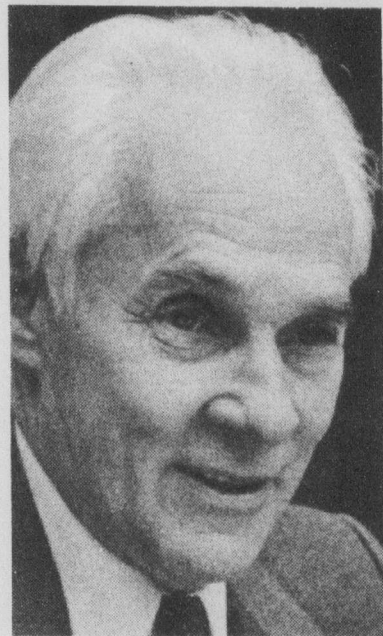

## Class experiment beats real thing

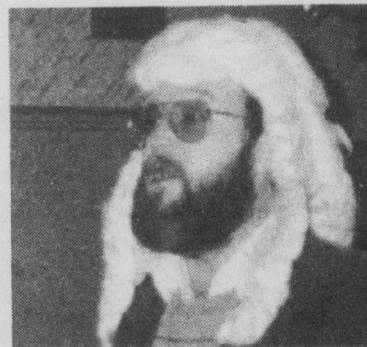
What a week! Whoever wrote the memorable line "t'is the season to be jolly" never marked term papers. If it hadn't been for some interesting wines — taken for medicinal purposes only — I don't think I would have made it.

The most fascinating of the lot, unfortunately, is not available to the general public. It seems that a while back the chemistry students at **Champlain College** decided it would be a good exercise to make some wine. Not only would they learn a considerable amount of organic chemistry along the way, but they would, shall we say, enjoy the fruits of their labor.

And enjoy we did! As the local wine scribe I was fortunate enough to be invited along for a sample and asked to give the students a mini-lesson on what to look for when tasting.

### NAMELESS WONDERS

For comparative purposes, the class had purchased two other red wines to go along with the **W-85 W-86** variety produced at **Chateau Champlain**. To save the other va-

rieties embarrassment they shall remain nameless. Suffice it to say that one was a **Bordeaux** at \$12 plus per bottle and the other was a bottle of **Cuvée d'Accommodation** at somewhere around \$7 per litre.

The **W-85 W-86** was a light, bright, clear red wine with a good

clean nose and a scent and taste of fruit that compensated for a fairly high acidity. It showed lots of vigor and was indeed more than pleasant. Sadly to say, the **Chateau Dépanneur** was second and the atrociously expensive **Bordeaux** a distant third. Surely this is what is meant by the phrase "better living through chemistry".

Later in the week, I struck gold again. This time with an Italian wine called **Cabernet Ca Bolani**. Made from the **Cabernet Franc** grape — a cousin of the famous **Cabernet Sauvignon** — this wine hails from **Aquileia** at the north-western end of the **Adriatic**. A fairly recent appellation, it is a delightful cherry red, clear, bright and with excellent balance.

### WORTH THE PRICE

At \$8.55 per bottle it is probably a trifle pricey for some but it supplies excellent value for the money.

As the week progressed, and the end appeared to be in sight, I decided a white wine would be in order. For safety's sake I picked a wine from the Spanish house of **Torres**, one of the most reputable firms exporting from that country today.

I was not disappointed. The **Vina Marimar 1986** — named after the daughter of the present owner — was everything I had hoped for. Crisp and fruity it was an excellent example of a wine made from the ubiquitous **Parellada** grape. This time, however, the **Parellada** was perfectly balanced by the classic **French Chardonnay** which makes up approximately 38 per cent of the wine.

The **Chardonnay**, aged in oak casks, gave the wine a touch of finesse and class that matched perfectly with delicate spanish grape. At \$8.90 per bottle, another excellent buy.

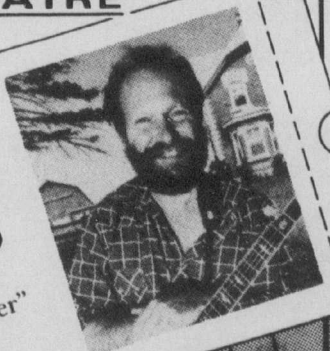
In retrospect, if exam week is half as good, I may make it after all. Cheers!

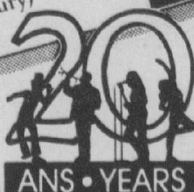

## Sweatshirts transformed with fanciful animals

# Clothing becomes art with paints and youthful advice

SHERBROOKE — "That's my jacket," three-year-old Sébastien Bureau declares proudly, pointing to a tiny Levis jean jacket decorated with a giraffe in glittery silver paint.

He then hams for the camera, showing off a sweatshirt adorned with a blue panda bear.

Sébastien is a walking advertise-

ment for his mother's fledgling business, painting original designs on children's clothing.

He's also one of her most reliable advisors.

Whatever appeals to kids, that's what Susan Steiner tries to put onto the sweatshirts, jean jackets, sneakers and other items of children's clothing she works on.

The giraffe received a good response, so she has repeated that mo-

tif on a few items. The frog is perennial favorite, so she has put frogs on Sébastien's sneakers and another version on a pair of denim overalls.

### DISPLAY HER WARES

So far Steiner's business has consisted of a few parties, much like Tupperware parties, where she has displayed her wares to mothers. She would like to build up enough interest in her products to eventually open a boutique, although she's not sure it would do well in Sherbrooke.

Steiner buys good quality Levis denims and Pennman's sweatshirts, and then paints on them, free-hand, with a thick, entirely washable paint she gets from Windsor, Ont. company. The paints come in flat, glossy and sparkly versions, which she mixes and matches in her designs.

