Ideas wrapped in beauty

*Horace show a
feast for eyes, mind*

Sometimes you don't have to travel very far to take a significant journey.

Proof of this axiom is available at Sherbrooke's venerable Galerie Horace, which has been transformed by its current two-woman exhibition into an airport of sorts. Viewers simply arrive with their own experiential baggage and let the art inspire them to new flights of intellectual association.

As Sherbrooke artist Brigitte Roy puts it, "what makes a work interesting is that it makes you think of other things, it inspires other thoughts."

What philosopher Immanuel Kant called 'free play' between the imagination and the understanding is evidenced in Roy's exhibition, *Sheltering Bodies*.

If any animal's body is a housing or shelter for its most vital possessions, then humans have added an extra layer, says Roy, with the protection of clothing.

Last year Roy was toying with this notion while collecting used clothing such as slips and gloves, unsure what to do with them. Her conception was galvanized when she heard a report on the radio about Afghani refugees making tents out of clothing and branches.

What gradually emerged was "Scent of the nest," a cluster of semi-translucent, cocoon-like shapes hung at various heights from the ceiling. The cocoons are made of women's slips, chosen for their off-white translucency and natural-looking lace fringes.

Roy, who has treated sensorial memory as a theme in the past, dipped the bottom of each cocoon in beeswax to lend a suggestive odour. Further, the piece's overall configuration, although not strictly hexagonal, nonetheless manages to remind of a beehive.

INGREDIENTS: (FOR FOUR PEOPLE)

- 200 grams of goat cheese (one "log")
- 200 ml of extra-virgin olive oil
- 60 ml red wine vinegar
- 4 tbsp. honey
- 4 cups assorted leaves
- 1 baguette, preferably a day old

DIRECTIONS

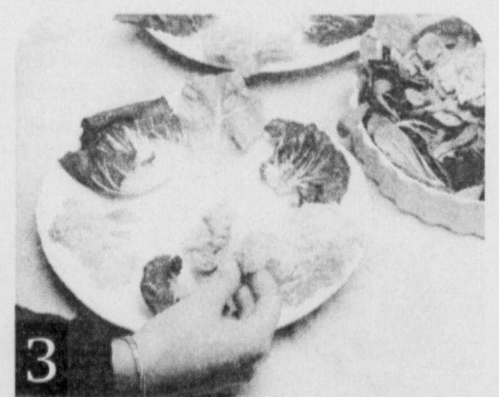
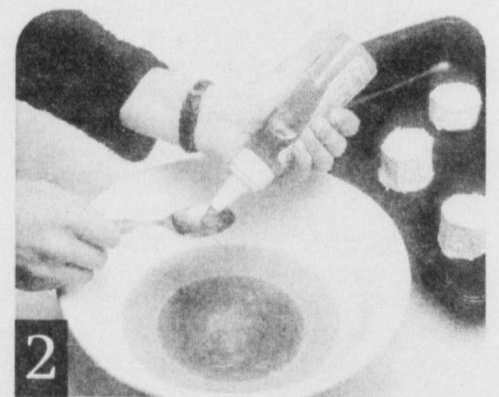
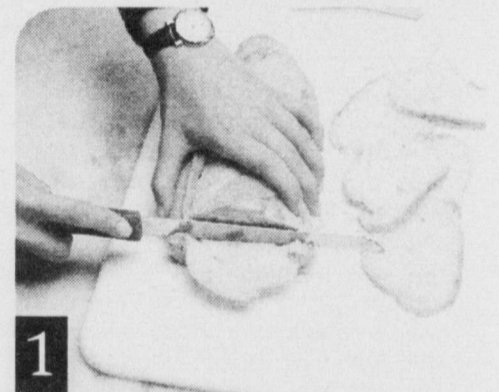
1. Pre-heat the oven to medium. Slice the baguette as thinly as possible (if it is a day old, it will be much easier). You will need eight slices. Spread the slices

on a baking sheet and toast them in the oven until golden.

2. Whisk in a bowl the honey, oil, vinegar and salt and pepper to taste until the mixture thickens. Cut the log into four pieces, and set them on a baking sheet. Wash the greens. I used young lettuce, mache and raddichio, but you can use whatever you like, as long as the leaves are young (which look better and are more tender).

