## Hunchback of Notre Dame: Another one bites the dust

As a perfect tragedy is the noblest production of human nature, so it is capable of giving the mind one of the most delightful and improving entertainments.

Well, Disney's *Hunchback of Notre Dame* is out and the damage is far, far worse than predicted.

I'd forgotten that a Disney animated musical these days is only the detonator, the epicenter of a cultural tsunami that sweeps the world inundating everything in its path.

There are posters, place mats, pencil boxes and puppets. There are figurines, dolls, toys and games, cups and plates and cutlery, bedclothes, caps, shirts, tapes, videos and, of course, books.

That lumpy little man beaming with good fellowship is everywhere — crowding out Victor Hugo's tormented bell-ringer who was so hideously deformed that even his mother couldn't stand him and so left him at the church door on Quasimodo Sunday.

A casual survey of the local book shop turned up no fewer than seven new editions of *Hunchback*, of which only three were attributed to Victor Hugo — and two of those had been Disneyfied with bright illustrations and upbeat endings.

And Disney's version is

making so much money that his culture vultures must already be ransacking the world's great literature for another tragedy to trivialize — *Faust*, perhaps. Mephistopheles should be good for a laugh and *Faust's* soul isn't much of a price anyway. He and Gretchen will outwit the rascal in the end and live happily ever after.

Nothing is sacred. Samson and Delilah might do, with talking donkeys and Samson pulling the temple down to squish only the bad guys while he and a delectable Delilah escape across the desert aboard their comical friend the camel.

Or how about Disneyfying *Hamlet* by letting Yorick's skull crack jokes. Ophelia doesn't really go mad and

drown herself, of course, and they get together in the end.

*King Lear* might do with Cordelia and her two ugly sisters squabbling over the kingdom while the foolish, fond old man wanders the heath with his jester, Poor Tom.

But my choice is *Oedipus Rex* Disneyfied into *King Eddy*, the story of a young man's search for his birth parents. When an oracle warns King Laius of Thebes that he is fated to be slain by his son, he abandons the baby on a hillside where he's found by a kindly old shepherd (see the possibilities?) who raises him among the sheep in his humble hut until the childless King of Corinth drives by and adopts the lad as his own.

When he grows up Eddy

hears he is fated to kill his father and, unaware of his adoption, frees Corinth to avoid any such possibility. In Thebes, he meets King Laius on the road. One is as stubborn as the other (you know how it is with fathers and sons) and neither will yield the way. They fight, Eddy kills Laius and goes on to solve the riddle of the Sphinx; "What goes on four legs in the morning, two legs at noon and three legs in the evening?" "Man!" says King Eddy and the Sphinx collapses.

Things get a little tricky after that but the Disney company can work something out for a feel-good ending to sell the togas, lunch boxes, posters, tapes, videos and books.

And another classic bites the dust.

