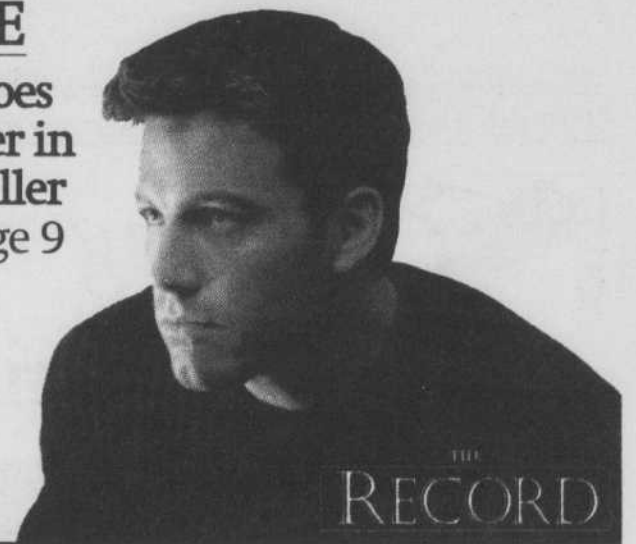


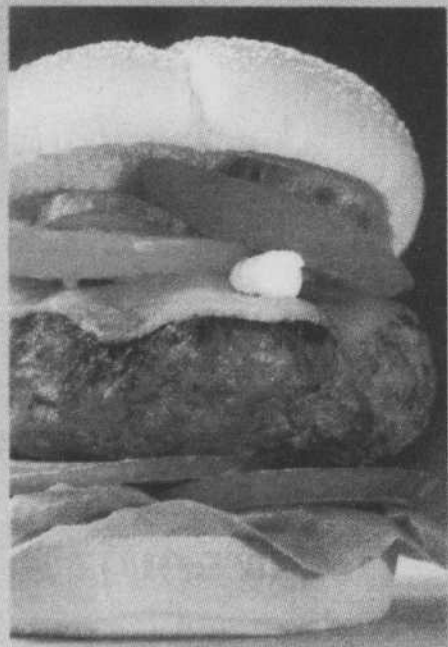

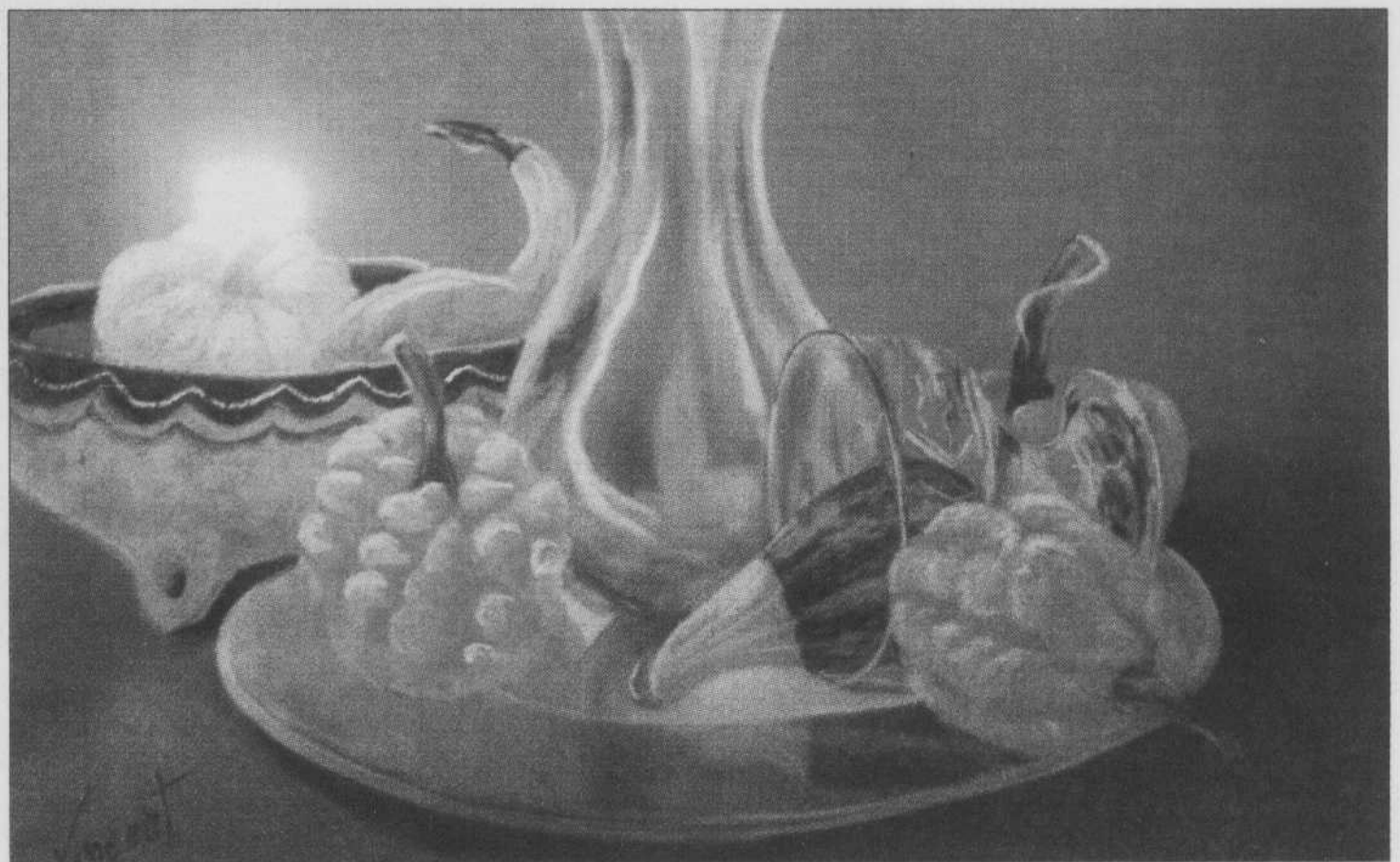

## Entre nous exhibit a mosaic of talent

For a group of 11 Brome Lake artists, all members of the *Art entre nous* collective, the invitation to exhibit works at Knowlton's Pettes Memorial Library for the entire month of May was an opportunity not to be missed.

And display they have, with a collection of 15 selected pieces, splashing colour and texture in the wood-paneled cozy main reading room that doubles as an ad hoc art gallery in summer.

