

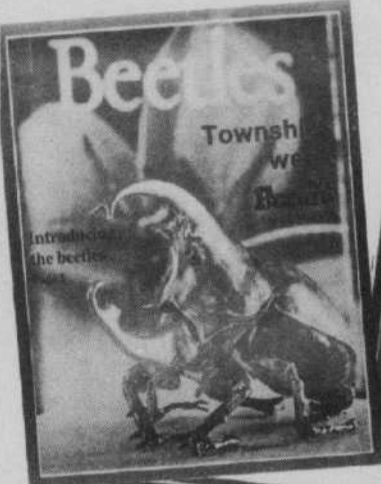

# A look back at what happened on the Townships scene

**SHERBROOKE** — Just when most of us are having the busiest time of our lives — between Christmas and New Year's Day celebrations — the Townships arts world seems to be taking a rest, gearing up for the year ahead.

Given this rare situation, a review of 1985 in the Townships arts scene seems in order — or at least the arts scene as reflected in *Record* coverage.

This will be haphazard at best, but it should give an idea of the rich

diversity of cultural history as a single year of it unfolds for us here in the E.T., as well as allowing us to relive some of the high points of the year.

First, the literary scene:

• early in the year, the Eastern Townships' literary magazine, *Matrix*, celebrated its 10th anniversary;

• **Jean-Benoit Nadeau, Sylvie Dolbec** and **Aline Godbout** won 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in the *Théâtre Entre Chien et Loup* 2nd annual drama writing contest in May;

• Drummondville author **Joyce Hibbert** published *Fragments of War*, a book of essays giving about 30 people's personal accounts of their experiences during World War II;

• Knowlton resident **G.A. (Hank) Rotherham** published *It's Really Quite Safe*, a book describing his career in the Royal Navy;

• a former *Record* columnist, **Gladys Taylor**, published her third novel, *Alone in the Australian Outback* — a true account of her trip around Australia alone at age 60;

• author and historian **Bernard Epps** published his fourth book, *More Tales of the Townships*, a collection of essays on events from local history.

And in the visual arts:

• **Satoshi Saito** and **Louise Doucet Saito**, ceramists from Way's Mills, opened an international symposium on ceramics held in Toronto in October;

• Bromptonville artist **Frédéric** was chosen to paint the inside of a shrine at Ste-Anne-de-Beaupré;

• Sherbrooke artist **Hélène Richard** celebrated 30 years of painting with a retrospective of her work at the Horace Gallery in November;

• Way's Mills sculptor **George Foster** took his collection of bronze sculptures of beetles to an Ottawa exhibition in October devoted entirely to insect sculpture;

• Tomophobia high-relief sculptor **Chick Schwartz** kept busy with shows in Montreal and Chicago (as well as lobbying against nuclear waste dumping in Northern Vermont);

• local artist **David Sorensen** took his show *The Corner Series* to Toronto's Bau-Xi gallery in March.

The musical world had its accomplishments too:

• local country and western singer **Debbie Drummond** recorded *Just Another Song on the Radio*, which

