Concert de la Cité fills summer with music

Music will be spilling from all corners of downtown Sherbrooke starting at the end of June. Les Concerts de la Cité's summer schedule, unveiled Thursday night, vows that will be the case.

"It will be a huge season," promises Alain de Lafontaine, the director of the Granada Theatre and head of Les Concerts de la Cité series. "It's the most spectacular season we've put together. It's the 18th edition now, this year we have more than 70 shows to present, different kinds of shows, classical music, jazz, folk, street theatre, choral groups."

The series offers free outdoor concerts throughout from the end of June until early September. The number of performances has doubled, and so have the venues. Place de la Cité, the cement amphitheatre tucked behind the Sherbrooke courthouse, is still the main venue, but there will be a second stage at the newly constructed Esplanade Frontenac overlooking the Magog River in the heart of Sherbrooke's revitalized downtown core.

De Lafontaine said adding a second stage at the Esplanade Frontenac opened the door to a much bigger production. "It's the reason we have more contributors, more help from the city, it's the reason we could do more."

The series' headline acts are already front and centre.

Martha Wainwright, fresh off her highly acclaimed new CD, will be one headline act in

mid-July. Wainwright is a great catch, said De Lafontaine, who's been trying for weeks to include her in the line-up. They found out this week she will be part of the series.

Montreal-based Senegalese artist, Zale Seck, is headlining the African Rhythms festival that will round off the series on Labour Day weekend. Seck has earned an international reputation for blending his music with colourful vocals and dance to entice the audience into his rhythms.

Wainwright and Seck are the star power, but they will be sharing the summer spotlight with many up-and-coming musicians born and bred in the Eastern Townships.

Gifts for dad that really cook

Food

Give the male gourmet in the house something sizzling this Father's Day

If my e-mail is any proof, more and more men are getting interested in cooking. Over the last number of years, a growing number of food queries sent my way are as likely to come from a Bob, Bill or Bret, as they are from Jackie, Jane or Joan.

Father's Day is an opportune time to get a dad who loves to mess around in the kitchen, on the barbecue or just loves to eat or drink well, something to stimulate his culinary creativity or help him better prepare the foods he loves to cook.

Below you'll find a series of gift ideas for the gourmet dad in your household as well as a few recipes to go with some of them.

PANCAKES WITH PANACHE

A number of kids have told me the best thing their dad makes is pancakes. My friend is one of them, but he prepares them for his family of five in an old skillet that only holds a few pancakes at a time. He and other ill-equipped dads should upgrade to a good-quality, non-stick electric griddle with a large cooking surface good for cooking a family's worth of pancakes. They are available at most hardware and department stores. Be sure to pick up a pancake flipper designed for non-stick pans; you don't want him scratching it the first day.

GRILL GEAR

Check out your dad's barbecuing gear and see if some of it needs replacing. Or think about the kinds of food he likes to prepare outdoors and build a gift around that. For example, if he likes to cook fish, get a grill basket designed for cooking whole fish, fillets or steaks; a smoker box and exotic wood chips he can use to give his fish a pleasing smoky taste; and a cedar plank (available in the seafood department of most supermarkets) on which he can cook delicious salmon.

If your dad is already well-equipped, he can always read and learn more about barbecuing. Two books I highly recommend are Ron Shewchuk's *Barbecue Secrets* (Whitecap Books), and David Veljacic's *The Fire Chef* (Douglas & McIntyre).

DAD'S GETTING SAUCY

Many dads love to marinate, baste and brush foods with a funky, flavour-filled sauce. Make a gift of them by plac-

ing some of the more eclectic and interesting-sounding ones in a basket, and be sure to include a silicone basting brush or two. These brushes are heat-resistant, dishwasher-safe and won't fray or burn like bristled brushes do. They are available at most stores that sell kitchenware.

SLIPPING SIDEWAYS

The movie *Sideways* brought a lot of attention to the pleasures of pinot noir, my favourite wine. If your dad is like me, or is simply interested in learning more about wine, make a fun gift by filling a basket with a couple of pinot noirs recommended by a respected wine retailer; some wine tasting glasses; a wine book, such as the highly recommended modern guide to wine *Have a Glass* (Whitecap); a DVD of the movie *Sideways*; and a corkscrew, wine stopper or other wine gadget you think he might like.

