Blue Rodeo musician slides into Sherbrooke for solo show

In recent years, it's been easier to catch Bob Egan playing to thousands with North America's best-known alternative country rock bands. His solo show in the intimate setting of the basement of Sherbrooke's Café Bla Bla this weekend will be a rare treat.

"I'll take them on a journey for a couple of hours," promised Egan, explaining the show will take his audience to different musical places.

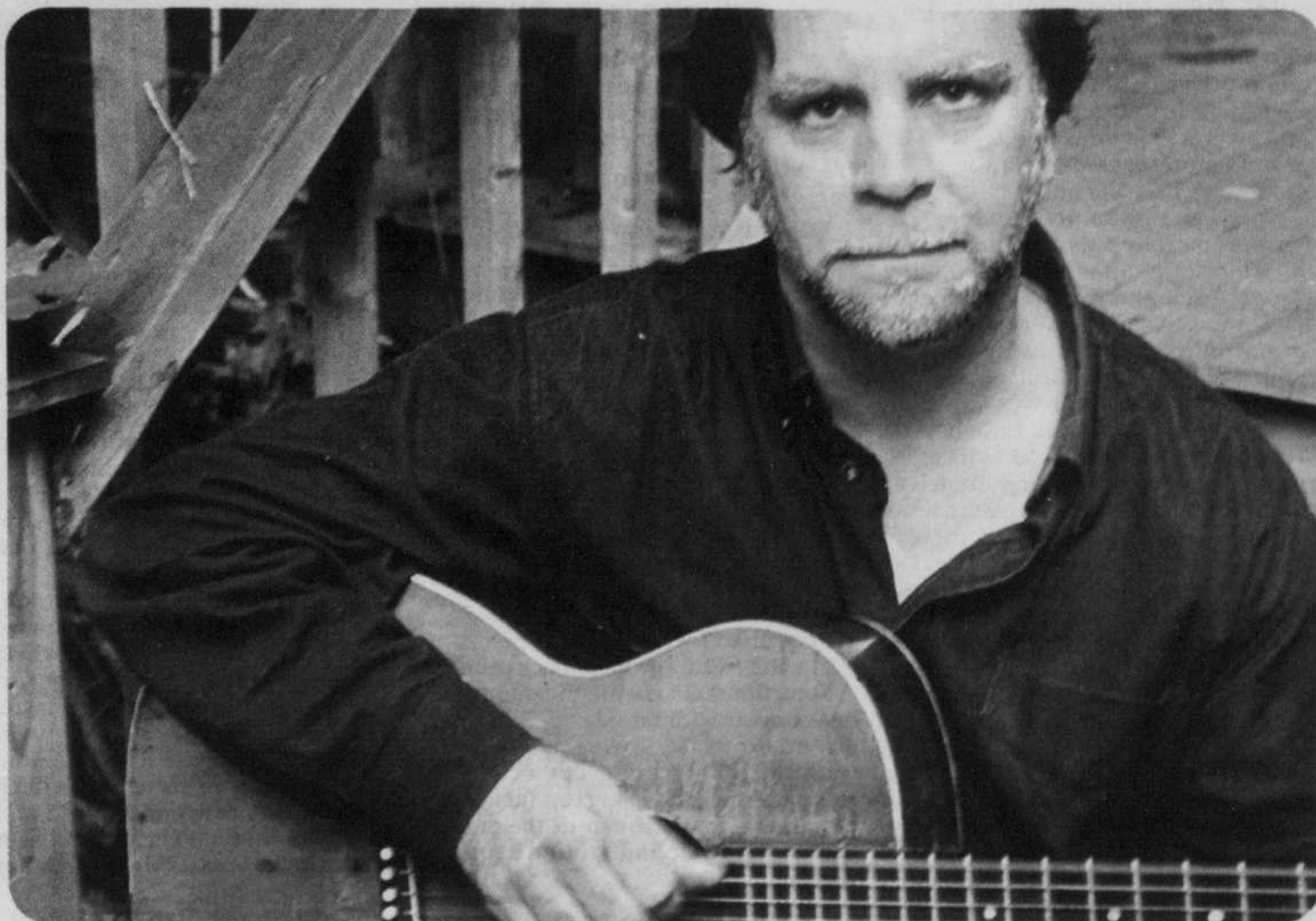
Egan has gained his reputation playing the pedal steel guitar — a guitar neck mounted on a stand equipped with foot pedals — from the lap steel family. He will have an assortment of guitars — including pedal steel and slide — in his toolbox for the Sherbrooke show.

Egan's ear first tuned to the pedal steel when he heard it played on albums by the Rolling Stones, Ry Cooder, and Dwayne Allman.

"When the first country rock wave kind of hit down in Illinois — that was about '75 or '76 — that's when I got a pedal steel and started playing that style," said Egan, who spent a lot of time living near Chicago, though he was born two states over in Minnesota.

The pedal steel guitar remains a lesser-known instrument, but its stock is rising again. Egan points out Daniel

Duck with maple syrup glaze is Tremblant chef's trademark dish

I recently got back from a short trip to Mont Tremblant, where I did some spring skiing (my first time!) and stayed at a new hotel, the Château Beauvallon. Far from the madding crowd of the actual ski hill, nestled between the woods and a private little lake, the U-shaped hotel, painted a sunny yellow, was built around a pretty garden with outdoor jacuzzi and pool.

The place is as family-friendly as can be, with murphy beds and kitchenettes in almost all suites, shuttles taking people back and forth to the mountain, movies shown every night in a common room and a casual restaurant, the Bon Vivant Grill, where kids are more than welcome.

The Grill's chef, Marc Laroche, is a Tremblant veteran with 25 years of experience working at different hotels at the resort and elsewhere, and an advocate of cooking with regional ingredients, such as duck from a nearby organic farm and the abundant (and excellent) local maple syrup.

One night he demonstrated to the group I was with how to cook up such ingredients. At the hotel's Presidential Suite, equipped with open kitchen, he prepared his trademark lacquered duck breast with maple syrup and tarragon while we sipped wine and watched him (he'll do the same for any group, upon request).

