Magog bar owner hits the 13th note

Jean-Denis Dubuc's album *La Treizième Note* has been 13 years in the making.

The co-owner of *Le Chat du Moulinier* in Magog has been playing sax at the popular bar, and at its previous incarnation *Le Chat Noir*, since 1990.

"People asked for an album for many years," he says. "It was about time to do this album."

The album is a blend of jazz standards and classic French songs. It opens with *Summertime*, performed by Dubuc's partner in life and in business, Micheline Roy. It continues

with instrumental tracks featuring Dubuc and three pianists, Jean-Jacques Beauchamp, Pierre Blais and François Morin. Beauchamp and Blais play regularly at *Le Chat*, while Morin has made several appearances.

"He's a very talented young guy," says Dubuc, who plays saxophone on the album. "It was good to have him along."

Also featured on the album are drummer Simon Bergeron, a graduate of the jazz

program at the University of Sherbrooke and a regular at the club,

bass player Guy Breton,

also a regular, and drummer

Jacques Gaudreau, who

plays on the single *Misty*.

"That's me fulfilling a promise I made 15 years ago," Dubuc explains. "I told him that when I record *Misty*, he would play on it."

The album was recorded in Sherbrooke using a simultaneous recording method.

Nothing beats orange crème caramel

Yes, we are back on desserts again this week. But guess what: This one takes only half an hour of prep time, and looks like something straight out of a five-star restaurant menu.

I learned how to make this as a young girl (yes, I spent lots of time in the kitchen at the early age of seven). It is the simpler, down-to-earth version of the classic French recipe. Instead of calling for expensive vanilla beans or confectioner's sugar, it requires only a few basic ingredients: eggs, orange juice, sweetened condensed milk, sugar and water.

Don't be fooled by the apparent simplicity, though. Serve this decadently creamy flan to your pickiest dinner guests, and I guarantee they will beg for seconds. This has always been the dessert I serve when I really want to wow someone. Try a bite and there's no going back — it will always be one of your winners too.

ORANGE CRÈME CARAMEL Ingredients (for six)

3 eggs, separated
1 cup sugar
2/3 cup water
1 can sweetened condensed milk (300 ml)

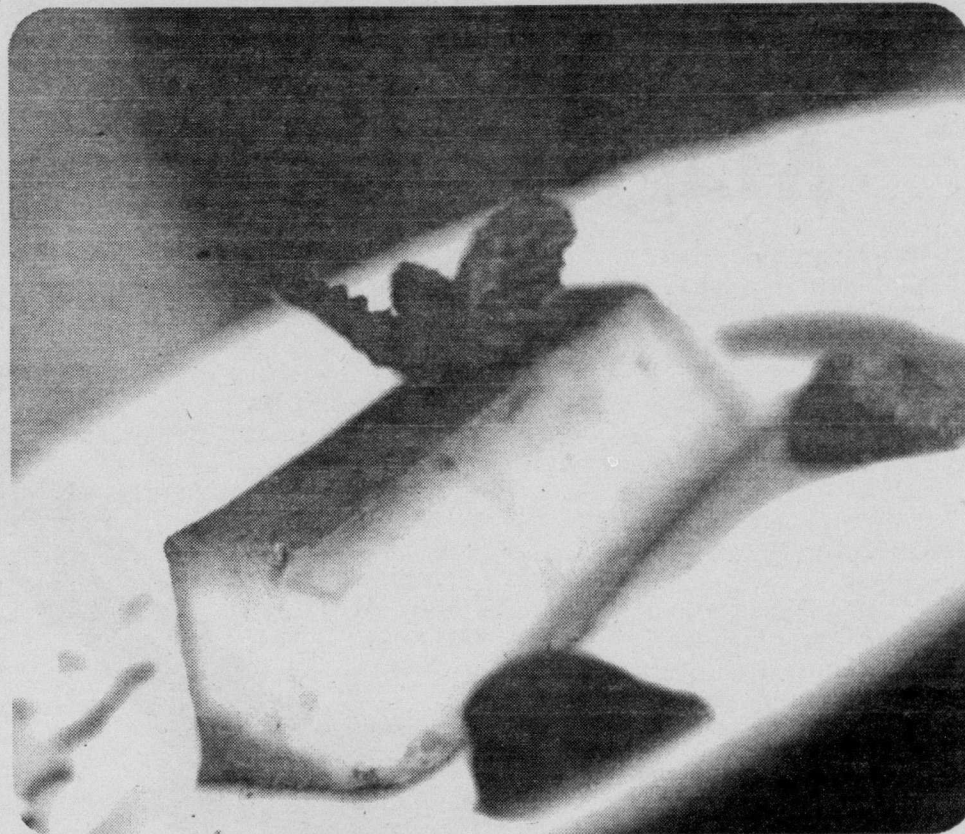
1 can of orange juice (use the empty can to measure)

DIRECTIONS

1. Choose the mould you will use. The easiest is the one that looks like a donut with a whole in the middle, but you can also use two terrine moulds. Cook the sugar in the mould until it melts and darkens to the same colour as maple syrup, stirring with a wooden spoon and tapping any sugar lumps to help them dissolve. Add the water. Don't worry, the caramel will smoke, bubble, fizzle and look funny, but slowly, as you keep stirring the water, will blend into it. You will end up with a nice and smooth caramel sauce. Remove from the heat and let it cool for at least 15 minutes.