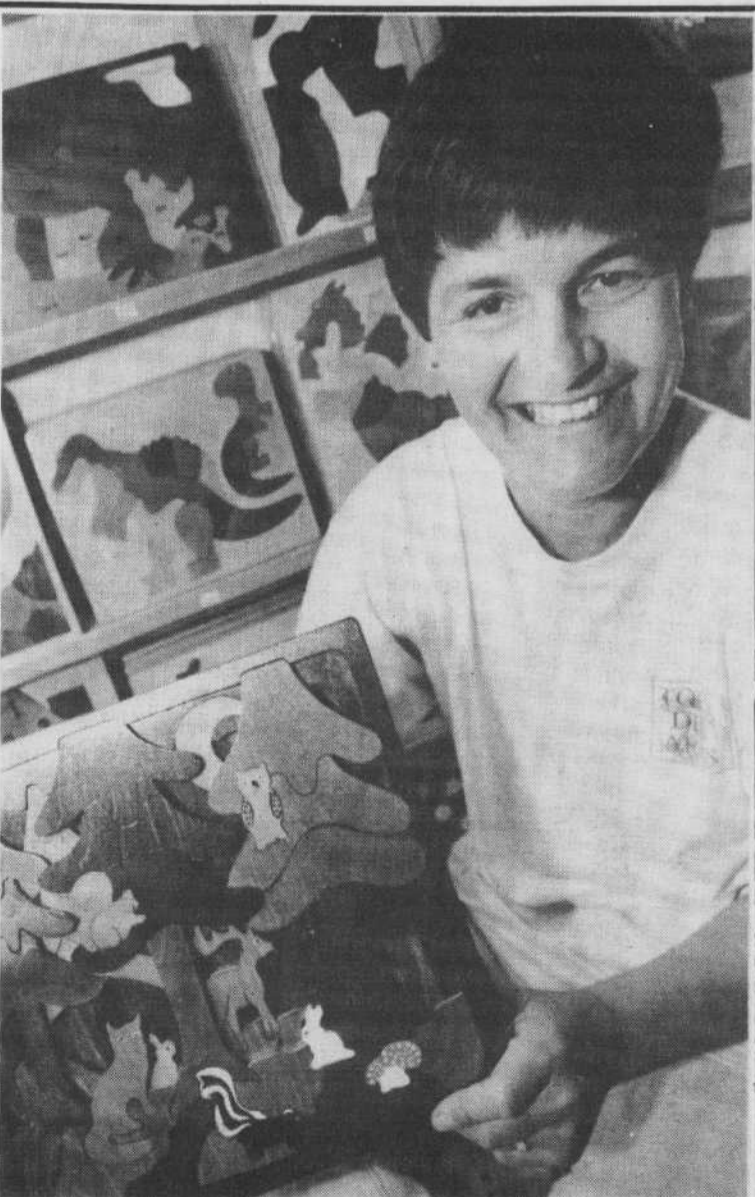

It is apt, then, that animals find their way onto the artisan's handcrafted wooden puzzles. Jones, whose workshop is one of 30 open to the public on the Tour des Arts in Brome County, said her latest work is a bilingual alphabet picture puzzle for children.

"Each letter features a picture of an animal that starts with the same letter in French and English, like 'A' for alligator and alligator," Jones explained. "There's only one, unicorn, in French, it's licorn, but even French people say unicorn, but I wrote the correct name in French. For all the letters, I've included the names of the animals in both languages."

Other imaginative designs include a collapsible puzzle basket and a three-dimensional, 72-piece depiction of a forest scene featuring trees, a deer, fox, rabbit, racoon, owl and skunk all under a half-moon (pictured at right). Jones' educational and entertaining puzzles are as delightfully colorful as the Swiss-born artisan herself, whose love of woodworking was instilled in her by her father.

Jones produces 5000 puzzles a year and is currently working on another 3-D creation. Her workshop at 1497 Jordan Road in Sut-

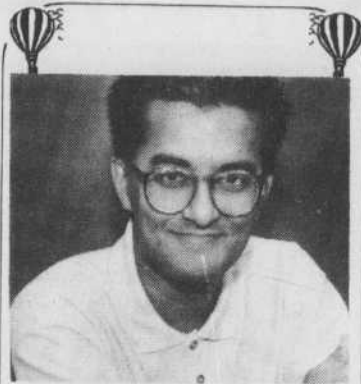
When I think of last summer, I remember it as being as hectic as any can possibly be. An increased workload and office reshuffling combined for dizzy days to say the least. There were some bright spots, however. One of those came in the form of a summertime intern named Jodie Hunt.

She brought her wide smile, exuberant personality, positive attitude and infectious giggle to our offices and was always a delight to be around. Jodie was a keen writer who composed a variety of stories for *The Record* for the news and arts sections. Her work for *Townships Week* included interviews with Piggery Theatre actors, a report on Canada Day celebrations in Sherbrooke and a piece on her native Gaspé.

Many of us were greatly saddened to find out that Jodie died of cancer in May, just two months after she was diagnosed. She would have turned 22 years old on Saturday, July 20.

It's difficult to understand why such a bright light was extinguished so soon after she had begun to shine. Hindus believe we only go through a continual cycle of birth and death so we can learn to be better human beings each time around and eventually reach a better place. We are taught not to mourn the dead, they are lucky to be continuing their journey. Perhaps Jodie learned all she could in her incarnation and it was simply time to move on for the betterment of her Self.

I've mentioned the Thornton Wilder play *Our Town* before. There's a passage in it where a woman who has died giving birth goes back to a childhood birthday and is agonized to discover her family and friends rushing about their business like there is no tomorrow. Look at me for just a moment as if

you really see me, she shouts. The message is that the living are blind, most of us don't appreciate life until it's threatened or taken away.

With this in mind, take a good look at your loved ones this weekend, see them for who they are and appreciate them. And don't let petty misunderstandings get in the way. For Jodie. And for yourselves.

One of the most important things we all must learn is to appreciate the moments of our lives without dwelling on the past or worrying about the future.

Jodie's parents said she had displayed quiet acceptance in her final two months and arranged her life with a level head. She even chose the place of her death, the beach at anse au Carnaval in the Gaspé, which she had often referred to as her "paradise".

If the living of life is an art, then Jodie was one of its greatest practitioners. Thank you for indulging me and taking the time to read about a special human being.