*Art entre nous*, a loosely knit circle of local painters, has gathered regularly on Tuesday afternoons since 1993, to share knowledge, experience, discoveries and kinship with one another. All are about their undertakings having a

sense of purpose, and a few are serious enough about this purpose to have turned it into a trade.

Such is the case of Marianne Vincent, a committed artist whose vivid depiction of a group of squashes titled "*Festival mexicain*" makes the most of an intricate play of yellowish hues to beacon the eye.

According to organizer Julienne St-François, the success of *Art entre nous* with both area painters and public can be attributed to its grass roots approach to learning and a commitment to an experiential approach.

"We purposely design our workshops to be as informal as possible so that we can exchange ideas and learn from each other. From time to time we invite accomplished artists to speak and demonstrate their skills. The

whole idea of getting together is to give artists of different inclinations the opportunity to influence each other."

By any account, the exhibit at the library can be considered an eclectic display of works varying not only in style, but also in form and level of talent. But therein resides what could be considered the single most attractive feature of this month's exhibition, a unique opportunity to sample the wide variety of works from some of the area's applied artists.

Although the exhibit's media of preference are overwhelmingly the expected watercolour and pastel, there is one very vivid acrylic canvas by abstractist Louise Coté and one oil by Anita Simondi, whose gentle illustration of a *Cyclamen* cluster stands out.

## Building a better burger

**B**eef burgers, despite a supermarket full of other options, remain a popular choice for a backyard barbecue.

Their homey feel, low cost, ease of preparation and the taste-tempting ways they can be sandwiched together explains their broad appeal over several decades.

But although their popularity has been consistent, the handling of beef burgers - from selecting the meat to shaping it to cooking the final product - certainly has.

Not long ago, some people would order their beef burgers rare or medium. We now know that eating undercooked ground beef is not a particularly safe thing to do. After consulting Canada's Beef Information Centre and other sources, I learned cooking time is only one of a range of issues to consider when preparing burgers for the barbecue.

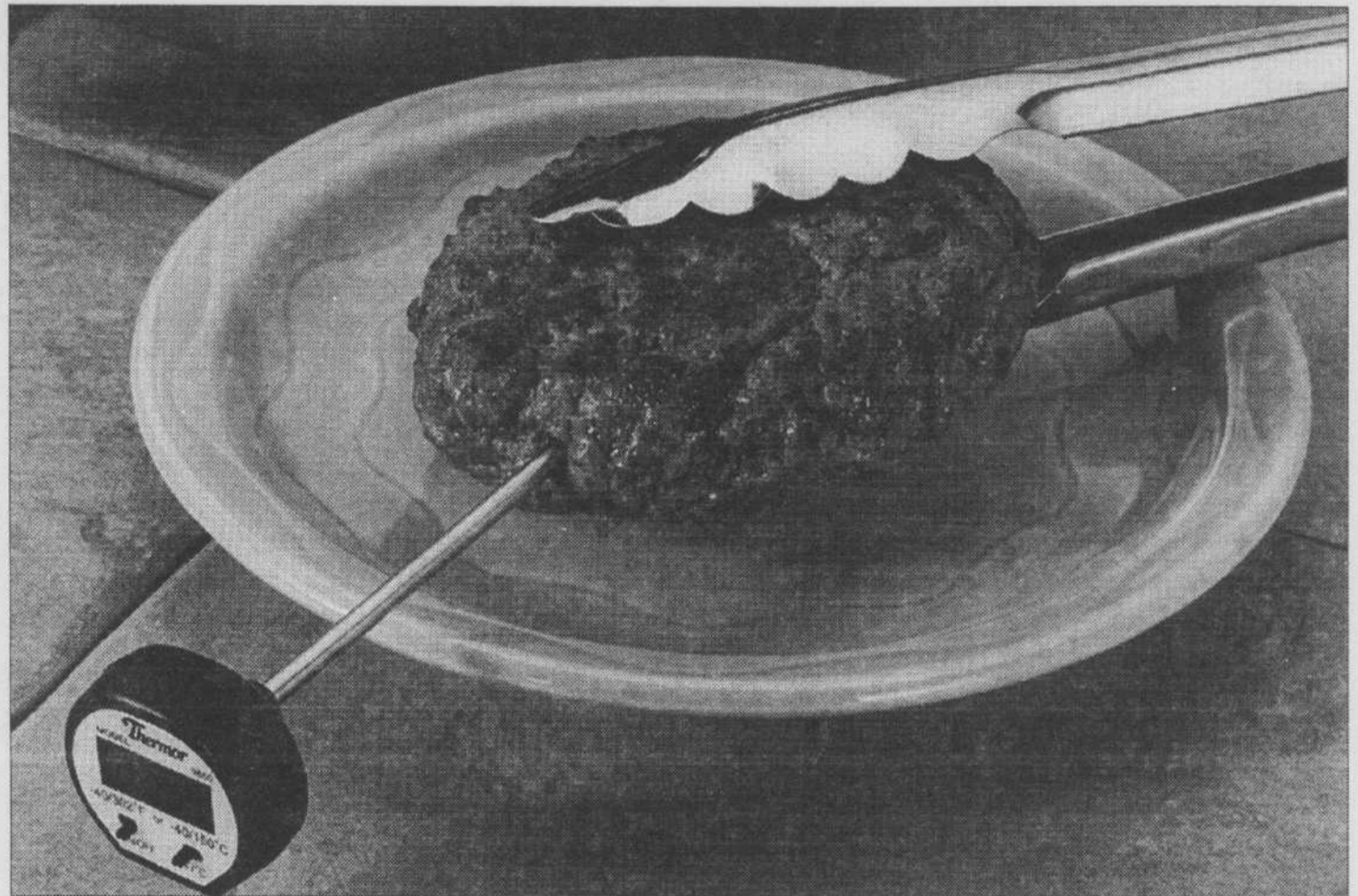
The place to start, logically, is the meat. Ground beef is sold in four styles based on fat content; extra lean (10 per cent fat or less), lean (up to 17 per cent), medium (up to 23 per cent), and regular (up to 30 per cent). For burgers, some of the older cookbooks I checked advocated using regular ground beef because a higher fat count is needed to create a rich, moist and juicy burger. However, with a focus on fat reduction these days, lean and medium ground beef are the styles most recipes call for today.

Although lower in fat, these styles of ground beef can also yield juicy burgers, if you follow a few rules.