GOURMET BOX LUNCH

If you have a hardworking dad who likes to eat well, buy a cool-looking lunch box and stuff it with non-perishable goodies he can enjoy during a break. These could include, among others, fine chocolates; roasted, premium nuts; gourmet crackers and tin of fine pate; flavoured beef jerky; and foil-sealed smoked salmon.

FAMILY COOKBOOK

Buy a book designed for holding recipes, or make your own. Fill it with

his favourite recipes, including some from his mother, grandmother or other family members. Be sure to leave plenty of room for him to add his own secret recipes. As the years go by, the book will become an important keepsake that he can pass on to his children.

SKILLET SUPREMACY

When people ask me what's the best thing to buy their man for the kitchen, I always tell them a large, heavy duty, high-quality skillet with an ovenproof handle and lid. He can fry bacon in it for breakfast, stir-fry in it for lunch and roast chicken in it for dinner. He can also stew and oven braise in it, start a dish on the stove and finish it in the oven in it and (the kids with love this), make grilled cheese sandwiches in it.

FLUFFY PANCAKES

A generous amount of baking powder makes these pancakes light and fluffy. Preparation time is 15 minutes. Makes 12 to 16 pancakes, depending on size

1 1/2 cups (375 mL) milk
2 large eggs, beaten
1 1/2 cups (375 mL) flour
1/4 cup (50 mL) sugar
1 tablespoon (15 mL) plus 2 teaspoons (10 mL) baking powder
1/4 teaspoon (1 mL) salt
Melted butter, vegetable oil or vegetable spray

Whisk the milk and eggs together in a large bowl. In another bowl, whisk the

dry ingredients together. Mix the dry ingredients into the wet until just combined, leaving the batter a little lumpy. Let the batter sit five minutes, and then give a few stirs before cooking. Preheat your griddle to medium, medium-high heat, about 325 F to 350 F (160 C to 170 C) for electric griddles. Lightly coat the cooking surface with melted butter, vegetable oil or vegetable spray. Pour on the batter, leaving a couple of inches between each pancake. Flip the pancakes when the tops are bubbly. Continue cooking until the underside is browned and the pancake springs back when gently touched.

PINOT NOIR POACHED PEARS

This divine way to cook pears is from my first book, *Everyone Can Cook* (Whitecap Books). Preparation time is 30 minutes; cooking time is 25-30 minutes.

Serves 4

2 cups (500 mL) pinot noir wine
2 cups (500 mL) water
1 cup (250 mL) sugar
1 cinnamon stick
2 whole cloves
1 teaspoon (5 mL) vanilla extract
4 slightly under-ripe, medium-sized pears
Whipped cream and mint sprigs for garnish

Combine first 6 ingredients in a pot large enough to hold the pears. Place over medium-high heat and bring to a boil, stirring to dissolve the sugar. Peel and core the pears. (A melon baller works well to core the pear from its blossom end).

Trim a little from the bottom of each pear so it will stand up. Add the pears to the syrup. Cover the pan, reduce heat to medium-low and gently simmer, turning them from time to time, until pears are just tender, about 15 to 20 minutes.

Remove from the heat and allow to cool in syrup, turning them over occasionally. Use a slotted spoon to transfer the pears to a plate, standing them up. Store in the fridge until needed.

To make the sauce, boil 1 1/2 cups (375 mL) of the poaching liquid until it is reduced to 1/2 cup (125 mL). Cool to room temperature and refrigerate until needed.

To serve, spoon a little sauce on a dessert plate. Place pear in the centre and spoon or pipe whipped cream alongside. Garnish with mint.

Note: Leftover poaching liquid can be saved and stored in the fridge for another use. I like to use it to moisten cake pieces when making trifle or to poach other fruits, such as peaches or apricots.

years in New York and around the world have created pressure on the Townships Stage production, both Mahtani and actress Stephanie McNamara are quick to say they don't think so.