She gets her ideas from looking through magazines and books, and from people's suggestions. Animals are her main subjects, but she also has floral and geometric designs.

Steiner thinks that working at home, if she can make a go of it, is the ideal way to run a business when you have small children.

Although the subject matter may be fanciful, Steiner isn't approaching the business idea totally unarmed. Her background is in the arts, having taken her bachelor's degree in graphic arts in New York City, and her master's degree in art education. She's just completing a marketing course at Bishop's University, which she hopes will help her launch her business.

### TRIED MARKET RESEARCH

She attempted some market research to see if her products would sell, but wasn't satisfied that the results reflected true consumer wants.

"There are some people who would look at this and not be interested; there are some who would say 'That's nice' but they'd never buy it," she said. "But there are people who look at it and love it and don't even ask the price. Those are the people I'm looking for."

Since her products are works of

art which take a certain amount of time to do, they aren't cheap. A plain sweatshirt might cost \$15 to \$18; with two or three hours of work on it, she has to charge \$26 to \$70 to make it worth the trouble.

"I usually keep track of the time it takes to do it to help me price it," she says. But there are times when she stops the clock and just keeps working until the design is "just right".

Steiner is hoping her business will get a boost when she has a booth at the *Salon des femmes* early next year.

LOS ANGELES (AP)—L.A. Law has entered the real world, with lawyers for creators Steven Bochco and Terry Louise Fisher stepping in to settle their dispute over control of the Emmy-winning TV show.

"It's now just a question of lawyers talking to one another at this point," Twentieth Century-Fox spokesman Lark Zonka said Tuesday.

A letter asked Fisher, who is also supervising producer, to stop attending story meetings and "discontinue communications with series personnel" during a "cooling-off period," said Twentieth Century-Fox Television President Harris Katleman.

The dispute results from an impasse in negotiations for a new

contract between Fisher and Fox that would make her executive producer next season. She would replace Bochco, who has signed a multimillion-dollar deal to develop series for ABC.

# Stanstead pair unwittingly launch New Age album

STANSTEAD — All Peter Mendieta and Allyn Harris wanted to do was write and perform some beautiful, innovative music and put it on tape.

They ended up being asked to pontificate on the phenomenon of New Age music — a term few people know how to define — on national radio.

As the Stanstead couple's second album, *Pools of Light* came out on cassette, Harris and Mendieta sent out press kits and promotional tapes to get some publicity. It re-

sulted, among other things, in an interview on CBC Radio's Morningside with Peter Gzowski.

The subject of the interview was not their album, however. The subject was New Age music.

"We didn't design it as a New Age album," Mendieta says, although he admits it has a lot of the features so-called New Age music tends to have.

So what is New Age music?

"I would call it a non-aggressive type of music," he says. It has a laid-back quality, with no drums or pulsating beat. If there's a beat to

it, he says, "it's not one that blows your head off."

It's a music designed to relax and soothe, rather than making the listener sit up and take notice. It frequently uses instruments and musical conventions borrowed from other cultures, he says.

### CONVENIENT HANDLE

"Everyone's running around trying to define it because people like to be able to describe things," Harris says. She explains New Age as a type of music that is created when musicians of various backgrounds — classical, pop, folk and so on — work together and produce a type of music that overlaps all the traditional categories.

For a record company or store, New Age is a convenient handle for music that doesn't fit into any of the existing categories.

Harris and Mendieta began their recording career just over two years ago when they recorded their album *Cycles* in a recording studio they had set up in their pink-painted home out in the country. It was originally designed to be a gift for some of their friends, featuring classical favorites and some original compositions with Harris on piano and Mendieta on guitar.

### 1000 SOLD

The album proved so popular that they had to produce more tapes, and eventually had a record album made. Doing all their own promotion, they have sold more than 1000 albums of *Cycles* so far. It brought in enough money to finance a second album.

The innovative quality of *Cycles* made it a hard recording to classify. Harris is amused by an Ottawa store that placed it in a section labelled "New Age, New World, New Acoustic, Ethnic Overlap, and everything else".

*Pools of Light*, which features all original compositions, continues in the relaxing, unobtrusive mode of *Cycles*, but is far more technically

complex, due to the use of synthesizers. In their press releases, they call it "an album of electro-acoustic pieces".

The couple started thinking about getting into synthesizers after the Canadian Sesame Street producers, for whom they've both done some song-writing, suggested trying some new sounds for the show.

Attending a concert by Laurie Anderson, a New Age musician who makes wide use of synthesizers, gave the couple the final push. "The next day I went out and bought a synthesizer," Harris says.

### UNLIMITED RANGE

The synthesizer gave the couple an almost unlimited range of sounds to use. Deciding which ones to use became the hardest part of the recording process. They opted mainly for the more familiar musical sounds, such as the cello, rather than the more artificial sounds usually associated with the synthesizer.

Using a synthesizer enables a composer to hear all the sounds he or she imagines, without having to hire an orchestra, Mendieta says. "Being able to put in the sounds from the synthesizer gets it closer to the music in your imagination and that's very satisfying," he says.

Of course, there's always the temptation to put make use of all the sounds available. The couple found they had to fight the tendency to put in "too many notes".

"We tried to keep the music sparse but rich-sounding at the same time," Mendieta said. "The music can be very simple, but if there's a lot of space the listener's mind can fill it in. It's kind of knowing what to leave out as well as what to put in."

Another innovation in this album is the use of natural sounds like the

creek rushing past their place, and birds. They discovered this wasn't as easy as setting up a tape recorder beside the brook.

### BATHTUB FILLING

"You say 'This sounds great' and then you play it back and it sounds like your bathtub filling up," Harris says. It took many tries to get the tape recorder set up at the right place to make the brook sound like a brook.

As for the bird sounds, they had to resort to a sound effects tape.

