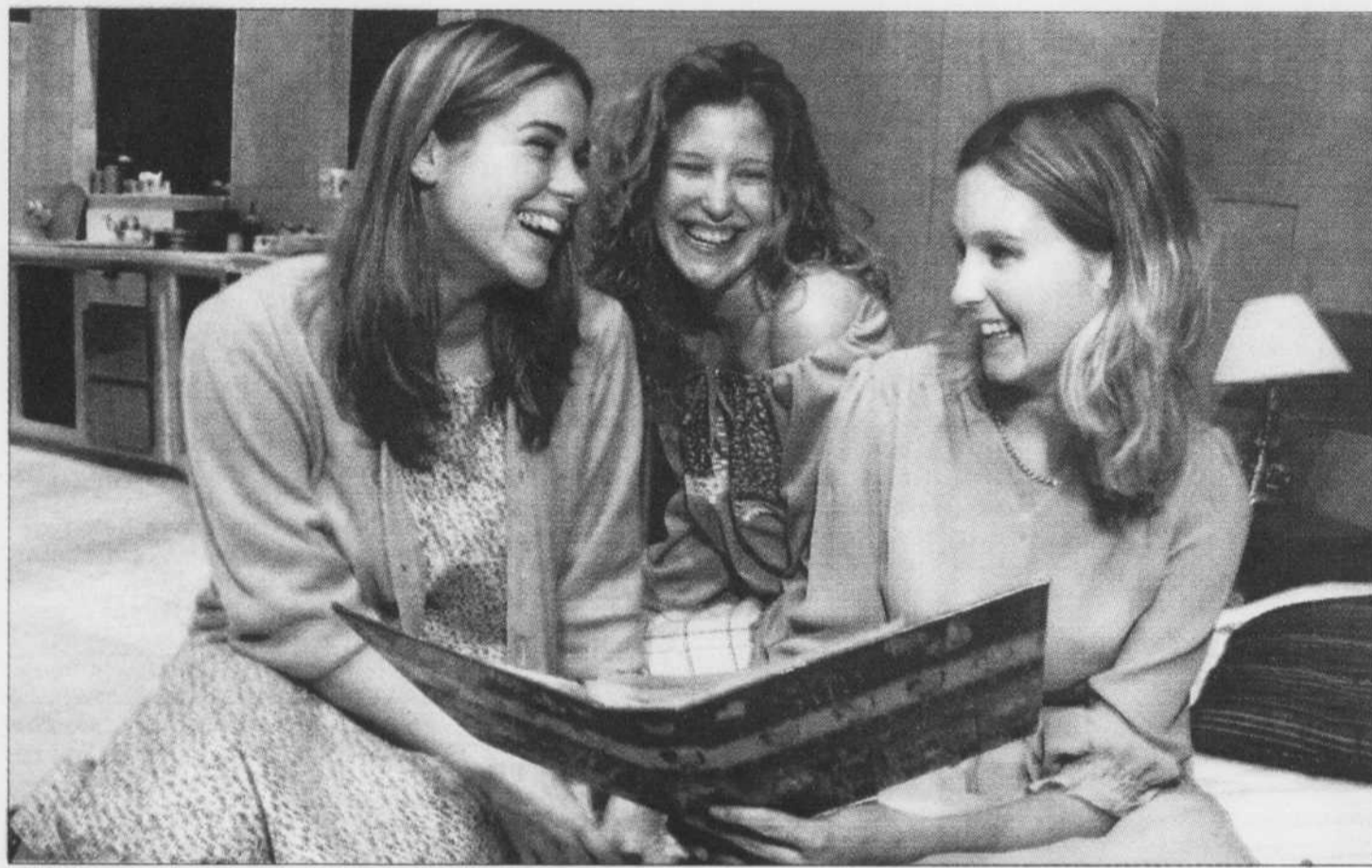

## Arresting entertainment in BU play

### Crimes of the Heart to open at Bishops

The Pulitzer Prize winning *Crimes of the Heart* written by Beth Henley, conjures up a range of emotions with its unique brand of dark, black humour. There are moments when something seems absurdly funny but one is not sure whether it would be appropriate to laugh out loud.