Mahtani admits that the show's reputation is a bit daunting, but he stresses that he and the entire cast are very excited about the opportunity to present such a big show in the Eastern Townships and "hopefully we've captured the flavour."

McNamara, a Montrealer trained at the McGill Conservatory of Music and the London Academy of Music and Dramatic Arts (LAMDA), is also full of enthusiasm. "I wouldn't call it pressure," she says, adding that for her it's a "real gift" to be able to perform such an interna-

tional crowd-pleaser in the Eastern Townships.

The cast is made up of talented and experienced Canadian performers. McNamara has been in musicals across Canada, England, and the U.S., including *The Turn of the Screw*, *Evelyn Strange*, and *The Importance of Being Earnest* at Theatre Lac Brome. Cyndi Carleton is the back-up singer for world-famous Elvis tribute artist Stephen Kabakos and has been in several productions in Toronto. Shaun Toohey is a regular performer on the Ottawa theatre scene. Dominic L'Orange was in the French world-premiere of *Chicago* and is now making his English debut.

"The universality of the play is what speaks to me, it is something we can see in real life, pushed to the extreme sometimes", remarks L'Orange. McNamara agrees, noting that the show tells stories

"which, to a greater or lesser degree, we've all lived through."

Because the cast is composed of four actors who each play several characters in stories arranged around the same theme — the whole gamut of romantic relationships — Mahtani explains that the show combines elements of a cabaret musical revue and a book musical. Mahtani thinks this blend of great songs, over-the-top storylines, and hilarious situations will appeal to every-

one, of all ages and both genders (yes, even men, Mahtani insists).

The show runs June 22 to July 10, with 8 p.m. showtimes, Wednesday to Saturday, and matinées Wednesdays at 2 p.m. and Sundays at 4 p.m. General admission is \$22, \$18 for seniors, and only \$5 for students (taxes not included). Dinner is available before the evening shows on Wednesdays, Fridays, and Saturdays, for \$22, tip and taxes included.

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Plasticiens push art's physical boundaries

Fifty years ago, four artists handed out their manifesto at the Librairie Tranquille in downtown Montreal, reacting to the automatism movement in art — abstraction without human intervention.

Louis Belzile, Jauran, Jean-Paul Jérôme and Fernand Toupin would go on to have a huge influence on the Quebec art scene. Though none of the first four are that well-known as artists, they influenced two more generations of Plasticiens, who focused on the rigorous restriction to geometric form in abstraction.

Suzanne Pressé, curator of the exhibit of the work of the four Plasticiens at the Musée des Beaux Arts de Sherbrooke, said Louis Belzile and Fernand Toupin, the two surviving artists, said Jauran, who died at 30 in a climbing accident, was the real force behind the manifesto. Jauran, or Rudolphe de Repentigny, was a painter and art critic, and the media representative of the group.

Belzile and Toupin, both in their mid-70s, continue to paint, as did Jérôme, who died last year at the age of 76.

Their manifesto was a reaction to automatism, while respecting the influence the movement had on art. The Plasticiens felt that the artist's though process couldn't be separated from art, and that sacred art no longer existed in 1955, but that all art was sacred. As well, the artists saw their finished works as objects in their own right rather than representations of nature or man-made objects.

The four first met at the Librairie Tranquille, which was a bookstore whose owner, Henri Tranquille, held art exhibits to sell art books, which were more expensive than novels. They had their first exhibit at the Échourie restaurant in Montreal in 1955.

The 50th anniversary exhibit in Sherbrooke, the only one of its kind, features 60 works from the four artists, including many of the earliest

works of the Plasticiens, dating from 1953 and 1954.

Pressé said one exhibit of 17 works, owned by a private collector, were shown earlier this year in Montreal. This is the first extensive show of a range of works from the original Plasticiens.

