

# My son's terrifying new amusement

**M**y mall stories from Hell usually amuse my friends and family, but a recent trip to the mall was anything but.

About two months ago, my son decided it'd be great fun if he ran away from me in public, this forcing me to chase him down streets and hallways with my teeth gritted and pulse racing, hoping and praying he'll remain safe until I catch up with him. You've never experienced terror until you've seen your kid take off like a bullet down a street, threatening to cross it without checking for traffic when he sees you approaching too rapidly.

Needless to say, bringing him to the mall was almost impossible considering his newfound hobby. However, I did bring him once for a trip that was supposed to be simple: Go to the bank, go to Zellers to pay my overdue bill, grab a juice and muffin, and take the bus home. Easy, I thought. In and out, no problem.

Wrong.

I went to Zellers with my kids and sat my son on the cashier's counter next to me to prevent him from making an escape but when I reached into my purse to get my wallet, he jumped off the counter and took off like the end of the world was

coming. I grabbed my daughter by the wrist and we literally flew down the aisle to catch up with him, but he'd already run up the escalator to the second floor. By the time we got there, he was nowhere to be seen.

For 10 agonizing minutes I went from cashier to cashier asking if they'd seen a boy in a red t-shirt and gray Bugs Bunny shorts. Nobody had. Fortunately, nobody had seen him actually leave the store, either, so I assumed he was hiding out somewhere in the racks of clothing.

What's a parent supposed to do in a situation like that? I had my daughter with me, who was wailing that her little brother was gone forever; meanwhile, a million scenarios passed through my head: What if he managed to open the door and is now running around the parking lot? What if someone grabbed him? What if he did indeed leave Zellers and is on his way clear to the other end of the mall? And here I am, virtually helpless.

My daughter and I went back downstairs in case he was there and I trusted the cashiers upstairs to watch for him. We found my son in the toy section, casually looking at all the cool stuff. I was relieved, angry, depressed, upset, embarrassed and guilt-ridden. You name it, I felt it. I immediately purchased one of the wrist-to-wrist "leashes", slapped it on him like a handcuff and went straight home, too numb to think or do much of anything.

Of course, losing my son was the most traumatic event of the day, but in

hindsight, one of the things that bothered me most during the ordeal was the way other parents looked at me as I was calling out my son's name and searching for him. You could see it all over their faces: Bad mother, bad mother.

Bad mother? I had done everything I could to keep him with me. I had sat him on the counter right next to me so I could hold him and keep an eye on him, but when I let him go for five seconds, he saw an opportunity to flee and went for it. It took me 10 seconds, at the most, to throw my wallet back in my purse and make my way out of the cashier's line to chase after him. By that time, he was gone.

I really think I did all I could under those circumstances, but until your own child proves to you just how little time it takes to disappear, you always have this arrogant voice in the back of your head that says *you* would have caught up sooner, *you* would never have lost your child, *you* are a better parent than that. Hey, until my son did this to me, I was the same way: "Me? Lose one of my kids? Never!"

Now my son is restrained by the leash I purchased, and he doesn't try to run away as often as before. Whenever I see a parent out in public, struggling to deal with a rebellious child, or wandering with that worried look, searching down aisles for an obviously lost child, I think, "There but for the grace of God go I." And later, when the parents think back, I hope they'll appreciate the two or three seconds of understanding that passed between us. I know I would have.

The Foster family vacation:

## Playwright, wife star in Piggery production

Norm Foster's latest play, *Here On The Flight Path*, which begins a two-week run at The Piggery Theatre tonight, is a family affair.

In addition to being the director and playwright of the piece, Foster stars as the male lead. His wife, Janet Monid, is the only other actor, playing three different roles in the comedy. Foster says he wrote the play with family participation in mind.

"I wanted to do something where we could work together so we could have a sort of work-vacation together," he says. "Now we get to spend three weeks in the Eastern Townships."

Foster says he likes the Townships for its holiday potential as well as its well-informed theatre patrons. Foster is no stranger to the region, he was here last year for the production of his piece *Wrong For Each Other*. He was also here in 1986 for *The Melville Boys* and in 1989 with *Opening Night*.