Don't hold back, advises actor Rebecca Yetman. "An honest response is necessary. If one wants to laugh or

cry, do, so long as it's respectful of other audience members."

The senior students of the Bishop's University Drama Department have been rehearsing for the production since the beginning of September under the direction of drama prof George Rideout. As opening night approaches, rehearsals have become more intensive, lasting at least three to four hours a night, every night of the week.

The play, written in the 1970s and a landmark for women in American Theatre, revolves around the tumultuous lives of the McGrath sisters. Rebecca Yetman plays Lenny McGrath, Hollie Duvall is Meg McGrath and Jennifer Wende is Babe McGrath. Doc is

played by Jesse MacLean, Paul Kingston is Barnett Lloyd and Amanda McCoy plays Chick, a cousin of the McGrath sisters.

Sibling rivalry is often the focus as the sisters laugh, fight and reminisce over an old photo album.

Director Rideout outlines the plot. "Babe shot her husband prior to the play. This comes after an affair with a young black man," explained Rideout. "The play, set in Mississippi, deals with spousal abuse and the interracial relationship question."

To master the southern dialect required for their parts, actors listened for hours to tapes to perfect their accents and practised their southern drawl with a dialect coach.

## Local restaurant takes on Italian chef for the week

### Danville restaurant Le Temps des Cerises welcomes Raffaele Aiello

**T**he award-winning Danville restaurant Le Temps des Cerises has decided to go Italian for the week.

Yes, the Belgian gourmet restaurant run by Martine and Patrick Satre are hosting Italian chef Raffaele Aiello until Saturday, Oct. 20.

Their aim, apart from promoting their own restaurant, is to welcome more European cooking to the Eastern Townships.

"Raffaele comes from the Miravidi Hotel in the D'Aoste valley of Northern Italy, which has a special type of Italian cuisine," said Martine Satre.

"It's mountainous region near bordering France and Switzerland, and the food products there, such as the cheese and the deer meat, have a quality that you can't find in North America.

"The cow's milk has a richer flavour, so their cheese is different. The deer there are not the same as they are here, so the meat also has a special taste to it."

The Satres discovered chef Aiello by chance. A sister of Martine was traveling in northern Italy this past spring when she decided to try the Miravidi hotel. After sampling his cooking, she phoned her sister right away.

"She said you have invite him to your restaurant, he's that good," said Satre. "I realized he would be taking his holidays in the fall, so I offered him a chance to visit Canada. He accepted."

The Satres agreed to pay for all of Aiello's travel expenses and salary in exchange for his culinary skills at their restaurant. It was also an opportunity for their local chefs to learn more European techniques.

"I want to learn recipes that are authentic," said Temps des Cerises chef Vincent Montcalm, who lives in nearby Victoriaville.

"It is not the complexity of the recipe that is important, it's the freshness and the originality of the products that are called for that make the difference."

Montcalm welcomes the opportunity to learn from European chefs who have more formal training than their North American counterparts.

Aiello learned his trade after three

years training at the Istituto Professionale Alberghiero Soverato cooking school in Italy. Montcalm said his training consisted of several months of chef school, and a lot of on-the-job experience.

A chef at Le Temps des Cerises for more than three years, Montcalm has not had the opportunity to travel to improve his trade.

"It may be expensive to have Raffaele come here, but it will help me with my skills and produce higher quality cuisine here," he said. "If I am ever given the opportunity to travel as a chef, I'll take it."

But Aiello's visit has not been without a glitch or two. Martine Satre understood that most northern Italians speak French, so she assumed she would be able to converse easily with Aiello during his stay.

"When he arrived, we learned he was originally from the South of Italy, and he knew very little French," she said. "I am from Europe, but I don't know any Italian. But when we both know cooking, the language barrier becomes less difficult."

With some translating help from Satre and Montcalm, Aiello said he needs to travel to pick up foreign culinary skills that will add to his reputation back in Italy.