The album also makes use of some unusual instruments, such as a hand drum and an Indian instrument called a tambura, made out of a large pumpkin-sized gourd. Mendieta, who was born in India, had the instrument made for him and imported.

Although Harris and Mendieta enjoyed doing their own promotion of *Cycles*, they've hired a Toronto distributor for *Pools of Light*. The distributor will make the album available across Canada. Five hundred copies of the tape are now out on the market.

The couple have been running around doing promotion ever since the album came out in early November, but now they're hoping the quality of the album will speak for itself.

"We feel it's the very best we can do right now, this album," Mendieta says. "We feel like if we can just get it out there, maybe it will do something itself."

# Sherbrooke organist Panneton releases third effort, *Fantasia*

SHERBROOKE (MHG)—Bach, Telemann and Mozart have a new record thanks to organist Hélène Panneton.

Thursday, Panneton, who also plays the harpsichord, launched her third album in her hometown of Sherbrooke. The album, called *Fantasia*, features 17th and 18th century Germanic music performed by Panneton on the organ.

While she believes the music will appeal to just about everyone, she is skeptical about how well the album will sell.

"The other two (albums) sold well. I made enough to cover the expenses. But this time it will be harder because it's a bigger production and it costs more money," Panneton said.

The album contains seven tracks; two from Johann Sebastian Bach, one from each of Georg Philipp Telemann, Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart, Dieterich Buxtehude, Johann Pachelbel and Johann Ludwig Krebs. It was recorded in Rougemont.

Panneton chose the music for the album and she chose it, she says, because it was music that fit the instruments. "I had a medium-sized well-balanced organ and the acoustics were very good," she said.

When Panneton is not recording albums, she keeps busy playing the organ at the St. Viateur church in Outremont and teaching music at Bishop's University. She's also been teaching music on the side.

When the Pope was in Montreal

recently, Panneton played for him. She has also played at the inauguration of the new organ at St. Michael's Cathedral in Sherbrooke.

The Sherbrooke-born musician received her BA in music at Vincent-d'Indy where she studied organ with Juliette Millette and André Mrineau. She won the John Robb organists' contest at the Royal Canadian College in 1976 and the first prize in organ at the Montreal Music Conservatory in 1977.

Panneton will play the harpsichord at Bishop's University's Centennial Theatre Jan. 8 with cellist Louise Trudel.

## Solution to rip offs or talent killer?

# Planned artist's mediation board gets good, bad reviews

QUEBEC (CP) — Singer-guitarist Joe Jammer needs some heavy allies to battle producers who rip off artists on royalties for such things as TV commercials and radio jingles — producers he calls "vampires."

The Quebec government is about to help Jammer and other artists and entertainers by passing legislation later this month recognizing a performer's professional status.

The law, said to be the first of its kind in North America, will create a mediation board of three members appointed by the government to act as a sort of labor relations board for artists.

The board will accredit artists' associations, which can then bargain collectively to gain even-

rything from pensions to vacations for members. The board will also mediate in negotiations and arbitrate in disputes.

Employers who don't obey board decisions face fines of up to \$25,000.

Musicians' and actors associations have been bargaining collectively for years but until now they have had no legal recourse if talks break down.

### FEARS COSTS

The proposed law has film and video producers fearful that they'll be forced to negotiate dozens of separate — and expensive — contracts with performers.

Here's how Bill 90 would help someone like Joe Jammer.

The flamboyant six-foot-four guitarist has worked with everyone from Mick Jagger to Quebec's Robert Charlebois. He recently sang and performed in a beer commercial for a Toronto advertising agency.

In a telephone interview, Jammer said he had a generous contract covering royalties for the beer ad but, when the commercial became a hit and ran for twice as long as expected, the producer became a "vampire."

Jammer said his last cheque was half as big as expected and when he complained the ad agency explained that "the client feels you've been paid enough."

"When I went to the Artists Union — and this is classic — the union said, 'We'll send them a letter, which they'll ignore. Then our lawyer will send them a letter. They'll wait until the cost of the action is higher than the money we're trying to recover.'"

Under the new system, the artists' union can bring the complaint to the government board, which would then make a decision that cannot be appealed.

Not everyone is a fan of Bill 90.

**DISLIKES LAW**  
Marie-Josée Raymond, vice-president of an association representing 85 per cent of Quebec's independent video and film producers, thinks it is a downright bad law.

"With tax shelter laws (to encourage Canadian film production) ebbing, this is another blow," she said in an interview. "We may end up negotiating with costume makers, dancers, saxophone players...there is no limit."

Raymond said the proposed law won't cover broadcasters, since they are under federal jurisdic-

tion. Therefore, a TV network will be able to produce films unburdened by the extra costs created by Bill 90.

Andre Di Cesare, president of the Quebec association of music and video producers, predicted that imposing minimum wages will close doors to young talent.

"The laws of the marketplace will force producers to rely exclusively on known talent to limit the risk," Di Cesare said.

Even Emile Subirana, who supports Bill 90, says the new system may not work as smoothly as envisioned.

"I hope lawyers will stay out of this," Subirana, president of the 3,200-member Montreal Musicians' Guild, said in a telephone interview. "There's already quite a bit of litigation now."

Anne will do *I believe in Santa Claus* — in French — with a group of children from East Angus.

Also singing will be the girls in Toulouse, Texas Quebec member Alain Carpentier, Sherbrooke native Carole Vincelet and Richard Huet. Show time is 7 p.m.

ASBURY PARK, N.J. (AP) — Actor Danny DeVito brought a bit of Hollywood to his seaside hometown with the world premiere of his movie, *Throw Momma from the Train*.

The movie's first showing was Tuesday night at the Paramount Theatre in this faded resort, in the neighborhood where DeVito's mother and sisters still live.