No. 1 on the agenda is to gently handle the meat. Do not over do it when mixing and shaping or your patties will be firm and compact textured once cooked. Instead, quickly and lightly shape the meat - I like to use slightly, cold-water dampened hands to prevent the meat from sticking to my hands - into patties that are even in thickness and just hold together.

Be sure that your patties are not too thin, or they can quickly overcook and dry out, and not too thick, or they can scorch on the outside before they are cooked in the centre. Three quarters of an inch thick is what most recipe suggest. This will give them some depth to retain the meats juices, while at the same time not take forever to cook.

When cooking the burgers, don't use too low a heat. Medium-high,

whether you're grilling or pan-frying, is recommended by most guides. This higher temperature will give the burger's exterior a nice sear, which helps lock in the juices. Once on the grill or in the pan, do not flatten the burger out, or you'll press those juices away. Sticking with this minimal handling, flip burgers only once during cooking.

Well done burgers are brown throughout and juices show no pink. How can you tell when the meat has reached that stage? The Beef Information Centre and other food organizations suggest you investment in a quality, instant-read, digital thermometer or thermometer fork. These devices, which the Beef Information Centre calls "an investment in safety," show an actual temperature reading, not just a doneness range. They are sold at most cookware shops, can be used in all foods, and cost about \$35.

When checking the temperature of burgers do so within one minute of removal from the heat. Insert instant-read thermometer stem or fork thermometer tines sideways into the

centre of patties. Leave thermometer in food for at least 30 seconds before reading temperature. Well done beef burgers should be 71 C or above. Always use hot soapy water to wash the tongs, plate and thermometer stem used in checking partially cooked meats before using again.

Now, to the final and most fun step in the burger building process: topping and sandwiching them together. No rules here, except for the use of good sturdy bun and a tasty imagine!

### GROUND BEEF HANDLING TIPS

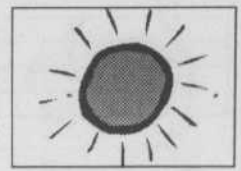
- The majority of consumers select beef based on its bright red colour. However, variations in colour can be due to many factors, including the type of packaging and is not necessarily an indicator of freshness. The best indicator of freshness is the "packaged on" date or the "best before" date.

- On warm summer days purchase the ground beef near the end of shopping to ensure it stays as cold as possible. Wrap carefully and store in the coldest part of the fridge away from potentially dripping on any other foods. Use within 24 hours of purchase or freeze for up to two to three months. Thaw frozen ground beef or frozen pre-made patties overnight in the fridge, not on the counter at room temperature.

- Wash hands thoroughly before and after handling ground beef. Do the same with work surfaces and utensils that have come in contact with the meat. Do not place cooked burgers on the same plate the raw burgers sat on.

- Cook ground beef to a safe internal temperatures of 71 C or above. Be especially careful if you're cooking for those at high risk of serious illness from food-borne bacteria - infants/young children, pregnant women, the elderly or those with chronic illness. Using a food thermometer or temperature indicator is a reliable way to test for safe internal temperatures.

## Friends of Saint-Benoît-du-Lac celebrates 50 years

It's been a quick 50 years for the Association of the Friends of Saint-Benoît-du-Lac, but it's one that Association president Roland Quintal and Dom Jacques Garneau, Father Superior of the Abbey wants to share with the public.

The group will celebrate its 50th anniversary on May 25 at the Monastere des Ursulines du Vieux-Quebec, in Quebec City.

Dom J. Anselme Mathys and several religious schools originally founded this non-profit association, in March 1952. The Association consists of more than 1,500 teaching schools, priests and members of evangelistic communities in Eastern Canada. Its goal is to encourage people to experience and learn to appreciate the peaceful life of contemplation, prayer and hospitality that exists in these religious communities.

"The Association works hard at promoting publications, taping of the Gregorian Chants, organ and harpsichord music and greeting cards created at the Abbey," said Gilles Carignan, of the organizing committee.

"The Monastery is well known for its many different kinds of cheeses that they make and sell as well as the apples and other fruit that grows in their orchards."

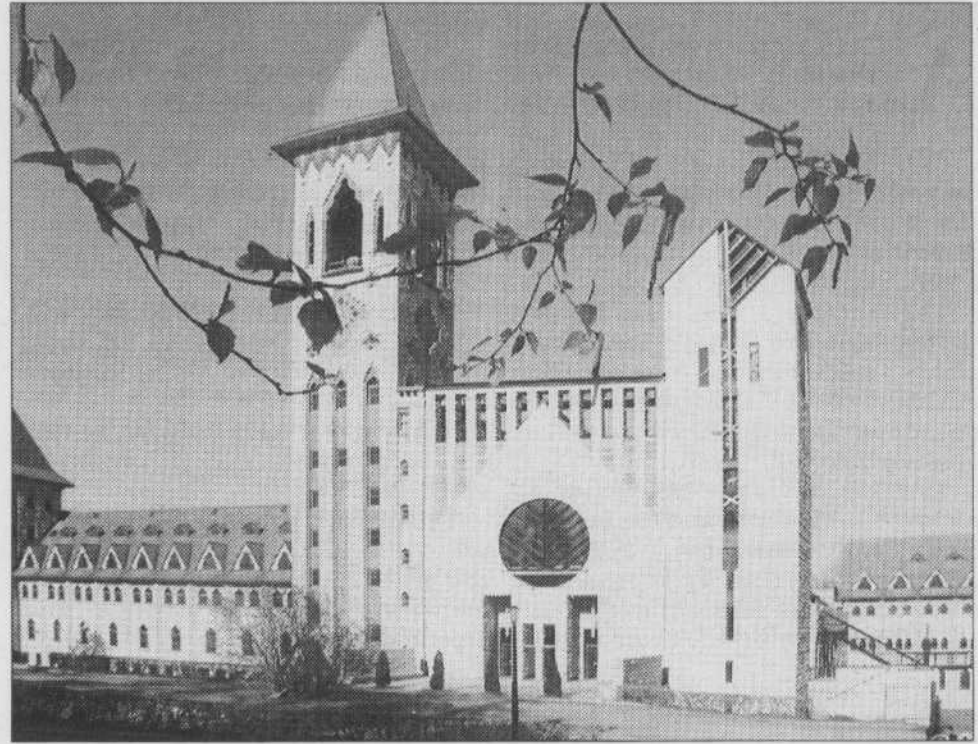
Carignan added that the produce of the Abbey has won worldwide recognition through international competitions. They are currently in the process of enlarging the store and developing their own brand of ketchup.

