Rumors opens at Knowlton playhouse

The Knowlton Players production of Neil Simon's *Rumors* opened Thursday night at the Knowlton Pub Playhouse.

Simon's farce about the dinner party from hell made its debut in 1988 at the Broadhurst Theatre in New York. The play explores themes of love, marital fidelity, loyalty and, most importantly, gossip as four couples gather ostensibly to celebrate a 10th wedding anniversary.

A botched suicide attempt by the

host and the disappearance of his wife upsets party plans and necessitates a string of explanations that grow increasingly bizarre as the dinner guests try to cover up the evening's strange events from late arrivals.

The Knowlton community theatre has mounted other Simon plays during its 10-year history, including *Come Blow Your Horn* (1991), a previous production of *Rumors* (1993) and *Plaza Suite* (1999).

Roger de la Mare, a member of the theatre's founding board and a veteran of 34 plays, acted in the original 1993 production of *Rumors* and now plays host Ken Gorman opposite Michaela Barnes as his wife.

This production also marks the Quebec directorial debut of Chris Freeman. Freeman has appeared locally with Echo

Art, Sunshine Theatre and is also the founder of The Actor's Workshop in Knowlton.

"In a Neil Simon play there's no waiting profundity, no deep message. If he has any message at all for the ages it's probably 'What? Just being entertaining is a sin?'"

Freeman points to a similar debate nearly 400 years ago that raged about an English Bard.

"Like Shakespeare, Simon too creates real people and persuades us to recognize a familiarity within ourselves," said Freeman.

Perhaps, but the Bard who penned light farces such as *As You Like It* and *Much Ado About Nothing* also penned *Richard III* and *King Lear*.

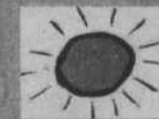

Il Duetto a hidden gem in Sutton

Two kilometres from the busy core of Sutton, along Academy-Élie road, is a quaint little restaurant full of homespun charm and country delight.

Il Duetto is an eatery that is bathed in warmth – the comfortable deep reds of its walls, the eye-catching cornucopia of paintings of every style, the pastoral wainscotting and the café curtains all work together to create a reassuring atmosphere of rural elegance.

The food, however, is not what you might expect in the middle of the countryside. Quite simply, this is Italian cuisine at its best, with a bold twist of French sensibility thrown in for good measure.

The restaurant's extensive menu includes about a dozen different pasta creations featuring combinations of cannelloni, tortellini, fettucini, pennine and linguine served with a variety of tomato, olive oil, pesto,

garlic, cream and cheese sauces. Another dozen dishes feature duck, pork, veal and chicken complimented by cheesy, creamy sauces.

The prices are reasonable and standard across the menu. All the pasta dishes may be taken as a main course at \$12 each or as an appetizer at \$6.75. The *plats principaux* are all \$16.75.

Cold appetizers, which include a Sicilian Antipasto, a salad of bell peppers, anchovies and quail eggs; Warm Goat Cheese Crostini; and Prosciutto and Pears, are all \$6.75. The two soups on the menu – Buttercup Squash and Prosciutto Soup and Tortellini in Broth – are \$5.25. Desserts are all \$4.50.

An inviting 'create it yourself' *table d'hôte* is offered at Il Duetto. Patrons may choose any starter from the selections of cold and warm appetizers or pastas, any main dish from the pasta and meat menus, any dessert and coffee or tea for \$23.95. A five-course special, which includes all this plus another appetizer, salad and a *petit trou*, is offered for \$35. My companion and I found the first *table d'hôte* more than sufficient.

Being an Italian restaurant, we both decided to partake of a pasta to start. The Meat-Stuffed Tortellini with Fresh Basil, Olive Oil and Sundried Tomatoes made a mark before it was even tasted with its divine scent of sweet basil and sour sundried tomatoes. It was excellent, fulfilling the high expectations of its alluring aroma.

The Pennine with Vegetables, Garlic and Olive Oil was served with a piquant red tomato sauce. The pasta was perfectly *al dente* and the veggies uncommonly crisp. Another great appetizer, bursting with flavour.

