## Do Me Justice returns to Massey-Vanier

**D**o Me Justice is a band built on long-distance relationships. Though the group, who until recently were known as Dev, Matt and Jo, have been friends since their elementary school days at Parkview Elementary in Granby and have been playing music together since their time at Massey-Vanier, getting together for jam sessions and practices is not an easy thing to do these days.

The trio of Matthew Thomson, Devon Jolander and Jonathan Lacoste have dealt with international borders; Lacoste moved to New Mexico after the trio had written their first two original songs, and lengthy stretches of time passed without a single jam session, but through it all the group has stayed together.

"It's funny because I'm always the one that says long-distance relationships never work, and I guess we've managed to keep it working because there's no doubt that since we've been together we've been long distance for more than we've been within the same area code, let alone within a couple hours drive," said Thomson from Mount Allison University in Sackville, New Brunswick. It's Thomson's current geographical situation that has the group playing the long-distance-band game once more. While Thomson is a 15-hour plus drive away, Jolander and Lacoste's bedrooms are within a few feet of one

another as the two are currently roommates in Montreal.

Despite the divide, Do Me Justice makes it work, in part thanks to the wonders of the internet. They exchange ideas and tracks among one another via the web, and like all bands these days, have a MySpace page where, no matter where the band or their fans are, their music is still accessible: [www.myspace.com/devmattandjo](http://www.myspace.com/devmattandjo).

While their website lists over sixty-influences, one listen and it's obvious that their main sound comes from the music vein of semi-jam bands and artists such as the Dave Matthews Band and Ben Harper. "We have a couple of goofy songs on there (their MySpace page) well actually one kind of goofy one and a lot of songs about girls, we kind of found ourselves writing songs about girls 95 per cent of the time," said Thomson, before adding, "we figured we'd buck the trend and start something original, so we decided to write songs about girls."

One such song about

girls," Be Me", a song directly from the Dave Matthews Band vein of music, is a slow, acoustic number that has been generating some attention for the band as it's picked up some radio play in the Eastern Townships.

That's right! Bière Ô Loo is a pub in the region that sells only local micro brewery and imported beers (sixty varieties), plus a selection of 40 different whiskies from around the world. You won't find a typical North-American beer on the premises.

"Because we don't sell any of the major North American-brewery products," says Eric Trudel, husband of owner Veronique Phaneuf, "we are different from all of the other local pubs."

Imagine being in a Quebec bar unable to order a "Molson" or "Labatt". It would be like listening to a radio station in Canada broadcasting more than one language. Has anyone ever heard of CIDI 99.1 FM?

All in a day's work, there was a need to have a "hands-on experience" in order to create the year-old establishment's first CIDI radio spot. Ooh, the sacrifices we have to make on behalf of CIDI.

Now that CIDI may be picked up in certain areas of Waterloo, the divide between Brome Missisquoi and Shefford is finally beginning to dissolve. It's good to know that RCM has a role to play in bringing people together.

There is a European feel to Bière Ô Loo, and a welcome one at that for expatriates Grenville (England) and Bremer (Germany). "This place resembles very much the traditional British Pub," says Grenville, "except that it has more places to sit down."

According to Grenville, England's walk-in pubs have only barstools to sit on and most people have to stand while sipping their favourite brew. Bremer on the other hand was happy to find a Ger-

man beer of his choice available on the menu. All-in-all a good time was had by all CIDI personnel.

Grenville and Bremer were added to the Bière Ô Loo commercial as characters meeting on a Knowlton street corner looking for a place to go for a beer. Bremer mentions in the ad that he knows of "this neat place down the road in Waterloo" and manages to convince Grenville of the benefits of sitting on a terrace overlooking downtown Waterloo, while having a special drink, one that can only be found at Bière Ô Loo.

My, my, radio can be such fun. Please call 1-888-5392098 or 450-242-9873 to see how you can become part of the RCM team. Community building is what we are all about. Wouldn't it be fun to be able to say you had a great day at play today instead of work.