He adds the trip can also promote travel by Canadians to Northern Italy.

"I am a sort of promoter for the hotel and an ambassador for my region," said the 30 year-old Aiello.

"If I can get to travel to other parts of Canada and the United States, I will learn more and be a better chef."

This is not the first time the Satres have had European chefs at their restaurant. Three years ago, they had a chef from Switzerland, and last year, one from Brittany, an area in the north of France.

"Next year, because it will be our 15th year in business, I intend to have chef from Scotland," said Martine.

"I think this is appropriate given that the restaurant here used to be a Presbyterian Church, which originated in Scotland."

Taking advantage of Aiello's presence this week, the restaurant is offering a four-course northern Italian meal, with at least three choices per course.

On Friday, Oct. 19, the restaurant has invited tenor Perry Canestrari to sing Italian Opera.

On Saturday, the theme will be Venison, using local deer meat, but served up the northern Italian way.

### Group to bring sweet sounds back to the region it came from

Blue grass fans be warned, Rectory Hill is the place to be this Saturday night.

That's when the well-known band Folk Grass will be playing at the former St. Stephen's Church, 850 Range 11 Rd.

This will be the third cultural event this year for the church, which was bought by Marie-Eve Adam, an organizer of historic events for the local Celtic Way office.

Folk Grass is made up of Roland Berard on guitar, Sabine Bittner-Maher on mandolin and fiddle, Raymond St.

Laurent on fiddle and Perry Beaton on upright base.

Though based in Montreal's South Shore, the group has been active in the Blue Grass Old-Tyme music club in Waterloo since its start 10 years ago.

Beaton, an avid base player and photographer for The Record, joined the group last winter.

"A lot of our music is original material," he said. "It is based on the blue grass that was first played in the Appalachian mountains long ago.

And Inverness sits right at the northern tip of those Appalachian mountains."

Beaton added the first blue-grass was based on Celtic music

brought over by the Scotch-Irish who settled in the Southern Appalachian mountains in the United States close to two centuries ago.

"That music has been heard by generations of Inverness people over the years, so we want to bring it back to them now," he said.

Adam hopes that this event and others planned for the rest of the fall will bring back an interest in local cultural events in the Inverness, Kinnear's Mills and Thetford Mines area.

"It's only a little church building, with 80 seats, but I would like to use it as a cultural centre for local people," she said. "We could have more concerts, show some films, maybe even stage a play. The key thing is to have a place where the community can come together and be entertained."

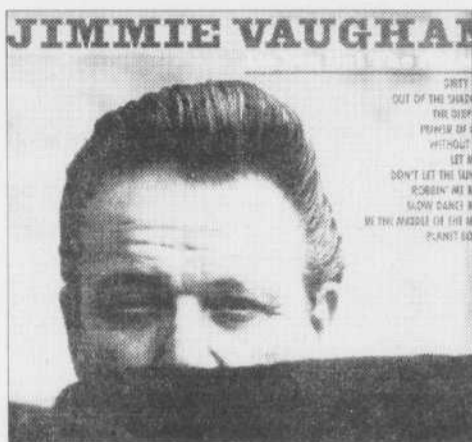

# Heavy blues sounds highlight Vaughan's latest

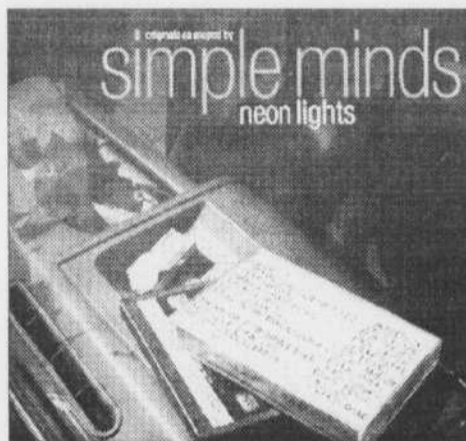

(BMI)

Jimmie Vaughan's latest release is a strong album featuring six original tracks and five covers. Bill Willis highlights Vaughan's guitar playing on the Hammond B-3 organ, as these two carry a heavy blues sound consistently throughout the album. Needless to say, Vaughan has a very

strong blues voice, but he doesn't rely only on that. Several tracks, including 'Dirty Girl' are instrumental. Other songs, like 'Out of the Shadows' featuring Lou Ann Barton on lead vocals, play off the tracks with lyrics. The album's inconsistency, however, is its one downside. As the title suggests, if you do not like the blues, do not buy this album.