3. Fan out the leaves on four plates as prettily as possible. When it is time to serve, warm the cheese in the oven for a couple of minutes — being very careful not to melt it. Pour some vinaigrette on the leaves. Set one piece of cheese on each plate, with a baguette crisp on either side.

Local folk artists shun the canvas for recycled materials

If you can find it, Francine Beliveau can teach you how to paint on it

What do you do with old items around the house that cannot be used anymore, but are still too sturdy to throw out.

"You paint them," says Francine Beliveau, a Melbourne artist who just wrapped up her sixth year teaching local residents the art of painting on everything but a canvas.

At an exhibition last weekend, 50 students showed off their works of art. The objects they painted on ranged from old school desks and hand saws to teapots and wooden shovels.

"These are objects that we can recycle. We can give a second life to by painting on them," says Beliveau. "You could say it's a type of folk art that my students can either sell or use to decorate their homes."

Beliveau started the art classes six years ago in her kitchen with a small group of budding painters. Now, she offers eight classes during the winter months on the second floor of the Melbourne Township town hall.

"We can do scenery painting, or folk

art themes or even use a naif, child-like style," she adds. "The challenge is to paint on objects rather than on a canvas. It's not so easy painting a scenery on a piece of slate or a fruit basket."

Beliveau said her private courses are attended by women from the Richmond and St. Francis valley area. Still, she has yet to see a male come to one of her courses.

"This type of work the men tend to leave to their wives to do," she admits. "The men tend to be the suppliers of the used objects, or go into their workshops and make the wooden bases or prepare other materials for their wives' works of art."

"Maybe, someday, I'll get one of them to attend a course."

Student Marilyn Thompson, who works mostly with slate, is grateful that Melbourne Township has allowed the classes to be held on the second floor of the town hall.

"The windows are large and numerous, so there is a lot of natural light coming in," she says. "It's the next best thing to having a skylight. The more light, the better for us to paint."

Museum exhibit to live on at home

The varied works at the Musée des beaux-arts de Sherbrooke will now live on, in splendid colour, with a new catalogue to complement the recently unveiled *Manières et matières* (Manners and matters) exhibit.

Lise Boyer, director of communications at the museum, said the exhibit and ensuing catalogue (in French) was the result of a grant from the Minister of Culture and Communications. The funds helped the museum to renew its existing permanent collection and produce the 152-page catalogue to accompany the exhibit.

The new display showcases works from the permanent collection — approximately 4,000 pieces by more than 1,000 artists from the 19th, 20th and 21st centuries.

"The exhibition presents 56 works which are spread out over the three periods covered by the collection: Pre-1880s art, modern art (1880-1945) and contemporary and present art, since 1945," noted the Musée's curator Suzanne Pressé.

"It's coverage is thus a voyage through

times, but a retrospective one, which starts with a sculpture, *Mind Mines* by the very contemporary artist Michel Goulet."

Pressé said while the collection focuses on local artists, it also includes a fair share of works by international artists who were inspired by the region.

For example, on exhibit is a notable reproduction of a William Henry Bartlett painting. It is the oldest representation of an Eastern Townships scene, dated between 1838 and 1842. The famed artist provides a view of Copp's Ferry near Georgeville, and the work is titled thus.

"The exhibition's title, *Manières et matières*, reveals the complexity, represented by the works shown: Subjects, materials, styles, ambiguities, structural and psychological tensions, spatial distortions, doubts and certainties offer the visitors a life experience not without a certain admirative frisson," said Pressé.

Tour seeking young artists for local circuit

Painters, poets, sculptors, musicians, dancers, comedians, singers and alouette — all of these artists and more between the ages of 15 to 25 are invited to apply for a spot on the fourth annual Sherbrooke Art-Circuit, to be held in September.

The initiative by the Regroupement des Artistes des Cantons de l'Est is sponsored by the City of Sherbrooke in partnership with the Quebec Ministry of Culture and Communications.

Those interested in participating can fill out an application form and send it to Summum Communications, accompanied by a demo tape, manuscript, or photos that show their work. The forms are available at the Éva-Sénécal Municipal Library, select local schools, as well as at the offices of Summum (86 rue Wellington N, Room 2).