Although I usually steer away from



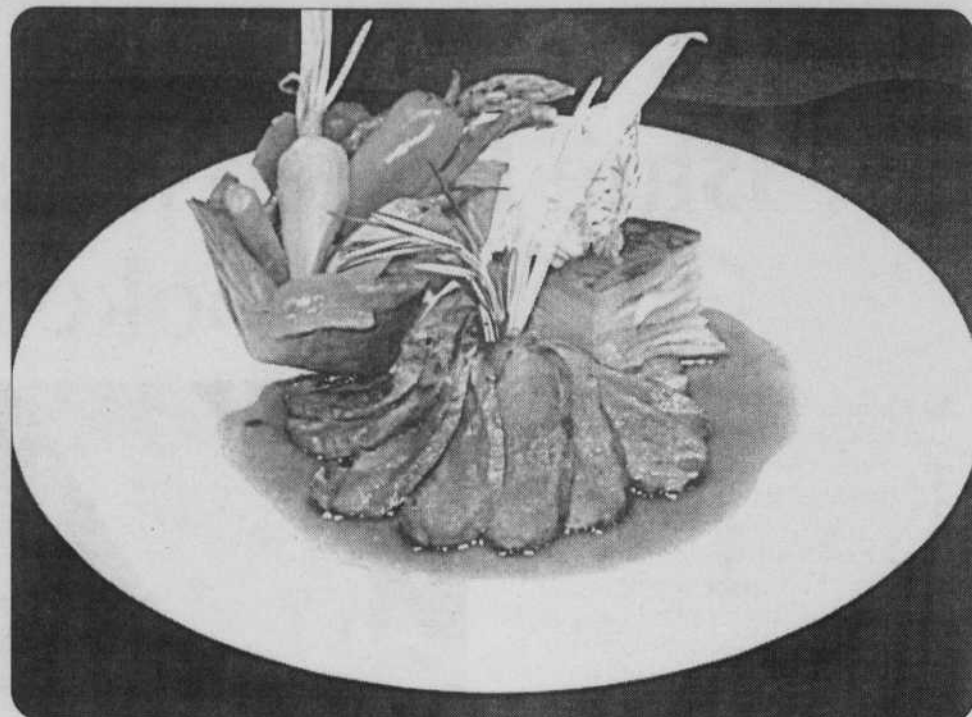

duck, afraid of overcooking it, the how-to seemed a lot easier than I had expected, so I decided to share the recipe with you. This versatile dish goes well with many different sides: roasted veggies, mashed potatoes, polenta or even plain rice. Try it on a special night, when you've got guests to impress.

LACQUERED DUCK BREAST WITH MAPLE SYRUP AND TARRAGON

- Ingredients (for four people):
- 2 large duck breasts, (about 500 g each)
 - 1 1/2 cups beef or duck demi-glace (buy dry mix and blend with water following package instructions)
 - 1 cup high-quality maple syrup
 - 1/2 cup white wine
 - 6 branches fresh tarragon chopped or 2 tsp dry tarragon
 - 4 shallots, peeled and sliced (can be substituted for 1 red onion)
 - 2 tsp olive oil
 - 1 tbsp. butter
 - 1 tsp. dried thyme
 - Salt and freshly ground black pepper

Directions: On cutting board, place duck breasts with fat side up. Trim and discard excess fat, leaving a thin layer. With the tip of a knife, cut a criss-cross pattern on fat, being careful not to cut all the way through to the meat. Season with salt and ground pepper. Reserve.

In saucepan, combine the sliced shallots, white wine, half the tarragon, thyme, black pepper and salt. Bring to boil and let it cook until volume is reduced by half. Add half the maple syrup and the demi-glace. Keep simmering until it boils down to a thick syrup-like consistency.

Remove sauce from heat and strain, discarding the solids. Return the sauce to the pan. Add the butter and whisk vigorously. Add the remaining tarragon, and salt and pepper to taste. Cover and keep warm.

Preheat oven to 375 F. Heat a non-stick frying pan on stove. Place duck breasts fat side down on the pan and cook for 4 minutes. Remove from heat and brush the breasts with the other

half of the syrup. Transfer to a baking dish or pan and place in preheated oven and cook for 10 minutes or until juice trickles out from the side of breasts.

Be careful not to overcook!

To avoid losing the juices, let the meat rest, covered with tin foil, for at least five minutes before cutting. Place duck on clean cutting board and cut into thin slices.

Pour a bit of sauce on each plate. Place duck slices on top of sauce, fanned out (half a breast per person), and serve at once, with whatever side dish you've chosen.

Garnish with tarragon and bring the remaining sauce to the table, reheated, of course, in a gravy boat.

Time to bring back the Sunday family feast

The Sunday lunch is the perfect family meal. Brunch is too finicky; dinner is too fancy. But lunch is leisurely, a meal for lingering, for savouring, for catching up on the week's news.

Lunch gives us time to go to church or the gym beforehand, and time afterward to get ready for the week to come. It also gives the cook time to put a roast in the oven and the guests time to get there, even if it means going over the river and through the woods.

Sadly, though, the Sunday lunch is a thing of the past, an Old World tradition lost in a new world of over-scheduled

lives and far-flung families.

We say it's time to bring back this lovely tradition, starting with our easy Easter feast.

Sunday lunch should be a little bit relaxed — not, say, yoga-pants-at-the-table relaxed, but definitely less formal than dinner.

That goes for the food and the place settings, too. There's no need for complicated sauces, multiple side dishes and fancy desserts — a simple roast, a single veg, an easy starter and something sweet to finish are all you need.

For a spring feast, you'll want to serve the pretty green things that are coming

into season right now.

A simple salad provides a fresh start to the meal, especially when served with a savoury

After that, nothing could be more seasonably delicious than roast lamb. For a small gathering, serve tender, sweet rack of lamb — one rack is enough for two people — slathered in mustard and herbs and roasted just until it is pink. For a larger crowd, prepare a juicy leg of lamb studded with garlic, and you'll have plenty of leftovers for sandwiches afterwards.

For sides, all you need are some baby new potatoes, perhaps roasted with rosemary and sea salt, and some fresh as-

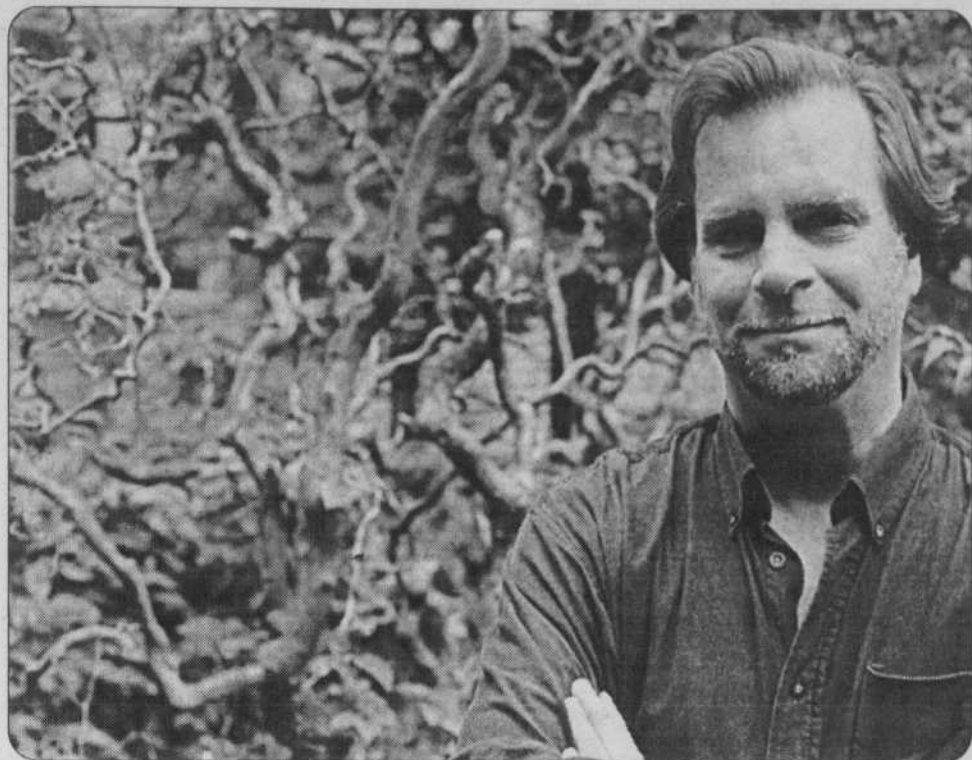
paragus.