### Tour des sons

Multi-instrumentalists Allyn Harris and Peter Mendieta will give a special concert as part of Brome County's Tour des Arts next weekend.

Pianist Harris and guitarist Mendieta will play their unusual mix of folk, jazz, classical and new age music and will also demonstrate the possibilities that can be achieved on a large variety of bells and percussion instruments from around the world.

Joining the Stanstead duo are poet and artist Liz Davidson and puppeteers Felix Mirbt and Almut Ellinghaus.

With Davidson, Harris and Mendieta will accompany the reading of two of her poems with an improvised soundtrack.

"We kind of know the flow of the poetry, we know what the poem is saying, but we haven't written the music down. The actual notes can vary," said Mendieta.

Davidson, whose poetry deals with the human condition and our mythology, will read "Speaking of Stones" and "Beyond".

"Speaking of Stones' is about stones having memories and reminding us about what we are and about how we think they have no life, but that has a life," she said.

Davidson said Harris and Mendieta have encouraged her to play with her words.

"It's a kind of magical thing when I don't get too scared," Davidson said with a hearty laugh.

A new performance of music and puppets will be presented by the duo with Mirbt and Ellinghaus.

"The music is already written," said Mendieta. "It's a piece that Allyn put together over the winter. They're creating a special piece to go with Allyn's music."

Harris has been known to play the piano from the inside.

"Allyn is quite good at playing the keys, but also opening up the piano and playing the strings from the inside," Mendieta explained. "But you need a grand piano for that and in the church we don't have one, so we'll bring the recording of the piano and play percussion. It's amazing the sounds it gets. It sounds like a droning thunderstorm."

Hopefully, Harris' will be the only sounds of thunderstorm on Saturday, July 27, when Harris and Mendieta and their guests take the stage of the Calvary United Church, 6 Maple in Sutton, at 8 p.m. Tickets, \$4-8, will be available at the door.

SHERBROOKE — La vieille chapelle Ramsay is the perfect place to renew your vows, meditate, seek spiritual guidance — or enjoy a pleasant night's stay in the heart of the Townships.

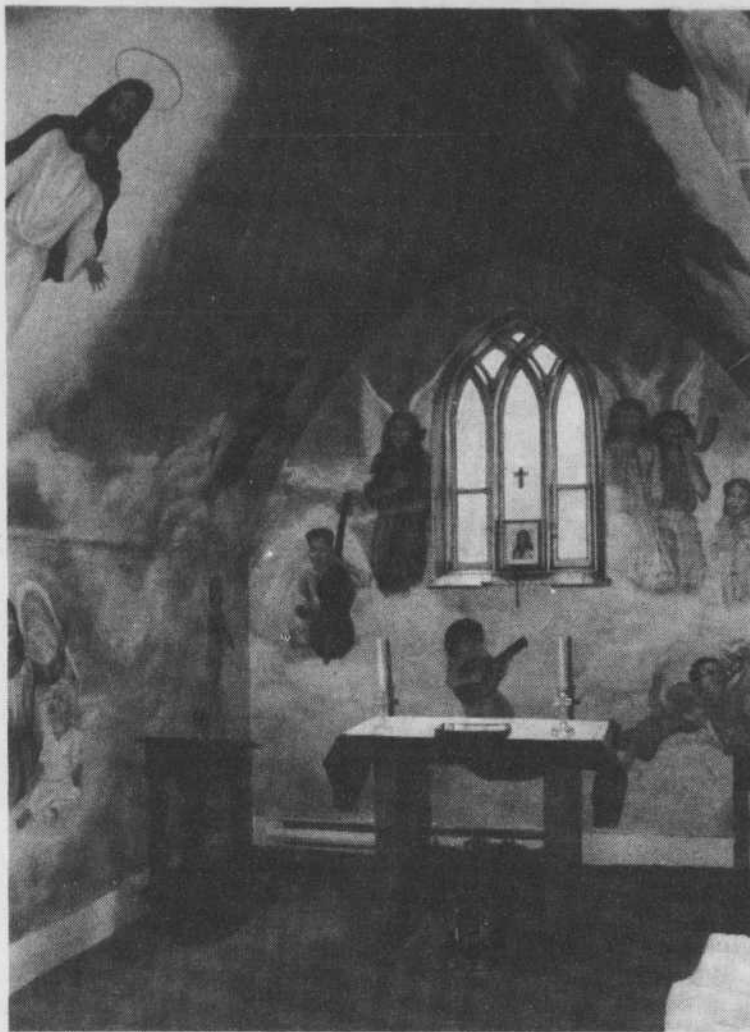
Owners and innkeepers Regina Makuch and Jean-Louis Le Cavalier transformed their historical home in Magog into a unique bed and breakfast.