On July 4, 1912, Dom Paul Vannier arrived in Montreal with the mission to start a religious monastery to be named after the French Abbey of St-Wandrille. While visiting Magog, he fell in love with the area on the banks of Lake Memphremagog, where there was a vast piece of agricultural property for sale.

Ignoring the usual rules that governed life in a monastery, Vannier began to involve himself in the lives of the Catholic population of the surrounding area. The diocese already present was young. 'Gibraltar' was to be a parish which would include both the monastery life and strong ties within the community. It would reach an area six miles circling the steeple. In December, 1912, at the celebration of the Immaculate Conception, the parish became a reality.

The results were less than Dom Vannier had hoped for but he did not discourage easily. Out of a population of 700, only 200 were Catholic, as the rest were Protestant. To accommodate the rapidly increasing parish, Father Vannier had a balcony constructed overlooking the lake. By the open windows, the men were able to see or at least hear the services. The interior seating was reserved for the women.

When summer arrived, the numbers increased even faster due to well-to-do people from the Montreal area who built sum-

mer homes around the shores of Lake Memphremagog, most of whom were strong Catholics. Because of the proximity to the monastery, many came to continue their religious education.

The sudden and tragic death of Dom Vannier in November, 1914 and the declaration of World War I gave a fatal blow to his hopes to build a chapel behind the Abbey. The conflict had particularly grave repercussions for the young monastery. Communication with their superiors and families in France was no longer possible, and they were severely mistreated by a group of German soldiers who had invaded their quiet life.

Repeated requests for assistance from the mother Abbey in France were never answered. Faced with the decision to close the monastery, it was decided to try rais-

ing chickens and growing crops to increase their chances of survival. Fruit trees were added to make them more self-sufficient.

In early 1927, P. Brun and Fr. Hilaire became aware of the plight of a small Anglican Church in East Bolton (Austin). Due to decreasing numbers, they were being forced to sell. The selling price was the incredible price of \$250. Mass was celebrated for the first time in this new Catholic Church in May 1927.

There are currently 50 Benedictine who reside at the Monastery, as well as those who visit for short periods of time. The regional AA is just one of the many organizations that hold seminars at their facilities today, while more than 200,000 people pass through the doors of the Abbey each year.

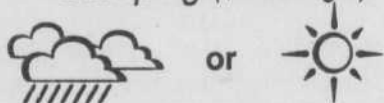

# Concert honouring war victims set for weekend

A superb venue with marvellous acoustics is where you will find more than 30 players bequeathed with musical talent on Saturday. The Sherbrooke Fusiliers will be performing a benefit concert at the church in Wotton as part of the festivities highlighting the 100th anniversary of Maurice O'Bready.

The Fusiliers are well known throughout the Eastern Townships and as a military group have played to members of the Canadian Forces and performed for civilians on numerous occasions as well.

Sylvain Côté is the lieutenant directing the orchestra and has been actively involved with the group since 1996. During the concert there will be a wide variety of music played to suit all tastes. In addition, there will be

soloists and vocal performances integrated into the concert.

"The musicians are all involved in music and they will play a really diverse assortment of music. I can't tell you now what they will play, I don't know. They will decide when they are looking at the crowd on Saturday," said an enthusiastic Manon Vaillancourt, co-ordinator of the celebrations.

"Depending on the crowd they will play jazz, music from films, classical, popular music and of course military music.

"They are a harmony orchestra with singing, percussion, woodwind and horns."

The concert on Saturday follows a very special ceremony taking place at the cenotaph at 7 p.m. It will commemorate those who fought in the Second World War.

Vaillancourt noted that of the 1,000 residents living in Wotton at the time of the war, 23 fought in Normandy — a high concentration for such a small population. In all, the names of 123 fallen soldiers are remembered on the monument.

"For the ceremony at the cenotaph we have invited the veterans from Richmond, Victoriaville, Danville and the surrounding areas," she said. "Everyone will be decorated, wearing their medals and it is a very moving ceremony."

After the ceremony at the cenotaph there will be ample space in the church for about 1,000 individuals. There is no cost for the concert and voluntary contributions are welcomed.

Vaillancourt explained that there are 11 people involved in the organization of the year-long festivities for

the 100th anniversary of O'Bready. There is also representation from the various groups and community organizations in the village. Donations from the concert are equally allocated to the various organizations.

"This is not so much a festival, as there are festivals throughout the province in the summer, but a celebration," added Vaillancourt. "The acoustics of the church are fantastic. It is a 60-foot high structure and it is completely made out of wood. The sound is incredible and the concert promises to be amazing."

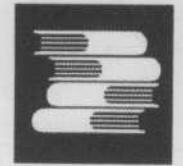

## Servants of the People: Inside Story of New Labour

*Tony Blair borrowed a page from U.S. President Clinton*

Upon becoming leader of the British Labour Party, in 1994, Tony Blair introduced many changes to the way British politics were conducted.

Three years later, in May 1997, he was elected with a landslide majority. Last spring, he was given a second mandate.

It is thus interesting to question how the New Labour government operates. In that sense, *Servants of the People: The Inside Story of New Labour*, by British journalist Andrew Rawnsley, is a very good road map. It's clear that Tony Blair has changed politics in Britain. And this may be a trend followed by other countries who are governed by the British parliamentary system, like Canada, for instance.

Since the events of Sept. 11, 2001, Tony Blair has been a staunch ally of President Bush, but his source of inspiration and motivation was - right from the start - Bill Clinton. As much through his ideology as in the way he operated politically, the 42nd President of the United States was a mentor to Tony Blair and his team. For that reason, it may not be surprising that the Labour government established a deci-

sion-making process that is - in many ways - borrowing pages the American presidency.

For example "no secrets of any substance were ever going to be shared around the Cabinet table - a fairly redundant item of furniture in the Blair government."

Most of the key decisions in the Labour government were to be taken by the PM's entourage and by the people in the Policy Unit (an important department at 10 Downing Street). The New Labourites are governing from the centre.