## Who owns the airwaves?

I haven't written an article for several months. Time constraints and the fact that having written 300 to 500 words a week for several years about radio and CJMQ 88.9 FM, left me with little to say.

A brief introduction is in order. CJMQ 88.9 FM is a category A community radio station serving the Eastern Townships. Our transmitter and antenna are located high above Sherbrooke in Fleurimont. Our main offices are located at 184 Queen Street in the borough of Lennoxville.

We transmit at 2000 watts and have a broadcast zone of approximately 50 kilometres.

CJMQ 88.9 FM, is a locally produced English language broadcaster serving the Eastern Townships.

I have decided to start at the very beginning, radio frequencies, and radio waves.

Who owns the air waves over the Eastern Townships? We have to start with this question because so much of our philosophy is based on the answer. Radio transmissions are limited in

the distance that they can travel. While it is true that the stronger in wattage the signal is, the further it can travel, however there is a limit to just how far the radio waves can go. So the answer is that we, the community of the Eastern Townships' own the air waves over our region, or at least we should.

The Canadian government manages and protects the air waves of Canada through its' agencies the CRTC and Industry Canada.

Radio waves can't be seen, even if you squint really hard but they are there. The FM radio band covers a given spectrum of a much larger radio band; 88 MHz to 108 MHz makes up the FM band.

Even if there are no transmitters sending out radio waves on these frequencies, they still exist as a potential for broadcasting.

The potential of the broadcast band over any given region has to be used wisely. With the advent of the first radio broadcasters the frequencies they used were limited to their local region.

All radio broadcasters were, in the beginning locally produced for local use.

The local radio station served the local community, announced local events, advertised local goods and services, was locally owned and operated, very much a part of the community.

As technology evolved it became possible to take the signal of a broadcaster and send it over wires for hundreds of miles to distant locations and then broadcast that signal over someone else's air space that is how networks were born.

Financially networks can be very lucrative. Imagine the cost savings, one broadcaster creates programming usually based in a large urban setting, serving that region and then sends the signal to outlying regions using the air waves that belong to those distant communities with little or no local content, to justify their use of this local resource.

Many of these networks are privately owned. Some are not content with taking one local frequency they often

broadcast over two and sometimes even three frequencies within the same region somewhat reminiscent of the radio jamming tactics of the cold war.

Locally produced Broadcasters are rare, precious and essential to our communities.

Next week I'll delve a deeper into some of the consequences to a community inundated with network feed from large urban centres. These consequences are potentially destructive and detrimental to local economies.

There still exist some communities that don't have networks on their radio band. We'll look at the role local radio plays in these regions and the impact on the community when all you hear on the radio is by you about you, for you.

What price do we pay for the loss of our air waves to large networks? Perhaps the cost is much more than we might at first think, and touches many facets of our day to day life, more on this next week.

Here's something that gives a whole new meaning to the term "getting grounded."

In "Survive This," airing Tuesdays on YTV, eight kids between the ages of 14 and 17 are dropped into the Northern Ontario wilderness and told to fend for themselves.

That isn't quite as coldblooded and brutal as it sounds. But let's just say that an all-you-can-eat buffet for these teenagers consists of bugs, berries, nuts, fungus and whatever they can catch and kill.

The show is something of a spinoff of "Survivorman," Les Stroud's OLN Canada series, in which the musician-survivalist lives through imaginary disasters that leave him in wilderness settings with nothing to get by on but basic equipment and his wits.

For "Survive This," the kids are matched up with Stroud, who puts them through survival training lessons and challenges that are designed to test their physical, emotional and mental stamina and their ingenuity when it comes to creating food and shelter from nothing but natural materials.

"It was a really challenging experience, physically demanding," says Adam Deganis, 15, one of the kids in the show. "I was prepared for it, but you did need to be physically fit."

The series was shot in July and August 2008, and the kids lived in the bush for the whole time, performing a series of group and solo tasks designed to teach them survival skills.

With only a few supplies, the kids were assigned tasks that involved foraging for food, building shelter, finding their way across rough terrain or even helping an "injured" friend.

