrutiny in the media of border issues and of how heightened security is impacting life in communities all along the border. The border has played an important role in the history and the everyday lives of people living along its length - in communities in both Vermont and Quebec, and it will undoubtedly continue to shape these communities in the years to come.

The Vermont-Quebec Border: Life on the Line includes about 200 rare early images from northern Vermont and the Eastern Townships of Quebec. The book

offers insights on a range of issues, including customs, security, smuggling, cross-border trade, international friendship and cooperation, and more. It also features excerpts from interviews with long-time border residents and other figures connected with this part of the world.

While the focus of the book is on the past, clearly there is a message here: modern security concerns should not be allowed to destroy the unique international community that has evolved along this 145-km (90-mile) stretch of the Canada-U.S. border. Or, as the Derby Line - Stanstead Joint Municipal Committee on Border Issues stated in 2007 (as quoted in the introduction to the book): "We are proud of the spirit that exists here on the border, and we do not accept to be penalized for a simple accident of geography which, for us, is all that the border really is."

Matthew Farfan is a writer, editor, and heritage consultant. He is the author of several books, including *The Eastern Townships: In Town and Village* (2006), *The Eastern Townships: On Lake and River* (2008), and *Cemetery Heritage in Quebec* (2008). Parents who have taken road trips will chuckle sympathetically – or cringe gleefully – watching NBC's "Great American Road Trip," premiering Tuesday, July 7.

Sure, everyone should see this exquisite land, but doing it while spending a month together in an RV with no personal electronics likely would seem a bit daunting to even the closest of families. Yet seven brave families of four pile into NBC-provided RVs to head west on Route 66 from Chicago to L.A. in this reality series hosted by comic Reno Collier.

During each one-hour episode, the families face challenges. The family that loses leaves. The last family remaining after the eight episodes wins \$100,000.

The first challenge is being deprived of iPods, portable DVD players, cell phones and the electronic communication of choice – texting. For most children and teens, this is akin to cutting off oxygen.