Foster and Monid have spent the last week in rehearsals, during which the couple were normally at the theatre from noon until midnight. Meanwhile, their children, Jacqueline, 6, and Daniel, 9, stay with a babysitter down the road. Once the play has started its run, the family will have their days free to spend their work-vacation as they please.

Foster has reached the point in his career where he can create plays that suit his family vacation plans. He has been called "Canada's pre-eminent comic playwright," and is currently one of the nation's most prolific and produced writers.

Four of his plays will have world premieres this year, and *Wrong For Each Other* will be produced in London, England and Sydney, Australia this year. He said it has taken him anywhere from one month to five years to write a play, but on average it takes him about four months.

Foster grew up in Scarborough, Ont., and studied Radio and Television Arts before he wrote his first plays while studying in Thunder Bay, Ont. in 1980. He moved with his wife to Fredericton, N.B., 10 years ago. He also works as an announcer at a local radio station, a vo-

ca-tion which he says gives him a lot of ideas for stories, and experience in the acting field.

"I wouldn't say the switch from writer to acting was too difficult for me because I play several different characters on my radio show, so I was used to a little acting," he says.

Monid studied theatre at the University of Waterloo, and worked in Toronto in everything from theatre to movies to modelling before moving to Fredericton. She has been acting "for as long as I can remember," she says, laughing.

The couple say they have a great time working together and sharing artistic viewpoints, but only to a certain limit.

"I'll give suggestions if I think something needs fixing, but I try to not to interfere with the director," Monid says. "I think only one person should work as director on the set."

The director in this case is Foster, but since he is also starring in the play, he asked for a little help. Directing himself, he said, doesn't always work very well.

"It's difficult to conduct yourself,"

he says. "You tell yourself that something has to be done or changed, but once you're acting in the middle of the

stage, you forget what you meant to do." Greg Tuck, artistic director for the Piggery, is helping out with co-direction on the play.

*Here On The Flight Path*, which had its debut at the Sheraton Inn in Fredericton in February, is the story of John, a divorced and lonely newspaper columnist who lives alone in an apartment. Over the course of three and a half years, John meets and converses from balcony to balcony with the three very different women, all played by Monid, who move into the adjoining apartment, sharing views on life, marriage and sex. The play received excellent reviews in Fredericton.

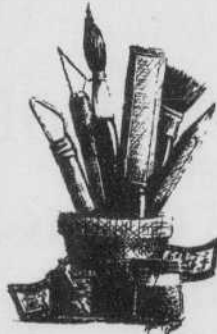
Foster and Monid can be seen on stage every night for the next two weeks. You can also catch them weekdays with their children in and around the Townships, working on the other part of their "work-vacation."

# Turovsky adds variety to Festival Orford

The tranquil landscape of Mount Orford once again provides the ideal backdrop for evenings of classical music during the 46th Festival Orford running through Aug. 17.

Held each year at the Orford Arts Centre summer music school, the festival of classical music provides a chance for students and the public to enjoy performances by internationally renowned artists.

Some 300 students from Canada and around the globe, including China, Russia, Germany, France and Japan, flock to the centre to study with professional musicians.

"The festival is serving the school by inviting professors who are at the same time great performers," said the centre's artistic director Yuli Turovsky.

Students also benefit from rehearsing with a renowned 14-member chamber orchestra I Musici de Montreal, in which Turovsky plays the cello and conducts.

"Since I Musici is in residence here, students are participating in rehearsals with a professional orchestra," said Turovsky. "It gives them experience they cannot get easily.... The learning process becomes much faster."

## FAMOUS MUSICIANS

Indeed, being in the presence of performers such as Eugene Levinson, principal bassist of the New York Philharmonic, Frank Morelli, principal bassoonist for the New York City Opera, and members of the Montreal Symphony Orchestra is sure to have a positive effect on budding musicians.

Breezes hushing over lush leaves, the chirping of birds and the lack of distractions are conducive to long days of study and practices.

"I've had a student come up to me and say, 'Yuli, I've been practicing six and nine hours a day! I've never done that before'," said Turovsky with a laugh.