No need to fuss with hollandaise sauce — you can get all the buttery, citrusy goodness by dabbing the green spears with a lemony herb butter.

To finish, you can pick something up at the bakery or simply arrange strawberries, grapes and other fruits on a platter along with a festive flock of chocolate Easter bunnies.

And remember, the Sunday lunch should start a little late, say, 1 or 2 p.m., and can last well into the afternoon. After all, you're not in a rush to get back to the office, are you?

Lanois's new instrumental album, which prominently features the pedal steel, picked up a Juno last week.

Though he always dreamed of going into music, Egan gave in to his parent's pleas that he get an education and another line of work. He was "a suit and tie guy" for several years, before he started his own business, running a guitar repair shop.

Egan's life took a U-turn after a concert with for the up and coming songwriter, Jeff Tweedy. He was invited to join Tweedy's alternative country rock band, Wilco.

"It was a kid's dream come true. When Wilco asked me to join them I had to sell my business and go on the road for the first time in my life. Cut all the ties and never look back."

For the next two years, Egan toured with the alternative country rockers promoting the album *Being There*.

"We criss-crossed the U. S. easily eight or nine times. Each tour, things went up a level. We went from 500 seat clubs, to 1,000 seat halls, to 2,000 seat theatres, to selling out the Fillmore in San Francisco a couple of nights in a row," Egan recalled.

After a few years with the band, Wilco headed in a different direction, and Egan began working on his short-lived solo career. Egan found himself opening for Jim Cuddy — from Canada's alt country darlings Blue Rodeo — and he was invited to join Cuddy's band.

"Blue Rodeo brought me here," said Egan.

Egan was a fit for the band. It was an opportunity to reach large audiences, and to attract audiences for his solo shows.

"Musically, they've given me pretty free reign to come in and do my thing. I have all that great material, and voices, and rhythm to work with. It's really al-

lowed me to become a much better player."

While Blue Rodeo remains Egan's main project, his solo career is starting to take off. His third album is recorded, and all but finished; he's now working on distribution deals and choosing the artwork for the cover.

"It's something I've been working on for years. We'll put it out there this summer and see what happens."

It appears Egan will have no problem finding places to showcase his talents as he tours his solo album.

"I constantly have to check to see what the current date actually is, because I'm living two, three, four months out."

Already, he's delving into his next project — an instrumental pedal steel album. He's been encouraged by the reaction he's gotten from audiences.

"When people hear it, they're blown away. It's a pretty amazing little instrument. I think my job is to get more people to hear it and blow them away."

That's what he hopes to do in Sherbrooke. Egan said playing shows, like the one tonight at Café Bla Bla, are where he can really communicate through his music.

"I play in front of thousands of people per night with Blue Rodeo, so it's a real treat to get in a room with 50 to 100 people and look them in the eyes and play directly to them. It's very, very satisfying."

Still, Egan seems to have found the perfect balance since moving to southern Ontario to pick up with Blue Rodeo. As someone whose music career kicked off late, he doesn't take it for granted.

"These are the opportunities you've prayed for your whole life. To go out and build a fan base and play shows, and see the world. I don't think about it much, I'm just doin' what I'm supposed to be doin'. Does that make sense?"

Alien acoustics to mesmerize modern music fans at museum

American electronic musician Robert Rich performs a style of music that defies category, though it helped define ambient, tribal, and trance genres.

"I was trying to create a music of another species, or an alien life form," said Rich of one of his more recent albums.

Even the artist, who will be performing at Sherbrooke's Musée des beaux-arts this weekend, has a hard time coming up with a description for what he does.

"It's always been a weakness for me," said Rich in an interview from the road somewhere between Fort Worth, Texas and Memphis, Tennessee.

"I have trouble finding really good

words that don't create lots of hyphenations and backpedaling in regards to other people's assumptions with genres. It doesn't fit a genre very clearly."

Rich chooses to describe it as "deep listening music," a term he employs because it focuses on how people hear the music rather than what he wants to get across.

Rich's music is experimental to say the least. Over the last quarter century, the prolific artist has churned out 30 albums. As he is constantly trying to rediscover and create new sounds, each album is different.

"The irony is that I've had albums on industrial noise labels, and death metal sub-labels and all sorts of strange things, but at the same time I play in cathedrals and planetariums and much

more refined environments," said Rich, adding his music was relegated to the New Age rack in the 1980s because that's how the label wanted to market it.

Rich's music is in the tradition of Brian Eno or Steve Roach, artists whose music is to be experienced, as much as it is to be enjoyed.

"There are certain people that go, 'this is the kind of music that I've always heard in my head.' They recognize it like they've always been listening to it," said Rich, who was behind the legendary all-night sleep concerts in California.

The roots of Rich's music are so widespread, it's no wonder people relate so closely. His musical influences criss-cross international boundaries and musical genres, everything from African classical to German space music, and from sacred to psychedelic rock.

"There's a whole string that connects all of these traditions. That is something that deals with music as a source of energy or as a source of communication of the ineffable."

Since he was a teenager, Rich has been pulling apart synthesizers and putting them back together, searching for new sounds. More recently, he began building his own synthesizers and has a lucrative side business developing sound libraries for synthesizer companies.

He also produces mood music for film scores, in the same vein as Philip Glass.

Though he plays several instruments, Rich thinks of himself less as an instrumentalist and more as someone hunting for new sounds.

"They all become sound sources for a kind of sonic stew that I want to create."

Sherbrooke will be Rich's only Canadian date on this tour. He said a fan invited him to come and he jumped at the chance.

"It's the same way I end up playing almost everywhere. I have a listener who really, really wants me to be there and he had the wherewithal, the energy, and the contacts to let people know and make it happen."

Erich Langlois is the listener who is bringing Rich to the Musée des beaux-arts.

Langlois came across Rich's music more than a decade ago, and has maintained an interest.

"I'm a first timer producing a concert," said the Sherbrooke native. "It's pretty exciting for us to have this kind of musician, so humble and so talented, coming to our town."

Langlois admits setting up the show has its complications, but he said Rich has been very good to work with along the way. He noted Sherbrooke has a dynamic music scene, but Rich's style offers something completely different from what people are doing here.

"This is very grassroots," said Rich about the invitation to the Townships. "It's not something that is supported by an industry, it's not a big selling commercial kind of thing. But it's the kind of music that reaches people very personally."

Rich said the show will be a mélange of his work from the past 15 years. In addition, a film projection will accompany the music for the first set. Later, a laser show he designed will light up the room.