Upon arrival at 10 Downing Street, "Tony Blair recognized no equal in his Cabinet, and only his Chancellor (Gordon Brown) was sufficiently strong to challenge that supremacy. This Prime Minister planned to be primus. From the beginning, it was designed to be a presidential premiership." Reading Rawnsley's book, one easily comes to understand that Gordon Brown is the de facto number two in the British government. At worst, he and his followers are quarreling with the prime minister and his entourage. After all, Rawnsley writes that "anything Blair had, Brown had to have, and bigger and better." At other times, "the marriage of Brown and Blair, when functioning creatively, could be one of the most productive partnerships British politics is ever likely to see."

The reader must know that, in 1994, after John Smith's death, Gordon Brown wanted to become leader of the Labour

Party. While he decided not to run against Tony Blair, he was the leading contender to the Labour throne.

This way of governing also has important implications for parliamentary life. Very soon and without much astonishment, observers came to realize that, "New Labour regarded its MPs not as its conscience, but as its cheerleaders." The British MPs are thus in a similar situation as their Canadian colleagues. They are often - not to say most of the time - left in the cold.

As a leader and politician, Tony Blair is a big-picture man. Andrew Rawnsley realizes that "as a political type, Blair was an artist, not an engineer. His strengths lay in reading political moods, not reconfiguring structures. He wanted product, but he was not interested in the nuts and bolts of the machine."

This being said, one of Labour's great strengths is about media spin and modern political techniques (like polls and focus groups). With the devoted assistance of people like Peter Mandelson (called by many the "Prince of Darkness") and his press Secretary, Alastair Campbell, Tony Blair has been able to get away from many difficult situations. For instance, "the frequent bouts of chaos and indecision at the centre of government had been skillfully concealed by the spin of the strong leader." Andrew Rawnsley thus comes to the conclusion that "no previous government has dedicated so much talent and

energy to trying to rule through the media."

While thumbing through Rawnsley's pages, it's possible to meet a very talented politician: Tony Blair himself. Very soon, one could see that "Blair possessed the great political gift of leaving most people who met him feeling warmer about themselves - and therefore about him." After all, the British PM is a charmer who made a profession of being able to "kill with cream" and become "everything to every man and woman". These are the hallmarks of a good politician. But, over time, people can get bored with this short-lived and superficial talent. Over time, this situation may well become New Labour's new challenge.

*Servants of the People* is thus a very interesting book, for anybody interested in knowing more about the way politics operates. Charisma, good public relations and avoidance of confrontational attitudes are the traits of this new brand of public service - a brand well understood and explained by Andrew Rawnsley.

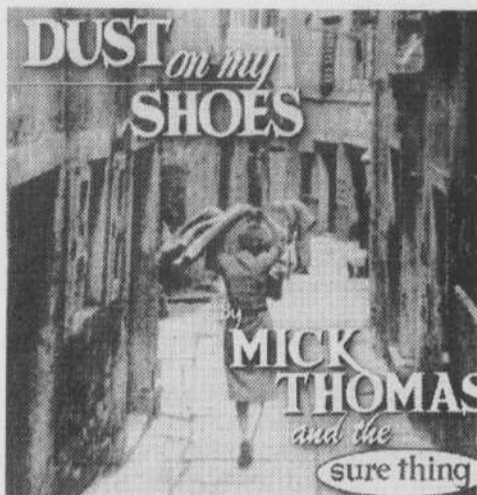

# Hard to miss with Mick Thomas' latest



**MICK THOMAS AND THE SURE THING**  
*Dust on My Shoes*  
(Croxtan Records)

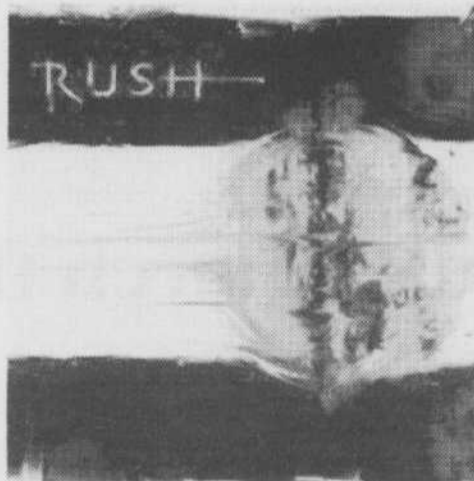
North American audiences may not recognize Australian outfit Mick Thomas and the Sure Thing, but following the group's international release of *Dust on My Shoes*, they could become a household name. The definite twang on vocals by singer/songwriter Mick Thomas, who also plays rhythm and bass guitar, the music is far from folk, but is still reminiscent of classic Bob Dylan. The definite rockability of guitar work by bassist Darren Hanlon, the group is far from a rock group, but could stand alongside a band like the Wallflowers. There is no real category for Mick Thomas and the Sure Thing, but their music does have a general Celtic appeal to it. The vocals dominate and the acoustic instruments place second throughout the album. Highlighting *Dust on My Shoes* is the presence of all three members on vocals (drummer Michael Barclay rounding out the trio). Also, Hanlon's handiwork on harmonica adds a personal, home-cooked touch to the music, especially on the single 'Lawrence Durrell'. The album ends with four bonus live tracks on the European edition, highlighted by the single 'Under the Clocks'.

**PET SHOP BOYS**  
*Release*  
(Parlophone)

It's not that the Pet Shop Boys have so much dropped off the radar as they were forced out. With the shifting focus to international teen pop bands and North American hard rock ensembles, the UK duo has been regulated to sporadic appearances on badly assembled '80s compilations. More recently, the group has released another album, entitled *Release*, which is a 10-song disk that just doesn't fit the legendary group's profile. Internationally renowned for their distinctive '80s pop sound, Neil Tennant (vocals, guitar, keyboards) and Chris Lowe (keyboards, drum programming) focus more on light rock, adult contemporary tunes in songs like 'Love is a Catastrophe' and 'I Get Along'. Only on singles like 'Here' and 'E-mail' do the Boys' sound like the Pet Shop Boys, but even then, who wants to here that in 2002. The answer is no one. Unfortunately, the Pet Shop Boys' release of *Release* falls in suit with several other legendary artists who have recently made a disastrous return (Leonard Cohen, Mick Jagger), only to stain what was a storybook career.