2. Beat the whites until they form hard peaks. Add the yolks, condensed milk and orange juice. With your mixer set to its lowest speed, beat until blended, but not too much — you want to preserve as many air bubbles as possible.

3. Using a ladle, pour the custard mix into the mould gently so that it stays on top of the caramel instead of mixing with it. Cover the mould with tin foil. Bake in a pre-heated oven set to 350F for one and a half hours, in a bain-marie (meaning you have to put the mould inside a bigger one containing water, adding more if it dries up). Let it cool for at least 10 minutes. Run a knife around the edges and then unmould it onto a

platter, being careful to turn it quickly to the caramel sauce doesn't splatter all over the place. Garnish with pieces of strawberry and a sprig of mint (as in the photo) or any other kind of fresh fruit.

Spice up simple boneless chicken

Like many foodies I scour newspapers, magazines and cookbooks for recipes that catch my eye. I am always on the lookout for a recipe that is tasty, interesting and uniquely flavoured, but also fairly straightforward to make.

I'm pleased to report that I have just the kind of recipe we're all looking for and we have Lucy Waverman to thank.

Waverman is one of Canada's most successful food writers. Her substantial food resume includes a number of cookbooks to her credit.

Today's recipe is as delicious as it is dead simple. You mix up a bunch of stuff in the food processor, slap it on some boneless chicken, and roast it in the oven. You could even prepare it ahead of time and then shove it in the oven just before dinner. Could it be much easier?

This recipe takes about 15 minutes to prepare and 20 to 25 minutes to cook. I suggest serving it with basmati or jasmine rice.

INDIAN SPICED ROAST CHICKEN (Serves two)

4 large boneless chicken breasts
Salt and freshly ground pepper
For the mint-chili pesto:
2 tablespoons (25 mL) fresh ginger, chopped
2 tablespoons (25 mL) garlic, chopped
1 teaspoon (5 mL) garam masala
1 teaspoon (5 mL) jalapeno pepper
1/4 cup (50 mL) fresh mint, chopped
1 tablespoon (15 mL) lemon juice
3 tablespoons (50 mL) vegetable oil
Preheat oven to 425 F (220 C).

DIRECTIONS

1. Combine all pesto ingredients in a food processor and process until smooth. Rub over chicken and season to taste with salt and pepper.

2. Place chicken in a greased shallow dish or skillet and roast for 20 to 25 minutes, or until chicken is fully cooked and no traces of pink remain and juices run clear.

Desmarais to give a lesson in jazz piano

There's a lesson in jazz piano coming to Lennoxville, but there's no playing involved. At least not for the audience.

On Oct. 16, Lorraine Desmarais will give her piano lecture concert *Evolution of Jazz Piano* at Centennial Theatre.

The award-winning pianist will present a program explaining the styles of jazz piano, the differences between the periods of jazz music and give examples of every style.

Desmarais, known for her own compositions and style of jazz piano, will be emulating the greats, including Scott Joplin, Bud Powell, Thomas "Fats" Waller, Chick Corea and McCoy Tyner, to better explain jazz music to the audience.

"We call it, 'everything you ever wanted to know about jazz but were afraid to ask,'" Desmarais jokes.

The conference was first performed in 1994. Desmarais did 50 concerts that year, 25 of them at the Maison de la Culture in Montreal. The next year, she took the conference on tour around Quebec.

"It's not me, not my own concert," she says. "But it's a nice compliment to my own work."

Desmarais says she prefers to work on her own compositions and improvisations when she plays, but the strict structure of the conference provides a challenge to her.

"They ask if I can play like Oliver Jones," she says. "I can try, and do a lit-

tle bit like him. But everybody has their own voice. You can still say this is Oliver Jones, this is Oscar Peterson, this is Lorraine Desmarais."

Desmarais first started playing on a toy piano. Her parents saw how much she enjoyed it and set her up in lessons.

"I already improvised at a young age," she says. "My teacher was good, sharing a love of music, not just technique."

Encouraged by her teacher, Desmarais pursued jazz piano.

"I have cassettes at home of my own compositions," she says. "They're from when I was 12."

Desmarais recently returned from a concert with the Nova Scotia Symphony, where she played the orchestral arrangement of her album *Love*. The CD kicks off with Victor Young's *When I Fall in Love*, and follows with a series of songs exploring the many facets of love that Desmarais wrote. The orchestral arrangement was done by Simon Leclerc of the Orchestre Symphonique de Montreal.

"Symphony orchestras really like playing the music," she says. "They want new repertoire. Most of the orchestras I've worked with have really like the new aspect of jazz."

Desmarais's next project is an album of classic Christmas tunes for next year. She's looking forward to touring after its release.

"I wish we had a tour now," she jokes.

Her next performance is in Croatia for the Association of composers of Croatia.

The musicians were in separate booths, but playing together.

"If you're playing jazz, it's really hard to have the proper feeling playing track to track," Dubuc explains. "The way you're blowing influences the other musicians. The spontaneity and creativity is boosted with playing at the same time."

Le Chat du Moulinier opened originally as Le Chat Noir in Magog. Three years ago, the restaurant and bar moved to Place le Moulinier for the panoramic view of Lake Memphrémagog. The restaurant is known for its eclectic cuisine and live shows, featuring the house regulars, including Dubuc and his wife, and well known performers

including Rane Lee, Stephanie Biddle and Carol Welsman.