The French touch at this Italian eatery is clear in the meaty main dishes. You'll find such creations as Veal Scallop with Boar Prosciutto, Cheese and Sage Cream Sauce; Duck Thighs with Garlic and Sundried Tomato Sauce; and the Assiette Duetto – Boneless Quail and Duck Breast in White Wine and Cream Sauce.

I had Pork Scallops With Gorgonzola and Cream Sauce. The scallops were nice and tender and the rich, creamy sauce had the pungent zap of gorgonzola cheese and herbs. It was decadent, but not overly so, and it was served with crisp red peppers, broccoli and carrots, as well as a fine tomato and herb risotto.

My companion had the Osso Bucco in Fig Sauce. This was finely cooked veal shank served in boneless chunks with a bold fig sauce and the same accompaniments as the pork scallops. Meat-lovers won't be able to resist this pleasing dish.

The homemade desserts were sublime examples of the best that can be created with cakes, creams, fruits, chocolates and liquors. Just try to stay away from a menu that contains these invitations: Chocolate Cake, Pears and Chocolate Syrup; Tiramisù - Italian Coffee and Cheese Cake; Crème Caramel with Or-

ange Zest; Vanilla Ice Cream with Italian Bitter Liquor; and Fresh Orange with Sambucca and White Chocolate.

Three of these gourmet delights – the Chocolate and Pear Cake, Tiramisù and Crème Caramel – may be ordered as one dessert. If you can't decide between the taste temptations, this is the way to go. Small portions of this trio will create a fiesta of flavours in your mouth. The Tiramisù worked its charm subtly on the palate. First the texture of the cake and cheese made themselves known, followed by the alcohol. The Crème Caramel contained a refreshing citrus flavour as the orange zest was cooked right on top of it. It was satisfyingly smooth.

The piece de resistance was the Chocolate and Pear Cake. The tasty pear cream was layered between the light cake and the whole thing was covered in a rich chocolate sauce. It is simply one of the most delectable desserts around and should be inducted into the 'Chocolate Hall of Fame.'

This unforgettable dinner for two, not including wine or gratuity, came to \$55.

Thirteen years ago, Sandro Meffé combined his passion for fine food and lust for life and opened Il Duetto. Today, it is one of the finest and most accessible restaurants in the region. You will not be disappointed.

Quebec ambassador to tango returns

Romulo Larrea, who's playing in Sherbrooke next Tuesday, heard the call when he was 10.

"It was my first time hearing a string quartet live," Larrea said. "Hearing the interplay of the instruments, I knew then that I was going to be a musician."

At the same time, thousands of miles to the north, the brilliant composer Astor Piazzolla was making musical history with his 'neuvo tango'.

Born in Argentina, raised in New York and schooled in Paris, Piazzolla infused a wealth of musical diversity into his beloved tangos.

He re-worked the traditional chord progressions and rhythmic structures, ending up with forms that sound completely intuitive but are actually so difficult that the composer is reported to have said "If anybody gets lost he'll have to meet us at the coda."

Romulo Larrea was not to meet Piazzolla for some time. Growing up in Montevideo Uruguay, where tango was ever present, Larrea was learning to play the bandéon, playing for the public in ensembles by the time he was fifteen.

"I love playing for people," he said.

A high point in the performance is the rapport that occurs between the audience and performers.

Larrea's instrument, the bandéon, is the heart of tango music. It is a German invention, developed in the mid-nineteenth century to be played in churches.

Forty years later it had found its way into the bar rooms and cabarets of Argentina, where tango was born. The keys, laid out in a "totally illogical" fashion, according to Larrea, are tuned by

German instrument makers to the typical intonations of the tanguistas, according to their specifications.

Larrea and his family moved to Montreal in 1978. Tango was not well known and he was the only bandéoniste in Quebec. His goal was, and still is "to spread an appreciation of tango music as widely as possible."

In the late eighties it was Piazzolla, by now a friend and mentor of Larrea, who inspired him to follow his dream of incorporating a string quartet into his traditional tango trio of piano, bass and bandéon.

The six youthful, energetic and talented musicians who chose to join him have never looked back. The ensemble are as tight and telepathic as any band can be, and accompanying them as she has always done, will be Larrea's daughter, Veronica Larc, a stunningly powerful vocalist capable of evoking the emotional depths of the genre.