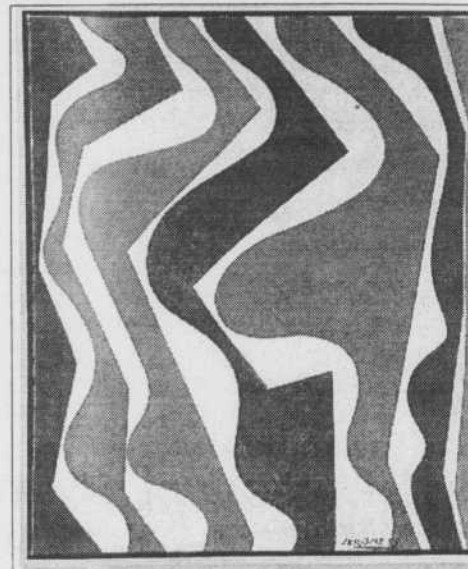
The four artists varied slightly in technique. Jérôme, for instance, left for Europe in 1954, and his style changed from the geometrics of his early works, most of which did not survive a sojourn in his studio while he was away, to a more fluid abstract. Toupin moved beyond just geometrics on the canvas, creating many sided polygon canvases, a real step away from the tradition of the rectangular canvas.

Louis Belzile explores colour on canvas, using variations in colour to create depth and perspective on the two-dimensional surface of the canvas.

Jauran eventually found that the ethical dilemma of being both painter and critic was too much and switched to photography in the Plasticien style.

The three photographs in the exhibit are explorations of light, shadow and form. Pressé said they are the most contemporary of all the works in the show.

"You could find them at a show of current works anywhere now," she

said. "The paintings have already slipped into history."

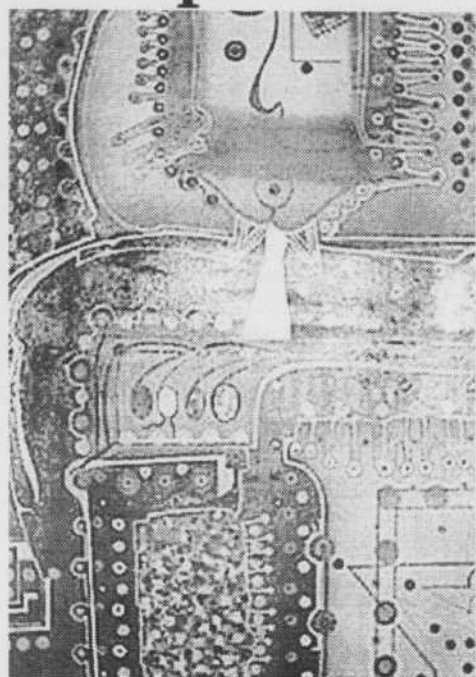
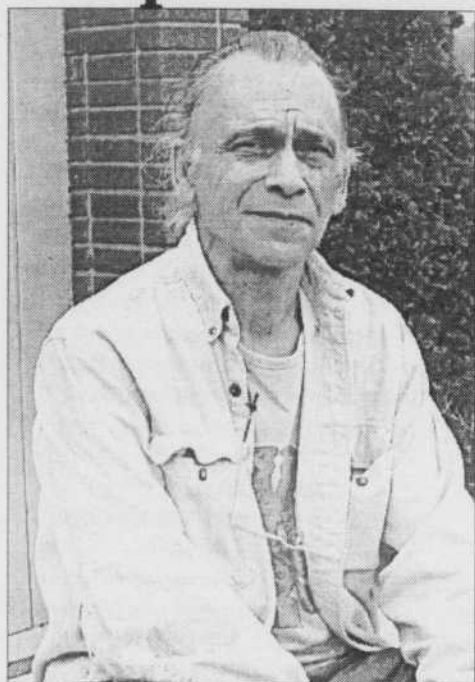

Local artist's work premieres in Spain

Manuel Mayoral, a 62-year old Sherbrooke resident, boarded a plane last week bound for his birth country, Spain. What's special about this trip is he packed not only his bags, but 101 paintings, which he will exhibit for the first time.

"An old friend of mine who opened a gallery in Marbella (a touristy area in southern Spain) said to me during one of his visits, 'why don't you come display your work here?'," said Mayoral. "So that's what I'm doing. I've rolled the paintings up (some are as big as 92 by 122 feet) and am taking them with me."