Dubuc said the restaurant's Web site, www.lechatdumoulinier.com, has been great for bringing in people.

"We have 1,500 people on our list, Le Club des Chats, the Cat's Club," he says. "We have a committed clientele."

La Treizième Note will be launched Friday night with a happy hour from 5 to 7 p.m., followed by dinner and a show featuring the performers from the album. That is, except François Morin.

"He's getting married the next morning," Dubuc says. "We didn't expect him."

Local artist feels her work evolving

Suzanne Deslauriers' paintings and figurative artwork have been admired by many throughout the area in recent years. Her studies in Plastic and Graphic Arts have led her down a path that has seen her work evolve from abstract oil painting, to her current love of working with textures.

Her use of collage, using coloured cutouts, horse hair, fur and cotton cloth produce a sand-like texture as background for her artwork.

"I still enjoy painting with oil, but I find that working with collage and textured art keeps me constantly in the discovery mode," explained Deslauriers. "Using this technique, I find that I am able to achieve a greater depth of emotion and activity than I could by merely using paints. The energy comes from its roughness and actual lack of perfection."

Even as a child, Deslauriers was interested in art. Although she tried other interests, she always seemed to come back to her love of painting. She feels the world has so much natural beauty to offer. It is for this reason that she decided to spend three months dur-

ing her university years backpacking throughout Europe.

She deliberately chose this form of travel because she didn't want to be labelled as a tourist. It was in this way that she was able to really mix with the people and learn from their cultures. She would sit for hours sketching local people and scenes.

"It was an exciting time but problems did arise, due to the fact that I couldn't always speak the language and was unfamiliar with my surroundings," Deslauriers added. "I remember visiting one museum in particular. I was so fascinated by one of the paintings that I tried to get as close as possible to study it. What a commotion! I didn't have any idea that I was the one who was causing such a stir! It was only through the kindness of someone who could speak the language that I finally understood and very sheepishly stepped back."

Deslauriers' work has been exhibited at the Centre Culturel Azur and most recently as a part of the symposium Estrie Vert. She is currently making plans to exhibit her work in Montreal next summer.

"It took a lot of encouragement on

Life After George lacks emotion

The Centaur Theatre held its season opening in Old Montreal recently with the Canadian premiere of the Australian play *Life After George*. Playwright Hannie Rayson flew in

from Melbourne to attend the evening. Given all the hoopla, was the play itself worthwhile? It all depends – if you enjoy overly long and earnest theatre with little to offer in the way of wit or emotional impact, then *George* is the play you're after.

The play went on for three hours – and it is definitely a two-hour story. Rayson wrote the play in 2000 and it has been produced in Australia, London, and now Montreal. Somewhere during that time somebody might have suggested some judicious editing. Or perhaps it started out being four hours long!

There are over 60 scenes in the production, and though it is deftly directed by Gordon McCall, the play drags. Much of the information is unnecessary and many of the scenes are redundant. Compacting the play would have improved it. The story just isn't good enough to go on that extra hour.

The plot revolves around Professor Peter George (George to his intimates), who crashes his plane in the opening scene. His three wives gather for the funeral, along with his daughter Ana. His best friend Alan Duffy tries to keep the peace between the women.

George may be dead from the first scene on, but he makes many appearances in flashbacks. He is a likeable man, passionate and convicted, full of integrity where intellectual standards are involved, much less moral in his personal life. His three wives are all interesting and accomplished women. His daughter has never grown up and out of his shadow. His infi-

delities are exposed as the play unfolds.

Secrets are revealed, funeral plans are made and unmade, and some life-altering realizations take place by the end of the show. A lot is happening – but the core of caring is missing.

Ron White heads an excellent cast as George. Deborah Kipp plays first wife Batrix, Patricia Yeatman is superb as the unsympathetic second wife Lindsay, and Paula Jean Hixson is the widow, Poppy. Anne Day-Jones is good as the rather annoying Ana, and Kent Allen is solid as George's best friend Duffy. The set is minimal but imaginative, and director Gordon McCall has given us a polished production.

Despite fully developed characterizations, the people in this play somehow don't move us. It is not the fault of the actors – it is a thoroughly good ensemble. Rayson has written the play with too much emphasis on ideas and not enough on emotions.

This production has some merits, but not everyone will enjoy this show. For a student of 20th century leftist history there is a lot of meat. For a playgoer wanting to be touched or moved, there are just too many words.

Five questions with Jackie Hall

Q & A

For the last several years, Jackie Hall has been working on raising literacy rates in both adults and children in the Estrie area. Her crusade has taken her as far as creating the group Literacy in Action, formerly St. Francis Literacy Organization.

The Record recently sat down with Jackie for an interview.

THE RECORD: How and why did you first get involved in the literacy project?

HALL: "I was asked to take over Leila Atkins' adult class in Magog when she retired. It is a very difficult thing for an adult to admit that they have a problem such as this, and even more difficult for him to ask for help. I felt the key was to focus on family life — bring the opportunity into the family when the children are young. A parent is much more comfortable asking for help for their kids than themselves. In the end, they all win."

THE RECORD: What made you decide to 'home school' your children?

HALL: "There are three types of literacy: functional, cultural and marginal. School and hospital systems today have become so big that it is impossible to see the individual person. Handing my children over to a system that I didn't really believe in didn't seem quite right."

"I taught my children to participate and appreciate life's gifts through reading stories, cooking and general family togetherness. The special time that I spent curled up next to the fire reading to my kids while other parents were shipping their little ones off to the bus will always be very precious to all of us."