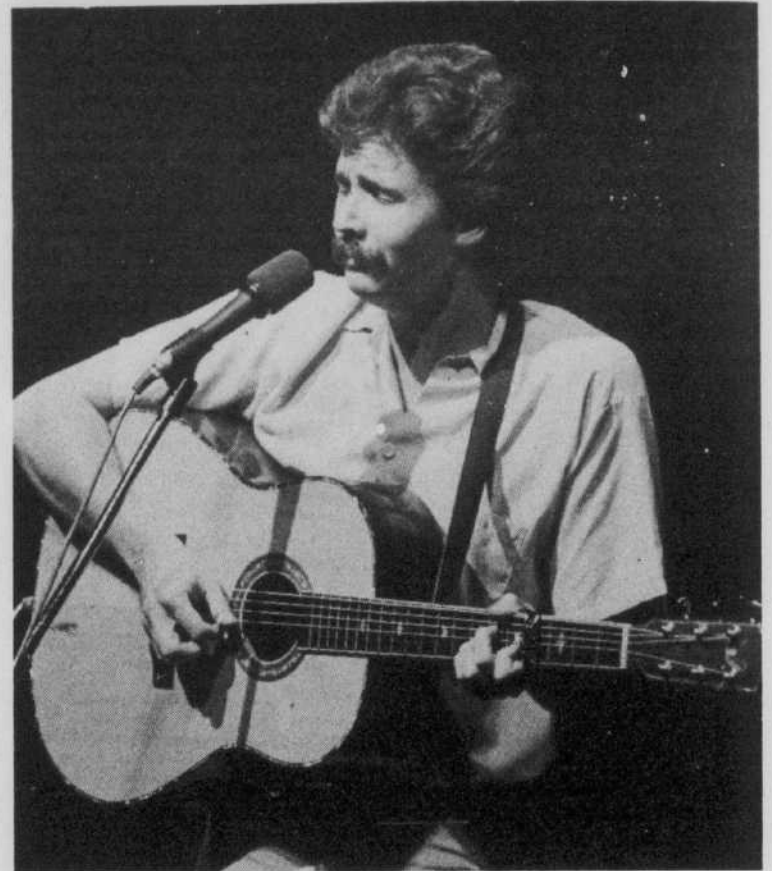

# Music played a big part in cultural advancements

got good air play on radio stations across the country;

- Lennoxville musician **Dave Lapp** recorded his first album, *Night Life*, and it was released in October;

- the Bishop's University music department acquired an exquisite hand-made harpsichord — a definite boon to the already expanding department;

- the Orford Art Centre in Cherry River received a \$349,214 grant which administrators believe will start the centre on its way to being a year-round cultural centre, by allowing them to winterize and expand the buildings;

- Stanstead musicians **Allyn Harris** and **Peter Mendieta** used their own recording studio to record *Cycles* — a taped collection of piano and guitar duets which includes classical favorites as well as several of their own compositions;

- *Les 4-Temps*, a Sherbrooke amateur musical group of 90 members, celebrated 10 years of existence with a fall show that was bigger and more colorful than ever

- CFIN Radio, Quebec's first all-country FM radio station, reported in the spring that its listening audience had doubled over the winter;

- Sherbrooke-born singer-songwriter **Micheline Goulet** recorded her own eight-song cassette.

Then there's radio and television:

- local broadcaster **Wally Trudeau** began an English-language radio program, *Townships Magazine*, on CFLX-FM (95.5) which broadcasts music of the 40s, 50s and 60s and often includes an interview segment with local personalities;

- in September, Radio-Quebec inaugurated a new TV show called *On n'a pas tout vu*, in which musician-turned-interviewer **Jacques Michel** searches out amazing people in the Townships and lets them tell their stories.

Things were happening in the area of heritage and culture as well:

- **Edmund Eberdt**, founder of the Heritage Sutton Museum, (formerly the museum of communications) was honored in August with an award from the National Parks Centennial Citizens' Committee for his "outstanding contribution to local heritage". (Meanwhile, on a gloomier note, government funding was cut back so much that the museum had to close for the winter, after being open year-round for three years.)

- the **Auberge Hatley** in North Hatley and **La Chapelle** in Lac Mégantic were named co-winners of the first *Mérite Annuel de la Fine Cuisine Estrienne* contest in November;

- the **Lennoxville-Ascot Historical Society** set out on a fund-raising campaign with a goal of \$150,000 to buy property for a museum and cultural centre in Lennoxville. A variety show, *Memories*, held in November, raised \$1661 for this goal.

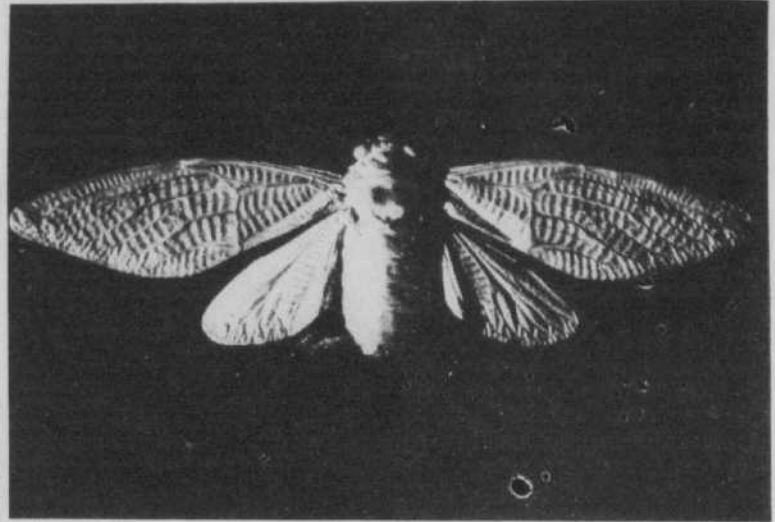
All in all, not a bad year, eh?