"Oh my God, he's so short," a woman screamed as DeVito, 43, was literally carried in to the theatre from the limousine by several police officers.

Under the glare of spotlights and television cameras, other celebrities showed up, including actors Christopher Reeve and John Shea and actress Carol Kane, who appeared with DeVito in the TV show

Taxi. Rock star and local resident Jon Bon Jovi arrived amid screams from fans.

NEW YORK (AP) — The National Book Critics Circle has nominated novels by Toni Morrison, Philip Roth and Tom Wolfe as among the year's best American works of fiction.

The organization's board of directors completed on Monday the list of 25 nominees in five categories — fiction, non-fiction, biography, poetry and criticism.

The fiction nominations are for Wolfe's *The Bonfire of the Vanities*; *Beloved*, by Morrison; *The Counterlife*, by Roth; *Crossing to Safety*, by Wallace Stegner; and Jane Smiley's collection of stories, *The Age of Grief*.

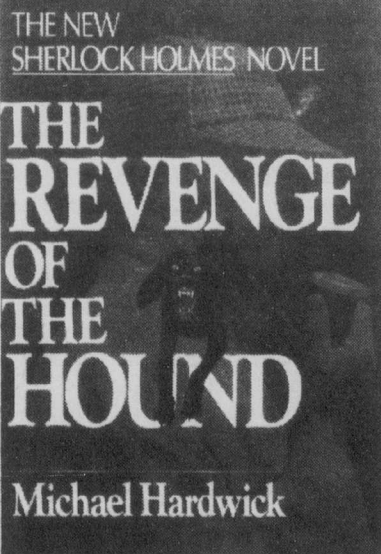

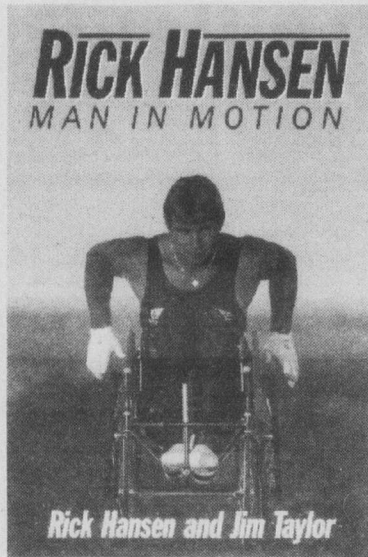

The conclusion of his *North and South Trilogy*, Heaven and Hell finds John Jakes picking up his epic tale of the American Civil War in the spring of 1865. His two representative families — the Hazards of Pennsylvania and the Mains of South Carolina — find their survivors locked in further intertwining, exciting adventures. This series satisfies the American penchant for dynastic families and roots with one massive tome to add to the previous two sagas. (HARCOURT BRACE JOVANOVICH: \$28.95).

Canadians who whetted their appetites for national heroes with the running exploits of Terry Fox and his imitators will find the exploits of the valiant Rick Hansen to their



liking in his book *Man In Motion*, co-written by Rick and Jim Taylor, a veteran sports columnist with the *Vancouver Province*. In a half-diary, half-memoir format, Hansen transcribes the events that surrounded his 24,901-mile wheelchair journey through 34 countries around the world. (DOUGLAS & MCINTYRE: \$19.95).

Acclaimed as her most accomplished and spellbinding achievement, author Toni Morrison's *BeLoved* is the writer's latest probing of the psyche of the American black, set in post-Civil War Ohio.

Morrison's novels are noted for their handling of language, the force of their emotional appeal, and her ability to combine the lyrical with the imaginative. (RANDOM HOUSE: \$27.75).

Winners of the Seal Books First Novel Award have not always been authors that readers are eager to discover, but Jo Anne Williams Bennett has cracked that jinx with *Downfall People*, a book about the lives of natives in West Africa. Her experience in the area arose when she spent two years there researching a dissertation on Muslim education, the fieldwork which served as the social and cultural background for her first novel. (BANTAM-SEAL: \$4.95).



## RECORDS & TAPES

Sounding a bit like Tom Waits gargling Drano, Marianne Faithfull's voice on *STRANGE WEATHER* (ISLAND-MCA) works its way through the song that shot her into prominence at the height of the British Invasion in 1965, *As Tears Go By*, which she reprises here. A musical version of sad-sounding starlets like Marlene Dietrich, Faithfull sings *Boulevard of Broken Dreams* as only someone who has walked the street could. George Harrison has turned the

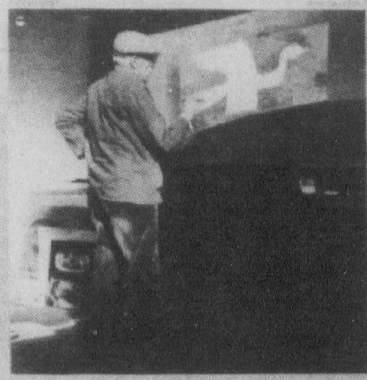
# Great albums and soundtracks that eclipse the movie

pop music business upside down with his monster LP *Cloud Nine* (DARK HORSE-WEA), produced by Jeff Lynn, mastermind behind the Electric Light Orchestra. It's a musical mating that spells dividends for music lovers, as George's tracks have the magic in them that hasn't really been present since his *All Things Must Pass* triple album set from 1970. One listen to the haunting nostalgia of *When We Was Fab* will send Beatlemaniacs searching for this record, but be forewarned, it is in very short supply, making it surely the hottest selling album in recent history, rivalling even Prince & Michael.

Quebecers have always taken Supertramp into their hearts with a special fervor, so their latest album *Free as a Bird* (A&M) will most definitely find favour, though aficionados of Rick Davies and friends may find that the recording of this set in Encino and West Hollywood will have changed the basically British ambience of Supertramp a tad.