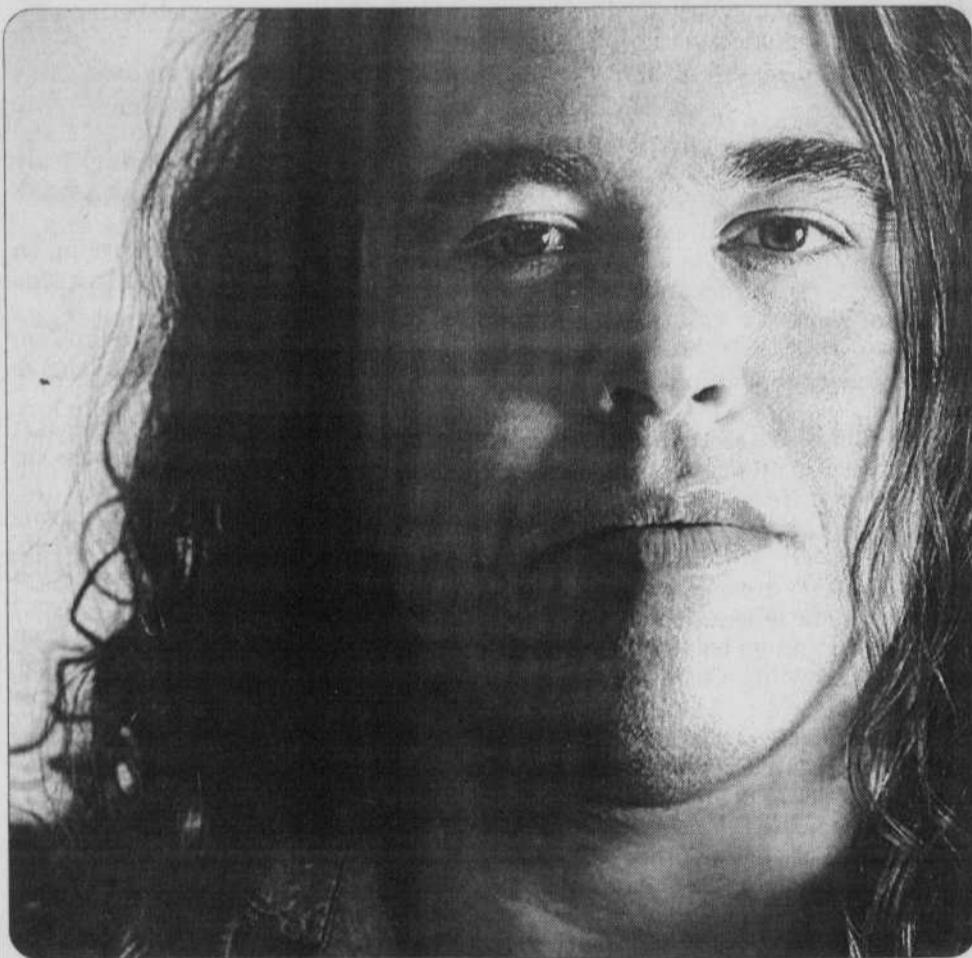
As always, Rich will improvise and search for elements of sound as he performs.

"For me it's the joy of discovery. To stay interested as an artist, I'm the sort of person who just tries to forget what I've done in the past, and break my habits, forget the techniques I've learned, and devise new ones each time."

Québécois musician Martin Deschamps keeps on rocking

When Québécois rocker Martin Deschamps was asked in the late 1990s to front legendary band Offenbach, the small man with a booming voice said yes immediately.

Undaunted by the pressure of replacing the band's late singer, local legend Gerry Boulet, Deschamps, who is disabled, saw it as an opportunity to do what he loves best, on the grandest stage of all.

"It gave me a chance to show what I

could do to larger crowds - to rock and bring the house down," he told The Record recently, explaining that the 50-concert adventure gave him credibility within the province's music industry. "It was like my own school of rock. There was pressure (replacing Boulet) but hey, maybe I was meant to be a legend too."

Local artist sees career finally on the fast track

Young Cowansville artist Marie-Andrée Leblond returned to Galerie Knowlton last weekend, talking with patrons and showing her latest collection of paintings, extending her enduring themes of roosters, horses, nudes and dancers.

Metallica and Deep Purple.

Deschamps' disability — he was born with two fingers on one hand and an underdeveloped left arm — has never been a disadvantage for the determined musician growing up.

"It was never a problem for me. It's all about attitude. Kids can be cruel but I just made friends with the biggest one of them all," he laughed.

As a child, Deschamps regularly listened to a variety of albums his parents had at home. That repertoire included Perry Como, Aretha Franklin, Les Classels and Latin and Merengue artists.

Confronted regularly by questions about rock 'n' roll's future in la Belle Province, Deschamps dismisses those who claim profitability only runs through pop music in Quebec.

"There's a huge fan base (for rock 'n' roll), there are people who need to have it, get their fix," the father of one said. "But it just doesn't get enough attention from the industry or musicians."

On Intense, an album produced by Glen Robinson who has worked The Tea Party, Tori Amos and Keith Richards, Deschamps goes back to his rock 'n' roll roots for a much grittier and darker sound.

"I try to create a classic every time I write a song. If it doesn't sound like a classic in my head then it's not making its way on to an album," he explained. "This one (Intense) is a lot like the first album (Comme je suis, 2000) It was a great process because we got together often to work on the music and just to rock. People will feel the vibe, feel the heart we put into this one."

"Every album is like a new start for me. A new opportunity to impress rock fans with the music."

Actor Morgan is everywhere these days

Jeffrey Dean Morgan has spent the winter waiting for a heart transplant. But he's also had a second life — as a ghost-busting father helping his sons fight off demons. And if this isn't enough, he's also the ghost of Mary Louise Parker's dead husband.

Yes, Morgan is an actor — but he's an actor with a triple assignment, one which constantly keeps him hopping back and forth between Vancouver and Southern California.

"There are times when I'm just so tired," he laughs. It's one of his rare days off, and the 39-year-old actor sitting in a restaurant in North Los Angeles, marveling at the fact that he has recurring roles in three shows — the hugely successful hospital series, *Grey's Anatomy*, in which he plays Denny, a marine biologist in need of a heart transplant; the Vancouver-filmed WB suspense series, *Supernatural*, about two estranged brothers who reunite when their father, played by Morgan, mysteriously disappears; and the popular cable series, *Weeds*, in which he plays a deceased spouse who haunts the memory of Mary Louise Parker.

His presence on *Grey's Anatomy* has helped turn the ABC-CTV series into the new king of Sunday night television. In the U.S., the medical show has been on a roll ever since it chalked up 38 million viewers on Super Bowl weekend.

In Canada, the darkly handsome actor is also creating a buzz with viewers, thanks to be a budding romance with Katherine Heigl's Dr. Izzie Stevens. "What a smile!" burred one female viewer on CTV's Web site forum. "Like to see more of this character!"

These days, every morning when he arrives for work on *Grey's Anatomy*, there's mail waiting for him. "I've also noticed in the last month that I have trouble getting out of the airports in Vancouver and Los Angeles without being recognized six or seven times."

Morgan says he got hooked on *Grey's Anatomy* even before he joined the series.

"The writing is so brilliant and the characters are so well developed. I think

that's why viewers have been drawn to it — the great characters. It's so rare for television shows to do this. There are so many where you don't get to know the characters and actually care about them — what each of them is going through, their romantic lives and their families."

Morgan's character first showed up on the series in January.

"Everyone in the hospital knew me. He comes in for a heart transplant, and the heart he was supposed to get ends up not being viable, so he leaves the hospital and he goes his merry way, and we don't know if we'll ever see him again. But now he's come back on the show — rushed to hospital a couple of weeks ago with a lot of complications, so now basically he's being kept alive by an artificial heart."