# Murder, mystery with cops, psychos in STUDIES and DEAD

A NEW NOVEL BY

## Night Studies



By the author of *The Book of Eve, A Population of One, and The Marriage Bed*

**Night Studies** by Constance Beresford-Howe (MACMILLAN): \$19.95, 230 pp.

Constance Beresford-Howe has chosen the institution at which she teaches to serve as the monolithic setting for her novel *Night Studies*. Ryerson Polytechnical Institute becomes transformed into Simcoe Community College in a book that takes an Arthur Hailey approach to its subject. The organizing principle that was used in books like *Hotel* or *Airport* is developed by Beresford-Howe in *Night Studies*. Although there are perhaps two or three central characters, whose lives are the focus here, the night program of Simcoe College and the clientele it attracts, serve as the bond to hold together a diverse panorama of characters.

There are students, such as Genevive Wu, a Hong Kong English as a Second Language student, illegally in Canada without a visa; Reg the security guard; Fred Makda, an Inuit who controls the parking lot; Mrs. Pentecost, a black washroom attendant who finds an abandoned newborn baby on her rounds; and a host of other bit players in this scenario that examines the conduct of a thriving metropolitan night school.

Two of the teachers, Imogen Hughes, and her colleague Tyler have more than their vocations in common. Hughes has lost her husband to the coming-out-of-the-closet movement of the seventies, while Tyler's wife, a manic-depressive, has been mistreating and even beating their child. Complicating these domestic and vocational trials for the two central characters are the strange manipulations of the hypocritical Director of Night Studies, Clifford Proctor. The book's climax occurs on a fateful evening when an angry storm raging outside the black, monolithic educational structure plunges the building into darkness, and Beresford-Howe whips her plot's characters into a corresponding emotional frenzy.

The quick cuts of the *Night Studies* plot are a bit disconcerting, when some last a mere paragraph in length, and the attempts at complicating several of the lives

with mildly kinky sexual deviances seem thrown in for a soap opera-ish titillation effect, rather than out of essential plotting and characterization motives. But *Night Studies*, despite its structural aggravations and sometimes one-dimensional stereotyping of characters, manages to make continuing education at a downtown Toronto college an interesting study for a contemporary novel.

**Only The Dead Know Brooklyn** by Thomas Boyle (STODDART-GENERAL): \$17.95, 282 pp.

The title is not true! After reading Thomas Boyle's cleverly plotted crime thriller the reader is far from dead, but he certainly feels as if he knows Brooklyn, so rich with da Brooklyn flavour is this book. Boyle's novel unfolds very slowly, seeming to be at first about the academic life at the Brooklyn Institute For Urban Studies, where one Fletcher Carruthers III receives a startling phone call. A female caller informs the pedantic Carruthers that she has unearthed an original holograph manuscript of Walt Whitman's *Leaves of Grass*. Carruthers sets out for a mysterious rendezvous with the secretive caller, riding the labyrinthine Brooklyn subway and train system only to meet a pair of nuns in full habit who lead him to a completely unsuspected captivity.

Boyle just as suddenly introduces the plot line that becomes the fascinating angle for this captivating thriller. It turns out that the arrogant Carruthers has run afoul of a militant sect of weirdos who wish to protest the gentrification of areas in Brooklyn, where various ethnic groups are being shoved out of their housing as whites move into black neighbourhoods upsetting the very strict racial boundaries of the old borough.

One of this weird assembly is Tyrone Ward, a child of an interracial affair (his mother claims to have been intimate with many of the black players with the old Brooklyn Dodgers baseball team), who

is a serial killer with a diabolically witty sense of humour. His gruesomely recounted crimes include oddly literary motifs, and the usual clues that are associated with the psychological belief that such criminals are beginning to be caught. Tyrone carries on a strange relationship on the telephone with a radio correspondent whose voice captivates him, and he feeds her clues about his series of murders. In one of these, the victim is found in a large, gaily wrapped Christmas package, and another is hoisted up onto a cemetery piece of statuary dedicated to a Brooklyn firefighter.