Mayoral will be displaying at Victor's Gallery in Marbella, June 17 to 30, and then at the Goya Association of Artists in Zaragoza, July 7 to 29. "I was originally supposed to exhibit in three galleries, but there just wasn't enough time in between the two shows," said Mayoral, who is being accompanied by his wife Eva.

The paintings were made using a number of techniques, including acrylics and mixed media, and have been given original names in English, French, and Spanish such as Without Gravity, Vertigo and The Eyes of My Garden, but it's the title of the show itself which will likely garner the most attention: Papa Shit 101.

"I don't know anything about computers," explained Mayoral. "My two sons are the ones who help me send photos, emails, invites, that kind of thing. The folder they named for me

on the computer is called 'Papa Shit' — hence the name of the show."

Mayoral began working on this collection in February 2004 while on vacation with family in the Dominican Republic.

"I painted every day, and sometimes until 5 in the morning. You don't need to have a lot of ideas necessarily, just creativity," said Mayoral, who worked on numerous pieces at a time. "I give it all that I am. I just close my eyes and paint what I see. I call it automatism because it comes easily and automatically to me. My inspiration is constant, but Native art and modern Quebec art have had an influence on my creations."

Aside from painting, multi-talented Mayoral is also a creator of jewelry, and has his own jewelry shop on Aberdeen Street.

"That's what I started doing to make a living when I moved to Sherbrooke 30 years ago. It all began when I made a bracelet for my wife. Her friends noticed it and wanted me to make them one too. My work is now sold at several goldsmiths. I design personalized jewelry for people as well, which is rare in Quebec."

As for which art form Mayoral prefers: "I love both, though jewelry seems to be more practical for people," said Mayoral with a grin.

And it's possible Townshippers will soon have the opportunity to admire his paintings. "I want to find the right place to display them. I want my work to provoke conversation. It's important my art be appreciated."

Yong Sook Kim-Lambert was born in Korea, currently lives in Pennsylvania, but considers Magog her home.

"This is where I started teaching, as well as began my career as a painter," said Kim-Lambert, who spends time at her house in Magog every summer and winter.

"I feel very attached to the landscape. One of my paintings — Lac Memphre — was actually done in Pennsylvania from images in my head."

Kim-Lambert has a Bachelor of Fine Arts from the University of Hong-Kong, where she studied Western Art. Since 1991, she shares her time between Canada, Korea, and the United States, and has shown her work in dozens of cities. Group exhibits include the San Diego Watercolour Society, National Society of Painters in Casein

and Acrylic in New York, and of course Magog's Le Centre d'artistes Creatio, where Kim-Lambert's most recent works can currently be admired.

"There are more than 30 paintings, all of which are water-based," said Kim-Lambert, who has been a member of Creatio since it was founded four years ago. "My favourite is Opus

47. It's a collage of working and living in different languages: English, French, Korean and Chinese, and an expression of feeling. Opus 47 is part of an 'Opus' series I'm working on.

There are now about 60 works and counting. I borrowed that music term because of the impact classical music has had on me and my art."

Aside from putting her paintbrush to good use to produce her own work, Kim-Lambert is an art teacher at a boarding school in Tyrone, Pennsylvania.

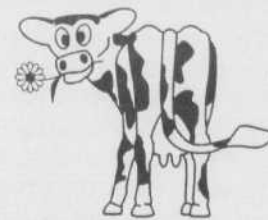
"I have always been interested in art. I come from a family of 11 children. One of my brothers, who is also an artist always encouraged me. So it's not surprising that art is a big part of my life."

A forgotten world comes to life and a mere CD struggles to contain the epic beauty of this sprawling, cinematic song cycle about life in the hill-top barrio that was ultimately levelled to make room for Dodger Stadium. After resurrecting the aging members of the Buena Vista Social Club, Cooder does the same for East L.A. legends like Lalo Guerrero and Little Willie G. in this sublime collection of Latin and Mexican-tinged pop and R&B tracks, sung in English and Spanish by both the veterans and Cooder. You can feel the summer heat, hear the tinny car radio and sense struggling humanity's impending collision with power and money in the Communism-obsessed America of the 1950s. One to get lost in.