Morgan knows he's in the series to the end of the season — but, no, he doesn't know what's going to happen to him.

"I hope he gets his heart and lives happily ever after."

Furthermore, he's as intrigued as the viewers about the future of his relationship with Heigl.

"There was an immediate attraction here. I think Denny is a really charming guy, and even with this heart issue, I think the minute he saw her, he saw the girl of his dreams. And regardless of his condition, he was going to be charming and flirt away, which is what he's done."

Morgan loves this character. "Denny is the man I want to be without the heart condition. He's honest. He's funny. He says what's on his mind, he's a good guy, so playing him has been nothing but a pleasure."

Weeds hasn't yet started shooting its new season, which is fortunate for Morgan because he admits doing *Supernatural* and *Grey's Anatomy* simultaneously are already proving stressful. In fact, he collapsed on the set of *Supernatural* in Vancouver the other day, and a doctor had to be called in. He knows now that he must pace himself.

The schedule he's been following explains why. He gives one typical two-week example

night late. I have Saturday off, and on Sunday I fly to Vancouver. I get in Sunday night, work Monday morning on *Supernatural*, get on a Monday evening plane, and am at work at 6 in the morning Tuesday in L.A. I fly out Wednesday at 6 a.m., work all night Wednesday in Vancouver, and stay there 11 consecutive days."

Then it's back to L.A. for work on *Grey's Anatomy* before leaving for another two-day stint in Vancouver.

Currently, he's also a prominent presence on *Supernatural*. "The boys have been looking for their dad all season and you've seen me briefly, but now we're reunited till the end of the season trying to destroy the killer of my wife and their mother."

The Seattle-born Morgan originally wanted to be a writer — "a sort of Beat poet of the 80s" — and had never dreamed of an acting career. But everything changed when he helped an actor friend drive a U-Haul to Southern California. "I never left. I decided to take an acting class, and got a movie role in six months."

He considers that he's been lucky over the past 15 years, having worked in series

as varied as *Monk*, *CSI* and *Star Trek: Enterprise*. Yet it was only a year ago, that he wondered whether his bubble had burst. That was when his manager of eight years called him and bluntly said: "Jeff, I can't rebuild your career. It's not going to happen for you."

The next day, Morgan hired another manager, and the day after that was hired for *Supernatural*. Then came *Weeds*, followed by *Grey's Anatomy* in November. He also found himself confronted with a tough decision: just as he was about to sign for *Grey's Anatomy*, he was offered the role of Nicolas Cage's brother in Oliver Stone's new 9/11 movie.

"I had to choose between the two projects," he says now. He finally opted for *Grey's Anatomy* after Stone wouldn't let him see a script. Besides, there was his mother to think of. "She probably would have killed me if I hadn't done it. She's such a fan of the show."

But it still feels sweet to be in a position where he actually had to make a choice and turn down Oliver Stone. "It's a sign that my life is completely turned around."

British thrillers roundup

When reality bites, escapism is good

Already half over, the first decade of the Third Millennium has not been especially kind, what with tsunamis, hurricanes, wars, and the threats of global warming and viral pandemics.

Much recent crime writing has taken a similar path, focusing on the darker corners of the human soul, and exploring natural catastrophes and imaginative ways for twisted human beings to inflict suffering on one another.

It is, encouraging, then, that there persists a market for traditional mystery fiction, with its emphasis on genuine puzzles for plots, set in a sequestered world inhabited by mostly gentle eccentrics.

This week's author stands out amongst those who write "cozies," as such novels are termed, both for the quality and the quantity of his writing.

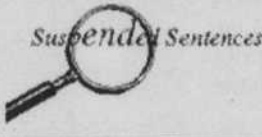
Although some readers might see such novels as irrelevant in today's turbulent world, I would argue that they are precisely the opposite: Never have we needed more urgently novels that remind us that there is a more prosaic, gentler (if occasionally murderous) and indeed humorous world out there than the one described in the turgid headlines of our daily newspapers.

THE AUTHOR

One of Britain's most prolific contemporary crime writers, Simon Brett began his career in the creative arts as a radio and television producer before turning to writing novels full-time.

Viewers may recall his charming do-

mestic comedy, *After Henry*, starring Prunella Scales (of *Fawlty Towers* fame), which aired on British, and later on Canadian, television.

Over the past three decades Brett has penned well over 50 novels and plays, as well as editing several classic anthologies in the mystery genre. His 1986 novel, *A*

Shock to the System, was nominated for an Edgar Award, and was later turned into a film starring Michael Caine.

Organized into several distinct series (the Charles Paris novels, the Mrs. Pargeter series, and the Fethering novels), the protagonist may differ, but the novels are, without exception, cozies, deliberately lacking in explicit or graphic violence, but with an always captivating plot, imbued with the sly sense of humour that characterises their author.

Simon Brett lives with his wife and three children in the village of Burpham, near Arundel, in the South Downs.

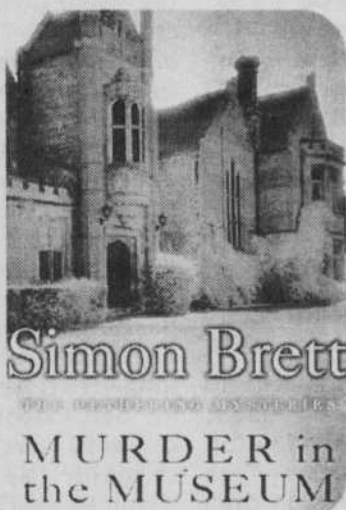
MURDER IN THE MUSEUM (MACMILLAN, 2003)

A country could rest on that. But there are many more, including Hercule Poirot, Commander Adam Dalgliesh, George Smiley and other classic characters. Then there are these recent books — not all classics, but many striking.

Above Suspicion
By Lynda La Plante
Simon & Schuster

As creator of the ferocious London detective Chief Inspector Jane Tennyson, screenwriter La Plante knows a thing or 200 about creating tough, complex sleuths.

So the real mystery in this epic tale of the search for a serial killer preying on London-area prostitutes is why she wastes so much time on the bland main character, rookie police officer

Anna Travis, giving short shrift to the book's real dynamo — Travis's boss, DCI James Langton, who kind of resembles Dr. Gregory House from the TV series *House*.

Perky, vacant Travis is Nancy Drew-complex, while the rule-breaking, dogged, moody Langton, largely on the sidelines, is an intriguing creation — especially when he puts Travis out as bait for a prime suspect who has taken a fancy to her.

A Langton-focused mystery might be an A-grade read. As it is, *Suspicion* is a

solid C+, redeemed by La Plante's mastery in making the challenging investigation riveting. Warning: Even by the standards of this genre, this is a gruesome book.

Aggressor

McNab continues excavating his past as an ex-member of Britain's Special Air Service commando unit with this novel featuring SAS veteran Nick Stone. Stone heads to the ex-Soviet republic of Georgia, tracking a former colleague eager to make big bucks on a risky freelance job. Everything goes wrong, of course.