Guests can enjoy this peaceful oasis which, apart from bedrooms, washrooms and a lounge, also contains a chapel.

"People come here for a spiritual retreat, to relax and to meditate," said Makuch. "Visitors who stay at La vieille chapelle Ramsay experience an inner feeling of peace and find themselves rejuvenated at the same time."

The chapel's walls were once badly cracked and Townships artist Erik Trudel spent nearly four months painting a baroque orchestra of angels along with a depiction of Jesus on them.

Sherbrooke painter Genieve Reesor created the murals inside the bedrooms and the lounge. A wildlife theme is repeated throughout the rooms, which have been named the Dove, Deer, Dolphin and Pegasus. The lounge has also

For breakfast, visitors are in

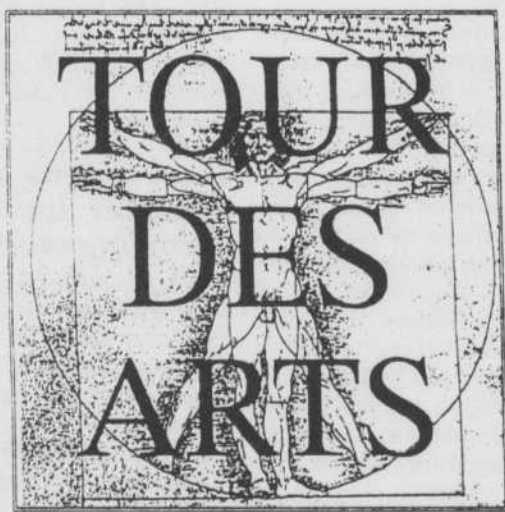

SHERBROOKE — Thingamajigs, the new exhibit at the J. Armand Bombardier Museum in Valcourt, gives people of all ages the opportunity to discover more than 35 uncommon and strange objects.

Visitors are asked to call upon their imaginations to guess the functions and uses of the strange objects on display. One might wonder about the use of a metal crown covered with thorns, for example. This was once used as a tool to dry meat. "The exhibit is not only a fantastic way to learn and an amusing way to solve riddles, it is also a great way to escape the nasty weather we've been having this summer," said Mary Louise Standish, the museum's communications officer.

"We have gotten an excellent response from the general public so far. People of all ages have come in and tried to solve the puzzles and riddles."

The objects displayed are on loan from Le musée de la civilisation de Québec. They were drawn from various sections of that museum, including domestic life and trade, costumes and textiles, ceramic and glass, popular arts and toys.

A showroom containing uncommon objects from various museums of the Townships is also on display.

Local artist Normand Toupin, who is known for giving common objects an uncommon twist, is also displaying his junk art, made from found objects.

Thingamajigs runs through September 8. Visiting hours are from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. daily. The entrance fee is \$5 for adults, \$3 for students and seniors, and free for children under six. The museum is located at 1001 J.A. Bombardier in Valcourt. For more information, call (514) 532-5300.

## Townships theatre is right for Quebec premiere of *Wrong For Each Other*

# Piggery play explores the nature of true love

STE-CATHERINE-DE-HATLEY — While analyzing The Piggery Theatre's second play of the season, director Greg Tuck and actors Margot Dionne and John Dolan made a list of its inherent themes.

This became something of a mantra which the three repeated during the intense, 17-day rehearsal period of *Wrong For Each Other*, by New Brunswick playwright Norm Foster, which receives its Quebec premiere at the Piggery.

It isn't surprising then, when asked to discuss the play, that this mantra easily rolled off the tip of their tongues.

"Love has a value. Persistence is a virtue. Love conquers all. Hope springs eternal," chanted Dionne, quickly adding with a laugh, "Corny is good."

The play follows the private lives of Norah Case (Dionne) and Rudy Sorenson (John Dolan), a divorced couple who have a chance encounter four years after their break-up. Through a series of flashbacks, audiences join the pair as they skip down memory lane through their first date, wedding and heartbreaking parting.

### ROMANTIC COMEDY

"It's at once a great comedy and a great romance at the same time," said director Tuck at the theatre on Monday. "And one of Norm Foster's, who is a prolific and a really popular playwright, this is clearly one of his two or three best. It's

really something and kind of a tour de force for a couple to play, and it's quite a roller-coaster ride for the audience."

Dolan said the two-hander will appeal to people as they see themselves in the characters.

"I think everybody who watches it is going to recognize at one point or another, either in a particular scene or at a moment, they're going to recognize part of themselves in either character, which I really

like about it," said the Quebec City native, adding that despite the title, they aren't really *Wrong For Each Other*.