Toronto singer-songwriter Jason Collett is part of the loose, prodigious indie-rock collective Broken Social Scene. An American Indian treasure at Beaulne Museum

The Musée Beaulne, in Coaticook, will be unveiling the sculpture Le Visage de Schefferville, found in 1976 by hunters from Baldwin's Mills during an expedition. This item, donated to the Musée du Séminaire de Sher-

brooke in 1979, has recently been given to the Musée Beaulne.

Four members of the hunting party are still living: Wilson May, Merrick Belknap, Rodney McLeod, and David Ham. They have asked that the carving be donated to the Musée Beaulne where it can be more visible.

A one-sided carving, the stone measures 9 3/8" long by 3 3/4" wide and is 2 1/8" thick. In 1979, Professor Thomas E. Lee of Université de Laval claimed that the sculpture was a Viking face, circa 1000 A.D. Recently, in re-examining the carving meticulously, Professor Yves Robillard of the Université de Québec à Montréal concluded that the item is of more recent origin. He believes it is a North American Indian artefact of around 1950, representing the Spirit of the North.

The Musée Beaulne will be holding

an unveiling of the sculpture on Saturday, June 18, at 2 p.m., to show their gratitude to the Musée du Séminaire de Sherbrooke (now Musée de la nature et des sciences), and to the community members who originally discovered the sculpture and asked for the donation.



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Lindsay Lohan says she's a workaholic

Lindsay Lohan is an 18-year-old on a roll — maybe too much of a roll.

Even as her latest movie, Disney's *Herbie: Fully Loaded* prepares to roll into cinemas on June 22, she has several other projects in the works — including the romantic comedy, *Just My Luck*, and the high-prestige *Prairie Home Companion* for director Robert Altman.

But Lohan is also trying to sandwich in a music career and — this is the really tough part — trying to live a normal life. But can a youngster who's idolized by millions of teenagers because of her performances in *Freaky Friday* and *Mean Girls* ever succeed in being normal? Not if the paparazzi have their way: Lohan is facing reporters this morning only 72 hours after her car was crunched by a rampaging photographer who was immediately arrested on suspicion of felony assault. And if this wasn't enough, both her personal and public life are touching off a frenzy on the Internet where there is an ongoing preoccupation with her breasts.

Last year, during the shooting of *Herbie: Fully Loaded*, Lohan landed in hospital suffering from stress. She shrugs off the incident now, saying that she was simply overdoing things — making a movie while also working on her first album, *Speak*, which was released late last year.

"My first album was rushed. I recorded practically every song in my trailer on the set of *Herbie*. So that's why I got sick at the time. I was running myself down. I was literally running from the set in between set-ups and singing and I would go home and work in my bedroom, too."

So she ended up in hospital for a couple of days — and to most performers this would be a cue to slow down. So, Lindsay gets the obvious question this morning: Why doesn't she take a break?

"Well, I can't now," she replies. "I have a movie coming out."

She's every teenager's delight with her cascading blonde hair and cheerful outgoing manner, but there's also a hint of nervousness in those fluttering hands. She apologizes that she has a touch of laryngitis, but that doesn't deter her from having

a lot to say.

"I'm a workaholic," she says blithely, "so I tend to just keep going. I'm so used to working at this point that when I don't have anything to do, I go kind of crazy — I feel like I need to work (BEGIN ITALIC) more (END ITALIC). So I've surrounded myself with people who make sure I say 'no' more than 'yes' at this point."

She is capable of self-analysis.

"You get to a point where you want to please everyone — and that's difficult," she confesses. "It's all been a learning experience for me. So I've been learning to take the time to say: 'What does Lindsay need? What do I need to do for myself?'"

As for that bombardment of tabloid scrutiny, she's philosophical.

"I think there's become an obsession with celebrity status right now — buying the tabloids and feeding into it. So it's hard because people don't know me necessarily as a person."

She recalls one report which suggested she'd been carousing around Los Angeles until 4 in the morning at a time when she was filming elsewhere. She notes that it would have been physically impossible to be in both places at the same time. "Would I clone myself?" she asks sarcastically. "I've just learned to ignore it."