"About three years ago, the Waldorf School moved into Waterville as part of the alternative education offered by public school system. My kids have been attending this school ever since. The curriculum of Waldorf deals with the whole person, the spirit, mind and heart. Music and art are a part of classes."

THE RECORD: You also have a love of dance and music from the days of our ancestors. What is contra-dancing?

HALL: "Contra-dancing is actually a form of Appalachian clogging which has no specific steps. The actual dance is influenced by the actual mood of the music. I guess it is really a mix of Irish and Québécois dancing styles."

"I also teach this type of dancing, and am delighted with the interest of the young people lately, especially the Bishop's crowd. In the U.S., contra dancing is very popular in the 40 to 60's crowd, but it is so exciting to see this newest development. Nicolas Williams, from Tuq, will be playing at our upcoming dance on Oct. 18. His music has a sort of Celtic/gypsy sound to it."

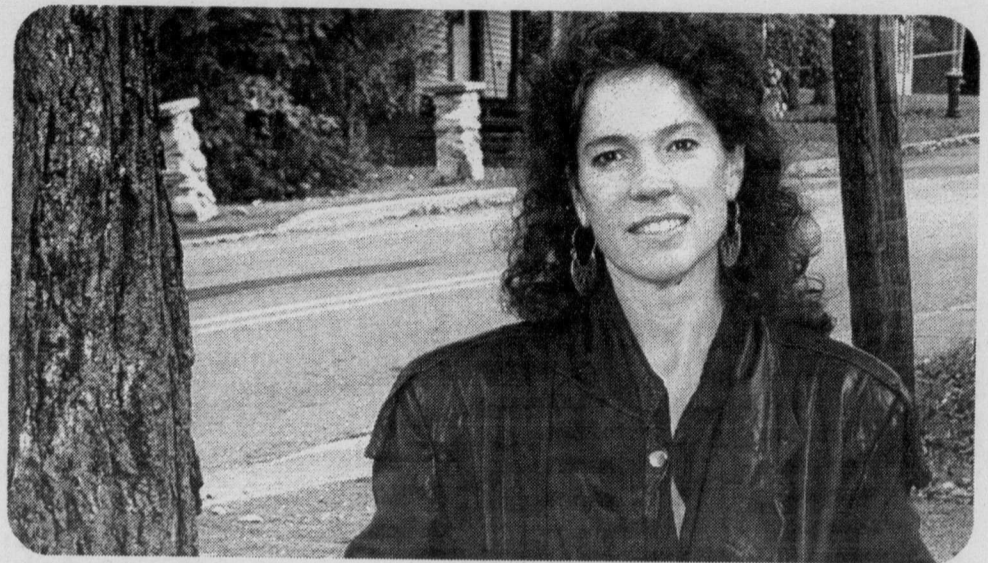
THE RECORD: Tell us a little about some of Literacy in Action's projects to increase public awareness?

HALL: "This year was our fifth year putting on the Words on a String Festival. This open-air festival centers on family involvements, theatrical shows and readings, and music."

"Our association with the Tools for Life Project in Stanstead has also been great. The young mothers and children involved in the project learned how to make the most of what they had and talents that they weren't even aware of. The co-ordinating staff was perfectly matched for the project."

THE RECORD: Could you elaborate on why you think communication is so important?

HALL: "I believe that it is very important to work on ourselves as individuals. The answers are all inside us. When I speak about communication, I am not just referring to talking but the most important aspect is listening. Marilyn Manson, despite much negative press, was right on the mark with his answer when someone asked what he would say to the kids involved in the Columbine tragedy - 'I wouldn't say anything, I would just listen.'"

This will mark the fourth visit this year for the amazing guitarist, who is

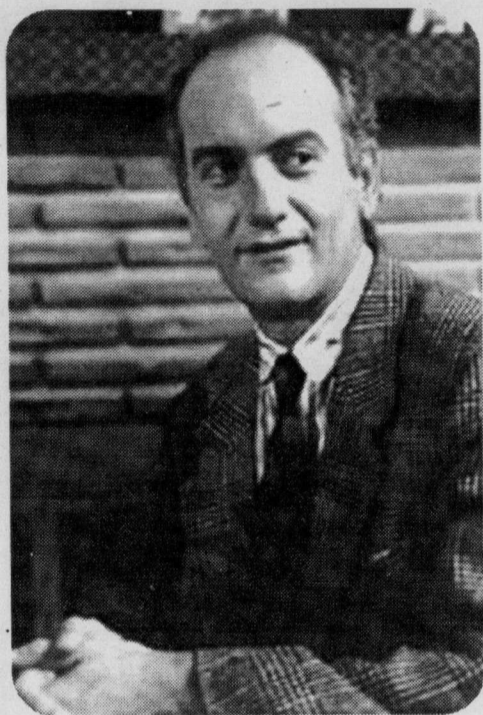
still on tour promoting his latest album Six String Therapy.

Director loves the area so much he's moved here

The Eastern Townships, a recent home to big-budget movie shoots including *The Human Stain*, *Taking Lives* and *The Secret Window*, will now welcome another production by a director who loves the area so much that he has moved here.

Director, producer, writer, editor and actor Bashar Shbib is preparing to film his latest project, entitled *Graniteville*, in the area. Not only that, but he has also set up residence full time in Stanstead.