"It was very much what Les does with his show," says executive producer Vince Comisso. "How do you come to be in a situation? A bus crashes. Your helicopter goes down. Your raft collapses. So we put these kids in that kind of situation and said, 'Now find your way out. Navigate through these areas and find things to eat.'

"They were not given food. They were given survival training, and they had to figure it out."

"And at the end of each episode, we asked, 'Who wants out?' And kids took us up on it. When we started, there were eight kids. By the time we finished, there were four."

Though Deganis comes from very urban Mississauga, Ont., part of Toronto's lakefront urban sprawl, he may have been best equipped for the experience. He's athletic, he hunts and fishes, and he idolizes Stroud.

"He taught us a lot," Deganis says. "He was a good guy to hang out with. I was trying to do as much in our show that he does in his, trying to be exactly like him."

## Tom Everett Scott

With any part he plays, Tom Everett Scott likes having time for research.

That meant learning to play the drums for the Tom Hanks-directed movie "That Thing You Do!" and going out on patrol with Los Angeles cops for his latest role.

In NBC's new Thursday ensemble drama "Southland," Scott portrays Russell Clarke, an L.A. police detective struggling to stay focused on his job while dealing with an unhappy home life. Making the show for producers including John Wells ("ER") is a much happier situation for the boyish Scott.

"On my first day," the actor recalls, "I was 'arresting' some guy and running down alleys and jumping over fences. It was great." For a performer whose past series characters have ranged from a stockbroker ("The Street") to a paramedic ("Saved"), depicting police activity is a different twist.

"I went out on ride-alongs, and it was exciting and eye-opening," Scott reports. "We went to all different sections of Los Angeles. Just on a personal level, it's good to have a better understanding of how it works anyway. Most people's interaction with police is limited and not always positive. This was a good chance to get to know some of these guys."

A husband and a father of two, Scott - also featured in the current Disney movie "Race to Witch Mountain" - understands how officers such as his "Southland" alter ego can run into marital problems.

"Most of these guys work so much, their marriages suffer. This is a very well-crafted drama, and these people are going to be very interesting to watch. It's just a real pleasure to go to work on this."

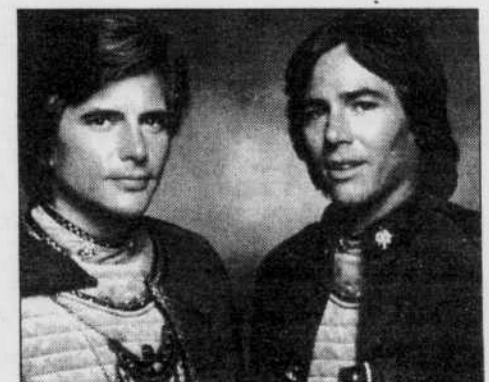

**A:** Though the 44-year-old Brooklyn native has been romantically linked to several men over the years, she remains unattached and completely dedicated to her profession – mainly to the theater. She says the only thing she likes about doing movies is the money.



**Q:** What ever happened to Pam Dawber from "Mork & Mindy"? A friend of mine says she's over 60, and I say she's in her 50s. Who's right? –Margaret Donaldson, Vancouver

**A:** You are. Detroit native Dawber won't be 60 years old until Oct. 18, 2011. Though she is supposed to have an extraordinary singing voice, she started out as a model and studied acting. After doing some stage work and a series of unsuccessful film and TV auditions, she was cast by Robert Altman as one of the leads in his ensemble piece "A Wedding" in 1978. That led to her being signed by ABC to co-star with Robin Williams in "Mork & Mindy" as the young woman with whom spaceman Mork from Ork lives. She has been married to actor Mark Harmon ("NCIS") since 1987. They have two children, one of whom is actor Sean Harmon. She has been retired from TV since 1999.

## Little Edie Beale from 'Grey Gardens'

Drew Barrymore may be known for mood hair – she's now a blonde in the Marilyn Monroe tradition – but she's always been cute and young.