Or at least, she tries to ignore it. Lindsay's guilty secret is that she doesn't always avoid what's written about her. "If it's there, I read it!"

And if she's in a supermarket and her picture is on the cover of a magazine?

"I grab it!" she giggles.

During the filming of *Herbie* — a rollicking update on the vintage 1969 Disney hit, *The Love Bug* — older costars Michael Keaton and Matt Dillon gave her some solid guidance — "just to take care of yourself and make sure you're doing what you want to do."

The *Herbie* of the title is the aging 1969 Volkswagen Bug, a car that has its own mind and emotions — just like a real person. *Herbie's* free-wheeling personality turned the original film into an instant classic and also spawned sequels and numerous TV films. But in this latest incarnation, *Herbie* is down and out — an obsolete clunker who has been dispatched

to the junkyard where he awaits demolition. But naturally, given that this is a Disney movie, *Herbie* will be rescued and his rescuer is — that's right — none other than Lindsay Lohan. She's Maggie, third-generation member of a legendary car racing family and a kid desperate to get behind the wheel herself and head for the circuits. *Herbie* becomes the fulfillment of this dream as he's spruced up and revitalized and ends up racing at NASCAR with Lindsay at the wheel.

Thanks to her two previous movies for the studio (*Freaky Friday* and *The Parent Trap*), she feels "very safe" with Disney. She also feels that besides offering a load of good entertainment, *Herbie: Fully Loaded* carries a good message: "It's very empowering for women because this is a male-dominated sport."

Lohan took special driving lessons and loved actually being part of the world of NASCAR and sharing the speedway with the likes of real-life racing icons Jeff Gordon and Dale Earnhardt Jr. She was alarmed at having to use a stick shift but "I picked up pretty fast."

Because of this film, she considers herself a much better driver. Even so, she found herself helpless a few days ago on a busy Hollywood street when a 24-year-old paparazzo crashed his car into the side of

her Mercedes in an attempt to take her picture. The photographer was arrested and Lohan was left marvelling that she and her companion escaped with minor injuries.

"It happened so fast and I didn't really believe it actually happened, and I couldn't get out of my side door. I knew a story of someone who was close to one of my family who passed away when someone hit their car so all I could think at that moment was: 'I can't get out of my door. I'm going to die in this car. My door is jammed.' And then my friend was panicking and had just whacked her head on the window and she couldn't find the 'unlock' switch. What was going on was incredible."

Then, when she finally got out of the car, the paparazzi were taking shots. (The Los Angeles Times later reported they were attempting to get photo proof of alleged surgical nips and tucks to her face)

"I was in shock. I did not know what to do. Thank God no one was seriously injured. I still have to go to the doctor."

It seems all this happened because her bodyguard — whom she now introduces to reporters — wasn't with her. "I snuck out without Dean," she says apologetically, "and that's probably why I wasn't safe."

CTV builds on its familiar winning formula

The sibilant "C" in CTV stands for "stability." Viewers of CTV can expect to see a familiar look when Canada's most-watched television network returns with its new season in the fall.

Bell Globemedia president and CEO Ivan Fecan and CTV Media Group chair Susanne Boyce unveiled CTV's fall plans before advertisers Monday in Toronto, following a season in which CTV captured 18 of the Top 20 most-watched programs in Canada, up from 14 the previous year.

On the theory that if it isn't broke, don't fix it, CTV will again anchor its prime-time schedule around franchise hits CSI and Law & Order. Six of seven nights will feature at least one of those programs, either the original, a spin-off or a rerun.

In keeping with TV's time-honoured tradition of recycling its most profitable ideas, CTV's new U.S. acquisitions skew heavily toward clones of Medium, Lost and Desperate Housewives, three of last season's most unexpected new hits. Two of CTV's four new fall dramas will have a decidedly Lost-like, supernatural feel to them.

The other trend, as reflected by the new Commander in Chief, starring Geena Davis as a mother and the first female president of the United States, focuses on career vs. family.

Returning series include Cold Case, Grey's Anatomy, Lost, Desperate Housewives, The O.C., ER, Alias, Medium, The West Wing, Wife Swap, The Amazing Race and According to Jim.