"Just by circumstances, things happen. You see, they're quite right for each other, they just don't know it. Like they say in the play, a lot of people always miss that moment when they find the right person, they let the moment go by and spend the rest of their lives going, 'Geez, I wonder...'" In this case, they're looking for that all the time, and they rediscover certain things and it's fun that way."

"Opposites attract," added Dionne, citing another theme

in the play.

### LOVE STORY

The American-born actor said part of its appeal is that it's an old-fashioned love story.

"It becomes apparent that through each other, they become themselves," she said. "They really are people who really need each other in order to fulfill their destiny."

Two years ago, Dionne played one-half of another couple who were made for each other yet didn't know it in Noel Coward's celebration of love *Private Lives*, also at the Piggery.

"There are similarities," Dionne said, between that

play's Amanda and Elyot and Norah and Rudy. "Those are arch high comedians and these are..."

"Arch low comedians," said Tuck to gales of laughter from Dionne and Dolan.

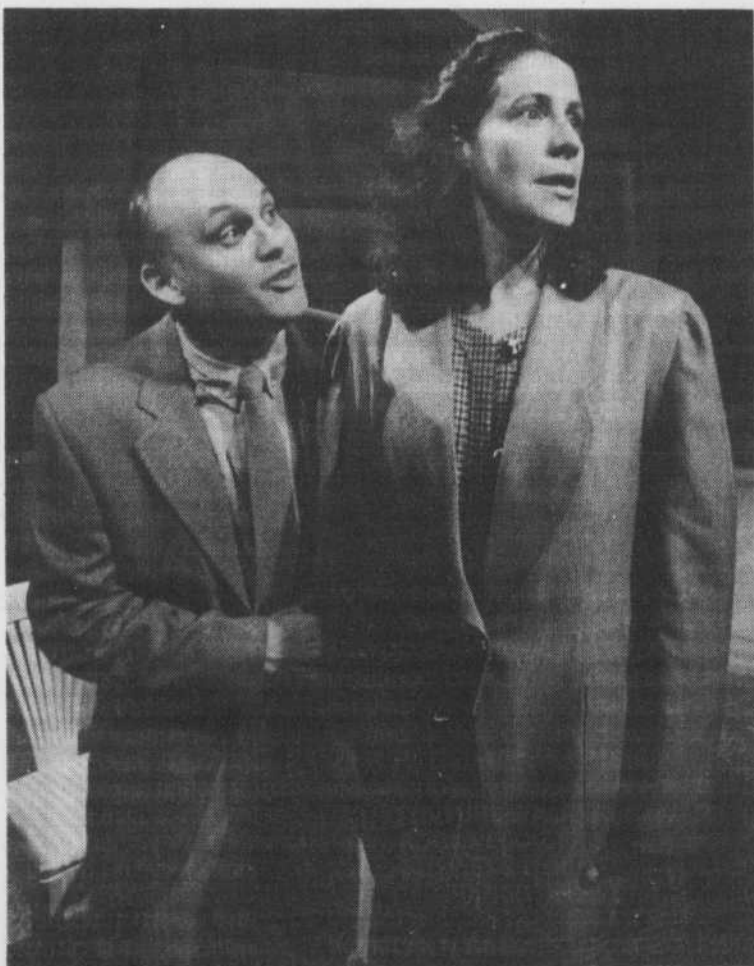
Tuck was commenting on Foster's listener-friendly writing style.

"It's a great truth," he said. "Among the discoveries we made was a real respect for the style. People think of him as a kind of sitcom guy but this is very refined writing. There is a certain accessibility about the piece that meets audiences and audiences like that, but I think he's misperceived because the substance of what he's writing is rich, human."

Foster has also penned the hits *The Melville Boys* and *Opening Night*, which were mounted at the Piggery in 1986 and 1989, as well as *Sinners* and *The Affections of May*.

"One hundred years from now when they look at who wrote what here and now, they're going to look at these plays because they say something about who the people were," Tuck added. "Just because he's chosen to write them in an accessible form, I think that's in the great tradition of the theatre. He writes them for people and people come to see them."

*Wrong For Each Other* is playing at the Piggery Theatre in Ste-Catherine-de-Hatley through August 3. Performances take place nightly from Tuesdays to Saturdays at 8:30 p.m., with matinees on Wednesdays at 2 p.m. and Saturdays at 4 p.m. Tickets: \$17.50-\$25. ## Wrong actors say Quebec makes them feel just right

STE-CATHERINE-DE-HATLEY — Although the two stars of *Wrong For Each Other* live and work outside of Quebec, both actors said they have a need for frequent visits to the province they grew up in.