Aggressor is rich in interesting tradecraft and details of a commando's craft and attitude. But insider knowledge does not necessarily add up to a compelling storyline, and the plotting here is a

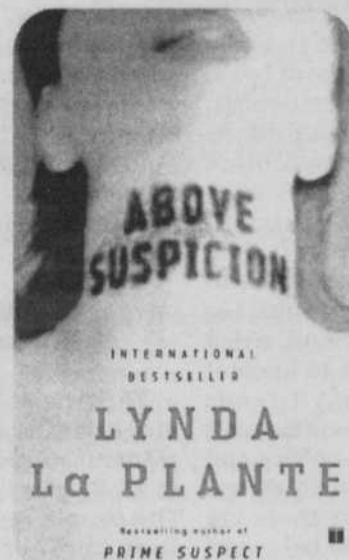
bit sluggish.

The Old Wine Shades: A Richard Jury Mystery, By Martha Grimes

The whimsy levels run so toxically high here that, at one point, Grimes has a dog as narrator. Did you hear about the musician who left his banjo in the car, ran an errand, and came back to find the car window smashed? Panic-stricken, he ran to the car to find not only his own banjo still there, but another banjo deposited on the seat next to it. There are probably as many jokes about banjo players as there are about trombonists; they just don't get respect. But maybe the jokers haven't heard Nova Scotia's Chris "Old Man" Luedecke. The singer-songwriter happens to play the much-maligned instrument, and play it well, although one tends to listen more to what he has to say when he sings. For the opening track of *Hinterland*, titled 'I Quit My Job', it's difficult to know if he's being earnest ("All my friends work their dreams with their hands") or ironic ("I can always live on rice and potatoes"). He has a songwriter's eye for imagery ("At the airport there are kisses there that cannot be believed" he sings, sliding up to hit a falsetto note) and a songwriter's penchant for the telling of truths ('The Wrong Side of the Country' finds him realizing he's not cut out for the travelling troubadour role, being homesick and unhappy in Vancouver). He shows his talent on the banjo on the instrumental 'Salute to Gold River', where he's joined by fiddle player Laura Federson. Steve Dawson lends his fine guitar to several tracks.

Brazilian Lounge
Putumayo/Koch

Bebel Gilberto isn't the only hot artist to come from Brazil; the country is full of them, and the world full of expatriate Brazilians making fine music. The Putumayo label includes Gilberto, who performs 'August Day Song', and 11 other acts, in this



compilation which will please some traditionalists, but a lot more new disciples of the music. Traditionalists will find identifiable Brazilian music forms (samba, bossa nova), while a newer crowd will appreciate the blend of electronic and acoustic instruments and the presence of DJ mixes on some of the tracks. This is the case on 'Como You Fazer? (Remix)', where Mariana de Moraes sings a bossa nova arrangement by the producer-musician duo Dois Irmaos, who go heavy on swirling electronic sounds. 'Parece Mentira' has a similar mix, with vocalist Katia B singing sensually over a tasty mix of percussion and electronics. Seu Jorge, the Brazilian musician on board Bill Murray's boat in the movie *The Life Aquatic with Steve Zissou*, contributes a deep baritone local on 'E Depois', an offering from star producer and musician BiD.

The title of this compilation pretty much says it all. Every song on this album features the ubiquitous cowbell in all its glory. The people responsible for this may have put together the album with tongue firmly planted in cheek, but it's good fun nonetheless. Leading off with the song immortalized on Saturday Night Live with the line "More Cowbell!" '(Don't Fear) The Reaper' by Blue Oyster Cult lets the listener know the compilation will be top-heavy with classic 70s-era rock. The album does include some obvious "cowbell" choices, like 'Mississippi Queen' by Mountain and 'We're Not Gonna Take It' from '80s hair metal rockers Twisted Sister. There are some surprise choices like 'Burning Love' by Elvis Presley, not the first guy you'd think of when you think cowbell. The same goes for 'Working for the Weekend' by Canadian '80s rockers Loverboy. The cowbell is relatively absent from the song, save for the opening four beats. This compilation is a real kick to throw on at a party. It's sure to be a hit in frat houses across the continent.

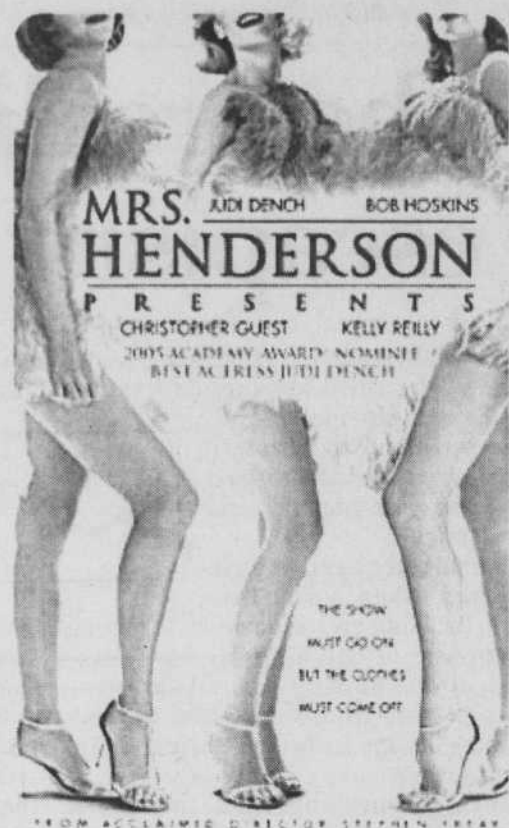
Mrs. Henderson Presents: Dame Judi Dench can bring genuine humanity to characters far removed from our own world, and that's exactly what she does in this perfectly charming, and somewhat melancholy, story of a rich widow who turns a shabby nightclub into London's first venue for nude revues during the Second World War.

The film from director Stephen Frears evokes the era with lighting, art direction, costumes and set decor, but it's really the central performances from Dench and co-star Bob Hoskins that bring a quiet moral focus to the story, and make it memorable.

DVD features include Dolby Digital, audio commentary, the making-of *Mrs. Henderson Presents*, trailers and bonus featurettes. (Parental Guidance: contains nudity, mature theme.)

Rating: three-and-a-half stars out of five.

ANI DIFRANCO
*Carnegie Hall 4.6.02**Righteous Babe/Festival*

Seven months after the Sept. 11 terrorist attacks, Ani DiFranco brought her solo act to New York's Carnegie Hall and, at a time when social commentary was scarcely heard in America,



shared her views on country and world through her songs. This is a document of that often dramatic musical event. DiFranco, who has lived in New York since the early 1990s, wastes no time making her opinions known. The lyrics of the opener, 'God's Country', take on the religious right(eous), and 'Subdivision' examines the race and class divisions in America. 'Not So Soft', one of three spoken-word offerings on the CD, describes the commercial goings-on in New York's financial district (site of the doomed World Trade Center), and you sense the audience holding its breath as she talks about "burning buildings," which in

this case is a reference to the sun shining down through the glass and concrete. Whew. Then, almost 50 minutes into the concert, she performs 'Serpentine', a new song which slashes at the George Bush regime ("Uncle Sam is rigging cockfights in the promised land") and, questioning the media, contains the line "Freedom of the press is meaningless if nobody asks a question." Her vocal style and phrasing here is reminiscent of Joni Mitchell, passionate and inventive, the improvising spirit of jazz taking over the songwriter. 'Serpentine' sets the stage for 'Self Evident', a long, intense spoken-word offering that takes the listener inside the Trade Centre towers, trying to shed light on something that will never make sense. When she finishes this song there is utter silence for several seconds until the audience breaks into an ovation. A good editor might have limited the nervous, giggling patter between songs, although one could make the case that this is part of the performance. DiFranco is known for writing songs that are deeply personal, and Carnegie Hall 4.6.02 may go deeper than anything she's ever done.