The popular Saskatchewan corn-fed comedy Corner Gas will return to Mondays with 19 new episodes. Degraasi: The Next Generation will also return, with 13 new episodes. Last week, Degraasi became the first homegrown Canadian program to be nominated for a U.S.-based Television Critics Association Award.

Other returning Canadian programs include Instant Star, Comedy Now!, Comedy Inc. and the venerable news-magazine W-Five.

Cancelled programs include Joan of Arcadia, Third Watch, The Benefactor and Dr. Vegas.

CTV's new dramas include:

- Close to Home, a legal drama from Éprodur Jerry Bruckheimer, set not in a big city this time but in a small town. The ensemble drama features Montreal's Jennifer Finnigan as a prosecutor and new mother trying to balance work and family;

- Ghost Whisperer, in which Jennifer Love Hewitt plays a newlywed who communicates with the dead. The program is based on the writings of psychic James Van Praagh, and stars Aisha Tyler and David Conrad in supporting roles;

- Inconceivable, a medical drama about the doctors, lawyers and psychologists who work at a fertility clinic. The ensemble cast includes ER's Ming-Na, Jonathan Cake, David Norona, Rachael Lew, Joelle Carter, Mary Catherine Garrison and Alfre Woodard in a guest role; and,

- Invasion, a Lost-like ensemble thriller about things that go bump in the night following a devastating hurricane in Florida, starring William Bichtner as a town sheriff in a fight to the death against something he's not even sure exists. The cast ensemble includes Eddie Cibrian, Spalding, Sask.'s Kari Matchett and Brampton, Ont.'s Tyler Labine. The pilot episode was directed by West Wing and Jack & Bobby vet Thomas Schlamme.

CTV has also purchased the rights to three new dramas that will appear on U.S. networks this fall, but will be kept aside on CTV and inserted as needed. They are:

- Commander in Chief, a family-driven riff on The West Wing from ABC, featuring Davis as the first woman president of the U.S. Donald Sutherland plays the First Gentleman in an ensemble that also includes Kyle Secor, Ever Carradine and Halifax's Leslie Hope;

- Criminal Minds, a filmed-in-Vancouver procedural thriller from CBS about the FBI's Behavioral Analysis

Unit, starring Mandy Patinkin, Thomas Gibson, Shemar Moore, Matthew Gubler and Lola Glaudini; and,

- Night Stalker, ABC's updated version of the 1974 Darren McGavin cult classic, rewritten and produced by X-Files vet -- and former UPI wire-service reporter -- Frank Spotnitz and directed by one-time X-Files and NYPD Blue director Daniel Sackheim. Irish actor Stuart Townsend plays a haunted reporter determined to find the truth behind his wife's murder.

CTV also announced a slate of some 13 Canadian made-for-television movies, including the self-explanatory Endgame in Kosovo: The Louise Arbour Story, Shades of Black: The Conrad Black Story, The Man Who Lost Himself: The Terry Evanshen Story and War Correspondent: The Clark Todd Story.

Three new, scripted Canadian series -- Whistler, Alice, I Think and Jeff Ltd. -- will bow in midseason. Whistler is an hour-long ensemble drama set at Whistler ski resort. Alice, I Think is a quirky comedy based on the books by Susan Juby about an eccentric 15-year-old girl and her equally unique, dysfunctional family. And Jeff Ltd. stars The Eleventh Hour's Jeff Seymour as a megalomaniac marketer whose warped touch turns everything to gold, except his personal life.

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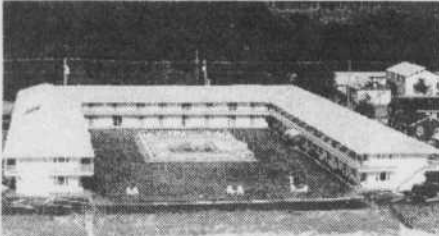
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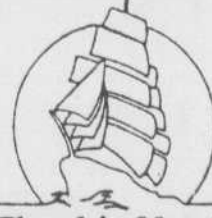
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