At last year's festival, the newly appointed artistic director added a little zest to the proceedings by holding the first Orford Arts Centre International Music Competition for the students. In three categories - cello, violin and piano - participants vied for scholarships to the arts centre worth \$2000 and a chance to be featured with I Musici on a compact disc. The winner in the violin

category, Alexander Trostiansky, will be returning this year to perform Arensky's Concerto for violin, op. 54, with the Montreal Symphony Orchestra during an August 2 performance in Magog's St. Patrick's Church, part of the *Orford en région* series.

Turovsky is repeating the competition this year, as well as including a new contest. Pianists will compete for a chance to perform as the featured soloist when I Musici plays Beethoven's Concerto No. 2 on July 25 at the centre.

Turovsky has also added opera and

dance to this year's festival. Voice students and an orchestra composed of musicians teaching at the centre will perform Mozart's *The Marriage of Figaro* July 18. On Aug. 18, five dancers from Hungary, Belgium and Canada will perform a Dominique Porte choreography to Ligeti's *Six Bagatelles for Wind Quintet*.

"It's not a very long piece," said Turovsky. "But it brings something new."

Visual arts programming during the festival takes a twist as more than 100 artists will be featured in a series of

eight, 10-day exhibitions.

"I think that with the competitions and the new things it's very stimulating," said Turovsky. "Variety is one of the things we're looking for."

Adding dance, opera and painting into the scope of the festival is part of Turovsky's plan to return the Orford Arts Centre back to its artistically diverse roots.

"It's important since this is an arts centre," he said. "Of course music is a first priority, but we should develop into other things. It should be more stimulating for the students to develop different tastes."

## BACK TO ITS ROOTS

"It started like a multi-media place, with theatre and painting," Turovsky added. "Through the years, with the music school, the level of the importance of music became very high. I want to give back some features that were here at the beginning."

Tradition is being followed at the Orford Arts Centre this year with free concerts played by the students each Thursday evening and Sunday morning. Sunday morning concerts feature an outdoor buffet.

Students are also bringing the festival to other venues in the Townships, including Eastman's St. Edward's Church on July 23 and the Haskell Opera House, on the border of Rock Island and Derby Line, Vt. on Aug. 6.

Radio-Canada will be recording five concerts throughout the festival for broadcast on the series *Les Grandes Soirées*, including the closing night's performance when the winners of the music competition will perform as soloists with an orchestra composed of the centre's teacher-musicians.

Turovsky said even seasoned musicians feel an extra tingle of excitement when performing for broadcast.

"When you're in front of a microphone it does make you a bit more nervous," said Turovsky.

He said with some of Radio-Canada's shows being carried by other stations, concerts at the centre should be heard "not only in Canada, but anywhere in the world."

Something old, something new and a collection of borrowed tunes  
**New summer sounds to do the two-step to**

**A**re you looking for some entertaining music this summer? Music that will make you want to get up from your lawn chair and two-step around the swimming pool? Let's start with something familiar but still fresh at the same time.

Neal McCoy, *Greatest Hits*, (Atlantic)

This album, a 10-song collection, has music that is perfect for creating summer memories. Almost every cut on the album will remind you of a special moment of the summer of 1997. All of McCoy's hits are here, from his first No. 1 single, 1994's "No Doubt About It," to "Wink," which topped the charts for a whole month straight that same year. Another great cut is the soulful remake of The Casinos' classic "Then You Can Tell Me Goodbye."

There's also something new - McCoy's latest single "The Shake". It's a high-tempo number that'll make you want to kick-up your heels. It's a reminder of the rockabilly songs of the '60s and it's very much in line with McCoy's philosophy that music should be fun.

It is a terrific greatest hits package

and it's a guaranteed hit at any summer bash. I suggest you hurry to a record store while there are still some copies left.

Lee Ann Womack, *Lee Ann Womack*, (Decca)

Womack, the daughter of a country radio disc jockey from Jacksonville, Tex., was exposed to country music at a very tender age. She dreamed of becoming a country singer and joining Patsy Cline, Brenda Lee and Loretta Lynn on the roster at Decca Records.

Her dreams have come true. Womack signed with Decca and released her self-titled debut album. She remains true to the sound of the '50s and '60s which got her noticed in the first place.

The whole collection shows how Womack has been influenced by the grand ladies of country music. Her vocals are a lot like Dolly Parton's, but on the other hand she's got the sassiness of a Loretta Lynn, the grace of a Tammy Wynette and the contemporary appeal of Reba McEntire.