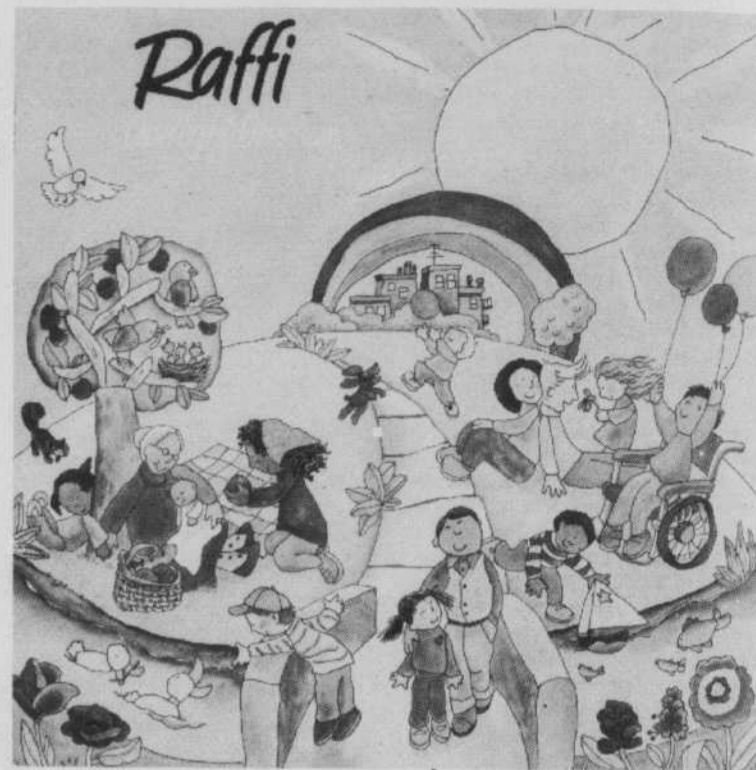
The cop who pulls the detail down on Boyle's ghastly procession of strange crimes is Lieutenant Francis DeSales, a New York Police Department investigator with a French Canadian father and an Italian-American mother. DeSales and his cohorts roam the streets of Brooklyn, from Flatbush Avenue down to Coney Island, and there are a few surprising incidents in this novel that are downright hilarious, in spite of the gory plot line that follows the crazed serial killer.

The literary angle to *Only The Dead Know Brooklyn*, the particularly deftly drawn cops and killers, and the atmosphere of the neighbourhoods of the Borough of Brooklyn, make this book a guaranteed exciting adventure in crime fiction. You can bet that most readers of Thomas Boyle's second novel will be on the lookout for his first venture into print, *The Cold Stove League*, based on the impressions left by this book.

### KIDS' RECORDS

Raffi ONE LIGHT, ONE SUN (TROUBADOUR-A&M)

If there may be said to be a superstar artist recording in the children's record category, then surely the 37-year-old troubadour known only as Raffi is one artist whose name alone lights up kids' eyes. With all but one of his previous six albums having sold platinum (past the 100,000 mark in sales, distinctions usually only conferred on Bryan Adams, Bruce Springsteen or the latest British heartthrobs like Wham!), Raffi's work can generally be heard on most pre-school or kindergarten class turntables when the activity switches into the musical mode. On *ONE LIGHT, ONE SUN*, which was recorded at Anne Murray and Gordon Lightfoot's favourite studio, Toronto's Eastern Sound, Raffi once again charms his way into kids' hearts with a wonderful selection of new and old tunes. The Beatles' classic "Octopus's Garden", plus old standbys such as "Take Me Out To The Ballgame", "Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star", are added to delightful wordplay songs such as "Apples and Bananas", or the calypso-styled track "Tinga-



layo". A song such as "Fais Do Do" lets the immersion kids try out their slick accents to the accompaniment of Raffi's guitar, and songs from other parts of the world lend an international flavour to this record — a Chinese instrumental piece and "Des Colores", a Mexican folk song.

For parents who shrink from the

idea of their 5- and 6-year-olds mouthing the latest Madonna sex-gloss hit parader, the songs of Raffi are so indelible that parents can be sure the house will be reverberating to "one, two, three strikes you're out" or successors to the famous "Baby Beluga" after only a couple of playings of *ONE LIGHT, ONE SUN*.

## Music

Things would be a lot duller in this column if it weren't for the New Year's Eve parties being planned almost anywhere that people gather. Take your pick and get out and celebrate!