*Romeo's Escape* (EPIC-COLUMBIA) will find its way onto most New Year's retrospectives of top albums of 1987, thanks to David Alvin's eight year association with the L.A. rock scene as lead guitarist with the Blasters, after dues-



paying with The Knitters and X. Alvin's sound could be deemed to be the kind of music that gets R.E.M. dubbed as the best rock band in America. Alvin's songs are entirely synthetic — a raw blend of southwestern country music, city blues and pop rock, which comes out as a cross between Los Lobos and Let's Active. Had Hank Williams been wired on coke instead of juice, his songs might have sounded a bit like Dave Alvin's.

With the kind of music on the soundtrack of the new Timothy Hutton/Kelly McGillis film *Made In Heaven* (ELEKTRA-WEA), the screen images may get overshadowed by the likes of R.E.M., songs written by Neil Young, Ric Ocasek and Mark Isham, and revival of a couple of dynamite Buffalo Springfield tracks that should ignite the spark lit by discovery of *For What It's Worth* by the Euro-pop generation. *Romance* is the track by R.E.M., while Martha Davis sings Young's *We've Never Danced*, with Ocasek contributing *I Still Want You*. The revived Buffalo Springfield tracks are the ahead-of-its-time *Mr. Soul*, and Neil Young's *I Am A Child*. It would appear that legit cinema is discovering the sixties just the way that 7-Up, beer brands and Nike's are, so look for a flood of cinematic musical memories featuring the

best bands of that halcyon age.

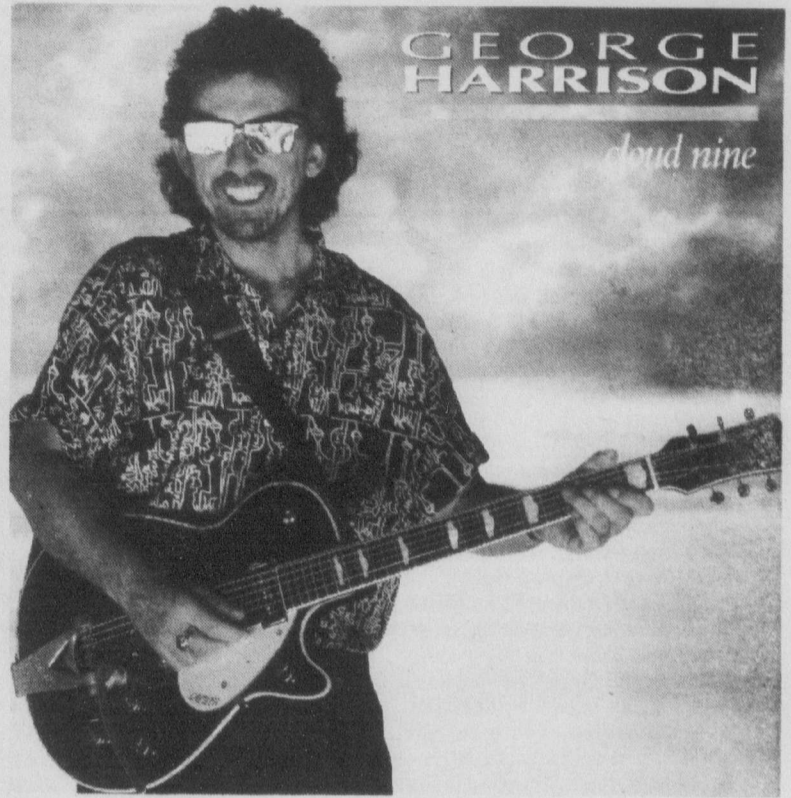
After placing his inimitable musical stamp on the soundtracks of films like *Local Hero*, *Cal and Comfort and Joy*, Dire Straits's mentor Mark Knopfler lends his gentle harmonic progressions on guitar and his impeccable sense of timing to the background music of *The Princess Bride* (POLYGRAM). The result is a storybook kind of soft mood music that allows listeners to sit by the fireside and thrill to one of the best of rock's guitarplayers taking a busman's holiday for which we all can be thankful. Knopfler's playing surely has reached its upper limit of tastefulness with this recording.

Ry Cooder has reached into some fairly obscure musical trunks to pull out some of his best guitar stuff, but on his latest album he borrows a song from Johnny Cash's Sun Records days for both the title track and one of *Get Rhythm's* best songs. From the same era he pulls out Elvis's *All Shook Up*, or maybe that should read Otis Blackwell's classic, plus a fairly obscure Chuck Berry tune *13 Question Method*, which like his other signature songs like *Reelin' and Rockin'* or *My Dingaling*, skirts very closely around obscenity in a risqué, teasing fashion.

Cooder's guitars — slide, Stratocaster, and acoustic — ring out all over this album, with the picking enhanced by Jim Keltner's drumming, Van Dyke Parks's keyboards, and the vocals of Larry Blackmon of Cameo on *All Shook Up*. Ry Cooder's production on his own album shows that he knows precisely what he wants when he enters the studio, and all of it is preserved with care on this exciting album.

#### VIDEO SCREENINGS OUTRAGEOUS FORTUNE (TOUCHSTONE HOME VIDEO)

Pairing Shelley Long with Bette Midler is a bit like throwing a baby lamb in with a starving alligator, but the movie *Outrageous Fortune* manages to turn this unlikely duo into a pair of wacked out ladies who share a boyfriend and a penchant for trouble. The situations are about as cerebral as a Three Stooges film, but we're supposed to accept that Long and Midler are budding actresses who both fall for the same schoolteacher, who turns out to be a nefarious scoundrel who has stolen a vial of deadly toxin which can defoliate half of Ameri-



ca if he should loosen its stopper.