Shbib is best known for his work on films *Julia Has Two Lovers*, *The Kiss*, and *Strawberries and Wine*. He has worked with the likes Dominec Cara-

PELLA, Geoff Deadman, Neil McDonough (now acting on the TV series *Boomtown*) and former *X-files* lead David Decovney.

His films have also appeared at the Berlin Film Festival, and received critical acclaim at both the Montreal Film Festival and the New Orleans Film Festival.

"I spent my youth growing up on a Charolais beef ranch in Coaticook, so I am very familiar with the area," said Shbib. "I did move to Los Angeles for a while, but I returned because of the mentality of the Canadian people. Their openness is very refreshing."

Graniteville is a murder mystery that takes place in a small town. He has been holding casting calls for the last couple of months to fill the positions that are needed.

"I want to involve as many local people as possible," said Shbib, who is president of his own independent film production company, Oneira Pictures International.

"I originally wanted to call the pro-

duction *Granite Falls*, but I recently found out that there was a copyright on that name, so it is now entitled *Graniteville*. The sessions will wrap up in December, and we plan to start shooting sometime in March."

More than 65 people, ages five through 70, have already answered the casting call for actors and crew members. They will be divided up into two teams that will receive a 10-week training session.

Shbib is also bringing in two people from Montreal, one from New York and one from Hungary to host the sessions.

A special screenwriting workshop will also be starting on Oct. 15. At the end of this time, each participant will have written their own screenplay.

Shbib said his prudent shooting schedules enable him to freely direct and produce the modestly budgeted movies that he personally enjoys making. He noted that at least 25 per cent of his crew on *Graniteville* will be made up of trainees.

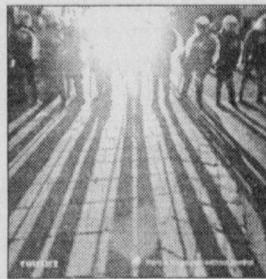

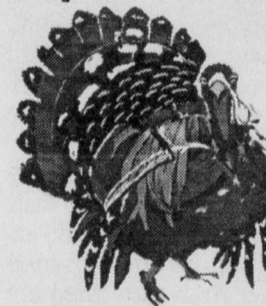

Yasir Arafat is master of disappointment

The bloody rivalry between Israel and the Palestinians seems never to move from the top of the news. When observing the terrible events occurring in the Middle East, it's easy to conclude that the present situation will never end positively, as long as Yasir Arafat and his nemesis Ariel Sharon are occupying the driver's seat of their respective people.

But it's important to understand the personalities of the players in this sad spectacle.

After reading 'Yasir Arafat: A Political Biography' it's easy to grasp the fact that the problem does not necessarily come only from Ariel Sharon or any other Israel politician.

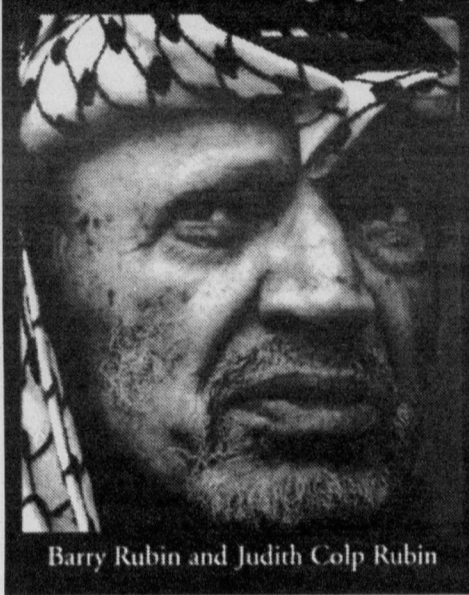
Of course, Ariel Sharon is sticking to his view of what is right and just. But he was not always Israel's prime minister of Israel, while Yasir Arafat has been leading the Palestinians since the 1960s. And a lasting peace was never achieved, even when Israel's Labour Party controlled the levers of power.

Many times, in the last 20 years, Palestinians were offered an opportunity to obtain their own State and contribute to establishing a lasting peace. But, according to authors Barry Rubin and Judith Colp Rubin, these opportunities were always missed, because of the intransigence of one man: Yasir Arafat.

This political biography offers the reader a unique opportunity to discover Yasir Arafat's personality. Lies, double-talk, exaggeration, manipulation and poisoned relations with other Arab statesmen are only examples of the many disappointing traits of this historical figure's personality.

During the various negotiations to settle the Israeli-Palestinian issue, Arafat refused most of the time to offer anything substantial, while demanding a lot from the other side of the table. And "one of Arafat's greatest skills was his ability to convince so many that he really wanted

peace but had been cheated and victimized by others.

The sheer audacity of his behaviour helped to promote this claim. Who could believe he would turn down a chance to get an independent state and rescue his people from occupation if made a good offer? But this is precisely what had happened." That's the Arafat technique, according to the authors.

The authors demonstrate that the Palestinian leader is much more interested in the cause he defends than in the well-being of his people. In this eloquently-researched biography, we also encounter a man who micro-manages the Palestinian Authority, depriving it of real democracy.

The authors also illustrate that the destruction of Israel is far from over in the Palestinian Authority's mind. During all the time spent at the negotiation table, violence remained at the top of the list of the ways used to achieve the goals of the Palestinian Authority.

As long as Israelis will not be convinced that their disappearance from the Middle East is not the ultimate goal of the Palestinian Authority and its monarch, lasting peace and security will remain out of reach.