**Country Rhythm** continues at the **Bretagne Bar Salon** this weekend, playing Friday and Saturday night starting at 9. Then, on Tuesday, starting at 10 they'll be celebrating New Year's Eve with a dance and buffet.

Coming up New Year's Eve as well at the **Richmond Community Centre** is a party with **Weekend Express**. This is sponsored by the Richmond Quebec Young Farmers and will include a buffet.

The **Burning Log Bistro** outside Mansonville, features **Kim Glover** this Saturday night. Glover plays guitar and sings in an easy-listening folk style. Then Sunday afternoon, the recently established tradition of a weekly jam session continues, and anyone who does anything musically (including listening, I presume) is invited to drop in and take part. There's live entertainment on New Year's Eve as well **George and Jacques**, a duo from Montreal that plays about 2000 different styles, according to club owner **Jim Lawrence**. These guys play Beatles stuff, some blues, jazz and folk rock. Tickets for the party are \$18 per person and that includes, besides the entertainment, two or three surprise events, a midnight buffet and half a bottle of champagne per person.

The **Waterloo Legion**, Branch #77, is having its annual New Year's Eve dinner and dance Dec. 31 from 9 until 1, with music provided by the **Bolton Brothers Band**. Everyone is welcome, and price is \$7.50 per person.

The **F.L. Hideaway** in Lennoxville has **Brian Monty** and the **Blues Band** tonight and tomorrow night, and then again New Year's Eve. Tickets for the New Year's Eve party are \$5, and you're advised to get them early.

**Sweet Sixteen** plays rock and roll at the **Del Monty** in Rock Island tonight and tomorrow night. There's a New Year's Eve party there as well.

The **Knowlton Pub** doesn't have a band, but there will be a D.J. there for their New Year's Eve party. Tickets for this event are \$5 and that includes munchies and champagne at midnight.

**Idle Hands** plays at **Jim's Place** in Burroughs Falls tonight and Saturday night as well as New Year's Eve when there will be a cold buffet and door prizes and other New Year's Eve type stuff.

**Whiteline** plays at the **Maples** in Stanstead this weekend and for their New Year's Eve party. They'll have door prizes, champagne and some drawings wherein you'll have the chance to win some free drinks.

The **Kon-cords** are at the **Shady Crest** this weekend, playing tonight and Saturday night, and Sunday starting at 3:30. The band will also provide the music for New Year's Eve.

Folk singer **Linda Morrison** performs at the **Auberge Glen Sutton** tonight and Saturday night, and then New Year's Eve it's the **Hall Brothers**. The party begins at about 10 p.m. and reservations are preferred, since most of the tickets are gone already. For \$10 you'll get a buffet meal and champagne at midnight.

Jan. 17 the **Musique Chez Nous** series continues at the **Centennial Theatre** with a concert by pianist **Art Rowe**, semi-finalist at the 1984 International Bach Competition in Toronto.

## Exhibitions/Events

The artists are all busy in their garrets, I guess, trying to produce something new to show in 1986 after the barrage of art shows throughout the fall. Here's all the information I have about coming shows to date:

The **Art Sutton** Christmas sale and craft show continues until Jan. 5 at the **Galerie Arts Sutton**, 8 Main St. in Sutton. This features lots of paintings, pottery, drawings, sculpture, photography and crafts and the gallery is open Thursdays through Sundays.

The gallery of the **Caisse Populaire de Sherbrooke-Est**, at the corner of King and Bowen in Sherbrooke, features work by Montreal painter **André Philibert** until Jan. 3 and this exhibition can be seen during banking hours.

The **Marsil Museum** in St. Lambert has an exhibition entitled **Silhouettes** on until March 2. This features some of the old costumes and textiles that are in the collection of the museum, particularly women's and men's clothes from 1860 to 1930. The major styles of the period, including the crinoline dresses, bustles worn in the lower back, the S shape of *la belle époque* (beginning of the 20th century), and the straight

and simple dresses of the 20s. Some men's fashions will be displayed, but naturally the emphasis will be on women's costumes, since they are more varied and extravagant. There will also be a conference on **The History of Costume** (in French) at 2 p.m., Jan. 9 led by Danièle Archambault. The museum is at 349 Riverside Drive in St. Lambert. The museum's hours are Tuesday to Friday 1-4 and Sunday from 2 to 5 p.m.