Tango itself, as a distinct art form, celebrates a century of existence.

"Dance, music, lyrics...all are an expression of tango," said Larrea. With roots in Latin and African music, tango is similar to jazz. It has finesse and sophistication as well as swing.

Romulo Larrea, with his own roots deep in the tradition, will guide his audience through the essence of tango and the immense contribution made by the late legendary Astor Piazzolla.

'Homage to Astor Piazzolla', Larrea's fifth concert in the Townships will take place Tuesday, Oct. 26, at 8 p.m., at Salle Maurice O'Bready at Sherbrooke University. Tickets cost \$24. For information and tickets, call 819-820-1000.

The debate over greatness aside, Simon's comedic talents, honed along-

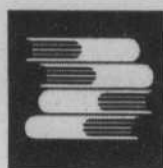
side some of the funniest writers in modern media, should provide for a refreshing evening. And, as Simon and his audiences know well, being entertaining is a sin that is readily forgiven.

Investing techniques for the golden years

'Retiring Wealthy in the 21st Century' by Gordon Pape

A better title for Gordon Pape's 'Retiring Wealthy in the 21st Century' might be 'A Practical Guide for Retirement in the 21st Century' - albeit a little less exciting.

Perhaps knowledgeable people with a good deal of capital can parlay their excess money into wealth with the aid of Pape's brand new book, but the book is of greater interest to the average Canadian who doesn't know the difference between an RRSP, an RRIF a LIRA and an LIF.

Lest one panic about getting lost

among the numerous acronyms the financial community is so inordinately fond of, it must be said that Pape's book is clear, information-packed with a good index and references.

Though Pape's thumbnail sketch of Emma Harris, eating her macaroni and cheese shivering in her 15 degree apartment in the year 2050 in the first chapter 'You May Not Like the Future' is totally unconvincing - Pape's prose is best when sticking more closely to the subject of bonds, debentures and annuities - people aging today are aware of greater longevity, certain limitations on pension plans and the probability of a large population aging at the same time. When Pape addresses these concerns with his clear-headed advice, he is at his best.

Some of the basics are worth repeating - that an individual or couple should

sit down and do some serious financial planning, examining goals (Pape includes a Personal Lifestyle Planner), an estimate of expense needs with attention to current and future needs, a review of revenue sources and develop a strategy; that RRSPs are one of the best tax shelters available to the average person and that the average person must take some responsibility for retirement savings because pension plans may become overburdened.

He also looks at the ins and outs of the various different pension plans now available to workers and what they will mean short and long term. Useful for many of us is a chapter on preparing for retirement late entitled, 'Strategies for Late Starters' with detailed instructions for maximizing investment potential.

With its numerous charts and de-

tailed workings-out of various investment plans, Pape takes some of the mystery out of investing in the future. He stresses the need for a diverse program including some foreign investment, how to avoid getting taxed at the maximum rate, cash flow - when caution is and isn't important.

Pape's chapter, 'Sun-Belt Retirement' looks at the practical aspects of owning or renting property in the sun-belt of the United States for a portion of the year, including some of the unforeseen pitfalls that must be considered such as pest control, the need for hurricane shutters and landscape maintenance.

This is a fine resource book to consult in conjunction with workshops and experts. No one likes to think about firming up a retirement plan, but Pape seems to cover all the bases in his latest book.

The names of the nominees and the titles of their works are listed below. The jury is comprised of 42 members including 14 independent peer juries, seven English, seven French.

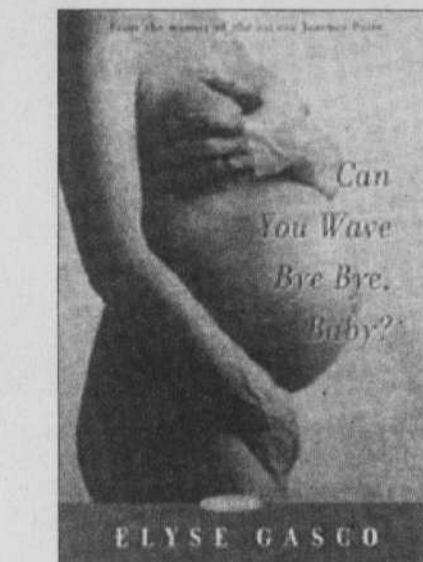

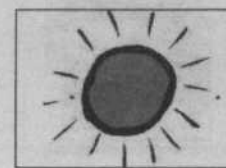

Explore the 'black powder trail'

Everyone is raving about fall foliage and taking trips to view the autumn colours and looking for new outdoor adventures to experience in our last October of the millenium.