The deadline to apply is May 16. A jury comprised of professional artists will disclose the names of selected candidates before the end of June 2003.

"It's not a contest," says Dominic Chamberland of Summum. "Last year we received 70 applications, and 30 were chosen. It's an opportunity for young people — 'the artistic relief' — to perform in pub-

lic, receive guidance from established artists, and taste an experience."

Chamberland notes this year's tour will be held in four venues: Galerie Horace, for the visual arts, Théâtre Granada, Théâtre Léonard St-Laurent, and the Petit Théâtre de Sherbrooke for the performing arts.

For the performing arts section of the tour, selected participants will offer the public a show 15 to 20 minutes in length, solo or in a group. Poetry, humour, theatre, song, dance and music are some of the disciplines that will be presented.

For the visual arts, participants will expose some of their work, or even create work directly in the presence of visitors. The types of artwork include painting, sculpture, photography, installations, illustration, or art video.

Chamberland encourages young artists to seriously consider the Art-Circuit as a unique event to showcase their work.

"What's interesting about this is that in previous years, young artists have been noticed," he says. "This has brought them further opportunities, as well as the opportunity to exchange with other artists. They meet together, start new projects... it's a great opportunity for young people."

Five questions with Dean Mullavey

Q & A

Dean Mullavey, a longtime North Hatley resident, began his journey in the art of pottery while finishing his undergraduate degree in New York. It was there that he received his Master of Fine Arts with a specialty in ceramics.

Since coming to Canada, Mullavey has been giving workshops and exhibiting his work. *The Record* recently caught up with Mullavey to get a better insight into his views on the world of ceramics:

QUESTION: What is the difference between pottery and ceramics?

ANSWER: Pottery is a specialized term for making containers from various forms of clay, which are then exposed to extremely high temperatures. This process is called firing. For that glob of clay to have any real existence, it must be fired.

Ceramics are used around us everywhere today. It is in our false teeth, in the fibres of our carpet, in the glasses that we drink out of or the mugs for our coffee. Without the use of ceramics, there would not be a space program.

QUESTION: What do you think influenced your work the most?

ANSWER: Most of my ideas come from the original Oriental style of creating pottery, the more traditional ways. Un-

fortunately, in many places, potters are not considered artists, but rather artisans which doesn't really make sense when you realize that to be a good craftsman, you must first be a good artist.

QUESTION: Do you see any differences between the way ceramics has evolved in Canada compared to the United States?

ANSWER: I think that the United States began experimenting in the development of ceramics much sooner than Canada. You see a lean more toward sculptures and industrializing. Pottery is still pottery — as long as it can be made out of clay — why not!

QUESTION: Could you tell us a little about the process of making pottery?

ANSWER: The potter's wheel can be very challenging. Its circular motion places limits on the art medium. There are three different kinds of clay which provide three very different results. Clay for earthenware is simple clay like what we find everywhere used to make plain pots. Clay that stoneware is made of has less iron in it and can be 'fired' at a considerably higher temperature. Porcelain is the purest form of clay.

QUESTION: What do you prefer — teaching or creating new works of art?

ANSWER: I will always be a teacher at heart, but you know you can't really be a good teacher unless you are really passionate about what you are trying to teach

Chefs to teach how to cook lamb like a pro

Lambs are known for the wool in our clothes, the meat we eat and the comic effect of their sheer presence. But for Martine and Patrick Satre, they are also the subject of gastronomy, the art of good eating.

The couple, who own and run the gourmet restaurant Temps des Cerises are offering weekend cooking courses on how to prepare lamb like a pro.

The courses not only show people how to properly prepare lamb, but also provide a tour of a local lamb farm, as well as four meals and an overnight stay at the Satre's renovated Victorian inn L'Auberge Jeffrey.

The weekend package is an attempt to promote tourism in the Danville area, given that the Satre's restaurant is known as far away as Montreal and was

twice the winner of Le Grand Prix du Tourisme des Cantons de L'Est in 1992 and 2001.