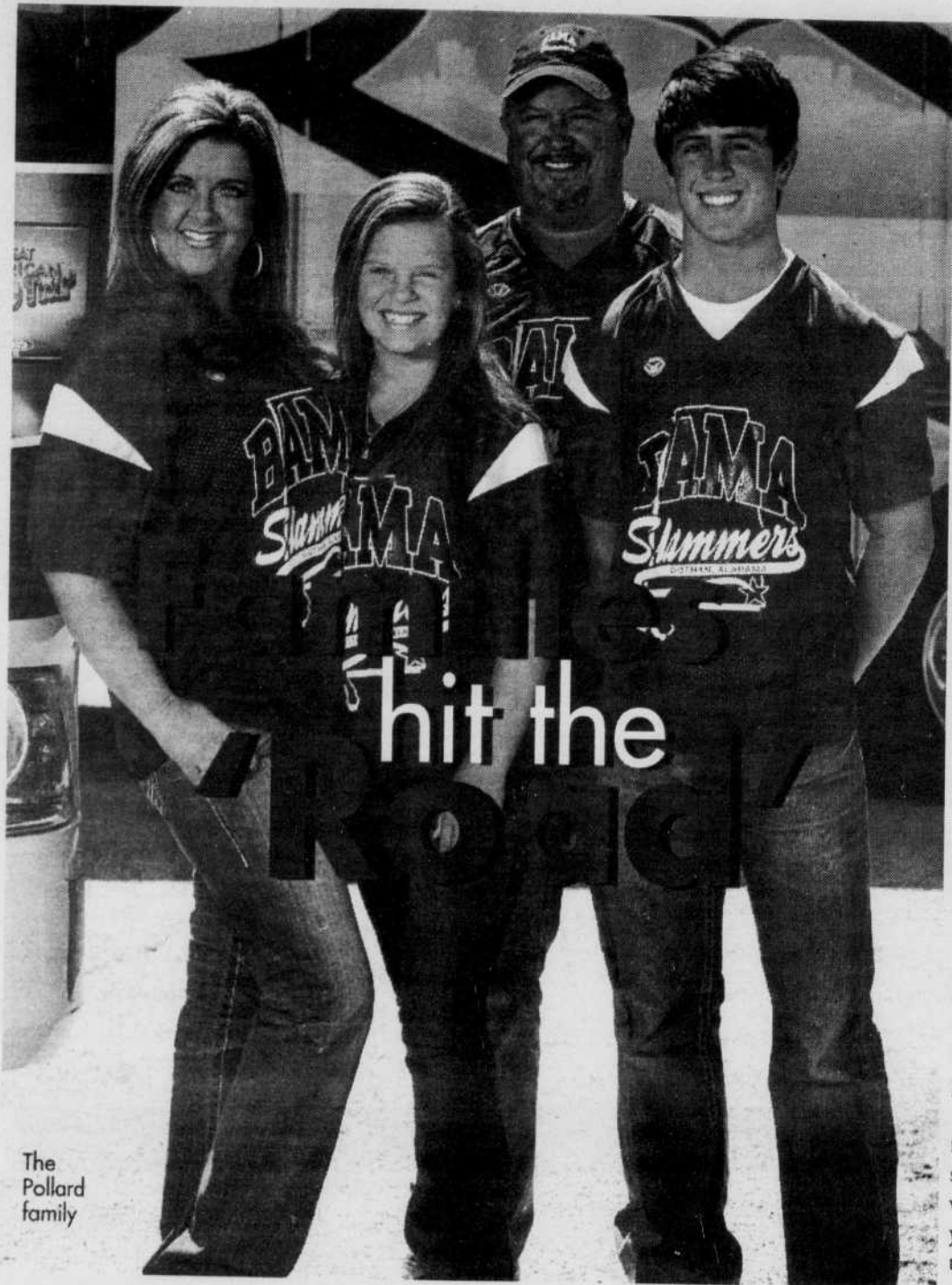
"They're meant to be fun family challenges," says executive producer Lisa Hennessy. "There's one where the dads did a cook-off – who could make the best burgers. And we did a blind taste test. We also have bigger challenges where the families do a zip line. We did it outside Las Vegas, and they have to hit a target with a balloon filled with paint. They're just meant to be fun and funny."

In the pilot, parents wear gigantic Styrofoam heads fashioned to look like presidents. They had to wear these while running an obstacle course outside Lincoln's home.

"The kids have the time of their lives," Hennessy says. "They saw places they had never seen. They interacted with other kids. There's a place on (Route) 66 called Pops. It has the most soda pop of anyplace in the world. It's the fun little places like that that the kids went crazy over. We went to Lake Mead and went in a houseboat, and they catch fish with their hands. One of the kids caught his very first fish on the trip. One kid was terrified of the zip line and did it and had the best time of his life."

The 14 youth are between 9 and 16, and the families were selected to be geographically, racially, ethnically and economically diverse. Members from three different families say they enjoyed the sights and the challenges, and there were no reports of pending divorces for couples thrust together every possible moment. In fact, family togetherness and wanting to see the country were what motivated people to participate. And the payoff isn't bad, either.

"I have always been fascinated with reality (TV, but) I was not willing to leave my family for an extended period of time," says Amie Pollard of Wicksburg, Ala. "When I saw this I thought, 'Oh, my gosh! The trip of a lifetime, and we can do it as a family.' I was kind of already having that separation anxiety because my son is literally less than a year from going to college. This is the chance for us to have one big hoorah as a family, take a huge vacation together and do things we have never, ever done before."

"The Listener," a new Canadian supernatural drama, airs Thursdays on CTV. Episodes also air on Space: The Imagination Station.

A young paramedic named Toby Logan has the ability to listen to people's most intimate thoughts. He uses this gift to work the streets of Toronto in an ambulance. With the help of partner Oz Bey, Detective Charlie Marks, his ex-girlfriend Olivia and an ER doctor, Toby uses his special skills to help people and solve crimes.

Toby is kind of like Patricia Arquette's character in "Medium," but unlike her, Toby is active and out in the field rather than simply working as a medium to assist in criminal investigations. Furthermore, none of Toby's co-workers know of his supernatural gift right away; that comes to light throughout the first season.