Womack's musical style gently combines classic country with new and that puts her right there with today's strongest female vocalists.

Her first single "Never, Again, Again" is about heart-break that people from any generation can relate to since the stories often remain the same. There's

also "Make Memories With Me", a beautiful duet with Mark Chesnutt, that's reminiscent of a Loretta Lynn and Conway Twitty duet.

Womack gets into contemporary country music with "Buckaroo" and "The Fool". "Trouble's Here" is an up-tempo number while "Get Up in Jesus Name" would be great for an old-time gospel revival.

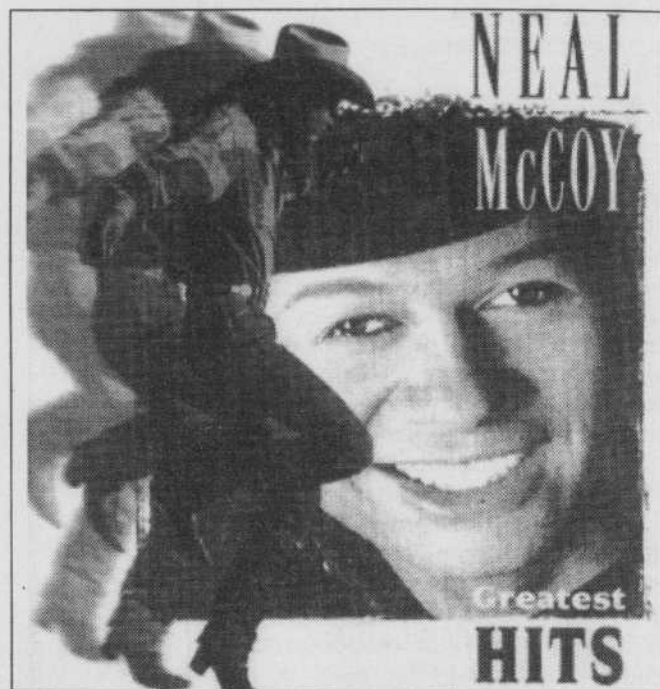
It's been a long time since the country scene has seen someone so young, who has been influenced so much by the past. Womack with her old-time influences just might have a very bright future.

**Various Artists, Traveller, (Asylum)**

Several country singers appear on the 18-song collection, which is the original soundtrack for Traveller, a film about a group of Irish grifters conning their way through the rural South.

The tunes are remakes of popular songs from the late '20s to early '70s, performed by contemporary country artists as well as bluegrass, pop, soul and blues stars.

Bryan White and Kevin Sharp respectively lend their savvy to '50s hits "Rockin' Robin" and "Young Love". Randy Travis takes Roger Miller's legendary "King of the Road," while Jimmie Dale Gilmore offers up two excellent covers of Lefty Frizzell's music



- "If You've Got The Money, I've Got The Time," and "I Love You a Thousand Ways."

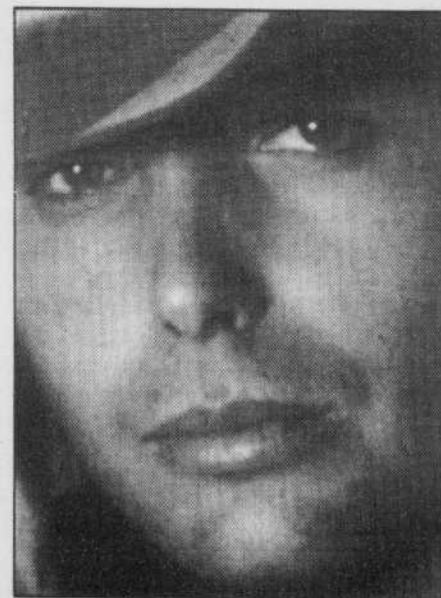

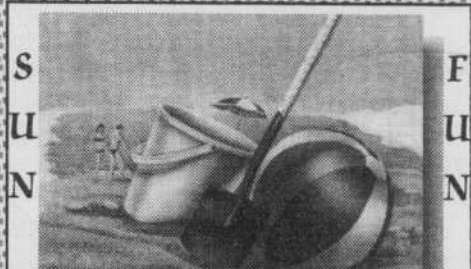