"I don't think I could endure my present life in New York if I could not come to Quebec for at least three months a year, spend Christmas and the breaks and all of that here," said Margot Dionne, who was born in New Bedford, Massachusetts, to French-Canadian parents before they moved to Montreal when she was a child.

Dionne currently lives in New York City with her 11-year-old daughter Lily, where she teaches high school drama. She spends summers in

picturesque North Hatley visiting her parents.

Quebec City native John Dolan worked at Bishop's University in Lennoxville and Sherbrooke University before making the big move down the 401 to Toronto.

He said the Townships will always hold special memories for him.

"It was a very instrumental part of my life, very important," he said. "Big decisions were made here for me. I'd live here again — if there was something I could sell."

Dolan, who also has family in Montreal, said Quebec is where he discovered his love for theatre.

"It was at the Frontenac Playhouse in Quebec City, gra-

duates of Bishop's University founded that theatre," Dolan remembered. "I used to love it. That's the first smell I had of English theatre."

Dolan said he visits Quebec City often, but there's not much left for him.

"Our high school's gone, the church's gone, the cathedral is now like a condo. It's so weird. There's this church where everybody got married and died and all that stuff, history, and it's just like a condo now, but there you go."

Dionne and Dolan have acted together at the Stratford Festival and in the Piggery's production of the thriller *And When I Wake* in 1989, also directed by Greg Tuck.

## Lacy J. Dalton, Razy Bailey to entertain in New Hampshire

# Two country favorites at the Lancaster fair

People magazine called her "Country's Bonnie Raitt" and indeed she's got one of the most instantly recognizable voices in the industry.

Lacy J. Dalton will perform at the agricultural fair in Lancaster, New Hampshire, on Saturday, August 29, at 2:30 and 7:30 p.m.

Dalton was born in Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania, into a musical family. Her father played a variety of stringed instruments, sang and wrote songs. Her mother played guitar and sang harmony, while her sister was a talented pianist.

Dalton's early influences were Bob Dylan and Joan Baez. The sound of folk and rock along with lyrics that would bring a message to the listeners were what grabbed her heart.

When she left Brigham Young University to become a singer, her primary interest was still folk music. She ended up in California, where she broadened her singing and writing to include other types of music such as blues, jazz, R&B and country.

She recorded a demo tape in a Santa Cruz garage and out of all the different material, the country songs made the strongest artistic statement.

background, this came as no surprise.

"As I grew older and played different types of music, I began to write country songs," she said. "They just flew out of me and it was easier for me to express myself in a country vein."

This demo tape landed Dalton a contract with CBS Records and legendary producer Billy Sherrill. With her heartfelt conviction and gritty, down-to-earth vocal style, this new country music songstress was all set to go to the top.

Dalton has produced many hit singles, including "Crazy

Blue Eyes", "Hillbilly Girl With The Blues", "Takin' It Easy", "16th Avenue", "Dream Baby" and "The Head".

Dalton has been nominated for Best Female Vocalist several times and, in 1979, won the Academy of Country Music's Best New Female Vocalist award.

Her songs have been nominated for Grammy Awards and she has numerous BMI awards for airplay.

Dalton is always very careful when picking her material to ensure that her songs are not just flash-in-the-pan hits but classics that will wear well year after year.

"I like songs that are fun, but I like songs that have something to say, and I generally pick things that have something to say over a catchy, hooky little thing," she said.

His career was off and running. Bailey made the music history books when both the side As and Bs of three of his records in a row went to number one. Among those hits were "Lovin' Up A Storm", "Friend-

s", "If Love Had A Face", "She Left Love All Over Me", "Scratch My Back", and "Midnight Hauler".

After being nominated for the Academy of Country Music's New Male Vocalist Award, Bailey was Billboard magazine's country artist of the year. To date, the talented man has 30 Top 10 singles and 13 number one hits to his credit.

Bailey is capable of delivering tender, yearning ballads as well as toe-tappers. Songs such as "Too Old To Play Cowboy" and "I Ain't Got No Business Doin' Business Today" have become perennial disc jockey favorites.

This shy country boy has good-time energy, charm, genuine warmth and deep south humility. With a personality like that, Bailey can win over any audience in performance.

Recently, the country singer branched out into producing, with great success. Bailey is the perfect picture of a successful country music career.

# Grease!: Cartoon musical takes trip down memory lane

MONTREAL — *Grease* is the word. Or so it has been ever since the 50s rock 'n' roll musical jived its place onto the Broadway map in 1972.

Its surprising success kept the show going on the New York stage for almost eight years.