**RUSH**  
*Vapor Trails*  
(Anthem/Universal MCA)

Always dedicated followers of fashion rather than trendsetters, Rush have managed to retain the sheen of progressiveness even though much of their output is derivative. If that sounds like damning with faint praise, so be it. Their first album in four years, and first full studio release in nearly six, is a tour de force of technology and masterful musicianship. *Vapor Trails* arrives with all the advance hype and reported Internet piracy of a George Lucas movie. But, happily, it also stands as a milestone for Rush, their most consistent album since the mid-1980s. It com-

pares favourably with the likes of Permanent Waves, Moving Pictures and Power Windows. The first single, 'One Little Victory', opens with drummer Neil Peart's call to arms and never lets up through more than five minutes of power-chord intensity. Often victims of wretched excess, Rush keep it simple here, building the sound up from the basic trio of drums-bass-uitar. Alex Lifeson's guitars have ringing crispness, while Geddy Lee's bass thumps proudly and his voice is agreeably restrained. In their 28 years, Rush have never been innovative. Rather, they alter their focus to suit current trends, throwing off the heavy metal of Led Zeppelin/Black Sabbath in favour of ZZ Top-style blues, Police-style reggae, or Peter Gabriel-style world beat. This time, it's a Creed-style alternative sound, which Rush helped shape nearly three decades ago. An ironic twist of musical fate, but one which serves them well.

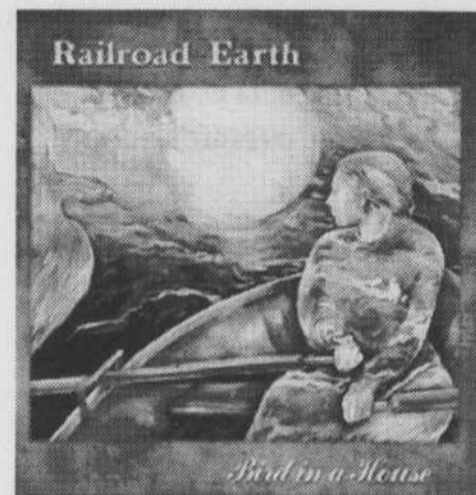

**BONNIE RAITT**  
*Silver Lining*  
(Capitol/EMI)

Although she relies for the most on the inner circle of her band for material (including the lead single, 'I Can't Help You Now'), Bonnie Raitt has made a shrewd choice for the title track of her new album. It's British rocker David Gray's *Silver Lining*, a moody R&B number from Gray's *White Ladder* CD. Raitt uses the basic keyboard underpinning, but punches up the sound. The song is just one of several standouts in a solid outing produced by Raitt, Tchad Blake and Mitchell Froom. Highlights include: the sexually charged 'Gnawin' On It'; 'Monkey Business' (with songwriter Jon Cleary supplying the Delbert McClinton-style background vocal); the gorgeous ballad, 'Wherever You May Be' (with guest vocals by Arnold McCuller); and the African rhythms of *Hear Me Lord*.

(Sugar Hill)

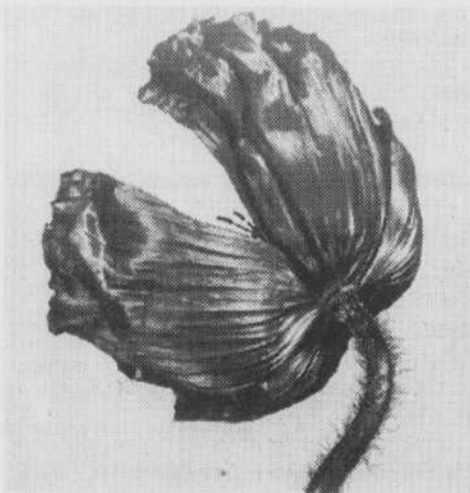
On this follow-up to last year's stunning debut, *The Black Bear Sessions*, this New Jersey-based rocking bluegrass band proves that early success wasn't a fluke. The musicianship is superb, the arrangements and production excellent. But what sets Railroad Earth apart from similar rootsy acts is the songwriting of lead singer-guitarist Todd Sheaffer. He's responsible for all or part of 10 of the 13 tracks here, and, like a John Fogerty, he gives this band its special sound. On the stretched-out instrumental break of a song such as 'Like a Buddha', Railroad Earth recalls no less than the legendary New Grass Revival.

**Denise Djokic**  
*Barber, Martinu, Britten*  
(Sony Classical)

Recorded just two weeks after her Jan. 26 appearance with Windsor Symphony Orchestra, this debut by 21-year-old cello sensation Denise Djokic is a revelation. The three 20th-century works she has selected — Samuel Barber's *Sonata for Cello and Piano*, Op. 6; Bohuslav Martinu's *Sonata for Cello and Piano*, No. 1; and Benjamin Britten's *Third Suite for Solo Cello*, Op. 87 — are rarely recorded. So the disc is most welcome on that count. Djokic imbues each with a depth of feeling, especially the Martinu, a crazy-quilt work of jazz and atonality. As she showed in her wonderful reading of the Shostakovich first concerto in Windsor, the Nova Scotia native makes leaps of passion, from moody reserve to exuberant joy, with remarkable ease, and never loses her beautiful, rich tone. The challenging 'Third Suite by Britten', which rounds out the program, is the CD's showstopper, a true test of virtuosity and expression. No less impressive is her accompanist on two of the works, Quebec-born David Jalbert, whose vigorous passage work is the ideal foil.

# Shaw's opening play like a soufflé gone flat

## Caesar and Cleopatra production fraught with ambushes

Throughout his long life, George Bernard Shaw was fascinated with the nature of greatness. With no play did this fascination yield richer dividends than with Caesar And Cleopatra, that cunning piece of historical revisionism that launched the Shaw Festival's new season.

The play itself is fraught with ambushes - critic Max Beerbohm talked of its "irresponsible complexities" when he reviewed it a century ago - because of Shaw's readiness to move from moments of soaring eloquence to capricious humour in the blink of an eye. And the actor portraying Caesar faced a daunting assignment - to pursue that often elusive concept of greatness and fashion from it a credible human being of wit, moral fervor and intellectual and emotional substance.

Festival veteran Jim Mezon is the one entrusted with this task, and his

wise and perceptive characterization is the most positive aspect of an often troubled production. It's a carefully nuanced performance imbued with wit and - save for those occasional emotional crescendos - a quiet authority, a portrait of a man whose very consciousness of his own fallibility - he is, for example, getting old - merely accentuates an inner strength.