The FBI gets into the action and our wild and crazy guys take to the desert. There they encounter an Indian scout played by George Carlin in a cameo he would like to forget. The sight gags are piled higher and higher in this mildly humorous film. Having Shelley Long play a young actress who gets to display her marvellous acting prowess by doing a number of "real life" acting experiences is some sort of Chinese box of improbability, and

even Ms. Midler, the Divine Ms. Midler, hardly gets off any of the kinds of lines that made her notable in *Ruthless People*. As comedy this movie struggles desperately to obtain a sort of *Romancing the Stone* ambience, but gets as close to it as *Mad Magazine's* What Me Worry character gets to the Mona Lisa. 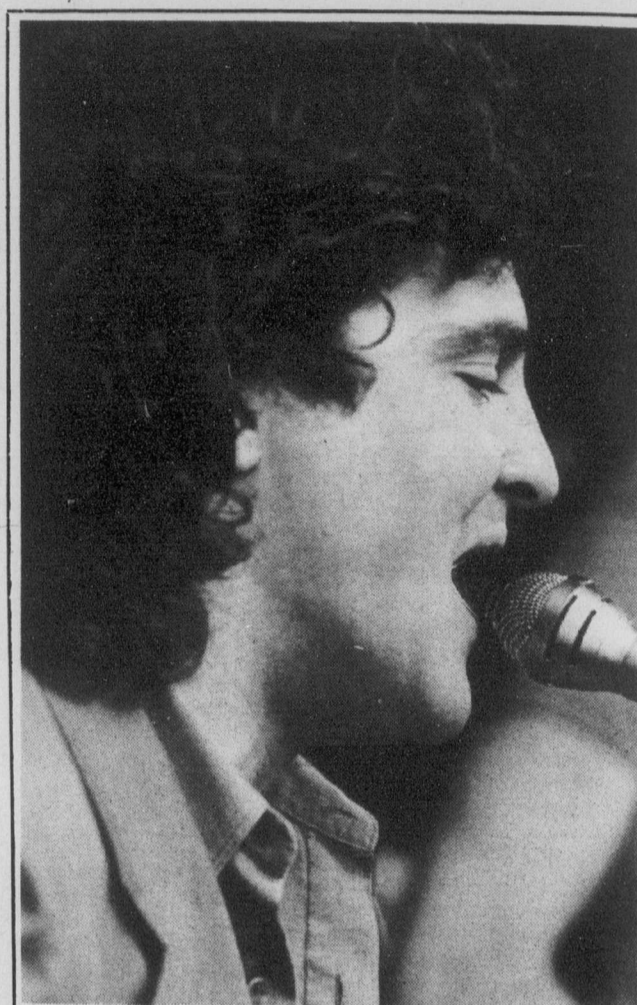

# Montreal rocker Corey Hart down but not out with fans

Corey Hart zoomed into the upper reaches of stardom faster than any Canadian rock star. Just as quickly, he suffered one of the worst crashes.

In 1984, the struggling Montreal singer was suddenly transformed into an international star when his debut album, *First Offense*, became a Top 10 hit worldwide.

His second album, *Boy in the Box*, was even bigger. It sold more than a million copies in Canada alone.

Then came *Fields of Fire* in 1986—a "relative failure" with sales of 300,000 in Canada, said Keith Brown, label manager for Hart's record company, Aquarius Records in Montreal.

Things got worse on tour. Hart felt lethargic in Japan, and complained of chronic tiredness in the United States where many shows were far from sellouts.

He was unable to keep food down, was losing weight and couldn't sleep, but decided to wait until he was back in Canada to see a doctor.

Despite his worsening condition, his management kept adding dates

to the tour. The inevitable happened in Northern Ontario.

**'HAD NO ENERGY'**

"I did one show in Sudbury, and I came off the stage and I collapsed. I had no energy," Hart said recently from London.

He said he got through a lacklustre show in Sault Ste. Marie. But after a Thunder Bay concert, he collapsed again.

He flew to Montreal, where a doctor found he was 12 pounds underweight, diagnosed exhaustion and prescribed three months' rest.

Even though it meant Hart and the promoters would lose thousands of dollars, the rest of the tour

was cancelled.

"I know I was pretty screwed up," said Hart, 25.

"I had literally not taken a break since 1982.... Since then I did three albums and three major tours. It was an accumulation of all that work catching up with me."

Cancelling the tour also gave him a reason to say yes to CBC brass who had been badgering him for years to do a TV special. If he couldn't come to his fans' towns, he'd come into their homes.

Titled *Corey Hart*, the hour-long "rockumentary" will be broadcast this Sunday. In interviews, Hart discusses living in Spain, Mexico

and Montreal, and trying to make it as a singer.

There's also footage from a concert at the Montreal Forum in September—he rested for only two months—held especially for the special.

Hart discounts rumors that he suffered not physical exhaustion but nervous collapse, panicky because *Fields of Fire* was not selling well and concert attendance was down.

"It had nothing to do with that," he retorted. "Granted the record didn't perform as the ones in the past, but to me I've never looked at this as a three-inning ball game."

## Movie will portray witch hunting as war on 15th century feminists

ST. JOHN'S, Nfld. (CP)—The misty forests of Newfoundland and Nova Scotia are being considered as possible locations for a movie about the witch burnings of 17th century Europe.

The Canadian movie, a sort of feminist version of the Robin Hood legend, is about a band of accused witches who hide in the forest and launch daring rescues of other women, producer Nanci Rossov said.

"At the time the film starts, which is 1644, it was the beginning of the last great purge of witches in Europe," said Rossov, who was in St. John's this week to promote the film with Sonja Smits, star of the CBC television weekly series *Street Legal*.

When Rossov and Smits decided to do the project, they realized the subject had yet to be dealt with seriously by the movie industry.

"It had either been trivialized or made fun of or made horrific as in a horror story," said Rossov, a Canadian-born director, writer and

producer who now lives in Los Angeles.