The musical got a second lease on life when, in 1978, the very hot John Travolta and popular singer Olivia Newton-John paired for the movie version of the smash hit.

Newton-John's producer at the time, John Farrar, decided that many of the songs that may have worked on stage were to be replaced by newer, more standard ones. So out went the nostalgic 'Since I Don't Have You' and in came the popular 'You're The One That I Want.'

Judging from what happened, that was the right decision. *Grease*, the movie, skyrocketed and forever made a dent in movie musical history. It even made temporary superstars out of its leads and took the music charts by storm.

*Grease* was a phenomenon in the late 70s. But, as they say, that was then and this is now.

Fifteen years later, Broadway legend Tommy Tune gave director Jeff Calhoun the

okay to remount the stage production and sell it to a new Broadway audience eager for their own sense of nostalgia.

Since 1994, the Broadway show *Grease!*, lacking in the extravaganza that is so common in the musicals of today, has instead allowed for a trip down pop culture's memory lane and showcased the musical talents of the likes of Rosie O'Donnell. It is also the forum that has given second chances to less prolific talents such as Brooke Shields.

The producers, hoping to duplicate this successful star-as-bait formula, have taken the show on tour using somewhat brand-name talents to help lure in its audiences.

However, no one I spoke with at opening night in Montreal could remember Mackenzie Phillips, who plays Rizzo, although many remember *One Day At A Time*, the hit TV show she starred in.

No one could recall Adrian Zmed (who plays Danny) from the movie *Grease 2* and TV's *TJ Hooker* fame (even his co-stars Michelle Pfeiffer and Heather Locklear would have been long forgotten with such resumes) and those who care to remember what a fine comedian Joe Piscopo was or still is did not come to see him in a show where he's relegated to playing some disc jockey spinning the

This *Grease!* tour is a certifiable Broadway one. It has the authentic crayola stage that is set up like a comic book box. It has its funky costumes and props that add more color to the already pastel backdrops. It even has award-winning lighting designed to keep us focussed on each and every color on stage.

However, this is a cartoon musical, a fact that is never obscured. It has its share of punchy, animated choreography that makes you admire the ensemble of singers and dancers.

But who asked for the stars? It makes it more difficult when the pressure's on them to perform in a city where their names are not recognizable on a marquee.

Phillips is, without doubt,

very good. Zmed is okay (maybe an off-night) and Piscopo has no one but himself to blame for taking the virtually no-role top billing.

Whereas Tony Award-winning Marilyn Cooper nearly steals the show as Miss Lynch, the controlling principal. Terron Brooks brings down the house as a cross between Little Richard and RuPaul with his soulful, groovy rendition of 'Beauty School Dropout'.

Even unknown Ali McLennan, as Sandy, makes a solid first impression with a charming performance and a powerful singing voice.

All this cannot hide the fact that *Grease!* is a slight show, yet the packed opening night audience still gave an impressive standing ovation to this

footnote in theatre history. For some, it seems, *Grease* turns an otherwise tiresome workday into a fun-filled, kick-back-and-relax type of evening.

Still, by the curtain call, *Grease!* on stage leaves you longing for a quick video rental where you fast forward straight to the end, when "You're The One That I Want" comes on and you kick back and singalong. For the children of the 70s, that is our nostalgia.

*Grease!* plays Montreal's Place des Arts through July 21. Final performances are Friday and Saturday at 8 p.m. and Sunday at 6 p.m. with matinees on Saturday and Sunday at 2 p.m. Tickets, \$39-65, are available at all Admission outlets and by calling (819) 820-1000 or (514) 842-2112.

## Gumshoes, bombshells and lounge lizards in Knowlton

# Theatre Lac Brome gets the *Gunmetal Blues*

KNOWLTON — If you have a flair for gumshoes, bombshells and lounge lizards, you should check out *Gunmetal Blues*, the second show of the season at Theatre Lac Brome.

"It's pretty much every cliché you can find, from the hard-boiled detective to the blond bombshell to the cheesy lounge singer," said director Lise-Ann Johnson at the Knowlton playhouse on Wednesday. "There's lots of bourbon and smoke on the runway."

The comedy, based on the book by Canadian author and actor Scott Wentworth, was inspired by film noir classics of the 1940s and 1950s, such as *Double Indemnity*.

Johnson said part of the fun of putting the play together was watching old movies to get a feel for the era.

"It's an incredibly fun piece to work on," she said. "The style is so rich and fun to play with. Even when the stars were down and out they looked glamorous."

The Montreal-based director said the changing emotional landscape of the 40s and 50s shows through in these films and evoked a kind of nostalgia for that world.

