

# STREET KEY

## DIVISION OF THE CITY WARDS

Champlain Ward.—From Sous-le-Fort to Champlain toll gate.

Jacques-Cartier Ward.—From St. Roch to St. Ours, and from the south side of St. Joseph to the Cape.

Montcalm Ward.—From the Glacis to the St. Foye and St. Louis toll gates, divided by the south side of St. John.

Palace Ward.—From Mountain hill steps to St. John gate, divided by the north side of St. John, Fabrique and Buade.

St. John Ward.—From the Glacis to St. Foye toll gate, divided by the north side of St. John.

St. Louis Ward.—From Mountain hill steps to St. John gate, divided by the south side of St. John, Fabrique and Buade.

St. Peter Ward.—From Sous-le-Fort to St. Roch, and from the river to the Cape.

St. Roch Ward.—From St. Roch to St. Ours, and from the north side of St. Joseph to the river St. Charles.

When no NUMBERS appear with the NAMES, such NAMES are understood to occupy the first number preceding them.

The STREET KEY is presented in its most simple form, it being considered only as a reference to addresses. For fuller information the ALPHABETICAL DIRECTORY must be consulted. A certain number of names are unavoidably left out from the Street Key—owing to the tardiness of persons in giving us the required information—which however appear in the Alphabetical list.

In the Street Key, numbers followed by a— are houses *not rented* at the time of publication.

Names of residents in houses of ill-fame are *not inscribed* in the Street Key, and as a consequence will not be found in the Alphabetical Directory.

At the time of putting the Street Key to press, 15th of April, there were still 775 lodgings and offices *not rented*

The letter *p* after name means *residing proprietor*.