There's no need to go far to find something interesting.

The old Powder Mill or "Centre Culturel et Patrimonial La Poudrière de Windsor", with its adjoining Watopeka Park, offers, something for everyone.

With several kilometers of forest trails, attractive views of the Watopeka River, and a complete museum exhibit in the one mill building left intact, the 'Poudrière' offers a day of family fun right in the heart of the Townships.

The history of the mill, which had its origins in the need for black powder during the American Civil War, began in 1864. The mill continued to produce black powder - for blasting and for guns - and the business prospered so that the factory complex contained 56 buildings by the end of World War I. It finally closed its doors in 1922 after a violent explosion.

The trails through Watopeka Park not only reveal the beautiful flora and fauna of the region, but also trace the history of the powder mill by explaining the powder production process on panels along the wooded trails.

Each panel is posted near the remains of building foundations, which are the remnants of many of the original structures that composed the factory. One dam remains intact and creates a lovely

waterfall near the entrance to the park. The remains of other dam structures may be seen along the Watopeka River in the Park itself.

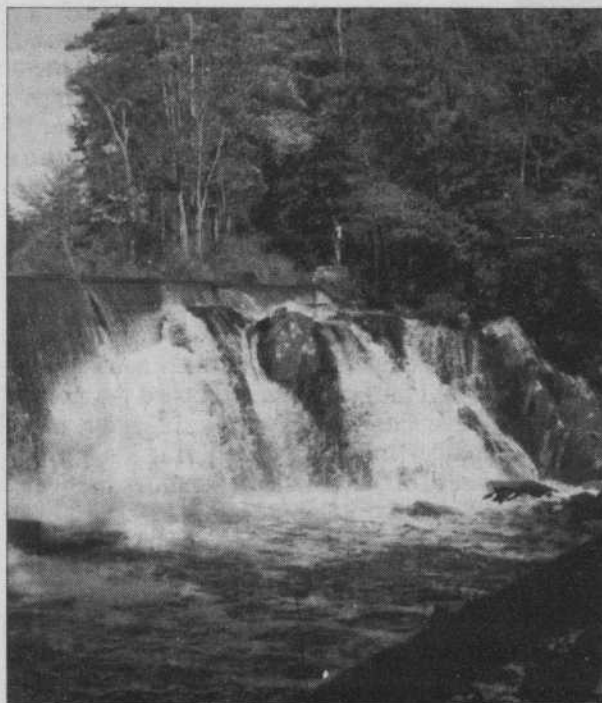

Besides the information about black powder production, there are panels in the woods which illustrate plants and wildlife which may be encountered in the park. The panels show coloured drawings and give the Latin, English and French names of each species.

The trails are stimulating but not too physically challenging. They lead through woods, along the river's edge and even give a view of marshland above the dam. There are many benches to sit and appreciate the view. Dogs are welcome to enjoy the walk too on a leash.

The one remaining building, at 342 St. Georges Street, was restored in 1992 to serve as a museum. It contains a permanent exhibit about the mill's history as well as temporary exhibits of different types. The museum is open to casual visitors and there are group tours if you reserve ahead.

Out of place in NY, Egypt and high school

THE OUT-OF-TOWNERS

The Out-of-Towners, directed by Sam Weisman, is a comedy inspired by the clichés that surround New York City.

In this movie, Steve Martin and Goldie Hawn play the roles of Henry and Nancy, a married couple from Ohio. After 27 years of marriage, they find themselves "stuck in a rut."

Suddenly, their situation brightens up when Henry is scheduled for an important interview in New York City. Nancy decides to join him for the trip. During the 24 hours that they spend in the city, they encounter a series of comical misfortunes.