The package also helps promote local agriculture by letting people visit the 800-acre Manasan farm, which is owned by Bob and Lois Laberge. The Laberges have been raising hormone and antibiotic-free Hampshire sheep and Angus beef cattle since 1954.

This is the second year the Satres have offered cooking courses in Danville, which teach cooking basics, preparation of wild game and fish and tips on how to prepare a gourmet meal.

The courses are being offered on the weekends of May 17, 24, 31 and June 7. Cost is \$330 for one person, \$580 for two people.

The courses are taught in French by chefs Martine Satre and Vincent Montcalm. For more information, call 819-839-2818.

AIR & BARICCO**City Reading: Tre Storie Western**

City Reading: Tre Storie Western is ambient music at its best. It stems from a real life situation whereby the French duo Air provide the musical backdrop for the readings of noted Italian writer Alessandro Baricco last November in Rome. Tongues firmly in cheeks, they jest with the album release, and may take it to the next level with a video game release. Three Western stories are read in their original Italian. Excerpts from the texts in the booklet are translated into English by Ann Goldstein, the same woman who translated a short story of Baricco's for The New Yorker. It is a fascination with the American west that pervades: The music has a bare, acoustic feel with added instrumentation complementing and never detracting from the story itself. Even if Italian is not familiar to you, this European concept album provides a welcome break from the pop landscape.

Have you ever wondered about the state of the world? Why things have denigrated into the present state? The



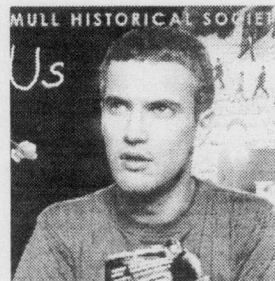
Delaware quintet otherwise known as Boysetsfire, does on their newest album, Tomorrow Come Today. Like their three previous albums, this is hardcore, punk and rock complete with melodic moments and metal leanings. Throttling the listener is intentional, though only four tracks of the dozen are truly noisy, while the rest border on hard rock with an attitude. The album's always

biting lyrics deal with issues like corrupt governments, democracy and domestic abuse, to name but a few. The group's progressive viewpoint aims at engineering listeners to think about the concept of patriotism — the necessary dialogue and dissent that follows to revitalize the system. Tomorrow Come Today is a testament to the notion that young people do think about, and impact, change upon society. A bonus DVD features a dozen songs with commentaries and a band interview.

Continuing in the same tradition as world music, The Rough Guide to Ska brings fine Jamaican Ska sounds from the 1960s to light. Even at that point there was no one sound to the movement. Names like the Maytals may ring a bell, or the legendary The Skatalites with 'Malcolm X', 'Ska-Racha' and 'Freedom Ska'. About 1,000 words guide you through this fine musical journey of the instrumental people in the dissemina-

tion of early Ska. Why the assorted pieces were chosen and further information about each track is also provided. Though caveat

emptor, the 20 tracks on this lovely retrospective look into a young genre runs at about 40 minutes. Ska has since mutated many times into a number of different forms over the years, including several waves, so this is a grand way to know ska's roots in one handy album with some near impossible to find, rare pieces.

She made a name for herself with a guest spot on Angie Martinez's hit single 'If I Could Go'. But you may also already have Lil' Mo's debut album, and are just adding to the collection with her sophomore release, Meet The Girl Next Door. At just under an hour including introduction and interludes, Lil' Mo brings some smooth pop hop, R&B-laced vibes to groove your way from spring into the hot summer sun. 'Brand Nu' is a perfect example of a new trend in hip hop: Combining elements of a song from days of yore with new lyrics and a more contemporary layered music for good measure. There is no one averse track on Meet The Girl Next Door, as artists like Lil' Kim and Fabolous join Lil' Mo. A majority of songs are written and produced by the woman herself.

Take the old, take the new. Have the funk sounds of the 1970s finally met with the waves of the 1980s? Think of Daft Punk, moments of the Cinematic Orchestra and a whole host of other European outfits making electronic music and you have a small indication of what this recording

is all about. From 'Vinylstyloz' to the album's end, you will groove, tap your toes and move to the syncopated beats. If electronically-generated sounds are not your cup of tea, then leave this aside. Otherwise, party the night away with fun dance numbers like 'Da Symphony', revel in instrumental pieces with the addition of male vocals on 'Soulfly' or the guest words of Shock-G and Humpty Hump on 'Way Of Life'. But by far the catchiest tune goes to 'Bizarre Mind'.