The persecutions took place over a 300-year period as Europe was coming out of the Dark Ages and into the Renaissance. Rossov said estimates of the number of people killed range from nine million to as many as 30 million. About two-thirds were women.

### WAR ON WOMEN

Those most likely to be accused were widowed and unmarried women not under the protection of a male, midwives and traditional healers who were competing with the growing male-only medical profession and women who owned land sought by the state.

Feminist historians have said the atrocities of this period have been wrongly dismissed as a superstitious frenzy brought on by deadly epidemics of Black Plague. The feminists have interpreted the witch burnings as a war against women who sought equality with men.

"There's no question in my mind

that one of the reasons this story hasn't been told is because it is women's history," Rossov said.

The film's not preachy, however.

"We have worked very hard to make it a popular film."

The script contains harrowing rescues of women about to be tried by water—a trial in which a woman was tied up and thrown in water. If she drowned, she was innocent, if she managed to float, she was found guilty and burned at the stake.

There's also romance.

### HAS LOVE INTEREST

Hester, the leader of the band played by Smits, has a love interest, as does Gertie, "who is kind of the Little John of the band. Her boyfriend, lover, whatever, is as big and as strapping as she is, so there's lots of conventional imagery in it."

Newfoundland and Nova Scotia have the dark, misty forests and wild, rocky landscapes sought by the film-makers, who intend to make the set look like Scotland.

It will cost about \$3.5 million to produce and will require a crew of about 200 to be hired from the Atlantic region.

Telefilm, a Canadian film-production company, and Studio D of the National Film Board, have committed some financial backing. Rossov and Smits are also seeking help from provincial government bodies and local arts communities.

Rossov said Newfoundland has the terrain and quality of light and possibly the people being sought by the film-makers.

"The women of Newfoundland are a very interesting, strong, individualistic group of people. Their speech patterns are unique and we want to create an otherness sense."

Nova Scotia has a more centralized and established film industry which would make it easier to produce the movie, she said.

They plan to shoot it next summer and release it in the spring of 1989.

## Crystal Gayle's career on rise after 15 years

NASHVILLE, Tenn. (AP)—Crystal Gayle's singing career, like her flowing ebony hair, has just kept on growing.

With an entrancing voice and songs about common hopes and simple pleasures, she soon will mark her 15th year as a recording artist.

Gayle's had more than 30 Top 10 hits on the country music charts and she's now working on her 14th album. Few women in country music have achieved such enduring success.

Her five feet of fetching, silky hair has become a trademark.

"When I first started (in show business), I had long hair and it was just my style," she said. "It just turned into my trademark."

The 36-year-old petite performer is best known for her 1977 hit, *Don't It Make My Brown Eyes Blue*.

"I love it and I'll never get tired of performing it."

There are also two other of her songs she rates as good or better: *When I Dream* and *He Is Beautiful to Me*.

"They both say a lot and are well written. You can sing them with a lot of meaning. They go beyond a regular song."

Gayle offers these capsule comments on two of her other No. 1 hits:

**BUILDS CAREER**

— *I'll Get Over you*: "It was my first No. 1 song and was well written and produced. Each song before it had kept getting a little higher (in the charts), so this one built my career."

— *Straight to the Heart* (her most recent No. 1 song): "I liked it because of the unusual intro: sparse with the instruments, then it goes into a really good beat. I liked what it said."

Gayle, a native of Paintsville, Ky., was the youngest of eight children. She grew up in Wabash, Ind., and moved to Nashville as a young woman.

She won a Grammy in 1978 for *Don't It Make My Brown Eyes Blue*. A year later she made an historic trip to China where she performed with Bob Hope.

Gayle most recently joined singer Gary Morris in recording the theme song for the soap opera, *Another World*, and appeared with him on the provocative cover of the album *What If We Fall in Love*. The photo showed the two embracing and left the impression both were nude.

Among her other hits are *Half the Way*, *Talking in Your Sleep*, *Ready for the Times to Get Better* and *Why Have You Left the One You Left Me For?*

Gayle says 15 years as a top entertainer have changed her little.

### GIGGLES MORE

"I giggle a lot more," she said. "I've matured in the business, but that's true of anyone. I haven't changed in values or in things that matter."

She describes her relationship with her older sister, Loretta Lynn, as "pretty close for not growing up together and being unable to see each other as much as we'd like."

Lynn, the subject of the movie *Coal Miner's Daughter*, had married and moved away from home before Gayle—whose real name is Brenda Gail Webb—was born.

Lynn, in fact, came up with the stage name for her sister. She took the first name from a fast-food hamburger chain, altered the spelling and dropped Brenda so nobody would confuse her sister with singer Brenda Lee.

Gayle says she's been so busy she hasn't seen the new weekly television show starring fellow country star Dolly Parton.

"I love her and hope it does great," she said.

At any rate, Gayle's 4-year-old daughter, Catherine Claire, already can sing most of her mother's songs.

"She's grown her hair long so she can be a singer," her mother quipped.

## Photos of 'what the family farm used to be'

# Farmboy-turned-photographer show the graphic side

WINNIPEG (CP) — The photo of neatly severed chicken heads half-buried in feathers around a tree-stump butcher block isn't meant to shock anyone.

Nor is the shot of headless hens, stacked on a table and draped with a blood-stained sheet, designed to turn the stomachs of queasy city types.

"I'm not suggesting that people have to look at the photographs every time they sit down to a chicken dinner," insists photographer Robert Barrow, his voice echoing through the spacious gallery of Winnipeg's Museum of Man and Nature.

"(But) that's part of what the family farm used to be to me."

The killing and cleaning of the chickens is just one slice of the family farm life urbanites can glimpse in Rural Route, a collection of more than 80 photographs featuring rural landscapes, animals and people.

