Provincial Legislature. QUEBEC, June 21.—The Speaker took the chair at 3 p.m. Hon. Mr. Meade gave notice of motion that to move he would read the certificate of Judge Gauthier in the Megantic election case referred to the Committee on Privileges and Elections.

Mr. Bernatchez moved the adoption of the report of the Agricultural Commission, but at his own request the debate was adjourned. The House went into Committee on the Bill on Mr. Desjardins' motion to amend the act 49 of Victoria, chapter 74, respecting the employment of combustible gases in this Province.