The best thing about this movie are

the oldies' soundtrack, and Martin and Hawn's performances, though both Martin have been funnier in previous films.

The Out-of-Towners plot twists and turns, yet it fails to capture us. As a result, 90 minutes to a viewer might seem like a long 24 hours! Overall, The Out-of-Towners is a disappointment.

THE PRINCE OF EGYPT

The Prince of Egypt is an animated film based on the Biblical story of Moses and his brother Ramses.

One day, while bathing in the river, the Queen of Egypt finds a slave orphan (Moses) and adopts him. As the years pass, Moses has successfully assimilated, and has developed a close relationship with Ramses (the Queen and King's biological son). Unexpectedly, Moses' life changes when he dis-

covers his true identity. From this moment, the two brothers' destinies are separated, and they become rivals. Thus, a heroic quest begins.

With its all-star cast of voices, including Val Kilmer, Ralph Fiennes, Sandra Bullock, Michelle Pfeiffer and more, Dreamworks Pictures has created an enchanting film that transports us on a journey of faith and courage.

Furthermore, Stephen Schwartz's songs intensify the film's themes and characters.

Deborah Chapman, Steve Hickener, and Simon Welles have directed a fun and inspiring film.

THE RAGE: CARRIE 2

MGM studios, 23 years later, have decided to launch a revival of Brian De Palma's Carrie, titled The Rage: Carrie 2.

The Rage, directed by Katt Shea, tells the story of a teenage girl, Rachel (Emily Bergl), who possesses telekinetic powers. Rachel is haunted by the mystery of her best friend's (Mena Suvari) suicide. When she discovers the reasons for the suicide, Rachel seeks revenge on those who have provoked her best friend's death.

Similar to De Palma's Carrie, The Rage's formula is a horror version of the Cinderella tale. Destruction, gore and frenzy are to be expected in this film. However, Katt Shea's version is neither as shocking nor mystifying as De Palma's.

Emily Bergl's performance, the visual effects, the editing and narrative (which incorporate footage from the original version) are the film's strengths. The Rage is entertaining for lovers of the horror genre.

Malkovich sends up his own image

John Malkovich didn't know whether he should be flattered or outraged when the movie script first arrived on his doorstep.

But since it carried the bizarre title of Being John Malkovich, there was no way he could resist reading it -- even though he thought it didn't stand a chance of getting made. He figured the title alone would be enough to put off prospective producers and financiers -- indicating as it did something weird, quirky and non-commercial.

He was even less optimistic about its prospects after reading fledgling writer Charlie Kaufman's script, which has to do with a scruffy failed puppeteer who accepts a job on floor seven-and-one-half of a strange office building and discovers a tunnel-like "portal" that leads him into the brain of -- John Malkovich.

But the two-time Oscar nominee wasn't insulted; in spite of himself, he was fascinated.

"So no, I didn't call my lawyer. I called my business partner and asked

him to meet with the writer because I thought it was so well-written."

Yet all these discussions were -- in his words -- "theoretical" because he still was convinced such a film would never get made.

But while Malkovich brooded over the impossibility of ever bringing it to the screen, other people were also becoming excited by the script. One of them was John Cusack who had been approached to play the puppeteer who's propelled into John Malkovich's brain. Cusack's verdict: "The sickest thing I could ever conceive of: totally original, totally new, intricate, twisted,

sophisticated and low-brow -- all at the same time. It's like an Escher painting. It has doors and stairways leading into themselves. It's totally wild."

In brief, he wanted to do it.

But Cusack was also skeptical: He too was convinced that Being John Malkovich would never make it to the big screen.

Yet against all odds, it did become a movie -- one that has been causing a stir in film festivals and is due to arrive in theatres across Canada in early November.

The script did find some influential champions -- including Hollywood producers like Michael Stipe, Sandy Stern and Steve Golin who had a track record for taking risks. They also found the filmmaker they believed would be capable of harnessing the weird situations and humour and turning them into a movie. Their choice: Idiosyncratic music video director Spike Jonze who had been on the lookout for a feature project. Other adventurous souls were ready to come on board -- among them Cameron Diaz as Cusack's animal-loving spouse, Katherine Keener as a sexy office colleague, and Orson Bean as a randy old businessman.