**SIMPLE MINDS**  
*Neon Lights*  
(Eagle Records/EMI)

While Simple Minds' latest album features 10 covers of varied artists ranging from Patti Smith to Kraftwerk, it becomes clear in a hurry that some doors are better left unopened. The Scottish band, while suburb with their own music, remixes a strange and not too lovely version of The Doors' 'Hello I Love You'. Additionally, while Simple Minds tries to redo 'The Man Who Sold The World', Nirvana's rendition still rules. And the start of 'Love Will Tear Us Apart' sounds more like 'Music Sounds Better With' by Stardust. In the end, all of these covers have a vague electronic pop feel to them. Four tracks do stand-out though, including 'Gloria', 'Homosapien' and the two bonus tracks. Ultimately, I'm left shaking my head, knowing that Simple Minds' latest album is mediocre at best.

*Slomotion*

Music to my ears — two CDs for the price of one. The Watchmen's latest album, *Slomotion*, is simply fabulous. The first disc features eight new tracks, accompanied by a nifty remix of 'Stereo' (from *Silent Radar*). Just as good, the second disk is highlighted by nine older tracks. Overall, the new material still has a gritty rock feel to it, though there are definite electronic pop vibes. The Winnipeg rockers, however are mellowing out somewhat with age. The single 'Absolutely Anytime' is catchy, while 'Together' pulsates and rocks much like Depeche Mode. The addition of The Watchmen's older material is a good introduction to the band, though I would rather have had 18 brand new tracks instead of just eight.

**DEEPAK CHOPRA AND DAVE STEWART**

This album, featuring former Eurythmic Dave Stewart and spiritual guide to the stars Deepak Chopra, tries to combine trip-hop rhythms with the spoken-word. While you have to admire Stewart for his courage, the album, entitled *Grow Younger, Live Longer*, comes across as self-indulgent babble. Chopra's spoken-word lyrics are said to be "mystical verses inspired by ancient Indian and Persian poets." Stewart's music is not nearly as weak as Chopra's lyrics, but in the end, this album feels like a commercial for Chopra's new book, which coincidentally has the same name.

## Chekhov's Shorts an intense experience

*Chekhov's Shorts takes five of the Russian writer's short stories and weaves them seamlessly together.*

At the start of Chekhov's Shorts, four actors appear on stage in heavycoats. One is a man, the other three dressed as men; all wear hats and beards. They throw powder up in the air and it falls back as snow in the frozen land of Anton Chekhov's Russia.

A woman seated in front of me at the Saidye Bronfman Centre for the Arts turned to her companion and joked, "That's Anthrax."

An innocuous comment that says a great deal. A month-and-a-half ago, this patron of the staid Saidye probably wouldn't have known what anthrax was.

Now, as it is with the rest of the world, it's part of her vocabulary and part of our consciousness. Thus is the post-Sept. 11 world we all now inhabit.

Russia's greatest writer would have understood a world where anxiety and fear are daily intrusions in our lives. Chekhov's characters are often stuck in a daily grind, mired by loneliness and trepidation. Somehow he manages to find the bittersweet humour of their situation, and provides us with just a glimpse of their salvation.

Michele Smith and Dean Gilmour, the writer-director-actors behind Theatre Smith-Gilmour, have taken five of Chekhov's short stories and woven them seamlessly together to provide snapshots of the human condition that are at once tragic and comical.