Starting Jan. 10 the **Horace Gallery** in Sherbrooke presents **Simply Savage**, an exhibition by **Jean Tourangeau**, a Montreal painter whose "neo-pop" art uses large canvasses, boxes and other objects to explore bi- and tri-dimensionality. As well as producing art, Tourangeau is an art historian, critic, and professor. He is presently preparing a travelling exhibition on Quebec art of the 1980s.

Also at the **Horace Gallery** is an exhibition of recent paintings and engravings by Sherbrooke artist **Yvan LaFontaine**. LaFontaine has shown his work across Canada, the United States, Switzerland, Brazil and Yugoslavia. These two shows continue until Jan. 31.

Taking over at this gallery Jan. 6 is an exhibition of paintings by **Gérald Tousignant**. Tousignant is a Danville native who worked as a commercial artist for six years, and now works for the *Commission Scolaire Régionale de l'Estrie*.

## Theatre

There's still not much in the way of theatre in the area, but things should be looking up soon.

In the meantime, there's still something for the kids, if you're willing to drive to Montreal for a night at the theatre. **Youtheatre** is presenting **Alice**, a play based, of course, on Lewis Carroll's classic tale of **Alice in Wonderland**, full of fantastic and grotesque characters such as the Mad Hatter, the White Rabbit, the Doormouse and the Queen of Hearts. This is on at 1 and 3:30 p.m. tomorrow and Sunday in the D.B. Clarke Theatre of Concordia University. Call (514) 848-4742 for reservations.

Perhaps this would be a good time to mention the **Théâtre Entre Chien et Loup**'s third drama-writing contest, in collaboration with CFLX-FM. This is open to anyone born or living in the Townships, and all pieces submitted must be original and unedited, deal with a contemporary theme and feature at least four characters. The first prize is \$300 and the winning play has a chance of being performed by the **Théâtre Entre Chien et Loup**. Second and third prizes are \$200 and \$100. The next theatrical event at the **Centennial Theatre** in Lennoxville is not until Jan. 20 when the musical revue **Ain't Misbehavin'** is presented. Based on the life of bluesman Thomas 'Fats' Waller, the play recreates the atmosphere of a delectably lowdown Harlem nightclub of the 1930s, where along with the title song, renditions of Waller classics like "Honeysuckle Rose" and "The Joint is Jumpin'" will be performed.

## Movies

'Tis the season to be spending money on movies and most theatres in the region have stocked up on the 'heavyweights', if you'll allow a loose usage of the term.

The Capitol in Sherbrooke has **White Nights** playing for the second straight week. **White Nights** stars **Gregory Hines** and **Mikhail Baryshnikov** and as one can imagine, it has a lot to do with dancing — both the tap and ballet varieties. It plays nightly at 7:30 but on Sundays and Tuesdays there's a 1:30 matinee.

The Cinemas Carrefour de l'Estrie has loaded up for the holidays sending **The Jewel of the Nile**, the sequel to the extremely popular **Romancing the Stone**, to the screen no less than six times a day. The same main cast that appeared in **Romancing** — **Michael Douglas**, **Kathleen Turner**

and **Danny DeVito** — is back in **Jewel** and it plays every day for the next two weeks or so at 12:30, 2:15, 4:00, 5:45, 7:30 and 9:15, all in the p.m. The movie has received lukewarm reviews in most of the large dailies and who are we to argue? But if it's as much fun as its forerunner, and the critics say it is, be sure it's worth the time.

Southeast of Lake Memphramagog at Newport's **Merrill Showplace** four movies are on. In Cinema 1 at 6:30 nightly is **One Magic Christmas** followed by **Young Sherlock Holmes** at 8:15. In Cinema 2 that wonderful athletic film **Rocky IV** plays at 7 and 9. Next door in Cinema 3 is the zany **Spies Like Us** starring **Dan Akroyd** and **Chevy Chase**. Starting times for that film are 6:45 and 9:10.

Cinema Princesse in Cowansville has good ol' **Rocky IV**, starring that champion of hollowheads, **Sylvester Stallone**, using his knuckles and substantially-sized cranium to turn those dirty red Soviets into black-and-blue Russians. This clinker goes on at 9:05. Mercifully, moviegoers are treated to something slightly more realistic in **Transylvania 6500** at 7:15.

## Television

Now you really don't want to spend your time watching TV this weekend, do you? I would advise against it. Sit around the fire, sip egg nog, visit with family and friends while you can.