### COLLECTS 'CULTURE'

A farmboy-turned-photographer from Swan River, Man., Barrow,

36, spent about five years and travelled three provinces collecting black-and-white photos of a culture he feels is disappearing under a trend to bigger, more mechanized agriculture.

But that trend means little to city dwellers, who still buy chicken wrapped in neat cellophane packages and may know no more of farming than television news stories showing giant combines, he said.

"I don't think people consciously think of where their food is produced," said Barrow, a local photographer whose work has appeared in several Winnipeg art galleries.

Many of the photographs are from Barrow's hometown where he helped run the family wheat, cattle and chicken farm until moving to Winnipeg more than a decade ago.

Others pictures, from Saskatchewan and Prince Edward Island, could bring a rush of memories for any farmer who's hung up his overalls and moved to the city.

### SUGGESTS 'DEATH'

Although the family farm is un-

der economic seige, Barrow's pictures are devoid of strong political images like an auctioneer's block or rifle-toting farmers guarding the gate from foreclosing bankers.

But some shots suggest the death of the family farm. Distant piles of gravel resemble giant grave mounds, while a blanketed batch of young tomato plants, surrounded

by an eerie mist, looks like a body wrapped in a shroud.

Oddly enough, it was the stormy debates to remove the historic Crowsnest Pass freight subsidies for grain that sparked the idea for the exhibit.

A farmer friend from Swan River, Man., invited some Winnipeg acquaintances out to his farm and

queried them about the controversy, which ended in 1983 with grain transportation benefits going directly to the railways.

"They said they didn't think it affected them very much because they didn't buy any of their food from the farmer, they bought it at the store," Barrow sighed.

The exhibit runs until Jan. 17.

## Playwright Miller talks about Marilyn, media

TORONTO (CP) — Playwright Arthur Miller can speak at length on almost any subject — from theatre to the U.S.-Sviet summit — but his body tenses and his eyes turn cold when asked about former wife Marilyn Monroe.

Writing about the legendary actress was painful, Miller admitted Tuesday at a news conference to promote his autobiography, *Timebends*.

"That was part of my life so I didn't go out like some people and try and find a way to write about her," he says. "I did the minimal amount that could be done."

"This book is among other things a history of the last 40 years. It's something else than Marilyn Monroe in there."

The 72-year-old author of *Death of a Salesman* has been hounded by the news media about his disastrous four-year marriage to the actress, who committed suicide in 1962.

He denies the Monroe connection eclipsed his career as a playwright.

"That's only in your mind," he snaps.

Miller writes with affection about Monroe saying she was ahead of her time and maligned by an unrelenting press.

### FACED PROBLEMS

"I think if she'd come along later she would have had fewer problems because the hypocrisy regarding sex and rest of it was far greater in the '50s and '40s," he says in a gravelly voice. "But she

may not have been as remarkable later."

He still harbors hard feelings toward the news media which "trivializes events which have enormous tragic circumstances for the world for mankind."

"I turned on television this morning and they cornered Nancy Reagan and began pumping her for some remarks about Mrs. Gorbachev," he complains. "Now here is one of the most important meetings between two of the greatest powers that ever occupied positions in the history of the world and there's twenty minutes on the television about their clothes."

### AGREES WITH AIM

The Washington summit, expected to produce a superpower treaty to eliminate medium-range missiles, is a step in the right direction, he adds.

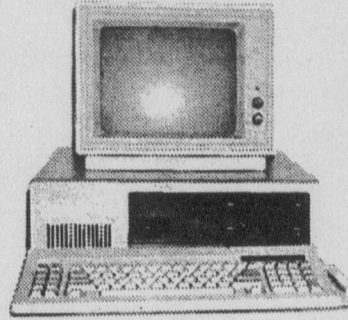
He is also critical of the current theatre culture in New York.

"The commercial theatre, straight plays, in New York is currently dead as a going operation," he asserts. "What we've got now are imported musicals that have proven in the estimate of the producers that they can attract the public."

"The irony is that my plays are playing more in England than any English playwrights," he chuckles.

A new play is in the works but a teasing Miller won't reveal any details except to say that "it's a contemporary thing."

"I have a big play on the desk now," he says. "I don't know why I would bother with it, but I do."

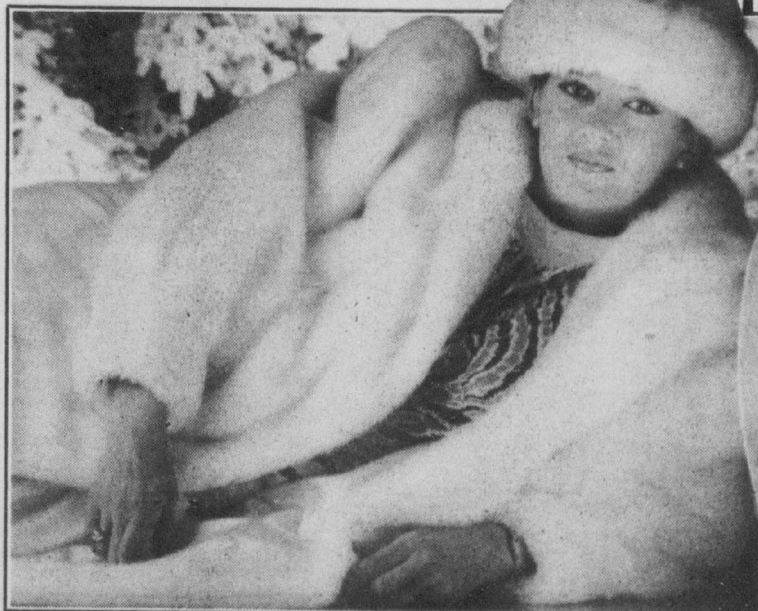