Along with Montreal native Patricia Marceau and Monica Dottor, the four begin the journey by picking up four solitary suitcases that wait for them down-

stage and board a train speeding through the frosty land of a Russian winter. They bring to life Chekhov's short story *On the Train*, which frames this most unusual piece of theatre we are about to experience.

Using little else but their suitcases and their wits, the actors are transformed. We meet curious little Belikov from Chekhov's *Man in a Shell*, who represses his passions deep within; *Kashtanka*, the abused dog who discovers a different life in a circus; and the coffin-maker from *Rothchild's Fiddle*, who is so mired in his own disappointments he barely notices his wife until she dies.

Perhaps the most tragic of them all is Vanka, the 13-year-old maid from *Sleepyhead*, who is so tired that all she wants to do is rest, but the baby won't stop crying and her masters won't stop screaming orders at her. Vanka only finds a heavy-hearted peace when she puts the baby to a final sleep.

Chekhov's Shorts, like the writings of Chekhov himself, is about human emotions, human foibles, our failures, and, in small measure, our successes.

It is about the place that people are at a certain point in their lives. Moments of silence are balanced by moments of great activity. It forces audiences to think and feel in a way most theatrical experiences don't.

Creating some extraordinary images are four gifted actors who have mastered a physical and vocal technique they use to great effect here. They embody the spirit of animals, bring an orchestra to life and

provide the sounds of a rushing train, along with their sensitive portrayals of Chekhov's human characters whose sad vulnerabilities are exposed in the harshest of lights.

Chekhov insists his works are comedies and, as such, they are as apt today as they were when they were written more than a hundred years ago for we find ourselves trying to smile in the face of fear, anger and frustration.

In the wake of Sept. 11, there is no better writer to capture our current collective emotional state than Anton Chekhov and Theatre Smith-Gilmour brings his works to life brilliantly. The company has toured Chekhov's Shorts across Canada the United States and recently played to high praise in Hong Kong.

At times disturbing, at others heartwarming, Chekhov's Shorts is an intense experience you won't soon forget.

Jennifer Wende and Rebecca Yetman, both fourth year drama students, offered perspectives into the lives and minds of their characters in the play.

"I am Babe, the youngest sister and I've just shot my husband," said Jennifer Wende. "I am the youngest character and I'm more like an eight-year-old than a 24-year old. Babe sees Lenny (Rebecca Yetman) as a mother figure, and Meg (Hollie Duvall) who has returned from Hollywood to deal with family problems, is the older sister Babe looks up to."

Lenny was 14, Meg 11 and Babe eight-years-old when their mother hanged herself from a tree with the family cat. By that time their father had already

left the family. Life for the McGrath sisters has been about negotiating life through catastrophes.

The play takes place the day before and after Lenny's 30th birthday as she wrestles with a premature mid-life crisis.


"Lenny has spent most of her life caring for others," commented Yetman. "I want the audience to have fun and think more about their own relationships," she said.

"We often hurt the ones we love but they are the ones that stick up for us. We should think more about how we treat the people we love."

# Terrorism fallout hits Hollywood

Last month Columbia Pictures postponed the start of shooting for *Tick Tock*, a Jennifer Lopez thriller about terrorist bombs in Los Angeles shopping malls.

And over at Warner Brothers, studio officials scrapped the Oct. 5 opening of *Collateral Damage* starring Arnold Schwarzenegger as a firefighter who embarks on a personal mission of revenge after his wife and son perish in a terrorist bomb attack on a skyscraper. Producer David Foster told reporters that it would be inappropriate to release such a movie in the immediate wake of the Sept. 11 attacks.

"It's just too painful for people," Foster said. "This picture is so on the money it's unbelievable."

Such decisions might seem to signal a new fastidiousness on the part of Hollywood when it comes to the kind of violent, escapist fantasy that has fuelled studio coffers over the past 15 years. Listen to Los Angeles Times columnist Patrick Goldstein:

"Summer after summer they have churned out eerily similar fantasy images of planes being hijacked, buildings being blown up and cities being reduced to rubble all in the guise of popular entertainment," he said.