We like being privy to the supernatural abilities of Toby and being able to "listen in" on other people's problems with him. As

such, we'd like to be able to witness different supernatural crime-solving skills through other protagonists' eyes.

"THE SEER": A found object at a crime scene sparks a line of investigations led by a 20-year-old clairvoyant – let's call her Edie. She has a sixth sense enabling her to see beyond what is visible to the nonpsychic eye. When a razor blade is found at a playground, Edie uncovers a vicious murder committed there days prior. A rare coin, among other clues, leads to the unraveling of a treason case. Nothing escapes the eyes of Edie, the seer of all.

"THE SNIFFER": A detective with a superstrong sense of smell lets his nose lead the way in every case he's assigned to. A strong cologne, the smell of vanilla and the rancid odor of mold all invoke introspective discoveries within the detective whose claim to fame is his ability to "sniff" out criminals.

"THE FEELER": A forensic scientist feels the pain of the victims whose crimes she

reviews. Every cut, incision and bruise leads to discovering the culprit in each case. The "feeler" can sense where each battle wound took place, how it happened and ultimately, who committed it. Piecing together lesions and lacerations, it's never straightforward, but the process of uncovering is undeniably compelling and often bone-chilling.

"THE KNOWER": Kind of like those stories you hear about a mystical man on a mountain who knows the meaning of life, the Knower lives in a one-bedroom flat in Montreal, and his abilities go far beyond merely "psychic." He actually knows everything. From the specific times crimes were committed to the gritty details of how they transpired, the Knower fights to become acknowledged as an official consultant to the police force after proving himself time and time again. How many cases will it take for the Knower to get the recognition he should receive?

Buddy Valastro



Buddy Valastro of TLC's Monday series "Cake Boss" has been baking so long he's not positive when he started. He recalls going to Carlo's, the old-fashioned Hoboken, N.J., bakery featured in the show, with his beloved late father, Buddy. The elder Buddy, from a line of bread bakers, emigrated from an island off Sicily. He started as an apprentice at Carlo's, eventually buying it.

Valastro remembers rolling out cookie dough at 11. Now, he says, "I do the same things with my kids." Amazing cakes come from this kitchen, cakes that look like dinosaurs, jewelry boxes and buildings on fire. Cooling in the gigantic freezer is a cake with 3-foot-high soldiers, a keyboard and blocks, all signatures of FAO Schwarz, the upscale toy store. Valastro's cakes are works of art, but unlike some who value presentation over flavor, his are also delicious. He mixes cream cheese into the pound cake, and all decorations are edible. A well-organized wall of file drawers is filled with different flowers for decorating cakes, and

Valastro is proud that they're botanically accurate. He demonstrates making a rose, feeding gum paste through a machine until it's paper-thin, pressing a mold into it, and handcrafting each petal until it looks as if it came from a florist, not a bakery. At 33, Valastro refers to himself as one of a dying breed because he bakes from scratch. "You could buy a pie the size of a spare tire that was made two years ago for six bucks," he says. Or you could buy fresh, which customers can smell the moment they walk into his store. If you want to judge a bakery, Valastro advises going on a Monday or Tuesday, when display cases should be empty. "I only make for the day," he says. "That's the trick."

The bakery: The building has been a bakery for more than 200 years. "There's cake in the walls," Valastro says.
Favorite cake to bake: Wedding cakes. "It's calming," he says. "I like to do intricate things."

Q: With as long as the show has run and how popular it is, do you draw lots of attention when you're out in public?

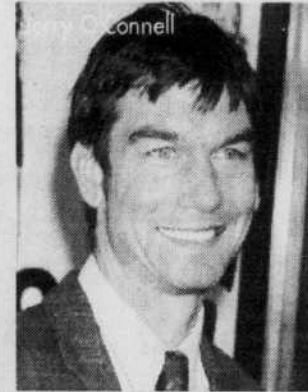

Stella from 'Jonas'

School uniforms exist to make students appear neat and ready to learn and to create a bond of conformity.