After reading this monumental biography, Yasir Arafat's opponents will see their fears and perceptions justified, while his defenders will have a hard time responding to such a meticulous work. Definitely, this book is required reading for anybody who truly wants to understand the enduring unrest in the Middle East.

Yasir Arafat is debunked, finally.

Garbo laughs

Movie buffs and novel lovers will be captivated by Elizabeth Hay's second novel, *Garbo Laughs*, which tells the story of Harriet Browning, her family and friends. Harriet was deprived of movies as a child and is making up for lost time. In the process, her two children, the remarkable Kenny and his sister Jane, become amazingly knowledgeable about the medium of film.

While Harriet is the main character, Kenny is the one who captivates my heart. At 10, Kenny is obsessed with movies. His bible is a 1996 movie guide, and he wears an outfit complete with fedora to show his love of Frank Sinatra. He can't believe his mother prefers Marlon Brando to Sinatra.

Kenny constantly asks questions about movies and actors, generally as a means of assessment. And it is Kenny who introduces the family to Dinah, a neighbour who becomes part of the Friday night film club of Harriet, Kenny and Jane. Lew, Harriet's husband, has minimal interest in films, but indulges his family's desires. Dinah shares Kenny's opinion of Sinatra and she adores the serious little boy, as anyone who reads this novel will.

Harriet is fascinating rather than adorable. She is a writer who spends much of her time not writing. Movies fill her life, and when she is not watching them, she is writing letters to her idol, Pauline Kael. (As someone who bought *The New Yorker* for years, just because of Kael's film reviews, I understand Harriet's love of the critic's highly idiosyncratic, knowledgeable and appreciative of emotion).

As Harriet says in one of her letters to Kael: "You loved Cary Grant too, and unashamedly. But you loved him

in a hardbitten way, condoning our addiction and wondering at it and mocking it, but above all understanding it. A woman with the courage of your romantic, skeptical, humour-filled convictions."

Missives to Kael are scattered throughout the novel, and in them Harriet reveals herself far more than she does to Lew or anyone else.

But interest in film is only one of the things this novel has going for it. Hay does a splendid job of capturing Ottawa, including the great ice storm. Her style comprises the ironic and the concrete in a deliriously moving way: of the storm, the narrator remarks, "Outside it was incredibly beautiful and birds were dying."

Hay's work is filled with such verbal punches. One of my favourite (and the book is loaded with them) is the skewering of Aunt Leah, a basically nasty old woman who, in response to Harriet's comment that her nap was short, retorts: "I only ever need 20 minutes." The narrator tells us that she delivers this line "with the appalling conceit of the energetic."

It's perfect. The cranky and hypercritical Leah is also described with devastating precision as being like "Mussolini watching a train arrive late."

The novel ranges through films, family, friends, romance, love, illness, death and much of the detail of daily life. While it presents a fully formed world in which readers can lose themselves, it also offers the opportunity for self-reflection. Its blend of tragedy and comedy feels balanced and realistic, and the language is clear and sharp, paving the way for admiration and contemplation.

Eastwood had to fight for film

It was the sweetest of vindications for 73-year-old Clint Eastwood when a capacity New York Film Festival audience rose to its feet last Friday night at New York's Lincoln Centre for the Performing Arts and gave his new movie, *Mystic River*, a tumultuous standing ovation.

And that sense of vindication was renewed over and over again at a subsequent reception which kept the veteran filmmaker up until 3.30 a.m. acknowledging the congratulations of well-wishers.

Eastwood's triumph has an underlying irony. It's one of the worst kept secrets of the industry that *Mystic River* — a compelling adaptation of novelist Dennis Lehane's sombre best-seller about an act of child molestation and its destructive impact 25 years later on the lives of those most involved — almost didn't get made. But now, after stellar launchings at both the Cannes and New York festivals, it stands in the front ranks of this year's Oscar contenders.