"Change is overdue. In the past decade, Hollywood has metamorphosed into a soulless popcorn machine, creating mindless dreck designed to pay off at every stop on the global gravy train, from movie theatres to cable TV to DVDs."

Goldstein thinks the events of Sept. 11 have provoked "uncomfortable self-reflection" in Hollywood's corridors of power. But is Goldstein really right in forecasting an end to the climate that has fostered films like *Lethal Weapon*, *Independence Day* and the yet-to-be-released *Collateral Damage*?

Producer Larry Kasanoff, who worked on *Terminator 2*, certainly doesn't agree. Last week he criticized Hollywood for "reacting with fear" and announced that he's proceeding with the filming of *Heroes*, a movie about a terrorist attack on the U.S. and the subsequent retaliation by special-ops Army units. Kasanoff thinks that this is exactly the kind of movie the industry should be making right now.

Video rental figures give Kasanoff ammunition for his stance. Following the Sept. 11 attacks, video borrowers in the U.S. were seeking out escapist comedy and fantasy — but they were also cleaning the shelves of testosterone-driven terrorism fare like *Die Hard* and *The Siege*.

In Los Angeles, a video store in suburban Costa Mesa reported that the most

popular rental title was *Executive Decision*, a 1996 film starring Kurt Russell about Islamic militant hijackers equipped with nerve gas.

This flies in the face of the easy assumption that Hollywood is going through an agonizing period of soul-searching about the kind of fare it should now be offering — that in the current climate it would no longer have the stomach for a film like *Independence Day* with that now notorious image of the White House disintegrating. But, in fact, no clear consensus is emerging. Indeed, some key players are already cynically predicting that Hollywood will soon revert to business as usual.

The Hughes brothers, directors of the current *In Hell*, a Jack the Ripper thriller starring Johnny Depp, doubt that the industry has turned over a new leaf.

"There's always going to be a need for America to have fake, phoney heroes that make you feel good," scoffs Allen Hughes.

He points to the current box-office popularity of two recent releases — *Don't Say A Word* and *Training Day*, which Warners slipped into the slot originally to have been occupied by *Collateral Damage* — as evidence that filmmakers are still embracing escapist violence.

"Two weeks in a row, those movies make a shitload of money and the comedies aren't making any money," he says.

Media commentators like The L.A. Times's Goldstein and *Variety*'s Peter Bart have had tough words for the film industry and have called for change. But Goldstein also wonders how much real support he has.

"There could be a substantial audience that's less sensitive or more broad-minded

than me," he says.

Veteran producer Lawrence Gordon, who is about to open the cerebral thriller *K-PAX*, is the man who gave the world the *Die Hard* movies. He thinks the industry is taking a long hard look at itself, but he hesitates to forecast the outcome. He also believes some in Hollywood are already prepared to exploit the World Trade Center tragedy to the hilt because they think they can make money out of it.

"You've got to be sensitive to what happened, although there are some people who won't," Gordon told Southam News.

"We're still going to make action movies. We're still going to have explosions and planes. *Training Day* and *Don't Say A Word* are the biggest movies right now."

Speaking for himself, Gordon said he felt action thrillers must alter their content.

"I don't know if we'd do *Die Hard* today," he said candidly. "I don't know whether we'd be able to do it, even though to us it was just a good idea for a movie. But it's a tall building and terrorists. I can't see people saying today: Let's go make this movie."

Gordon says that any producer taking advantage of the trade center disaster at the present time would be "a culprit" in his books. But again he's speaking for himself:

"I would venture that right now it's being developed somewhere in this town."

But Gordon is openly mocking of a CBS proposal to prepare a new situation comedy involving a man and a woman who have lost their respective spouses in the World Trade Centre tragedy.

"I'm not sure that's going to get on the air," Gordon said sarcastically.

Gordon understands the rationale for pulling this month's release of *Collateral Damage*, a revenge fantasy about one man's retaliation against terrorists, but he's also pragmatic about its box-office potential. "It might be huge right now to see these guys get what's coming to them."