Jonze, who looks about 19 and speaks in a corn-pone drawl, has his own way of describing a movie that defies description: "It's about New York City, a puppeteer, a tragic marriage, a chimp, a boss, a receptionist, another woman, an actor, the New Jersey Turnpike, and also a plate of lasagna."

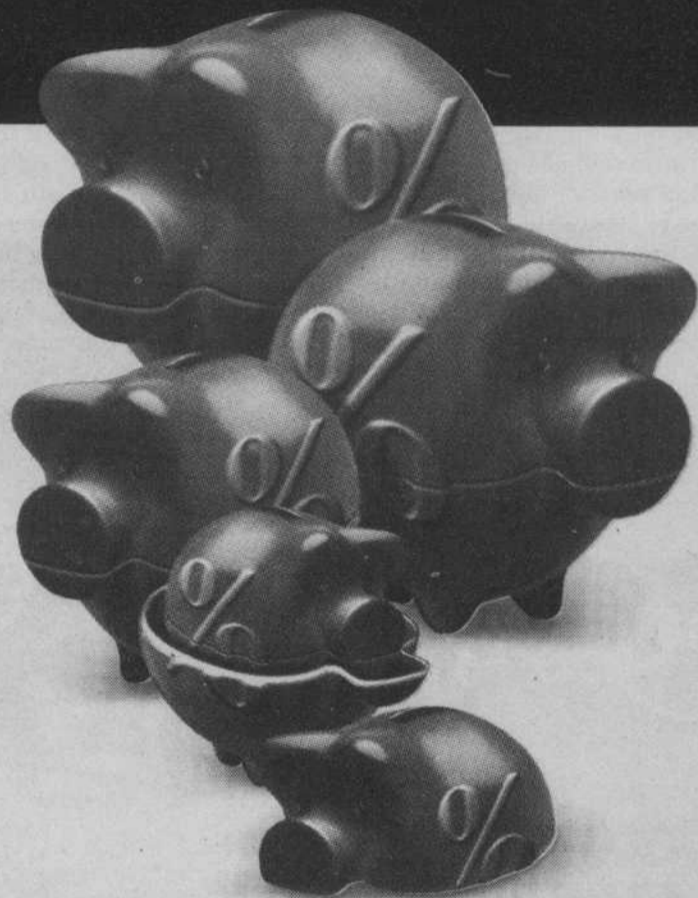

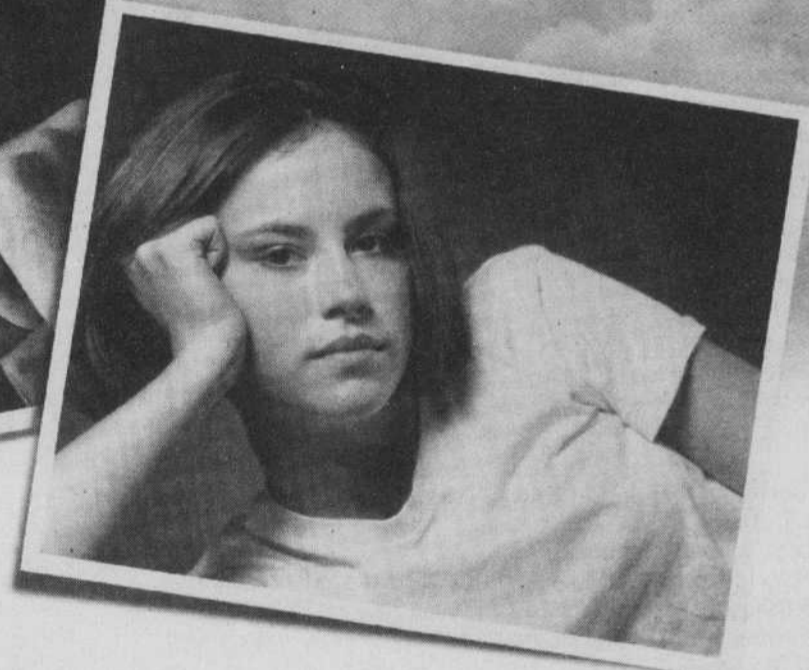
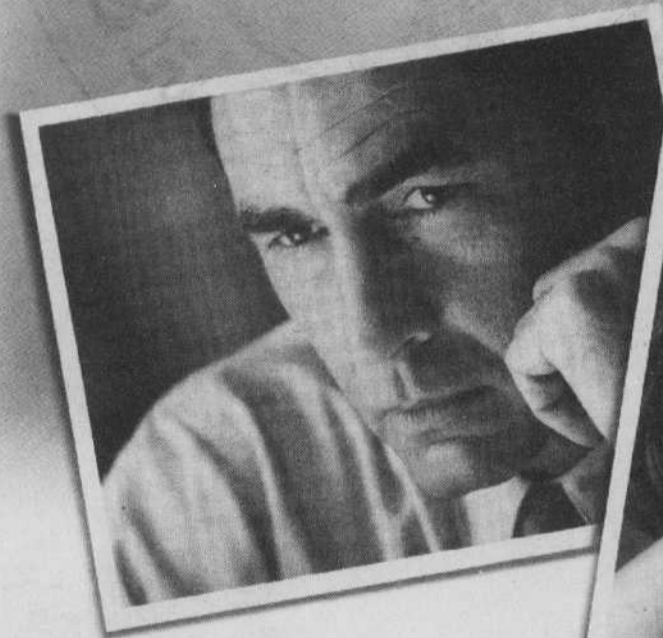