Think along the lines of Disturbed, add in some Chevelle, a sprinkle of attitude and a whole heap of homogeneity with the sort of dark, meaningful lyrics from these four creative fellows. They came together in the exact right mix that would see this major label debut percolate to full bodied, fine brewed perfection, right ready for the hit single 'Nothing Sacred' to assault your ears. In all fairness and hyperbole aside, it is a decent album, with good lyrics and varying moments of intensity. 'Figure 8' concludes in a manner reflective of the infinite loop all things circle around in and the production offers a solid shell for the band to let criticism slide off of.

Eisenhower: A good man for President

Sometimes, a reader interested in a public figure may not buy their biography because it may be too long, and time is unfortunately lacking to plunge into an historical figure's life and achievements.

The American Presidents collection, edited by historian Arthur M. Schlesinger Jr. and published by Times Books, however offers a very good opportunity for those who are interested in knowing more about past United States presidents — all in abridge versions of course.

Recently, former New York Times journalist Tom Wicker wrote a compelling addition to this collection about Dwight D. Eisenhower, commander of D-Day operations and 34th U.S. President between 1952 and 1960. Of course, much has already been written about this famous military and political leader, but Wicker's book is still interesting because it permits the reader to discover Ike's life and career at a glimpse.

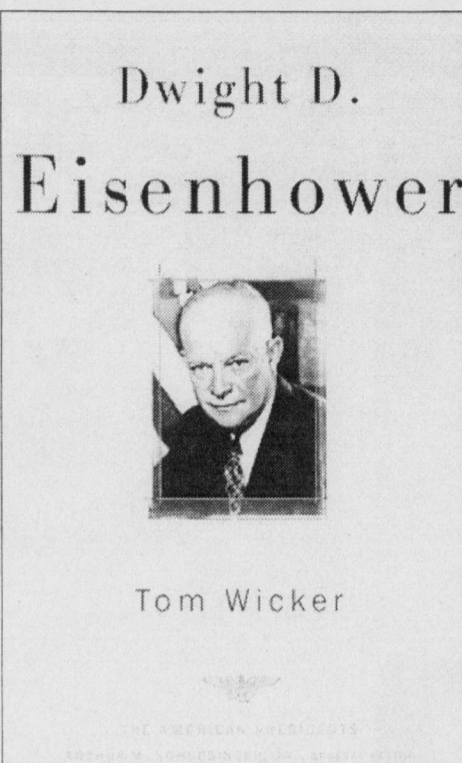
In the author's words, "Dwight D. Eisenhower was a great man — but not quite a great president. His opportunity — born of his presence, his experience, his competence, the trust placed in him, and the great world schism (between communism and the West) he inherited — was so immeasurable that perhaps no man, not even he, could have realized it."

Although Eisenhower made a number of efforts to bring peace to the world by preventing the hawks in his administration from carrying the day and bringing on direct confrontations in various locations in the world, Eisenhower was a big fan of covert operations. He directed his administration to carry out missions in Indochina, Iran, Guatemala and Cuba.

In Iran, Eisenhower brought down the regime of Prime Minister Mossadegh, and replaced him with the Shah. In Guatemala, Jacobo Arbenz Guzman was also replaced, following orders from Washington. As for Cuba, Eisenhower also had plans to replace Fidel Castro, but the task was left to his successor, John F. Kennedy.

Reading Wicker's book, we are also reminded that world affairs were Eisenhower's forte. In 1956, Eisenhower refused to support military intervention, led by France and Great Britain and involving Israel, to counter Nasser's nationalization of the Suez Canal. Eisenhower was kept out of the loop by his natural allies, who were to regret their move.

Two years later, Eisenhower approved a military intervention that brought U.S. Marines in Lebanon to protect the country against Syria. The American administration decided to intervene because it was asked to do so by the president of Lebanon.