Scary Movie 4 skewers War Of The Worlds and Brokeback Mountain

When Steven Spielberg unveiled War Of The Worlds a year ago, nobody was happier than veteran comedy director David Zucker.

But then there was an unexpected bonus when star Tom Cruise did his extraordinary sofa-bouncing routine on the Oprah show as a way of demonstrating his love for Katie Holmes. This left Zucker ecstatic.

It meant that he had been delivered two succulent setpieces for his new contribution to the Scary Movie franchise. He and his writers would cheerfully eviscerate Spielberg's take on alien invaders — and concoct an extended sequence of yucks from the film's most gripping moments. In the case of Cruise's Oprah antics, he knew that he had a cast member — Craig Bierko — who would more than rise to the occasion in a memorably manic display.

"These things are gifts," chortles Zucker. "Just like the existence of M. Night Shyamalan is a gift. If I met him on the street, I'd shake his hand."

The Village, Shyamalan's offbeat thriller about a strange 19th-century sect with a fear of the outside world, also gets lampooned in Scary Movie 4, opening April 14. For Zucker, for whom nothing is sacred when it comes to Hollywood product, the general solemnity of Shyamalan's films makes them irresistible.

"That's why makes them so wonderful," the 59-year-old filmmaker explains. "He has no sense of humour." But, adds Zucker, Steven Spielberg does have a sense of humour — and "he loves all our movies."

Whether Shyamalan will love Scary

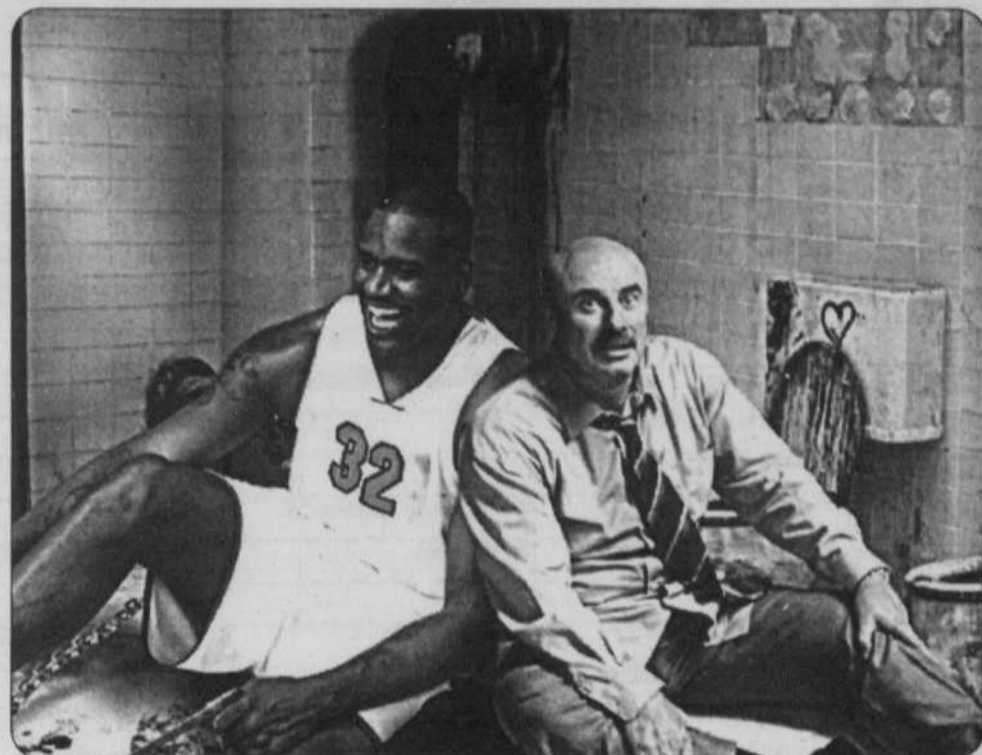
Movie 4 is another matter — particularly when it comes to a voluptuous Carmen Electra's scatological takeoff on Bryce Howard's portrayal of The Village's blind and innocent heroine.

However, the Hollywood production factory made further contributions to Zucker's list of favourite things during the 18 months preceding the arrival of his new film. Scary Movie 4 opens with a send-up of the two gruesome Saw movies with television's Dr. Phil and Shaquille O'Neill playing the chained victims and later makes enthusiastic comic fodder out of The Grudge and Million Dollar Baby.

Even Brokeback Mountain takes its lumps. That controversial item arrived after Scary Movie 4 had finished filming — and to Zucker, it showed a potential he couldn't ignore. So he brought people back for another two weeks of shooting. "That's kind of been the pattern — we always go back and reshoot."

Zucker's comic credentials include Airplane, his 1980 lampoon of airborne disaster movies, as well as the Naked Gun trilogy and such other hits as Ruthless People and Top Secret. He breathed new life into the Scary Movie franchise when he took on the third film in the sequence and delivered a chunk of box-office gold which earned \$50 million on its opening weekend and ended up grossing more than \$100 million in North America alone.

Given the scattergun approach of a movie which not only targets major Hollywood releases, but also pop culture, current celebrities, music and certain politicians, Scary Movie 4 can't really be expected to deliver a coherent plot. But it is anchored by the return of Anna

Faris as the lovable but cement-brained Cindy Campbell and Regina Hall as her sex-crazed pal, Brenda. And it features a non-stop succession of celebrity cameos featuring the likes of Dr. Phil, Carmen Electra, Bill Pullman, Chris Elliott, Molly Shannon, Anthony Anderson and rappers Chingy, Lil' Jon and Young Bloods.

There are also unbilled cameos — most prominently the spectacle of Charlie Sheen dealing desperately with the effects of an excessive intake of Viagra.

And then of course, there's Zucker's favourite comic actor — Canada's Leslie Nielsen — cavorting about in the nude in the role of an addled U.S. president.

Nielsen, 80 this year, is the quintessential fulfillment of Zucker's comic vision.

"He has the bearing and authority that make him a good comic actor, and he's good at letting the lines do the work. So he's not putting any comic 'spin' into it. My main direction to the

actors is to let the lines do the work and not put any spin into it."

Actors he's worked with before know the drill already. So when it comes to the new people, Zucker needs to remind them to play even the funniest scenes straight. "They find it comforting that I'm saying: 'Don't try to be funny. We don't need you to be Jim Carrey or Robin Williams. Just do the lines.'"

This, says Zucker, is what makes Nielsen such a master. His aging star was "totally game" to do the scene in which the president disrobes at the United Nations. "We read him that scene and he just burst out laughing. He couldn't wait to do it — and he was absolutely great."

After more than a quarter century in the business of manufacturing comedy, both solo and in partnership with Jim Abrahams and his brother Jerry, Zucker has developed some firm theories about the genre.