Then there are the creatively dressed students, albeit in uniforms, at Horace Mantis Academy on Disney Channel's Sunday series "Jonas." One, Stella (Chelsea Staub), is a burgeoning fashion designer.

As fashion-conscious as many teenagers are, Stella is more so because she is the

fictional Lucas brothers' stylist. "The Disney people wanted her more cutting-edge, a little more out there than other Disney shows," Janiger says. "She is accessorized and very put together; her shoes match her headband."

Janiger has found items at Wasteland in Los Angeles and at Loehmanns, the store famed for its community dressing rooms, where brutal honesty among the female clients is the custom.

There, Janiger has picked up cranberry blouses with puffy sleeves and skirts from Theory and Prada. She outfits Stella in vests and tops from Free People and H&M.

Janiger sews a lot of outfits "so you don't look at every show and see the same things," she says.

She completes Stella's look with shoes from DSW and Steve Madden and Betsey Johnson jewelry. The biggest influence for Stella's look, Janiger says, is Staub, though the actress maintains she has no fashion sense.

"I follow what she comes in looking like," Janiger says. "She just looks gorgeous. It's so great, and she is so comfortable with it. And that's not true that she has no knack."

"She came in with this book, and I had a little book I showed her that I had presented to Disney," Janiger says. "I listened to what they said. I saw what Chelsea wanted to do, and we tried to combine everything."

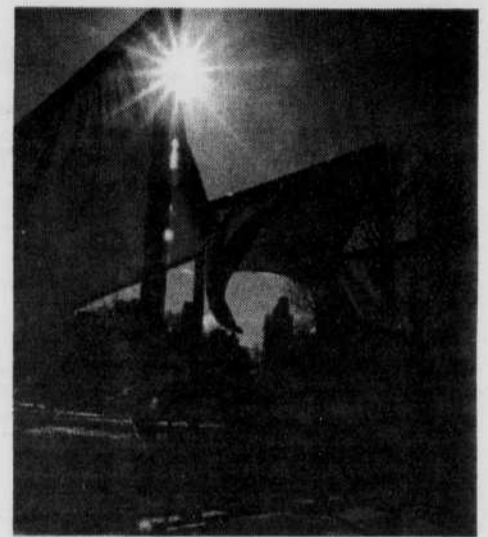

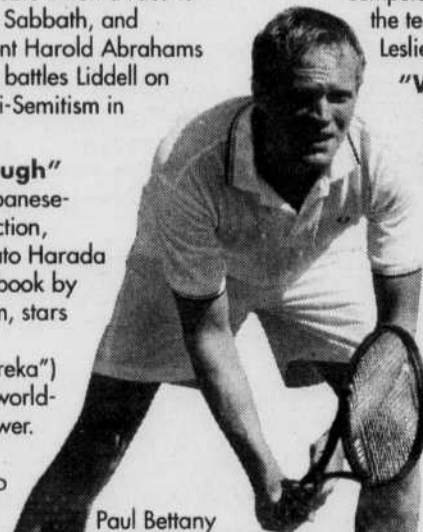

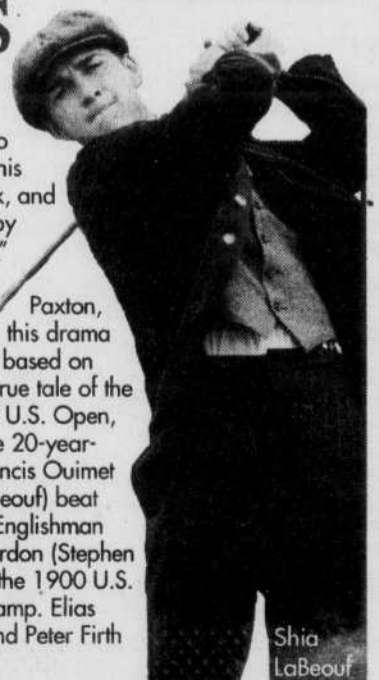
Olympic boycott, he decides to hang on and compete against younger rowers to make the team again in 1984. Also stars Leslie Hope and Helen Shaver.