Neither Desmarais nor Gordon requires an introduction to Townships music lovers.

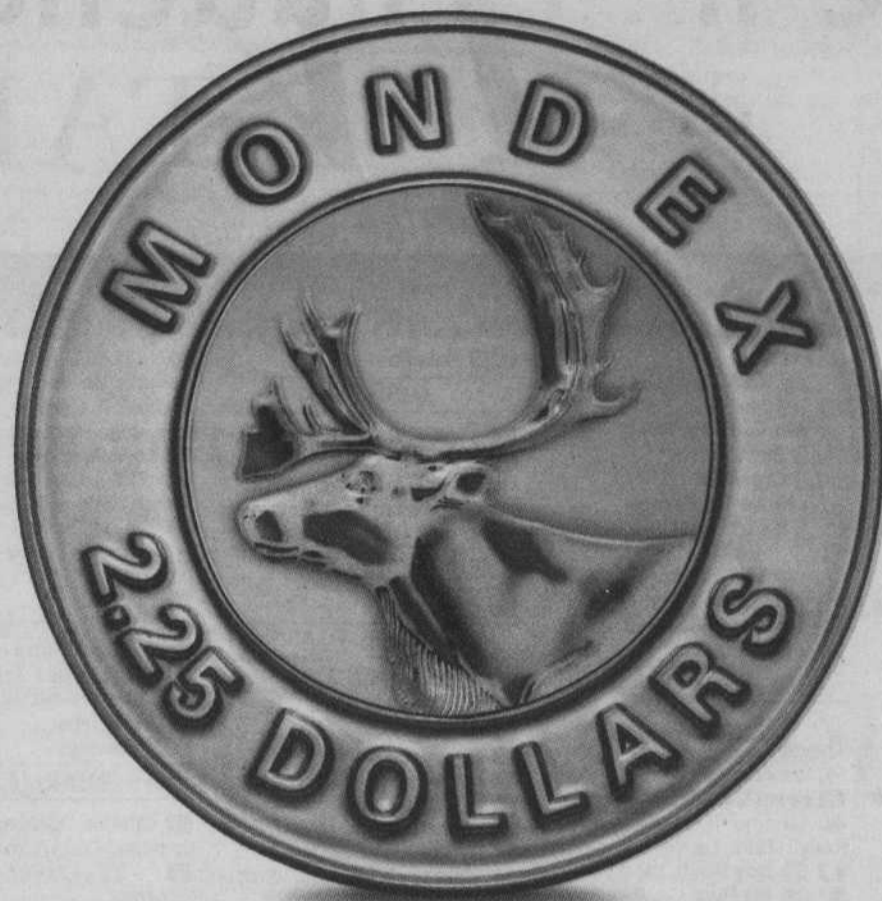