In HBO's "Grey Gardens," airing Saturday, April 18, she pulls off an amazing feat: She's convincing as an 18-year-old and as a 56-year-old. As wonderful as her acting is, she credits the makeup artists, wig makers and costumers who take her from a glamorous debutante in old New York to a very strange hermit in East Hampton.

Playing Little Edie Beale to Jessica Lange's Big Edie in the mother/daughter saga, Barrymore studied her real subject, who was a cousin of Jacqueline Bouvier Kennedy Onassis. The Edies were the subjects of a famed 1973 documentary and a Broadway play.

Little Edie had alopecia, a condition that makes hair fall out. For much of her life, she covered her head with turbans and scarves fastened with a brooch but also with towels and sweaters. She was a fashion iconoclast.

"She wore a shirt as a skirt," Barrymore says. "And safety pins were her best friend. She took a pair of curtains and made them into pants."

This movie had everyone involved with it a bit obsessed.

"It's one of those projects as a costume designer you would just kill to do," says Catherine Thomas, the costumer.

"It is interesting because we had the documentary footage; we could reference what was interesting," Thomas says. "What was challenging were the days leading up to that point. We had photos of Little Edie."

As a young woman entering high society in the 1930s, Little Edie wore those dreamy gowns that

seem lighter than air and float rather than cling. Those that were available were not in good enough condition, so Thomas asked Rosi Zingales at Studio Rouge in New York and Toronto's Seamless Costumes to sew the gowns.

Thomas found silk charmeuse and other fabrics at the Manhattan stores of Mood Designer Fabrics and B&J fabrics. She also used M&J Trimming Co. for accents.

Thomas scoured boutiques and the Internet for accessories. She found jewelry and clothes at New York Vintage and 10ft. Single by Stella Dallas in Brooklyn, and at Right to the Moon Alice she also bought clothes and shoes.

"Women have always worn scarves on their heads," Thomas says. "Whether Little Edie influenced that directly, I don't know. I think why people are so fascinated by her is more her overall sense of fashion and self, more of how she presented herself as an overall package."

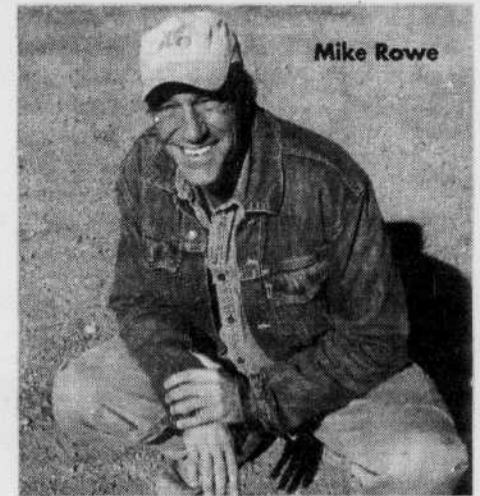

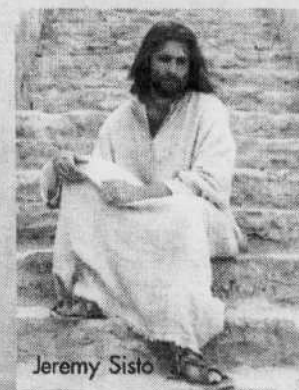

## John Rich records solo album

After being part of a country boy band, the very popular group Lonestar, John Rich teamed up with Big Kenny to create the Muzic Mafia and its entourage, including Gretchen Wilson and Cowboy Troy and more recently John Anderson.

John Rich and Big Kenny also recorded a few albums as the duo Big & Rich. All three Big & Rich albums offered mostly great country party songs such as 'Save a Horse', 'Big Time', 'Comin' to Your City', 'Please Man', and 'Between Raising Hell & Amazing Grace'.

A few years back, Big Kenny Alphin suffered a neck injury in a car crash, which lead him to take a sabbatical from touring in 2008. John Rich decided to use this time off the road with his partner, to revisit a solo career that he started in the late 90's.

He has just released *Son of a Preacher Man*, his second solo album, and first since *Underneath the Same Moon*. That album was recorded in 1999, five years before the first Big and Rich project.