Mezon's Caesar has a capacity for mischievousness: witness his nocturnal first encounter with Caroline Cave's young and impressionable Cleopatra - this is a beautifully rendered scene, designed by William

Schmuck and lit by Kevin Lamotte, with Caesar and the child-like Queen of Egypt diverting each other between the paws of a giant sphinx beneath the smudged glow of a low-hanging moon. Memorable as well are those sudden outbursts of moral passion when Caesar shows true anguish on hearing of the death of a Roman rival he respected and later discovers that Cleopatra has abandoned those leadership values

that he tried to instill in her. And there are moments of wisdom, when Mezon brings substance and emotional truth to lines that in lesser hands might emerge as no more than calculated insertions of Shavian rhetoric. "He who has never hoped can never despair" - Mezon convinces you that this is Caesar's truth rather than Shaw's. It is not an over-idealized portrait; this Caesar has a clear-eyed appreciation of his own failings and

those of other men and an understanding of the need to aspire to a greater good. "Is peace not an art?" he cries out near the end. "Is war not an art? Is civilization not an art?" Such utterances raise play and production to an eloquent level.

So why do other aspects of the evening disappoint? Why, despite the obvious care and intelligence director Christopher Newton has taken in mounting this play, does it so often seem like a soufflé gone flat? Newton has chosen to move this saga of ancient Rome into the 20th century.

The First World War setting is not necessarily a grievous offence: Shaw was, among other things, poking fun at the British occupation of Egypt - indeed, Desmond McCarthy, one of Shaw's most astute critics, has written of the playwright's penchant for "rubbing off as much as possible of the patina of time from historical characters and revealing the bright modern colour underneath."

But on this occasion, such modernization doesn't achieve a great deal. The sight of Caesar in jaunty fedora, military breeches and boots and of his men in military uniforms does not bring clarity to those often tangled expository passages dealing with rivalries within the Roman Empire and within the Egypt that the Romans have invaded. Instead, extended sections tend to be dreary and laboured: characters and issues seem undefined and the humour flags.

As Cleopatra, Caroline Cave has her amusing moments, but essentially it's a nervous meow of a performance: we never really see the transition from capricious kitten to mature queen who has implemented Caesar's tutelage only too well. Too many other performances are bland ciphers: Patrick R. Brown's failure to have more fun with that wily Sicilian, Apollodorus, is truly astonishing. There are few nuggets of gold: the mixture of petulance and comic uncertainty inherent in Jeff Lillico's performance as the boy king Ptolemy, the zeal with which Norman Browning turns the character of the loyal Britannus into the ultimate stuffed-shirt bureaucrat. But too much of the evening exudes a museum remoteness.

## Tremblay play ill-served by U.S. production

*Verteran actress misses the mark in For The Pleasure of Seeing Her Again*

**I**t's distressing to watch a justly honoured actress like Olympia Dukakis striking a succession of wrong notes in a role that one might have assumed was tailor-made for her talent.

But that, unfortunately, is what is happening at California's prestigious American Conservatory Theatre where Quebec playwright Michel Tremblay's *For The Pleasure Of Seeing Her Again* has just had a gala launching.

Dukakis, who won an Academy Award for her work in *Moonstruck*, is a firm favourite with A.C.T. audiences, and her final opening night curtain call was greeted with thunderous applause. But this mass display of affection cannot disguise the fact that she is only intermittently successful in distilling the essence of the remarkable mother that Tremblay brought to invigorating and exasperating life in his 1998 play.

The piece, it is well known, is an affectionately crafted valentine to the playwright's own mother - a simple but forceful woman whose vigorous imagination and unbridled zest for life helped unfetter Tremblay's own creative gifts and nurtured his emergence as an internationally celebrated Canadian dramatist.

It takes the form of a memory play in which a gay middle-aged son looks back - with love, gentle humour and the wisdom of his own years - on his mother as she was at five different times of his youth. As is so often the case with Tremblay, it shows him re-defining the dramatic conventions; hence, the flashbacks consist of imaginary conversations with a mother whose love and generosity of

spirit ultimately triumphed over her old-fashioned fears and prejudices about her boy's personal and artistic journey. And, within the compass of these five scenes and two characters, a richly textured social and emotional fabric assumes life.

At least that's how things should be when this play is presented on stage.

That is not how they are in San Francisco where A.C.T. artistic director Carey Perloff's clunky direction shows repeated bad judgment. One

glaring error is the arbitrary imposition of an intermission on a text which is supposed to be performed without a

break: for the sake of giving audiences the sense of a normal-length evening at the theatre, the play's dreamy emotional flow is disturbed.

Marco Barricelli does communicate warmth and emotional balance as the son in the various stages of his early youth - as an actor, he clearly is attempting to meet the demands of a situation where it is all too easy to become no more than a sounding board for what are essentially monologues from Nana, the mother. If this fine actor frequently seems to be functioning in a vacuum, the fault rests with Dukakis. With the exception of the touching final scene, Dukakis seems ill at ease with both the character and the material.

Stylistically, Tremblay does make demands on his performers, but surely an actress who has performed Greek drama and Brecht on stage is capable of more than shallow mannerisms.

A false note is immediately struck in the opening scene in which she subjects her 10-year-old son to an

emotional harangue which climaxes with her frenetic, eye-rolling prediction that he'll end up in reform school. Dukakis does virtually the entire scene leaning forward inquisitorially, as though she's about to pounce on her errant son. She's still striking the same, stagey, one-note posture in succeeding scenes.

Assuming that opening-night problems with lines have now been resolved, one is still left with a hollow shell of a characterization in which Dukakis, the paint-by-numbers technician, is more evident than the seasoned artist who might have been expected to explore the various facets of this character - from her lack of sophistication to her capacity for self-dramatization to her wonderful, generous love - in all their glory.

Dukakis's performance is a failure of imagination. You're left reflecting ruefully on Vancouver actress Nicola Cavendish's exemplary performance in the same role four years ago at Montreal's Centaur Theatre.

# Affleck sought blessings for super spy role

The money would seem to tell it all. Ben Affleck was paid \$600,000 US for *Armageddon*. Yet, only four years later, he is earning \$10 million US apiece for two of this season's biggest films — *Changing Lanes* and the upcoming *The Sum of All Fears*. Furthermore, when Affleck starts work later this year on *Daredevil*, he'll be getting \$11.5 million US up front plus a percentage of the profits.

But when it comes to this actor, dollar figures don't tell the whole story. Neither does *Premiere Magazine's* annual rating of the 100 most powerful people in Hollywood: in the 2002 survey, Affleck made the list at No. 77.