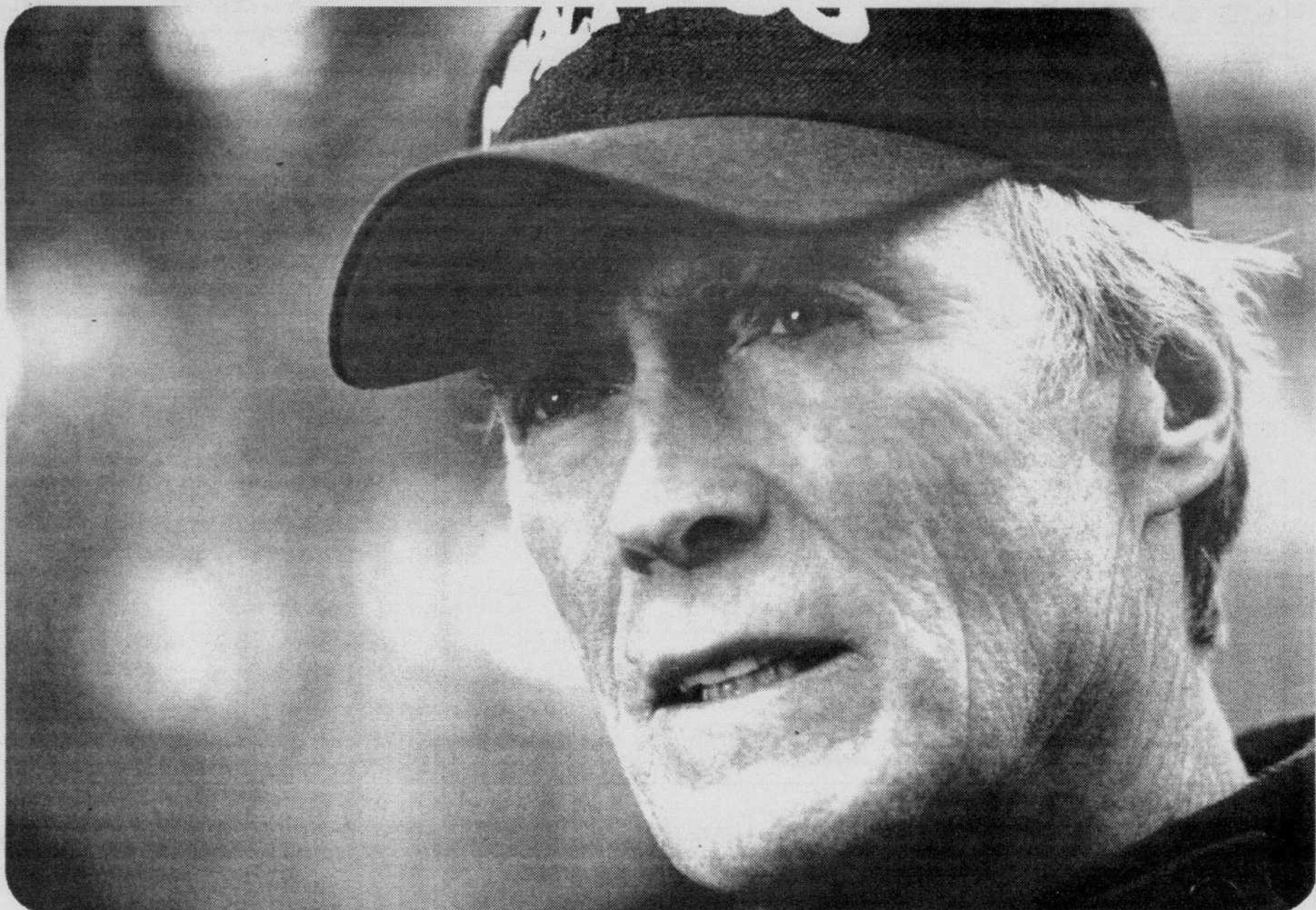
"The studio didn't want Clint to do it," one of Eastwood's closest confidantes told CanWest News Service the morning after the New York Film Festival launching. "They didn't want any part of it." But because Warner Brothers, the studio in question, has had a long and lucrative relationship with Eastwood, both as director and actor, it finally greenlit a project it hated — but with the proviso that he stay within a \$25-million budget, a meagre figure by today's standards.

Eastwood told The Los Angeles Times in the summer that Warner Brothers "finally did it almost as a favor. They said I was welcome to take it anywhere else. Like — 'Thanks for the vote of confidence.'"

Eastwood was determined to make *Mystic River* on location in blue-collar Boston where the story takes place. He rejected any attempt to save money by having Toronto or Montreal stand in for the Massachusetts city. He knew that Boston — or rather a grey, drab but immensely vital Boston that the tourists never see — was one of the movie's vital characters and that second-hand imitations wouldn't work.

Eastwood waived his normal director's salary. Members of his blue-ribbon cast — Sean Penn, Laura Linney, Marcia Gay Harden, Tim Robbins, Kevin Bacon, Laurence Fishburne — believed in the project so strongly and were so anxious to work with Eastwood that they took salary cuts. Eastwood ended up making the movie for less than the \$25 million available to him and also brought it in under schedule.

Screenwriter Brian Helgeland normally directs his own scripts these days, but he agreed to adapt Lehane's novel because it was for Eastwood. "Clint has this grandfather clause," Helgeland laughs.

"Nobody wanted to make the movie really. It's sort of Clint's force of will that got it made."

And Helgeland, who wrote L.A. Confidential and directed the successful *Knight's Tale*, says it's clear to him why Warners didn't want to make *Mystic River*. "Studios don't know how to make dramas any more," he says bluntly. "They don't know how to make any movie. They know how to make bad movies."

Helgeland says that the studio was also reluctant because Eastwood was working as director only.

"He's not in it (so) they don't have that to sell. But the thing is that because it's a

struggle for him to get it made, I think it makes him love it even more because he's the only one out there loving it. It makes for a better filmmaker when you're the guy who has to push it through."

Eastwood was drawn to the novel by the same plot element that made the industry wary: when a child is molested, the crime has repercussions which reach a further tragic outcome 25 years later.

Eastwood told the Los Angeles Times in the spring that because he is a father, child abuse has always been an obsession.

"It's a robbery of a person's life in a way they can never retrieve. It's the worst kind of abusiveness because the child is totally at the mercy of adults."

In the movie, opening today (EDS: Oct.

8) in Toronto and Oct. 15 elsewhere, Tim Robbins plays an emotionally scarred husband and father who is still haunted by the kidnapping and abuse he suffered as a child. Kevin Bacon and Sean Penn play his two childhood friends: Bacon is now a homicide detective investigating the brutal murder of Penn's daughter.

Despite a mounting number of rave reviews, *Mystic River* is seen as a major marketing challenge for Warner Brothers. But Eastwood himself seems optimistic. "I have never lost the idealistic feeling that there is an audience out there that wants something better than guys hanging on a wire or standing in front of a blue screen," he told The Times in late May.