Wailing With the Williams

COUNTRY CONNECTION

Hank Williams, Jr. has long surpassed the status of superstar and the country music industry and his fans now look at him as an icon. What can we say, for the Williams family music is a family tradition.

Just like his father before him, Hank Jr. is an outlaw, a rebel and a country music legend. The road to stardom was long and rocky but Williams successfully emerged from his famous father's shadow, forging a career of his own. He created music taking his inspiration from many different genres.

His work boasts the same gut-wrenching emotion that was his father's trademark. But it stops there. There's very little room for comparison as he recorded such classic hits as 'Whiskey Bent and Hell Bound', 'All My Rowdy Friends', 'Old Habits' and 'Born to Boogie'.

He, in turn has been the influence of many young country singers as well as rock bands

The secret to his longevity is his ability to connect with the changing times. Not that his music follows trends rather, Hank Jr. is not afraid to diversify his style, to take on new challenges or to address issues our modern society faces in his own candid, gutsy, redneck ways.

Fans will be happy to know that Hank Jr.'s first full length album of new material in 6 years, has just been released. Titled,

127 Rose Avenue, the new collection is classic Hank Jr., which means everything from country to blues and bluegrass. The topics range from child abuse, to the current economic recession, domestic problems and Bocephus takes them on with poignancy.

The first single released '*Red, White and Pink Slip Blues*' ought to get a lot of attention from those who suffer from the current economic recession. The song is about a millworker who finds himself without a job after his factory closes down. Steven Dale Jones wrote this number and made it a very moving story.

'*Last Driftin' Cowboy*', most likely inspired by the name of his father's band, offers wonderful pedal-steel guitar work. This is something that we hardly find in today's country.

There's '*High Maintenance Woman*' (not the Toby Keith song of the same title) an hilarious number about a relationship in which the wife is a big spender, which doesn't go quite well with her low-budget husband.

We also have to remember that contrary to many younger country music artists, this honky-tonk rocker is still signed to a major label and still charts the Billboard country charts. This should prove that he's top of the crop.

There's '*The Farm*' on which Hank Jr. teaches all the younger artists how to rock and just let it rip. Many newcomers would have plenty to learn from the master. '*Sounds Like Justice*' offers a strong message. The song tackles the tough and sad

issue of child abuse.

He slows down the pace on the bluesy '*Mighty Oak Trees*' on which he tips his hat to everyone who has supported him throughout his life. '*Gulf Shore Road*' is a ballad which shows a romantic side of the artist that we rarely see.

The title track '*127 Rose Avenue*' is the address of Hank Jr.'s legendary dad's home, which is now a museum. With a bit of sadness and hope, the grown man recalls a visit to his childhood. He sings about having to pay for an admission ticket only to be greeted warmly by his dad's spirit.

'*All the Roads*' is probably the most surprising number on this album, as Hank Jr. ventures into bluegrass. Here Hank Jr. actually delivers one of the best-loved songs in a long while with bluegrass group the Grascals.

This new album comes as a confirmation that he is still a grand artist, who can compete in today's country music world.

Holly Williams

Just like her brother, her father Hank Jr. and her grandfather Hank Williams Sr., Holly Williams has chosen to be a singer/songwriter. It's a family tradition.

Although she's only 28-years-old, Williams writes as though she has been living for a very long time. She seems to be mature beyond her age.

With her sophomore album '*Here With Me*' Williams has finally found her niche. Her style of country-folk mixed with contemporary country will remind people of Mary Chapin Carpenter but she can get

rowdier too. One thing is for sure, she's got her unique style and she's not a reminder of her father and grandfather.

Of course she takes after the two for her ability to write a great song but this is where it ends. She penned eight songs but she has also enlisted the help of Nashville songwriters such as Sara Baxton, Luke Laird, Hilary Lindsey, Chuck Jones and she even does a cover of Neil Young.

'*Mama*' is more personal as it talks about her upbringing. It is a touching tribute from Williams to her mother. But she tells it like it is. She tells of the hard experiences her mother had to go through because the father was gone.

'*Let Her Go*', on the other hand, is more about her dad who was over-protective. But there are also songs about coping, faith, troubled relationships, emotional growth, finding love and being thankful.