But if you really want to know what the pick of the crop for TV viewing is for the next week, here are a couple of suggestions:

Saturday night on **Vermont ETV**, there are two movies featuring **Greta Garbo**. The first, **Anna Karenina** co-stars **Fredric March** in Tolstoy's story of an illicit romance in the imperial court of Russia. This begins at 9 p.m. The second Garbo movie at 10:30 p.m. is **Mata Hari** in which Garbo is an alluring spy during World War I who beguiles men into giving her information. **Lionel Barrymore** co-stars.

Sunday at 8 p.m. on **CBC Television**, the **Gilbert and Sullivan** hit of the Stratford Festival, **The Pirates of Penzance** is broadcast. As Gilbert and Sullivan's **Pinafore** made fun of the British nave and **Iolanthe** spoofed the House of Lords, **The Pirates of Penzance** pits British bobbies against unlikely pirates on the Cornish coast.

Jazz fans will love **Vermont ETV**'s offering for New Year's Eve. **New Year's Eve Jazz Celebration** starts at 11 p.m. and features such stars as **Joe Williams**, **Jerry Mulligan**, the **Ray Brown-Milt Jackson Quartet**, **Phil Woods**, **Ethel Ennis** and **Toots Thielemans**. Tunes include **Take the A-Train** and **Our Love is Here to Stay**.

**CBC Television**'s New Year's Eve celebration, **Masque '86**, begins at 11:30 p.m. This gala comedy variety show will be telecast live from Vancouver's Canada Place and **Michael J. Fox** and **Jackson Davis** co-host.

## Radio

For those who like to ponder the passage of time as the end of the year draws near, **CBC Radio** and **CBC Stereo** have plenty to offer. To begin with, on **CBC Stereo** Saturday night, **The Entertainers** presents a year-end comedy write-off, featuring some of the brightest radio comedy writers presenting sketches reminiscing on the year gone by.

At 9:05 New Year's Eve, the **Ideas** series on **CBC Radio** looks at the calendar and how three different cultures have found different solutions to the problem of measuring time accurately through natural phenomena. Following this, at 10:05 p.m., **CBC** broadcasts a three-hour **New Year's Eve Special** from Halifax, featuring rock and roll and historical tidbits from the 50s and 60s right through to 1985.

New Year's Day **Gail Hulnick** of **CBC Vancouver**'s morning show shares the latest on Expo 86 and Vancouver's centennial celebrations at 6:05 a.m. on **CBC Radio**. At 9:05 you can hear New Year's greetings from the governor-general and the prime minister.

# U.S. and U.K. TV trade: Quality programming for junk?

**NEW YORK (AP)** — Britain exports its literary classics to U.S. television, and America sends back its pop-culture hits, overloaded with sex and violence. The head of drama for the BBC considers it a fair exchange.

"There's clearly room for different dramas that aspire to different things," said **Jonathan Powell**. "What we find most satisfying are **Dallas**, **Miami Vice** and **Hill Street Blues**. I think **Miami Vice** is terrific. We just don't make cop shows like that in England."

The type of programming the

two nations import speaks volumes about their cultural notions of each other, the gaps in their programming mixes and their distinctly different TV heritages.

**Powell** said Britain has its own prime-time soap operas, but they tend to follow people in small communities and lack the larger-than-life qualities of **Dallas** and **Dynasty**.

Consequently, British audiences enjoy gawking at the resplendent excesses of the **Carringtons** and **Ewings**.

"Maybe we do want to watch things that conform with our preconceptions of each other's

cultures," said **Powell**. "We make **Upstairs, Downstairs**, you make **Dallas**, which is really a cultural fairy tale."

Both programs look at class distinctions, **Powell** noted, but the American series places its greatest emphasis on money.

### HAS A SHARE

Britain also has its share of cop-and-robber series — "our own **Kojaks**," **Powell** says — but they're not nearly as violent. "British TV is not as pacy as American TV."

For the most part, U.S. imports from Britain are costume dramas, historical pieces, mystery classics that generally wind up on

public television.

"In the States, you get a crazy, nostalgic view of England, but the TV product doesn't convey a picture of England as she really is," said **Powell**.

The differences in tastes and styles go beyond contemporary images; they go back to the drama traditions of the two countries.

British television has its roots in the theatre, while the direct descendant of American TV is the Hollywood movie studio.

"That difference in origin tells a great deal about our approach and yours to television dramatization," said **Powell**, who is responsible for 250 hours a year of drama programming for the BBC.