"There's something in this play of a sense of longing for an easier time," Johnson said. "When society was corrupt, but it wasn't that corrupt."

### LOUNGE LIZARD

There's also a musical side to the production, courtesy of balding lounge performer Buddy Toupee, played by Robert Burns, who plays piano and sings throughout the play. The music and lyrics were written by Craig Bolmer and Marion Adler.

"It's sort of a musical in a film noir style with the heart of

people you'd expect, including several femme fatale characters played by Jayne Paterson, summed up as The Blond.

"Gallahad is the central character who narrates the story," Johnson said. "It's his case and he talks to the audience, moving the plot along. But in a sense they are all central in different ways. The Blond is the mystery of the play, and you never quite get a handle on her. While Buddy Toupee is the ultimate voyer, who guides the audience along."

### FAMILIARITY

She said it's the familiarity that will bring many of the laughs to the audience. "The humor I think comes from the images that everyone will recognize."

The settings try to capture the essence of the genre, from smoke-filled bars to dirty offices.

Johnson said the production makes much use of shadows and backlighting to create the different scenes. Jennifer Cook designed the sets, while Steve Shon is the man responsible for the 90 or so lighting cues.

"The sets are smokey, boozy and shadowy. There's a lot of high contrast and stylized settings. There's a lot of art deco, but art deco that's seen better days," added Johnson.

Johnson said the play should provide plenty of laughter in a style and setting not seen every day. "It's a style piece that's driven by that sense of style."

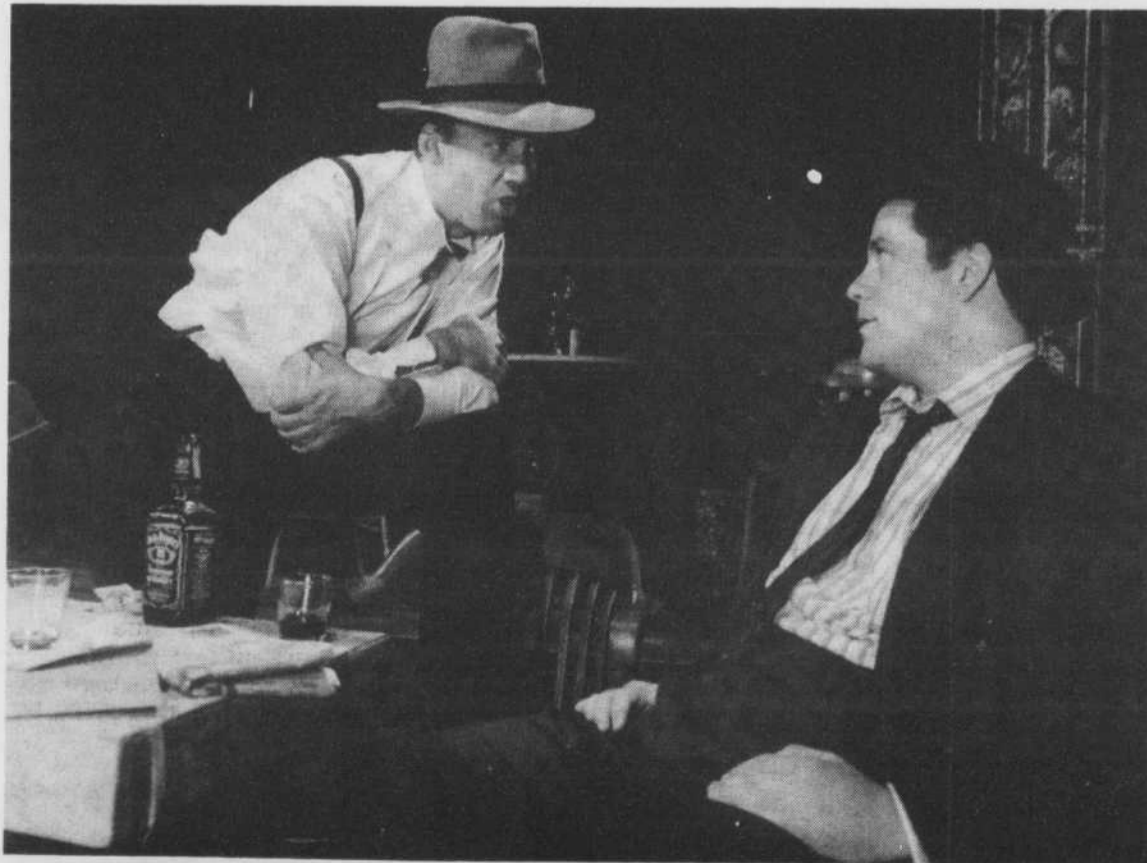