Newcomer Keith Anderson has what it takes

Music

Keith Anderson is a fresh face on the country music scene and he has a unique sound that young fans will want to hear more often of in the future. His music has so much energy and it's so much fun. This is what you can call feel good music, it is infectious.

Although Keith Anderson is not the vocal powerhouse that some of his fellow artists are, he is still very interesting because of the fresh, sincere and totally enjoyable mix of musical styles he brings together, thanks to his talent as a songwriter. Keith Anderson is determined and knows where he is going in the country music world.

Judging by Anderson's choice of co-writers, John Rich of the duo Big & Rich (who produced the title track) and Jeffrey Steele (who produced the rest of the album), and the fact that he wrote the Gretchen Wilson duet with Big & Rich "The Bed", he clearly takes his influence from their Muzik Mafia world on this

raw, ripping debut. There's also a penchant for partying here and the themes found on the album like drinking, making up (and out), and still more partying are recurrent. This is one album that's bound to stand out. And it just might get some airplay, considering the current trend towards edgy. Oklahoma native Anderson is not that rowdy. He is actually a well-educated man who likes his music to rock.

Every song Keith sings sounds like a hit, and that includes "Pickin' Wildflowers", his romping debut single, a flirtatious number which leaves very little to the imagination. He had already proven himself as an ace songwriter with the Grammy-nominated "Beer Run (B Double E Double Are You In?)", recorded as a duet by Garth Brooks and George Jones before he even got his record deal.

Well, be prepared to boogie and if you are expecting smooth traditional

country, forget it. Electric guitars melded with screaming fiddles and rollicking pianos. Sure, there are a couple ballads such as "Lazy With your Love", and the truly terrific "I'll Know It When I Get There" and a few more that are more laid back.

"Podunkæ is about the love-hate relationships many have with their small hometowns. The song is really a flawless gem that everyone will love. There's also a beautifully reminiscent tale of unrequited love in the current single "Every Time I Hear Your Name".

You'll also find "Plan B", a tribute to moving on without looking back. But still it is the upbeat, such as the big boy anthem "XXL". "The Clothes Don't Make the Man", is a Gospel number that celebrates God while taking a shot at pedophile clergy. It is tough and not subtle at all but it holds a lot of truth. Producer Steele captures the musician's sense of grit, pain, hope, and worries on the heartfelt ballad "I'll Know When I Get There". Anderson has exceptional talent and he puts his unique spin on his songs.

He was brought up in a small city and like most of the people who are raised in small places, there's an openhearted

friendliness about him. He is an athlete who ended up picking music over sports but still he kept that team player quality

Keith is a native of Miami, OK, a town of 10,000, near the Arkansas border and the Ozark Mountains. His father LeRoy worked as a mechanic and handyman. His mother Janice ran a dog grooming business from home. Anderson grew up being more interested in athletics than music. Then, when he was 14, he saw girls go crazy when his brother sang at a school talent show. After that, he learned to play drums and began playing in his brother's band.

College sidelined Anderson from music temporarily. With his degree in hand, Anderson moved to Dallas and joined a large construction firm. But the call of music was stronger and he quit his job and moved. Music of course did not feed him, so on the side, he worked as a landscaper, personal trainer and model. His hard work and perseverance did the rest.

This album is a true gem. Keith Anderson's new album is one of the best to have come out so far. It's edginess might turn away some, but most will still hear the reverence for traditions in his music.

An absolutely crucial one is that none of these films should last longer than 87 minutes.

"Yeah, but it's decreased now," he laughs. "This one is 83 minutes. The audience gets tired if you go too much longer. Comedy just shouldn't ever go into the 90s. Anywhere in the 80s is fine. It takes a lot of energy to laugh, and if you've done your job, the audience will laugh throughout."

This brings him to another firm rule: be prepared to be ruthless in excising scenes which don't work.

"Probably the most difficult thing for me is to ignore the fact that I've been over the script a million times and done the rehearsals. When it comes to watching the scene unfold, I'm the monitor and I have to put myself in the place of an audience seeing it for the first time."

Once, he gets into this mindset, Zucker has to laugh spontaneously. If he doesn't, then he knows there's a problem with a scene. But if his colleagues hear him "giggling" they know that's a signal "to move on and do another take."

A further testing ground is the test screening. If the preview audience doesn't laugh at a sequence, that sequence will go.

Finding the right material to begin with is a further challenge - especially if you're doing a send-up.

Horror films are an essential component of the Scary Movie strategy and Zucker and his pals were waiting for one which could provide the centre-piece for their new project.

"We were waiting for a big movie, a big scary movie to spoof, and the original plan was to go with Ring 2," he remembers. After all the original

The Ring had helped send Scary Movie 3 on his merry way to box-office heaven. But Ring 2 was a flop.

"It was rejected by the audiences for whatever reason - it may have been due to Scary Movie 3!"

At this point they looked at a more successful supernatural horror movie, The Grudge. They also awaited the arrival of War Of The Worlds, hoping Spielberg wouldn't disappoint them.

"So when War Of The Worlds opened and did huge business, we knew we had our two main movies. So we proceeded to write a story where the Grudge house is next to Tom Cruise's house."

Another rule: don't attempt to spoof a single movie. It doesn't work.

"We can't do the whole movie on any one thing. The best approach is to make these things a hybrid."

Which is why Saw, Brokeback Mountain, The Village and Million Dollar Baby also became part of the mix. "The combination of these parts make an original whole."

mans remain missing.

At its best there is a creepy, cutting edge to this mystery, Grimes's 20th featuring Jury and his quirky associates. But the story occasionally gets bogged down in its own cuteness. The tone and atmosphere here is as British as Tony Blair, but Grimes was born in Pittsburgh and lives in Washington, D.C.

One point of trivia: All of the Jury novels are named for actual British pubs.

Grade: C+

their problems. First, workers preparing the gardens for spring planting unearth a human skull. Its presence raises disturbing questions about a former gardener at Bracketts, Mervyn Hunter, who is serving a life sentence in a nearby minimum-security prison for murder.

When Marla Teischbaum, an American professor researching Chadleigh's life for a biography, seeks access to the Trust archives, her efforts are strongly resisted by the poet's sole surviving relatives, daughter Belinda and grandson Graham Chadleigh-Bewes.

Newly-appointed trustee Carole Seddon tries to thread her way amongst the various contestants in this multifaceted battle of wills. Aided by a literary expert, she doggedly pursues the truth about the enigmatic poet, reaching back to the horrors of Passchendaele and the First World War. In the process she finds herself in mortal jeopardy, with yet more deaths in store.

RECOMMENDATION

Murder in the Museum is an urbane, literate tale that is by turns tragic, engaging, and darkly humorous. It is a perceptive study of the venality that often underlies personal ambition, the corruption that can take place within families, and the posturing and petty conflicts all too characteristic of institutional boards. The village setting is familiar to anyone who has wandered the rural roads of England; the characters are all-too-believable; and the dialogue is crisp and always in character. Murder in the Museum is an excellent cozy, as engaging as it is enjoyable. I recommend it highly.

Previous volumes in the Feathering series include The Body on the Beach, Death on the Downs, The Torso in the Town, and The Hanging in the Hotel. (Do we see a pattern here?) Book seven, The Stabbing in the Stables, was released in March.