Half of the songs on the new album were written a decade ago and it is a lot closer to traditional country than what he usually does as part of Big & Rich. It seems that his talents are not limited to any one thing or idea.

Overall, this CD showcases John Rich's talent as one of the best singer-songwriters in the business now. The diversity of songs on this album will make it lasting and put him in the same category as the best.

The biggest and most pleasant surprise, is Rich's voice that has really matured. He has always had a higher pitched voice than most country acts and here he sounds really good.

The record kicks-off with Rich's first single, 'Shuttin' Detroit Down', which gets a lot of attention with lyrics such as: 'In the real world their shuttin' Detroit down/While the boss man takes his bonus paid jets on out of town/ DC's bailing out them bankers as the farmers auction ground...' He co-wrote this number with friend John Anderson.

'Preacher Man' is the title track and finds Rich singing about being raised by a father who was a preacher, and how the career he chose probably didn't please his father.

'Trucker Man' is much more than just another song for truckers as it follows up on the blue collar theme developed in the single 'Detroit'.

The same thing also applies to 'The Good Lord and the Man' a patriotic anthem. A nice surprise comes with 'Why Does Somebody

Always Have to Die', which in theme is a reminder of Randy Travis's 'Three Wooden Crosses'. The two numbers offer an emotional ending. This is a well-crafted song on this album.

'Another You' showcases Rich's romantic side as he sings with conviction the delightful ballad. John Anderson's other collaboration 'I Thought You'd Never Ask' is a fiddle and steel old-fashioned country love ballad with a happy ending. Rich has truly captured some sweet country emotions.

This album is an enjoyable musical ride. Rich's new solo album falls heavily towards a more mature songwriting effort. And with topics such as struggling workers, hard-working truckers, the greatest generation, country boys, his father and love, John Rich has hit all the basic themes of Country music.

The annual exhibition of the work of graduating students in the Fine Arts department will present artworks by the

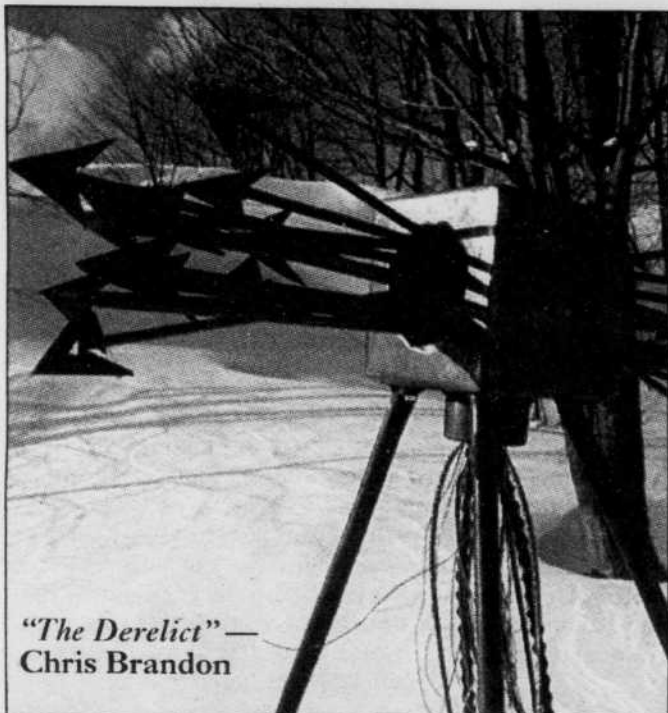

Moreover, Junction saturates the asceptisized space of the Foreman Art Gallery with abounding heterogeneity, turning it into a "laboratory" allowing the free play of artistic discourse under all possible forms.

Junction occupies the Foreman Art Gallery of Bishop's University from April 8 to 25, 2009, and is complemented by a publication under the same title. The exhibition regroups works by Christopher Brandon, Chelsea Caillier, Maude Charland-Lallier, Marie-Pier Cor-

riveau, Jessica Darveau, Allison McClare, Kathyne Owen, Mathieu Pépin, Craig Pettman, Raechel Stableford and Rachel Thompson.