On the other hand, in domestic policy matters, Wicker reminds the reader that "Eisenhower avoided direct personal involvement in the two great moral issues of 1950s America, school desegregation and McCarthyism." On the first matter, Ike was sympathetic to the Old South. On the second, he thought it was better to let Senator Joseph McCarthy — the communist hunter — destroy himself.

To those who are tempted to believe that Ike was not a real politician, Wicker notes an encounter the president had with a veteran journalist. This journalist, Merriman Smith, said he believed Eisenhower did not like the role of politician. "I have been in politics, the most active sort of politics, most of my adult life," replied Eisenhower, "There's no more active political organization in the world than the armed services of the U.S."

That said, it is worth noting that during Eisenhower's presidency, vice-president Richard Nixon was the good soldier who was left with the political chores. The president remained above the fray, which is one of the reasons why many historians still do not classify Ike as a politician.

He may have had a ferocious temper, and was prone to make ungenerous comments about his opponents, but Eisenhower was considered a father figure.

All in all, Ike's place in the former presidents' gallery may not be in the same league as Washington, Jefferson, Lincoln or Roosevelt, but he is a man worth understanding or simply discovering for a first reading encounter.

Reeves antes up for Matrix Reloaded *Movies*

Keanu Reeves may not be very media savvy, but he's more than willing to discuss at length the metaphysical underpinnings of the Matrix universe.

Keanu Reeves admits the stories are true. There were days when he was screaming with pain in preparing for *The Matrix Reloaded*.

But he'll insist that it was all in a good cause — that it was necessary to up the ante for new instalments of the genre-busting trilogy that began its historic journey four years ago with *The Matrix*. He'll tell you that he shared the determination of The Wachowski Brothers, the filmmaking visionaries who dreamed up the Matrix story, to deliver audiences fight scenes even more complex and demanding.

He was also conscious of the huge gamble that was being taken in making the final two movies together with an eye to releasing both in the same year — *The Matrix Reloaded* arrives May 15 and *The Matrix Revolutions* on Nov. 7 — so his adrenaline was already racing. But it was still tough — very tough.

"It was just basically practice and learning," Reeves explains. "Because of the experience of the first one, I had some body memory. I knew what I was going into, and my body knew. I could pick up the choreography quicker. And I knew where I was in the wire work."

But the Wachowskis and fight choreographer Yuen Wo Ping wanted Reeves and his costars to perform even more daunting feats — not only on the invisible wires, which were used with such revolutionary brilliance in the first film, but also on the

ground. Reeves became acutely conscious that he was pushing 40 during those days when he was asked to add something new. That's why the stretching exercises had him crying out.

"It's no joke. It's 20-pound sandbags on your legs. It's people pushing down on you. You do it if you want height in your kicks and clean lines and things like that," he says flatly.

Still, things got so bad that between scenes, he immersed himself in a tub of ice.

"You're basically tearing micromuscle tissue every day, so you get inflammation — and I'm not 22 any more!"

Reeves can discourse at length about the metaphysical underpinnings of the Matrix universe, about the comic and computer game influences, about the echoes of Alice In Wonderland, about the mixture of religion and mythology tossed into the brew. If you let him, he'll even discuss the importance of philosophers Schopenhauer and Hume in the Matrix mix.

Yet he remains an enigmatic figure. True, he does talk to the media, which is more than can be said for Andy and Larry Wachowski, the reclusive brothers who made the movie. But the barriers go up if he finds a question too personal.

But against that, there was the commitment he felt to the film and to the role of Neo, the computer hacker who discovers his destiny and about *The Matrix*. Above all there was his loyalty to the brothers.

"What Larry and Andrew are trying to achieve in their storytelling, the physical action they present, the elements of new cinema and technology they have invented to create images, is unparalleled."

Moreover, he believes the film raises profound moral issues in depicting the battle between the humans and the 250,000 Sentinels in the Machine Army who are programmed to destroy them. He talks about "that whole aspect of free will and choice the whole nurture-nature aspect" and suggests the trilogy raises some

pointed questions. "What is fate? What are you compelled to do? What is free will?"

He's proud of the showcase action scenes — perhaps most spectacularly a confrontation with Neo's old nemesis, the relentless Agent Smith (Hugo Weaving) — a confrontation that becomes a nightmare when Smith is joined in battle by 99 lethal facsimiles of himself, all equally determined to extinguish Neo.