Her songs are modern and fresh. Unlike the men in her family, it seems she doesn't have any demons. Do not expect another rowdy Williams.

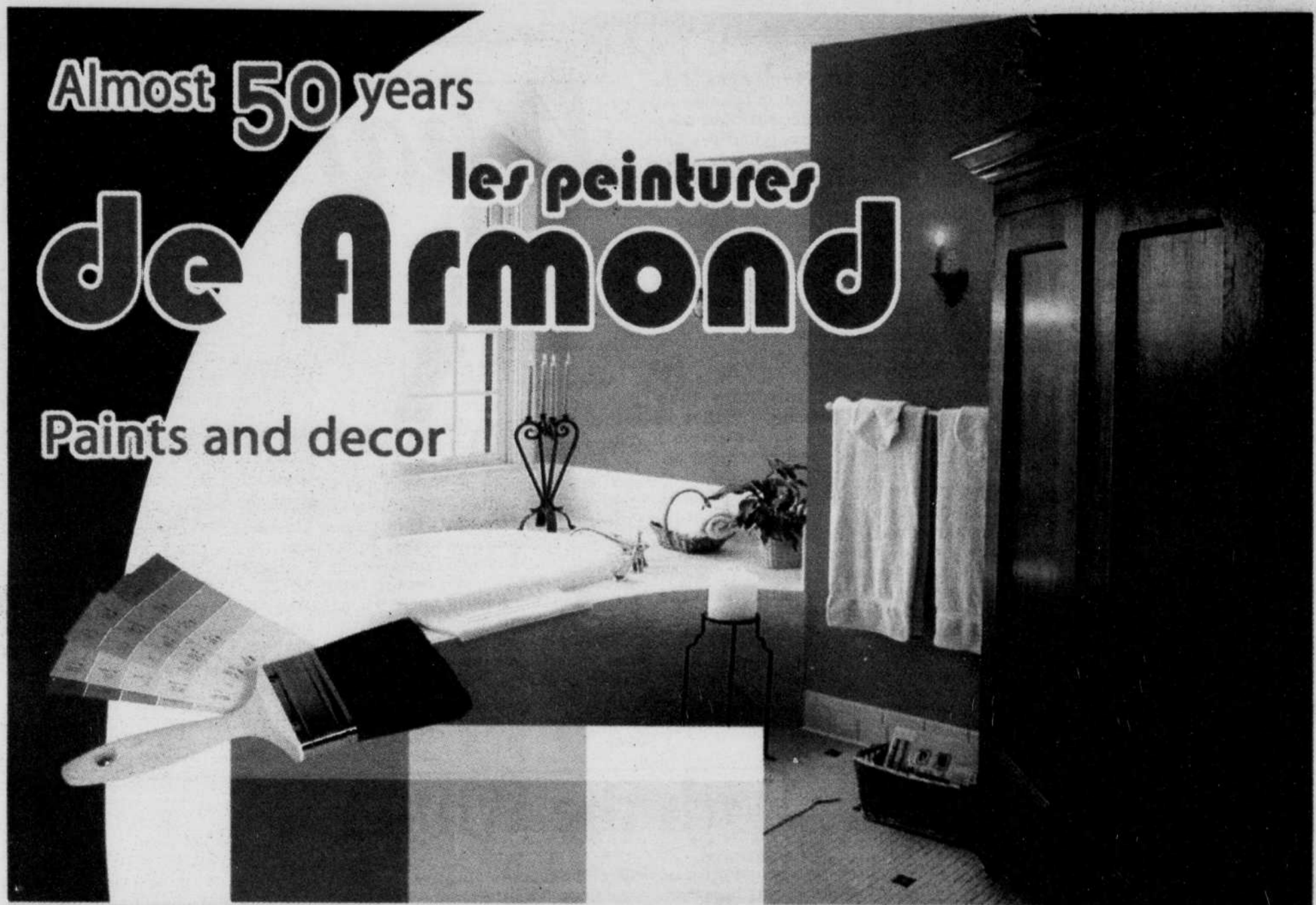
This second album is a lot more country flavoured than her debut and it is much better.