As for the more frivolous hype — like being named by *People* magazine as one of the 50 most beautiful people in the world — Affleck is apt to respond with a sheepish, self-deprecating shrug.

Instead, there's the sense of a young actor determined to hang on to his life and priorities. He has loped into a small room crammed with nearly print journalists, and arranged his rangy six-foot-two frame behind a small table, before flashing that 20-carat smile and exposing a set of perfectly capped teeth.

"He's too good to be true!" gasps one female journalist — and one suspects Affleck would agree with her. By his own admission, he's still on a learning curve, still growing up, still learning to cope.

There is, for example, his well-publicized sojourn last summer at the Promises Rehabilitation Centre in Malibu — the drying-out place Affleck mischievously refers to as "Camp Snoopy." His comments on his stay there are brief, but still forthright.

"It's as simple as this: I quit drinking," Affleck admits. "I don't drink any more. It's really not that big a deal. You know what I mean? It has no real bearing on anything else in my life."

"It's a life choice. I did it, and that's really all there is to it." He grins and then adds, almost apologetically: "I know there must seem to be a juicier story there, but there isn't."

He's similarly candid when asked about *The Sum of All Fears*, the latest Tom Clancy thriller to hit the screen, and

the challenge of taking on the role of CIA hero Jack Ryan, a character earlier portrayed by Alec Baldwin (*The Hunt for Red October*) and Harrison Ford (*Patriot Games*, *Clear and Present Danger*). At the start, Affleck, 29, felt like a boy being asked to fill a man's shoes.

"I was terribly apprehensive," he continues. "In fact, I thought it was a terrible idea when I first heard about it. How could I possibly take over from Harrison Ford or Alec Baldwin? I'm not Harrison Ford. I'm not Alec Baldwin. It was ridiculous."

"I knew that this would be a double-edged sword because there would be a built-in interest in this film. People would want to see it. People like this character, they like the books, but they also like the way they saw it before."

Affleck is helped by the fact that the new film, opening May 31, takes some liberties with the time factor. Although it's set in the present day — and deals with a successful terrorist initiative to explode a nuclear weapon on American soil — it presents a youthful Jack Ryan at the start of his career, as a fledgling CIA analyst who finds himself a pivotal figure in a terrifying situation.

This approach soothed Affleck's fears somewhat: "I would be able to play the guy where he didn't have all the answers yet, where he was still new, green and uncertain. So I thought audiences in a way would more closely identify with that than if I were a guy who had it all figured out and knew what he was doing."

But Affleck was nevertheless anxious enough to seek the blessing of the two previous Jack Ryans.

"I didn't want to do it without the support of the people who'd played him before. Maybe that sounds weird, but it just seemed the right thing to me."

He talked to Baldwin when the two were working together on *Pearl Harbor*.

"He was very supportive, really sweet and very encouraging. I also called up Harrison Ford and he was very gracious. He said: 'I think you'll be great.'"

Even so, his predecessors cast a long shadow when he started filming. "There was the challenge of trying not to think of following these guys. It was a little bit like rock climbing: If you look down you're dead. If I'd stopped in the middle of a scene and thought, 'Is this how Harrison Ford would do it?' I would have ruined things."

Affleck also talked to the person who was worrying him the most — author Tom Clancy.

"He created this character, and I just wouldn't have done it if he didn't think I was the right guy and there would have been no hard feelings. To get his approval and his OK meant a lot to me. And the fact

that he's now seen the movie and likes it means even more to me."

In fact, Affleck is going out of his way this morning to thank colleagues for being so supportive. This includes the film's director, Phil Alden Robinson (*Field of Dreams*), and co-star Morgan Freeman who plays the CIA director.

"Morgan I consider to be one of the, if not the, greatest living actors. I idolize and hero-worship the guy to the extent where it's kind of embarrassing."

Affleck is opening in *The Sum of All Fears* at a time when he's still on view in *Changing Lanes*, which triggered some of the best reviews of his career for his performance as an ambitious young lawyer in moral crisis. Yet a year ago he was being pummeled by critics for *Pearl Harbor*. On the subject of bad reviews, he again tries to be forthright.

"I have to try and not take it personally... I'm a good sport about it. There's no shortage of critics in the world, but there is a shortage of people willing to endure criticism with grace and humility. I like to count myself in the ranks of the latter."

## Time flies for Brock as he releases third album

**T**ime flies when you're having fun, and that can't be any more true for relative newcomer Chad Brock, who has recently released his third album.

The disk holds a special place in the heart of Brock, who dedicated to his grandmother, Margaret Stafford, who passed away on May 28, 2001. She was a big influence on Brock musically, as she played music for 69 years in the church of Coleman, Florida, where her husband (Brock's grandfather) served as the minister. She was 92 when she died.

The co-producers Norro Wilson and Buddy Cannon did a wonderful job on Brock's latest because they left a lot of room for the country

singer's creativity. His vocal abilities are better showcased in this release as opposed to his two prior albums, which is a good sign considering he has already been enormously successful. Early hits like 'Ordinary Life' and 'Yes' initially got songwriters interested in Brock, and this is likely why songwriters have been sending him such a great selection of songs lately.

The theme for this album is love, whether it is falling in love or staying in it. The feelings are honest as Brock sings about love from all the possible angles.

The first single, 'Tell Me How', allows listeners to feel the hurt when he sings "How am I supposed to live without you now/How do I go on breathing/When the dream that I've been living's left me now/Tell me how."

Also highlighting the album is the single 'Park The Pickup (Kiss the Girl)'. This song will make you smile and surely bring vivid memories of the last time you went

parking with a sweetheart. Brock offers a flawless rendition as he sings: "Some would say that she's wrong to keep/The secret from him but she/Knows the truth would tear his world apart/She's gonna live and die with the lie."

The Florida native also offers a masterful performance on a beautiful love song entitled 'Right Now'. Another song, 'Livin' In Las Vegas', is more of a humorous number which Brock handles very well.

The diversity of emotions displayed on Brock's album shows how versatile the country singer can be. There are 10 songs on the new album, and on the first edition of the disk, listeners are treated to three bonus tracks: 'Yes', 'Ordinary Life' and 'Lightning Does The Work.'

The album is a delight and you might want to listen to 'I'd Like To See You Try' in your car and crank it up as you drive. This one is a feel good, well-written fun song that you'll play over and over.