The action shifts between extreme slow-motion and supersonic speed; during the extended shooting of the scene, nine stuntmen also portraying Agent Smith were brought in, and they in turn were multiplied tenfold by computer technology.

There are even moments of a computer-generated Neo. Reeves jokes that the digital Keanu in the movie is "fantastic" but says he doesn't worry about actors in Hollywood being replaced by computer images.

"If they do digitally alter my performance, what I want is performance approval," he grins."

Not merely intellectual, though, the interest of "Nest" also comes from the visual harmony of the whole, true for another of her intriguing works, a wall-mounted structure entitled "Innumerable wing beats." The image of a mother hen huddling her chicks under her wing for protection is given a twist when we realize the oversize wing's feathers are women's white elbow-length gloves, which stave off the cold (and the lower classes, it might be added).

Moving to the other side of the gallery, Francine Prévost presents "Entropy: The tides of time," a sculptural installation piece.

Small internally illuminated ceramic structures dot the floor of the darkened room, volcanic islands in a sea of white wires and obscurity. The sight is visually striking and also full of possible meanings.

Volcanoes are like beings, which can start as islands before aggregating into archipelagoes, connecting to each other as people do during maturation. With a liter-

al fire in their belly reminiscent of a soul, they make a good symbol for people, says Prévost.

Although no man is an island, Prévost

says, "we're each in our own space and also interrelated, but not as much as we think."

What she means is hinted at in her title. In communications, entropy refers to the measure of the unpredictability, or unexpectedness, in a message source in a signal system. What is unexpected here, suggests Prévost, is that despite the impression that we are in touch with each other now more than ever, the opposite is true.

"We are really connected now and so used to communications, but at the same time I laugh about it a bit because people have never really been as

distanced from each other," she says.

"The systems are getting better, so people don't see each other as much. I see young people follow this pretext of communicating, but really they're each alone in front of a screen."

Many more white wires than are necessary to light up the volcanic islands in the chain serve as symbolic reminders that many of the tenuous technological connections we currently put so much stock in lead to emotional dead ends.

It doesn't take long to see that connections abound between Roy's "Scent of the nest" and Prévost's installation. Roy's mo-

tive of clothing cocoons sheltering a life inside is echoed in Prévost's piece, where the glowing spirit of each volcano is protected and separated from others by its craggy igneous exterior. And both works to group units together, the pattern of the whole overriding the individual in visual impact.

There are also several connections between the artists themselves. Prévost is a technician at UQAM's sculpture and ceramic studio, where she enjoys a fruitful exchange of ideas with the students. She finds the studio a playful place to get back to basics for a generation of students who have spent too much of their time plugged in and, she contends, tuned out from reality.

When Roy, who holds a Master's in Visual arts from UQAM, isn't busy refinishing furniture, she teaches art units at elementary and secondary schools in Sherbrooke. She began exhibiting in 1988, and has 17 solo and 18 group shows in the past 15 years.

The parallels and meanings seem limitless at this exhibition, and viewers can freely play with them at tonight's vernissage (7 p.m.), or Wednesday to Friday, noon to 5 p.m.; Saturday to Sunday, 1 to 5 p.m. at Galerie Horace, 74 rue Albert until June 15.

Lonestar, Mark Wills headline WOKO Bash

The first event of this summer's lineup of festivals, fairs and special country happenings is coming soon.

Lonestar, meanwhile does not need any introduction. From their debut album to the more recent I'm Already There, the band hasn't stopped charting hits.

Their single 'Amazed' had a huge impact that no one could have predicted. It

garnered two Grammy nominations, two CMA nominations and two ACM awards for Song of the Year and Single of the Year.

The group first came together in 1992 in Nashville. All four members—frontman Richie McDonald, keyboarder Dean Sams, guitarist Michael Britt and drummer Keech Rainwater—are from Texas, and started touring in 1993 in a Jeep Cherokee, performing more than 500 shows.

They soon made a name for themselves with their distinctive tight harmonies, creative instrumentation and ability to push the boundaries.