Two of those programs, for which **Powell** also was executive producer, had recent exposure in America.

**Bleak House**, the eight-hour series based on **Charles Dickens'** classic book, has its sixth installment Sunday night on PBS' **Masterpiece Theatre**.

Last fall, **Tender Is the Night**, a six-hour adaptation of **F. Scott Fitzgerald's** novel, was on pay-cable's **Showtime**, which also cofinanced the venture.

With production costs escalat-

ing, co-productions are becoming more the rule.

### KEEPS CONTROL

**Powell** said BBC's artistic control is retained by maintaining greater than a 50 per cent stake.

One longtime investor, **Mobil Corp.**, the underwriter for **Masterpiece Theatre** and **Mystery!** on PBS, "doesn't make us make concessions to the U.S. audiences, so we don't end up with something that lands in the middle of the Atlantic," **Powell** said.

When **ABC**, **CBS** and **NBC** do mini-series, they believe big names attract the largest audiences. Hence, **ABC's** North and South had cameos from **Elizabeth Taylor**, **Gene Kelly**, **Johnny Cash** and other celebrities.

"Star names come first in the States," said **Powell**. "We place greater emphasis on casting the right performers for the big mini-series, such as **Jewel in the Crown**. That includes even the small roles."

"We do not do marquee casting."

**Tender Is the Night** relied on well-known American actors, including **Peter Strauss**, **Mary Steenburgen** and **Edward Asner**. **Powell** said they were strong actors who were right for their roles.

# Wild Bill Cody still rides, but slowly

**EVANSVILLE, Ind. (AP)** — He was one of the rootinest, tootinest sons of a gun who ever rode the range.

But these days **Wild Bill Cody**, rodeo hero and star of more than 40 movie westerns, lives in a nursing home at the age of 72.

When visitors arrive to talk about his career, he is still the dandy. **Cody** dons his heavy leather boots, manoeuvres his thin arms into his handmade leather vest decorated with shells and metal studs, and adjusts the feathers and beads around his neck.

He twists several large silver and turquoise rings on his fingers, and then the tour de force — he points to one of the three cowboy hats on his dresser, has it handed to him and, with great pomp, plops it onto his head.

Fading, cracking scrapbooks are pulled from a nearby drawer, and **Cody** begins his story.

He was born **Frederick Garfield Penniman**, but changed his name to honor his favorite Old West character, **Buffalo Bill Cody**. He says he's three-quarters Indian, something he's immensely proud of now, although he quit school in up-

state **New York** after the fourth grade because classmates constantly teased him.

"I started out when I was 15 — I ran away from home," he says.

### HAUNTED BY RECORD

For many years, **Cody** was haunted by a police record from **New York City**, where he was caught with a gun he found behind a speakeasy.

"From then on, everytime I saw a cop, he'd spread me out," he says. "It got to be too much to take, so I got me a job" with the military.

Later, he joined a rodeo, and that's when the makings of a legend began.

"I held the championship in crack-whipping and sharpshooting," he says. "I'd put my wife on a spinning board and cover her with newspapers, then threw knives at her blindfolded. I knew what I was doing."

Walk-on parts in the movies led to bigger roles and finally stardom.

**Cody** stayed with **Columbia Pictures** until 1952 and made more than 40 westerns. He then set off on a worldwide tour with other western actors as part of the **All-American Wild West Rodeo**.

"We went to places like the **Philippine Islands**," he says. "I even met the king of **Siam**."

As recently as July, **Cody** made a cameo appearance in **The Alien Outlaw**, a **Triad Motion Pictures** production that has not been released yet.

His life has had its share of sad times. In 1956, **Cody** underwent surgery for cancer in his voice box. Doctors said he would never talk again, but he proved them wrong.

### WIFE WAS SHOT

**Cody's** third wife, **Alice Collins Penniman**, was accidentally shot with her own gun by a curious nine-year-old boy during a rodeo tour.

"I had three wives, but she was the only one I ever loved," he says. "After my wife got killed, I had to have someone to look after my seven-year-old daughter, so I married again. But after eight years of trying to look after that woman, I gave up and got a divorce."

**Cody's** daughter, **Mary Alice**, now lives in **Evansville** and visits her father daily.

**Cody** moved into the nursing home earlier this year after a mild stroke, but says he'd still rather be in his trailer home in **Owensboro, Ky.**