Caine dishes up a new career

Michael Caine is feeling a renewed itch to get back into the restaurant business. The two-time Academy Award winner has opened 20 over the years and has sold them all. But the other day he spotted some vacant premises in his native London and figured they would be perfect for a food place.

"My wife goes in fear that I'm going back into the restaurant business," Caine chuckles. But he insists that this time he'll keep the number down to no more than two.

In the past, Caine owned successful restaurants in both Britain and in Florida, and he has some firm ideas on the ingredients for a successful one. "People say to me, 'You're not the cook?' and I say 'No.' Then they say, 'You're not a restaurateur?' And I say, 'No.' Then they ask, 'So what are you?' And I say, 'I'm the customer from hell!'"

"I go into that restaurant, and the first thing I say to the chef is: 'I'm not going to tell you anything about cooking because you're the chef. But I'll tell you two things that have to be right — the bread and the coffee. Because the bread's the first thing I taste and the coffee's the last thing. You're responsible for the middle.'"

And what about the premises themselves? Caine has some simple rules. "I've studied restaurants and everybody must be able to see everybody at all times. No corners, no round corners, because the restaurant must be the spectacle. They are not coming here to eat and then go on to the movies or the theatre or the ball game. They come in here for the evening — because once you've got rid of the food, you then get to the profitable part where they sit and get bombed. And you're selling wine, which is where the money is. Pasta and wine are a license to print money. Steak is a disaster."

Caine says steak poses two problems. The first is that there is no real restaurant mark-up on the steak to begin with. "But not only that, if you make the steak and they say, 'I asked for medium rare and this is a medium,' you take it away and throw it away. There goes your profit."

CRUISING FOR A BRUISIN'

Tom Cruise could find himself in hot water with British filmgoers if he goes ahead with plans to star in a new Second World War movie about the Battle of Britain. According to reports in the London media, the film will suggest that an American had a lot to do with winning it,

even though the United States had yet to enter the war.

Cruise is slated to play real-life American airman Billy Fisk, and the script has him lead the Allies to victory over the German Luftwaffe. RAF veterans are reportedly furious about the project because Fisk only flew three combat missions, was one of just 12 Americans involved in the battle, never downed a single German plane and was killed when he crash-landed his aircraft. But they are also angry over the provisional title for the film. It's "The Few" which is the mythic phrase long applied to the heroic British airmen who helped save the country from German invasion during its darkest hour.

The London Daily Star reported that a Hollywood insider had said that the film would never get an industry greenlight if an English actor had the starring role. "The hero must be an American. The public wouldn't have it any other way."

If the film goes ahead it will create even more uproar in Britain than the shameless Hollywood fabrication, U-571, which rewrote history to claim that the U.S. Navy and not the Royal Navy captured the Germans' top-secret Enigma codebook.

Alan Jackson conundrum is easy to solve

Why is Alan Jackson so popular? That is the question people often ask me, so the first thing I tell them is that it's more than just his good looks.

The real reason Jackson is so well liked is that everybody can relate to his music. He performs songs about real life and real people. No one in country music has poured their heart and soul into the lyrics more than this tall singer does. Anyone who listens to his music has the impression of knowing Jackson on a personal level.

He has also been extremely generous with his fans, and this is another reason why people always loved him so much. There's no ego trip with Jackson. Every new award finds him as humble as ever.

Case in point, his Greatest Hits Volume II. Nearly all of the album's songs are truly inspired by his own life and

experiences, as he always finds an original way to write about it.

The compilation features 18 songs taken from the albums Everything I Love, High Mileage, Under The Influence, When Somebody Loves You and Drive. It is a wonderful collection for those who like listening to the hits one after the other.

Jackson often uses the perspective of the blue collars when he writes. The singles 'Little Bitty' and 'Where I Come From' are perfect examples of how the lanky, blond singer still remembers where he comes from.

Jackson can also be more intimate when talking about his own relationships, like he does on 'Drive (For Daddy Gene)' a song about his father teaching him how to drive a car.

He goes deeper writing about love on 'I'll Go On Loving You', 'It Must Be Love'

and the romantic 'When Somebody Loves You'. He also gets highly emotional on 'Where Were You (When The World Stopped Turning)' about the tragedy at World Trade Centre.

When the Georgia native decided to release a complete album with nothing but covers from his favourite artists' hits, he pulled it off. He covered classics by Don Williams, Jim Ed Brown, Hank Williams Jr., Merle Haggard and more. He did it with reverence, but amazingly managed to chart with some of these covers. 'Pop a Top' was a huge success for Jackson, and made new fans discover old classics. Only Jackson could get away with this. The Greatest Hits collection also offers

two new numbers. The first one is the Jimmy Buffet style 'It's Five o'clock Somewhere', a catchy song that includes a duet with Buffet himself. The song, which came out as a single this past summer, was favourite for most everyone.

The second song, 'Remember When', is a husband-and-wife ballad that only Jackson could deliver. His honesty seems to turn everything to gold, while his consistency as a singer/songwriter is really impressive.

From sentimental ballads to high-spirited drinking songs, from goofy material to statement songs, Jackson knows how to keep a good balance. What this greatest hits package does is make us want another album of new material by Jackson.

The road to success was not an easy one for Jackson, but his perseverance got him to do exactly what he wanted for a living: Great music.
